Despite Arrest, Herndon Gets His Airplay Back

Today's country radio listeners may be more tolerant than the industry expected. At least, that is the early consensus among programmers, based on audience reaction to the arrest of Epic Records Nashville artist Ty Herndon June 13 in a Fort Worth, Texas, park. Herndon, who lives in Dallas, was charged with indecent exposure and possession of a controlled substance; he was subsequently freed on bond.

Programmers polled by Country Airplay Monitor say far more listeners called their stations to voice support for Herndon during his ordeal than to condemn the artist's actions. For that reason, most stations that had backed off on Herndon's current single, "I Want My Goodbye Back," after the arrest have since restored its airplay. Only a few stations dropped the single, which goes 39-35 this week on the Country Airplay chart.

According to police reports, Herndon allegedly exposed himself and masturbated in front of an

undercover vice officer in Gateway Park. A controlled substance, reportedly methamphetamine, was discovered while Herndon was in custody. Initial Associated Press reports stated that Herndon solicited sex from the officer, but those allegations are nowhere to be found in the police reports.

In a written statement, Sony Music Nashville executive VP Paul Worley stated, "We stand by Ty and his music during this difficult period. He's a part of the Epic Nashville family, and our hearts go out to him."

In an early taped message, played by many radio stations, Herndon calls the charges "bullshit" and adds that "he will be doing his best to fight" them. In a subsequent message, he says that he is "sorry for the embarrassment of this thing" and that he will be away for about a month, "working on myself, getting rid of these pressures and drug problems of mine." He adds, "You guys don't listen to what people are saying [because it is] just not true." Herndon says in his message that

