Legendary PD Sunny Joe White Dead At 42

Top 40 radio has lost a legend, as Sunny Joe White, 42, who launched heritage top 40 WXKS-FM (Kiss 108) Boston in the late '70s, died of an apparent heart attack at age 42 Sept. 7. White had suffered a minor heart attack last week and had just been released from the hospital when he was found dead at his Boston home. He had a history of heart trouble.

White, who signed on Kiss 108 as a disco station, was responsible for its segue to top 40 in the early '80s and for its reputation as one of the format's most cutting-edge stations. During his tenure, Kiss 108 was responsible not only for scores of national hits, but for an untold number of songs that remain familiar to any Bostonian, even if they weren't national hits. White also programmed crosstown WZOU in the early '90s and did a brief stint on-air at AC rival WVBF (now WROR) before retiring for several years. Most recently, he had been consulting and do-

ing middays at R&B WILD, a station he programmed during the '70s, and had hoped to put together a network of R&B outlets with WILD as the base.

"Sunny was Hollywood in Boston," says Columbia VP of promotion Charlie Walk, who invited for White in 1988 while attending Boston University. "Where research is the rule today, with Sunny, gut was the rule and research only a tool. Sunny was the only guy who could get away with playing Billie Holiday back to back with Elvis Presley on a top 40 station and have the highest-rated show in the market."

RCA senior director of crossover promotion Jerry McKenna worked with White for six years at WXKS and WZOU. "Sunny was a true visionary who understood how to connect with the masses on an emotional level," says McKenna, who wrote programming-philosophy letters to him while in high school. "Sunny actually saved those letters and showed them to me when he interviewed me," McKenna recalls. "He told me anyone who cared that much about his station deserved to work there."

A memorial service was set for Sept. 11 at Boston's Concord Baptist Church.

WGTZ Dayton, Ohio, PD **Louis Kaplan** is named PD at modern AC **KLLC** (Alice 97.3) San Francisco.

WZJM (Jammin' 92.3) Cleveland PD **Lisa Rodman** is named PD of new top 40 rhythm **WDRQ** Detroit, replacing **Brad Waldo**. **Dave Eubanks** is acting PD in Cleveland.

Longtime suburban Chicago top 40 **WBUS** (the Bus), sold into a Spanish-language duopoly several months ago, has gone dark pending its format change. . . **KYIS** (Kiss FM) Oklahoma City becomes the latest convert from gold-based AC to modern AC. **SBR** is consulting.

Jack Evans, OM of Jacor's classic/mainstream rock combo **KRFX/KBPI** Denver, is named director of programming operations for new top 40/dance outlet **KHTS** (Channel 93.3) San Diego and duopoly partners **XETRA-AM-FM**.

Lee Logan, most recently PD of **KFRG/KOOJ** San Bernardino, Calif., is named group PD for AC/oldies group South Central Communications, replacing **Bill Jones**.

KUTQ (Q99) Salt Lake City, which had just returned to a rock-based top 40 format after a year as a modern rocker, becomes classic rock **Rock 99**. **Chet Buchanan**, PD of top 40 rhythm duopoly partner **KZHT** (Hot 94.9), is named PD, replacing **Ken Carr**, who stays on for middays. **Q99** APD **Shoe** joins Buchanan in mornings on **KZHT**. **KUTQ** will get new calls.

Adult top 40/classic rock combo **WWMX** (Mix 106.5) **WOCT** Baltimore is sold by Capitol Broadcasting to **ARS** for \$90 million. In other sales, **Paxson** acquires another Jacksonville, Fla., outlet, the yet-unborn **WPVJ** 106.5 FM.

Guy Zapoleon is consulting modern AC **KYSR** (Star 98.7) Los Angeles. . . **KSSK-FM** Honolulu drops rhythmic acts (**Coolio**, **Quad City DJ's**, etc.) for a more traditional hot AC format. . . Country **WLKE** Ellsworth, Maine, PD **Chris Powers** is the new PD at **WZPK** Portland, Maine; acting PD **Bob Starck** exits.

Robin Barbero rejoins syndicator **SupereRadio** as VP/GM. That company has also parted with **Murray/Walsh Productions** to revive the "Supernix Dance" program, a four-hour unhosted dance show debuting Sept. 13.

WPLJ New York morning guys **Scott Shannon** and **Todd Pettengill** are now in syndication on hot AC **WKLI** (K100) Albany, N.Y. (which Pettengill consults). Ironically, the duo now com-

petes with Pettengill's former station, **WFLY**.

