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A Step Closer To '90s Programming

Over the past year, *Airplay Monitor* has been reporting on the growing encroachment of '90s music into the specialty-program niche that once belonged to the '80s. Now we seem to be a step closer with the announcement of the syndicated *Retro Stars With Dave Stewart*, a weekend show focusing exclusively on '90s material. The two-hour show is geared primarily for top 40 and adult top 40 and hosted by WPLJ New York's

Dave Stewart—who is neither the Clear Channel/New Orleans programmer nor the Eurythmics co-founder.

'JOURNAL' JOINS INDIE BANDWAGON

The June 10 *Wall Street Journal* added its voice to the popular-press coverage of the rising cost of doing business. The article spotlights Clear Channel's exclusivity deals with eight different indies, talks about their PD Perceptual product that is supposed to give labels feedback on their songs from PDs (and which has seen its price drop after its introduction), and mentions the company's upcoming programmer meetings in Los Angeles where labels are said to be charged about \$40,000 to sponsor lunch or cocktail hours to expose their artists to the group's pop programmers.

Saga/Clarksville, Tenn., sales manager **Susan Quesenberry** becomes GM, replacing **Scott Farkas**. The cluster includes adult top 40 **WCWQ**.

AAA Entertainment/Long Island, N.Y., GSM **Rick Devlin** becomes GM of the cluster, which includes adult top 40s **WBEA** and **WMOS** and **AC WBAZ**.

Radio Disney affiliate **KMIK-AM** Phoenix GM **Michael Malace** replaces **Ken Brentlinger** as GM of classic hits **KAZL** and R&B oldies **KAJM**.

NO FREE BREAKFAST?

The Philadelphia Inquirer reports that **WIOQ** (Q102) Philadelphia stunt boy **Diego Ramos** will not be charged with a crime after a stunt involving him trying to dodge a \$9.18 bill at an International House of Pancakes brought the police to the restaurant. The district attorney's office decided not to press charges for the "outrageous" stunt but sent a warning letter to the station.

HANDS OFF THAT PRIZE

WSTO Owensboro, Ky., recently held its fifth annual Hands On Marathon, where contestants tried to keep their hands on a car the longest to win a three-year lease on the vehicle. PD **Dave Michaels** says he found out later that the station's winner resides in Alabama and has won at least three other similar contests in Carbondale, Ill.; Longview, Texas; and Rochester, N.Y. The station had to award the prize since the winner didn't break any rules, but Michaels says that future contests at the station will have a residency requirement as part of the rules, and he suggests others do the same.

FORMATS: LESS EXTREME

Rhythmic top 40 **KXME** Honolulu drops its longtime "Extreme Radio" handle, becoming "104.3 XME: Hawaii's No. 1 hit music station." PD **K.C.** remains. Cox top 40 format coordinator **J.J. Rice** says the revamped station will feature "less [repetition] and all kinds of music." R&B **KXUU** (U92) Denver opts for dance-driven rhythmic top 40 as **KXDC** (102.1X), under consultant **Bill Tanner**. The station is currently running jockless.

Top 40 has gained more than 100 stations in the past five years, but the format universe is still 100 stations smaller than it was during the format doldrums of 1992. New *M Street Journal* format data for the past 10 years show top 40 had 578 stations in 1992 vs. 474 now. But the format bottomed out to 318 stations in 1995, rebounding to 358 in 1997.

Kelly's Airplay Drops Following Indictment

How will the indictment of **R. Kelly** affect the veteran hitmaker at radio? Following one consultant's suggestion that AC stations drop "I Believe I Can Fly"—the one Kelly title that's commonly found in the format's libraries—that song was down 107 spins from the previous chart week. And two tracks from the Kelly/Jay-Z project that were already losing spins at R&B radio continued to do so: "Get This Money" (down 84 detections) and "Take You Home With Me" (down 86). The track "Somebody's Girl" was up one spin at mainstream R&B radio.