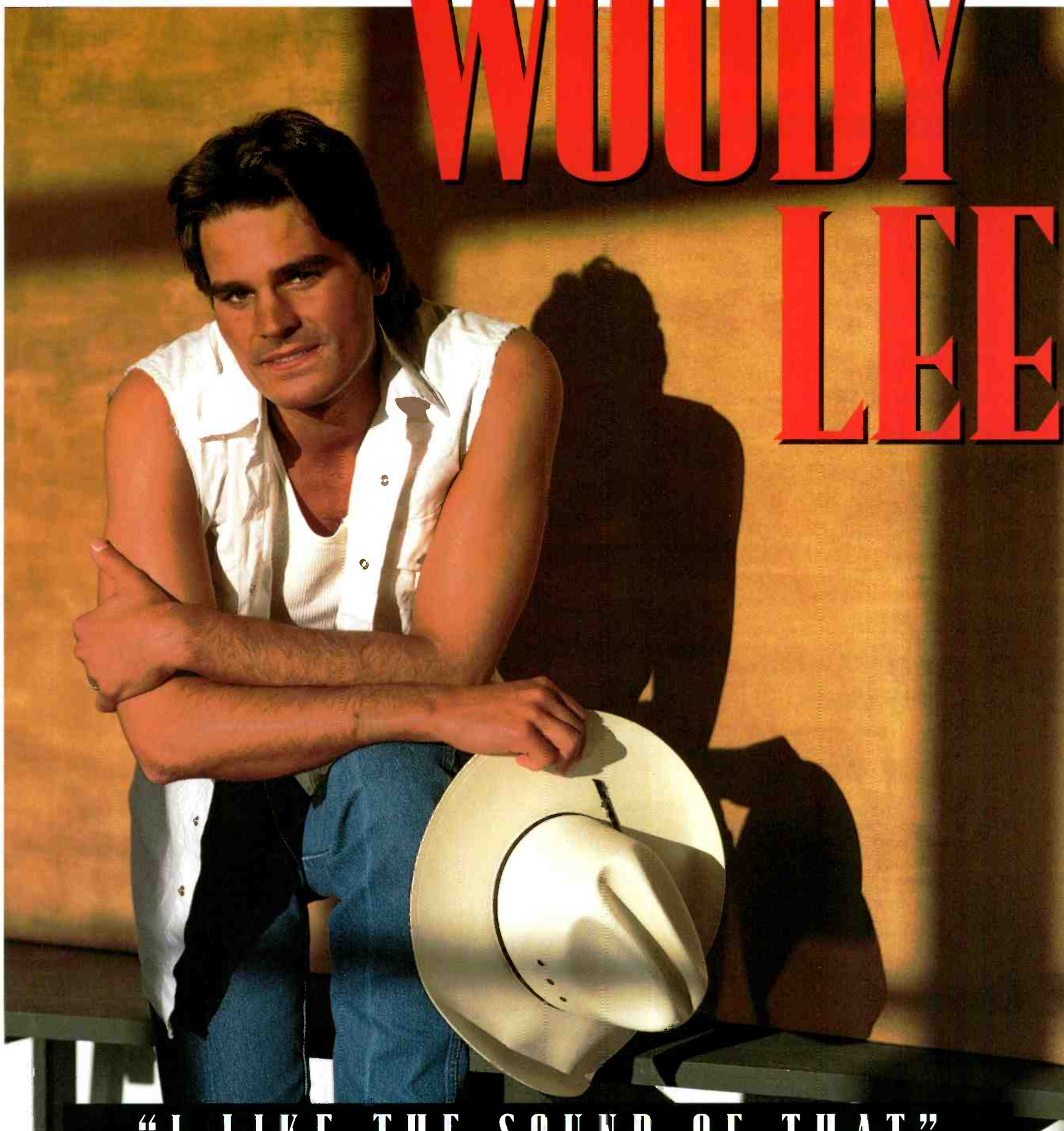

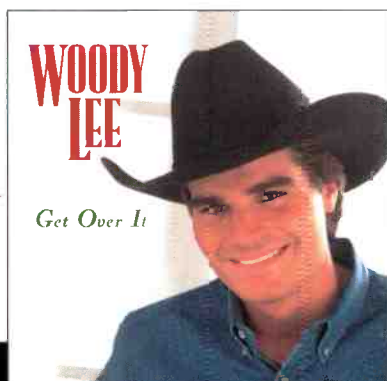

Country Shares Slip 25-54, 18-34

Country remained the third-most popular format nationally in the winter Arbitrons but lost rank in several key demos, going from second to third 25-54, and fourth to fifth 18-34, according to the latest Billboard/Arbitron national format numbers for the 94 continually measured markets.

In 12-plus listening, country was off 12.6-12.4, behind news/talk (16.0-16.2) and AC (15.2-15.0). Winter-to-winter, country was down 12.8-12.4, while news/talk remained unchanged at 16.2 and AC dropped 16.8-15.0. It was country's lowest showing in the national ratings since fall '91.

In 25-54, the O.J. Simpson case continues to negatively affect country, with listening at the format down 12.9-12.8, while news/talk surged 12.7-13.2. Year-on-year, country decreased from 13.3-12.8, while news/talk was down slightly from 13.3-13.2. AC remains the 25-54 leader, up 22.0-22.4.

In the 18-34 demo, country dipped 11.8-

11.7, down from 12.0 a year ago, while AC (14.4-14.5) reclaimed the national format lead from album rock (16.1-14.4). Top 40 and modern rock rose 5.1-5.7. AC inched up 14.4-14.5, while top 40 surged 13.4-13.7. R&B radio was up 11.7-11.9, bumping country from fourth to fifth in the demo.

In 35-64, country held steady at a 14.1 behind N/T (18.6-18.6) and AC (18.2-17.9). With women 18-plus, country listening fell 13.5-13.2, trailing AC (19.3-19.5) and news/talk (14.8-14.9). Year-on-year, country was virtually unchanged at 13.5-13.2. For men 18-plus, country listening was up a tenth to 12.1, while year-on-year, it was down from 12.6.

In mornings, country was off 12.5-12.4 and down from a 12.8 last winter. In middays, it nudged forward 12.6-12.7 vs. a 13.0 at this time last year. In afternoons, it was off 12.9-12.7 vs. a 13.1 a year ago. At nights, it went 10.6-9.9 vs. a 10.3 in winter '94. It was the first time country had fallen out of double digits in the daytime since winter '92.

Rivers Joins KPLX As PD

Susquehanna's KPLX Dallas has tapped **Smoky Rivers**, OM at sister WGH Norfolk, Va., as its new PD, replacing **Brad Chambers**, who exited at the end of March. Taking over as acting PD at WGH is assistant PD/afternoon-drive personality **Randy Brooks**.

