## As Spring Arbs Roll In, Top 40's Class Of '96 Shows Some Leg


First there was a slew of new '70s oldies stations. Many had good initial numbers but caved almost immediately, then abandoned the format. Then there was a slew of new adult R&B outlets that had terrific initial numbers, then leveled off, but at a respectable number.

Now there are a new slew of top 40 launches. And among the good news this spring in Airplay Monitor's twice-annual analysis of how the newest top 40s are doing is the fact that many of

the stations that debuted big last year and then leveled have rebounded, suggesting that the format and those stations have legs.

Among those top 40s launched in 1995-96 and showing strong rebounds this spring are WDAY (Y94) Fargo, N.D., which had gone 9.4-8.4-9.1 over the last three books; WWLD (Wild 106) Tallahassee, Fla., rebounding 5.4-4.3-8.6; WSSX (95SX) Charleston, S.C., up 5.0-7.2 after falling from the sevens several books ago; WFBC (B93.7) Greenville, S.C., which

## Chancellor Buys WNSR, KBIG; Splits KIBB/KYSR GM Duties

**B**onneville Broadcasting will exit the New York market when its modern adult **WDBZ** (the Buzz) is acquired by Chancellor Media as part of a \$740 million multi-station deal. Along with **WDBZ**, which has reverted to previous calls **WNSR**, Chancellor gets AC **KBIG** Los Angeles and oldies **KLDE** Houston. Bonneville picks up Chancellor's country **KZLA** Los Angeles and news/classical combo **WTOP/WGMS** Washington, D.C. Any format shift at **WNSR**, will have to wait until the LMA with Chancellor goes into effect no earlier than Sept. 1.

In other Chancellor/Evergreen news, Evergreen Media has received a request for additional information from the Justice Department regarding the acquisition of Katz Media. The DOJ, however, did approve the sale of Heritage Media to News Corp., thus facilitating the attached sale of Heritage's radio stations to Sinclair.

**Ed Krampf**, most recently **GSM** of **KIOI** San Francisco, is the new VP/GM of Chancellor's **KIBB** (B100) Los Angeles. **Ken Christenson**, who had overseen B100, remains VP/GM of co-owned **KYSR** (Star 98.7).

FCC general counsel **Bill Kennard** has been officially nominated for FCC chairman.

The sale of Benchmark to CapStar has closed. Former general partner **Joe Mathias** is now a managing director of the CapStar exec council. Also, **WJBR-AM-FM** Wilmington, Del., **GM Jay Sterin** adds duties over AC **WSRV** Dover, Del., and its sisters, replacing **Chris Wallace**.

**KDON** Monterey, Calif., is among six Monterey Broadcasting stations sold to Clear Channel for \$23.2 million.

### MANAGEMENT: MARTIN BRANCHES OUT

As **ARS** closes on country **WDSY** (Y108) Pittsburgh, **Andrea Martin**, GM of its new sister station, top 40 **WBZZ** (B94), adds those duties for **WDSY**. She replaces **Frank Iorrio**, now GM of rival hot AC **WVTY** (Variety 96) and its sister stations. Iorrio replaces **James Carter**, who went to former owner Hearst's TV division.

**John Shea**, **GSM** of **WNNK** Harrisburg, Pa., is named GM of adult top 40/adult R&B combo **WKDD/WTOU** Akron, Ohio, replacing **Andy Graham**, now at **KRKQ** Des Moines, Iowa.

**Paul Ehlis**, GM of Citadel's Colorado Springs stations, including top 40 **KKMG**, is the new GM of its Albuquerque, N.M., outlets, including adult top 40 **KKOB-FM** and AC **KMGA**.

### PROGRAMMING: STEAL TO KDMX

**WKRQ** (Q102) Cincinnati PD **Jimmy Steal** is named PD of Nationwide adult top 40 **KDMX** Dallas. Steal programmed that market's **KEGL** during its top 40 prime. He replaces **Kim Ashley**, who remains aboard as APD. Elsewhere at Q102, **Jeff B.** is now official in nights.