When **WMC-FM** (FM100) morning-team member **Danger Boy** left for crosstown modern outlet **KMZN**, the two stations got into a dispute over the use of the name; the jock involved has since been known as **Danger Man**. Said jock has now crossed to country **WOGY** (Froggy 94), where he will co-host mornings as **Danger Frog**.

WFLZ Tampa, Fla.'s **Bubba the Love Sponge** begins nights at album **WKLS** Atlanta Oct. 1. . . **WERQ** (92Q) Baltimore taps **Frank Ski**, from R&B rival **WXYV**, for mornings. He'll team with drag queen **Miss Tony**.

Ed Lacombe, most recently production director for **NewCity/Cox's** Syracuse, N.Y., FMs, is now APD for top 40 **WWHT** (Hot 107.9).

Top 40 veteran **Don Burns** is named morning host at top 40 rhythm **CIDC** (Hot 103.5) Toronto, replacing **Jesse Dylan**, now with crosstown rocker **CHLQ** (Q107). Burns joins **Tom Allen** from format rival **CING** (Energy 108).

Top 40/adult **WTIC-FM** Hartford, Conn., splits middays, sending **René** to nights, as production director **Neal Jackson** takes 10 a.m.-noon, and MD **David Simpson** goes from nights to noon-3 p.m.

WBLI Long Island, N.Y., p.m. driver **Kelly Nash** is named p.m. driver at hot AC **WDAQ** (98Q) Danbury, Conn. **WBLI** PD **Ken Medek** goes on-air for afternoons; **Bill Terry** comes off the air to focus on promotional duties.

Just months after signing a new three-year deal, budget cuts claim **KGBY** (Y92) Sacramento, Calif., MD nights **Vince Garcia** after seven years. Call Garcia at 916-921-2224. . . At AC **WSNE** Providence, R.I., night jock **Amy Navarro** and midday host **Jay Stevens** flip shifts.

Longtime Buffalo, N.Y., DJ **Art Wander**, most recently in nights at **N1 WGR** Buffalo, retires.

WSNX Grand Rapids, Mich., p.m. driver **Mark Jacobs** will program album **WMRR** Muskegon, Mich., as well as crosstown R&B adult **WHMG** once that deal closes. Acting **WSNX** PD night jock **Keith Curry** moves up to cover afternoons, as P/T **Jamie Jordan** covers nights. . . **WBZZ** (B94) Pittsburgh loses night jock **Mr. Blank** to mornings at modern **KNRX** Oklahoma City.

Jock name of the week: **WWLD** (Wild 106) Tallahassee, Fla., taps **Crash Test Opie** from **WILN** Panama City, Fla., for 10 p.m.-midnight.

'Land Grab,' Growth Of Dance Hot Seminar Topics

have made sense for another owner. **ARS** already owns one very successful station in that market.

In other sessions, panelists at "The All-New Top 40" session felt their format was indeed showing sustained signs of resuscitation, thanks to a more balanced mix of musical genres on the air. "We assumed all we could play was alternative, then came to the revelation that we can play **Donna Lewis**," said **Tom Polenan**, PD of **WHTZ** (Z100) New York. "Our core audience has always been looking for the hits. Now we're kicking ourselves because we've been close-minded."

Most acknowledged the success of dance **WKTU** New York as a factor in realizing that listeners were open to dance music as much as the modern rock that has all but commanded top 40's attention for the past several years. The rise of **WKTU** and the rapid boom in **WKTU** clones

The Justice Department will play a heavier role in station regulation than the FCC. This year's major-group players may not be next year's major-group players. And perhaps the **Baby Bells** or other nonradio groups will.

Those were some of the predictions made at the group heads session of the third annual Billboard/Airplay Monitor Radio Seminar and Awards, held in New York Sept. 5-7. The seminar played host to more than 850 attendees, with 1,200 revelers at Sept. 7's awards dinner, hosted by **WKTU's** self-described "queen of all media," **RuPaul**.

During the group heads panel, featuring **Jimmy de Castro** of Evergreen, **Mike Ferrel** of SFX, **John Gehron** of **ARS**, **Viacom's** **Bill Figenshu**, **ABC/Disney's** **Tom Cuddy**, and **Saga's** **Steve Goldstein**, SFX's **Mike Ferrel** typified the group outlook on megapoly, telling the audience, "As Adam once said to Eve, 'Better stand back. I don't know how big this thing is gonna get,'" referring to the still relatively unknown consequences of deregulation and the resulting consolidation frenzy.