WRBQ (Q105) Tampa, Fla., GM **David Manning** becomes VP of that station and duopoly AC partner **WMTX**.

Jeff Thomas, general station manager of oldies **WOLAS** West Palm Beach, Fla., is the new GSM at **WPOC** Baltimore, replacing GSM-turned-GM **Jim Dolan**.

Fred Horton, who had been handling PD duties at **WGNA** Albany, N.Y., following the departure of **Jon Allen**, is now officially OM for that station in addition to his previous OM duties at co-owned oldies/album combo **WTRY/WPYX**.

Production director **Tom Goodwin** adds PD duties at **KXKT** Omaha, Neb., replacing **Mark Evans**.

Gerry McCracken, known to readers of this column for programming country stations in Dayton, Ohio, Columbia, S.C., etc., exits '70s gold **KBGG** San Francisco.

At **WUSN** (US99) Chicago, night jock **Bill Garcia** goes into the midday slot vacated by the retirement of **Nancy Turner**. Late nighter **Jeff Henschel** expands his shift to 7 p.m.-midnight. Also, former p.m.-drive producer **Cory Duke** is now doing overnights, replacing **Gina Steele**.

At **KDRK** Spokane, Wash., morning hosts **Jay Daniels** and **Kevin James**, who had been in place since the only February, are out. Taking over is interim OM/PD **Tim Roberts** and music director **T.C. Patrick**. Roberts is looking for T&Rs.

At **KUBL** (K-Bull) Salt Lake City, newly named p.m. driver **Travis Moon** becomes MD. Former PD **Randy Rose** stays on as APD/middays. Also, **Pat Garrett** from **KEYV** (Y93) Las Vegas is the new night jock.

KRYS Corpus Christi, Texas, taps **Heidi Wilson** as morning show co-host, replacing **Scott Ward**. Also, adding P/T work on **KRYS** is marketing director **Pam Johnson**.

Steve Pelke, PD of **WOKO** Burlington, Vt., adds PD duties for the station's new duopoly partner, **WKOL**, which flips from modern rock to oldies as **Kool 105**.

After a very brief stint doing public relations for the Navy, **Stacy Reynolds** returns to mornings at suburban-D.C. outlet **WRFK** La Plata, Md. . . . **WICO** Ocean City, Md., names **E.J. Foxx** promotion director/temporary midday host. She comes from suburban D.C.'s **WRCY** Manassas, Va.

Olympics World Games, July 1-9 in New Haven, Conn. Tracy Lawrence, country's spokesman for the Special Olympics, will headline. Michelle Wright will also appear.

Fresh from hiring former KPLX Dallas PD Brad Chambers, Dallas-based artist management company Management Associates has signed management agreements with Doug Stone and singer/songwriter Kate Wallace. Both will be managed from MA's new Nashville office, which opens Aug. 1.

CMT has inked a long-term deal with Brazilian cable operator TV Abril to distribute CMT in Brazil. TV Abril reaches over 360,000 subscribers via its own system in six major cities and 45 affiliates, representing almost 65% of the market. Also, CMT has chosen Joe Diffie as its July showcase artist.

Clint Black has teamed with USA Harvest, the largest all-volunteer food organization in the U.S., to collect canned food during his concerts. Also chipping in are Black's concert sponsors, Keebler Inc. and home shopping channel QVC. Keebler will match fan food donations at all Keebler-sponsored concerts, and QVC will air the events.

Recurrent Chart Arrives

CURRENT EVENT: Country Airplay Monitor is approaching its second anniversary of service to the radio and record community, and we look much different today than we did two years ago. Readers of Country Airplay Monitor will notice a couple of important changes in the next two weeks, beginning with the addition of the Hot Country Recurrent airplay chart.

Until this week, that chart appeared exclusively in Billboard. Thanks to your feedback, the chart will hereafter appear on page 7 of this publication. Recurrents are titles that have already appeared on the top 75 airplay chart for 20 weeks and have dropped below the top 20. We feel this information will be of great value to Airplay Monitor readers and moving it to this publication will allow Billboard to accommodate the Top Country Singles

Sales chart—a 25-position weekly tabulation of SoundScan data on country cassette-singles sales. This new chart will provide the Billboard readership with accurate point-of-sale information for country singles. As always, we're interested in your feedback regarding these changes.

