Do PD Gripes About Arbitron Sampling Apply To Callout Too?

PDs have long complained about their frustrations with Arbitron sampling. Record reps have long complained about what they see as radio's over-reliance on callout research. But RCA's Dave Loncao raised an interesting question during a recent discussion with *Airplay Monitor*: Why do PDs complain about Arbitron but then quote religiously from callout, which is also subject to the vagaries of sampling?


"I sympathize with them," says Lon-

cao of PDs. "They have to use as archaic a form of research as Arbitron... about which radio always complains. It's no different on the radio side."

Loncao, who says he's been on the receiving end of research calls and was "floored" by the amount of feedback he was supposed to give, as well as by the researcher voicing his own bias, feels auditorium testing gives a more accurate read on music. Since most PDs aren't likely to find weekly auditorium tests practical, Loncao says, "I understand that [callout is] the cheapest and best ongoing way for radio stations

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



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Burbank's B100 Making Multiple Moves

Looks like KIBB (B100) Los Angeles PD Tony Coles will soon need a Thomas Guide to find the restroom. Current plans call for B100 to move out of the Burbank, Calif., studios it shares with KYSR (Star 98.7); Coles would end up with three offices: his old one in Burbank, where traffic and production will remain; one in suburban Glendale, where B100 will share studio space with AC KBIG; and one in the same L.A. building that houses Chancellor R&B KKBT (the Beat), where B100 GM Ed Krampf and sales and promotions will be based.

Unofficially, B100's move seems to have been prompted, at least in part, by the fact that KYSR's yet-to-be-confirmed new morning guy, Jonathon Brandmeier, would reportedly require more alleged square footage for a customized studio.

BUSINESS: CLEAR PROMOTIONS

Clear Channel has announced a new management structure, dividing its stations into four regions, each under a senior VP. George Sosson will oversee Clear Channel's east region, Stan Webb its central stations, between Tennessee and Texas. Jim Smith will oversee western stations as well as networks and international holdings. Peter Ferrara, former COO of Granum, now oversees the Florida stations that Clear Channel is buying from Paxson.

WRVW (the River) Nashville gets three new sister stations as parent SFX Broadcasting (soon to be Capstarized) picks up crosstown WLAC-AM-FM and WJZC from Sinclair Broadcast Group. The acquisition of WLAC is subject to Department of Justice review, followed by an LMA within 30-60 days, says WRVW PD Charlie Quinn.

Capstar also picks up modern adult KOSO (B93) Modesto, Calif. That station unveils the last pieces of its new lineup this week as night host Paul Browning adds APD stripes and moves to afternoons. Jack Paper joins for nights from modern KSLY San Luis Obispo, Calif.

WKQR (Q102) Cincinnati VP/GM Jim Bryant is promoted to market manager for American Radio Systems, Cincinnati, which includes Q102, oldies WGRR, and the soon-to-be-acquired WMMA in nearby Lebanon.

Mary Norman is the new GM for WJOI (Kiss FM) Memphis, the new top 40 that signed on Aug. 28, as tipped here last week. Norman was GM for sister children's outlet WOWW.

PD Chris Kerr exits Saga's modern adult WXPT (the Point) Milwaukee after three months. Packages to GM Tom Joerres or consultant Dave Beasing. Call Kerr at 414-466-4890; E-mail: CK1017@aol.com.

Former KQKS (KS107.5) Denver PD Mark Feather is driving the U-Haul to California as we speak. Look for him to pull over and get gas in Bakersfield (insert joke here), where rumors of a top 40 start-up are circulating. Meanwhile, KS107.5 replaces mixer John Dickenson with the syndicated Hot Mix.

KUCD Honolulu flips from jazz to modern adult as Star 101.9. Mahlon Moore remains PD, and the station is running jockless for now.

Hot AC WQPO (Q101) Harrisonburg, Va., returns to top 40 under consultant Bill Hennes.

New hot AC KCVM (Mix 96) Waterloo, Iowa, launches under PD Jamie Philips, formerly PD at crosstown top 40 KOKZ. He'll also do mornings with station manager/newsman Jim Coloff; middays is new talent Vicki St. James; afternoon/promotions duties are given to Brandy Seals from morning co-host at crosstown country KKCX; and nights are handled by Jeff Michaels, who performs double duties at sister N/T KCNZ.

