## Just Another Day On The Beach: Putting A Human Face On Unemployment

Last month, KJMN (Jam'n 92.1) Denver PD Mark Feather and his staff left the building when owners ENCL flipped the station to Spanish.

Two weeks ago, Chris Kerr exited the PD chair at WHZZ (Z101.7) Lansing, Mich., after taking his 3,000-watt blowtorch from eighth to fourth place 12-plus, No. 2 18-34, and No. 3 18-49.

John McFadden spent the last three years at Jefferson-Pilot's WWSN (1 Hits 107.9) Charlotte, N.C., as both APD and PD. He exited the station in January. McFadden has just been named Elektra's Atlanta-based promo rep.

"I got my Valentine's Day kiss on Feb. 14," jokes Carmy Ferreri of the day he exited the APD MD position at Viacom's rhythmic AC KIBB (B100) Los Angeles.

At press time, Mike Edwards had just exited his OM post at WBHT/T

WARM/WMGs Wilkes-Barre, Pa., after 3½ years, when soon-to-be-owner Tele-Media elected not to renew his contract, inherited from Susquehanna.

These are but a few of the faces of unemployment '97. Although everyone agrees the radio landscape has drastically changed under fewer owners in the 'Telecom Act' era, they also agree that the principle of sitting at home by the phone remains pretty much the same.

### THEIR BACK STORY

"Being out of work the second time was definitely easier than the first, both from an emotional and an organizational standpoint," McFadden says. "When I was let go (from WKEE Huntington, W.Va.), my ego was really bruised. This time, I never worked so hard in my life to land a job."

Ferreri previously programmed

## RADIO ACTIVE BY KEVIN CARTER

### Murdoch To Buy Heritage, Sell All Outlets

**R**upert Murdoch's News Corp. announced plans to acquire Heritage Media Corp., assets of which include 24 radio and six TV stations, all of which Murdoch plans to spin off. Affected are top 40 WEZB (B97) New Orleans and hot AC combo WAMG/WMYX Milwaukee.

The Chicago Sun-Times reports that Evergreen Media is close to a deal for top 40/adult WPNT. Various other deals are supposedly in the works for Evergreen's WEJM-AM and WMVP/WLUP, according to that story and one in Crain's Chicago Business.

Jacor Communications picks up three Santa Barbara, Calif., stations from Criterion Media, including AC KSBL.

#### PROGRAMMING: KMEL REPACKAGED

KMEL San Francisco is now billing itself as "the station for the hip-hop generation," a move that PD Michelle Santosuoso says will "actively promote the culture of hip-hop" and "spread the message of consciousness and positivity." As part of the restructuring, 10-year station vet Renel exits middays, replaced by utility player Rosary. P/Ts Trace and Franzen are now in late nights, replacing "The Love Zone." Renel was feted at a gala farewell party Friday night, at which she sang duets with Freddie Jackson and Terry Ellis from En Vogue. San Francisco Mayor Willie Brown and Oakland Mayor Elihu Harris were both in attendance.

Bill Conway, most recently OM of AC/classic rock combo KYXY/KPLN San Diego, is the new PD at AC KOIT San Francisco, replacing acting PD Suzy Mayzel, who will concentrate on her international consultancy.

Morning host Charlie Connolly adds PD stripes at AC WKJY Long Island, N.Y., replacing Tony Florentino, now at WTVR-FM Richmond, Va. It's his first PD job.

Apparently using the same movers as Bob Case and Shellie Hart, KUBE Seattle APD/MD middayer Lindsey Cipic transfers to the PD chair at New Century sister country KBUQ Phoenix, replacing Sean Holly, now programming crosstown KHTC. KUBE night jock Bobby O. is named interim MD; PD Mike Tierney needs a midday jock.

Jeff Andrews (ex-KKSS Albuquerque, N.M., KLYV Dubuque, Iowa) is named PD of Marathon Media's KSOF Caledonia, Minn./La Crosse, Wis., which is currently soft AC but rumored to be flipping to top 40 as KHTW (Hot 94.7). Meanwhile, former KLYV PD Scott Thomas, currently in nights, is named PD again and will move up to afternoons, filling former PD Andrew Zepeida's old shift.

