Seeking Next Talent Wave? PDs Say, 'Grow Some Jocks Of Your Own'

Automation and virtual radio has made programmers fearful that there's no longer a small-market training ground for the next generation of major-market talent. Now, programmers, who listed the "talent puzzle" as their top concern in a year-end Airplay Monitor survey of PDs in all formats, say the answer is already in their halls. They've shifted their focus from raiding small markets or seeking celebrity talent to strengthening in-house mentoring and internship programs and taking the time to develop new talent as soon as it walks in the door.

Triple-A WHPT Tampa, Fla., PD Chuck Beck says, "Programmers must look for the raw talent and work with them to fit our needs. We are not taking the time to develop personalities. That's part of our jobs."

Album KRXQ Sacramento, Calif., PD Curtiss Johnson adds, "I've had quite a bit of success by growing my own," citing "a few interns in the past that showed potential, great attitude, drive, and desire." Among those who came forward when Johnson programmed KUPD Phoenix was Ari-

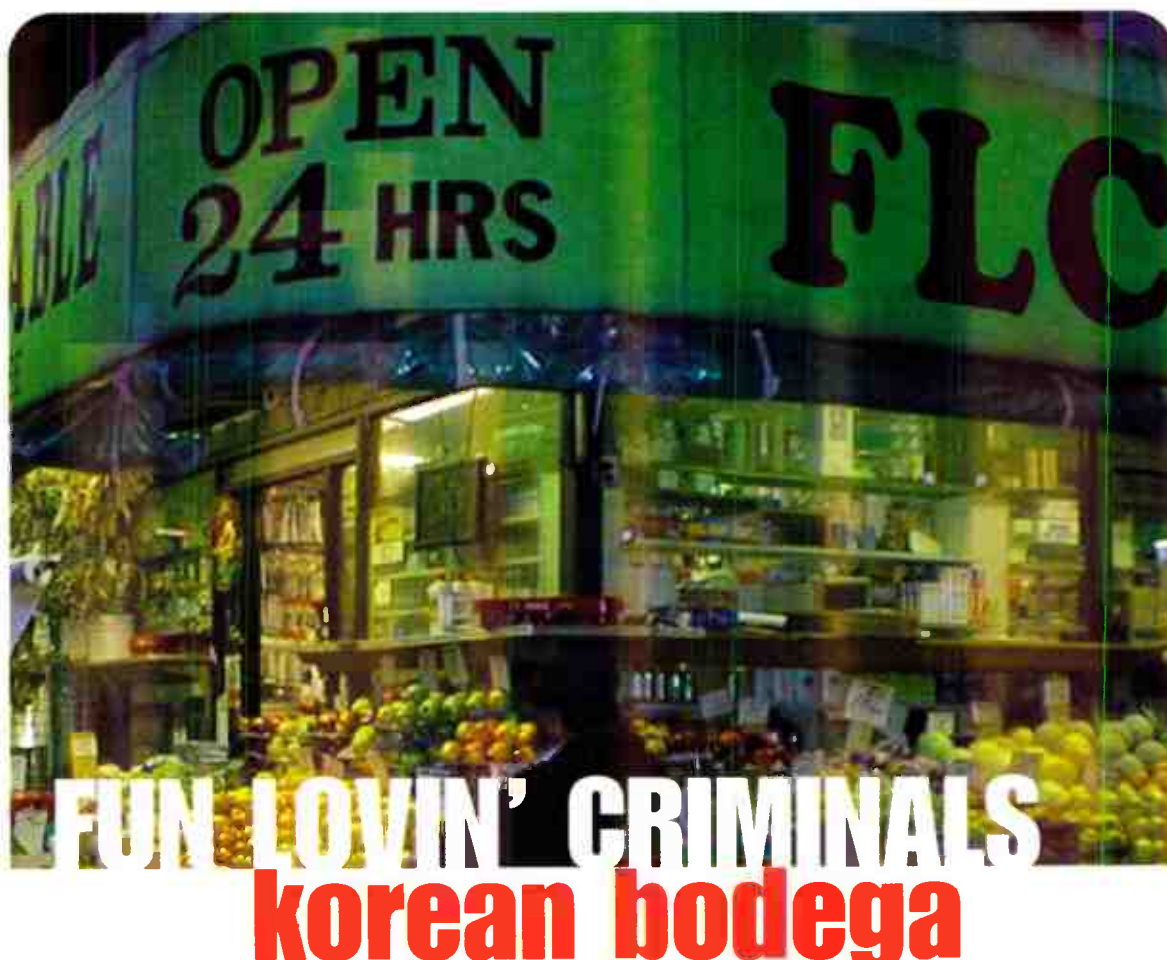
zona State University student Pete Cummings, who played drums in a local band, answered phones, and helped out during Johnson's afternoon shift in the early '90s.