After only one week atop the rhythmic top 40 chart, **Eminem's** "Without Me" (Web/Aftermath/Interscope) is pushed down to No. 2, making way for **Nelly's** "Hot in Herre" (Fo' Real/Universal). This marks Nelly's third rhythmic No. 1. His first single, "Country Grammar," spent 10 weeks on top starting in July 2000. His second No. 1 was "Ride Wit Me," which spent six weeks at No. 1 last March. "Hot in Herre" moves up to No. 2 at crossover, where it is just 90 spins away from the new No. 1, "Oh Boy" (Roc-a-Fella/Def Jam/IDJMG) by **Cam'ron Featuring Juelz Santana**. Eminem still holds down the No. 1 spot on The Billboard Top 200 albums chart, brining his two-week sales total to 1.6 million. This week, "Without Me" moves into the top five at mainstream, stepping 7-4.

After considerable European chart success, American singer **Anastacia** earns her first mainstream top 40 hit with "One Day in Your Life" (Epic). It's the first U.S. single from her album *Freak of Nature*. Anastacia's first single, "I'm Outta Love," made it to No. 2 on the dance charts in February 2000.

Daryl Hall & John Oates earn Airpower and Greatest Gainer stripes at AC, as their latest single, "Do It for Love" (BMG Heritage) moves 19-16. The track is the first release off their CD *VH1 Behind the Music: Do It for Love*. The duo is currently on tour through September.

LABEL NEWS: *Billboard Bulletin* reports that Bertelsmann's BMG music division has acquired the rest of Zomba Music Group/Jive, one of the world's largest independent music companies. Sources estimate the deal is worth \$2.84 billion.

Warner Bros. promotes **Doug Frank** to the newly created post of president of music operations. Frank is a 15-year WB vet and segues from his VP of music position at Warner Bros. Pictures.

Among those leaving Gold Circle Records at the end of June are senior VP of promotion **Alan Orem**, VP of promotion **Mike Klein**, and national director of promotion **Leslie Marquez**. All three may be reached until the end of June at 310-319-3620.

mouth VP/GM **Don Dalesio** moves to the company's headquarters as COO.

Rhythmic **WXXP** (Party 105) Eastern Long Island, N.Y., PD/midday host **Phathead** exits, replaced in-house by **Andre Ferro** from modern sister **WDRE**, which has recently phased out its dance-music content.

AC WEZF Burlington, Vt., PD/morning man **Tom Van Sant** relinquishes those stripes to concentrate on other programming duties in the Clear Channel cluster. Omaha, Neb., TV vet **Bob Cady** joins as morning host. The station needs a co-host for him.

AC WZWW State College, Pa., PD **Matt Spence** takes the same at **AC WCEI** Easton, Md., replacing **Scott Johnson**.

If Indies Fade, Issues Still Remain

The record industry asks Congress to look into independent record promotion. Clear Channel chairman/CEO Lowry Mays also welcomes pending legislation aimed at independent promotion and forecasts the day when that system is dismantled. The Recording Industry Assn. of America (and its numerous co-signatories) ties the indie issue to the impact of vertical integration and consolidation—any investigation of which would likely include CC. Clear Channel Radio CEO Randy Michaels tells the *Los Angeles Times* that “we didn’t create the independent promotion system. They did.”

Regardless of whether labels or radio fed the current indie system (and the answer to that one is “yes”), it’s not hard to interpret either side’s motivation for welcoming intervention now. The record industry’s current fiscal woes are well documented. Michaels also told the *Los Angeles Times* in March 2001 that his group’s plans for its own label initiatives could “save labels money” by cutting out the middlemen, namely indies. But while our industry has spent several years working up to a public discussion of independent promotion, the current system is almost a red herring now. Even if labels walk away from indie promotion as many did in 1986, and some in the industry believe they will shortly, many issues remain unresolved.

If indies go away tomorrow, the industry and the FCC will still have to address whether we want songs to go on the air for reasons other than their programming merit and whether there is ever a legitimate reason for a station owner to take label money to the bottom line for anything other than a paid spot. (Or to threaten to withhold airplay based on consideration shown a rival.) Since the mid-’80s indie scandal, the rallying cry for some in this industry has been, “But what about the supermarkets?” Retail sells price and position and even gets to charge a prospective supplier for taking a meeting. Radio has spent the past 15 years looking for a legal way to replicate the supermarket industry, with most of the biggest groups floating or actually fielding plans for paid spins or backells at some point in the last five years. Eliminating indies doesn’t mean that broadcasters will stop looking to the labels as a source of revenue; it just means they won’t have to share.

