Lessons Rock Labels Can Learn From Country's Artist Relationships

In country radio, observers say, the station visit is the foundation upon which country labels build their bands' success stories. It's absolutely mandatory that a full-scale radio tour to 150-200 reporting stations across the country take place before the first single is serviced. Artists cross paths in station lobbies as one goes in to play just as another comes out.

Certainly rock radio is no stranger to the artist visit, as countless benefit CDs will attest, each with its own unplugged versions of today's hits as recorded in a station's studios. But there is a difference. Consultant Tom Barnes pointed it out in a recent article (Rock Airplay Monitor, April 17) when he said that rock labels should follow the example of country labels' maintaining a strong connection between the artist and their fans . . . and radio, for that matter. And most programmers who have worked both rock and country can attest that the level of artist accessibility is greater. But not everybody we asked is sure the one-on-one approach would translate if stacks of Marshall amps are involved.

Rock radio veteran John Sebastian is PD of country KZLA Los Angeles. He says, "From day one, I was blown

away at the line of not only baby acts but well-known acts that came through the station."

He says that while in country, artists are so open that they seem like cousins. "Virtually they are unavailable in the rock realm . . . I don't know what happened that country all of a sudden figured out that this would be a real boon to their artists' careers."

"Country artists are easier to get to," adds Doug Hamand, OM of rock WKQQ Lexington, Ky., and its country sister, WBUL-FM. "They're more approachable than on the pop side, where . . . once they get a record on the radio, here comes the ego. You can't touch him, you can't speak to him, you have to stand in a line backstage and not say anything, not move." In contrast, "backstage at a country show, these guys are coming up to you and putting their arm around you, taking pictures with you.

REBA'S HERE TO SEE YOU

Sebastian tells of frequent visits and E-mails from Reba McEntire and even mentions that he and Garth Brooks are "talking about having dinner sometime. That would be like having dinner with Mick Jagger, Elton John, or Billy Joel." When it is



CBS, Jacor Swap Highlights Deal Trend

The last week brought an avalanche of station trading news. CBS and Jacor swapped stations in several markets, including San Jose, Calif., where Jacor picked up modern KOME and classic rock KUFX. Jacor was already slated to pick up album KSJO from ARS in the market. In St. Louis, classic rock KSD is put in the Jacor portfolio, and classic hits WOCT Baltimore is added to the Jacor lineup. CBS enters Columbus, Ohio, through the deal, via the pickup of album stations WLVQ and WAZU. In total, Jacor picks up six CBS stations and CBS gets five Jacor properties.

The swap satisfies the divestiture requirements that the Justice Department and the FCC established for CBS' pending purchase of American Radio Systems' stations in Baltimore, St. Louis, and San Jose; the FCC approved that deal May 27. Once the ARS deal is closed, CBS will have 165 stations in 33 markets. Jacor will have 204 stations in 55 markets when its pending deals close, including the buy of Nationwide Communications.

In a separate deal, Jacor spins modern WZAZ Columbus to Blue Chip. And the Baltimore Business Journal reports that Jacor is negotiating with Hearst Corp. to add album WIYV and N/T sister WBAL.

Capstar Broadcasting Corp. has completed its \$2.2 billion acquisition of SFX Broadcasting. That closing spurred the resolution of several other deals. Heftel has closed on SFX's modern adult outlet KKPN (the Planet) Houston and flipped it to regional Mexican. The remainder of the SFX Houston stations (including KODA and classic rock KKRW) were picked up by Chancellor. So are SFX outlets in Pittsburgh (including modern album WDVE, modern WXDX, and modern adult WDRV), San Diego (classic rock KPLN and soft AC KYXY), and Dallas (album KTXQ and AC KBFB). And Cox has closed on its purchase of four Long Island, N.Y., stations, including top 40 WBLI and album WBAB/WHFM.

With Chancellor picking up album WWDC-FM (DCI01) Washington, D.C., GM Goff Lebar exits, as expected. Sister talk WWRC/AC WGAY GM Rick Mack is interim GM at WWDC.

EXCL and ARS close on their station swap, giving ARS two Portland, Ore., signals, including triple-A KINK, and divesting it of a pair of Sacramento stations.

