

KFRC ANNIVERSARY
KFRC-San Francisco is celebrating their 50th anniversary and PD Michael Spears has prepared a super celebration for the city. They have arranged to brighten up San Francisco at night with a laser

beam light show. Lights will be visible 50 miles into the sky and are to be reflected off special mirrors atop the Mark Hopkins hotel. Station will also premiere the new Stones' movie, which requires a special installation of \$50,000 worth of sound equipment.

WBBF SIGN PROMO
WBBF-Rochester invited listeners at all the area high schools to make large signs with the call letters "BBF." They sent their Red Baron skywatch plane up to fly over the city. The winning school made a sign with a bunch of cars spelling out "BBF." Others made human chains on the ground. Station invited everyone to a special midnight movie at one of four theater locations.

LATE NEWS:

KLIF Jock Arrested

Linwood Henderson, "Cousin Linnie" at KLIF, was arrested and charged with theft involving 37 stolen television and stereo sets and other loot totalling \$13,000 in value, and charged with being the head of a major Dallas burglary ring. Two other men were also arrested. KLIF President and GM Al Lurie told R&R "KLIF has been informed by the Dallas Police Dept. that KLIF air personality Cousin Linnie Henderson has been charged with theft. Until justice has been done, Linnie has been placed on an immediate, indefinite, leave of absence with full pay, pending the outcome of this case..." PD Todd Wallace will soon announce an interim replacement and other shift changes but he added "...we are of course assuming Cousin Linnie is innocent."

PAT WHITLEY OUT AT WNBC

Perry Bascom, GM of WNBC announced that Pat Whitley was no longer the Program Director. There was no announcement of a new PD, although Al Brady will be sitting in until one is named.

WNCN TO WQIV-New York

Following up on the changeover from classical WNCN to progressive WQIV (for "Quad Four"), the format is to debut on the air October 5th. PD will be Larry Miller, from KUDL-Kansas City. Other jocks that have been named to the staff are Tom O'Hair, formally KSAN, and Rosco, formerly WNEW FM. Format will be somewhere between ABC's WPLJ and very progressive WNEW FM. The planned changes are subject to FCC approval.

CASPER CONSULTS 91Q

91Q-Hartford, Dick Casper, formerly KCBQ, then of the Heffel chain is now consultant to WRCH-Hartford which has gone on the air as "91Q". They began this past weekend with an oldie weekend featuring many of the top jocks that have been successful in this city over the past years. Joey Reynolds, Long John Wade, Jim Neddlefon and Lee Baby Sims all made guest appearances. Dick Ellis, former PD is out, Operations Manager is Lee Manson. Format is top 20 hits, with emphasis on gold. They call it "The Golden Sound of 91Q." Call letter change to WRCQ has not yet been approved. The guest jocks were only in for the weekend. Air talent is all new.



FM ROCK RADIO

BY MIKE HARRISON

"Official" record charts can be very misleading if the researcher is under the impression that a record's up and down number movement is parallel to its sales and popularity graph.

If a chart is designed to give records clean sweeping, accurate trends, then it is designed for the walls of record company executives and program directors who need thumbnail justification for every decision they make. The application of "body english" to a record to achieve this is made under the false assumption that records move through their place in the scheme of things with the same order and formation that the planets go around the sun. It is inaccurate.

Everything is relative. A runner can run the mile in six minutes and come in first in his race. Another can run it in four minutes in another race and place second. Who's the better runner?

For example, a couple of weeks ago the Bad Co. album moved from two to five on the R&R Album Chart. This week it's up to four from five. No, the album did not dip in popularity and is working its way back. Its sales and requests have consistently gotten stronger. Only in relation to other Top five albums did its rank drop.


It is conceivable for a record to go from two to one the same week that its sales go down depending upon how badly everything else is doing.

It is especially important to be aware of these things when doing oldies research. The odds are a record that was number three during Christmas week, was a bigger hit than the number one record in July of that year.

The next time your friendly record promoter tells you his record is moving in XYZ market and cites sales figures, check them out before you tell him "I won't play it because it lost its bullet."

Tickets for the initial date are sold out.. **Eric Clapton** is embarking on another tour this month labeled "mini-concert" due to only 10 day, 8 city dates which is basically **East Coast** with some **Canadian** stops. **Focus'** lead guitarist, **Jan Akkerman** just had a guitar named after him by **Franus Of Nashville**... The guitar is a "top of the line instrument" deluxe electric guitar selling for \$1,200.00 called **The Jan Akkerman Guitar**... **Peggy Lee** has a new album out on **Atlantic** which features a **Paul McCartney** song especially written for her entitled "Let's Love."

Veteran independent promotion man, **Del Roy**, has joined the firm of **Harvey Cooper & Associates** as announced last week by **Harvey Cooper**. Roy's experience in promotion and sales spans twenty years with strong Country and Western and MOR background... **Neal Ames** has been upped from General Manager to full partner at **Rustic Records** according to **Bobby Stevens**, President of the label. Ames background includes Presidency at **Buffalo Records** and Road manager for **Sly and The Family Stone**.. The **Country Division** of **Capitol Records** has moved its headquarters in **Nashville** to 806 16th Ave. South under the supervision of **Frank Jones** who is the General Manager and **CRI Vice-President** of the division. Jones has named **Bill Williams** as National Country Sales and Promotion Manager along with **Don Ovens** who has assumed the title of Director, **C&W Marketing Services** both to report directly to Jones ... **Playboy** Country and Western singer, **Barbi Benton**, will be a celebrity guest on the **NBC's** "Celebrity Sweetstakes" to be aired September 30th at 11:30 a.m. The show's executive producer is **Burt Sugarman**.