If indies go away tomorrow, the FCC will still have to decide how it wants stations to address the issue of consideration on the air and what constitutes consideration. And while it’s hard to imagine the disclaimer that captures all the

intricacies of why some songs are on the air—“During the broadcast day, you may hear some songs on X109 that we initially thought were hits but which failed to test after 75 spins. Because those artists are participating in our station show, we’ve decided to continue playing those songs, just not as much as we otherwise would”—almost no disclosure is taking place now.

If indies go away tomorrow, the music industry must still address its own longstanding “whatever it takes” mentality. Privately, many labels say they’ve already cut back what they’re spending on independent promotion. But costs in some formats are spiraling. And even on the pop side, there are still whispers of some labels exceeding the old prices on records that really need the help. Whatever new rules Congress or the FCC may put forth, there will still be a VP of promotion with a label president or artist manager to satisfy who will, at 3:30 p.m. Tuesday, be looking for a way around them, unless the industry decides that the way to sell records is not being “most added” at any cost.

So what collective industry decision would restore some sanity to the process? Three months ago, during the controversy concerning Radio One’s indie deal, we made a statement that bears repeating now: “When does a radio station deserve promotional support from a label? After it has made a programming decision to promote a record with meaningful airplay and when the label support is used to help stations market those songs and not going to a station’s bottom line. When should an independent promoter be paid? When the information a promoter brings to a station helps swing the decision to play a record—not when the station made that decision on its own.”

The FCC and Congress have a lot of intricacies to sort through, and their knowledge of these issues seems to be driven largely by the consumer press’ reporting on independent promotion. While that reporting has brought many more of these issues to light than were public five years ago, it has still only scratched the surface. So one can only hope that Congress or the FCC will have the sophistication to see these larger issues at a time when any number of industry parties might be happy to offer the indies as a scapegoat. It’s not our intention to minimize or suggest that Congress not deal with any abuses of the indie system that may be taking place but merely to suggest that there is a broader landscape to view.

Sheehan’s recipe for summer success is for the carnivores in the audience. “Successful promotions need what I call a ‘piece of meat’—a reason for people to come out,” he says. “Just to do an appearance because it’s a big client does not equate to success. Usually, if there’s little to no meat, it’s a failure.” What are the big plans for his listeners this summer? Sheehan says it’s giving away “a grand [\$1,000] at a grand opening,” giving the audience a chance to get their picture taken with “hot chicks,” and events at “well-traveled locations with built-in crowds.”

Clear Channel/Miami’s Camie Dunbar tailors summer promotions to fit the needs of her stations and their sales departments. Top 40 WHYI (Y100) does a \$100,000 back-to-school backpack promotion all summer. The packs are stuffed with prizes from clients and are worth about \$200 each. At the end of summer, winners enter a national contest to win the grand-prize money. Rhythmic AC sister WMGE (Mega 103.5) is going retro and tying in with area nightclubs to host a “dance fever summer.” Dunbar says the

contest culminates with a “Mega-type concert and the finals of the dance contest, all hosted by [former *Dance Fever* host] Denny Terrio.”

QUICK HITS

Modern AC WMBZ (the Buzz) Memphis didn’t ask listeners to locate a “hunka hunka burnin’ love” during a city-wide scavenger hunt promotion, but the station did tie in some obscure Elvis-related items. OM Jerry Dean says the scavenger list was difficult and included a “1950s Coke bottle and a \$2 bill with the [station’s] frequency in the serial number, [but] the two tough items were an authentic Grammy Award and a 1953 Humes High School yearbook. That’s the year and school that Elvis graduated from.” Dean says the promotion caused quite a stir. “The classified ads in the paper were full of people who wanted to rent or buy the items.” The winning scavenger rode home in a brand-new \$23,000 car.

Summer’s No Time To Slack Off

Traditionally, stations put the bulk of their promotion muscle into the spring and fall Arbitron surveys, using the “off” books to plan ahead. While the biggest giveaways—cash and cars—are still saved for those key books, our Promoganda panelists contend there is no such thing as downtime, especially during the summer.

For many Promogandists, the biggest promotions and prizes this summer revolve around concerts. Album rock KSJO San Francisco’s Jim Sheehan says his station does as many rock shows as possible, because the station “has been rockin’ in the Bay Area since 1968. Our listeners expect [us] to be at shows—invited or not.”

