## Pirate-Radio Broadcasters: They Want The (Micro) Airwaves Now!

"Something offensive for the whole family" was a slogan used by pirate radio station Radio Free Ybor City in Tampa, Fla., before the FCC caught up with it three weeks ago. That station was one of at least two renegade outlets in the area shut down by the commission within the last month. Equipment is usually seized and fines levied in these situations, but at least one broadcaster is fighting the status quo.

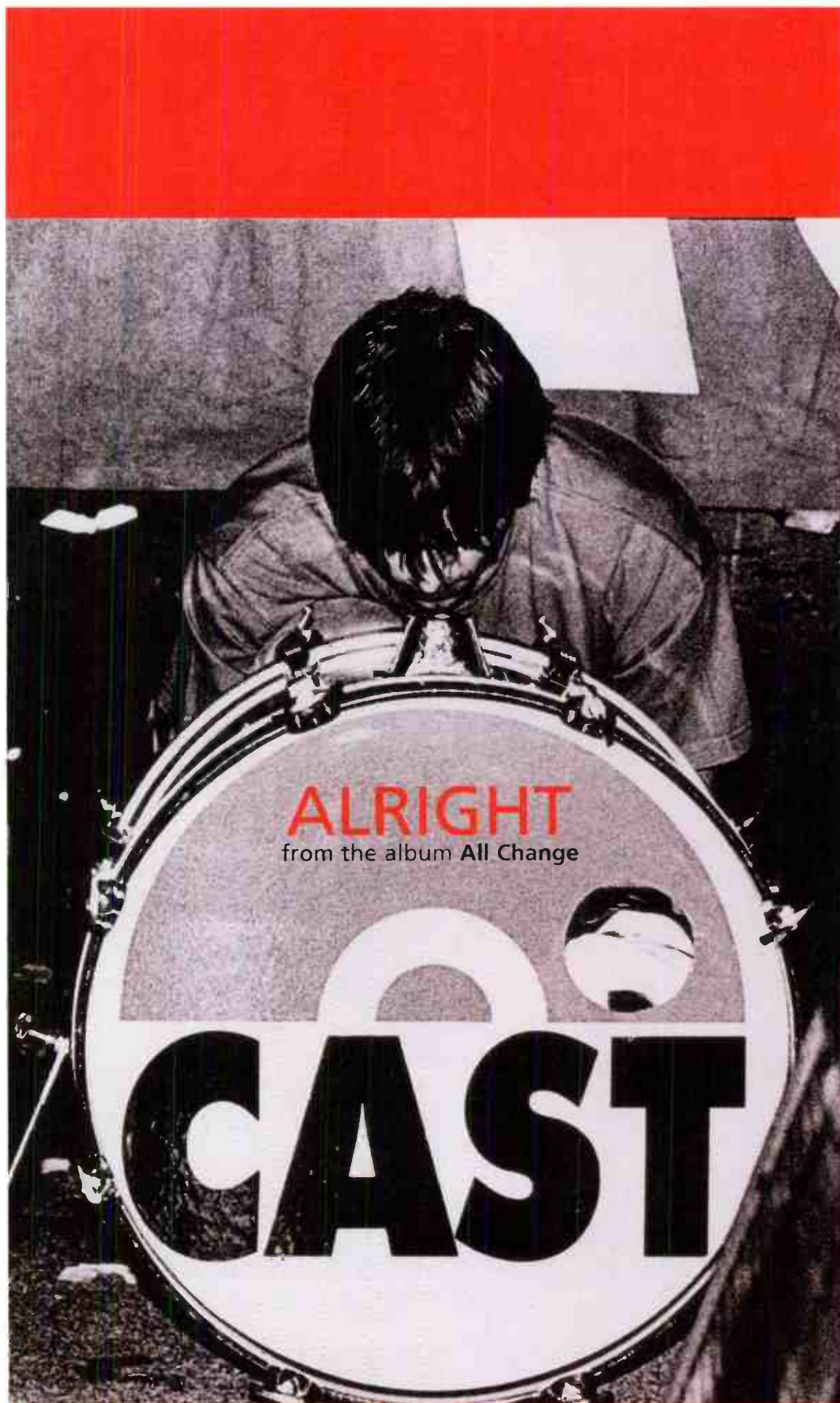
Community-oriented Free Radio Berkeley (Calif.) is involved in litigation with the FCC that it hopes will make radio pirates' low-wattage "micropower" broadcasts legal. The station's operator, Stephen Dunifer, is a guru to many microbroadcasters (the politically correct term for pirates). He provides information and sells equipment to aspiring low-power broadcasters. One of his goals in starting the station, besides serving the community, was to challenge the FCC in court. The station broadcasts openly, says Dunifer, because "the history of this country would not be the same if people had-

n't gone out and broken and defied unjust and immoral laws."

Free Radio Berkeley is, "very eclectic, [with] music that ranges from international [and] folk to hardcore, grunge, garage . . . to news, commentary, spoken word, community events, and information." He claims that current FCC regulations violate his First Amendment rights. "The airwaves have been stolen by the corporations, and it [is] time to take them back so that communities could have a voice." Dunifer points out that the "entry-level costs" to get a broadcast license are so "prohibitively high that it precludes all but the wealthy from having a voice."