MANAGEMENT: HEY, PORTER

Jacor Salt Lake City VP/GM Rick Porter moves to Dayton as VP/market manager, which includes oversight of modern WXEG and album WTUE.

Don Oylear, GSM of country KUPL Portland is the new VP/GM at CBS' classic rock WZPT, country WDSY (Y108), and top 40 WBZZ (B94) Pittsburgh.

Central Star Madison, Wis., station manager Jeffrey Tyler is now GM of the company's five properties there, including album WIBA and modern WMAD. In other station news, WMAD overnighter Hambone takes nights, replacing the recently exited Robin Ellis, and WIBA P/T Jonathan Slayther moves to WMAD for overnights.

Barbara Allen exits as GM of AC/country/album rock combo WMYI/WSSL/WROQ. Greenville, S.C. Southern Star regional VP Bill McMartin is acting GM.

The Research Group executive VP Roxann Miller joins Cox Radio Inc. as VP of research, based in Portland, Ore.

PROGRAMMING: KOME ON OVER

In San Jose, with Jacor taking over

KOME, many KOME staffers remain in the CBS family, transplanted to KITS (Live 105). In are OM Ron Nenni and PD Jay Taylor; gone are VP Richard Sands, PD Roland West, and others. Howard Stern is now in mornings at Live 105.

Triple-A WBOS Boston has its new PD, as George Taylor Morris signs on. Morris was most recently across the street at classic rock WZLX, where he was APD.

Top 40-turned-N/T outlet KDRE Little Rock, Ark., becomes triple-A/modern hybrid Lick 101. GM Neal Ardman is programming the station. Cory Deitz and Jay Hamilton remain in mornings. The station is holding open auditions for its other positions.

Mike Topoll from the H&D Broadcast Group becomes GM of album WZNX Decatur, Ill. In a separate move, MD/afternoons Brian Rickman is named PD, as Chris Anderson exits. Rickman is looking for a replacement to cover Anderson's duties as local host of the station's Bob and Tom morning broadcasts.

Modern KHLR Bryan, Texas, APD/MD morning man Mark McKenzie becomes PD, as PD/middayer Mike Fitch exchanges the title for production director. Morning co-host Don Kelley adds APD stripes.

Modern WBZU Richmond, Va., PD J.J. Quest exits.

Classic rock KZFX Omaha, Neb., OM Mike Steele resigns.

After a brief experiment with current product, KSD St. Louis returns to classic rock.

Oldies KFMT Omaha, Neb., flips to classic hits under new PD/morning man Chris Walz. Karla James is out.

The M Street Journal reports that digital programming supplier CD Radio has announced its programming lineup. It includes two classic rock formats, two modern rock formats, five oldies channels, "soft rock," "love songs," four jazz channels, R&B, dance, two Christian formats, and at least nine Spanish-language channels.

The Los Angeles Times reports that L.A. radio veteran Jim "the Poorman" Trenton (ex-KACD, KPWR, KROQ) is leasing afternoons on suburban KPLS-AM beginning June 8 for a new show focusing only on unsigned and indie-label acts. Poorman's "Anti-Radio" will exclude anything that's been played at commercial radio. KPLS is a former children's radio outlet that's being sold to a religious programmer, so expect the anti-radio experiment to be short-lived.

PEOPLE: DELISI DELIVERED TO WPLT

Triple-A CIDR (the River) Detroit MD Ann Delisi crosses to modern WPLT (the Planet) as MD, replacing the recently exited Alex Tear.

Modern KNRK Portland promotion director Patty Pastor expands her duties to include sister classic rock KGON under the new title marketing director. KGON promotion director Garry Greth is now in Seattle doing promotion at classic rock KZOK, where he is reunited with KZOK PD Carey Curelop. The two last worked together at KLOS L.A.

With album KICT Wichita, Kan., MD Sherry McKinnon out, middayer R.J. Davis picks up MD duties. The overnight shift that McKinnon had been voice-tracking will be folded into a promotion director post that's up for grabs.

Triple-A WZEW Mobile, Ala., picks up Uncle Tim Hallmark as promotion director from crosstown adult R&B WDLT.