Figenshu, who compares the current acquisition-o-rama to the original Oklahoma Land Grant, admitted, "We still don't know what we don't know," but he expects such mega-firms as **Microsoft**, **AT&T**, and **ITT** to muscle in. But before that happens, he says, "we must consolidate ourselves first."

The increasing clout of the Justice Department and blunted power of the FCC was another hot topic. Evergreen's **DeCastro** predicted that the Justice Department would fine group owner **Chancellor** for possible ownership violations in Florida, something Justice itself would not confirm or deny as of press time. **DeCastro** also predicted a quick end to the **LMA** era, because "the Justice Department just doesn't like it."

Credit was given by the group heads to **Infinity's** **Mel Kamazin** for helping lock in **Wall Street** as a partner. But, **Ferrel** warned, "Wall Street rewards size. We must continue to demonstrate growth, or it's over." There was also a (fairly safe) prediction that many of the broadcast companies represented on this year's panel would be different (or gone) by the same time next year.

ARS' Gehron, speaking to the prices now paid for radio stations, defended the \$90 million his company had just spent on two Baltimore stations, pointing out that while the deal might not

was the focus of the dance music panel. But **WKTU** MD **Andy Shane** says that despite the format's success at radio, many labels are still not paying respect to dance music. "I'm tired of hearing that dance music is not selling," he says. "If labels would stop treating their dance departments like a throwaway and increase their spending, they would sell more records."

The influence of modern rock at AC was the main topic at the latter format's main session Sept. 6. While most of the PDs felt that the top 40/adult format now has more in common with mainstream top 40 than AC, **WMIY** Greenville, S.C., PD **Mark Pollitt** noted that he looks for "hot ACs that are beating soft ACs, and there aren't very many of them. . . so why am I trying to be so hip?" **Pollitt** said he worried that an over-dependence on modern would alienate AC listeners in the same way that hip-hop once allegedly alienated top 40 listeners.

The seminar's most controversial moment, however, came at Saturday night's awards show, when **ABC** syndicated country personality **Moby** was booed for pretending to wipe himself with (absent) winner **Howard Stern's** trophy and then smashing it into two pieces. The award is currently being repaired.

the 1995 Billboard/Airplay Monitor Radio Awards.

Multiple-award winners this year include another perennial, WTKI Milwaukee, which scored three awards: adult medium-market station of the year, PD of the year (Danny Clayton), and MD of the year (Leonard Peace).

WBITT (Hot 97) Wilkes-Barre, Pa., PD/morning guy Kid Kelly repeats last year's success by being named small-market top 40 PD as well as air personality of the year. Hot 97 MD Danny Ocean is also a winner, as is Stan Phillips, MD of sister AC station WMGS.

WFLZ Tampa, Fla., was again named medium-market top 40 station of the year, and PD B.J. Harris and larger-than-life air personality Bubba the Love Sponge were also repeat winners.

Small-market station of the year winners include KHFI Austin, Texas, in the top 40 category, and WKDD Akron, Ohio, in adult.

In non-top 40 news, KKBT (the Beat) Los Angeles won five awards, including R&B major-market station of the year; PD Harold Austin and MD Marianna Snider also scored awards, along with marketing director Eileen Woodbury, while Theo took the prize for local air personality. Across the street, KROQ was named modern rock station of the year, and Kevin Weatherly was named modern rock PD of the year.

PEOPLE WHO MOVED

This being radio, the 1996 awards were again chock-full of folks who had gone somewhere else by the time they were nominated or by the time they won. WKTU New York MD Andy Shane was a major-market winner, but his award was for his tenure at crosstown WHIZ (Z100).

Elsewhere in top 40, Dan Bowen, now programming Jefferson-Pilot's KWMX (K-Hits 107.5) Denver, won again for the last year of his 13-year stint at WNCI Columbus, Ohio.

In the medium-market adult category, it's a three-peat for Mason Dixon, who won again for his morning show at WMTX (Mix 96) Tampa, Fla. Ironically, Dixon is now across the street programming Gannett's WUSA.

Dale O'Brian, recently named PD of top 40 WWZZ (Z104) Washington, D.C., won for small-market air personality, along with his former morning-show mates Kristie Hicks and Matt Jaeger at WMXL (Mix 94.5) Lexington, Ky.

Burke Allen was named small-market PD of the year for his efforts at WAEV (Mix 97.3) Savannah, Ga. Allen is now programming KISN Salt Lake City.

