Atlanta's 99X Is The Biggest Rock Winner At Radio Awards

Once the dust cleared in the banquet hall, modern WNNX (99X) Atlanta emerged as the winningest station in rock radio at the 1998 Billboard/Airplay Monitor Radio Awards. The awards were presented Sept. 19 at the Billboard/Airplay Monitor Radio Seminar.

WNNX leads the pack with four awards: major-market modern station of the year, PD of the year for Leslie Fram, MD of the year for Sean Demery, and promotion director of the year for Jennifer Nech. It's a remarkable showing for 99X, which left Billboard/Airplay Monitor's convention last year in Orlando, Fla., empty-handed.

WNNX inherits the "most awards" honor from a consistent industry favorite, album WRCX Chicago. Still

no slouch, Rock 103.5 picked up major-market album station of the year, with Jo Robinson getting MD of the year honors and former morning host Mancow being named local air personality of the year. Those awards kept WRCX atop the album rock pack this year.

Perennial triple-A favorite WXRT Chicago walked away with its annual hat trick. Once again, it picked up station of the year, PD of the year for Norm Winer, and MD of the year for Patty Martin. Combining their awards with WRCX makes Chicago rock's strongest city.

The only other station to earn more than one award was former modern outlet KOMA San Jose, Calif., which picked up secondary-market modern station of the year.

Brandmeier Unhappy With 'CKG Middays; Hawk Disses Stern, But WLUP Settles

According to The Chicago Tribune, **Jonathan Brandmeier** has been leaving voice mails with executives at N/T **WCKG** Chicago complaining about his midday slot at the station. Columnist **Jim Kirk** reports that Brandmeier has been telling execs, "You're hiding me. I'm a race-horse stuck in the stall. I'm a caged tiger." To the paper, he says, "You don't put me in that shift . . . If I'm No. 1 in mornings and afternoons, all of a sudden I'm no longer a viable personality? Give me a break. It's really up to CBS to decide whether I'm in the right place."

At the 11th hour, classic rock **KKHK** (the Hawk) Denver opted not to put the syndicated **Howard Stern** morning show on the station. Meanwhile, The Chicago Sun-Times reports that Stern's 5-year-old \$45 million suit against **WLUP** Chicago for dropping his show has been settled out of court. WLUP was then owned by Evergreen, whose successor, Chancellor Media, settled with Stern for undisclosed terms.

MANAGEMENT: FULLAM UP?

WHTZ (Z100)/**WKTU** New York senior VP/GM **John Fullam** is promoted to regional manager of Chancellor; his new turf includes the group's stations in Detroit; Washington, D.C.; and Long Island, N.Y.

In other Chancellor news, VP/director of national sales **Chuck Armstrong** becomes VP of entertainment marketing and new media. The job will have him develop marketing plans geared toward exposing new record, TV, and film releases; generate nontraditional revenue streams; and create an Internet strategy that will coordinate cross-media, multi-platform campaigns.

Regina Todd becomes GM for Citadel's Wilkes-Barre, Pa., properties, including album **WZMT**, top 40 **WBHT** (Hot 97), and AC **WMGS**, following ex-GM **Bill Betts'** segue to Citadel's Allentown, Pa., outlets.

Dax Tobin, known to many on the rock side as GM of **KISF** Las Vegas during its tenure as modern rock **KEDG**, is leaving the station to launch his own advertising agency. Owner **George Tobin** reassumes GM duties. Meanwhile, **Fitz**, who survived the station's modern rock-to-adult R&B switch, is now officially PD for the new format.

Twenty-year marketing executive **David I. Sass** is named president of SFX Entertainment's new SFX Live division. Pace Communications president **Bruce Eskowitz** joins as executive VP. The company handles sales, marketing, promotion, and client services for national live entertainment through the SFX chain.

PROGRAMMING: DUNCAN EXITS KLOS

Album **KLOS** Los Angeles PD **John Duncan** exits. **Rita Wilde** takes on programming duties while a new PD is sought.

