## Programmers Go Back To School To Hone Management And People Skills

With the unprecedented flurry of buying, selling, and consolidation in radio, many PDs and other managers are taking self-improvement courses to make themselves more valuable.

"Continuing education is no longer a luxury. It's now a necessity in this ever-narrowing radio world," says consultant Guy Zapoleon. "The future managers will have to be time experts, spiritual team leaders, and 'resource ninjas.' Great PDs have to have an innate talent for programming, but more of our jobs will be based on our ability to manage and inspire the people we work with."

WDCG (G105) Raleigh, N.C., OM Brian Burns agrees: "People management is not a natural skill; it's a learned skill that takes practice to perfect," he says. "There's a big difference between being a great PD and a great manager. In the old days, the best DJs became PDs. Sure, they understood the mechanics of programming, but not the mechanics of people management."

To help perfect their people skills, G105's previous owner, Prism Radio Partners, sent its managers to Pyramid Resources, a management consulting firm run by former G105 GM D.J. Mitsch.

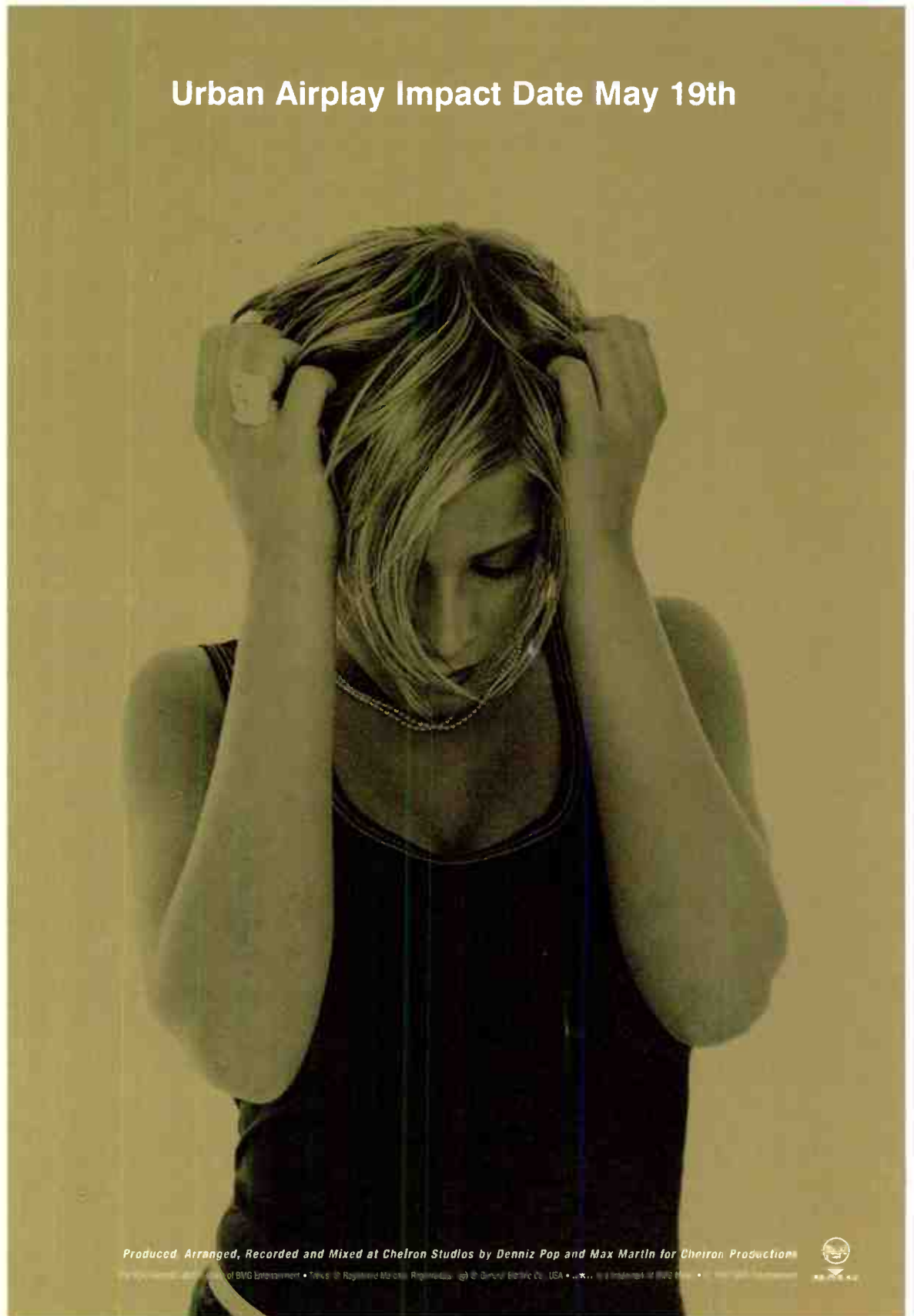

## TOP 40 TOPICS BY SEAN ROSS

### Was The Dance Revolution A Bloodless Coup?

**T**he minute WKTU New York signed on, knives were poised for it, both by dance music's detractors, who said it wouldn't last, and the genre's supporters, who felt it didn't go far enough. The sniping stopped for a few minutes when WKTU's success was too overwhelming to credibly deny. Now that WKTU is no longer No. 1 in the market for the first time in three books, two of the more unlikely stations inspired by it (WMYK Norfolk, Va., and WSGF Savannah, Ga.) have returned to R&B in recent weeks, and the Euro-dance sound WKTU helped spread to mid-America is represented by only a few chart titles.

Those who are spoiling to prove that the dance boom is over, or never really materialized, might make something of this, but the national picture is more complex. WIOQ (Q102) Philadelphia, the station that preceded WKTU into rhythmic top 40, continues to build. KHYS (Kiss 98.5) Houston is on the rise. KYLD (Wild 107.7) San Francisco was No. 2 in the winter book. And, as shown by last week's story on where records start, mainstream top 40 is taking twice as many records from rhythmic top 40 than it was six months ago, although whether it wants dance records or merely the poppiest R&B crossover is debatable.

Clearly there have been changes. What hasn't come out of WKTU's year of dominance is any kind of game plan for breaking dance music. Consider the number of obstacles. WKTU, which signed on more as a rhythmic top 40 than a dance station, has always chafed at the dance label. And even as a reluctant format flagship, it relies too heavily on recurrents, bringbacks, and '70s gold for many PDs to take their cues from its playlist. (Which is its right. WHITZ [Z100] New York helped foster the '80s top 40 boom, but it rarely started records, and since it was in market No. 1, nobody expected that.)

