Indie-Promo Panel Stirs Most Talk At NAB Show

A contentious panel on independent record promotion was one of the most-talked-about sessions at the National Assn. of Broadcasters' Radio Show, held Sept. 12-14 in Seattle.

Panelist Mitch Glazier, senior VP and legislative counsel for the Recording Industry Assn. of America, said the RIAA's goal with regard to independent promotion is to get the FCC to "set fair rules where they haven't before. We're asserting that the effect of the independent promotion system, as it stands today, is unfair."

Attorney Rick Bernthal of the Washington, D.C., firm Latham & Watkins told Glazier, "What you're really

objecting to here is that, for the first time in history, the radio industry now has bargaining power equal to or greater than labels [as a result of consolidation]. That is what's hard for [the record industry] to accept."

Tom Barsanti, senior VP/GM of independent promotion firm Jeff McClusky & Associates, said, "One thing we'll all agree on is that it's difficult to break music, but we work very hard to do that. We feel a little bit victimized by the darts thrown at our target. We feel we're part of the solution, not the problem."

Glazier responded by saying the nature of indie promotion had changed from "getting a buzz going around the country to very, very large groups with national playlists. When you have control, through exclusive relationships, of 60% of the rock stations in the country, the power you have . . . puts us in a very vulnerable position. Instead of the value of pitching, now you have the

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CC Reorganizes Programming SVPs

Clear Channel is reorganizing its radio programming divisions under seven senior VPs, based on geographic regions. Effective Oct. 1, the new programming senior VPs are **Dave Lange**, Northeast region; **Harve Alan**, mid-Atlantic region; **Marc Chase**, Southeast region; **Gene Romano**, Midwest region; **Jack Evans**, Northwest region; **Steve Smith**, Southwest and West Coast regions; and **Bill Richards**, Southwest/Central region. The company will soon appoint 40 regional VPs of programming.

Those "radio senior VPs" will be paired off with "product senior VPs" in the same regions: **Dave Lange** (Northeast), **Jim Shea** (mid-Atlantic), **Peter Ferrara** (Southeast), **Dave Crowl** (Midwest), **Jay Meyers** (Northwest), **J.D. Freeman** (Southwest), **Charlie Rahilly** (West Coast), and **John Cullen** (Southwest).

Meanwhile, Clear Channel/Salt Lake City hires former Citadel executive **Stuart Stanek** as VP/market manager, replacing **Tom Sly**, who recently exited. Stanek will oversee the cluster's seven stations, including top 40 **KZHT** and **KISN**.

Paul Fiddick returns to radio as president of Emmis International. The former head of Heritage Media was last with the U.S. Dept. of Agriculture.

ANOTHER CC RIVAL KISSES OFF

Cumulus-owned adult R&B **WSIS** Savannah, Ga., relinquishes the Kiss moniker, after a 10-month court battle with Clear Channel. WSIS had been using the Kiss moniker for several years, when Clear Channel decided to exert its claim to owning the name nationally. WSIS is presently using only its call letters as an identifier.

SALES FIGURES JUMP IN JULY

The Radio Advertising Bureau reports that combined local and national radio revenue for July jumped 9% compared with the same period last year. Local revenue increased by 7% for the month, while national sales climbed 16%, compared with July 2001. For the first seven months of 2002, total radio revenue climbed 2% against the same period last year, based on a 6% increase in national figures and a 1% increase in local sales.

Charlie Lombardo, who just left the PD job at Barnstable's rock AC **WMJC** (the Island) Long Island, N.Y., resurfaces at co-owned AC **WLVG** (Love 96.1) on L.I.'s East End, replacing **Frank Aiello**.

Taken a look at the Power Playlist of adult top 40 **KIOI** (Star 101.3) San Francisco lately? That station has pumped up spins on its powers to 69 times per week and, according to reports from the market, backed off its one-time '80s lean. Meanwhile, sister **KISN** Salt Lake City segues back to adult top 40 from all-'80s.

Crossover R&B **KWPT** (the Party) Eureka, Calif., loses PD/morning host **Rico Garcia** to the night slot at new adult top 40 outlet **KHOP** (Planet 95.1) Modesto, Calif.

Modern rock **WWVV** (Wave 106.9) Savannah, Ga., which began life as a modern AC, returns to that format, repositioning itself as "Modern Hits, the new Wave 106.9." The modern format, and PD **B.J. Kinard**, move to the frequency of active rock sister **WFZH**, while **WWVV** picks up the syndicated **Bob & Sheri**. Triad/Savannah OM **Bob Neumann** assumes the Wave PD duties. Night jock **Gene Murrell** is upped to APD.