Album **WXTB** Tampa, Fla., APD/MD **Brian Medlin** becomes PD of album sister **WYNF** Sarasota, Fla.

Modern **WGMR** State College, Pa., PD/MD/midday host **Richard Drake** exits. OM/week-endler **Mike Evans** picks up Drake's responsibilities.

Classic rock **KCDQ** Odessa, Texas, flips to active rock, with new calls **KFZX** being applied for. The station picks up **Bob and Tom** for mornings, with **Ethan Demetrius** joining from album **KFMX** Lubbock, Texas, as MD/afternoons. **KKZQ** Fayetteville, Ark., night jock **Slick Willy Dickson** joins for nights.

Album **KBAT** Midland, Texas, flips to rhythmic top 40, as PD **Leo Caro**, MD **Kevin Chase**, and the entire staff of top 40 rival **KCHX** take over the former rocker.

Veteran programmer **Cary Pall**, most recently group PD of the Goodstar stations, is returning to Dayton, Ohio, and to the consulting business. His first client will be the Goodstar outlets.

PEOPLE: HANSON HEADS TO 'RIF

Troy Hanson, last PD of album **KAZR** Des Moines, Iowa, joins album **WRIF** Detroit as MD, replacing **Dave Wellington**.

Triple-A **WDOD** Chattanooga, Tenn., morning team **Jack** and **Jason** cross the street to new mainstream top 40 convert **WKXJ** for mornings, which doesn't sit so well with the **WDOD** folks. Asked about the move, **WDOD** OM **Dan Howard** says, "**Jack Cole** is under a non-compete; however, he has been on the radio, and our legal division is looking into the matter."

Album **KPOI** Honolulu OM **Jeff Blazy** takes mornings, as PD **Brock Whaley** moves to afternoons.

Modern **KBRS** Fayetteville, Ark., picks up **D.T.** from satellite top 40 network Music Channel One for mornings, as **Grover** exits. Middayer **Robin Lee** exits the station and radio. Afternoon co-host **Brick** slides into middays.

Album **KCGQ** Cape Girardeau, Mo., drops the syndicated **Steve and D.C.** morning show, with PD **Kevin Casey** taking wake-up duties.

Modern adult **KQMB** Salt Lake City APD/MD **Ben "Beej" Bretz** adds APD/MD/nights at classic hits sister **KRSP**. Night air personality **Frank Belko** moves to the afternoon shift, replacing **Stevy**, who is now programming oldies sister **KMGR**.

Consolidation Continues To Command Conferees' Attention

Maybe it was the triple-digit temperatures, but heated conversations on hot-button topics sparked many panels at the Billboard/Airplay Monitor Radio Seminar and Awards, held Sept. 17-19 in Phoenix. Here are some choice hits, verbal and otherwise, from the confab.

The confab-opening rock panel addressed consolidation but focused as well on record companies downsizing and exchanging local reps for regionals, straining the radio/record relationship and creating a need for more promotional creativity. Epic's Scott Douglas spoke of working individually with promotion directors early on in the Korn project as being a key element in breaking the band.

Speaking on the traditionally contentious issue of station festivals, **WRCX** (Rock 103.5) Chicago APD **Jo Robinson** suggested that with baby bands, it would be more beneficial to all concerned if stations were given more time to develop a new song into a hit with their audience before the label starts trying to bring the band into the market for a station concert.

And when it came to big-time station festivals, **WDHA** Morristown, N.J., PD **Lenny Bloch** said he may pursue the model that **WRCX** and **WLZR** Milwaukee set with **Rockstock** a few

years ago, when the two stations paired up for an all-day rock festival at a site halfway between both markets. Bloch said that **WDHA** and **WBAB** Long Island, N.Y., have been in discussions to co-promote shows based in New York.

