Whether it be on record or tape—this year give the gift of Christmas—the gift of music.

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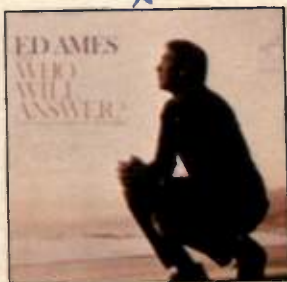
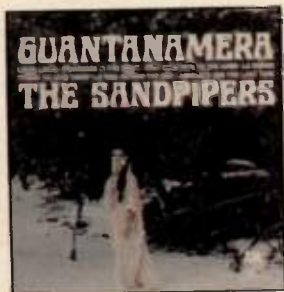

STRANGERS IN THE NIGHT: Along with his smash hit, the title tune, Frank Sinatra offers an appealing program that includes "Summer Wind," "Downtown" and "All or Nothing at All."

CLAUDINE: Claudine Longet (Mrs. Andy Williams) displays a voice that is both warm and inviting, and she adds her own unique touch to this ballad collection that includes "A Man and a Woman," "Meditation," "Sunrise, Sunset" and "Hello, Hello."

A PORTRAIT OF RAY: An exceptional collection of new recordings by the master of the blues, Ray Charles, that spotlights "Eleanor Rigby," "When I Stop Dreaming," "Understanding" and "A Sweet Young Thing Like You."

GUANTANAMERA: The talented Sandpipers made their mark on the pop scene with the title tune. Now they bring their own unique style to "Strangers in the Night," "La Bamba," "Louie, Louie" and "Cast Your Fate to the Wind."

TAKE GOOD CARE OF MY BABY: The warm, smooth voice of Bobby Vinton adds new appeal to this outstanding collection of ballad hits, including "Sentimental Me," "To Be Alone," "Serenade of the Bells" and "I Apologize."

D-I-V-O-R-C-E: Fine country stylist, Tammy Wynette, leads off this exceptional collection with her "D-I-V-O-R-C-E" hit, and offers other winners "Gentle on My Mind," "Honey" and "The Legend of Bonnie and Clyde."

WHO WILL ANSWER: Ed Ames offers a compelling collection of thought-provoking ballads focused around his hit that entitles the album. Others included are "Blowin' in the Wind," "I Wanna Be Free" and "Yesterday."



DEAN MARTIN'S GREATEST HITS VOL. 2: This second collection of Dino's hits includes his recent winners "In the Misty Moonlight," "Let the Good Times In," "The Door is Still Open" and "Little Ole Wine Drinker Me."

A HAPPENING IN CENTRAL PARK: Barbra Streisand is a "happening" anywhere as her superb song stylings add new dimensions to such material as "He Touched Me," "Second Hand Rose," "People" and "Happy Days Are Here Again."

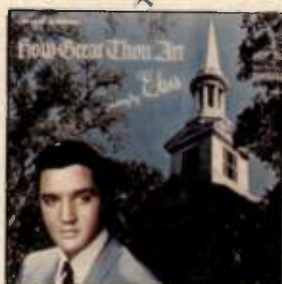

HONEY: Andy Williams has taken the best of the current crop of hits, and adds his own distinctive touch to each. "This is My Song," "Scarborough Fair," "Love is Blue" and "Windy" are complemented by the title tune.

MAN & HIS SOUL: A brilliant collection of the very best of Ray Charles, this two-record set includes "I Can't Stop Loving You," "Georgia on My Mind," "Hit the Road, Jack," and "Baby, It's Cold Outside," along with 20 other Charles' gems.



YESTERDAY I HEARD THE RAIN: Tony Bennett's popularity continues and so does his superior song styling as he here offers such selections as "Get Happy," "Hushabye Mountain" from "Chitty Chitty Bang Bang" and the album's title song.

FELICIANO: Young Jose Feliciano has finally gained the recognition he deserved with his recent hit "Light My Fire" (included here). Others in the program are "California Dreamin'" and "Last Thing on My Mind."

TAKE ME BACK TO LAINE COUNTRY: Country music hits and Frankie Laine are a natural as proven by his treatments of "Little Green Apples," "Honey" and "Wayward Wind."