Michael Newman adds new client **WKPO** (Hot 105.9) Madison, Wis. That station also picks up new morning host **Jen Waters** from country sister **WXRO** Beaver Dam, Wis., and new P/T Dr. **Dave** from crosstown **WZEE** (Z104). Mixer **Jay "Triple-X" Thomas** becomes mix-show coordinator.

Strictly Rhythm promotion staffer **Harry Legg** becomes the VP of programming for a new company called Hollywood Intermedia and producer of a new syndicated one-hour magazine talk show, *Harrison on the Edge: The Voice of Gay America*. Legg, who continues his Strictly duties, was previously APD/MD at **WKIE** Chicago.

First An Idol, Now A Greatest Gainer

American Idol winner **Kelly Clarkson** debuts at No. 31 on mainstream top 40 with "A Moment Like This" (RCA). The track is the format's Greatest Gainer and the highest debut this week. Less than a week's airplay gave Clarkson a No. 60 debut on last week's Billboard Hot 100, making "A Moment Like This" a likely candidate for No. 1 on that chart when the commercial single is released this week. Clarkson would need to sell 140,000 singles to be No. 1 with her current airplay.

Kelly Rowland's solo debut, "Stole" (Columbia), earns Most Airplay Adds at mainstream top 40, rhythmic top 40, and crossover, as well as R&B/hip-hop and rap. The track is the highest new entry at rhythmic, where it bows at No. 29. Rowland is also heard on the No. 1 single at mainstream and rhythmic top 40, **Nelly's "Dilemma"** (Fo' Reel/Universal). That song's seven weeks on top at rhythmic tie Rowland's previous record at rhythmic: As part of **Destiny's Child**, she spent seven weeks on top with "Say My Name."

Ashanti charts her sixth single of the year at rhythmic top 40 with "Baby" (Murder Inc./AJM/IDJMG). She has charted with more singles at rhythmic so far this year than any other artist. **Ja Rule** and **P. Diddy** are tied in second place with five so far this year.

As **No Doubt** featuring **Lady Saw's** "Underneath It All" (Interscope) becomes the band's fourth top 10 mainstream top 40 hit, **Rock Steady** becomes the first album by the group to spawn three consecutive top 10s at the format.

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cost of playing, and that's very different."

Barsanti replied, "I'm not aware of a company that has a national playlist."

Emmis Communications radio division president Rick Cummings agreed. "There is no such thing as a national playlist. What this is about is fear on the part of the record labels. They've had two bad years and are heading for a third. They look for [factors to blame] but rarely look at A&R."

Later during the panel, Glazier agreed with Cummings that "the fear is real," but he noted that it's a "fear of not playing the game" and its potentially detrimental affect on a record. He also tried to strike a conciliatory note, saying, "I agree independent promotion shouldn't be and isn't the scapegoat. [The RIAA] spends much more of our time looking at piracy."

Elsewhere during the panel, Bernthal described the difference between payola, which is a federal crime, and pay-for-play, which is legal as long as the required sponsorship identification is aired. The record industry, Bernthal noted, can legally pay a station for access, research, or feedback. "These things are legitimate."

Ted Kalo, the minority deputy chief general counsel for Rep. John Conyers Jr., D-Mich., said Conyers objects to stations not complying with disclosure laws that govern pay-for-play, something Kalo said "disadvantages independent artists and labels. The more this [system] get institutionalized, [the more] you'll have the institutionalized artists [on the air], not the up-and-comers. This will hurt the record industry and radio."

Citing a recent *Airplay Monitor* story, Barsanti responded that there are now more top 20 records from independent labels than there have been in several years, "so clearly this is not the case. Independent artists are still getting played."

Cummings asked Kalo if Conyers "has ever spent a week inside a station." Kalo replied, "I'm sure he has. He's a jazz fanatic." Cummings scoffed, "Well, there you go. [Unlike jazz], this is about playing hit records for as big an audience as possible."

Kalo said, "You're saying the audience only wants vanilla but they've never tried chocolate." Barsanti shot back, "What you're saying is the federal government should decide which flavor is best." Kalo responded, "I'm here to plead with you to right your own wrongs so we don't have to do it." Noting that broadcasters point to their many different formats as proof of their diversity, Kalo said that "it's the homogeneity within each genre that's the problem."