Panelists reinforced the idea that the rock format believes in artist loyalty and cited the success of **Tool**, **Days Of The New**, and **Creed** as acts who have gotten multiple-song airplay. There's even a core audience for the format's previous image acts. Over seminar weekend, **KUPD** Phoenix presented an '80s hair-band weekend, a promotion that Bloch said was his biggest all summer. Added **Sharon Schifino** of **WHJY** Providence, R.I., "The thing about hair-band rock of the '80s is [that] the fans are still there. They want to hear 'Looks That Kill,' but they aren't going to go out and buy the new album."

I WANNA PUSH YOU ASIDE

Larger station clusters and lower passion scores were among the chief topics at Saturday's modern rock panel. When **KTEG** Albuquerque, N.M., PD **Skip Isley** told the audience that he had ceded **matchbox 20** to his modern adult sister, a frustrated **Tom Biery** of **Warner Bros.** called it "insane to think that because one station plays **matchbox 20** the other couldn't." **Biery** added that he couldn't understand a format that breaks acts and then, as soon as they're huge, cedes ownership.

Album **WRIF** Detroit PD **Doug Podell**, whose sister is modern **WXDG**, retorted that today's cluster programming requires giving each station a lane. "It is not about music or breaking the next **Wallflowers** . . . It was a format for breaking new artists; it is now a format that is supposed to make money."

Modern **KROX** Austin, Texas, PD **Sara Trexler** concurred that "we all have passion for the music" but doubted the level of passion left in the audience. Looking at her test scores, she sees songs with net positives in the low 60s, rather than in the 80s. "Look at other formats, and their best music scores higher." Likewise, said **Podell**, "in rock, our scores are the lowest they've ever been" in Detroit.

Consultant-turned-promoter **Dan O'Toole** noted from the audience that if, in **NETRA-FM** (91X) San Diego's heyday, that station had researched the music, it "would have shown it wasn't the music, it was the station" that listeners cared about. That led former PD **Mike Haloran** to contend that when he left 91X, "they started giving listeners what they wanted,"

measured by research, and the station started failing.

So has all of this drained the fun entirely out of radio? The consensus at the "Making Radio Fun Again" panel was that despite the shadow of consolidation, cutbacks, and increased competition at radio, the fun factor has not evaporated, if only because radio remains so different from the "real jobs" held by listeners. As **Pamal's Brian Krysz** noted, "Who has as much fun getting free CDs, concert tickets, [and] free drinks except for maybe a politician?"

RADIO TERRORISM?

The "Who Owns What Acts" panel debated the politics of concert presents and related issues. Although the panelists agreed that their listeners don't often know who "owns" the acts, and that the loss of one presents won't irreparably harm a station, "it can have a cumulative effect," **KROQ** L.A. PD **Kevin Weatherly** warned. "We want our audience to identify top-of-mind with our [core] artists."

MCA Records senior VP **Nancy Levin** slammed groups that flex chainwide clout. Citing a market in which one station first broke

Semisonic and three **Jacor** stations also played it, she claimed **Jacor** threatened to drop **MCA** product on all its stations if it didn't receive the presents, as well as in-studio appearances, etc.

"We don't negotiate with terrorists," she declared.

Representing the concert promotion side of the business, **Evening Star's** **Danny Zelisko** voiced a familiar complaint that artists who play station shows fail to sell tickets to their own concerts scheduled weeks or months later. **Weatherly** responded that **KROQ** works with local promoters and, secondly, if promoted well, the station appearances can help give a boost to a new artist's career.

DIALING FOR DOLLARS

The seminar's "Dialing For Dollars" panel covered a variety of strategies to increase radio's share of the label dollars that now go to print. **Elektra's** **Greg Thompson** noted that, as a promotion person, "print is not our choice," saying it comes from "extortion labels pay [retail] for placement in the market. Radio needs to go to retailers, not labels."

BANG II Records' **Ilene Berns** urged programmers to "talk to **Kmart** and **Wal-Mart**" directly. **KHS** Los Angeles marketing director **Von Freeman**, as moderator, pledged to do that, offering **Jacor's** aforementioned group muscle to promise labels the same efficiency offered by a print ad that lists multiple titles. **Paul Drew**, a longtime proponent of above-board pay-for-play, suggested that radio's new megagroups again own their own record labels, citing the number of TV shows that were now partially owned by networks.