THE BEST OF EDDY ARNOLD: More than two decades of Eddy Arnold pop-country hits are contained in this album, and they include "Cattle Call," "Bouquet of Roses," "I Want to Go With You" and "Make the World Go Away."

The albums in this category truly represent an embarrassment of riches. The world of musical sound on records today offers more fine performances than ever. You will have no problem selecting choice material from this list.



BEAT OF THE BRASS: Herb Alpert marks his solo vocal debut with "This Guy's in Love With You," and the Tijuana Brass with Alpert at the helm offer "Monday, Monday," "Talk to the Animals," and "Cabaret," among others.

DO YOU KNOW THE WAY TO SAN JOSE?: The subtle Mexican-oriented rhythms of Julius Wechter & the Baja Marimba band offer such gems as "Sunrise, Sunset" and "Sunday Morning."



FOOL ON THE HILL: Sergio Mendes and his remarkable Brasil '66 treat with intriguing vocal and instrumental renditions of "Scarborough Fair," "Upa Neginho" and their "Fool on the Hill" hit.

MANTOVANI'S GOLDEN HITS: The master of the cascading strings is featured in a collection of his most successful recordings, including "Charmaine," "Moon River," "Around the World" and "Games That Lovers Play."



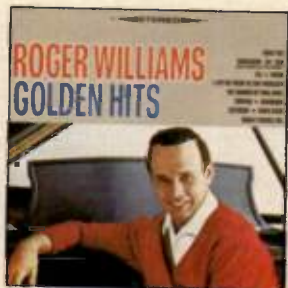

ROAD SONG: Late jazz great Wes Montgomery is heard here in an outstanding album, which includes "Yesterday," "Scarborough Fair," and the title song.

BOOTS WITH STRINGS: Boots Randolph, a sterling saxophone playing is appreciated by all, is joined by strings here for such melodic numbers as "The Shadow of Your Smile," "Moon River," and "What Kind of Fool Am I?"



THE SEA: The poetry of Rod McKuen and the music of Anita Kerr combine to make this musical portrait a classic filled with beauty and sensitivity.

PHONOGRAPH RECORD: Composer-performer Mason Williams rode to the top with his brilliant "Classical Gas" instrumental hit, and here with that hit are other winners, "Wonderlove" and "Baroque-a-Nova."



THE GOOD, THE BAD AND THE UGLY: Leroy Holmes and his fine orchestra offer a superb collection of movie themes, which, in addition to the title tune, include "To Sir, With Love," "Camelot," and "Thoroughly Modern Millie."

THE BEST OF HENRY MANCINI: Here's a honey of a collection that includes all Mancini originals, beginning with "Mr. Lucky" and "Peter Gunn" and continuing on to "Baby Elephant Walk" and "Charade."



MANTOVANI... MEMORIES: The Mantovani melody magic is a continuous force in the album market. The maestro has the winning formula down pat and scores again on this packaging of richly instrumentalized songs that includes the top of the current and standard ballad drawer.

CLASSICAL GAS: The winning team of Eddie Heywood and Hugo Winterhalter ("Canadian Sunset") are reunited in a potent sales package. An exceptional mood is created with their treatments of "For Love of Ivy," "Love Theme From 'Romeo and Juliet'" and "Love Is Blue."



WHAT NOW MY LOVE: This well balanced and diversified collection of plucky instrumentals by Herb Alpert & the Tijuana Brass includes "If I Were a Rich Man," "It Was a Very Good Year" and "Love Theme from 'The Sandpiper' (Shadow of Your Smile)."

LOOK AROUND: The infectious and smooth Latin rhythms of Sergio Mendes and his Brasil '66 add spark to this program that features "The Frog," "Batuçada" and "The Look of Love."



A CURRENT SET OF STANDARDS: Billy Vaughn's pleasing interpretations produce a fine album here as the orchestra plays such new standards as "Little Green Apples," "Mrs. Robinson," "The Look of Love," and "Honey."

MANTOVANI TOUCH: The British maestro adds his own distinctive touch to such instrumental gems as "My Cup Runneth Over," "Release Me," "A Man and a Woman" and "Days of Wine and Roses," among others.



LOVE RHAPSODIES: The distinctive sound of the Midnight String Quartet is well suited for love songs as this collection with "Fascination," "Goin' Out of My Head," "Tara's Theme" and others, clearly demonstrates.