KXXS Yakima, Wash., flips from country to hot AC. PD Bob Reece and the airstaff remain.

Duncan Payton, PD/MD of adult top 40 KRUZ Santa Barbara, Calif., is promoted to senior director of programming and music.

Former KDON Salinas, Calif., PD Jennifer Wilde is now available for her next gig. Call her at 408-449-2371.

PEOPLE: LUNDY, BROWN STEP DOWN

Legendary oldies WCBS-FM New York midday talent Ron Lundy, a veteran of the top 40 days of WABC, has announced his retirement after 31 years. Also announcing his retirement was Charlie Brown, morning host at classic hits KJR-FM Seattle, but also morning host at crosstown KJR-AM and KUBE at various points. And after 35 years in radio, KBIG Los Angeles MD Dave Verdery will retire with the station's pending sale by Bonneville to Chancellor.

Modern adult WTMX Chicago midday guy Dave Hilton exits after 15 years. P.m. driver Brian Peck moves to middays. Dave Fogel, from rock sister WLUP, joins for afternoons.

Larry Stevens, who had initially planned to join modern AC WBAM Montgomery, Ala., last year, before a noncompete got in the way, joins PD Trish Stevens in mornings. Marty Blair moves to Stevens' old midday shift.

WWMX (Mix 106.5) Baltimore hires Ria Morgan for middays. She comes from triple-A WBOS Boston by way of a pit stop at WXHT Portsmouth, N.H. Morgan replaces Tamara Nelson, now doing morning news and successor to Julie DeHarty, who relocated to Dallas. KZQZ (Z95.7) San Francisco fills late nights with Kevin Scott, night jock at WNVZ (Z104) Norfolk, Va.

At adult top 40 WKTI Milwaukee, morning hosts Bob Reitman and Gene Mueller renew their contracts. Also renewing, Rick Dees with Radio Today, which will continue to do promotion and affiliate relations for Dees' CD Media.

Modern adult WLNK (the Link) Charlotte, N.C., inks Beth Ann McBride for middays, replacing Angie Payne. McBride comes from the same shift at crosstown WNKS and a short stint at country WTDR.

Rhythmic top 40 KHTN (Hot 105) Modesto, Calif., inks former KSIQ Imperial Valley, Calif., PD Dangerous Dan Watson for mornings, replacing Mark Medina. Ryan Cota remains aboard as producer/sidekick.

WAOA (WA1A) Melbourne, Fla., hires former WZYP Huntsville, Ala., P/T Brad Newman for nights, replacing Rich O'Brien, who returned to program WMGI Terre Haute, Ind.

WCIL Carbondale, Ill., picks up the syndicated Steve and DC morning show, replacing John Riley.

WRTS (Star 103.7) Erie, Pa., moves night host Marc Richards to mornings, replacing Shane Taylor, who exited to join AC WWSH Pittsburgh for mornings. WKSE (Kiss 98.5) Buffalo, N.Y., late-nighter Brian B. Wild replaces Richards in nights. A search for a morning co-host is still on.

Rival WJET (Jet 102) inks Dino Robataille for MD/afternoons, from overnights at WIXX Green Bay, Wis. After three days on afternoons, Craig Warvel returns to mornings with Deb Ireland and Dangerboy Dave Leroy.

Midday host Brenda Jagger adds MD duties at hot AC WSUL Monticello, N.Y. PD Josh Summers had also handled the MD job.

At KLRS Chico, Calif., which flipped last week from satellite hot AC to mainstream top 40 as "Colors 92.7," former newsguy Joe Wosik is now solo in mornings; local fave Sally Foxx handles 10-noon, followed by Eric B., a veteran of KSFM Sacramento, Calif. PD Chris Cair is currently pulling the marathon 4-10 p.m. shift.

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Hip-Hop Permeates R&B Radio And Beyond

At various points this summer, there have been as many as 14 records by rap artists on Airplay Monitor's mainstream R&B chart. That's more than a third of the 40-position chart, and it doesn't even include records by non-rap artists that just happened to feature rappers.