What are the other hot giveaways for summer? Country WPOC Baltimore’s Sheila Silverstein believes the little things make the difference. “We take advantage of the weather in summer to get out into the streets with participation in festivals [and] fairs,” she says, “but just stopping with the van and giving out ice cream to little league [teams] or people washing their cars in the local parks [is also important].”

Murdock agrees. “You have to have a summer tie-in to get listeners out to appearances and remotes. This summer, we have pinwheels for kids. At the Six Flags [amusement park] opening, we [gave out] towelettes to cool off. I unloaded

three cases in two hours. Hot days are great to have cool drinks or even water for listeners.”

Vestfall considers the lure of the ocean as her summer-event competition. “The beach is only two hours away from D.C., so [an event] best be good to get people to give up going to the water,” she says. “You want to be in front of lots of people, so fairs, festivals, and concerts are always good places to go.”

Country WMZQ Washington, D.C.’s Wendie Vestfall agrees. “We’ve got ticket giveaways scheduled in every daypart through October right now. We give our listeners a chance to win everything from big-event concerts like Brooks & Dunn to a Blake Shelton county-fair-type show. [We] live and breathe concerts in the summer. We also have a policy of only giving away pavilion tickets to outdoor venues, so they know they are winning the best seats possible.”

But adult top 40 KIMN (Mix 100) Denver’s Mark Murdock believes “concert ‘presents’ and appearances are overrated, unless you have all the tickets to the show. Putting on a free concert is the way to go,” he says. “Listeners really feel you are giving them something. Our Sister Hazel concert will have free food and free beer. Beat that.”

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within a week of each other this summer. Those shows, Wolfe says, have already sold about 11,000 tickets each. But he also thinks "the economy has something to do with it," noting that his jocks talked to many listeners who would like to come to Country Fest but can't afford it this year, despite that all but a handful of premium tickets sold for a relatively low price of \$15 or \$30.

Adult R&B WHQT (Hot 105) Miami dropped its annual Hits and Oldies Family Reunion two years ago. "Even though it was very well-received by listeners [drawing 70,000 in 2000], it wasn't profitable enough to continue," PD Derrick Brown says. To resume the shows, he says, the station would have to sell tickets and have a lineup that merits charging \$10-\$15. More important, "we'd have to see a title sponsor kick in \$50,000-\$60,000 up front, and in these economic times, that's hard to find. Also, we would have to look at how we deal with vendors. In the past, we had them pay a flat-rate fee, like a couple hundred dollars, yet they would walk away with bags of money—\$9,000-\$10,000 for the day."

Country WBCT Grand Rapids, Mich., has found a way to make money from its June 22 B93 Birthday Bash, despite giving away the tickets. Doug Montgomery, director of FM programming for Clear Channel/Grand Rapids, says B93 will make "six figures" in merchandise sales alone in the month of June, much of it at the show, which draws 60,000-80,000 fans each year.

COMPETING FOR ACTS

Among the most commonly cited challenges in producing station shows are the inability to secure headlining acts—many of which are doing their own tours during the summer—and the difficulty in competing with the big package tours that are coming through town.

Some major-market R&B station concerts are already sold out, including WQHT (Hot 97) New York's June 26 Summer Jam and WJMN (Jam'n 94.5) Boston's June 29 Summer Jam. But as WHRK (K97) Memphis promotions director Frank Gilbert notes, those stations "are the ones who can get the big acts."

Top 40 WKSS Hartford, Conn., promotion director Gregdog sees problems on the horizon with more and more package tours slated for summer. The Anger Management tour and the Pop Disaster tour are "coming in one after the other." To avoid seeming mundane by comparison, "we took some artists that were in this area anyway and we packaged it together, called it Pop Divas Live, and presented an all-female lineup. We tried to theme it differently instead of the 'Kiss 95.7 Show.'"

Top 40 WDRQ Detroit PD Alex Tear agrees that "there are so many superstar acts out there touring that it's very competitive" and cites an increasing number of package tours, along the line of Moby's Area² festival. "The average WDRQ concertgoer only hits two to three shows a year. It's just the reality."

WBLN New York promotion director Tina Nachman believes fans are losing interest in multi-act shows overall. "Back in December, [New York's] *Daily News* did a story comparing all the radio station Christmas shows [in the city]. It said they all sold poorly and that listeners [who were] interviewed said they didn't want to see these 'laundry list of artists' concerts anymore. They're just not entertaining," she says. "The shows that sell out are the ones geared to a 12-24 audience. The adult audience would rather see their favorite artist perform an entire show, rather than 10 acts doing one or two songs to track. That's why so many station concert shows are having a hard time."