'Touch, Peel And Stand' Sets Record

AFTER 46 WEEKS at mainstream rock and 47 weeks at active rock, Days Of The New's "Touch, Peel And Stand" (Outpost/Geffen) goes to recurrent. "Touch" sets a mainstream rock record for having the longest chart run since the recurrent rule was put into effect in June 1992. The only two songs that have had an equal or longer stay on the chart are Van Halen's "Top Of The World" and "Right Now," which spent 51 and 46 weeks on the mainstream rock chart, respectively. Days Of The New's newest, "The Down Town," moves 40-26 at mainstream rock with a 90% increase and 35-22 at modern rock with a 96% gain. And another long-running title, Creed's "My Own Prison" (Wind-Up), goes to recurrent after 28 weeks on the modern rock chart.

CMC International has three acts charting simultaneously at heritage rock for the first time in the label's history. Deep Purple's "Any Fule Kno That" debuts at No. 38, joining Blue Oyster Cult's "Harvest Moon" (39-32) and Van Zant's "Rage" (23-31).

Although the Beastie Boys show up regularly in the gold lists of many modern rock stations, they have only charted three times since the debut of the modern rock chart in 1988. "Intergalactic" (Grand Royal/Capitol), the Boys' fourth modern rock title to chart, debuts at No. 34 with 57 stations. To top their previous chart numbers, "Intergalactic" will have to go higher than No. 18, the peak position of both "Hey Ladies" (1989) and "Sabotage" (1994).

INDUSTRY MOVES: ZTT inks a four-year distribution deal with Universal; the label was distributed by Warner Bros. until last year. The first album to benefit from this agreement will likely be an Art Of Noise release due late this year.

Mercury senior director of modern rock promotion Michael Idlis has resigned. He looks to make an announcement shortly on his next move. After June 19, he can be reached at 212-245-6292 . . . MCA ups Southeast regional Jeff Davis to national director of East Coast promotion. Davis will head all rock and alternative promotion efforts . . . Nettwerk national director of promotion Marc Alghini heads to Astralwerks for the same post . . . Geffen's Northwest regional promotion slot has been phased out; you can reach Carolyn Padgham at 206-723-2405. Padgham's duties have been absorbed by San Francisco local Scott Perlewitz.

V2 adds former Revolution local Randy Smith for Southwest duties. Look for V2 to hire several regionals and one national in the coming months.

Joe DeMeo, formerly with Delicious Vinyl, joins Trauma as VP of sales and field marketing . . . Sony Music Distribution L.A. marketing manager Gary Kelly is upped to New York/Washington, D.C., marketing manager for Epic.

ARTIST DEVELOPMENTS: Billboard Bulletin reports that Stone Temple Pilots singer Scott Weiland, on tour for his solo project, was arrested on charges of drug possession June 1 in New York . . . As the Black Crowes near the completion of their fifth album, their first for Columbia, the band will spend a six-week stretch playing clubs starting June 19 in New Haven, Conn. Look for the album in September . . . Republic Records has signed Rob Van Winkle, who is in the studio working on his label debut, "Hard To Swallow," with producer Ross Robinson (Korn, Limp Bizkit). You might recall Van Winkle by his old performance name, Vanilla Ice.

Sprung Monkey's Brotherhood of Jams

If there's one consistent thread within the music of San Diego's **Sprung Monkey**, it's eclecticism. First, the group's members hail from ethnic backgrounds that are more varied than most—a mix of Hawaiian, Mexican, African-American, and Japanese. Second, they have a penchant for juggling everything from funk-inflected metal and hip-hop to jazz and punk in an eclectic mix like that made by **Faith No More**.

But as singer **Steve Summers** says about Sprung Monkey's major-label debut, "Mr. Funny Face," diversity works in different ways. "We do so many different styles of music, so we know that some of the songs we do are never going to see the radio. We also feel that some of the things are right in the mix," says the half-Hawaiian singer about the prospect of getting airplay. "Then you come to realize that there's this wheel of big business behind the whole music industry, and if you're lucky enough, you can catch a break and bypass all of that."

After eight years together and two independent albums ("Swirl" on Surfdog Records was produced by '70s luminary **Roy Thomas Baker**), Sprung Monkey appears ready to be hoisted from perennial local favorite to national competitor with "Get 'Em Outta Here." While the album's amalgamation of aggressive rap/metal/funk is bound to make further inroads with the band's already established skate crowd, the single's breezy, feel-good vibe has broader pop potential. Summers says there's a specific inspiration for each song. "I always go into it with an idea in mind. Whether I can pull it off or not, it always comes out different." For instance, the single's call-and-response chorus, he says, was influenced by hip-hop act **the Pharcyde**.