Several audience members questioned why, as one put it, "the government thinks it's wrong for a hit to be a national hit?" Another said, "The reasons you hear the same records on every station is because that's what the people want to hear."

Kalo said, "The problem is not that it's a national hit, it's [determining] how did it get that way?"

Bernthal called Kalo's concerns about independent promotion "a red herring. You are objecting to the basic economic relationship between radio and records that has existed for 40 or 50 years," he said. "What is the harm? What is the real evil here?"

Kalo said, "The evil is [that] disclosure is not taking place."

Bernthal responded, "Say, hypothetically, a station out there is taking money for every record it plays. Isn't there a marketplace solution? If you're only playing records you're paid to play, you would die."

Cummings agreed, noting that "one-tenth of a ratings point in L.A. is worth \$8 million. There is nothing [Barsanti] can offer that even approaches [the value] of one-tenth of a ratings point."

For the first 17 or 18 years of Emmis' history, Cummings said, the company had a mandate to not deal with independent promoters. After trying out indie relationships a few years ago, however, Cummings discovered that "we did not do business differently. We did not grow horns . . .

[KPWR] Power 106 [Los Angeles] will bill \$40 million this year. Less than 1% of that comes from our indie [Jeff McClusky & Associates]." Cummings later added, "If record companies are going to pay vast sums of money to get records played, why should we not participate in that if it's not corrupt?"

But Cummings also noted that Emmis stations are allowed to make decisions on a local basis about whether to work with indies. The company's three New York stations, he said, "don't do it. They're not comfortable with it."

SHOW US YOUR LIMITS

Sam Donaldson, host of the ABC Radio Networks talk show *Live in America*, moderated a lively radio group executives session that took on voice tracking, the economy, and even Opie & Anthony. When Donaldson called voice-tracking "dishonest," Clear Channel Communications president/COO Mark Mays said, "We don't want to deceive the listeners by saying, 'We're at Broadway and Third.' We do want to talk about things like, 'There is a Seattle Seahawks game in town this weekend, and tickets are not sold out.'"

But Ed Christian, president/CEO of Saga Communications, said, "We like to have our talent be known at the [local] Piggly Wiggly," calling voice-tracking an issue radio brought on itself because "we're not attracting talent to this industry."

Entercom Communications president/CEO David Field, whose company voice-tracks only between stations in the same market cluster, said the audience will ultimately decide the fate of the practice. "If [it's] a strategy the market deems to fail, it will fail."

Execs also weighed in on the cancellation of syndicated duo Opie & Anthony for a "sex in church" stunt. Donaldson noted there has been "an inch-by-inch" easing of acceptable standards that "led to this final explosion."

Mays said, "The Opie & Anthony thing was very much over the line . . . It becomes our job to paint those lines for our talent and make sure they stay within those lines."

But Christian said the Opie & Anthony listeners "did not think [the pair] did anything wrong . . . They are mirroring the tastes of their audience, and that's a sad commentary."

After Christian asked, "Where's the line?", Mays got a big laugh when he quipped, "The door of St. Patrick's Cathedral."

Participants agreed that they saw encouraging signs on the horizon for an improved economic situation for the radio industry. Most felt that consolidation has been good for the radio business. Radio One COO Mary Catherine Sneed said, "I don't remember seven or eight years ago reading about radio in *The Wall Street Journal* or *The New York Times* [the way you do now]. Radio was a little business . . . but consolidation has made it a more important business."

Donaldson asked the panelists if consolidation has been as good for the listeners as it has been for the business. Mays said, "I'm pretty passionate that consolidation benefits all parties. I think it's absolutely good for the listeners. There are more formats than there would have been without consolidation."

But Donaldson questioned whether there is enough programming diversity, asking, "Is cookie-cutter radio a reality?" Sneed responded, "There is more diversity now than ever. It's popular within the industry to say [there] isn't, particularly on the label side, but there are . . . more artists being played today than there used to be."

Field said radio remains one of the most diverse media. "You can go to any mall in America and the same movies are playing. Every hotel has the same lineup of TV channels. Magazine racks are the same. Our industry spends millions of dollars a year researching local tastes, yet we're the ones getting bashed for being homogenous . . . It is others perpetuating slurs on our industry."

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Can A Station Be Too Focused?



A year or so ago, a consultant and I were talking about the decision that one of his smaller-market rhythmic clients had made to pull most of its pop titles, something the client had done with success in other markets. Even in a smaller market with a negligible ethnic population, he noted that being purer had gotten the station its best ratings ever.