Other highlights of the **Billboard/Airplay Monitor Radio Seminar and Awards**, which attracted approximately 850 attendees and 1,000 to its Saturday-night awards dinner:

- **DreamWorks** **SKG** co-founder **Jeffrey Katzenberg** and **DreamWorks Records** co-leader **Mo Ostin** showed clips of their animated holiday epic "The Prince Of Egypt" and outlined the all-star artist participation in the film's three soundtracks.

- Featured speaker **Allen Kovac** of **Left Bank** Organization bemoaned the corporate label pressure to cut marketing, which stunts artist product growth. His answer is to build an audience for acts on his **Beyond** label through outside marketing before taking them to radio.

- Acts on **Sept. 18's** artist panel described their experiences with radio as positive overall, despite what some saw as an arrogance on the part of some PDs. **Mark McGrath** of the Atlantic act **Sugar Ray** remained sanguine, telling attendees that he was still the "stupid puppy . . . who says, 'Fuck me for all I'm worth.'"

Bruce Hornsby "Debuts" On Triple-A Chart

ON THE CHARTS: Bruce Hornsby is considered a core triple-A artist, but his track "Great Divide" (RCA), which enters the triple-A chart at No. 13 this issue, marks his first appearance on there. (It's his first project since Monitor spun off a triple-A chart.) The pianist's double CD "Spirit Trail" hits stores Oct. 13. Ashley MacIsaac contributes violin to "Great Divide."

In the 10-year history of the modern rock chart, there has been a handful of records that have come back to reclaim the No. 1 spot, but never has a record come back a third time. Until now: Eve 6's "Inside Out" achieves that goal by losing fewer spins this week than *Barenaked Ladies*, which has been locked in a duel with Eve 6 for the top spot since early August.

NEW REPORTERS: Added to the mainstream rock and heritage rock panels this issue is **KYYS** Kansas City (PD Larry Moffit, MD Slacker, 913-677-8998). Added to the mainstream rock and active rock panel is **WXRA** Greensboro, N.C., which slides over from modern rock. **KRAD** Corpus Christi, Texas, officially joins the modern panel, while former modern outlet **KHTY** is removed. Moving from mainstream and heritage rock to triple-A is **WLUM** Milwaukee, joined by new triple-A reporter **KXL-FM** Portland, Ore. (PD/MD Carl Widing, 503-243-7595). Panel sizes: mainstream rock, 111; modern rock, 75; active rock, 50; heritage rock, 61; and triple-A, 23.

PERSONNEL FILE: Warner Bros. 25-year vet **Stu Cohen** exits his senior VP of promotion post. The promotion staff continues to report to national promotion VPs **Tom Biery** and **Barney Kilpatrick**, both of whom report to executive VP/GM **Andy Schuon**.

Capitol VP of rock promotion **Dave Ross** is bound for Interscope to head up its rock efforts. **Billboard** Bulletin reports that Mercury Records Group president/CEO **Danny Goldberg** has denied rumors that he'll resign.

Former Dallas-based Work local promo guy **David Newmark** has joined DreamWorks in the same capacity . . . Geffen Los Angeles regional promotion manager **Zack Philips** relocates to Denver for the label . . . Hollywood hires former Breakaway promo staffer **Denise Wilke** for its Chicago-based Midwest regional position.

with Jay Taylor getting PD of the year honors. Like WRCX and WXRT, KOME's win is an encore performance from last year.

Other repeat winners from last year include album **WEBN** Cincinnati, for secondary-market album station; album **WLZR** Milwaukee PD Keith Hastings, for secondary-market album PD; and **KROX** Austin, Texas' Sara Trexler, for secondary modern local air personality honors.

Howard Stern again picks up an award for nationally syndicated air personality of the year, and Tom Calderone's swan song with radio was his return invitation to the podium to pick up consultant of the year for rock radio, recognizing his work with Jacobs Media.