Rhythm-crossover WSGF (Hot 103.9) Savannah, Ga., is in the process of moving back to a more R&B direction. Morning jock Red Hot J., midday jock Ron Fly, and night guy E-Man exit. PD/p.m. driver Keli Reynolds remains.

WAOA (WAIA) Melbourne, Fla., owner/GM George Mills, a veteran of WRMF West Palm Beach, Fla., hires WRMF morning co-host Rocky Borden as PD, replacing Scott Chase, now at WZOK Rockford, Ill. Borden will co-host mornings with Timmy Vee.

KKMG Colorado Springs, Colo., PD Scooter B. Stevens is consulting KTMT Medford, Ore.

With Sunburst having closed on album KXUS Springfield, Mo., Donna Baker, GM for Sunburst's AC KGBX and country KGMY, adds those duties over KXUS, moving GM Jeff LaRocca to KXUS station manager. KXUS middayer Patty Burns flips to KGBX as promotion director.

#### LANCELOT LINK, SECRET FORMAT?

WWSN (Hits 107.9) Charlotte, N.C., undergoes a major image overhaul, becoming WLNK (the Link), but it remains modern-based adult top 40. Meanwhile, former WWSN PD John McFadden is named Atlanta-based promo rep for Elektra Records (see page 1).

Also featured in this week's page 1 story, OM Mike Edwards exits WBHT/WARM and WMGS Wilkes-Barre, Pa., as soon-to-be-new-owner Tele-Media elects not to renew his Susquehanna contract, which happened to expire last week.

#### PEOPLE: SAN DIEGO IN CHAOS

KRQQ Tucson, Ariz., afternoon jock Ryno exits for nights at KKLQ (Q106) San Diego, reuniting him with PD Mark Todd. Look for APD/night jock Adam Smasher to take over afternoons. Late-night jock Dino is named assistant MD. Shannon Black is now official in middays. PD Tim Richards needs a night jock/MD now.

Nationwide's KMCG (Magic 95.7) San Diego PD Bruce St. James hires Kelly Marshall for middays from KRWM (Warm 106) Seattle and Chris Wilcox from KMXZ (Mix 94.9) Tucson for a shift to be announced.

XHTZ (Z90) San Diego MD Jeff Nelson exits after 6½ years, replaced at night by production director Big Daddy, whose duties are absorbed by mix-show jock DJ Style. Music coordinator James Dee also absorbs some of Nelson's duties.

KIBB (B100) Los Angeles midday jock Leigh Ann Adam has been promoted to music and programming coordinator. Boris Granich (ex-KPWR) joins for weekend mix-show duties.

After a week of stunting, Big Apple listeners have voted to officially return Mr. Leonard to the morning show at WHTZ (Z100) New York.

KMXB (Mix 94.1) Las Vegas: Mark and Mercedes join for mornings from the late KJMN (Jam'n 92.1) Denver. Mix PD Mike Marino fills middays for now, replacing Brandon, who exits. Marino needs middays/production director.

KDON Monterey, Calif., grabs Maverick from late nights at KWIN Stockton, Calif., for afternoons, replacing Robb Holloway, now at WEZB New Orleans.

KIMN Denver middayer (and market legend) Jack "Radio" Regan segues to nights at sister oldies KXKL, replaced by KXKL P/T Peter McLain (ex-KDMX Dallas, KWMX Denver).

Nassau Broadcasting imaging guy Jeff Fife becomes night jock/imaging director at modern rock KNRK Portland, Ore. WPST Trenton, N.J., PD Dave McKay seeks an off-air promotions director, as p.m. driver Joel Katz pawns off those thankless duties onto some other unsuspecting person.

New top 40 WBAM Montgomery, Ala., taps new production director/p.m. driver Lon Simons from crosstown classic rock WXFX, where he did nights/production. He replaces Tod Stone, who exits. Also new is night guy Brian Knight from P/T at AC rival WMXS.

