I little over a year ago, five guys who called themselves the Iguana lived in Mel-bourne, tried to earn a decent living, and also played music and sang high, real high.

Their brand of entertainment was classified differently to most other Melbourne pop groups monies and involved vocal arrangements. Like most pop groups, their first aim was

to release an original single. This they did with a song titled "Imagine This". The number hardly set the world on fire,

in fact it only resulted in a trickle of smoke. Unperturbed by this failure, the five boys, Gary Sweetman (lead singer), Peter Saunders immer). Graeme Jones (bass) and Cleve and Gary Littlewood (guitarists) searched for a new formula.

BRILLIANT VOCALS

As the latter part of '67 went by the Iguana started to gain popularity on the Melbourne

Many of the top groups admired them for their simple, yet brilliant, vocal arrangements. It wasn't until January of this year that it began to happen for the Iguana.

They had just completed the summer sea side resort season, and were due to put down their second single.

Looking for recording material, the Iguana visited Sydney. During their stay, they per-formed at a couple of gigs . . . the re-action was amazing, and return bookings poured in:

The boys returned to Melbourne and de-cided to record a number, which had beet originally recorded by the 5th Dimension it was titled "California My Way"

The story of "California My Way" is still happening. After five months on the Go-Set Australian National Top 15, the Iguana still hold place No. 11.

During this time they have become one Australia's top attractions, and Brisbane has become their second home.

AUSTRALIAN SONG

Just recently Peter, their drummer, was called up for National Service, so they replaced him with a young Melbourne guy called Russell McGregor

Last week their third single was released titled "Sunshine People". Although the number is not an original, it is an Australian composition. It was written by Hans Poulson who. incidentally penned Johnny Farnham's "Jamie"

The Iguana's main aim at the moment is to try and open up the Australian recording market. They are concentrating on original numbers with a jazz influence and commercial

Here's hoping for the Iguana's sake and the Australian scene that their venture is suc

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
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CA'S NEW GUIDE TO FIVE OF AMERICA'S TOP NEW GROUPS



TERRY BRITTEN HAS A GO TOO

Last week, Groove bass player Jamie Byrne made some very outspoken comments about the state of the Australian pop scene and it's top groups. This week we asked the country's top group the Twillights to contribute their thoughts.

Lead guitarist Terry Britten agreed to voice their honest opinions for the first time ever in Go-Set.

CROOVE

The Groove are just doing what we did with "Needle In A Haystack" — using commercial overseas material, only they we done it three times in succession. The Groove should wake up and record some of their own material, and give people a chance to see what they are made of.

Even if it does flop, it does you more good at least you are giving your fans something which is you, instead of a blue print of something else word for word, note for note.

Australians aren't helping Australian talent by buying a reproduction of overseas stuff.

MASTERS APPRENTICES

The Masters are a lot poppier than the Twilights. What else can you say about the Masters except they believe their own publicity. It seems to me when a new member enters the Masters. Jim takes him aside and gives him

the lowdown "Listen man, we're a pop group. Here's \$5 go and buy a big hat and some bright, bright clothes." We did all that a year ago, and now the Masters get credit for being original.

The fact that Australians can praise the Masters for being original only reflects on how far behind the scene here is. Even overseas groups, with the death of the hippy cult have groups, with the death of the hippy cult have least to exploit. They are moos collected and drearer, relying on themselves and their music rather than an image.

MAX MERRITT

If you want to put everything on a world scale, as we seem to do here all the time now, comparing our supposed tog groups with overseas acts — there are thousands of Max Merritts with real voices. He really only counts here with the aspiring "in" people — but Max Rows this, his pretentious audiences don't.

TWILIGHTS AND POP SCENE IN GENERAL

We don't rely on overseas material, clothes, takes pretentious images or sex publicity. We're trying to be as honest as we can. I'm sure when the Twilights eventually break up, they will feel a lot more satisfied and calmed the satisfied and the satisfie

The only worthwhile person who is in the position to criticise is Stan Rofe who will rubbish and criticise, but also offer advice and a possible remedy.

They used to say Colin Buckley was the best singer in Australia - but they also said he was the wildest man on the pop scene.

Take the famous occasion that his record com-pany finally broke down and paid for a cocktail slush-up promote one of his re

Colin was young, hot headed and slightly stoned. He was sick of being a "non play" artist and lined up the disc-jockey guests. and told them that the whole party was a waste of time because they wouldn't be dropping any action on his disc no matter how much free booze they get.

Colin went on to get ever higher and almost spent the guest of the Victoria Police

While other artists envied his voice, they loved to re peat stories about his famous rows, which in the end all but wiped him out

as a performer. The legend about his voice grew and grew and so did the legends about him being

Just about every manage: in Melbourne at the time had affairs, but nothing good ever

Perhaps he missed his big chance when he used to work on the same bandstand as Normie Rowe for Ivan Dayman.

Normie would clap his hands between his solos and had the longest hair of any artist on the scene.

Colin hissed in his ear: "Why don't you forget the hair and take some singing lessons like I do?"

Normie ignored him and went on to be a big star. All Colin got was to be better singer for all the les sons, but he was never a big

Colin was still a musos singer, but he made some ousy records - he admits it

The first hit was "Hand ive" which didn't do too badly for him, others were "Itty Bitty Love", "Thirteen Women" and "I Got My Eyes On You".

The Big Mistake according to Colin was copying Elvis Presley's "Little Egypt"

"That labelled me as Presley impersonator and I vas never able to shake it off", he says.

But the odd truth is that Colin's musical taste runs to pure soul, and he was wall-ing like James Brown and the funkiest of them before the record buying public had ever heard of them.

Colin probably was never a bad guy at all.

He was just a hot head who was brought up to look after himself and had too nuch ambition.

His reputation is not un justified. One day he was having a money "discussion" with a former manager, and when they disagreed Colin took the man's office apart stick by stick!

These days Colin is really cooling it. He has a steady job and