GONE AWAY

Like the MTV-bound Calderone, several winners picked up awards for jobs they no longer hold. KOME and Taylor, are both gone from San Jose, with Taylor running nearby modern **KITS** (Live 105) San Francisco. And repeat winner Mancow left the station for which he won his

latest award, moving crosstown from WRCX to WKQX.

In the spirit of consolidation, we've tallied which owners picked up the most awards. The winner in that heat was CBS, with seven trophies to line Mel Karmazin's den—eight if you include Westwood One's win for its "House Of Blues" syndicated show. WNNX's quartet of wins earned Susquehanna second place, and WRCX's three wins mean Chancellor gets third place.

And congratulations to the winner of our first label of the year category. Our readers put Capitol Records on top for both mainstream

and modern rock.

It's important to note that there was some shifting of categories this year. In the past, we broke markets down to major, medium, and small categories. This year, we have major- and secondary-market categories. We've also folded modern rock and mainstream rock into one category for radio consultant and network/syndicated program of the year.

Single White Female Sings The Blues

When you're a young white female singer on the blues circuit, as **Susan Tedeschi** is, you either get used to the rigors of road life or you get out. From the looks of it, the diminutive 27-year-old with the big voice would rather be nothing else but the seeming underdog in the predominantly male blues world. Tedeschi just came off the road from a summer tour with **Buddy Guy** and **Jonny Lang** and is getting ready to start a jaunt Sept. 15 with **B.B. King** and **Dr. John**.

Tedeschi has dealt with the initial skepticism that occasionally greets her when she takes the stage, the odd promoter of ill repute, and the rambunctious beer-swilling crowds. She says only one thing continues to be an obstacle for her and reminds the guitarist of her gender. "Guys get dressed right there in the parking lot and throw some water on their hair, and they're all set. I can't do that," says the Norwell, Mass., native. "I have to get some electricity, curl or blow-dry my hair, put on some makeup and jewelry, because there's a certain image that you want to have onstage."

Looking pretty may seem a novel concept in the blues, but that image has endeared her to blues crowds around the country. Looking like the girl next door until she lets her vocals rip, Tedeschi has been known to leave crowds with their collective jaw hanging.

Her blues howl—something between **Janis Joplin** and **Bonnie Raitt**—hasn't gone unnoticed by the old guard either. Veterans such as **Otis Rush**, **Erma Thomas**, and **Guy** have invited her to share the stage with them. **Guy**, in partic-

ular, has "been very sweet and very supportive. Just to sit and drink cognac with him," she says with a laugh. A dozen times on their recent tour together, **Guy** featured Tedeschi during his own set. "Onstage, he said to me, 'You can join my band anytime. I'll make you the star of my show anytime.' He tells me to leave my band and come out with him."

Tedeschi has been at it since graduating the Berklee School of Music in 1991, with a degree in performance and arranging and little regard for the blues. But the genres Tedeschi sang—old boxcar country, R&B, and gospel—put her right on a path to discover the blues, particularly learning to sing with gospel choirs. Ironically, Tedeschi's introduction to the blues came via another former gospel singer who turned her on to "Aretha Sings The Blues," which she calls "an incredible record. It changed my life, I'm sure."

The pull to the blues became an obsession for Tedeschi, and immediately she began jamming in Boston's blues clubs and formed the Susan Tedeschi Band in 1993. Since then, she's been collecting awards and accolades for her powerful vocals, including the label "best new R&B act" in 1995 by Boston magazine and being asked to appear at many festivals around the country. **Tone Cool** signed the group last year.

Tedeschi is aware but not intimidated that, as a white girl from suburban Boston, she is treading ground previously walked by such formidable characters as **Big Mama Thornton** and **Etta James**, two of her vocal inspirations. "I've always been amazed about how many people look at you at first and don't know what to expect," says Tedeschi. "But when you actually sing and your soul pours out of you, then they don't judge you anymore. [Well], they do, but they give in. The music is stronger than the preconceived notions that people have."






