• ROCK ROUNDUP •

WITH LAST WEEK'S ANNOUNCEMENT that WSHE Miami had gone "rock alternative" (musically between modern rock and triple-A), the modern rock format has now set up shop on FM in all of the top 50 Arbitron markets, save for Pittsburgh (where it's represented by a suburban AM) and Tampa, Fla. Here's a set from the new WSHE at noon on June 9: Adam Ant, "Wonderful"; the Dave Matthews Band, "What Would You Say"; Adrian Belew, "Never Enough"; and Radiohead, "Fake Plastic Trees." At 4 p.m. they started the hour with Soundgarden, "Black Hole Sun"; PJ Harvey, "Down By The Water"; Pearl Jam, "Elderly Woman Behind The Counter"; Urge Overkill, "Sister Havana"; and Ned's Atomic Dustbin, "Stuck." Also illustrating the many flavors of the format through the day were Toad The Wet Sprocket, the Cranberries, and Big Head Todd & the Monsters.

DESPITE HAVING BEEN OUT since August of '94, the Toadies' "Possum Kingdom" has been one of rock radio's most interesting stories this year. The Dallas band's single, which moves 33-26 in its third week on the Album Rock chart, has earned extraordinary pockets of support at a handful of stations (mostly on the East Coast) and is now spreading nationally. Most notable in its support has been WXTB Tampa, Fla., where "Possum" has logged a phenomenal 943 plays over the last 10 months. The amazing thing for the stations that have been on the single for a while is that the track shows no signs of burning. Valerie Knight, music director at KQRC Kansas City, reports that "Possum" has been getting top five phones for four months straight. At WAXQ New York, where PD Ron Valeri said he hoped to duplicate the success he experienced at WAAF Boston with the record, it's been a No. 1 request for many weeks and a consistent top 10 call-out record.

According to Interscope's Rob Tarantino, the Toadies' album was serviced to college and metal stations first, where it created a little bit of a buzz with the track "Backslider." But the set didn't take off until WXTB's Greg Mull started playing "Possum." For the Christmas season, the label serviced a track called "Santacide" along with an edit of "Possum" on a promo CD. Officially serviced as a single in January of this year, the track began building on the early support of stations KQRC, WAAF, WROC Fort Myers, Fla., and KTUX Shreveport, La.