"Pete would do running monologues in many different character voices in the hallways and toy with listeners when they called in. I decided to have him play DJ in the production studios on the weekends. After several months of going over the tapes with him, I eventually had him do some overnight weekend shifts. Before I left Phoenix he was the full-time overnighiter. When I left, Tim Maranville pulled him up to nights," Johnson says. "A year later, Pete Cummings was in the afternoon-drive chair."

That tradition continues in Sacramento: "I have a few positions on staff now, behind the scenes and behind the mikes, that were former interns of the station." Johnson favors interns "for entry-level positions, because you know what you're getting. You know their work ethic, how they get along with other staff members, and any quirks they may have."

A brief glance at recent issues of Rock Airplay Monitor's Radioactive

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World Radio History

This Week, Join Us For A Wild Ride To The Cutting Edge Of Sensibilities

Following several highly publicized crashes of chartered gambling buses between New York and Atlantic City, N.J., one of them fatal, modern WPLY (Y100) Philadelphia is challenging listeners to "the Ultimate Gamble"—surviving a bus ride with the station's morning show and "the grim reaper in the driver's seat" to Atlantic City.

In other news from the cutting edge of public (or at least regulatory) sensibilities, syndicated Jacor personality and album WXTB (98 Rock) Tampa, Fla., morning host **Bubba the Love Sponge** has once again gotten his host station an FCC fine. This time, management will owe \$7,000 for a May 28 broadcast the FCC deemed indecent. This comes on the heels of a \$23,000 fine last October, after Bubba joked about having sex with cows. Meanwhile, Jacor album flagship **WEBN** Cincinnati drops the Bubba network feed. Night jock **Cousin Deke** expands his 7-10 p.m. shift to 7 p.m.-midnight.

BUSINESS: NEW GREATER PHILLY GM
At Greater Media's Philadelphia stations—including album WMMR, modern adult WXXM, and classic rock WMGK—senior VP/GM **Dennis Begley** exits, replaced by the cluster's VP/director of sales, **Rick Feinblatt**.

Capstar will spin off five stations it wanted to buy in Wichita, Kan., to win Justice Department approval of its \$190 million purchase of Triathlon Broadcasting. Capstar will keep album **KRZZ** and three others.

PROGRAMMING: RICHTER ROCKS WYMG
Triple-A WVRV St. Louis PD **Mike Richter** exits for the PD/midday gig at album **WYMG** Springfield, Ill., replacing **Mike Thomas**. Adult top 40 WLTS New Orleans PD **Joe Larson** heads north to WVRV to take over for Richter.

Modern **WEJE** Fort Wayne, Ind., PD **Scott "Weasel" Hecathorn** is now OM at **WEJE**, modern adult **WYSR**, and new rhythmic top 40 convert **WGL**, which was simulcasting **WYSR** and seeks new calls.

Soft AC **WWRM** Tampa PD **Paul Ciliano** is upped to OM of Cox's Tampa stations, including classic hits **WCOF**.

Album **KEZF** Albuquerque, N.M., morning man **Jeff Young** adds PD duties. The active outlet picks up new calls **KRQS**.

Album **KCLB** Palm Springs, Calif., PD **Ron Stryker** exits.