Sprung Monkey started out in typical fashion "as kids drinking in the garage" using the moniker **Love Slug**. "We kept the same theme, I guess, for better or worse," says Summers, confirming the anatomical nature of the band's current name. "But now it seems like at times [the name] can come back to haunt you, so we tell people it's like 'being crazy.'"

Less typical, however, has been the relationship between the singer and his brother, guitarist **Mike Summers**, who formed the band. Usually the mention of siblings together brings about an assumed cynicism that the partnership is imminently doomed, but not here. "I can't remember ever fighting with him once in my whole life," says Steve. "I think our parents have just been like two angels, so we've always had that to look at and the love they have for each other and the way they've treated us. I've never even heard them fight." Their father was a former sax player who played in big bands and who, Summers notes, "was in the military when he went over and got himself a little Hawaiian bride." Sprung Monkey even pays homage to the Summers' Hawaiian roots in a tribute to a recently deceased cousin of the Summers' in a song called "He Aloha Mele."

A winner in the San Diego Music Awards for three years running beginning in 1994, Sprung Monkey has built its reputation on a strong affiliation with the skate crowd. Additionally, it's appeared in a handful of skate-lifestyle videos. "Kids are attaching themselves to our band through these Fox motocross videos without even knowing anything about us," Steve Summers says.

Summers adds the band members skate a bit themselves, but you won't see them out on the courses trying to traverse the vertical jumps. "I got one in the trunk in case I ever run out of gas," offers the singer, adding that he'd prefer to leave the daredevil antics to the pros. "We enjoy the energy of the whole scene. Those are the people who are really going for it in that realm, and we like to think we're the same way musically."

They'll be feeding off that energy again this summer when they head out on the road with Unwritten Law in June, followed by dates on the East Coast leg of the Warped tour. And certain things will not have changed since Sprung Monkey began in the garage of the Summers' home. "We have yet to get a white guy in the band. So we just hire them as our road crew and make the white man work for us," Summers says, laughing.

Lessons Rock Labels Can Learn From Country's Artist Relationships

pointed out that he is, after all, in L.A., Sebastian replies, "I hear the same story wherever I go, Lubbock, Phoenix, Cleveland."

Sebastian also notes "a sincerity to their approach to meeting you that bowls me over, where sometime you got the feeling with other formats, even in those rare circumstances where a band does come by, [that] they were going through the motions and supposed to do this. With country artists, it's like, 'I really appreciate any opportunity I can to meet you and play my music.'"

Clear Channel Orlando, Fla., OM Chris Kampmeier, whose duties now include oversight of modern adult WSHE, programmed country at WYNY New York. He says, "One of the things that differentiates country artists compared to rockers when they're making the rounds is that the country performers know that if they play it right, it is a lifetime career." But, he says, rock musicians know their life expectancy is a bit more tenuous, so they don't put as much effort into it as he saw in his country days, and it's evident in "their attitudes and their relationships and the extent to which they reach out to their fans."

Yet Kampmeier does see a similarity between country artists and today's modern adult acts. "They're very down to earth, very easy-going, very happy to meet anybody they could, comfortable playing in the conference room. It could be that the music has more of an acoustic foundation, but it seems to be a hungry attitude."

ROCK NOT ALL THAT BAD

Not all rock heavyweights are that aloof. Hamand says that when Aerosmith was in the area, WKQQ got to broadcast live from the venue and was joined on the air by all the band members. "For Aerosmith to do what they did for us was phenomenal. They had a lot of fun with us, took a lot of calls," says Hamand.

As Susquehanna's director of programming in Atlanta and Dallas, Brian Philips works with country KPLX Dallas and modern WNNX Atlanta. Country artists, he says, "are very good at staying in touch and having a personal touch," although Philips thinks the industry could be "a lot more inventive with how we use the artist's time" than plunking them down in a conference room. He cites the work he's done at 99X, where the artists are involved with charity events, bringing them closer to their audience, to the benefit of both parties.