Even allowing for the tendency of some R&B PDs to jam harder during the summer, rap's presence on the R&B charts is much stronger than last summer. A year ago, there were five rap acts on the mainstream R&B chart; two weeks ago, there were five rappers in the top 10—all of which shows just how much further obscured the lines between R&B and hip-hop have become.

Some of this is because the R&B charts themselves now include WQHT (Hot 97) New York, KMEL San Francisco, and other hip-hop-friendly stations, but there were also changes throughout the format. The success of young-end R&B outlets like Hot 97 sent a wakeup call throughout the format, both generating new younger-leaning start-ups and forcing a number of more traditional mainstream outlets to try to head them off at the pass.

A typical story: In 1992-93, WUSL (Power 99) Philadelphia tried to ignore the then rap-heavy WIOQ (Q102). This year, when WPHI (Philly 103.9) came along, WUSL was already leaning younger. Mid-'90s crossover outlets liked to say they acknowledged hip-hop, while their competitors played Regina Belle and Freddie Jackson ballads. Now, save for an occasional Mint Condition or Kenny Lattimore record, you're hard-pressed to find a lot of traditional balladry on mainstream R&B radio. In fact, even adult R&B radio gets much of its new music from Maxwell, Erykah Badu, and other artists who meld hip-hop and traditional R&B influences.

The musical changes began around 1992-93. At that point, rap and ballads sold and tested well. Uptempo R&B often did not. Looking back, it now seems that R&B and rap could have split along generation lines, similar to the birth of rock'n'roll. Instead, Mary J. Blige's "Real Love" showed that R&B could appropriate elements of hip-hop, not just vice versa. And on the title track of "What's The 411?," she proved that divas could rap, too (not that Teena Marie did a bad job on "Square Biz," 12 years earlier). From then, R&B and rap were more intertwined than ever.

It was also around this time that the "posse cut"—in which a rapper was joined by multiple guests and verbal athleticism was more

important than radio-friendly hooks—began its journey from the B-side to the front lines. Combine these developments, and we now have "Not Tonight," a top five crossover and R&B hit starring three rappers, a New York DJ, and a singer/rapper who insists on doing both, lest she be confused with Patti LaBelle.

Actually, there's little danger of anybody being confused with Patti these days, including, to some extent, Ms. LaBelle herself, who has always been willing to duke it out with newer artists on their own turf, something she does nicely on "When You Talk About Love." As for the current hits by the women who could inherit R&B's diva mantle, Blige's "Everything" and Mariah Carey's "Honey" owe more to dancehall (dub-flavored tracks, sparse melodies, a combination of singing and rapping, and the appropriation of several other songs), than they do to Patti, Aretha, Diana, etc. And while a 35-year industry veteran like LaBelle would, by necessity, have to reinvent herself, Carey's career was only a few years along when she decided to stake out her hip-hop/R&B credentials, even if it meant some AC stations couldn't play all her hits.

Two years ago, as a result of hits like "Real Love" and "Dreamlover," we seemed to have a pretty good supply of mid- to uptempo R&B records that had enough hip-hop elements to appeal to both constituencies ("Creep," "I Wanna Be Down," "This Is How We Do It," "Candy Rain," "Freak Like Me," etc.) There are only a few of those at the moment, although so far I'm willing to attribute that solely to the ever-changing product cycle. One wonders if that type of song would make it easier for R&B records to break through at mainstream top 40 these days, although hip-hop's presence at that format, between "Men In Black," "Mo Money Mo Problems," and "I'll Be Missing You" is also greater than it's been in a few years.

The irony, of course, is that even if mainstream top 40 PDs played no R&B crossovers, they'd still be playing hip-hop, sorta. After Tom Cochrane's "Life Is A Highway," hip-hop's beats and loops became common in pop/rock. By 1993-94, they were heard even at soft AC. And last year, they were particularly noticeable in modern rock. Top 40 PDs who were truly scared of hip-hop would have to avoid "Semi-Charmed Life," "Quit Playing Games (With My Heart)," "Sunny Came Home," "Bitch," "Coco Jambo," and "Fly." The end of summer will tell, of course, but R&B PDs, for their part, seem to no longer be steering clear of hip-hop at all.