Album **KQWB** Fargo, N.D., PD/afternoons **Guy Dark** exits. Promotion director **Jake West** is named PD. Morning man **Noel Scotch** is now APD/afternoons. Night host **Big Dog** is now MD.

Classic hits **WOKI** Knoxville, Tenn., PD/middayer and album **WXVO** interim PD **Tim Sheehan** becomes PD over both stations. At **WOKI**, morning man **Randy Reed** moves to middays. **John Boy** and **Billy** are on in mornings.

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Metallica Tops Itself With 'Turn The Page'

METALLICA'S "Turn The Page" spends its ninth week at the top of both the mainstream and active rock charts, one more week than the band's previous longest-running No. 1, "Until It Sleeps." "Whiskey In The Jar," a cover of **Thin Lizzy's** Celtic-flavored '70s classic, becomes Metallica's eighth title on the active rock chart since that chart's debut in June '97. All of the band's previous active rock titles have reached the top 10.

Meanwhile, the number of cover songs on the modern rock chart jumps to four, as **Limp Bizkit's** rendition of **George Michael's** "Faith" debuts and Metallica's take on **Bob Seger's** classic "Turn The Page" re-enters. The quartet is rounded out by **Class Of '99's** "Another Brick In The Wall" and **Orgy's** take on **New Order's** "Blue Monday." While it never charted at modern, Michael's "Faith" hit No. 1 on Billboard's Hot 100 chart during the holiday season exactly 12 years ago. (And **Wham!** did get some modern rock airplay in its first year or so as a British hit-maker until "Wake Me Up Before You Go-Go" defined it as a pop act.)

Collective Soul's "Heavy" is the band's second-highest mainstream rock debut, surpassed only by "Precious Declaration," which entered at No. 12 in February 1997. Six of the group's previous 11 mainstream hits have reached No. 1, including "Shine," the No. 1 mainstream rock track of 1994.

As Industry Consolidates, McClusky Does Too, With Eyebrow-Raising Cumulus Deal

As radio's major groups appoint group PDs to oversee a growing number of stations, some independent promotion firms are tweaking the way they do business to secure access to the groups' decision makers, something that became clear late last year when Jeff McClusky & Associates announced an exclusivity deal with fast-growing Cumulus Media.

Coming on the heels of smaller deals by JMA and Citadel Broadcasting, Capstar's Gulfstar, and Clear Channel, the Cumulus deal caused a stir in the industry for several reasons. It gave McClusky a presence in both country and R&B radio, formats where label execs have resisted the exclusivity-pact concept, especially with outside indies. Then there are the particulars of the deal, which include having McClusky work the format consultants at Cumulus' Stratford Research arm, not individual PDs, something that struck a nerve with some promo execs who have long feared any sort of centralized music decisions by the new mega-groups.

McClusky started his firm 18 years ago, specializing in top 40 stations, then branching into

value than some guy hawking records over the phone. So we created promotion funds to give stations access to concert flyaways and things that can help their ratings.

"Obviously, we've tweaked [our operations] tremendously since then. We hired Tom Barsanti, who really understands the needs of broadcasters. We started a real broadcast promotion department, where we'd be responsible for getting plane and concert tickets and booking the hotels. We have to super-serve radio."

McClusky says he's cognizant of the industry buzz generated by the Cumulus deal, the first one where he's specifically not dealing with the PDs of individual stations. "The main thing that raised eyebrows was where we supposedly asked Cumulus PDs not to talk to the industry about music," he says. "This goes back to Cumulus' music system, which involves conference calls between PDs and the people with the final say, the group's consultants. We also have weekly meetings with the consultants; they are Cumulus' point people when it comes to music... In every [business relationship], we want to deal with the decision makers, and with Cumulus, that happens to be their consultants."

Asked if that raises the specter of group adds and thus music homogenization, McClusky says, "That's something you have to ask the broadcasters. At Cumulus, there's a lot of individual adds at the various markets. It obviously serves their best interest to have PDs in Toledo, Ohio, and Amarillo, Texas, speak up and say, 'We need to play his record,' and the consultant needs to respond to that. I don't believe the consultants have a dictatorial relationship with their PDs."