"For the first 400 years that the printing press was created, it had to be licensed," Dunifer's attorney, Luke Hiker, says. "It becomes so blatantly obvious what's going on, as far as control of the airwaves [is concerned] . . . A lot of people refer to these stations as pirate radio. The pirates in this situation are the FCC and the major media broadcasters that have stolen the airwaves themselves from the American

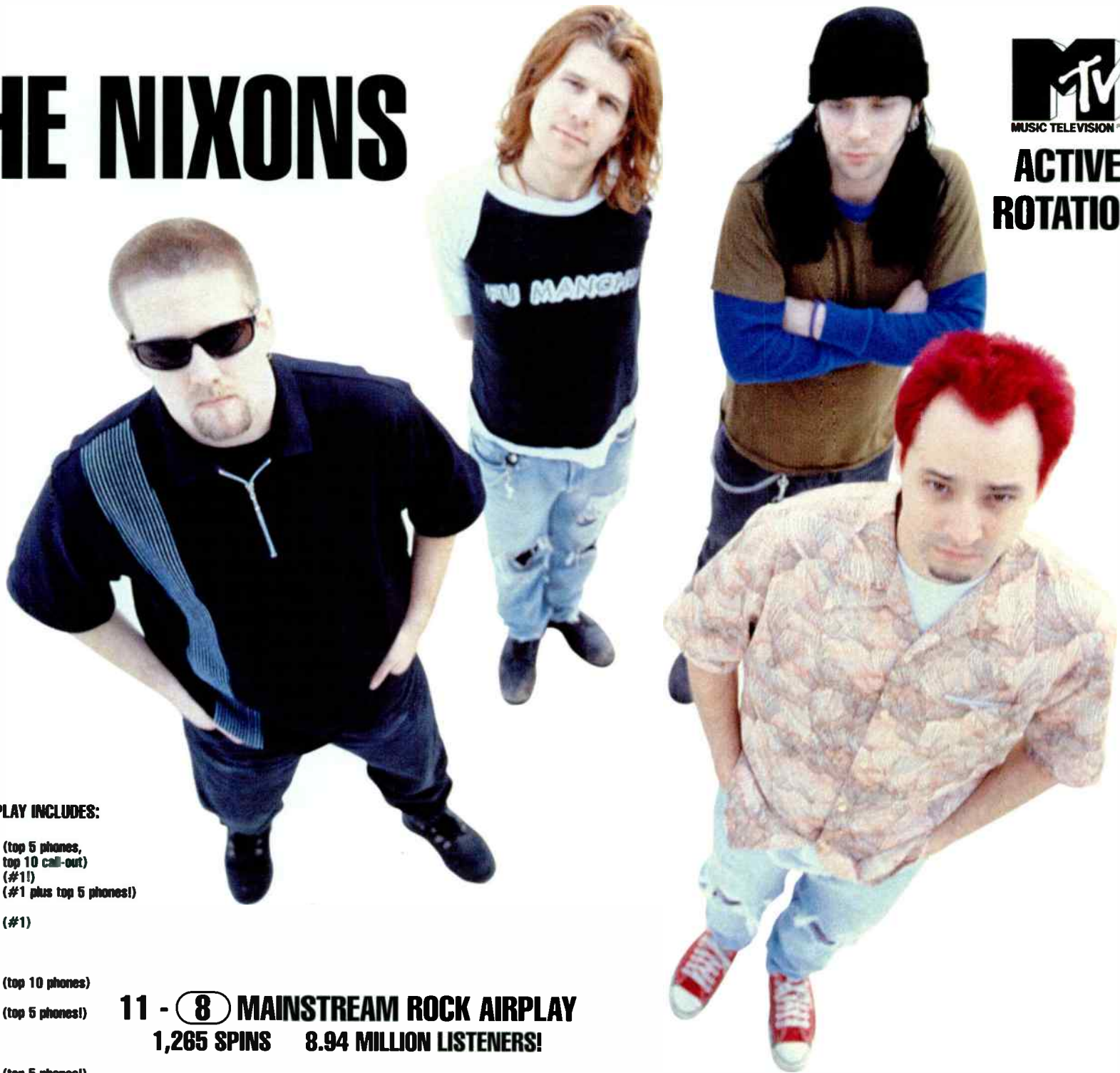

## Kingston Exits Z100 For Rival K-Rock

Steve Kingston is out as PD of modern-leaning top 40 WHTZ (Z100) New York and in as PD at crosstown WXRK (K-Rock)—in six months. Also, Tom Poleman of the similarly programmed top 40 KRBE Houston is now PD at Z100.

Kingston will have to sit out a six-month noncompete with Z100 before he assumes the PD title at K-Rock. Saying Kingston has "an obligation to honor" his noncompete, WXRK GM Tom Chiusano wouldn't comment on speculation that Kingston would take an Infinity corporate title to wait out the agreement. As for the fate of current K-Rock PD Andre Gardner, Chiusano says that decision will be up to Kingston, although he hopes there will be "something for Andre here."

K-Rock also officially announced that John "Whipping Boy" Wilbur from KBPI Denver would start as the station's night jock March 25.