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20 Staffers Pink-Slipped In Enclave Closure

MUSICAL CHAIRS: Although it appeared that the Enclave was spared the ax when EMI closed its doors in June, the label has now closed down, leaving 20 staffers looking for other employment. Here are the names and contact numbers of the available promotion people: senior director of promotion **Mark Abramson** (212-974-2360); national alternative promotion person **John Bauccio** (718-625-2595); national triple-A promotion guy **Rich Robinson** (732-345-9231); Southwest regional **Mari Dew** (972-788-4991); Northeast regional **Dara Kravitz** (212-645-9826); and Midwest regional **Chelle Robinson** (630-372-7335). The Enclave's West Coast regional **Hilaire Brosio** has already landed at Elektra as national director of rock promotion, West Coast. Recording act **World Party** will also shift from the Enclave to Virgin. The fate of the Enclave's other remaining artists, including **Belle & Sebastian**, **Sloan**, **Fluffy**, and **September 67**, is still pending.

Sony/550 Music awards VP of promotion stripes to **Joel Klaiman** and **Desiree Schuon**. They were, respectively, VP of alternative and VP of pop.

Mercury hires former PolyGram Group Distribution sales rep **John Landers** as its Dallas regional. Elsewhere at Mercury, **Chris Lopes'** former assistant **Brian Courville** moves from Los Angeles to New York and is upped to national manager of college promotion.

Look for the picture of Elektra national crossover director **Tom Maffei** modeling a designer sweater on page 242 of this month's Details magazine.

DISSOLVING DEALS: According to Billboard Bulletin, Interscope will pay Trauma between \$3 million-\$5 million to end its joint venture. **No Doubt** will record for Interscope, but Trauma will receive royalties from the band's next two releases. Trauma retains the rest of its roster, including **Bush**. Billboard Bulletin also reports that Geffen and Almo Sounds have mutually decided to dissolve their pressing and distribution deal... Roadrunner and Next Plateau have dissolved their joint-venture agreement.

ARTIST MONITOR: **Deborah Gibson**, the artist formerly known as Debbie, joins the Broadway cast of "Beauty And The Beast" Sept. 24... **Real McCoy's** latest single, "(If You're Not In It For Love) I'm Outta Here," was originally a single by country singer **Shania Twain**... **LeAnn Rimes** is the latest celebrity to model a milk mustache for the American Dairy Assn.'s "Got Milk?" campaign... **Erykah Badu** used to be known as "MC Apple"... "Trendy" by **Reel Big Fish** has been adopted by baseball's Florida Marlins, a telltale sign that ska has now crossed into the mainstream consciousness.

Letters: Anybody With A Stick Deserves Product

I just read [Top 40 Topics] in the [Aug. 22] Monitor, and I just wanted to say bravo!

As a promotion person for 10 years in several markets, I have seen the whole "reporter" thing bite people on the ass on several occasions. I was lucky. First, I had common sense, but more importantly I learned from the beginning from people like Jeff Appleton and Danny Buch and Andrea Ganis that if a radio station had a stick, they should be taken care of with product. I still have most of those early relationships because of that work ethic.

As a promotion person in Los Angeles, I have watched the whole [KACD] Groove Radio scenario unfold. Whether or not [former PD] Egil [Aalvik, aka Swedish Eagle] is out of work because of the lack of reporting status is debatable, but I can attest to the station's support and the benefits that can be reaped from that. Groove Radio started playing "You're Not Alone" by Olive last September off an import. It has consistently been one of their most requested records... We have sold almost 1,000 singles in the market since it was re-

leased on RCA four weeks ago. [KITS] Live 105 San Francisco added the record two weeks ago, [NETRA] 91X San Diego [added it] this week, and KROQ L.A. is testing it. None of this would have happened without the buzz that was created by Groove.

How do we combat this problem? I'm not sure if there is a solution, but writing an article like this will certainly help to bring attention to the issue... By working together, I am hoping that the future of Groove Radio is bright. They have been good to us at RCA, and if only I could clone their passion for new music! God knows, there are not many people out there looking for new artists to play. We need them!