MORE GROWTH: Shortly after the first of this year, Airplay Monitor and Broadcast Data Systems introduced **HOTLINE**, a Tuesday-morning fax showcasing the top 40 airplay chart positions. Beginning June 20, we'll offer you an expanded **HOTLINE** with the entire BDS-based top 75 chart on the same Tuesday morning schedule as the prior version. The syndicated "After MidNite With Blair Garner" is giving one listener a chance to win a live broadcast from his or her home. Garner will bring along special guest Tracy Lawrence, who will arrive in his tour bus, play a concert for the winner and 100 friends, and give the winner an autographed Yamaha guitar. Listeners must send in a postcard with the answer to a Lawrence trivia question to qualify for a random drawing in mid-July. Country Weekly magazine will do a spread on the visit.

WBCS Boston holds its second Boston Country Sunday on July 2 at the Great Woods Center for the Performing Arts. Performing will be Tim McGraw, BlackHawk, Little Texas, and Mark Collie. A portion of the ticket proceeds will go to Action for Boston Community Development.

WCMS Norfolk, Va., has teamed up with America Online and the ABC Radio Network to enable subscribers to view and download station information via ABC's file. **WCMS**, which has been on the Internet for several months, is the first station outside a top 10 market to team with ABC. Its AOL user name is wcms100@aol.com.

WKHX (Kicks 101.5) Atlanta raised more than \$191,471 during its seventh annual Children's Miracle Network Radiothon June 3-4. Anchoring the broadcast, which was held in conjunction with the CMN national

telethon, was **WKHX** p.m. driver Bill Celler. Last year, **WKHX** raised more than \$178,000.

WYGY Cincinnati helped out local bands June 10 with a seven-hour show billed as the Best Young Country Bands in the Tri-State area. The latest in the Proctor & Gamble concert series featured Yankee Grey, Stagger Lee, Rockin' The Range, Quarter Mile, and Blackwood Ridge.

KYCW Seattle, meanwhile, is doing its part for local charities and artists by teaming with hometown label 3:23 Reckerds and the Seattle Art Institute for a 13-track CD featuring local bands performing classic and original country songs. All proceeds go to **KYCW**'s charity-of-the-month program.

KRMD Shreveport, La., brought national talent to local listeners for its 101 Days of Summer free concert. The May 29 concert at Fairgrounds Field featured Pam Tillis, Ty Herndon, and Bryan White . . . **WQIK** Jacksonville, Fla.'s Freedom Fest Five scheduled for July 4 will feature Aaron Tippin and Faith Hill at the Mayport Naval Air Station.

KKBQ (93Q) Houston celebrated the NBA finals by broadcasting live for a week from the Orlando, Fla., hotel where the Houston Rockets were staying during the Rockets/Orlando Magic series.

WBOB Minneapolis' latest in its series of unusual weekends was the Kung Fu Weekend, during which the 10th caller to hear the "bob chop" won station memorabilia.

WPOC Baltimore ushered in the summer with BalloonFest—the annual three-day event held in mid-May to celebrate the Preakness horse race—which featured such acts as Martina McBride, Collin Raye, Sammy Kershaw, Steve Kolander, and Marty Stuart. Proceeds went to the American Red Cross.

Patriot's Cerami Now At Liberty From Capitol Nashville

Patriot Records VP of promotion Sam Cerami and Capitol Records Nashville have parted ways following the Capitol Nashville consolidation. Cerami, who turned down a national promotion position alongside Capitol's new VP of promotion Terry Stevens, says Capitol Nashville president Scott Hendricks "offered me a good position with the new company and I appreciate it, but I feel it is in my best interests to leave at this time to pursue [other opportunities]." Cerami expects to announce his plans within the next two weeks.