THE 'NOW' SOUND: Jackie Gleason's orchestra has a set of tunes "For Today's Lovers" here, including "Two Different Worlds," "Can't Take My Eyes Off You" and "Yesterday."

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Awards for the Best

The three most-coveted album awards are the Grammy, the Gold Record, and the Billboard Award. These trade awards reflect the top albums of the year from esthetic and sales standpoints.

The Grammy

The Grammy is the most coveted award in the field of recording—the highest honor that a recording or song can achieve—recognition by one's own peers. Its recipients are determined by the votes of more than 2,000 members of the National Academy of Recording Arts & Sciences (NARAS), all of whom are, themselves, actively engaged in creating phonograph records.

LADY SOUL: The title of this album aptly describes Aretha Franklin one of the most sensational performers on today's scene. Included here are hits "Chain of Fools" and "A Natural Woman."

THE TWAIN SHALL MEET: This album by Eric Burdon and the Animals features two of their most recent hits, "Monterey" and "Sky Pilot," along with other winners "No Self Pity" and "All is One."

THE SOUNDS OF SILENCE: With their first big hit to title the album, the talented composer/performer team runs through a sparkling program that also includes "April Come Show the Will" and "I Am a Rock."

WILDFLOWERS: Folkster Judy Collins has a voice that is at once sensitive and compelling, and she has long been a favorite with her beautiful treatments of "Michael From Mountains," "Since You Asked" and "Both Sides Now."

FOUR TOPS' GREATEST HITS: "Shake Me, Wake Me," "Baby I Need Your Lovin'," "Standing in the Shadows of Love," "I Can't Help Myself" and "Bernadette" are but five of the dozen Four Tops' hits contained in this album.

THE BATTLE OF THE BANDS: The smooth, easy-beat pop group offers an outstanding program that features "The Last Thing I Remember," "Food," "Chicken Little Was Right" and their "Eleanor" hit.

HURDY GURDY MAN: Donovan's most recent hit titles this intriguing album that features the vocalist in a variety of moods. Others included are "West Indian Lady" and "Jennifer Juniper."

DIANA ROSS & SUPREMES' GREATEST HITS: A honey of a collector's item, this two-record set includes all of the trio's top winners.

"Where Did Our Love Go," "You Can't Hurry Love," "The Happening," "Baby Love" and "I Hear a Symphony," among others.

WAITING FOR THE SUN: The Doors' third and most recent album release packs the same wallop as the first two. This one includes "Spanish Caravan," "Wintertime Love" and their hits "Unknown Soldier" and "Hello, I Love You."

MAGICAL MYSTERY TOUR: The most phenomenal pop group of the past decade seems to improve with each album entry, and this is no exception. Their hits "Hello Goodbye," "Strawberry Fields Forever," "Penny Lane" and "I Am the Walrus" are in this one.

A TRAMP SHINING: British actor Richard Harris proved he can sing in the film version of "Camelot," and now in his solo album debut, he offers a compelling collection of Jim Webb tunes including "Didn't We," "If You Must Leave My Life" and his own big hit "MacArthur Park."

VALLEY OF THE DOLLS: Class stylist, Dionne Warwick, offers her own compelling interpretations of the title tune, along with "Up Up and Away" and "Do You Know the Way to San Jose."

RIGHTEOUS BROTHERS' GREATEST HITS: The "blue-eyed soul" team is no longer together, but they've left behind a wealth of great hits, including "You've Lost That Lovin' Feeling," "Georgia on My Mind" and "Unchained Melody."

ALL MITCH RYDER HITS: The album title quickly sums up the contents here. Included are "Joy," "Sock it to Me Baby," "Devil with a Blue Dress on," "Good Golly Miss Molly" and "Jenny Take a Ride."

FUNNY GIRL: Diana Ross and the Supremes lend their patented style to music from "Funny Girl," including the title song, "I'm the Greatest Star," "I Am Woman," "People," and "His Love Makes Me Beautiful."

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CREEDENCE CLEARWATER REVIVAL: The San Francisco rock group comes on with powerful vocal work and a heavy rock sound that features their "Suze-O" hit, along with "I Put a Spell on You" and others.