I truly enjoyed your commentary, and I am going to use the column in my efforts to spread the love for not only Groove but radio stations like them—no matter the format.

M Street Format Monitor In 3rd Year, Modern Adult Has 59 Outlets

Depending on how you count, the modern AC format is somewhere between 2 and 3 years old. And there are already more modern adult outlets around the country than there are classical stations, according to the M Street Format Monitor's total for August.

M Street's national format tally had previously counted most modern adult stations as part of either the adult top 40 or triple-A formats. This month, it breaks them out separately and finds that there are 59 modern adult stations. M Street also moves many for-

mer '70s outlets from the oldies category to classic hits, giving that format a corresponding bump from the 10th to the ninth most-programmed format nationwide.

In other news this month, country continued to decline but maintained its firm hold on the No. 1 slot. Top 40 and modern rock remained flat, while mainstream R&B, AC, and mainstream rock declined. The combined R&B adult and R&B oldies formats continued to move forward, further opening their lead on mainstream R&B.

Do PD Complaints About Arb Sampling Apply To Callout Too?

to get a read on the gut calls they've made in their current categories. I hope someday that they have something that has less flaws."

So Airplay Monitor took Lonca's "Yeah, but what about callout?" question to several researchers experienced with both Arbitron and music testing. While most were quick to note no exact comparison could be made, they agreed that both forms of research were best viewed over a length of time, and that the biggest problems existed when any one cell had to be examined too closely. (We did, however, find one researcher who felt that the consequences of a potential Arbitron mistake are much higher than a corresponding problem with callout.)

And while many of us have heard, at some point, an angry PD contend that his weekly callout has a larger sample size than some contested Arbitron cell, many respondents were relatively sanguine about both methodologies. As John Sebastian, PD of country KZLA Los Angeles and a longtime callout proponent, notes, "The Arbitron methodology is not flawless, and neither is callout research, but they're both a hell of a lot better than what's second."

With both Arbitron and callout, the sample-size issue is often key to most complaints. And both researcher John Parikh and Sebastian say more is better only up to a point. As Parikh explains, "The standard error for 100 is fairly high in statistics. For each 100 you increase the sample size, you get more accuracy, until 500." After 500, every increase of 100 people only slightly improves accuracy; therefore, "a sample of 100,000 is only slightly more accurate than one of 1,000, but as you increase from 100 to 500, accuracy increases 30%-40%."

That's why Sebastian believes that while a typical callout research sample is much smaller than what Arbitron uses, statistically, if the right demographic cells are covered and the information is interpreted correctly, the results should be extremely accurate.

But, as many researchers note, the proper sample sizes aren't always there. While consultant Liz Janik believes that the correct number of respondents is never less than 50, and should really be 80-100, she thinks stations—driven by a "lowest price" mentality and an over-reliance on interns as researchers—often miss that mark. "I see examples of 12-30 people representing the entire market," she says.

Janik also bemoans stations calling a set list of listeners who eventually lose their impartiality and become "professional respondents." Saga VP and Arbitron Advisory Council member Steve Goldstein also believes that "radio station databases by and large are composed of contest winners. That's a very small segment and skewed view of the average listener."

ALL THINGS IN TIME

Across the board, the people we spoke with believe that both research tools are more likely to be accurate over a longer period of time. And both are most vulnerable to the vagaries of sample size in the individual cells. "It says right on the front cover [of the Arbitron book] that those are estimates, and that's always important to keep in mind," says Goldstein. "What they're doing is reporting a snapshot, and they don't always get it right," but over time, the picture becomes clearer.

"It's the same with callout," Goldstein continues. "We have weeks when the callout looks unusual. We trend them over several weeks, and we do the same thing with ratings books. Then you're adding in more sample, and more sample means more stability."

"Looking at something over four to six weeks with well-done callout is effective in showing what they like, familiarity, and what they dislike," says Parikh. "When you get in trouble is when you want to look at, say, females 25-54, then the sample is back down to 20 people," and then you start to seriously erode accuracy.