Poleman is the third PD of Z100, following Kingston and Scott Shannon, the latter of whom is now at AC WPLJ New York. Also, Z100 MD Andy Shane has made his long-anticipated move to crosstown top 40 WKTU as MD.

### Viacom Gets WAXQ In Swap With Entercom

Viacom picked up WAXQ (Q104.3) New York March 15 as part of a swap with Entercom. Entercom paid \$90 million for GAF's New York property, which had been the subject of sale rumors for more than a year. In exchange for WAXQ, Entercom received Viacom's Seattle properties, oldies **KBSG-AM-FM** and modern **KNDD** (the End), and Viacom's interest in tower operations at West Tiger and Cougar. The deal gives Entercom four stations in Seattle (it already owned triple-A outlet **KMTT**). As a result of the deal, Viacom, owner of AC WLTW New York, now owns 10 stations.

Hard rockin' **WRZK** Tallahassee, Fla., has changed format to top 40 as "Wild 106," having been duopolized by not one set of crosstown stations but three! **WRZK** has been purchased by Tally Radio, a partnership of local owners Catamont, HVS, and Timm. HVS' **Jon Hill** will be GM of the new station. Former **WRZK** PD **Jeff Horn** moves to Catamont's classic rock **WWFO** (Fox 99) for p.m. drive duties. Also in Tallahassee, former **WXWX** Greenville, S.C., p.m. driver **Eric Gray** joins former PD **Rick Schmidt** at **WXSX** as morning co-host. **WXSX** evening host **Chaz** adds MD stripes, replacing **Orlando Davis**, who segues to Wild 106, and afternoon host **Evan Delaney** becomes APD.

In other station-sale news, **RadioWest** has signed a purchase agreement that would send **KBER** Salt Lake City to Citadel, owner of crosstown country **KUBL** (K-Bull) and AC **KBEE-FM** (B98.7). If the sale goes through, it will give Citadel the Bear, the Bull, and the Bee in the same market. Also, '70s rock **WRNO** New Orleans is part of the station swap that sends EZ Communications' New Orleans stations to Heritage in exchange for that company's Seattle properties. And classic rock **KKLV** Honolulu goes from Henry to Patterson.

**KRQR** San Francisco PD **John McCrae** fills the long-vacant PD slot at **WAQX** (95X) Syracuse. He'll start in early April. Meanwhile, speculation about **KRQR**'s musical direction is in

overdrive. Will syndicated morning hosts **Mark** and **Brian** make it through any changes?

Late word that PD **Mike Halloran** has reportedly left modern **XETRA-FM** (91X) San Diego. A cryptic posting on America Online from Halloran states, "Coming down the mountain cash in now honey and the radio is the hands of such a lot of fools trying to anesthetize the way that you feel; I have left the building." Now that **WXRK** (K-Rock) New York has named **Steve Kingston** PD, will Halloran make the rumored move East?

**WFBQ** (Q95) Indianapolis syndicated morning team **Bob** and **Tom** pick up some new affiliates this week, including new mainstream rocker **WRBR** (the Bear) South Bend, Ind., which switches from oldies under new PD **Joe Turner**. Also, previously reported new **Bob** and **Tom** outlet **WQZQ** Nashville is now known as "the Zebra." See photo below for the latest adventures of **Bob** and **Tom**.

Speaking of syndicated morning teams, the **Ron & Ron Radio Network** is producing "The Hooters On The Radio Show," which returns to the air on N/T **WBDN** Tampa, Fla., this week. **WBDN** GM **Jerry Sullivan** says the station has "never had more telephone calls" and that listeners have been visiting the station to get a peek at the Hooters hosts: **B.L.**, **Julie Williams**, and Hooters spokesmodel **Lynne Austin**. The midday show originally aired on **WSUN** in April 1994 but was dropped when the station went all sports. **Ron & Ron** president **Ross Reback** plans to take the show national, with a new affiliate expected to be announced next month. **WXRK** Toledo will debut what it calls a "New Perspective" March 28. The station will flip from classic to rock to adult modern under consultant **Dave Lang**.

Modern **WJRR** Orlando, Fla., adds "Just Plain" **Mark Sutherland**, most recently at modern **KTBZ** (the Buzz) Houston, to its p.m. drive show, joining host **Zippy**. **Drew "D.T." Townsend**, former p.m. drive co-host, moves to middays, displacing **Kevin Cruz**, who may stay on at another Paxson station.

**WUNX/WUNZ** Cape Cod, Mass., drops the remaining dayparts it was carrying from modern **WDRE** Long Island, N.Y.'s Underground Network. The station will continue to use "The U.N." as its on-air name with the following lineup: **Steve Binder**, a.m. drive; **Lori Lori**, middays; **Peter Maxx**, p.m. drive; and recently promoted P/T **U.N. Jack**, nights.

**KXDG** Joplin, Mo., flips from country to classic rock following its sale to crosstown country outlet **KJKT**. **Chuck Dunaway** is now GM for the station.

### Wannabe Pirates Can Light Up Dark Outlets

The issue of pirate radio (see story, page 1) raises the question, "Who owns the airwaves?" If someone wanted to publish a community newspaper, a license would not be required. All he would need is the cash and the desire to express his opinion. On the low-dough end of things, anyone with a pocketful of quarters can go to Kinko's and run off thousands of newsletters or fanzines if the mood hits him.