The Country Music Assn., **WWYZ** Hartford, Conn., and Interep Radio Store will team up for a country concert at the 1995 Special

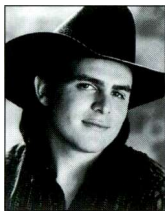

"THAT AIN'T MY TRUCK" (DECCA)

Valdosta, Ga., native Akins attended the University of Georgia with the ambition of making the NFL, but returned home after a year. His first public performance was at a wedding rehearsal dinner, which led to gigs at frat parties and hotel lounges, then a move in 1992 to Nashville, where he began co-writing and recording demos. Within the course of a year, he was offered three record contracts. When Akins' publisher pitched some of his songs for Mark Chesnutt, Decca took the songs and the guy who wrote them. Akins co-wrote nine of the 10 songs on his debut album, "A Thousand Memories."



Jeff Carson

"NOT ON YOUR LOVE" (MCG/CURB)

This Arkansas native found a job singing at Nashville's Opryland Hotel before signing as a demo singer, often performing as many as 20-30 demos per week, some of which became hits for Diamond Rio ("Mirror Mirror") and Tracy Lawrence ("I See It Now" and "Runnin' Behind"). James Taylor and Merle Haggard are influences.



Kenny Chesney

"FALL IN LOVE" (BNA)

Luttrell, Tenn., native Chesney's mother and aunt were regulars on an east Tennessee gospel radio show. He started songwriting and singing while at college in Johnson City, Tenn., and moved to Nashville in 1990 with a marketing degree. After months of day jobs and night writing, Chesney inked a publishing deal and then became Capricorn's first country artist. Chesney, 27, co-wrote four of the songs on his BNA debut, "All I Need To Know," including this one.

Philip Claypool

"SWINGIN' ON MY BABY'S CHAIN" (CURB)

Son of a prominent Memphis preservationist, Claypool had various high school bands but didn't steady his sights on singing/songwriting until his college years at the University of Tennessee, then Memphis State University. He cites Al Green and Waylon Jennings as influences; his debut Curb release features six self-penned songs.

Wesley Dennis

"DON'T MAKE ME FEEL AT HOME" (MERCURY)

Raised in Montgomery, Ala., 32-year-old Dennis recorded some songs for Nashville producer Bill Walker in the early '70s, but his stepfather discouraged him from pursuing a music career. Dennis tried again in the mid-'80s, recording "Lovers' Junkpile" for \$160 on Music Row. That song reached producer Keith Stegall, later Mercury VP of A&R, who signed Dennis.

Ty England

"SHOULD'VE ASKED HER FASTER" (RCA)

Oklahoma City native England, who played guitar by age 5, met Garth Brooks at Oklahoma State University, where the two promised to help each other to stardom. England toured with Brooks' Stillwater Band for six years until he met another Garth in 1990. Producer Garth Fundis signed England in August 1994. His self-titled debut album hits in August.



David Lee Murphy

"PARTY CROWD" (MCA)

Murphy arrived in Nashville in July 1983 from Herrin, Ill., and within six months was opening for Steve Earle. Reba McEntire cut his "Red Roses Won't Work Now" in 1985, and Doug Stone recorded his "High Weeds And Rust." In 1992, MCA/Nashville signed Murphy, releasing first the "Eight Seconds" soundtrack single "Just Once" and then this cut from his debut album, "Out With A Bang."



Perfect Stranger

"YOU HAVE THE RIGHT TO REMAIN SILENT" (CURB)

The band's first incarnation came in high school, when musical rivals Shayne Morrison and Richard Raines teamed up under the name of a Southern Pacific song. Steve Murray and Andy Ginn joined the current lineup four years ago. The group's indie-label debut album, "You Have The Right To Remain Silent," has been re-released on Curb and is now in stores.

Kim Richey

"JUST MY LUCK" (MERCURY)

Dayton, Ohio, native Richey picked up the music bug from her aunt, who owned a record shop. She learned to play guitar in high school and in college formed a band with Bill Lloyd. When that venture ended, Richey spent several years traveling. In 1988 she moved to Nashville to get serious as a singer/songwriter. Her self-titled, 13-song debut album was produced by Richard Bennett.