Meanwhile, the 40 or so stations that make up the rhythm-crossover panel are too diverse to really break dance records. Some are R&B stations that play little or no pop dance. WDRQ Detroit, like WKTU, is heavily built on gold. KYLD is so aggressive that many of the songs it starts are done by the time that labels can get around to working them nationally.

If little coherence exists on the radio side, the record side rarely seems interested in helping to

construct any. Some in the industry, more determined to focus on the **Rhythm Syndicates** and **Natural Selections** of the late '80s/early '90s than the **Madonnas** and **Paula Abduls**, announced early on that dance would be a format of one-shot turntable hits and then strove to deliver a self-fulfilling prophecy. As a result, the artist base has often been too divided between AC artists with dance remixes (that often aren't on their album) and dance artists who want to bolt the format as soon as they can to become serious *artists*.

Where are the clubs in all of this? The most active of the rhythmic top 40s are at least cognizant of them. The most conservative see them as having little to contribute. And given that it's still possible to spend all night in a New York club without hearing a vocal, that gap is unlikely to close. Club jocks remain devoted to the moment, while the one or two dance-pop records that can find a coalition at rhythmic top 40 may be a year or two old. (That's a problem at mainstream top 40, too, by the way.)

None of this is necessarily bad. WKTU's success (in 1978 and 1996) was very much a byproduct of being in New York. Its proper influence around the country was to make top 40 more rhythmic, not to father a bunch of clones. It's good that not every dance music station sounds the same. It's good that mainstream top 40, having so often burned itself, is now trying to accommodate changes in the landscape a few records at a time, rather than by binging and purging. It's only a problem if you were expecting the dance boom to look like a revolution, rather than a bloodless coup.

As for WKTU, while I occasionally wish it would broaden a little to include more R&B crossovers and more modern dance (more like a late-'80s dance station), what they should probably do now is to stay the course. Being *only* No. 3 in New York is not catastrophic. And any station that relies heavily on oldies goes through an unavoidable leveling; the real problem would be if the "I Will Survive" fans, having given themselves a breather, come back and the station has changed. New York radio has gone through major changes over the past year, largely because of WKTU. If nobody is galvanizing the market at the moment, there's still a lot more to listen to in a market that's rarely known for lots of choice.

### Settlement: The Commute Is On Evergreen

**S**an Francisco-area commuters get a free ride May 13-16 on the Bay Bridge (to the tune of \$500,000), courtesy of Evergreen Media as part of a \$1.5 million settlement Evergreen inherited from United Broadcasting due to **Mancow Muller's** infamous haircut stunt that jammed the Bay Bridge a few years ago.