Likewise, he says, "Arbitron is pretty darn good with the [overall] cume of radio stations. When you subdivide that, though, you run into problems. If you're talking about a radio station and you're talking about their 25- to 34-year-old fe-

male, there may only be 18-19 of them representing the entire market."

WHAT'S BETWEEN THE LINES?

With all research proponents having long claimed that research must be used only as one weapon in a quiver, there are still differing views of how much a user can read into either Arbitron or callout. Goldstein says that "there are a lot of new tools that Arbitron has that makes it a lot easier to diagnose what happened in the book. We used to look at rankers. Now we can get in farther and look month to month, compare P1s to P2s, do geographic tracking. We can really start pulling [the book] apart, and we do a great deal of that, because if we had a great book, I want to know what's driving it."

But with music testing, Goldstein says, "you're asking people to quantify something entertainment-oriented. It's akin to a movie. How do you rate a movie on a 1-5 scale?" For that reason, he says, callout is best trusted to show extremes, say the five best or worst titles.

Bolton Research's Ted Bolton adds, "If I'm doing callout and I find people very much dislike a record I'm playing, it's at the bottom of the list, I have very much certainty that the record should not be on my radio station. If it kicks ass week after week, that is something that I have fair certainty about. The problem is in the middle."

DIFFERING CONSEQUENCES

While Lonca would probably differ, Parikh also believes the consequences of a callout wobble are less than they are with Arbitron. "The consequences of making a mistake if you're a PD and you get off a record too soon are not that high. The consequences of not adding a great record are really quite low. [You] can add it and usually catch the wave. . . . The consequences of making mistakes on callout are not extreme, usually. They are extreme if you play the wrong record too many times."

But with ratings, "a couple of bad books as a result of sampling error can really hurt a radio station," Parikh says. He remembers a West Coast client that was consistently hitting 4 shares. "All of a sudden, we had a 0.7 month, followed by a 0.9 month. By the end of the second month, heads were getting ready to roll," he remembers. Management was having daily meetings on what they should do. Parikh suggested that they do nothing. "We got a 4.5 the next month, and the PD said to me, 'I suddenly got so smart in 30 days.'"

BOUVARD'S PERSPECTIVE

Arbitron GM Pierre Bouvard's two stints with the ratings research firm were separated by a stretch at Coleman Research, so he sees a lot of parallels. Just as a PD may use callout as an excuse to deal with a crush of record folks, media buyers are also facing too many pitches for too few availabilities. He's also seen interest in both ratings and callout proliferate. "Ten to 15 years ago, weekly callout was the exception rather than the norm. Now, you open up any trade, and there's an ad saying 'testing real well in call-out.' It's part of the nomenclature," he says. Similarly, as more PDs attend Arbitron's training seminars, Bouvard says, there's a greater recognition that PDs need both creativity and science on their side.

Bouvard acknowledges the inherent difficulty of mixing art and science. But he also says that PDs can strike a balance. "One thing I learned at Coleman Research is the difference between perceptual and behavioral research," he says. Perceptual is six months out in front of behavioral. If a station has been down on its luck and a new PD comes in and freshens things up, the perceptual will say you've turned this thing around, but the behavior will take six to nine months to catch up."

He recommends using perceptual to aid in decision-making and then watching the ratings for listener reaction. "Say you do a perceptual study and find the [traditional] sound for AC is eroding badly and the modern AC thing is happening," he says. "I'm going to make the decision to evolve away from traditional stuff toward modern AC. And then I'm going to sit back for the next year and see from a ratings perspective how I'm going to do."

MONITOR PROFILE

Dave Shakes Up Conventional Wisdom; Teaches Success In New World Order

I wanted to become a teacher," Dave Shakes says simply of his January 1996 decision to leave the day-to-day programming ranks and join consulting firm Alan Burns & Associates.

Shakes was originally propelled to national recognition as PD of WBBM-FM (B96) Chicago from 1990-93, where, at its height, the station reached a 6.9 12-plus. He later segued to KMEL San Francisco, during its transition from Century Broadcasting to Evergreen, and, later, moved over to sister AC KIOI (K101).