EX-TOP 40 GUYS MAKE GOOD

Jay Taylor, who worked at top 40 KLUC Las Vegas for many years and at the late top 40 WRBQ (Q105) Tampa, was named medium-market modern rock music director of the year for his work at KOMF San Jose., Calif.

Marc Chase, who helped launch WFLZ Tampa in its infamous Power Pig days, was named medium-market PD at Jacor's flagship station, WEBN Cincinnati, which was named mainstream rock station of the year.

AIR PERSONALITY HIGHLIGHTS

While WPLJ's Scott Shannon and Todd Pettengill scored again this year in the major-market adult category, their new rival at Z100, Elvis Du-

ran, won as major-market top 40 air personality. Duran was in afternoons during most of the period covered by this year's awards.

The soft-spoken Mancow Muller of WRCX (Rock 103.5) Chicago was the mainstream rock winner, while in modern rock, it was the morning team at WNNX (99X) Atlanta: Steve Barnes, Leslie Fram, and Jimmy Baron. On the R&B side, Theo, p.m. driver at KKBT (the Beat) Los Angeles, was the major-market air personality winner.

In the modern rock world, Butthole Surfers lead singer Gibby Haynes copped an award for his air work at his hometown station, KROX Austin, a stint that ended before the group's commercial breakthrough earlier this year.

PROMOTIONS IN MOTION

Other than WPLJ's Heidi Dagnese repeating this year in the adult category, perennial fave Karen Tobin of KHIS Los Angeles was again this year's top 40 marketing winner; Natalie DiPietro of WRCX Chicago won for mainstream rock, and Larry "Chachi" Loprete of WBCN Boston was the modern rock marketing winner.

SYNDICATION WORLD

KHIS Los Angeles morning personality Rick Dees won in both the adult and top 40 categories for best syndicated show with his "Weekly Top 40." Dees tied with Westwood One's "Casey's Top 40," featuring Casey Kasem, in the top 40 column.

Howard Stern walked away with three awards: network/syndicated program of the year in both the mainstream rock and modern rock categories and nationally syndicated air personality of the year.

ASK THE CONSULTANT

Not a bad year for consultant Guy Zapoleon of Houston-based Zapoleon Media Strategies, who repeats last year's success by winning awards in both the adult and top 40 categories.

Jacobs Media nailed two consulting awards, with Fred Jacobs winning for mainstream rock, and former WDRE Long Island, N.Y., PD Tom Calderone winning for modern rock. Don Kelly, who recently increased his profile on the top 40 and AC side thanks to WDRQ Detroit and KLIBB Los Angeles, was named R&B consultant of the year.

HOW IT WORKS

The Billboard/Airplay Monitor Radio Awards, which honor excellence in radio broadcasting, are given annually in seven format categories. This year's nominees were chosen in the spring by readers of the four Airplay Monitor publications, who cast write-in votes on a ballot. Final voting ballots were then placed in the July 5 issue of Airplay Monitor and the July 13 issue of Billboard; voting was open to all readers of the magazines.

The 1996 awards cover the period of May '95 to May '96. The major-market category comprises stations in the top 20 Arbitron markets. The medium-market category includes markets 21 through 50. Remaining markets are in the small-market category.

A total of 95 awards were given to 470 nominees this year.

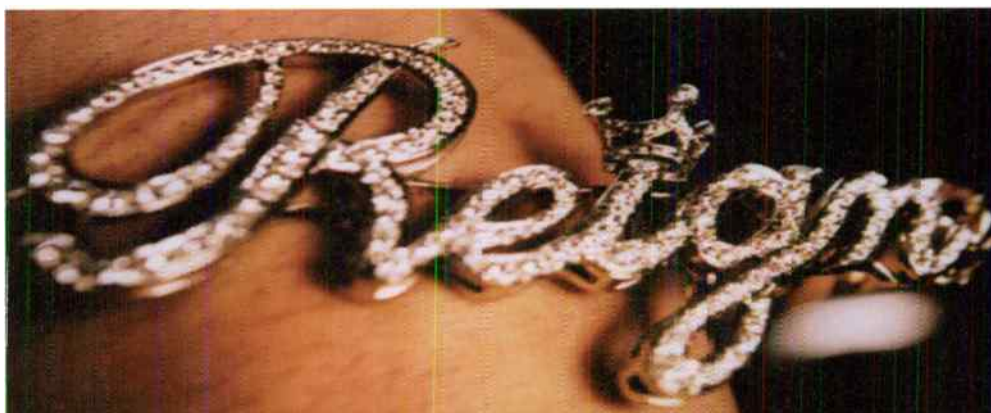