And Philips compares the tireless outreach of country artists, regardless of market size, to baby acts at the modern format. "In Atlanta, we've gotten really used to seeing a lot of artists. Almost every day there's somebody stopping in."

V2 VP of promotion Matt Pollack thinks rock has had more than its fair share of artist visits. "As a label, you have to be real cognizant that this is not a new concept," he says. "But it's so overdone, [that] unless the artist is so exceptional, it's diluted . . . I only do it with the artists that lend themselves to that environment. Some artists have the kind of voice where the room is so quiet you can hear a pin drop." But, Pollack recalls, "it's backfired in a couple of instances . . . An artist may have a terrific voice and you bring them into a room and it fails—it's embarrassing."

Pollack cites Alanis Morissette as one example of an artist helped by a station tour. "I remember Alanis Morissette going to every station she could. That's what won them."

"Everybody's come in and done these things and people never forget that Alanis Morissette played in our conference room," Philips adds.

CONFERENCE ROOM AS STUDIO

But not every rock act will come across in a conference room. Pollack says that hard rock acts in particular just don't sound the same unplugged. "A country artist I can see doing very well, because a lot of the music sonically comes in that mold," he says. "What works so well is [that country] songs lend themselves to intimate settings."

TVT Records national director of alternative radio promotion John Perrone agrees that

when it comes to some rock acts, sitting down with an acoustic guitar in a crowded conference room may not be the way to go. Citing both Gravity Kills and Sevendust, Perrone says that if he encountered a programmer who wasn't playing his bands, he'd "bring them to the venue to see them playing live and then maybe introduce them to the band. Especially on Sevendust, since they're such a powerful live band, we sold a bunch of people on what they can do live."

The same thing goes for Gravity Kills, whose "stage presence is amazing," says Perrone. And that's something you're not going to see in a conference room. "You want to show what they can do live," Perrone says. "We did a lot of radio festivals on the first record for Gravity Kills. Those kids flipped out when they played their single," and that sells a programmer, too.

GRAVITY SIGNS

Perrone says Gravity Kills has embraced the country philosophy of getting out there and meeting with the fans. "Every band should do it," he says. "There shouldn't even be a question." For the first Gravity Kills album, Perrone says, "they played every one of the radio festivals, and they have those autograph booths. Each band only gets a half-hour to meet their fans. Last time around, in Dallas at the Edgefest and in Houston at Buzzfest, they had their time, and then they were leaving but still had a line of fans. They sat there for an hour and a half to two hours meeting their fans, signing autographs and getting their picture taken with the fans. These kids remember this. This is the way they keep in touch with their fans."

Perrone adds, "We didn't have to school this band. They want a career, [and] they know that this is good for their career. They are completely and utterly ready to do what they have to do for their career. Meeting the kids and meeting the programmers and remembering the names of programmers they've met. People remember when this band came through, and they remember names and are good with that. They keep up with their Web site and answer every possible question that they can."

WHERE ARE THE LESSONS?

To Kampmeier, this is not necessarily so much an issue for labels as for management. "For any young person attempting to build a career, making as many friends as you can both among listeners and business people is going to help your career growth. And stations are certainly willing to devote a lot more energy to developing a new artist when the artist makes themselves available."

Philips says, "It's a fundamental business truth that if you meet someone face to face and especially if you get some follow-up, it's great. It's essential to getting to the next level." When an artist makes that personal connection, "it helps in this era of too many records, too many artists, and too many signings."

From the record side, Pollack would like nothing more than an artist who is as much a promotion animal as he is. "There's no bigger magic than when the artist is their own self-promoting machine. Some of the most successful acts are those that understand what promotion does," he says. "I've seen artists basically get themselves played on the radio. They went in there and worked the hallways, everyone from the receptionist to the GM. So by the time they opened their mouth to sing the song, they had the station in their hands."

While some country A&R folk will go so far as putting station-visit abilities on their checklist when signing talent, Pollack doesn't see doing that any time soon. "It's not a prerequisite at all in the A&R or promotion," he says. "It's just an added advantage. In marketing meetings, I always want to know, 'How are they on one-on-ones? Are they comfortable in an acoustic situation? How are they in interviews?' If they're not good at that, we move on. It's amazing that the country format really uses that as a base for signing artists. For us, it's an added advantage."