Arbitron has flagged AC KUDL Kansas City for a piece in its morning team's fax, which read, "We unashamedly ask you to identify KUDL as the station you listen to. Tell 'em you listen all morning and all day! Thanks!"

In this week's purchases, Jacor picks up Secret's AC WLTF and its AM for \$23.9 million. Also at Jacor, look for San Diego-based **Jack Evans** to be upped to director of programming, West, and Cincinnati-based **Marc Chase**, director of programming, East. Both will report to Jacor VP of programming **Tom Owens**.

Capstar buys top 40 WNOK Columbia, S.C., but then deals it to Clear Channel. Capstar also picks up Ameron Broadcasting's Birmingham, Ala., outlets, including AC WMJJ. Former Osborn Communications president/CEO **Frank Osborn** is now chairman of Southern Star and Atlantic Star Communications, two of the new station groups within Capstar.

was to improve our interpersonal relationships and people skills in order to get the most out of the relationship, because everyone is motivated differently," Burns says. The course "helped sensitize me to my actions and reactions, which, in turn, helped me mature as a manager," he adds. "I'm now more aware of the long-term ramifications of my decisions, rather than rushing to get something off the desk and move on to something I'm more comfortable with."

Radio people, both managers and subordinates, tend to be creative and emotional. One of the skills that Mitsch taught Burns was the "charge neutral theory," where the emotion is factored out of people management decisions. "Whether you're a parent or a manager, it's important not to attack the person; instead, you confront the person's behavior," says Burns, who tackled even subconscious personal ticks like hand gestures, eye contact, and tone of voice.

Zapoleon and many of his peers speak highly of a program called Center Sales Strategies (CSS) taught by Tampa, Fla.-based NewCity Associates. "It was the most important class I took as a PD," says Zapoleon of the invitation-only course that boasts a lengthy waiting list. "In addition to teaching you what your sales staff goes through, it teaches you how to think strategically, and it teaches you about establishing value—certainly something we have to do when we go out into the lonely consulting field." The course also demonstrates a "Client Needs Analysis." Zapoleon explains, "Before selling them something, we need to find out what the customers' needs are, something we ought to think about from a PD/listener perspective as well as a salesman/client relationship."

WNCI Columbus, Ohio, is a CSS client station. GM Dave Robbins, a longtime advocate of auxiliary employee-enrichment programs, found the course especially helpful in his transition from programming to the corner office. Although many seminars are targeted to sales, Robbins found universal themes that could be applied to any management experience.

Bob Neumann, PD of Nationwide rocker WMMS Cleveland, was knee-deep in a two-day brainstorming seminar at the time this article was written. "These courses are more important now than ever before, because programmers are now juggling more duties in many cases," he says.

### NEVER TOO LATE TO LEARN

Shakes, now a consultant with Alan Burns & Associates, took a seminar by the American Management Assn. (AMA), a nonprofit professional organization that surveys the workplace and offers seminars and networking opportunities.

"With all of the changes in radio ownership structure, they also offer a course devoted to learning to deal with change, working with sales, dealing with personnel issues, installing various systems, database marketing, working with the Internet, etc.," Shakes says. "I also learned a lot about marketing, positioning, and strategic planning—skills that are universal."

Lynn J. Johnston, managing director of AMA, says radio is just now learning what many other industries have already found out. "There used to be a career track for a lot of people, and that track is now being turned on its head because of many things now happening in the marketplace, one of which is more conglomerate-type industries, like these four- or five-station clusters in one market," she says. "That's happening all over, and it's wreaking havoc."

While a three-day management seminar doesn't come cheap (plan on anywhere from \$1,000 and up), Shakes says taking that first step will create a solid foundation and help jump-start any future educational efforts.

"We have to think of it as an investment in ourselves," he says. Many seminar graduates say that any money spent will come back tenfold after wielding your newfound skills.

"Any PD can benefit even by taking a course in basic computer skills, management, or public speaking at a local community college," Shakes adds, "if for no other reason than to experience real people in real-life situations once a week. A college campus is a great place to observe your 18-24 and 18-34 demos up close."

### INCREASE YOUR RESALE VALUE

Johnston sees employee training programs as a key strategy for any employer. AMA does an annual survey of downsizing and found "companies let go a certain amount of people as they downsized, but then they hired as many or more back," she says, describing a common scenario. "[The company says], 'The people we have don't have the skills we need, so we'll go outside and hire those skills.'" The key to that equation before any downsizing is done is, "Maybe you shouldn't be letting those people go; maybe you should be training them."

"You have to know how the other side of the operation works," WMMS' Neumann agrees. "And you have to know something about business. The days of a PD just picking cool tunes and managing jocks is over. That's where some extra business training or education comes in to play, because they can teach you management skills, dealing with people, and make you more sensitive to the bottom line."