McClusky's Cumulus deal also touches on another sensitive area, the presence of outside independent promoters in both R&B and country. A proposed deal between a pop indie and Radio One's R&B reporters dissolved shortly after its announcement in fall 1996. And last year, Bill Hard's Hi-Impact Marketing announced a deal with several Atlantic Star country stations. Under pressure from the country community, some of those stations quickly renounced the deal.

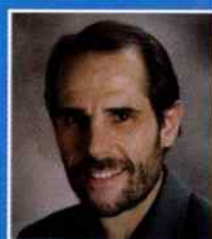
McClusky, himself, had started a Nashville branch in the early '90s. "I hired Eddie Mascolo and Bobby Young, and it took them a year to build a solid operation there," he says. "However, they left after being offered twice the money to start River North Records. I couldn't find suitable replacements, so I shut it down."

"Now we're back, working in conjunction with an established country independent, [Young-Olsen & Associates, co-helmed, ironically, by Young]. It's only a matter of time before we hire our own staff as well. Believe me, we're already getting calls from country stations."

McClusky is using the same M.O. as he launches his R&B division. Expect to hear of a tie-in with an R&B-based music company within weeks. Soon thereafter, he'll recruit an in-house promotion staff, including the hiring of someone, he says, with label senior VP of urban promotion-level experience. Although McClusky admits that he'll likely still meet some resistance in those formats, to succeed [in the new group deals] "we have to not only be involved in all formats, but in new media, concert touring, and every level of artist development."

As both radio and the music biz consolidate, McClusky wouldn't be surprised if other indies do the same. "I'd definitely be interested [in acquiring another independent] as long as it's compatible with our company," he admits. "We want to open an office in New York. Would we be interested in merging with a New York-based indie, management company, or music-related firm? Absolutely. There are some great companies out there, and we'd love to be involved with them."

album and modern rock a few years ago. JMA has 32 staffers divvied up among its offices in Chicago, Los Angeles, and Atlanta, with more hirings in the offing.

He's not the first indie to consummate group deals. Jacor and Jefferson-Pilot have engaged in similar ventures. "The real difference in the Cumulus deal is that it's the first one that covers all formats," McClusky says. "At this point in time, broadcast companies are looking for promotion and marketing partnerships, and they're more comfortable working with firms involved in all formats."

Now working with 30 Cumulus stations, eight Citadel, nine Gulfstar, and nine Clear Channel outlets, McClusky sees his deals as part of radio's changing landscape, although he notes that "we still do business with Infinity, Emis, and the others on an individual station, market-by-market basis. At the same time, we certainly hope to do more business with Capstar's other regional groups."

The group deals, McClusky says, reflect a changing atmosphere at radio. "Everybody's looking for access to PDs, so they can influence their perspective. The industry thrives on it. Broadcasters understand this and are asking themselves how best to use their access time. Even PDs in medium and small markets are running two or three different stations at once; they don't have time to talk to everyone. So the groups decide who has access. For my business, I better be able to get to the decision makers, because the labels are paying me to spread my passion for their music to the right people."

By contrast, McClusky recalls, "in the early '80s, all you needed to do was have a relationship with stations and the labels, and you could have value just by promoting music to the PDs. I've always been in the business of marketing partnerships. When we started, we first went to an FCC attorney to see if we could take a portion for our income and create a promotion fund for broadcasters. That would have more

column show other examples of internal success stories. Album KLBJ Austin, Texas, announced recently that P/T Arthur Dungan, who began with the station several years ago as an intern, had earned a full-time shift with the station in overnights. Modern WPLY (Y100) Philadelphia last month turned to intern Casey Boy as morning assistant when morning producer Ben Maxwell moved to overnights. Modern WPBZ West Palm Beach, Fla., night host Cindy Wallace earned a promotion to morning co-host late last summer. And modern WBTZ Burlington, Vt., recently moved production director Matt Grasso from nights to mornings.