Then the next book came out. Suddenly, the station in question was down from the high 4-share range to the low 2s. After rebounding slightly, it's now at a 2.5. Its story recalls the early '90s, when a number of unlikely markets got their first rhythmic top 40s (or saw their mainstream top 40s segue to rhythmic). Listeners rewarded those stations with huge initial numbers, then drifted away. Soon, so did many of those stations.

So how focused should a station be? It's a question that stations in almost every format are confronted with in some way. PDs are taught that hyperfocused is good. They're trained not to even test records that might break format, even if they come back on the first page of the music test. They're taught that expanding consumer choices mean products must be more niched. Their first task at any new station is to weed the library of all those records that couldn't have actually been there for a reason.

All that training is usually reinforced with a great first book—not only for the rhythmic station that pulls the pop records, but also for the adult top 40 that drops its currents and goes all-'80s or the top 40 station that makes its music younger and does even better in 25-34 as a result. Then there's the second or third book where the listeners who had given the move a seeming vote of confidence three months earlier decide to move on. Perhaps the novelty wears off, or perhaps it just takes casual listeners six months to figure out that the revised station isn't for them.

PDs should see this coming, but they don't always. The PIs are happier and more focused in their wants than ever. When the adult listeners who surprised top 40 PDs last year by liking "Let Me Blow Ya Mind" decide that maybe "One Minute Man" is a little too much for them, they may have already selected themselves out of the research sample. And PDs are only a little more cognizant this time around of the troubles that a closed research loop created a decade ago. At the outset of top 40's resurgence, 25-34s got a disproportionate say in the format's music. Now, they may not get any.

Once those listeners are gone, of course, it's hard to get them back. Most of top 40's attempts to do so in the early '90s only succeeded in aggravating the listeners who were still left. And it is certainly possible to be too eclectic. Certain hybrids, from the original KKBT (the Beat) Los Angeles to the current reggae/rhythmic AC hybrid KKVV (the Wave) San Francisco, have made sense to the well-respected programming minds who put them on the air, but they haven't been as easily explained to the audience.

Hybrid formats inherently have focus issues—defined as they are by the target instead of one genre of music. Rhythmic top 40 was already grappling with whether it could still accommodate dance music. Then the new crop of "pure dance" stations came along and many decided not to include hip-hop and R&B, even though that genre, ironically, is more danceable than it has been in years. The presence of a focused dance rival, meanwhile, gave some existing rhythmic stations license to pull the last few dance/pop titles they played. Now, PDs and labels alike are wondering if there's any place for dance-leaning rhythmic in a format that was built on dance music in the late '80s/early '90s.

For some stations, hyperfocus makes sense. WPY (Party 93.1) Miami has one of the nation's premier R&B outlets, WEDR, next door, as well as focused competitors covering rhythmic and mainstream top 40. It also has a full-market signal and major ownership behind it, meaning that it doesn't have to cast the widest possible net to gather enough listeners to be viable. For some of the more marginal signals depending on dance music to put them on the map, it's probably not as necessary or desirable to be as focused as WPY has been in its first nine months.

Some dance-leaning stations seem to be coming to that conclusion themselves. KXMG (Mega 93.3) Austin, Texas, has put some R&B/hip-hop product back, after going pure dance for a while. WKUT New York is ranging from '70s dance to some of today's R&B to underground dance, reflecting the hybrid with which it launched six years ago. It's not textbook radio, but I know some listeners who are more passionate about the station than they have been in years.

How focused a station has to be obviously depends heavily on its market situation and its history. As the station that put "Will Survive" back on the radio in the mid-'90s, WKUT has the latitude to flex in ways that KKVV probably doesn't. But PDs have a longtime tendency to believe that a vote for one type of music is a vote against all others. Listeners, in reality, are a little more open. Non-ethnic listeners didn't accept Jammie Oldies as their only oldies format because it was only playing half the music they liked from that era. Rhythmic listeners in small markets may have a greater appetite for hip-hop and R&B than once believed, but that doesn't translate to only wanting hip-hop and R&B.

Had Arbitron's Personal People Meter (PPM) been deployed as soon as expected, recent test results might have given PDs a new mission to cast a wider net. Some might have regarded the P4s, P5s, and P6s who emerged in the first PPM data as one-time "phantom cume" who could now be acknowledged but not courted. Other PDs would have been looking for a way to convert those listeners or perhaps to once again be the station the whole office could agree on.