## MONITOR PROFILE

### Top 40 Vet Philips Looks For A New Direction For Modern At 99X

**B**rian Philips was known as a "top 40 guy," programming KDWB Minneapolis and the late WEGX (Eagle 106) Philadelphia. He landed at WNNX (99X) Atlanta, which had just made the then-daring switch from top 40 WAPW (Power 99) to modern. Now OM of 99X and a Pollack Media Group consultant, Philips recalls those shaky days, post-flip: "We're so used to it now, but the idea of [modern] being used to build a contemporary commercial format was an unproven, if not completely new, idea. "On conference calls with CHR programmers, everybody thought they'd lost their mind. 'How bad could things have been at Power 99 that they thought that was a good idea?' Which, in retrospect, is pretty funny."

"I recall looking at [SoundScan numbers for] Nirvana and Pearl Jam and talking to [Steve] Kingston in New York, going, 'My God! Look at these bands selling, with no airplay. Who are these people?,' then trying to find a way to make those songs fit on Eagle and [WHTZ (Z100) New York]. That was a challenge, as they were bumping up against CeCe Peniston. It was an ugly time."

Philips sees cross-town top 40 WSTR (Star 94) as an example of how the country's changed. "I recall a record guy saying, 'We can't get Better Than Ezra's 'Good' played at Star; it thinks it's too alternative.'" Since then, top 40 underwent two phases, he says. "The next phase was 'We'll play 99X's songs after they're hits, but we'll allot six weeks of lead time for 99X to establish them as their own.' And the third phase is, 'We'll put Meredith Brooks on the day the envelope arrives with the record in it.'"

While modern may now be safe for the masses, Philips sees today's top 40 as conservative: "These stations are different beasts from what they were in the early '90s, [when] U2's 'Discotheque' would've been embraced even if it didn't prove to be a big top 40 hit... I'm surprised at

how safe and conservative this run of top 40 is... Part of that means it'll be less likely in the future to try to grab things from us 'til they're proven. [Top 40's] been burned a few times by [getting] out of balance with too much of [one] kind of product."

Modern, too, he feels, is at a crossroads. "What more can happen to this scene?" he asks. "The lead singer to the founding band of the whole ideal shoots himself. Stone Temple Pilots are trying to balance a touring schedule with rehab, and Soundgarden decides it's time to go separate ways... We're looking at a new generation of bands that are experimenting with a lot of things, but there's no cohesive galvanizing scene."

Like moderns, 99X is embracing many acts now being courted by modern AC. "Things you would've written off as too soft or adult have proved to have huge constituencies 18-24," he says. "Our objective is to build our future around bands like Live, Counting Crows... acts who write well and produce deep albums... Our emphasis is on sorting out bands based on their potential to [stay] with us for the long run."

Philips feels he's covered his flank well enough to scare off any potential modern AC rivals. "I don't know if a competitor looking to shift to modern AC wouldn't assume, quite correctly, that we are so well-entrenched with so many of the images that make up modern AC that there has to be a more practical thing to do in Atlanta."

Here's a sample hour on WNNX: Blind Melon, "No Rain"; Third Eye Blind, "Semi-Charmed Life"; Sneaker Pimps, "6 Underground"; Smashing Pumpkins, "Muzzle"; Psychedelic Furs, "Love My Way"; Foo Fighters, "Monkey Wrench"; U2, "Mysterious Ways"; Bush, "Comedown"; Abra Moore, "Four Leaf Clover"; Red Hot Chili Peppers, "Higher Ground"; and the Wallflowers, "One Headlight."

A perennial thorn in modern's side, talent development, was tackled by Philips from day one by creating a successful local morning show, anchored by PD Leslie Fram. "We went in with the idea that we needed to kill in the morning," he says. "That's our objective, more than passing the time of day 'til it's time for retro-lunch... The idea was to have a big enough morning show to steal people away from other morning shows and not mind if we lost them at 10 a.m. or if they didn't have a natural affinity for the music." **MARC SCHIFFMAN**

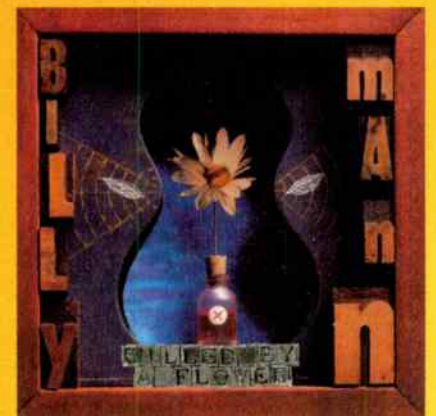
