Top 40 Rebounds, AC Closes In On No. 1 Again In National Spring Arbs

Those pesky teens. No major format admits to targeting them. And yet the fluctuations in their radio listening—often the result of being involuntarily exiled from one format or another—may have figured into the fate of two seemingly unlikely formats in the spring, according to *Billboard/Airplay Monitor's* exclusive national Arbitron ratings.

Adult contemporary stations, which slid sharply from 1992 to '95, have been creeping forward over the last three books, up 14.3-14.5-14.7-14.8 since last summer. Much of that rise has taken place at the format's younger end. AC stations were up 8.3-9.0 in the teen demo from winter to spring. They

were also up 15.5-16.1 in the 18-34 demo. By contrast, AC was up slightly in 25-54 (17.1-17.3) and off very slightly in 35-64 (16.7-16.6).

Teen listening had been in the 7- to 8-share range at AC since the early '90s, largely a result of the number of markets that no longer offered a top 40 option. Now, with top 40 beginning to resurface in most markets, the lower-end boost at AC may also be tied to the rise of modern AC stations, as well as a more rock-based mix at other hot AC and adult top 40 outlets. The net result is that AC, which lost the No. 1 national spot to news/talk radio in 1994, is closer than it has been in years to N/T, which was off 16.6-15.6 this spring.



Notice Anything Different?

TWICE YEARLY, Airplay Monitor updates the order in which stations appear in the Power Playlists based on the spring and fall Arbitron books. Stations are ranked in descending order of Total Survey Area (TSA) come for the largest market in which they appear—thus **WPST** Trenton, N.J., and **WSTW** Wilmington, Del., reflect their come in the larger Philadelphia TSA, while most San Jose, Calif., stations reflect their San Francisco TSA come. AM/FM or FM/FM combos count if they're 100% simulcasts.

You'll also notice that we've moved MTV's playlist to the Mainstream Top 40 Power Playlists page, where it'll be joined next week by the first-ever monitored list for the new M2 service. VH1 has moved to the Adult Top 40 page. These changes were made so that we could show you the greatest gainers for additional Top 40 Airplay Monitor formats, including crossover and modern adult.

One more change: The box that once referred to Most New Airplay This Week now refers to Most New Stations. It's a minor change but one that more accurately describes what's being measured—the number of stations showing six or more detections of a title for the first

time (whereas any increase in airplay, even at a station that was already playing a song, could technically be considered new airplay).

More To Friendship Than Reporting

Two weeks ago, when **Swedish Egil** left the PD job at **KACD/KBCD** Los Angeles, taking the station's "Groove Radio" nickname with him, Airplay Monitor's director of charts, **Theda Sandiford-Waller**, was having a discussion about the charts with a label exec who felt that Monitor was somehow responsible for his firing. As the record rep saw it, if Groove Radio had been a Monitor reporter, **KACD** would have gotten the support from the industry he needed, and **Egil** would still be there.

I didn't hear the conversation. And I hate to take what was probably a slightly contentious discussion and potentially magnify it by going public. But there's a larger issue here: stations that get no support if they're not reporters.

Since its sign-on last year, Groove Radio's ratings have been consistently just below a 1 share in Los Angeles, which is not insubstantial for two suburban signals that don't fully cover a sprawling market. Even under a 1 share, it reaches nearly 300,000 listeners, many of them, one would assume, active music fans (and thus buyers). And Groove Radio was probably the most aggressive rhythmic top 40 in the country, in terms of the indie-label records, imports, and other music that wasn't being worked nationally that it sought out.

So if Groove Radio was important to the industry—and a musically aggressive radio station with 300,000 active listeners in market No. 2 should have been—the industry shouldn't have been waiting on anybody to make it a reporter. **Swedish Egil** should not have wanted for label support. If he did, it speaks volumes about the industry mentality that reaching 300,000 potential record buyers is not important unless a station can contribute 40 spins a week to a song's chart position.

We've seen the scenario played out repeatedly. New stations, including some that represent a major market's first mainstream top 40 in years, hear from, at best, 25%-40% of their label reps until the day their reporting status comes through, at which point these stations often have millions of new best friends. Some record reps understand the importance of making friends early—I know one PD who can usually be counted on for Epic product, even when it's not a perfect fit for his particular station's lean, because **Dale Connors** was there from the beginning. Many apparently do not.