**Pat Paxton**, former PD of adult top 40 **KHMX** (Mix 96.5) Houston, joins Zapoleon Media Strategies as a consultant. Also, **KHMX** middayer **Lori Bradley** exits for middays at **KBKS** (Kiss 106.1) Seattle. Night jock **Ann Duran** moves up to middays, while overnighter **Matthew Cain** covers nights. Meanwhile, former **KTBS** (the Buzz) Houston PD **Cruze** is now handling mornings on crosstown modern adult **KKPN** (the Planet).

The L.A. Times reports that **KACD/KBCD** (Groove Radio) Los Angeles has become "the Groove" under recently named PD **Mohamed Moreta** and will become slightly less eclectic. The name "Groove Radio" is actually owned by former PD **Egil "Swedish Eagle" Aalvik**.

Former **WMGI** Terre Haute, Ind., PD **Beau Richards** cops the PD slot at **KIXY** San Angelo, Texas, replacing **J.J. Morgan**. Richards' wife, midday jock **Kelly Green**, has given notice and won't

return to **WMGI** after maternity leave.

Look for **KKXL** (XL93) Grand Forks, N.D., to return to the air Aug. 18 using the facilities of rock sister **KJKJ**. XL93 has been off the air since the flooding and ice storms that destroyed its building on April 18. Same staff, except for midday jock **Jarod Thomas**, who went to nights at country **KFGO** Fargo, N.D.

**KAHX** Corpus Christi, Texas, flips from mainstream to rhythmic top 40 as "Power 107.3" under consultant **Cliff Tredway**, PD of **KTFM** San Antonio, Texas. Tredway calls the station, currently jockless, a "young-end version of **KTFM**."

Former **KIIS** L.A. morning producer **Jack Silver** is named PD of N/T **KLSX** Los Angeles, replacing **Jay Clark**. Silver was operating a morning-show consultancy.

### PEOPLE: KID RETURNS TO Z100

**WBHT** (Hot 97) Wilkes-Barre, Pa., PD **Kid Kelly** is named APD of **WHTZ** (Z100) New York. Kelly, who still does P/T at Z100, did nights from 1988-94. Also, Z100's annual Jingle Ball will be held Dec. 9 at Madison Square Garden.

Less than a week after **WZYP** Huntsville, Ala., PD **Marc Summers** moved to **KZHT** Salt Lake City, morning duo **Ace and TJ**, have inked a deal with CapStar to syndicate their show in the Southeast from new studios in Birmingham, Ala., but, due to a one-year noncompete, the show isn't yet available in either Birmingham or Huntsville.

**Tim Hackett** is named to the newly created position of marketing and events director for Jacor's San Diego FM properties, including top 40s **KKLQ** (Q106) and **KHTS** (Channel 933), as well as AC **KKBH** (Mix 102.9) . . . After filling afternoons temporarily, **WALC** (Alice @ 104.1) St. Louis PD **Bob Davis** awards the shift to **Todd Meyers** permanently, replacing (the other) **Jimmy Steele**, who exited some weeks ago.

With **WMMX** (Mix 106.5) Baltimore ND **Julie De Harty** relocating with her husband to Dallas, midday jock **Tamara Nelson** will replace her. PD **Adam Goodman** needs a midday host. Also, **Dave Burgess** joins as promotions coordinator from **WPLY** Philadelphia, replacing **Carolyn Searfoss**, now at **The Baltimore Sun**.

**WZEE** (Z104) Madison, Wis., music coordinator/nights **Tom Dean** is named MD/afternoons, replacing **Catfish Cooper**, now at **KHKS** Dallas. The other **Scott Shannon** is covering nights.

At **KKXX** Bakersfield, Calif., **Joe Brown** moves from nights to middays and **Craig Marshall** from middays to afternoons, as **Jonathan Powers** is upped from P/T to nights.


**WKEE** Huntington, W.Va., ups morning co-host **Cliff Ross** to promotion director.

### Does '79 Still Mix With '97?

**M**ore than a decade ago, a buddy of mine named **WT Koltsek**, then editor of the radio fanzine that eventually became **The M Street Journal**, made the unlikely suggestion that "Y.M.C.A." by **the Village People** should one day be a staple record at hot AC as the folks who grew up with it moved into the 25-54 demo. By 1992-93, it was possible to hear classic disco on **WPLJ** New York, which was indeed targeting 25-54's newest members. By 1996, **WKTU** was here, and suddenly classic dance titles (well, at least a few of them) were, it seemed everywhere.