INCENSE & PEPPERMINTS: The Strawberry Alarm Clock hit the top of the best seller charts with their first outing, and now, in their album debut they offer "Hummin' Happy" and "Birds in My Tree," along with their big hit.

SHADES OF DEEP PURPLE: The rockin' Deep Purple lead this album off with their hit single, "Hush," and continue with powerhouse treatments of "Love Help Me," "Hey Joe" and "Happiness."

I HEAR A SYMPHONY: Diana Ross & the Supremes are in exceptional vocal form with this rhythmic collection of pop hits, that includes their own "My World Is Empty Without You," "A Lover's Concerto" and the bouncy title tune.

TEMPTATIONS' GREATEST HITS: The Motor Town group is consistently on the best seller charts, and their hits gathered here "My Girl," "Beauty Is Only Skin Deep" and "Ain't Too Proud to Beg" show why.



THE DOORS: The exciting and creative group made an impressive mark on today's pop scene with their powerful "Light My Fire" hit (included here), and this first album also includes "Crystal Ship" and "Break on Through."

DREAM A LITTLE DREAM: Cass Elliot of the Mamas and the Papas steps out here and Mama Cass has a wonderful album, which contains the title song, "Jane, the Insane Dog Lady," "California Earthquake" and others.

WINDOWS OF THE WORLD: A bright program of some of Dionne Warwick's finest performances featuring "I Say a Little Prayer," "You're Gonna Hear From Me" and "Always Something There to Remind Me."

IF YOU CAN BELIEVE YOUR EYES AND EARS: The very first album by the group that has proven a forerunner of the sound today, puts the spotlight on their "Monday Monday," "Go Where You Wanna Go," "Do You Wanna Dance" and "Spanish Harlem."

THE BEST OF THE IMPRESSIONS: The group's rock hits are well balanced with their ballad hits in this album that contains "Amen," "People Get Ready" and "We're a Winner."



PISCES, AQUARIUS, CAPRICORN & JONES LTD.: The Monkees, whose rise in popularity was meteoric, have a bright collection here which includes the hit "Pleasant Valley Sunday," "Hard To Believe" and others.

GOLDEN GRASS: The Grassroots have amassed an impressive list of hits, all of which are featured here. This set contains such selections as "Let's Live for Today," "Things I Should Have Said" and "Midnight Confessions."

LIVE AT THE APOLLO, Volume II: The excitement of a James Brown performance is captured in this two-record which includes the long version of "There Was a Time," "It's a Man's Man's Man's World" and "Please, Please, Please."

take care of your records

A record needs your attention and care if it is to give you maximum joy for maximum time. To care for a record properly one must consider two phases: 1) the playing of records and 2) the storage of records.

PLAYING:

1. Equipment is the key. Be sure to use proper equipment at all times. Be certain the stylus, especially, is in good condition. Your dealer will check it for you if you are in doubt. A faulty stylus will ruin your records.
2. The surface of the record reacts adversely to touch so records should be picked up at the rim and held with the palms of both hands flat against the rims. Fingering a record will transfer microscopic skin oils to the disk surface, and eventually dull the record's sound reproduction.
3. Dust is your record's enemy. Records should be dusted frequently, using either a lint-free cloth, or special dusting devices. Dusting should be done clock-wise, following the direction of the grooves.
4. The platform on which your records rest while playing should be kept clean. An unclean turntable surface will allow particles to become imbedded in the grooves of the record's reverse side while the disk is being played.

STORAGE:

1. Store your records the same way as you do your books. They should be kept away from heat and dampness. Be sure that they are not stored where sunlight may strike them. Heat warps records.
2. Records should be stored in a vertical or upright position held under mild pressure between other records or books. They should not be allowed to lean on either side, and above all, should not be kept flat so that warpage does not set in.
3. Records should be kept in the inner sleeve of an album. The sleeve should be slipped into the album cover with its open end toward the top.
4. Records should be dusted before they are stored. Whenever a disk surface has marks which dusting won't remove, a lint-free damp cloth should be used to wipe it clean.

LAUGH-IN: The entire cast of the Rowan and Martin hit TV show is on hand in this hilarious album of songs, sketches and just plain fun.