At adult top 40 WSUL Monticello, N.Y., P/T Brenda Jagger is upped to middays/programming assistant, replacing Paul Cruise.

KMXV Kansas City night jock Jacqui Lucky exits to do mornings with her husband at WCVQ Clarksville, Tenn.

WVSR Charleston, W.Va. night jock Kidd Conley exits. PD Bill Shahan needs someone in time for the spring book.

## TOP 40 TOPICS BY SEAN ROSS

### More Proof That R&B Builds Careers

**B**ruce Springsteen is back on the mainstream top 40 chart. So is U2. So is Aerosmith, joining both John Mellencamp and a coterie of newer but still established rock acts that includes Hootie & the Blowfish, Sheryl Crow, Red Hot Chili Peppers, and Counting Crows. With these veteran guitar rockers back after a spell during which pre-modern pop/rock acts had threatened to disappear, it is possible to come to only one conclusion. R&B and dance music build careers, no matter what anybody else says.

We've already spent a column running down the R&B crossover acts whose careers span anywhere from three years to more than a decade. But it was interesting to break out the stats for this week's mainstream top 40 chart and realize that even in a week with a heavier-than-usual concentration of established rockers, established R&B and dance acts are still the biggest part of this week's mainstream top 40 chart.

For the purposes of this column, we defined "established" as any act that is on at least its second hit project at top 40. Luscious Jackson and the Wallflowers both go back several years on the modern rock side but are still new acts as far as top 40 is concerned. Using those ground rules, here's how it broke out:

Established R&B/dance acts (12): BLACKstreet, En Vogue, Toni Braxton, Babyface, Keith Sweat, R. Kelly, Madonna, Monica, Real McCoy, Crystal Waters, Whitney Houston, and New Edition.

Established mainstream rock/modern rock triple-A acts (8): Sheryl Crow, Counting Crows, U2, Aerosmith, Bruce Springsteen, John Mellencamp, Red Hot Chili Peppers, and Hootie.

Established AC or pure pop acts (2): Celine Dion, Jon Secada, and maybe Madonna, but this single is a return to her dance-pop roots.

New R&B/dance acts (7): Spice Girls, Gina G, No Mercy, Ginuwine, Wild Orchid, Black-out Allstars, and Livin' Joy.

New mainstream rock/modern rock/triple-A acts (10): Cardigans, Jewel, No Doubt, Luscious Jackson, Wallflowers, Paula Cole, Leah Anne, White Town, 311 (again, as far as top 40 airplay goes), and Duncan Sheik.

New AC or pure pop acts (1): Savage Garden, although you could perhaps make a case for Sheik here, too.

So established acts from R&B and dance, the genres that are supposed to be populated by one-hit wonders, are the single biggest piece of the mainstream top 40 chart this week. Modern is responsible for more first-timers, not that

there isn't a lot of gnashing of teeth about modern one-shots these days, too.

What does this mean? Perhaps there's still a bias toward R&B crossovers by those acts that are grandfathered at top 40. The only new R&B act represented at top 40 is Ginuwine. The other veterans who crossed over suggest that En Vogue and Keith Sweat have a better chance at going pop with the same record than, say, Erykah Badu or 702. Even BLACKstreet and R. Kelly, acts who probably haven't gotten their due until now, have at least had several years to become brand names on the pop side.

Conversely, artist image seems to mean less to rock crossovers. After a period in which top 40 seemed willing to follow its modern image acts into an increasingly harder sound, top 40 is now doing better at getting what it needs from modern. Let modern PDs torment themselves about long-term prospects for some of modern's hitmakers; it's not top 40's problem. And top 40 couldn't very well latch on to modern acts who seemed determined to apologize for top 40 success by making progressively harder records.

The most surprising artist comebacks seem to happen at two points in top 40's history: when things are very focused and variety rules and when things are not at all focused and confusion rules. In 1983, when the format had hip music coming in from all quarters, there was no reason not to let Sergio Mendes back in with "Never Gonna Let You Go." In 1990-91, when there was little hip music coming from anywhere, it was easy for James Ingram's "I Don't Have The Heart" or Roberta Flack's "Set The Night To Music" to receive top 40 airplay.