Now, **WKTU** wasn't as heavily cloned as it could have been. Its greatest impact was in putting more current dance on mainstream top 40 outlets. But enough stations did take a flier on some classic disco so that it was suddenly easier to hear "It's Raining Men" by **the Weather Girls** on radio in 1997 than it had been in 1983. It was also possible to hear some of these songs in markets where they hadn't been played as currents but had, perhaps, gotten 15 years of dancefloor exposure.

In the abstract, I kind of liked this. Creative use of oldies has always been the thing I loved most about any radio station. The best was **KKBQ** (79Q) Houston in 1982, which played a ton of shock-effect oldies from all genres. Back when there was no industry love for "Ring My Bell," it was possible to hear that song on 79Q next to a current or, for that matter, "Saturday Night" by **the Bay City Rollers** next to a current. I'd always waited for another mainstream top 40 to use oldies that boldly again.

On **WKTU** it worked. While a lot of what **WKTU** played at the outset was on the level of "I Will Survive" or "Got To Be Real"—huge mega-crossovers that just happened to be disco—there were a lot of other records that only made sense if you'd been in New York for the original **WKTU**: "Mandolay" by **La Flavour** or "This Time Baby" by **Jackie Moore**. Those songs immediately made **WKTU** sound like New York, and, at least initially, they made it

the station that moms and daughters could agree on.

Outside New York, though it pains me to say this, classic disco hasn't worked as well in regular programming. Most of the stations that began their life heavily influenced by **WKTU** started slowly, then grew only as they went more current. Sounding like New York was a pretty good idea in New York but may not have been elsewhere. "I Will Survive" was a smash everywhere; in New York, it was a transcendent cultural phenomenon. It sounded natural next to "Be My Lover" because it was too familiar to sound otherwise.

In other markets, playing 15- to 20-year-old dance records may just have chased off teens, without bringing in enough adults to compensate. And there aren't a lot of other contemporary formats besides mainstream AC where you can hear 1979 and 1997 together. Many mainstream rock stations have split into active or heritage camps, rather than segue **Tool** into **Triumph**. Modern rock begat modern adult, and even there, there was surprisingly little demand for the MTV '80s, much less late-'70s punk (with the surprise exception of "I Wanna Be Sedated," the current cultural significance of which cannot be overstated). Only R&B is going against the grain. Recently, I've noticed a lot of mainstream R&B stations throwing in a classic **Grandmaster Flash** or **LL Cool J** record on the weekends as a way of trying to balance their teen and adult constituencies.

The good news is that top 40 is in relatively good shape for current music, so while I'm always happy to see gold used creatively, nobody is being forced to do so at the moment. Beyond that, this may all be just one more indication that adults who choose to listen to top 40 don't want to be treated as adults any more than parents at Walt Disney World want to drop off their kids at Space Mountain, then go find a special adult section of the park that has been made to look just like their office. Disco was, among other things, built on escapism. So, when it does its job, is today's hit music.

## ON THE AIR

Effective this week, **KBKS** Seattle, Wash., and **WRVW** Nashville move from adult top 40 to top 40/mainstream. Rhythmic top 40 **KCAQ** Oxnard, Calif., becomes a dual reporter to crossover. **WBOS** Boston and **WXLE** Albany, N.Y., are added to modern adult. There are now 34 rhythmic top 40, 53 crossover, 63 adult top 40, and 37 modern adult reporting stations. The Airpower criteria for the Modern Adult chart has been raised from 400 to 500 detections.

## As Spring Arbs Roll In, Top 40's Class Of '96 Shows Some Leg

has been through several up-and-down cycles since its 1995 debut but was up 5.5-6.9 this spring; and WEZB (B97) New Orleans, which came out of the box with a 4.9 share before bot-toming out at 2.9—it rebounded to 4.0 in the spring.

That such rebounds can happen is good news for several of the top 40s that debuted high in the fall or winter, then leveled this time, among them KEYW Tri Cities, Wash. (10.1-8.3); KRUF Shreveport, La. (10.7-7.6); WWZZ Washington, D.C. (4.7-4.6); WYOY Jackson, Miss. (5.8-4.4); KESR Little Rock, Ark. (4.3-3.5); KPTY Phoenix (2.9-2.6); and KHYS Houston (1.3-2.1-2.0).