Who's A Master Of Their Domain?

Many station Web sites no longer stream audio—if they ever did—and without that feature, it can be more difficult to drive traffic to a station site or get people to spend more time there. That doesn't mean, however, that Internet/Web-site use is not an integral part of Promogandists' planning. In fact, our panelists continue to rank their Internet promotions as among the most vital things they do year-round.

So how many Promogandists work to understand and update the workings of their sites? Only some. And many report that the time they have to devote to learning new technologies or designing basic Web sites is nonexistent, so they rely on the knowledge of others in something they all agree is integral to their jobs.

Most Promogandists do have someone on the premises who serves as Webmaster. In fact, stations in larger markets report they have even more staffers in their interactive departments. Album rock KSJO San Francisco's Jim Sheehan says his station has an "in-house Webmaster, with several assistants that can update ongoing [and] minor changes."

Of course, Sheehan's station is notorious for some of the Web-based promotions they have conducted, inviting listeners to display particular body parts in competitions for prizes including, in one promotion, breast augmentation. It may not be everyone's D-cup of tea, but it is effective in continually driving the rock audience to the KSJO site. Despite that reliance, Sheehan reports that he has no knowledge of how to update the site.

Album rock WXTB Tampa, Fla.'s Mike Oliviero reports a similar reliance on his station's Web site. "We are very Web-intensive," he says. "[It's] important one-to-one marketing [to] your station PIs. Any station which does not use their Web site as a living, breathing marketing tool is grossly missing an opportunity."

And with that reliance on the site and the importance he places on it, Oliviero says he has somewhat of an idea how to update his site.

MORE OF ME TO LOVE

Album rock WZXL Atlantic City, N.J., is conducting what can only be looked upon as an updated version of a "taster's challenge" kind of promotion. In this case, the station is looking to prove the claims of New Bust, a program

MONITOR PROFILE

PD John O'Dea Deals A Pair Of Flips To Flank The Competition

For years, Cumulus' WNNK (Wink 104) Harrisburg, Pa., was able to use its heritage and its lack of a direct competitor to be a top 40 station with a difference—offering high-profile personality in afternoons and skewing more adult musically. Then Clear Channel's oldies WWKL became top 40 WHKF (Kiss FM) and wrestled WNNK to a quick 12-plus draw.

This winter, WNNK made a surprising decision, unleashing a one-two formatic punch on the market. Wink migrated up the demo scale to focus on its older listeners as an adult top 40. Sister WWKL—which had picked up those

"It's just as personality," O'Dea says of the rechristened *Wink Wake-Up Show With Denny & Sue*. Despite the name, "they pretty much do a three-person morning show," O'Dea says. "Denny has a really dynamic personality . . . I don't think we missed a beat."

Besides, O'Dea adds, "it just felt right to have him take over for Tim rather than do a whole search of America for the next morning show. It's just so much better when you have somebody who's already acclimated to the station. The audience knows him [and] likes him, and he knows the market—so he can relate to everything going on in the marketplace."


rent tracks from Creed, Avril Lavigne, and Sheryl Crow, Wink still has tentacles in that world. "We just don't have any of the real dancey or rhythmic records on the radio."

That's because a week ago Wink turned heads with its flip, Cumulus grabbed attention again when it launched rhythmic Hot 92. O'Dea says Kiss has reacted in trying to hold its rhythmic ground, "but they still are playing the mainstream top 40 hits, the rock-and-pop-leaning songs. So that definitely gives us that edge [in that Hot is purely rhythmic]."

Musically, WWKL resembles rhythmic powerhouse WBBM-FM (B96) Chicago. Much as

calls when Clear Channel gave them up—dropped oldies to flank Kiss from the other side as rhythmic top 40.

"We had to go somewhere," says John O'Dea, PD of both stations. "What [were] we going to do? Go down and fight for the young end or maintain and control and superserve our upper end where all the money is? We decided in mid-February/early March to go full force at the adults." Blowing up more than 15 years of heritage was scary, O'Dea says, but "we [saw] a big hole in the market for adult top 40, and we just felt that this was the right time to go after that hole and fill it up before somebody else does."

Although the music and airstaff were retooled, O'Dea didn't launch a media blitz to announce the new direction at Wink. He says, "It was pretty much a soft opening, so to speak."