The **Zaire 1974 Music Festival** (held in conjunction with the **Ali-Foreman** Championship fight) was apparently a huge success for this African city. The three night concert boasted the talents of **James Brown**, **B.B. King**, **The Crusaders**, **The Spinners**, **The Pointer Sisters** and **Sister Sledge** plus top name African performers who performed this week (the 21st-23rd) to such celebrities as **Norman Mailer**, **George Plimpton** and the two fighters. The city became a mini-**Rio Carnival** with African bands playing all night to crowds of dancers with free wine and food flowing. The festival generated so much excitement in Africa that officials plan to make it an American event linking Africa and America.. **Capitol's** German rock group, **Triumvirate**, has arrived in the states to begin rehearsals for the upcoming U.S. tour.. **Kool & The Gang** will be appearing the benefit concert for the fourth **Annual Congressional Black Caucus** to be held at **Capitol Center** in **Washington, D.C.** the end of the month... Fastest rising exec of the month has to go to **John Rosica** of **ABC Records** who was just upped to Vice-President, Marketing this week. Last month Rosica had just been appointed as General Manager of **ABC-Impulse Records** and East Coast head of **ABC's** operations to be based in **New York**.. he's now on his way back to the West Coast.

The 'New' Bowie Comes To Town...

For those of you who haven't seen or read about the new **David Bowie** "image," I caught the last concert of his tour last week which featured a combination of the new and old Bowie. The glitter is still there to a limited degree, but Bowie's personal image is one of a subdued zoot-suit of the late 1930's in dress, and a **Broadway** extravaganza in material and performance. His dress is tight-waisted pants with baggy bottoms, suspenders, a jacket with padded shoulders, a long watch chain and red "Mary-Jane" shoes with yellow socks. His hair is still brilliant red, but cut short and parted on the side. Bowie's music is definitely headed towards a heavy **R&B** style and he is handling this transition in the best tradition of a **James Brown** or **Freddie King**. Bowie has **Joe Cocker** and **Mick Jagger** both beat in getting to the roots and feel of **R&B** as evidenced by his rendition of "Knock On Wood," his new songs of "Will You Rock 'N Roll With Me" and "It's Gonna Be May."

The show was packed full of arresting staging with full backdrops of city scenes, an elevator platform resembling a bridge complete with street lights, a cantilevered chair that suspended Bowie 20 feet over the audience and an enormous glass-paneled pentagon that opens with a huge hand lowering onto the

stage with Bowie sitting in the middle. Bowie's presentation, among the glitter and glamour, is a cross between "Guys and Dolls," "West Side Story" and **Marcel Marceau** pantomime theatre. The feeling is that enormous amounts of rehearsing and money for scenery have gone into this production which cannot simply be labeled a rock act -- it is truly rock-theatre at its best.

Bowie's voice, mannerisms and charisma were at their ultimate and this new "image" appears to have captivated an audience composed of old and new fans. This was a test period for acceptance, and judging by the audience's response, Bowie need have no fears for the death of "Ziggy" and the birth of **R&B** and mime theatre. Every movement, lyric and shading was calculated to create a new image of serious **R&B** and mellow rock. The older songs of "Jean Genie" and "Space Oddity," were subtly performed to incorporate the new sound with the old.

"Jean Genie" became a drama along with "Diamond Dogs," and "Space Oddity" was performed by Bowie on his cantilevered chair to prevent body movement. "Changes" was crossed over to **R&B**, complete with four soul background singers offstage. Although very comfortable with his older material, Bowie's newer selections of "It's Gonna Be May" and "Someone To Lead Us" is where his head is at this point. His band is superb and the keyboard man is particularly outstanding.

At the end of the concert, Bowie informed the audience that a complete new show, and sets, are forthcoming in 19 days for a new tour (beginning in **Minneapolis**) which leads to the speculation that the transformation will be complete with this tour being the transitory stage between the "old" and "new" Bowie.



DAVE CARRICO/BELL:

Orlando & Dawn, First Choice Heat Up Bell

Bell Records is getting hot with **Tony Orlando-Dawn** "Steppin' Out (Gonna Boogie Tonight)" and an R&B smash "The Player" by the **First Choice**.

Al Wilson has a fantastic new release "La La Peace Song" with significant pop adds: **WA PS**, **WDRQ**, **WBBF** No. 26, **WKY** and across the board R&B play. Wherever we have split play, this record is winning the battle. Sales and reorders very impressive this last week. This is a hot record.

"She's Gone," **Lou Rawls**, definitely his finest hour since his Grammy-winning performance of "Natural Man." Great song written by **Hall & Oates**, one of the most talked about records in the country. **Ron Dante's** "Charmer," a song that most everybody knows was the winner of the First American Song Festival. Dynamic record with a spectacular arrangement and production, not to mention a superb vocal by **Ron**.

Things are moving well at Bell, we're just beginning.

DENNIS GANIM/MGM-POLYDOR:

There Has Got To Be A Better Way!

The reaction to our last column where we listed all of the radio personalities, MD's and programmers brought such an overwhelming response that my staff insisted we continue it. However, as we discussed the chart and the possibilities of how to improve it and/or modify it, one thing became very apparent ... we started falling into the same trap as others who prepare charts. The following are a few examples of some of the trick bags we were falling into:

Since I and all of the members of my staff have other duties, we didn't have the time to devote all of our energies to this chart. And, even though the radio industry relies on it, we decided to hire someone to act as a buffer to listen to the hundreds of airchecks submitted to us each week. Naturally, we started to look for a large-breasted, pimply-faced female.

Our second decision was to allow the radio station PR man five


DeVaughn Begins Cross, Brian Cadd Takes Off