Then again, WLKT (the Cat) Lexington, Ky., which debuted last fall with a 9.9 share, was up to an 11.5, good for No. 2 in the market and showing that it is possible for a new mainstream to put several great books together.

Some other recent launches that continue to grow: KTXV (Y107) Columbia, Mo. (8.1-12.8); WMEE Fort Wayne, Ind. (4.2-6.6, with a little help from now departed rival WDJB); WQQB Champaign, Ill. (3.7-5.0); WKSZ (Kiss FM) Green Bay, Wis. (3.7-4.7); WDRQ Detroit (3.0-3.8); KSJM Tucson, Ariz. (1.7-2.3, while rhythmic rival KOHT fell 6.0-3.7); WQZQ (the Party) Nashville (up 2.0-2.8 while rival WRVW rebounded 4.9-7.6); WZSK (the Shark) Ocean City, Md. (8-1.3); and KYLZ Albuquerque, N.M. (1.1-1.5). KAHX Corpus Christi, Texas, debuted with a .8 share.

Last fall, WKEE Huntington, W.Va., returned from AC to a heavily dayparted top 40 format. This spring, PD Jim Davis, veteran MD Gary Miller, and their staff snagged WKEE's first No. 1 showing in the last 24 books, up 14.8-18.1. Last fall, WKEE had marketed heavily. This spring, it concentrated on its "no repeat workday guarantee" and a heavy street presence. And after avoiding anything rhythmic for years, the station did its first music test, which showed TLC's "Waterfalls" at No. 33, allowing some dance and R&B titles to return to the mix.

WHZZ (Z101.7) Lansing, Mich., like WFBC, has been through a few up-and-down cycles by now. But in the spring, it was up 6.5-7.3, good enough to earn acting PD Woody Houston the job officially. A mainstream top 40 that plays Puff Daddy, Fools' Garden, and Duran Duran's "Union Of The Snake." Z101.7 had a spring promotion called "Concerts, [Roller] Coasters, and Cash," with concert flyaways and trips to a local amusement park as well as money.

WWHT (Hot 107.9) Syracuse, N.Y., which launched last summer, is a rare case of a new top 40 showing results against an existing market force, in this case WNTQ (93Q). WWHT has gone 3.4-4.8-5.2 since fall vs. WNTQ's 10.2-9.2-8.0. Since January, new PD Ed LaCombe and consultant Randy Kabrich have sanded off WWHT's initial modern edge and tightened it musically. Now, WWHT and 93Q have company, following noncommercial outlet WJPZ (Z89)'s return to rhythmic top 40.

### DOES HERITAGE HELP?

During the format's doldrums of the early '90s, many of the stations that moved into top 40 were low-power, low-budget operations that often made no impact at all. Part of the format's rebound seems to have been keyed to a change in the type of stations it attracts. Not only were many of the new successes full-market signals with better resources, they were also frequently the stations that had ditched top 40 in the first place, and/or stations that segued from hot AC, bringing with them listeners who expected that particular frequency to play the hits and who were already amenable to hearing them.

Not every new success story has included either top 40 heritage or existing hot AC came. WLKT was a brand-new signal. KRCS (Hot 93.1) Rapid City, S.D., one of the spring's biggest first-book successes, was a suburban country outlet. It was up 1.5-9.0 this spring, under PD Leif Erickson, despite a morning-show change right before the book.

But top 40 heritage figures into many of the other successful new launches. WRTS (Star 104)

Eric, Pa., which segued from hot AC to mainstream during the fall under new PD Jon Reilly, was top 40 WCCK (K104) through most of the '80s. This spring, WRTS went 8.0-14.0, ahead of rival WJET's 10 share. WRTS, which returned to top 40 about the time that WJET ended a flirtation with modern rock, had TV and billboards during the spring, but no on-air cash. Reilly says the station got more mileage from on-air stunts such as a morning-show discussion of listeners' most bizarre school lunches, which led to the morning show visiting 35 schools.

