

The success of this number for the Groop, will be the best promotion to launch their names on the English scene.


### BEE GEES' SINGLE

# Gospel influence is enormous

Soul is this incredible thing that comes from so many musical places like blues and gospel and jazz and rock. As I'm writing this I'm listening to one of the few soul sessions on Sydney radio. And it's after 10 at night. So that's what it all means I suppose. Please, God please send some more soul to Sydney.

The part that religion and gospel singing played in the evolution of soul music is probably the most vital of all. To skim quickly through the biographies of every singer would reveal that nearly all sang with neighbourhood church choirs or as soloists.

JOE TEX who sang with his father and sisters in their home town of Baytown Texas The late OTIS REDDING'S musical protege. ARTHUR

## ARETHA IN CHURCH

The best example or this influence is Aretha Franklin who from her early teens song with her tather, the Rev. C. L. Franklin and her two sisters at the local negro church

Aretha made several gospel recordings with her father before immersing herself in the pop world. Even now her sisters accompany her and the gospel music influence is unmistakable. The grass roots of soul is unmistakably gospel. The hot brand of musical excitement that most negro churches pro-duce makes its presence felt in many ways

The receptly released Wilson Pickett L.P. "I'm In receibly released witsom receible 1.P. "The In Love" features a strongly gossel styled number "Tee Come A Long Way." Pa kett actually began his professional career as a gospel sunger in Detroit and worked as such until 1999. Then he joined a group called the FALONS as lead singer and with them sang an exciting mixture of rhythm and blues and gospel until his smash hit releases with Atlantic record company from 1964 onwards





## RAY CHARLES CARRIES BIBLE

Probably the best known scul singer Ray Chai-les though religious to the point of always carrying a biaille bible, disclaims the influence of gospel iste on his singing

Though he sang in charches and earlier in his life undertook some religious training he still main tains. My music comes from the way I feel and not from being influenced by gospel music.



COLIN PETERSON

Fifteen months ago, the three Gibb brothers, better known as the Bee Gee's left Australia for England.

Their 10 years in Australia had hardly proved fruitful considering the time and energy these boys had given to the Australian pop scene.

Oddly enough, the Bes Gee's were leaving Australia at a time when their current record "Spicks and Specks" was number one on the Australian National top 40 . . . this being their first ever national number one hit.

Prior to this record they had only achieved minor success on the charts.

The three Gibb boys arrived in England completely unknown. But lady fortune smiled on them and within three weeks they had secured a recording contract and were under the personal management of Robert Stigwood, who was a director of the Brian Epstein organisation. NEMS.

To strengthen the line-up of the group, the Gibb brothers asked two Australians, Vince Melouney and Colin Peterson, who were living in London at the

time to join them. The stage was set for the Bee Gees to release their first English record . . . it was titled "New York Mining Disaster".

"We take is more as a compliment than a nasty remark" said Robin. "We have always admired the Beatles, and to us they will always be the number one group. But one must remember that we were singing and writing our own style of music long before the

Beatles became a big name. "It is very hard," added Barry, "to have to change your own sound just because you happen to sound like someone else. I think it would be fair to say that the Beatles' basic sound is a universal sound that most

pop groups throughout the world are governed by." Since the Bee Gees have become one of the world's top groups they have been working flat out.