Part of those staff changes resulted from the loss of Wink's long-time morning and afternoon hosts. Bruce Bond left his afternoon talk show last December, while 16-year morning vet Tim Burns retired from radio. Midday Hollywood Heffelfinger moved to afternoons, with Kelly Iris joining for middays from WWKL's oldies staff. WWKL midday Gary Thomas came in for nights on Wink. Overnight host Denny Logan joined Sue Campbell and John Paul Shaffer in mornings. While on paper it may seem odd that an overnighter would take over a marquee slot like morning host, O'Dea points out that Logan was filling in during Burns' five vacation weeks per year.

O'Dea says the show has expanded Shaffer's role beyond simply being the news guy. "That dynamic makes the show a little bit hipper and a little more cutting edge. But again, I don't want to take anything away from Tim, because he was a huge part and a reason why this radio station was successful for so many years. It's just a new injection of energy."

As for Bond's exit, O'Dea sees value in getting those afternoon hours that were formerly talk focused, to help him establish the station's new musical direction. Besides, historically, when Bond was on the station, some listeners were discouraged from tuning in to Wink at work "because they knew that at three o'clock they would have to change it, since it would be all talk."

Asked if it was easier to flip Wink with Burns and Bond out of the picture, O'Dea says he doesn't think so. "Who knows what would have happened if [Bond] were still here [when the decision-making process to flip formats was undertaken]." There were bigger issues, O'Dea adds, of Kiss nipping at Wink's heels and valuable upper-demo adult top 40 ground to claim.

O'Dea doesn't negate Bond's presence in the market. Now hosting mornings at '80s convert WRKZ, Bond has been in the center of non-compete litigation between Cumulus and WRKZ. "I don't think there's any question Bruce has a big fan following," O'Dea says. A court decision is pending on the Bond matter.

O'Dea takes the "top 40" aspect of adult top 40 seriously. Among the personality-driven morning show, the upbeat production, and cur-

B96 won't shy from mainstream pop, O'Dea says that he's earlier on pop records than other rhythmic, citing recent releases by Justin Timberlake, Paul Oakenfold, and Shakira. "Rhythmic is going to play that, but I don't think to the same extent [that Hot does]," O'Dea says. And while those songs will also appear on rival Kiss, O'Dea says that "we're certainly out on it first."

Hot also plays tracks from the hip-hop side, but O'Dea tries "to make sure the music is not [all] hip-hop [with] three or four pure dance records," he says, adding that about 25% of the playlist is hip-hop.

While Wink may have affected a DJ overhaul with its switch, the Hot launch was handled differently, personality-wise. "On Hot, we have one local live person lit, six to 10 at night," O'Dea says. "Typically you start with a morning show first. We decided that [by] going after the 12-24 audience . . . we would start with the night show first and build it backward. So, we're just in the process now of [placing] our second full-time person, Lucas."

Lucas was in afternoons at top 40 WLAN Lancaster, Pa., using the on-air name Ronny Ramone. He has been with Hot since its spring launch, primarily making appearances and doing a mix show while Mackenzie held down nights. Now plans are for McKenzie to move to afternoons with Lucas taking nights.

Speaking to the changes at Hot, O'Dea says, "We had the right timing. Now we're the new kids on the block and bring a different style and different type of music presentation to the market."

that advertises it will increase women's bra sizes by three cups within three months.

The station promotion, for the sophisticates in the audience, is called **I Need Bigger Tatas Tuesday**. Women sign up on Tuesdays to compete in a pageant competition to win one of three breast-enlargement programs. And to make it completely topical, the winners will be chosen *American Idol*-style by three judges and the station's audience. And yes, the promotion will be featured on the station's Web site.

Speaking of *American Idol*, top 40 KCHZ (Z95.7) Kansas City staged a successful open

audition for the chance to be one of five area singers to open for Epic act **3LW**. A grand-prize winner was awarded five hours of studio time and a slot on the station's playlist. More than 300 listeners turned out for the audition, which was judged by station staff.

REMEMBRANCE

Many stations sought to make Sept. 11 commemorations tasteful and meaningful to listeners, and numerous examples of how stations succeeded in doing just that have already been featured in this space. However, one

more notable campaign was waged by top 40 WHOT (Hot 101) Youngstown, Ohio, where morning-team member Jim Loboy staged a one-man walk-a-thon from Ohio to New York. Called **A Walk to Remember**, Loboy walked more than 30 miles per day for 14 days to complete the 444-mile trek and reach the World Trade Center site by Sept. 11. Along the way, he raised more than \$25,000 for the local firefighters fund.