Some PDs are hoping to build station shows that transcend their lineup, such as top 40 KMXV Kansas City OM Jon Zellner. "Stations need to sell these concerts more as events and less as concerts," he says. "Otherwise, people are not going to buy the ticket." Zellner's Red, White & Boom is almost sold out. "That has as much to do with the branding of the show as the lineup."

At Radio One/Detroit's R&B cluster, promo-

MONITOR PROFILE

For Michaels, Dance Music Is Far From Disposable

After a brief detour to the A&R side with Universal Records, former KRBE Houston PD Jay Michaels has returned to his roots—and to his first market—as PD of dance-driven rhythmic top 40 KXMG (Mega 93.3). Michaels, who interned at heritage rival KHFI, says his well-known passion for music prompted him "to check out what it was like to work at a label." A week back into his radio career, "I feel like I've never left it. This is where I belong. Working at the label was great, but radio is where I'm meant to be. This is what really gets me pumping, and I feel very comfortable and confident in what I'm doing here."

Mega launched last August and evolved into a full-on dance presentation in December. Like WPYM Miami or the new KPRT San Francisco, Michaels calls it "pure pop dance radio," "Euro"-based without any hip-hop. "Our big artists are Madonna, Ian Van Dahl, Delerium, Basement Jaxx, Kylie Minogue. Then we have remixes of No Doubt, Pink, Mary J. Blige, and the Pet Shop Boys and things like that."

"The station that I compare this to is [KNR] Energy in Houston [now KHM] when that was on," Michaels continues. "It's... different records, but our goal seems to be the same."

For Michaels, the balancing act comes in providing a dance fix and keeping the station friendly enough to keep a healthy cume, even with some obscure tracks. "I'm trying to make sure that the station keeps its edge and its niche, because we're definitely feeling a niche," he says. "But we also want to make sure that it's cume-friendly."

There's a limited albeit growing number of similar stations across the country, so "a lot of these records are exclusive to us," Michaels says. "A lot of them might not be proven hits across the country. I want to be careful that we're not playing too many obscure dance songs."

At the same time, Michaels says there are songs that mainstream top 40 stations don't play that he can own, such as Ian Van Dahl's "Will I?" or Basement Jaxx's "Where's Your Head At," which he says "could have been a huge record at radio, but it's different, and people don't seem to be wanting to take chances on different-sounding records."

Michaels says his staff is very knowledgeable and helpful in finding music. "We've got a lot of people here at the station that live this... lifestyle," he says. "So, I'm pretty inundated with lots of new music, and it's just [a matter of] going through it [to find] the next big one. They're really on top of their game [here], so they really help me out a lot. They can pick these records... The station was first and way

ahead on this Puretone record, 'Addicted to Bass,' which looks like it's going to be a big hit. And the same with this Weekend Players' 'Into the Sun' [record], which sounds just like Everything but the Girl, that's an import right now."

Texas, Michaels says, has a special place in its heart for the Euro sound of Depeche Mode, Erasure, and New Order, so every hour in mornings, middays, and afternoons features a Mega Rewind track, "which is a big record from the '80s or '90s that's still really cool," he says. "That stuff has always been big down in Texas, and it fits really well with what's going on right now with this dance music." But he uses them sparingly, "not too many and not at night, but during the day I think it helps put some breathing room on the radio station."

Mega's noon show is a midday mix of currents with more '80s and '90s titles tossed in. "At three o'clock we play the Classic Three at Three, which is '80s and '90s dance classics, but not Huey

Lewis. You'll hear Book of Love and [CCCP's] American Soviets and stuff like that."

Michaels is "completely re-doing the imaging on the radio station." That's still ongoing, but Michaels promises that "it's going to be young, hip, and edgy... We're still running some of the stuff that was on when it was dance, R&B, and old school. This is going to be more a cross between KROQ [Los Angeles] and KRBE production."