MOST AREN'T BORN GREAT

"Talent does not just magically appear," says classic rock WING/top 40 WGTZ (Z93) Dayton, Ohio, OM Michael Luczak. "Talent is nurtured and developed. Eric Clapton didn't just wake up one day and start playing 'Tears In Heaven.' Rehearsal is a fundamental part of any show-business production. Radio guys forget this."

Luczak says PDs "must look to those 'newbies' in the building and those begging to get a job in radio to recognize, train, encourage, and rehearse new talent. Insist that the new promotion interns who really want to be on the air go into the studio for a few days a week for a couple months and really practice, then meet with the PDs for critiques along the way."

Album KEGl Dallas PD Greg Stevens says, "You have to have the opportunity to try things. Some of them are not going to work. You have to have those jobs where you make every mistake one time, and if the occurrence of people being able to have those entry-level jobs to break in to the business diminishes, then it's going to be much harder to find the people."

Stevens cites a current KEGl morning phone operator. "He has an awful lot of raw talent and has the ability to move up in this business as time goes by and he learns more. He's literally starting out in a top 10 market. He's just a naturally talented guy," says Stevens. "People who have the desire, the passion to work in the business and learn and try things and work hard, we try to let them do as much as we can . . . You can't take a person who's never seen a microphone before and throw him on in afternoon drive in this size market, but there are board-op things and production assistant things. There are still beginner-level jobs."

Saga VP of programming Steve Goldstein says his company's policy of training its talent is helping to attract new employees. "We will take the time to teach and train. That's one of things that distinguishes us" from broadcasters hoping for "instant soup" solutions, he says.

USING WHAT YOU HAVE

The increasing tendency to look inside doesn't just apply to first-jobbers but to the midlevel staffers already in place. To that end, consultant Tom Barnes believes, "programmers must resolve to aircheck their talent twice as much this year as last. Talent often gets very little feedback other than 'Keep it tight' and 'I don't get it.' We have to do better." He urges PDs to "spend more time articulating the vision for your station to your staff. The clearer the vision, the better the break."

Similarly, McVay Media VP of rock/alternative Greg Gillispie urges that critiquing tal-

ent go beyond "That break sucked." That's my commitment. When I visit my stations, I try to do airchecks with the jocks and provide good examples for them to listen to from other jocks around the country."

Luczak predicts that if each PD picked one person on staff already and mentored that person, "in a reasonable amount of time you will have developed talent right in your building."

He adds that programmers can best work with what's already on the air by ensuring a fertile work environment. "Very few corporate programmers or consultants ever suggest that the talent stretch out, entertain, or say something more than reinforcing the 'branding of our product identity, selling the listening benefits, blah blah blah,'" he says. "Let the existing talent on the air take some risks. Encourage creativity. Compliment the efforts to be unique. Even if a new talent is

copying another, so what? You mean to tell me nobody in this business ever stole an idea or sound?"

KRXQ's Johnson adds, "I've always enjoyed the mentoring process and utilize it from the top down. I'm always working toward getting my APD and

MD ready to program . . . I have few secrets from them. I encourage them to be as open with their underlings and get them ready to replace them. You would think that thought might be a little disturbing to them, but because I'm so open and nurturing with them, I run into few insecurity problems. This process leads to healthy redundancies on staff. When someone leaves, many times I won't have to look far for a replacement."

MEANWHILE, BACK AT CORPORATE

Key to being able to create an environment in which talent can be developed is working with those above you, as well as below. As talent concerns build, KEGl's Stevens says, PDs must "continue to voice that concern up the line, through corporate structures, so that the people who are in the higher-level decision-making positions will at least keep in mind that the new talent is going to have to come from somewhere."

Consultant Barnes says, "Every big broadcaster should have a corporate position for talent development . . . someone in the corporate office who knows every good air talent and agent in the country. They should also help PDs aircheck and manage the creative personality better."