All of which is yet further evidence that the industry again has to decide if it's in the business of selling records or achieving chart po-

sitions. It's easy for me to say that, I admit; I don't have a label head, artist manager, or artist's mom screaming at me every Wednesday morning. But I still can't imagine anybody on the label side really *liking* a world in which a reporting station in market No. 110 routinely demands free acts and a non-reporter in market No. 30 begs to be serviced. And 20 years after the last disastrous fallout from the industry's "whatever it takes" mentality, we're again in an atmosphere of industry insecurity, despite having hit records. Is that because the "cost of doing business" has been driven up by the demands of a relatively small number of stations in which labels have vested so much power?

Conversely, because of the way the industry treats non-reporters, or stations that report to one chart instead of another, there are a lot of PDs for whom reporting status takes on way too much importance. In recent months, I've also talked to one PD who's scared to switch his 1-share radio station to a developing format, because the label support won't be there. Truth is, there's no amount of label time buys or track dates that justifies being in a format if the audience isn't listening and retail isn't buying. Were it otherwise, many of the medium-market top 40s that bit the dust between '92 and '95 would still be here. And certainly The Los Angeles Times article in the wake of **Swedish Egil's** departure indicated that management wanted more listeners and advertisers, not more industry support.

None of this is to suggest that we're not proud that Airplay Monitor's charts and Broadcast Data Systems information have become the scoreboard of the industry. But we can only try to make the best possible decisions on what station works (or doesn't work) for a particular chart. We try to reflect how the industry does business, not dictate it. Industry relationships ought to be deeper than reporting status. If they're not, they need to be re-examined.

Groove Radio was **Swedish Egil's** second stint at **KACD/KBCD**: he programmed it in 1992 when it was **Mars Radio**, another station that industryites loved but that never reached critical mass with listeners. It seems like a safe bet that he'll return with something equally cutting edge. In the meantime, although the Times story indicated that the PD planned to continue his efforts on the Internet, **Swedish Egil** is a man without a radio station. And, unfortunately, that's an even more telling barometer of whom one's friends are in the business.

"**Woody**" **Harrison** picks up P/T at **WZPL** Indianapolis while waiting for that next fulltime gig.

Former **WYXR** (Star 104.5) Philadelphia MD **Joe Proke** resurfaces as music and marketing coordinator of jazz sister **WJJZ**.

New modern **AC KOSO** (B93) Modesto, Calif., taps **Jeremy Burgess** for morning co-host from country **KRST** Albuquerque, N.M. Middayer **Marty Lanser** and p.m. driver **Rob Kacey** will exit and can be reached through PD **Max Miller**.

Now, consider what's happening at country. After rebounding slightly in the winter for only the second time in an otherwise continuous slide since fall '92, country was down again in the spring, 10.6-10.4, for its lowest 12-plus number since the summer of 1990. Country is flat in 35-64 at an 11.9 share and off only slightly in 25-54 (10.9-10.7). But it's down noticeably in 18-34 (10.0-9.6), and particularly among teens (7.6-6.7).

Country has now trailed AC among teens for a year and a half. But the 6.7 share was its lowest teen number since winter 1992 B.C.—Before Cyrus—when Billy Ray gave the format a bona fide teen idol. Then again, the country/rock flavor that seemed to coincide with a 12-34 jump at a format not traditionally known for younger listeners has been noticeably absent in recent months, with country often sounding a lot more like the ballad- and midtempo-dominated format that it was in the mid-'80s.

BUYERS DON'T CARE. WHY SHOULD I?

Advertisers still target 25-54, of course, and so do country and AC stations. So the news of their young-end fluctuations might not seem to make much difference for either. But the numbers show that 12-24 can make a difference in a format's momentum and critical mass. And country record sales were never as strong as they were in the era when teen listening was higher (it reached double digits in '94).

Country and AC differ from top 40 and R&B radio in that there's little history of automatic teen usage. R&B and top 40 have always managed some teen numbers even though both have discouraged teens at various times and top 40 has fallen from more than a 50 share in teens in 1990 to less than 30% of teen listening today, due to several years when the format suffered from severe "25-54-itis."