Shania Twain

"ANY MAN OF MINE" (MERCURY)

Raised in Timmins, Ontario, Twain remembers the times her mom and dad, an Obijway Indian, would drag her out of bed at 1 a.m. (when Canadian alcohol sales end) to play local clubs. But when she was 21 her parents died in a car wreck. Making a living by singing at a resort, Twain raised her four siblings through high school, then moved to Nashville, where producer Norro Wilson recorded her self-titled debut album. Twain met producer/future husband Robert "Mutt" Lange at Fan Fair. Lange co-wrote and produced Twain's Mercury debut, "The Woman In Me."

Over 24,000 fans jammed the Tennessee State Fairgrounds for the 24th annual International Country Music Fan Fair, featuring performances from more than 100 enter-

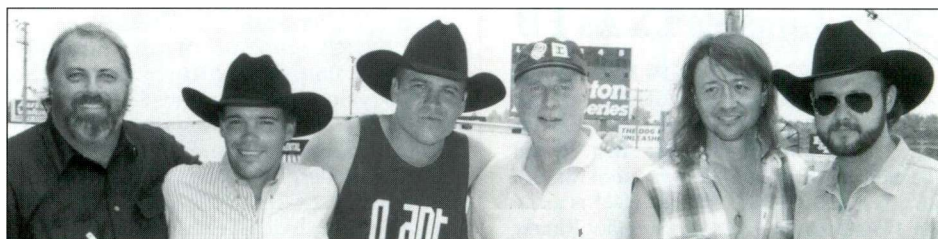
tainers as well as autograph/photo sessions with approximately 400 artists in eight official exhibit halls. Here's some of what happened backstage.

"the moral of the story is don't take a leak in the woods."

Epic Records is doing its best at damage control. In a brief message faxed to PDs and music directors, Epic Records Nashville VP of national country promotion Jack Lameier reiterated that there were no solicitation charges and that "Epic Records is and will continue to pursue airplay on 'I Want My Goodbye Back.'"

On June 11, two days before the arrest, Herndon's song was detected 202 times on 99 stations; on June 12, those numbers increased to 270 spins on 113 stations. On the day of the arrest, 131 stations were airing the song, which resulted in 277 detections. On June 14, after the news spread, 266 spins were counted at 128 stations; by June 15, those totals fell to 233 spins at 108 stations.

KYNG Dallas PD Dan Pearman, who says his station was the first to break the news, decided not to pull the plug on "I Want My Goodbye Back." He says, "It was a hit before [the arrest], so why wouldn't it be a hit after? . . . The other key was that I don't think I should be making decisions for my public. The listeners are going to pipe in, and [if their comments] were all negative, we would have responded. But there hasn't been anything negative. People seem to be very supportive. In fact, 'What Mattered Most' made our top eight at 8 [on] Thursday."

At crosstown KPLX, however, MD Chris Huff says, "We decided to hold off on playing the record when the news broke quite simply because it was a very difficult situation that Ty and his family were going through, and we didn't want to make it any worse. We wanted to be as sensitive as we could to this issue. We also wanted to see what was going to happen [with regard] to what new facts came out and what the public perception was going to be."

One station that axed the single but moved it back into regular rotation after two days was WPCM Greensboro, N.C. PD John Anderson says, "We figured we should hold off for a couple of days to learn the whole story. We had just bumped it into medium, and it went right back in there on Friday [June 16]."

(The station with the most unusual reaction to the Herndon incident, however, may have been WSIX Nashville, which responded with a "Ty One On" weekend in which it gave listeners a chance to win a copy of Herndon's album, a package of Goodie's Headache Powder, and "a WSIX ball cap.")

Interestingly, as a new artist, Herndon's lack of name recognition may be an asset in this case. For example, WMZQ Washington, D.C., PD Gary McCartie says he was expecting to hear more from the audience than he has so far. "You have to consider that he really is a young artist and that a lot of people don't really know who he is yet, even though they love the song ['What Mattered Most,' which] went to No. 1 in our charts. That was one of the reasons we feel like it wasn't worth a lot of press on our part . . . most people wouldn't readily recognize who he was anyway. Nobody's really had a chance to establish a relationship with the artist in that respect."