The same isn't true for wannabe broadcasters. The pirates I interviewed don't believe chaos would break out if microbroadcasting were allowed by the FCC. After all, they argue, it would be regulated. But by whom? The FCC has already cut back much of its operations over the years due to budget cuts. To ask the FCC to process thousands of requests for low-powered licenses would be ridiculous. Just ask any chief engineer working in radio right now how much of an adventure it is to get something approved by the FCC. And that doesn't count the random federal shut-downs we've enjoyed this year.

Still, the notion of hot-wiring a transmitter in your basement or bedroom is kind of sexy. Imagine—you could be just like Happy Harry Hard-on from the Christian Slater movie "Pump Up The Volume." All those G-men hunting you down like Jesse James, just for playing AC/DC depth cuts. Exciting, eh?

**Paul Krieger**, PD of modern **KMYZ** Tulsa, Okla., used to run a pirate radio station out of his basement. That's how most of us in the industry got to know him. After trying an assortment of transmitters, he ended up with a 10-watt stereo setup. The commission didn't come knocking right away. As pirate **KRCK** (formerly **KREG**) pumped out modern rock, it built a following in the area. It wasn't until a local TV station caught up with Krieger and did a story about him ("against my will," he says) that the FCC visited the Krieger household.

The G-men looked around and were impressed by Krieger's setup. They took down the serial numbers of his equipment, but didn't confiscate anything. He got a certified letter a few weeks later from the Feds telling him to shut his station down. He did and began broadcasting on local cable. Krieger didn't have a political axe to grind like Free Radio Berkeley operator **Stephen Dunifer**. He and his friends just wanted to learn radio and "play good music."

I got to hear some pirate radio the other night in New York. "Steal This Radio" broadcasts on 88.7 from a different location in the East Village each week. Sounding like a static-riddled college station, the 15 minutes I listened to featured music. It was mostly dusty progressive rock from the '70s. I guess the operators didn't do a format search or music test before signing on. I wonder when their perceptual studies are?

The need for the station, they told *The New York Times*, was to bring the community together. That light bulb went on over the pirate's heads after the city evicted squatters from several buildings it owns in the neighborhood. I'm not too comfortable with the "if something isn't being used by its owner, I'm entitled to it" logic. That's what most of today's pirates are doing.

Instead of trying to get a five-finger discount on the public's airwaves, maybe some of these pirates could join up and buy a real radio station. There are about 400 dark stations in this country today. I'm sure they're in towns that would love a community radio station. Pirates might argue that this would cost way too much money. Yeah, but I'm sure it would be less money than some of them have spent in fines, legal fees, and equipment. For pirates who are serious about serving communities through broadcasting, resurrecting dark stations would be a great idea. And if their radical programming concept, that "the Man" doesn't approve of, is sound, they'll be generating income in no time.

### Atlantic Records Downsizes; Rumbblings At EMI

Atlantic Records has eliminated 34 staff positions in a downsizing move. A majority of the cuts were made in support staff; however, the promotion department suffered one loss, as college rep **Mike Deitch** was let go. Reportedly, every department was ordered to make at least one move.

More rumbblings at EMI: reportedly, VP of rock music **Michael Schnapp** is exiting his post. This comes one week after the departure of **Todd Bisson**. Also, **Nick Bull** is leaving his gig as RCA's West Coast alternative maven to accept a similar position with EMI. Bull will remain based in L.A., giving EMI a presence there, and team with **Mike Abbattista**, Bisson's interim replacement. Bull is slated to take over at EMI April 1.

The speculation is that **Capricorn Records** will move to PGD sooner rather than later. The Atlanta-based label is now distributed by RED.

I.R.S. VP/marketing **Paul Orescan** joins MCA after nearly 12 years at **Miles Copeland's** imprint. VP/promotion **Karen Lee** and director of marketing **Mike Engstrom** will split his duties. I.R.S. has announced a distribution deal with San Diego, Calif.-based indie **Cargo Records**. I.R.S. provides manufacturing and major-label distribution through CEMA on selected releases. The first releases affected by the agreement include albums by **fluf**, **Blink 182**, and **Cindy Lee Berryhill**.