Major acts tend to wander onto the charts when they feel like it. Many show up during the fourth quarter. Those that don't get sets done in time for the fourth quarter chart a few months later. This Aerosmith album was, as we all now know, only supposed to be recorded once and would have been as different from the rest of the chart last year as it is now. So you can't psychoanalyze the makeup of the chart too much.

Still, the pretty even split between rhythmic and rock acts on this week's chart suggests that this is probably one of those balanced moments. Almost every genre on the chart has been declared dead at one point or another in the past 15 months. That PDs have ignored that sort of prevalent wisdom shows that they've gotten a little better at not making wholesale changes in the nature of the format every nine months. Had they not ignored those declarations, there wouldn't have been anything left to play.

## Canada Converts To BDS Data

**O**H CANADA! Several years after the first Broadcast Data Systems monitor was deployed in Canada, that country's leading trade magazine, *The Record*, has converted its charts to BDS-monitored data. In Canada, BDS monitors more than 125 stations in 15 markets and five different formats—modern, mainstream rock, top 40, AC, and country. Plans are under way to expand into more markets this year, and even if knowing that a Kingston, Ontario, monitor is coming doesn't mean much to our American readers, Canadian monitoring has meant that some U.S. outlets (such as modern WBTZ Burlington, Vt.) can be monitored from Canada. Some U.S. stations, such as WBTZ and Buffalo, N.Y.'s top 40 WKSF and R&B WBLK, also serve as dual reporters to U.S. and Canadian charts.

More important, the introduction of BDS in Canada has already shaken up the marketplace, just as it did when Billboard converted its first U.S. format, country, to monitored data in 1990. In Canada, where 20%-30% local content is the law for radio, David Farrell, publisher of *The Record*, says, "Phantom airplay has been exposed, and it has revealed an alarming prejudice against nonsuperstar Canadian artists."

AND HOME AGAIN: Meanwhile back in the U.S., BDS will spend most of 1997 upgrading hardware in our existing markets to accommodate new stations and looking into new formats, such as classic rock, to monitor. During the last quarter of '97, we'll again look at expanding into new markets, with an emphasis on those still unmonitored within the top 100. Meanwhile, look for new AC, top 40, R&B, modern, and country outlets in the next few weeks.

LAST MONTH, BDS unveiled its BDS/Preferred Data product to the industry. The new computerized monitoring system shows playlists of AC, country, top 40, and modern rock stations nationwide. BDS/PD is a Microsoft Windows, client-server-based system that delivers information to users via the Internet with

unparalleled ease and in-depth analysis. BDS/PD allows you to analyze your direct competition's daily music logs the next day; track a competitor's playlist, rotations, and spins by hour, daypart, day, week, year, artist, or title; and access core artists lists, positioning statements, and slogans. Users can create charts based on stations, days, and hours of their choice. MediaAmerica represents sales of the product in the U.S. For more info, call MediaAmerica Affiliate Marketing at 212-302-1100.

BDS VS. NATURE: One of the realities of having a remote monitoring system is its vulnerability to uncontrollable circumstances such as hurricanes, snowstorms, and other weather-related events. Other problems include power outages, station-signal fluctuation, damaged antennas, and monitor failure. When such instances occur, BDS quickly reacts to the problem, but in cases where the problem continues for three or more days, BDS and Airplay Monitor remove affected stations from the charts until the problem is corrected.

MIXES MATTER: We've said it before, but it's worth re-emphasizing to labels that BDS needs all versions of your song. For instance, even though we might have the CD in the system, mixers commonly use vinyl on the air. CD and vinyl are different media to the computer. The system takes into consideration the quality of the audio it listens to when fingerprinting. Even cassettes and DATs have different output. Remember, we need everything you send to radio, and we need it as early as possible. Please send your media to BDS, 8100 NW 101 Terrace, Kansas City, Mo. 64153; Attn.: Lana Goodman.