WJBQ (Q97.9) Portland, Maine, which returned to top 40 in the middle of the fall book, was up 3.3-6.7 this spring, outstripping PD Tim Moore's initial goal of a 5 share. It was also well ahead of the 2 to 3 share that was supposed to be available for top 40, at least according to a previous format study. Moore thinks the station's June 1 concert featuring Night Ranger, Susanna Hoffs, Jamie Walters, and Chris Wayne was WJBQ's breakthrough event.

WAEZ (Electric 99) Johnson City, Tenn., was another AC-to-top 40 transition, although its only top 40 history was in the late '70s, when it was WIDB-FM, which used the positioning statement "Let's All Go Bananas." WAEZ was up 3.7-6.7 in the spring book when Tri Cities got a new active rock outlet, WRZK. That's well ahead of the 2.6 share that suburban WXIS (X104) had attained after filling a hole left several years earlier by WQUT.

Not every station with a history scored high this spring. KIOC (Hot 106.1) Beaumont, Texas, was off 5.2-4.1 after returning from modern, while rival KQXY rose 8.0-8.8. KIOC had the added challenge of switching back to rhythmic top 40 about the same time that KHYS—which targets Houston from nearby Port Arthur, Texas—went from jazz to dance.

Some other modest first-book showings during the spring: WBDR Watertown, N.Y., debuted with a 3.4 share (it succeeded WTNV-FM, which left the format with a 15 share but got a 26 share in its first country book); KDRE (Z101) Little Rock was off 3.1-2.3 after switching from modern (its sister station, KMZX, went .7-.9 with rhythmic top 40); rhythmic WWXQ/WXQW Huntsville, Ala., went 2.6-2.5; WPRW Fort Myers, Fla., was off 3.4-2.8 from simulcast news/talk but seemed to dent rival WXKB (off 9.6-7.4).

KMGQ Santa Barbara, Calif., which was rhythmic top 40 by day and jazz by night, went all jazz once its 4.5-2.5 number came back. (Also exiting the format after a brief stay were KNVE Killeen, Texas, and WMYK Norfolk, Va.)

KHTW La Crosse, Wis., debuted with a 2.2 share. WJYY Manchester, N.H., was up .7-1.5. WSMK South Bend, Ind. (a former 3-share R&B outlet), was up .6-.9 as a dance station. KSES Palm Springs, Calif., was off .9-.7. WVYB (the Vibe) Daytona Beach, Fla., was up .7-1.5, but rival WFKS had its best recent book, up 2.3-4.2.

WFKS was one of many examples of longtime top 40 stations that grew nicely this spring, sometimes to levels they hadn't reached since top 40's slide began. WSTR (Star 94) Atlanta; KMXV (Mix 93.3) Kansas City; WRZE Cape Cod, Mass.; and WDBR Springfield, Ill., hardly qualify for a story on new top 40 builds, but they were among the many longtime top 40s with great news.

It's worth mentioning the modern ACs that debuted strongly this spring, since many of them seemed to be sitting in for mainstream top 40 in their market, particularly KVSR (Star 101) Fresno, Calif. (5.6-6.3); KZZO Sacramento, Calif. (7.1-8.2); WBAM (Star 99) Montgomery, Ala. (3.9-7.5); and WKSI (the Point) Greensboro, N.C., (2.6-4.8). WKSI and WBAM are former top 40s, too.

In six months, when we next look at new top 40 builds, we'll have word on how mainstream top 40 performed in Baltimore; Monmouth, N.J.; San Francisco; Bangor, Maine; and Seattle. When we started looking at this topic, the good news was that there was indeed a market for the format. Now we know there's a sustained chance of success. So what else will the format show us in the fall book?

### Persigehl Relights The Fire Under KZZP Phoenix—But It's A Dry Heat

**I**t finally hit me a few months ago that we don't have to play Celine Dion and Journey to attract adult women," says Dan Persigehl, PD of modern-leaning adult top 40 KZZP Phoenix. Snip. Gone. "Plus we also upgraded our on-air presentation, mainly through our production elements, our sweepers and promos, to establish artist ownership, but basically, we've made a conscious effort to make this station more fun to listen to," he says.

The women have spoken, and the answer is "Yes." The latest spring numbers show KZZP No. 1 with women 18-34, 18-49, 25-34, and 25-44, with a 12-plus gain of 3.4-4.5.