R&B radio, through much of 1995-96, achieved a record-high number with each successive national ratings book. It was flat in the winter, but in the spring, R&B was up 10.9-11.0 for another record 12-plus number, and it was third overall, ahead of country (No. 4). R&B was off slightly in the teen demo (24.3-24.0), although it remained a solid No. 2 there, but it set records in 25-54 (10.5-10.7) and 35-64 (8.5-8.8), as well as with adult women (10.8-10.9).

R&B's upper-demo growth took place despite the fact that adult R&B stations, when examined separately, were flat at a 3.7 share 12-plus, suggesting that the adult rise was at mainstream R&B radio. So maybe despite the publicity that hip-hop generated during the spring, the format got an equal boost

from the "Love Jones" soundtrack and all the other retro-flavored R&B music released as part of the format's neoprogressive movement.

In fifth place, top 40 was up 8.4-8.8, its best number since fall '95. Top 40 was flat in 35-64 (at a 4.4 share), and at night (11.6), but up nicely in every other daypart and demo. It went 27.8-28.9 in the teen demo, 12.9-13.4 in 18-34, and 7.0-7.2 in 25-54. Top 40 was up 7.6-7.9 in mornings, 7.0-7.4 in mid-days, and 9.1-9.4 in afternoons.

It's worth noting that even in this era of top 40 again playing teen-appeal music, from Hanson, Spice Girls, the Backstreet Boys, and others, the format's biggest audience bulge is in 25-34, where it gets 25.5% of its listening, vs. 21.9% for teens and 23.4% in 18-24. Almost 25% of top 40's listening is from those over 35 years old. R&B also has its bulge in 25-34 (25.5%). AC has it in 35-44 (25.9%). Country has an even spread past age 25; its bulge is also in 35-44 (22.1%). Modern rock's bulge is in 25-34 (34.3%), despite its reputation as an 18-24 format.

ROCK REBOUNDS, CLASSICS STABLE

Album rock, which fell to its lowest point in the winter, came back 6.7-7.0, for sixth place, with its biggest rebound in 25-54 (8.1-8.6). While album and classic rock have tended to trade off good books, the ninth-place classic rock format was up slightly, 4.5-4.6, for its best book ever. The format also cracked the 5-share range for the first time in middays and afternoons (up 4.9-5.0 in both).

Even though the oldies format rebounded 6.0-6.3 in the spring from its lowest number in recent memory, format observers worry that its bulge is in the 45-54 demo (34.1% of its listening), while its 18-34-demo shares have dropped from the 5s to the 3s since '95, leading many to wonder if the format will become hard to sell in the same way that easy listening was 10-15 years ago. Classic rock seems to have a lot to do with oldies' demo shift. Many of today's classic rock stations evolved from '70s oldies and carried the 18-34s with them. Classic rock's bulge is in 35-44 (37.4%).

Tied with oldies for seventh place is Spanish radio, flat at a 6.3 share 12-plus. Spanish is up in mornings (6.1-6.5), off at nights (6.8-6.4), and flat during the rest of the day. It was off with teens (5.3-4.8) but up in 25-54 (6.6-6.8) and 35-64 (5.9-6.2).

In 10th place, modern rock has been stable at a 4.1 share for three consecutive books, down only a few tenths from its peak of a 4.4 share in early '96, despite the format's negative press. Modern's female numbers, the ones you might expect to be the hardest hit by modern AC, were at worst stymied at a relatively low level, flat in the spring at a 2.6 share, down from a peak of 2.9. With men, meanwhile, the format was up 4.6-4.7 this time, but short of modern's 5.1 share last spring.

Adult standards stations, which have grown sharply in number recently, didn't expand their audience during the spring; they were flat at a 3.5 share, followed by jazz (flat at 3.1), religious stations (flat at 2.2), and classical (2.0-1.9).