## Just Another Day On The Beach: Putting A Human Face On Unemployment

crosstown oldies KRLA and rhythm/crossover KCGI Riverside, Calif. "I realized I haven't programmed the same format twice in a row," he notes, a fact that he feels works in his favor, given the rapid rate of consolidation and subsequent need for programmers who are proficient in more than one format.

Edwards, who previously programmed WKSE Buffalo, N.Y., smelled something funny. "When you're approaching the end date on your contract and no one has said anything to you, I figured something was up," he says.

He breaks out the sports analogy to explain his situation to industry outsiders who continually wonder about those unstable radio types. "I compare myself to an NFL quarterback with a winning record and a lucrative contract that the new owner chose not to pick up," he explains. "This wasn't a firing; there is no smoking gun. I'm now a free agent with marketable skills, and I hope another team will pick me up off the waiver wire."

KJMN's Feather knew the end was near almost a month prior to the station flipping to Spanish. So what did he and his staff do to capitalize on this rare advantage? Simple. "We started the 'unemployed bowling league,'" he says. Tuesdays at 12:30 p.m. sharp, most of the ex-KJMN staff, including ex-API John Dickinson, ex-promotion director Amber Pope, and various jocks bowl a few frames and have lunch together to blow off steam. "It took us over four hours to bowl three games this week, as everyone's pagers kept going off," he says. Staffers spent the afternoon returning calls they had placed earlier in the day to prospective employers.

### PREPARE TO BE UNEMPLOYED

Edwards says running three radio stations didn't leave a lot of free time to cover his butt. "You have to prepare for your next job while you're still employed," he says. "That doesn't mean you're any less loyal to your current employer; you're just prepared, and that's part of radio. Your future is not always in your hands." The exact amount of advance butt-covering needed, according to Edwards, "depends on who you work for and the level of commitment they've demonstrated to you," he says.

"If you've had a bad trend or feel there's anything lurking that someone could hang you for later on, you have to be prepared. Use that bad trend ... as a reminder to start building your safety net. In a worst-case scenario you're going to get blindsided," he says. "You'll have a family to feed, a mortgage to pay, no severance, and no game plan. That can be emotionally devastating."

### SOLUTIONS

McFadden kept a daily phone log with detailed notes on who he spoke to, what was discussed, and the phone number. "That makes it easy to highlight those numbers on my phone bill for tax time," he says. "Reading that log each day and seeing I spoke to 25 people gave me a sense of accomplishment, and a feeling of closure on the day."

McFadden also set up a call list and an action list for the following day. "I also sent thank-you notes after returning from an interview," he adds.

"My job is now getting a job," Edwards says. I can't afford to sit home and sulk. I plan on being on a first-name basis with the guy at the Fed-Ex office." Out of all the overnight packages he received in his day, he always opened those big FedEx boxes first. "Guess what I'll be sending my stuff in?" he says.

Kerr alerted consultants and trade magazines (what he calls "the carotid arteries of radio") and upgraded his AOL service to unlimited access, as he knew he'd be spending extra hours networking. "You never know who you'll run across, especially in the evening, when folks wind down. I've made some new and valuable contacts," he says.

"On day one of my unemployment, I called everyone I knew to let 'em know I was available," Ferreri says. "When I had a job, I would only check my home messages when I came home. I had even forgotten the access code to check my messages from another phone, but now that I'm

unemployed, I check that machine hourly."

### A NEW ATTITUDE

"When I first started, I wanted to work my way up to major market," Ferreri says. "My attitude has now changed. For my next job, I'll take a close look at the company, the people I would work with, and the lifestyle afforded by the market, as opposed to market size. You now have to interview a prospective employer as thoroughly as they do you. Remember, you're putting your life in their hands, especially when a major relocation is involved."

Kerr, too, advocates examining an entire company, not just a set of calls. "I'm using this time to re-evaluate what I really want to do, where I want to be geographically, and what role I want to play in the big picture at this point in my life," he says.

"When those job offers begin to come in, I'm only going to consider those that are best for me. It's important not to be too desperate for that next job, although the temptation can be overwhelming," says Kerr, who's been married for only six months. "My wife is working, and she's supportive of my career, but that next move must work for both of us."

