## Billboard/Airplay Monitor Radio Awards Nominees Named

After a highly publicized conversion from album rock to modern rock, WBCN Boston is this year's leading nominee in the rock category for the Billboard/Airplay Monitor Radio Awards.

WBCN was nominated for major-market station of the year, as well as PD of the year (Oedipus), MD of the year (Carter Alan), promotions director of the year (Larry Loprete), and air personality of the year (Mark Parenteau).

Modern rock stations also swept the nominations for major-market station of the year (where WBCN is joined by KNDD Seattle, KROQ Los Angeles, WKQX Chicago, and WNNX Atlanta) and major market PD/OM, where Oedipus is joined by PDs at WNNX, KROQ, WKQX, and WHFS Washington, D.C.

Nominees were chosen by Billboard and Airplay Monitor readers in a preliminary round of balloting in April. The ballot for the awards—and your chance to vote—is found in this week's issue of Rock Airplay Monitor. Ballots must be returned by Aug. 4. The awards will be handed out at the Billboard/Airplay Monitor Radio Seminar Oct. 12-14 at New York's Marriott Marquis.

## • ROCK ROUNDUP •

If you've walked around New York in the last six years or so, you've probably seen the names **Cost** and **Revs** plastered on walls all over the city. With graffiti rampant in the city's five boroughs, the tags had become mystery icons woven throughout the urban fabric. So, when The New York Times reported last week that Cost was caught and sentenced to 200 hours of cleanup in the city, it marked the end of an era.

For a music fan, however, street graffiti used to represent another way for kids to show the masses their allegiance to their favorite bands and sometimes, when emblazoned on the back of a neighborhood store for instance, it provided a sort of territorial badge distinguishing that part of town's band allegiance from another's. These were zealous music fans who risked being incarcerated to spread the word of their favorite bands. It was the passion these kids had for music that defined the city's pulse for me and became something I looked for in every town I visited.

Being a young, insatiable rock fan, I used to relish family trips to visit my grandparents in the Bronx and Queens, where the names of all the bands I had read about in magazines or had heard about through friends were spray-painted everywhere I looked: Alice Cooper's name scrawled on the side of the Long Island Expressway, which I noticed as we were stuck in traffic; several variations of the Led Zeppelin logo on the walls of the public school in Elmhurst, Queens; full-color Kiss faces painted on the side of a subway car in the Bronx. It was almost like having a conversation with the city about music.

I was so entranced with the concept of graffiti as a communicator that in my early teens I felt the need to bring my hometown up to speed by hitting my local shopping center with a flowing old English-lettered "Jethro Tull." These days, with merchandising and marketing dollars quite capable of making blockbuster bands household names, it seems there's less of a purpose for rock graffiti, and its role in the city seems to have diminished and been replaced with indecipherable tags bearing no music affiliation. And I thought all along that Revs and Cost had something to do with industrial/techno artist RevCo.