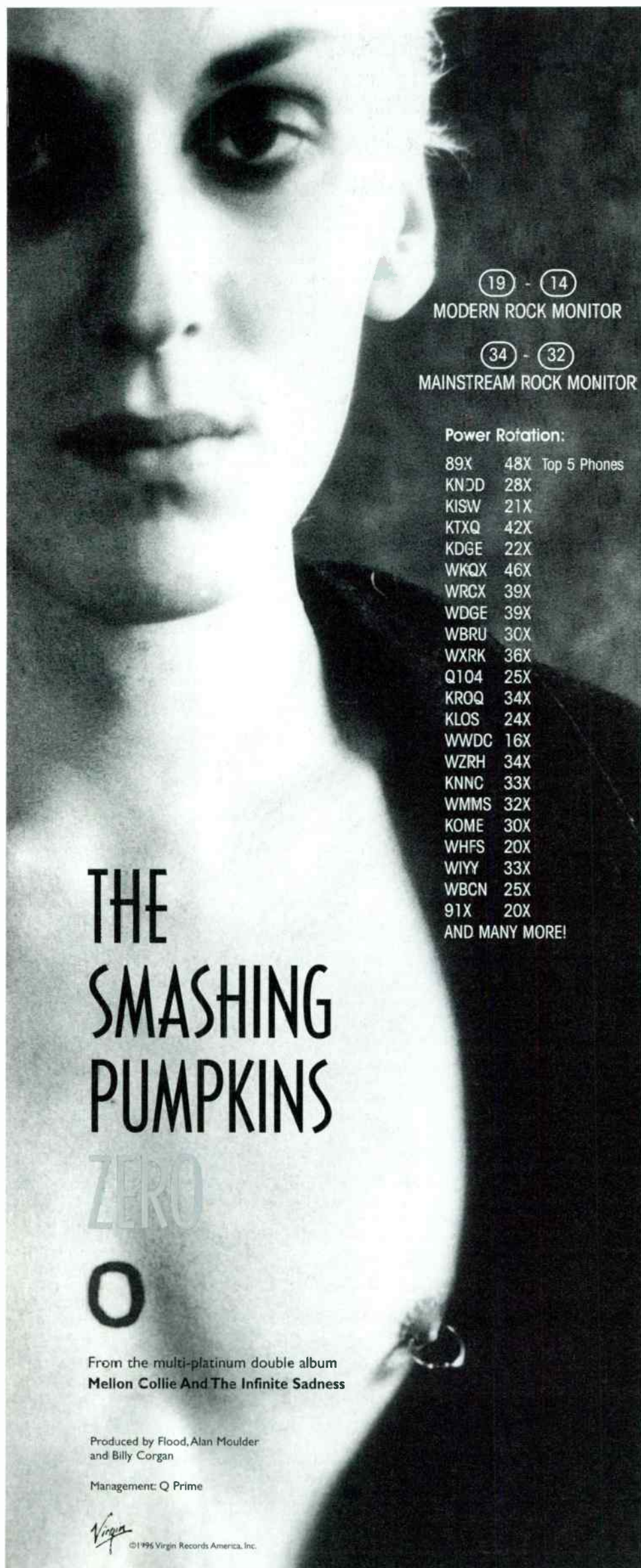

### Cast's Power Knows 'What's Goin' On'

John Power's idea of playing in a rock band is not a passive one. "Music has always been an integral part of my [life] and of people's lives," says Cast's singer/songwriter/guitarist and part-time philosopher. "We used to wonder when we were kids, 'What is this thing?' You can't see it, you can't touch it, but it evokes so many emotions [that] you take it on board as your own . . . You just think it's magic." Power believes that great music can create a communal spirit among people. "All music is inspiring. There's no difference from what Marvin Gaye was saying in "What's Going On" to what [fellow Liverpoolian John] Lennon was on about all the time," he says. "There's no difference between the source or the inspiration. What they're trying to say is the same thing."



Joining the much-acclaimed La's as bassist at the age of 18, Power got the inspiration for Cast during the La's final tour. When his composition "Alright" made its way into the La's set, he received praise from industry people, sowing the seeds for Cast. "Lots of little people give me winks and nods, so I thought, 'Yeah, man. I've put it to the test.'" When the La's broke up in 1992, Power returned to Liverpool and spent the next two years writing more songs. In 1994, after performing solo at festivals, Power firmed up Cast's lineup.

Elvis Costello and Oasis were early admirers of Cast. "We sent [Costello] a tape before we were signed, and he let us support him," Power says. The usually self-centered Oasis helped the band find the right forum. "[Oasis] played in Liverpool. I hung out with them and . . . and they said, 'We'll see what we can do,' and got us a support gig." Cast opened a show for Shed Seven and Oasis, impressing the A&R man who signed Shed Seven. Power says, "I was thinking, 'Surely someone's gonna see what we're capable of,' and [the A&R man] basically said we blew his band [off the stage]. He couldn't believe we weren't signed." A few weeks later, Cast was signed to Polydor.

John Leckie, whose production credits range from John Lennon and Pink Floyd to Radiohead and the Stone Roses, produced Cast's debut album, "All Change," which is set for U.S. release April 2. Cast makes its first U.S. appearance in San Diego March 30. A U.S. club tour will begin April 22.

### Verve Pipe Are Chillin' Like Villains

When the Verve Pipe's major-label debut, "Villains" (RCA), drops March 26, the five-piece band from East Lansing, Mich., expects to interest more than a few fans around the country. That's because it already has done its legwork. In just four years, the band has started its own label, LMNO Pop!; sold more than 40,000 copies of two self-produced albums; built a mailing list of 10,000 names by touring incessantly; and set up a touring and merchandising company in the label's East Lansing office. In addition, the Verve Pipe's industry profile received a boost with an appearance in Billboard's '94 year-end cover story on the best unsigned U.S. acts.

The Vander Ark brothers, Brian (songwriter/vocalist/guitarist) and Brad (bass), started the band in 1991 with drummer Donny Brown. The five-year age difference between Brian and his younger brother Brad was wide enough to insure that Brian was unaware of Brad's musical talents. On returning from the Army, Brian was surprised to find Brad a proficient bassist. He jokes that while it's cool to have his kid brother in the band, it's only because of their mom that he's in.