### RELAX, DAMMIT!

Ferreri suggests applicants "realize you can't force a job opening. We have to face unemployment as part of the reality of this business," he says. His landlord thought differently when he left KRLA for KIBB and then left for home. "I could see the wheels turning when he heard the news. 'I thought you were such a nice young man . . . what the hell kind of business are you in?'" he says.

Edwards is allowing himself some much-needed decompression time. "I've had no time to even take a breath, let alone make preparations for that next job," he says. "I now have time to rehone my philosophies, remember all the important things I may have forgotten, and observe the outside world to see how normal people conduct their lives."

Kerr now has friends mailing him airchecks of stations he admires. "I haven't had the time to monitor them and compare their different approaches," he says. "That helps relieve some of that nervous energy, which seems to be an occupational requirement in this business."

Feather shares another surefire coping technique: "I bought a puppy," he says. In between housebreaking his dog (and his 9½-month-old son), he does the usual networking and mailings. "This is my third time being out of work, so it's become easier to deal with," he says. "I can afford to make light of it to some extent. You can't treat it like the end of the world. I hang out with the staff, give them my support, and make calls on their behalf," he says. "I'll treat this like a semi-vacation for now," he says. "I'll start to freak out later if necessary."

Although finding a job was job one, McFadden built in extra time for his family. "I'd work the phones from about 9 a.m. until midafternoon, then we'd go to the park, watch TV, or get out of the house. Once you're confident you've planted the seeds, you can't stare at the phone or you'll drive yourself crazy," he says. "Your job target may be No. 1 on your call list, but you may be No. 37 on their list. Face it, they already have a job, they're busy."

### EVADING TOUGH QUESTIONS

McFadden recommends the book "Knock 'Em Dead: The Ultimate Job Seeker's Handbook" by Martin Yate. "It tells you how to jump-start a stalled job search, nail those phone interviews and psychological tests—even how to sit, what kind of clothes to wear to an interview, and how to evade tough questions. It's very specific," says McFadden, who referred to it while flying to job interviews.

"The industry has undergone so many changes over the past year, and the rules have changed drastically," Edwards says. But "if you have value, smart operators will recognize that fact and make you a part of their plan."

### Bowen Survives And Thrives In Denver; Soon To Star In Atlanta For Jeff-Pilot

**A**fter 11 years in a successful, relatively low-profile existence at Nationwide's WNCL Columbus, Ohio, Dan Bowen seems to be cramming a lot of living into the past several months. Let's do the math: nine months, three formats, two PD gigs.

The announcement last week that Jefferson-Pilot was transferring Bowen from rhythmic top 40 KQKS (KS107.5) Denver to flagship station WSTR (Star 94) Atlanta was just the icing on a very strange cake.

"My wife is ready to kill me," Bowen says of this brave but good-hearted woman who married him just a few short months ago. This same woman now has to give two weeks' notice on a job she's held for only three weeks. Shouldn't surprise anyone, given the frenetic pace Bowen has been living since arriving in Denver last July.

The station he was scheduled to program was called KWMX (Mix 107.5) when he was hired. "I knew going in that a change of direction was indicated," he says, and within his first week, the research confirmed that the "Mix" handle had run its course. "The station was caught between [modern-leaning adult top 40 KAIC] Alice 106 and [soft AC] KOSI," Bowen says.

Phase two was the unveiling of KHHT (K-Hits 107.5), an uptempo, closer-to-mainstream top 40 station that managed to last until the Christmas holidays. (Don't get too comfortable just yet, Dan.)

"Further research indicated that while K-Hits was showing growth, especially with the 18-34s, it was not growing fast enough," he says. "Our piece of the pie was just too small, and it was clearly evident that the overall rate of growth was not going to be as expedient as we needed."

What Bowen and staff did find was "an incredible desire for rhythmic top 40 in this market," he says. "We knew that by taking [KS104's] format from a weaker frequency [104.3] to the 100,000 watts at 107.5 would make a huge difference. Even though [rival rhythm-crossover KJMN (Jau'n 92.1)] was already doing the format with many former KS104 staffers, they were operating with an inferior signal and no marketing money to speak of. Also in our favor, we had veteran air personalities like Rick Stacy and George McFly. It was a battle we were willing to take on, with our goal to be alone in the format as soon as possible."