MONITOR PROFILE

Adams Hits The Mark As Fresno's B95 Returns To Its Rhythmic Roots

Paging through the spring Arbs, we noticed almost immediately that Patterson Broadcasting's rhythmic top 40 KBOS (B95) Fresno, Calif., holds the No. 1 title in most of our favorite demos, including adults 18-34, as well as every female demo, 12-54. B95 is No. 5 with 25-54 adults and is knocking on the door of 12-plus dominance, only a tenth of a point behind market leader, N/T KMJ.

PD Mark Adams recalls the winding road that started in 1988 at KJBR Jonesboro, Ark. Soon thereafter, he made the jump of his life to nights at the late KOY-FM (Y95) Phoenix. After a stint as APD/MD of KKXX Bakersfield, Calif., Adams followed PD Steve Wall to become APD/MD nights at XHTZ (Z90) San Diego. After a mass blowout, he landed across the street at KKLQ (Q106). Three years ago, he got the call from then B95 PD Don Parker to become his second-in-command. Four months later, Parker was gone, taking the PD spot at what's now KTBZ (the Buzz) Houston.

Adams credits Parker (now PD of KKFR Phoenix) for grooming him for his first programming assignment. "Don pulled me into

the inner circle from day one," recalls Adams. "He involved me in everything, from scheduling music to brainstorming promotions. I was a part of the daily decision-making process, which I feel helped me win the respect of the staff." His next move was to position himself as B95's go-to guy. "I realize it can be extremely awkward when a PD is promoted from within the ranks, but I had worked from day one to be perceived as management material, not just as a jock. I wanted people to look to me as someone who had answers," he says. Besides, he adds, it helps to set a professional example going in. "If your fellow jocks have seen you one too many times face down in pool of vomit, chances are there's going to be some respect issues if and when you're promoted to their boss."

Adams recently added PD duties for sister AM sports outlet KCBI (the Ball), the local affiliate of the Los Angeles Dodgers and San Francisco 49ers. B95's other roommate is active rocker KRZR. 





One In A Million Times Two: Aaliyah Strikes Double Platinum; Summer/Fall Tour To Hit The Road In August

ONE IN A MILLION, the current album from Blackground/Atlantic recording artist Aaliyah, has been certified double platinum by the RIAA for U.S. sales in excess of 2,000,000 units. Released last August, the album has spent 41 weeks in both the Billboard 200 and Top R&B Albums charts. *ONE IN A MILLION* debuted in the top 5 on the national R&B chart and has since gone on to hit the chart's #2 position; it is also a top 20 hit on the Billboard 200. *ONE IN A MILLION*, the artist's second consecutive million-plus selling album, teams Aaliyah with a cast of talented young producers, including Timbaland, Missy Elliott, Kay-Gee, Vincent "V.H." Herbert & Craig King, Jermaine Dupri, Rodney Jerkins, J. Dibbs, and Daryl Simmons.

Aaliyah hit the #1 spot on the Billboard R&B chart with the first track from the album, "If Your Girl Only Knew," also a #11 hit on Billboard's "Hot 100." "One In A Million," the album's title track and second single, spent eight consecutive weeks at #1 on Billboard's "Hot R&B

Airplay" chart and hit #2 on the Billboard "Rhythm Crossover Airplay" chart. The song's companion clip saw Heavy rotation on MTV, BET, and The Box, in addition to being in Custom rotation on VH1. The third single from *ONE IN A MILLION*, "4 Page Letter," was another urban and crossover success for Aaliyah, hitting the Top 10 on Billboard Monitor's "R&B Mainstream" chart. The "4 Page Letter" companion video remains in Recurrent rotation on MTV and Heavy rotation on the Box.

Aaliyah has appeared on *The Tonight Show with Jay Leno*, *Vibe TV*, *Live! Regis & Kathie Lee*, and *Showtime at the Apollo*. Next up is a tour of North America with Mary J. Blige, Ginuwine, and Dru Hill, kicking off on August 28th and running through the fall.

The New York-born singer's 1994 debut album, *AGE AIN'T NOTHING BUT A NUMBER*, racked up RIAA platinum and spawned a pair of gold singles. "Back & Forth" was a top 5 pop hit with a three-week #1 reign on the nation's R&B chart; "At Your Best (You Are Love)" brought top 10 pop success and a #2 R&B hit.