In 1992, the Verve Pipe recorded its first set, "I've Suffered A Head Injury," which contains the original version of "The Freshman". Guitarist A.J. Dunning was added for 1993's "Pop Smear" set, and newest member Doug Corella (keyboards/percussion) joined in September after playing with the band unofficially for 18 months. Except for Corella, everyone in the band sings.

The Verve Pipe built a loyal fan base in the Midwest, playing about 150 gigs a year in Central Michigan and Ohio. With East Lansing situated near five colleges, the band was able to establish a touring route in which it routinely sold-out clubs. In fact, college fans' suggestions on the Internet added to the band's base and provided it with tips on tour stops. Many former college fans remained interested in the band. So much so that when the band played its first gig in Atlanta in February '95, it was amazed to hear requests from its repertoire.

Jerry Harrison was the Verve Pipe's choice of producer for its RCA debut. After signing with RCA in March '95, the band met the noted producer/guitarist in New York. Harrison came to see the Verve Pipe at Brownies and agreed to produce the band. The entourage spent that summer in Sausalito, Calif., living on houseboats while recording at famed studio the Plant.

Other recordings by the band include XTC overs "Wake Up," on the Thirsty Ear compilation "The Testimonial Dinner," and "Blue Beret," on a compilation of East Lansing bands. The band will headline at Michigan State April 4 and play five other area dates. The band's West Coast debut will be at the Troubadour in L.A. April 25.

people." These community-based stations are necessary, Hiken says, because "the American people are without a voice. People don't have the money to own [radio and] television stations, the one newspaper in their town, or to compete with Westinghouse, General Electric, Disney, [and] Viacom. We should allow the American people to speak to themselves without the filter of a millionaire corporation. The FCC takes the position that they're only going to serve the interests of the corporations."

Free Radio Berkeley's suggestion is to allow micropower broadcasts legally, with operators notifying the FCC of their intent to broadcast on an open frequency. Should problems arise, Free Radio Berkeley argues, station personnel could be contacted. In response to critics who say this would cause chaos, Hiken says, "We could allocate a certain percent of spectrum space to [micropower] radio, because you could probably fit 50 or 60 stations in a small space instead of giving one great big one to someone selling beer and automobiles."

Dunifer adds, "We aren't looking for a willy-nilly, 'Everyone go out and put a transmitter on the air' type of situation. We're looking for a way in which every community could have its own voice through a low-cost, low-power FM service. The FCC could accommodate this through a deregulated registration process that would not involve full licensure, but would require minimum technical standards, [a] maximum power level, and that you register your operation with the FCC. I don't think that's unreasonable to ask for. If they're going to give away the store to corporate conglomerates, then they could give the American people something back, which they have not done."

In the Berkeley case, there is a possibility that federal judge Claudia Wilken will let the matter go to trial instead of just allowing the FCC to shut the station down and levy \$20,000 in fines. The FCC believes that Dunifer is airing his argument in the wrong forum. Instead, Free Radio Berkeley should be challenging the commission in the U.S. Court of Appeals. And while the FCC is hoping to win the case in Berkeley (a decision is scheduled for April 12), if a trial is held, it plans to "respectfully disagree" with any ruling against it. The commission would then move the proceedings to the Court of Appeals.

That wouldn't be the only effect of Radio Free Berkeley winning the case. The ruling would only apply to the court's jurisdiction of the Northern District of California. Therefore, the FCC believes, it would set the stage for "rulings across the U.S. that are inconsistent with each other."

The FCC stresses that Dunifer has no excuse for breaking the law, citing two methods he could use to challenge the commission or change its rules. The first method is to secure a waiver request to broadcast at a power less than the 100 watts the FCC allows, along a citation of reasons why the public interest would be served by the proposed microstation. Any negative decision could be challenged in the Court of Appeals.

The second method is to generate a petition for rule-making to change existing FCC rules asking that microradio be allowed. If the FCC disagrees with the petition, the decision can be appealed.

According to an FCC spokesperson, Hiken told the judge in California that both those avenues were too expensive for Dunifer to pursue. The FCC disagrees, saying that while filing for a waiver could be costly, filing a petition is "a very inexpensive way of challenging [existing rules]."

Andrew Yoder, a Baltimore-area writer, has just published a book about renegade broadcasters, "Pirate Radio: The Incredible Saga Of America's Underground Illegal Broadcasters." The book chronicles three decades of outlaw programming. "You could break most pirate types down into three groups," Yoder says. "People who are either radio versions of hackers, prankster-types who do things to fool people and have fun; radio broadcaster-types who are really into radio; and the... politically or religiously motivated [with] an axe to grind of some sort."

"Most pirates aren't noticed by the general public," Yoder says, "until they get busted or develop a huge following." And when they do get arrested or fined, "it's kind of hard to stick somebody with a \$20,000 fine for broadcasting, because the FCC doesn't have any way to actually extract the fines." And if the FCC does take a person to court, Yoder says, "not too many courts are going to fine some guy \$20,000 or send him to jail when there's somebody who's done a violent crime [not doing time]." Yoder says fines were probably raised just to make the prospect of getting caught more onerous.

The two Tampa pirates had very different agendas. Radio Free Ybor City's Billy Budget told The Tampa Tribune that he started the station because he was amazed "at the homophobic, racist, sexist" things he heard on CB radio.