"If it had been one of the megastars, it would have been more of an issue. At that point we would have been taking telephone calls and maybe putting them on the air to try and get a barometer of what people were thinking, even

though they were just charges. Herndon's new enough in the 'country music family' that a lot of people, even though they heard the news story, didn't connect [it with] who he was and what he was all about."

Another plus for Herndon is that consultants haven't jumped ship on "I Want My Goodbye Back." Rusty Walker initially balked at playing the song but then told stations to stay on it unless listeners complained. Pollack Mullins reportedly told stations to pull Herndon's songs the day of the arrest, only to tell them to return them to playlists if listeners requested them.

KYNG's Pearman also credits Herndon and Epic's legwork during the setup phase for Herndon's singles as a key reason radio reacted sympathetically to the charges. "In a trial," Pearman said, "there's usually some guilt by association simply because you were arrested. But Ty spent a lot of time on the road meeting programmers and made a very good impression and put in a lot of hard work. Programmers feel they know him a little, and that's helped out a lot. They believed Ty and Epic that they are in this for the long haul."

PDs also believe that in today's media environment, listeners are exposed to more news stories than ever before about the private lives of celebrities. Says KPLX's Huff, "Country is one [of the most], if not *the* most, conservative audience out there. Traditional values are very close to the heart of country listeners. By the same token, this is a society where the O.J. Simpson trial is one of the most highly watched TV shows. Here's an ex-football star who is being tried for the murder of his ex-wife, and it's just become a nonchalant thing for this society. I think maybe our senses have been dulled a bit."

WMZQ's McCartie adds, "We have all been disappointed by the acts or the charges against people we have all trusted. This event, even though he is yet to be [tried, much less] convicted, is just another in a long line. We purposely decided not to say anything about it at all except in a newscast the morning after. We only had a couple of calls, and we chose not to make a big thing out of it. Our reasoning is that he is innocent until proven guilty, and therefore it should have no effect on what we do at this radio station at all. Sadly, there is more of a relationship with the artist in this format than in others, and we care about what's going on and the problems he's having, but we won't let that affect the music."

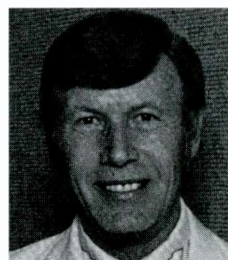
Given the country audience's reaction, some programmers believe listeners have become more accepting of how artists conduct their personal lives. Anderson says, "In this neck of the woods, the Bible Belt, it's kind of nice that people have wanted to know the whole story as opposed to just passing judgment. That to me is pleasantly surprising and could be a sign of things to come."

Others, however, are not so sure. Says KASE Austin, Texas, PD Brad Hanson, who returned "I Want My Goodbye Back" to the air after a two-day hiatus, says, "[Herndon's alleged actions are] not congruent with the audience that listens to country music. It's unfortunate, but it's a fact. So what are you going to do? Other programmers can make a statement in their market and play it in heavy—that's great. But I don't think that works everywhere."

COUNTRY PROFILE

WYXE-AM: A New Throwback To Old Days Of Country Radio

Crazy. That word seems to pop up frequently in connection with WYXE-AM Gallatin, Tenn. Crazy because the Patsy Cline song of the same name gets frequent airplay at this 2,300-watt classic country daytimer licensed to a town 25 miles northeast of Nashville. And crazy because the station is starting from scratch, vying for listeners in competition with Nashville's country powerhouses, WSM-AM-FM and WSIX-FM, as well as the slew of smaller country outlets that dot the area.

The DJs decide what to play . . . If someone asks for an Ernest Tubb song and it's in this studio, then it gets played. We'll go as far back as "Smoke! Smoke! Smoke! (That Cigarette)."

WYXE (Wixie In Dixie) is owned by former broadcaster, recording artist, and Grand Ole Opry star Ernie Ashworth, and crazy he ain't. The 67-year-old has worked for numerous radio stations during his career, including WSIX. He recorded for MGM Records as Billy Worth in 1955 and then was out of music until 1960, when in May "Each Moment (Spent With You)" was his first top 10 hit. He had his first No. 1 record (as Ernie Ashworth) with "Talk Back Trembling Lips" in June 1963, and he became a regular on the Grand Ole Opry stage in 1964.