Persigehl surprised more than a few industry insiders when he made the No. 118 to No. 18 market leap last year, from WKEE Huntington, W.Va., the radio home of former Nationwide group PD Pat Paxton. "Pat and I actually started in the business together," says Persigehl. "Back in 1985, we were each best man at the other's

wedding, two weeks apart in Sioux City, Iowa."

On March 8, 1996, Nationwide flipped AC KVRV (Variety 104.5) back to its heritage KZZP calls. Those who expected an immediate time-travel rush back to Guy Zapoleon's mid-'80s top 40 incarnation of KZZP were surprised to hear a more adult-targeted version that, for a while, didn't sound a whole lot different than KVRV. "We've been slowly finding our way," Persigehl admits. "About six months ago, after auditorium and perceptual studies, we discovered that this audience didn't necessarily expect or wish to hear Celine Dion and Third Eye Blind on the same station. We just felt there was more depth to get from this station, so we slowly started peeling away some of the AC layers."

The usual criteria for dovetailing differing genres of records together on one station used to be, "Never mind that the song tests, does it fit?" "Today's question becomes, 'Does it do both?'" says Persigehl, who admits to subtly shaving those AC edges off KZZP without making an on-air issue of it.

"Instead," he adds, "we played up the fun angle, promoting the image of KZZP as the upbeat, at-work station, showcasing average KZZP listeners performing various exciting and fun activities while listening to a station that reflected their upwardly mobile lifestyle.

"Much of our success comes from an ensemble of human resources, including

Guy, Pat Paxton, and my APD/MD Dave Cooper, who serves as my analytical side; he thinks in black and white; I'm the gray thinker," he says. "I believe in running as loose of a ship as possible, and that can get you in trouble in some cases. I have to trust the staff, but, more importantly, they have to trust me."

Part of that staff used to be Chicago-based air personality Jonathan Brandmeier, who worked at KZZP in the early '80s and was brought back, via satellite, before Persigehl was hired. Management soon realized that the early '80s was a generation ago in radio years, and they were dealing with morning listeners with short memories. By last September, Brandmeier was gone.

Persigehl opted for a more music-intensive show with Brian Allen and Ginny Harmon and recently added John Ballard from KISW Seattle and Jonathan Wilde from country KPLX Dallas as hosts, along with producer/utility player/street guy Mike "Train" Reck. Midday personality Valerie Knight joined from nearby KRQQ Tucson, Ariz., followed by hometown fave Carey Edwards on afternoons and Laurie Michaels doing nights.

While KZZP was fine-tuning its musical stance, crosstown KKFR (Power 92) was busy becoming the place where hip-hop lives and battling with rhythmic outlet KPTY. Persigehl insists that KZZP's success was not a direct result of KKFR's new direction, since the two shared little music. "I believe it was Arbitron finally catching up to reality," he says. "Six months ago, a perceptual study showed that it was just a matter of time."

Musically, KZZP plays just enough non-modern titles to cover its bases. "We're playing Hanson, but only in a secondary category, along with Savage Garden. No one else is even playing these songs," Persigehl says. "They're not our core artist, but they're certainly part of our adult, mass-appeal sound."

Here's a recent 5 p.m. hour on KZZP: New Order, "Blue Monday"; Sheryl Crow, "A Change Would Do You Good"; Howard Jones, "Things Can Only Get Better"; Proclaimers, "I'm Gonna Be (500 Miles)"; Jewel, "Foolish Games"; Bonnie Raitt, "Not The Only One"; Wallflowers, "One Headlight"; BoDeans, "Closer To Free"; Verve Pipe, "The Freshmen"; Pretenders, "Brass In Pocket"; Paula Cole, "I Don't Want To Wait"; Third Eye Blind, "Semi-Charmed Life"; and John Mellencamp, "Wild Night."

Persigehl's programming philosophy is that "80% of our content should come from the outside in, meaning content that's constructed through interaction with the listeners," he says. "The other 20% is what we bring to the table for them, including our style," he continues. "Everything we do is filtered through that 80/20 screen, including morning-show material, where we're especially aware of the 'shtick vs. substance' ratio.

"People are more of a resource than we realize," he adds. "That's why I constantly pick the brains of the sales staff, the office manager, marketing director Jennifer Yee, the listeners, and my friends in the business. I may hold the title of PD, but there's not a chance in hell I could do this by myself."