The other Tampa pirate shut down by the FCC broadcast warnings to the citizens of Lutz, Fla., about "secret societies conspiring to take over the world," according to The Tampa Tribune. The station's operator, Arthur Lonnie Kobres, told the paper that "a military police state is right on our doorstep."

Both pirates, like Dunifer, cited their First Amendment rights in defense of their actions.

Constitutional arguments aside, pirates are a nuisance to commercial broadcasters. Whether they're broadcasting on an adjacent frequency or hijacking a marti feed, outlaw transmissions can make life difficult for professionals.

Chuck Beck, PD of triple-A WHPT Tampa, says, "We were being interfered with for a while [by pirates]." While Beck says that the station's signal was only interfered with in a very small radius, you never know where a diary holder could be. He adds, "We have to go through the rules and regulations the government sets down for us. Why [should pirates be different]? If they want to do a community radio station, that's [why] we have public radio."

"This is how we make our living, and they're interfering with that. I say shut them down."

## Hey, Kids! Start Your Own Microstation!

One of the things that makes the current wave of radio piracy interesting is how easy it is to do. A casual sweep of the World Wide Web on the Internet yields all the information needed on broadcast equipment. "FM is one of the easiest bands to pirate," say Necross Sinister and Thomas Icom in "Intro To Pirate Radio" on the Web. The duo warn readers that "broadcasting without a license is illegal. If you are busted, your equipment will be confiscated, and you might be fined. Also, if you're a hacker or any type of nonconformist, or someone whom the big shots think is 'subversive,' expect more severe treatment."

Stephen Dunifer of Free Radio Berkeley provides information and equipment to pirates. He adds this caveat to aspiring broadcasters: "If you decide to put a station on the air, your signal should be as clean and stable as possible. This will deprive the FCC of many of its arguments against micropower radio."

Sinister and Icom provide readers with a step-by-step guide to putting a station on the air: They suggest getting such basics as a CD player, audio mixer, antenna, and transmitter. "For most practical pirate radio uses, 17 watts is all you'll need. For an antenna, you can either buy a TV antenna or just build a dipole or quarter-wave vertical."

Sound enticing? Dunifer offers a 15-watt package, among others, for \$410. That includes a power supply, frequency counter, power meter, filter, dummy load, and transmitter enclosure. Antennas cost extra. Sinister and Icom offer a similar package for \$690, which "meets all FCC broadcast specifications but is not type-approved."

# ROCK GODZ

## Modern Rocker WROX Norfolk, Va., Enters The (Perry) Stone Age Of Programming

**P**erry Stone is the PD/a.m. driver of modern rocker WROX (96X) Norfolk, Va., and the p.m. driver of news/talk sister WNIS. As that resumé suggests, Stone resembles WKRP's Johnny Fever, with one exception—he's real.

It all began for the New York-born Stone when the American Federation of Television and Radio Artists went on strike at AC WTFM New York (now WKFU). "I called the PD," Stone says, "and said, 'I'd love to come work at your station.'" And he said, "Are you a union member?" I said no, and he said, "Come here now!"

Because he was technically a scab, Stone could not say his name on the air, "so I was Yours Truly. Going into work, I had to sneak in the back way. They scratched up my car. After that, I got some offers, because

everyone wanted to know who this Yours Truly was." From there, Stone became p.m. driver at mainstream rocker WBAB Long Island, N.Y.

"As ironic as it seems, WTFM was bought by Doubleday," says Stone. "They changed the call letters to WAPP, [and] I got hired back to the same place with different call letters." He started in nights at the mainstream rock station and "was so wild and crazy" that he was moved to mornings.

From WAPP, Stone ended up in Boston on video channel V66 and held an air shift at top 40 WZOU. Stone wanted to return to morning drive and got that wish under Greg Ausham at WQFM Milwaukee. "That's when all the shock radio started. We had homosexuals protesting the station [and newspapers saying] the anti-Christ is here."

Looking back on that time, Stone says, "It was a wonderful time for me. I was very raw, but I had a clear-cut feeling of what I wanted to do. For the first time, I was doing a morning show, and they were letting me be."

Protests became so heavy that the station set up phone lines for listeners to vote whether or not to "fire Perry Stone." All that attention drew on-air comments from Howard Stern. "I loved it when [Stern] talked about me. I got a lot of publicity. I believe if Howard Stern talks about you, you matter. If he doesn't talk about you, he doesn't care about you."

When Stone's time in Milwaukee was up, his next stop was KSJO San Jose, Calif. "Again, lots of protests, lots of wild stuff. Big numbers in San Jose [and] San Francisco."

After about two years, Stone says, "all of a sudden the FCC is involved, [and] we get a \$25,000 fine." Stone exited and landed at KITS (Live 105) San Francisco. "Possibly

the worst experience of my life. People didn't look at me. These people live the lifestyle of modern rock. You could imagine [how] all the schtick I did at KSJO about [gays] and lesbians [went over]. My first day [on the job, somebody wrote] on the program log, 'I hope you die, you son of a bitch.' This was a nice welcoming thing for me... It was the first time I didn't want to get up in the morning."