Says Ashworth, who bought WYXE at a foreclosure sale in 1994, "We don't want to be like WSM or WSIX and compete with them on the modern country stuff. I knew from being in the entertainment business myself and from a lot of people I know that nobody was playing the type of music we do, so I wanted to try and fill a void I thought was in the market."

"I don't want to be under any pressure to run this thing. I want to have a crew who is happy and have that reflected on the air. I want to build a community-minded radio station and serve the community and play some music they can't hear anywhere else."

According to Ashworth, WYXE, which hasn't shown up yet in the Nashville ratings, is a down-home operation. There are only a couple of sales reps, including Uncle Cuz, who performs bits on the air. Nearly all sales are from area businesses, but there are a few national advertisers, such as the locally owned Mrs. Winners and KFC franchisees. Regarding profits, Ashworth says WYXE "is paying the bills."

"I don't want an image that we are a 'big shot' kind of place," says Ashworth. "We have people come by and bring us sausage and biscuits and cake. That's exactly what I want. I want them to feel that they are a part of this station. And the same way with the artists. My door is always open. We're one of the few stations [where] you can get past the secretary, mainly because we don't have one."

"This is the kind of radio I grew up with.

That's the way I built my career, going around to the local radio stations and taking my records and sitting down and talking with the DJs. And I want to do the same thing, because there are a lot of people who have good records who can't get them played."

Most of the shifts at WYXE are filled by radio vets, singer/songwriters, and former artists ranging in age from mid-30s to 70s. During the week, morning man Jerry Binkley plays bluegrass from 6-7 a.m., then classic country until 9 a.m. Robbie Wittkowski plays classic country until 11 a.m., when Ashworth comes on and does a half-hour of classic country, then a half-hour show called "Swap Shop." Noon-1 p.m. is Dave Sutton with Southern gospel. From 1-2 p.m., Jake Lambert plays bluegrass, followed by an hour of classic country. Smokey Stover plays classic country from 3 p.m. until sign-off at 6 p.m. On Saturdays it's bluegrass until noon, followed by gospel and the "Long Hollow Jamboree." On Sundays it's all Southern gospel.

About his on-air staff—most of whom were put in place just a few weeks ago—Ashworth says, "I want a crew I can associate with, and we have a lot of fun. Most of these guys are all up in this business and have lived the life, including me. We all either took our records to stations and tried to get them played or were playing the records at the station. That's what I want to come across on the air."

As for playlists or formatic rules, don't look for any. About 85% of WYXE's music is classic country, with the rest bluegrass, Southern gospel, and a little contemporary country. Ashworth cites Dwight Yoakam, Vince Gill, George Strait, Tracy Lawrence, John Anderson, and Marty Stuart as some of the new country artists that he features. Ashworth leaves new music decisions to former WHO Des Moines, Iowa, personality Wittkowski, the only WYXE jock under 40.

Here's a sample from morning drive: Cowboy Copas, "Fraulein"; Patsy Cline, "Crazy"; Chet Atkins, "Country Gentleman"; Little Jimmy Dickens, "I'm Little But I'm Loud"; Hawkshaw Hawkins, "Lonesome 7-7203"; Wilma Lee & Stony Cooper, "There's A Big Wheel"; Bill Anderson, "Still"; Floyd Cramer, "Last Date"; George Strait, "The Fireman"; and Ernie Ashworth, "A Week In The Country."

"The DJs decide what to play," says Ashworth. "We play mostly names that we're familiar with. And we play a lot of requests. If someone asks for an Ernest Tubb song and it's in this studio, then it gets played. We'll go as far back as Tex Williams' 'Smoke! Smoke! Smoke! (That Cigarette).' I heard someone the other day play 'Pistol Packin' Mama.'" To accommodate the older material, some of which has never been rereleased on CD, Ashworth has turntables installed in the studio.

While the big bucks are in modern country, Ashworth seems to be content with his throwback to the old days of country music. Asked if he wants to build WYXE into something bigger, he says, "If I can do it my way. I would like to take it forward and grow and grow, but I don't want to turn this into a station that sounds like everybody else on the dial. When they hit this station, I want them to know they are listening to something different."