The recent crop of pure dance sign-ons has had the effect of further polarizing the rhythmic top 40 format into stations that play primarily hip-hop and R&B and those that play none. While Michaels thinks some stations can mix both, citing WKTU New York, he also points to rhythmic rival KQBT (the Beat) and says, "We can't beat them at it. And people tune in to the Beat to hear hip-hop, and they'll tune to us to hear dance... After three months, the audience is reacting to what we're playing."

Ratings so far show a broad appeal to the music he's playing. "We've been on for three months, and we're doing really well 18-34 already. [During] the last trend, the station's 18-34 [number] was up there with the rest of them. People are reacting to the station, and it's only the beginning," he says. "It's a really good alternative to the same records that we've been hearing for the last couple of years over and over. And there's some great records that are coming over from Europe."

The airstaff is still being built. Michaels is doing middays, and MD Evan—who Michaels praises as an expert in everything inside the station and in Austin—is in afternoons, with Miss Kitty handling nights. Michaels calls her "one of the best talents I've heard probably since I've been in radio." He says she's wacky and like an MTV jock crossed with KYSR Los Angeles' Jamie White. "When she goes to clubs, people go nuts for her. I haven't seen that in radio in a long time," Michaels says. "She's a complete star."

That leaves mornings, which Michaels says will probably be his last task, "because I'm still trying to figure out how we're going to approach the morning angle."

With Mega, WPYM, WKTU, and the June 5 launch of KXDC Denver, Michaels is bullish on a growing dance format. "There's always going to be great records coming from overseas, especially dance records," Michaels says. "We just want to make sure we're in tune to those. I think the future's huge. I feel like this is something fresh for people, and we've got hit records to play that are compelling to listen to. It's not all disposable anymore." **MARC SCHIFFMAN**

tion and marketing director Vicki Preston prefers to partner with existing concerts. "That way, we brand ourselves with the hottest shows. Not only do we get a promotional value out of it, we also still get advertising dollars from the promoters, which affects the bottom line. It doesn't make sense for a radio station to compete against those shows, because in reality, we can't. We can't pay those big-time artists what they demand, and you also would be competing with one of your biggest advertisers—the promoter."

KEEPING PRICES LOW

Regardless of the lineup, the biggest challenge for broadcasters trying to sell tickets to their shows is keeping prices low. "A lot of radio stations think if they have a 10-15 act lineup, then they can charge \$30-\$40 or more for tickets," K97's Gilbert says. "But let's look at the overall picture. If you're a family of five, that's \$150 for tickets alone. Then they have to pay for parking and food. That's over \$200 for a one-day event." WHRK keeps its tickets at \$10 and throws in free

parking. "We make our money off sponsorships, anyway," Gilbert says. "That's the main reason why we've been able to consistently sell tickets at our events." Top 40 KHKS Dallas gave listeners a bargain the day before its June 9 show when the station offered two-for-one tickets.

"I've seen a lot of the radio show prices pop up," Tear says. "I'm thinking, 'Isn't this supposed to be a gift to your listeners?'" The WDRQ Heat Rave ticket prices range from the high 20s to the high 40s. But Tear has seen \$80 tickets for some station shows and wonders how a station can expect parents to pay for themselves, their kids and friends, parking, food, and souvenirs. "By the time you're done with it, you've dropped \$700," he says. "Are the Beatles back to life now?"

"The value of the dollar is [such that] they could be buying food or whatever with that money," rhythmic top 40 KNDA Corpus Christi, Texas, OM Bill Thorman says. "Sometimes one of the first audiences to attach itself to a new artist is a younger audience, but they don't have a lot of money to spend." His station is doing a series

of smaller \$1.29 shows.

"The major problem is radio stations are spending exorbitant amounts of money on acts that are not headliners," Zellner says. "We're kidding ourselves if we think people can afford \$80 concert tickets. The managers and the bands and the promoters and the promotions teams are sometimes seeing the desperation in PDs' eyes and saying, 'I can get you this band, but it's going to cost you \$80,000 or \$100,000' for an act with one or two hits."

Some of the desperation comes from the fact that station shows—once intended to bolster a station's image—have become vital sources of nontraditional revenue. But Dick Stark, director of marketing for Regent/Albany, N.Y., says, "Stations need to look at listener appreciation shows as a great marketing tool, a great thank-you to your fans. If you're looking at it to make money, you're doing it for the wrong reason."

In the end, Tear says it comes down to "why do you want to do a show? You want to take ownership of the artist and give a gift back to your listeners."