After a stop at classic rock WMGG Columbus, Ohio (now WBZX), Stone ended up at N/T WNIS as p.m. drive host. "A month down the road, [owner] Bob Sinclair purchased [WROX]. Jokingly, I said, 'If you need a morning guy, I've done it all my life.' He said, 'Do you want to do both?'" So now Stone does mornings on 96X with Henry Del Toro (formerly of crosstown rocker WNOR) and Holly Williams (formerly of crosstown classic rocker WAFX). His afternoon show on WNIS airs after Rush Limbaugh and covers current events and hot issues.

When PD Chris Corely left WROX to concentrate on his voice-over business in January, Stone added PD stripes to his a.m. and p.m. drive shifts.

This is his first PD job. Stone says, "I've worked with some of the best PDs, [such as] Dave Hamilton, Bob Buchman, Greg Ausham, [and] Ken Anthony. I think I've developed [from working with] all of those guys a good feel for what good radio should be all about."

Here's a sample 10 a.m. hour of WROX: Morrissey, "We Hate It When Our Friends Become Successful"; Porno For Pyros, "Pets"; U2, "Hold Me, Kiss Me, Kill Me"; Mazzy Star, "Fade Into You"; Gravity Kills, "Guilty"; the Church, "Metropolis"; and Dinosaur Jr., "Feel The Pain."

Stone rode the benefits of signal improvements (a secondary transmitter at 106.1) to an up trend, 3.7-4.6 12-plus. The station is one of a growing number of modern rock stations with direct in-format competition. Adult-leaning modern rock rival WKOC (the Coast) was down in the latest Arbitron survey 3.7-3.2.

How does Stone set his station apart? "It's the jocks," he maintains. "We are a renegade radio station. It's wild stuff. We have a punchier sound, whereas other stations lag [behind] and do the old AOR 'this was, that was.'"

Making the transition from talent to managing talent has been easy, Stone says. "I've been a crazy shock [jock], so I understand the mentality. I encourage people to be over the edge, because that's what separates us. I don't scream. I don't yell. I don't believe in hot-lining anybody, because I remember that was the worst feeling in the world. If I hear something I'm not happy with, I sit down and talk about it with the jocks."

What kind of stunts put 96X on the edge? "This transsexual had called us and said he needs a sex change but [his] insurance wouldn't cover it. [The operation costs] \$25,000, and we're going to have a fundraiser for him."

Stone also plans "national meat-out day," for which listeners and members of the local People for the Ethical Treatment of Animals chapter will be invited to join the station in a cook-out. Stone hopes to press one of PETA's hot buttons during the promotion—"boiling live lobsters on the air."

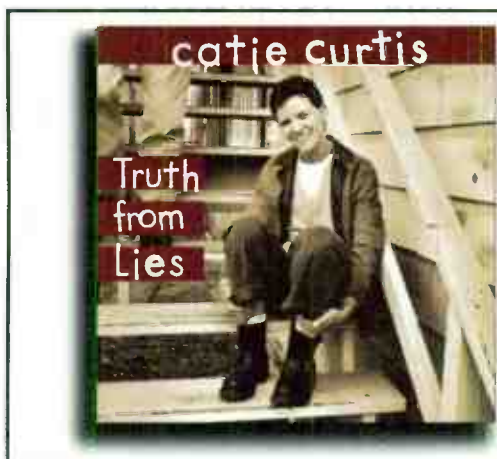

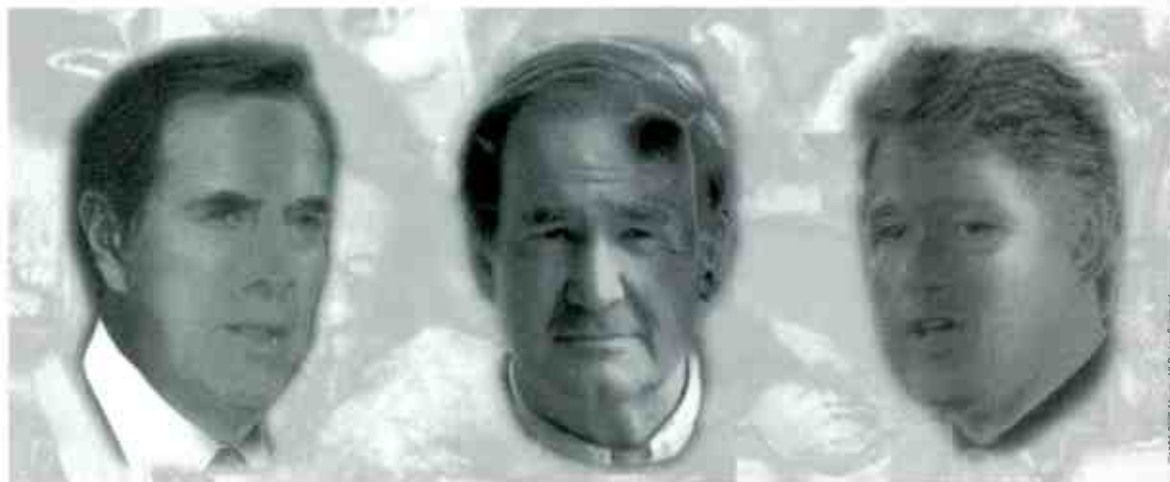