To smooth the initial transition from on-site PD to the big-picture world of consulting, Shakes took some sales courses. "I needed to be able to sell my business in a world where I would now have many different bosses," he says. Just like an actual salesperson, Shakes felt his delivery needed some fine-tuning. "I needed to be able to change my message style, depending on who I was addressing," he adds.

Fast-forward 18 months, and life on the other side has solidified nicely for Mr.

he says. "The more narrow you define your target, the more passion you can evoke for your product." Targeting, say, "a 29-year-old female from the suburbs . . . actually makes your job as a programmer very easy. Every decision about music and promotions is then filtered through that screener. You should have a finite idea of who you want to turn on to your station, and that must be communicated to not only the airstaff but the entire chain of command."

Shakes also encourages clients to steer all aspects of their presentation, including copy, toward a benefit, rather than a feature, point of view. Example of a feature: "You're giving away tickets to see 'Men In Black.'" Benefit: "You'll be among the first 100 people in this city to see 'Men In Black.'" "Often when something is stated as a feature, it just lays there unless you can sell it as a benefit," says Shakes, who feeds all liners and promos through his "bullshit detector." "After reading it, I ask the question, 'What's in it for me?' If the copy answers that question, you've just written a benefit-oriented liner."


It seems like for the past decade or so, everyone we know can quote marketing and warfare principles from Trout and Ries. Shakes now quotes freely from a new book he's been touting called "The 500 Year Delta," by Jim Taylor and Watts Wacker. "As it relates to our business, it says that consumers rule the roost, not the producer," he says. The book goes on to suggest that in the new, post-consolidation economic climate, two clearly defined types of workers will emerge—owners and temps. "There are two courses of action you can take: freak out, stick your head in the sand, and hope it goes away, or you can deal with it, end up thriving, and become happier than you've ever been in your career," Shakes says. For anyone experiencing nervousness and apprehension about this new world order, Shakes has a New Year's resolution for you to chant in your car: "I will take charge of myself." "I talk to owners and GMs every day who are actively looking for people with that very attitude," he says.

Sure, it seems like the job market is shrinking and consolidating right now, but many industry observers see an uptrend coming. "It's like what the computer industry went through," he says. "The first wave is the hardware phase, followed by the expansive software phase."

"Throughout history, each time a new form of entertainment came out, it affected the way people used the existing media. The advent of movies changed vaudeville, TV changed radio, and now so has the Internet, especially with the short-attention-span 12-34 demo, who now expect to be able to hit a button and receive instant gratification," he says.

Even within these new broadcasting conglomerates, Shakes observes a level playing field. "With all of the research and other tools available today, everybody knows where the hits are," he says. "The way to truly win today is by employing a unique, distinctive point of view. We're coming back to an era of programmers who have a vision, a flair. Just like a great chef who has a signature dish, the advantage will ultimately go to whichever of these new broadcast companies can best support these chefs."

Shakes, now firmly ensconced in Alan Burns' San Francisco office, for now conveniently located near Shakes' kitchen. When not airborne, he's tending to a client list that now contains mainstream top 40s, soft ACs, Spanish-language stations, and the most outwardly visible signs of his success: modern adult outlets KZZO (the Zone) Sacramento, Calif.; KMXB (Mix 94.1) Las Vegas; and WMBX Richmond, Va.

Although modern adult is still making up its own rules, Shakes believes he enjoys an advantage in this fledgling format by applying lessons learned from his rhythm-crossover days. "We realize how important it is to be on the street, reacting to our listeners," he says. Another advantage crossover PDs had was understanding a market's unique personality. "They didn't get crazy from peer pressure when they saw a record on some chart that they weren't playing," he says. "Many mainstream top 40 PDs haven't had that type of experience, and, along with today's modern adult programmers, are now learning a whole new set of skills." Shakes then wonders aloud if it's just a coincidence that the PDs of successful modern adult outlets KMXB (Mike Marino) and KZZO (Carly Ferreri) both cut their teeth in rhythmic radio.

Part of Shakes' role as a teacher/coach is showing PDs how to read those signals in their own markets. "Many stations make the mistake of chasing a demo instead of a target listener," he says. The longstanding radio joke that "25-54 isn't a demo, it's a family reunion" is now "becoming less and less funny, because nobody seems to get it,"