McVay's Gillispie goes a step further, advocating that the bigger companies take on the responsibility of training and educating their talent themselves. He

points to a friend in the computer business who is dispatched to Atlanta several times a year for updated training. "The companies are large enough now that they can institute that" for not just air talent, but also management and sales, Gillispie says. "A lot of it really boils down to how interested in developing new talent are broadcasters today? We certainly can't run with what we've got forever."

Luczak believes that if groups would take some pressure off today's multi-tasking PD, "they might have time to work with their talent." He'd also like corporate to "improve the pay scale. Most entry-level positions today are in the same pay league as fast-food restaurants. Reward the talent that is doing a good job for you financially," he says. "Maybe the word will get around that radio can be fun and pay OK."

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Marvelous 3 Push Power Pop Button

Singer/guitarist **Butch Walker** of Atlanta-based power-pop trio **Marvelous 3** believes it was high school life in the Atlanta suburbs that allowed him and his bandmates to persevere through more than 10 years of ups and downs together. "You had a choice at my high school," he recalls. "You could either shoot deer for a life, play football and hopefully get a scholarship to some offshoot college, or do what I did. Which was to have two-tone hair, eight earrings, and two different color shoes on. I was the only guy in my school doing that."

The friends immediately headed west after graduation and took up residence on L.A.'s Hollywood Boulevard. Their current name is only their latest, reflecting the new trio size of the band, and marks a stylistic change for Walker. The shorter, more playful power-pop songs he now writes require a different sensibility than the songwriter had previously explored as an indie stalwart. As Walker says, "For years, I couldn't write a song with the word 'love' in it."

The power-pop era of the **Knack**, the **Romantics** and the **Greg Kihn Band** looms large for Walker. "Those are my memories. That was it; that was my puberty. It was nothing but MTV 24

hours a day; it was the best it ever was, and that's when I consumed it 24/7. Sure, that could have been a bad thing, but it opened my eyes up and scarred me for life in a good way on rock that was cheeky, fun, that had an attitude, was fun lyrically to listen to, and was visual."

Equally influential in his musical upbringing was when "I was 8 years old, and my parents made the mistake of taking me to see **Kiss**, at the height of their makeup, fire, and flames career. I was a huge fan—ate, breathed, shit, and lived **Kiss**," he says. "[At the time,] it was the only thing kids could have fun doing. We didn't have Playstation; we had Paul Stanley."

Walker says he's received hundreds of E-mails from young kids praising his group's power pop as the perfect antidote to the abundance of aggro/grunge/ska-punk rock, which encourages and amuses him. "It's so funny; they think what I'm doing is new," he says.

As for those who suggest the verses of "Freak Of The Week" sound awfully close to **Roger McGuinn's** "So You Want To Be A Rock 'N' Roll Star," Walker replies, "I think no matter what you do musically, especially in the pop world, it's all been done before. There's nothing you can't do that hasn't already been done in some sort of variation." Reluctant to open a can of worms on the subject but searching for an illustration, he thinks of another contemporary hit. "I can take 'Push' by **matchbox 20**, and when I hear 'I will, I will, I will,' I think of **Captain & Tennille** ["Love Will Keep Us Together"]. Maybe that's the beauty of writing a hit song."