Week two of January '97: Jeff-Pilot, banking on the heritage of the glory days of KS104, officially moved the KQKS calls and format up the dial from 104.3 and debuted KS107.5.

The next hurdle for staffers was to basically blow off whatever K-Hits cume they had worked so hard to acquire, in order to curry the favor of the market's rhythm partisans.

"I warned the staff we would probably take a hit due to audience churn," Bowen says. However, with KS107.5 aboard only for 18 of the 28 days of phase one of the winter book, the station showed growth, moving 2.2-2.6 12-plus, 3.2-4.9

with 18-34, and doubling in female 18-plus output. That was the first hint of light at the end of a very long tunnel. "It was a lot to expect to pack up an audience along with a radio station and move them both down the dial together," Bowen says.

Meanwhile, rumors were flying that EXCL, owner of KJMN, was pondering a format flip to Spanish. On Feb. 24, those rumors came true.

Now that things have calmed down somewhat, here's a recent 2 p.m. hour on KQKS: Freak Nasty, "Da Dip"; Spice Girls, "Wannabe"; Ginuwine, "Pony"; Erykah Badu, "On & On"; Mark Morrison, "Return Of The Mack"; Brandy, "Best Friend"; LL Cool J, "Loungin'"; Az Yet, "Hard To Say I'm Sorry"; En Vogue, "Don't Let Go"; Dru Hill, "In My Bed"; Rob Base & DJ EZ Rock, "It Takes Two"; BLACKstreet, "Don't Leave Me"; and Fugees, "Ready Or Not."

Just as Bowen was entering the third consecutive month of the same format, he received the Atlanta call. "My first reaction was, I felt we were finally on a roll here. I feel good about the future success of this station, and I really wanted to be a part of that, but the opportunity to program Star 94 was just too good to pass up," he says. "Star 94 works with my areas of expertise and resembles WNCL, both musically and promotionally."

"As a first-time PD, to say that my tenure in Denver has been an incredible learning experience would be an understatement," Bowen adds.

Bowen leaves behind a staff that has truly survived the winds of war: Mornings feature Rick Stacy, Leah Brandon, and sidekick Larry Ulibarri. "What a great brain trust to have a former programmer like [Stacy], who has worked magic with his creative imaging," Bowen says.

Midday jock Rick O'Bryan moved up from nights when K-Hits debuted. McFly made his mark at WBBM (B96) Chicago and joined after a stint at WWZZ (Z104) Washington, D.C. "George truly communicates with his audience—that's his gift," says Bowen. Night jock Naughty Boy crossed the street from the defunct KJMN; he's followed by industry vet Steve Douglas.

Promotion director Aldo has been with the station since its days as Y108. He and marketing director Mark Etchason have managed to retain their sanity, despite having blown their budget in the past nine months constantly re-logoing every station vehicle and ordering (and re-ordering) banners, bumper stickers, and station apparel.

"GM Bob Call is a one-man machine," says Bowen. "He's a former programmer who has a total grasp of everything going on at all five of his stations here." Those five are country KYGO AM-FM, country KCKK, sports KKFN (the Fan), and KQKS.

KUBE Seattle PD Mike Tierney is now consulting KS107.5. "We want to be able to emulate the success he's had in Seattle," says Bowen. "Mike is a true radio scholar who instinctively knows how things are supposed to feel."

Bowen admits to more than a few sleepless nights lately, along with the late-night phone calls to his close friends, including mentor Dave Robbins, GM of WNCL.

"My brain just never shuts off, thinking about what has happened here in Denver and the future in Atlanta," he says. "We've laid out our plans for the spring book, which includes bringing back the legendary 'Kash Kow,' developed by Dave Van Stone. I feel I'm leaving KS107.5 in a position of forward momentum, and I feel confident the station is set up for the next PD to achieve greater success and help solidify KS107.5's position in the market."