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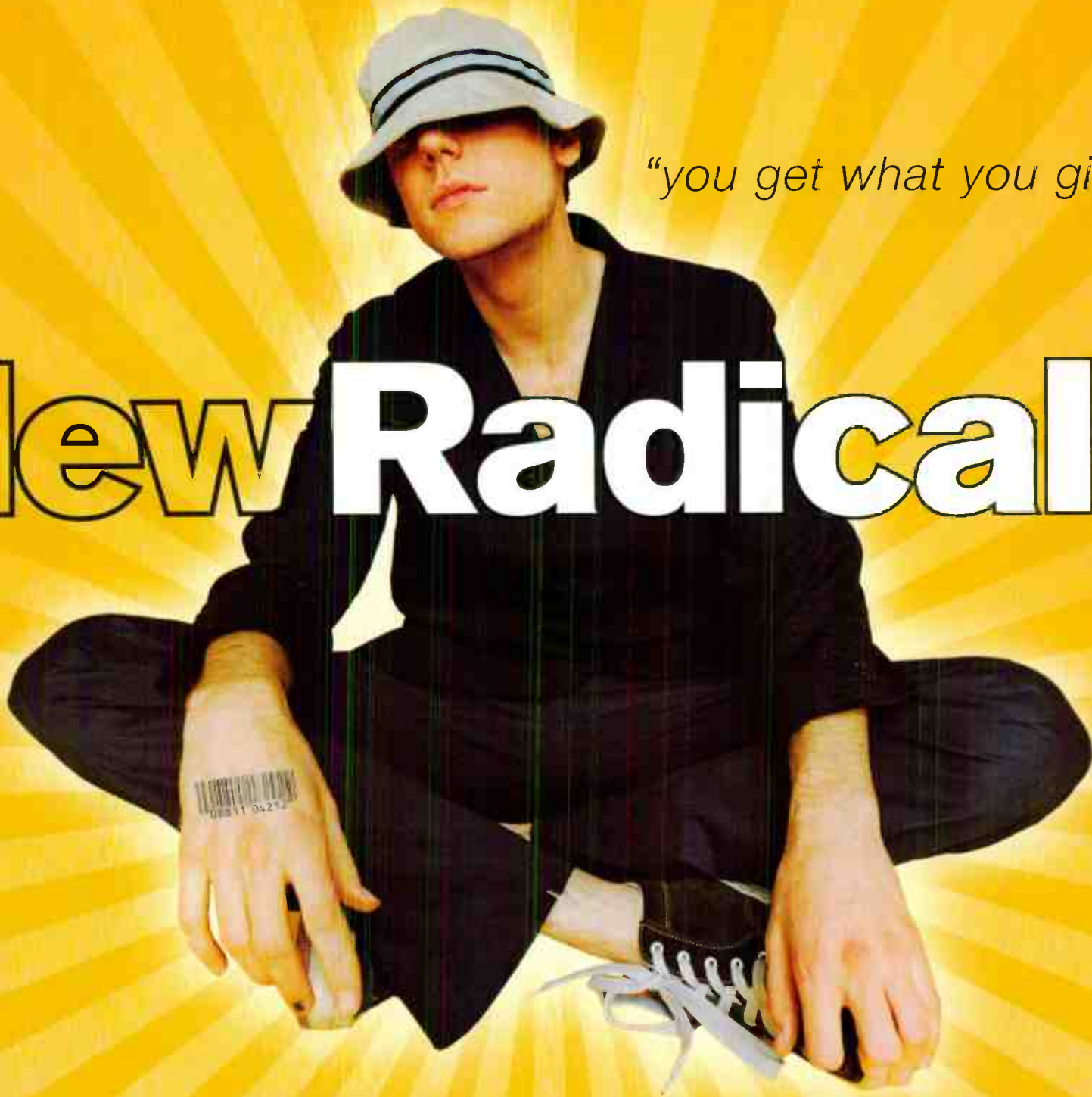

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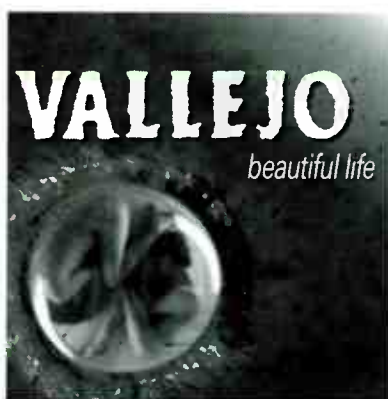

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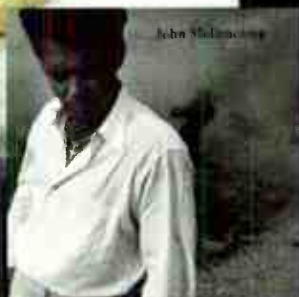