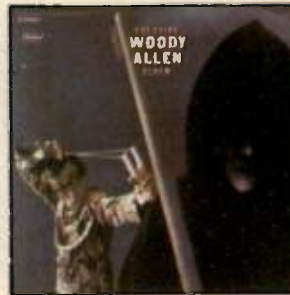

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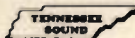


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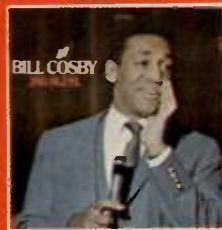

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Music for people on-the-go

For the on-the-go music fan, tape cartridge offers the latest in stereo listening excitement. This ingenious development offers the most convenient and efficient method of playing back recorded music as yet devised.

There are three different cartridge systems in use today. These are the 4-track cartridge, the 8-track cartridge (sometimes called Stereo 8 cartridge), and the cassette.

While they differ in their method of operation—enough so as to preclude the use of one type of cartridge in another system's players—they all have one thing in common. They all consist of a recorded tape sealed in a small plastic case. The listener merely slips the plastic case into its proper playback machine, and he instantly enjoys the music of his choice.

These plastic cases—or cartridges, as they are called—provide the listener with the benefits of a tape recording while sparing him the time and trouble of having to thread the tape through a player as in conventional reel-to-reel tape systems.

This feat is accomplished by having the cartridge so designed that the tape inside the case automatically rewinds itself while in operation. Both the 4-track and 8-track systems are similar in one respect. These consist of a single spool of tape with both ends of the tape spliced together to form

a continuous or "endless" loop. When the cartridge is in operation, the tape unwinds from the center of the spool, passes across the tape playback head in the player, and then rewinds itself around the circumference of the same spool. Thus, the tape can play continuously until the machine is turned off. The tape in both of these systems is a $\frac{1}{4}$ inch wide, and plays at $3\frac{3}{4}$ inches per second (i.p.s.).

The tape in the 4-track cartridge, as its name implies, consists of two double-track recordings. Each double-track reproduces a stereo recording. By merely flipping a control on his playback machine, the listener easily switches from one double-track program to the other. Usually each double-track program is comparable to a side on an LP. Thus, with a flip of a switch, the listener is able to hear "the other side" of his album while the cartridge remains in operation.

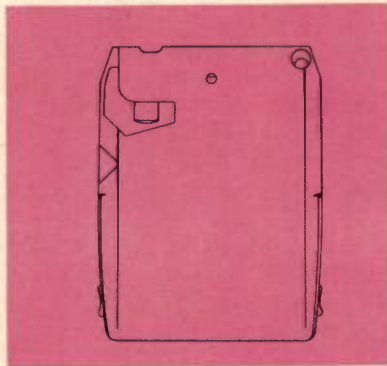
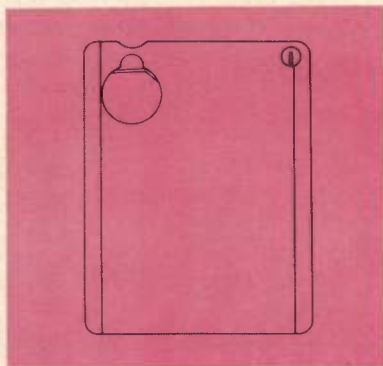
In the 8-track cartridge system, the tape contains four double-track recordings. All 8-track cartridge playback machines automatically switch from one double-track to the next so that the listener is able to hear what amounts to both sides of an album without touching the equipment. Most playback machines include a manual switch to permit the listener to change instantly from one double-track to the next.

Both the 4-track and 8-track systems have playback equipment available for installation in automobiles (where they are now in wide use), in boats and private planes. Also, playback units for use in the home rapidly are gaining popularity. In addition, their are a number of small portable players in wide use.

The cassette system consists of two tiny reels sealed in plastic to form the cartridge. One reel contains the tape while the other reel acts as a take-up spool when the cassette is in operation. The tape in the cassette is $\frac{1}{8}$ th inch in width and plays at $1\frac{1}{2}$ i.p.s. The cartridge in this system is smaller in size than either the 8-track and 4-track. This system, as the others, offer a wide variety of playback units for use in the home, car, boat, and private plane. It also offers a number of portables. Many of the cassette players also

feature a recording device, allowing the user to make his own family or dictation recordings as well as use the unit for playback purposes.

All these systems—8-track, cassette, or 4-track—offer the listener a highly portable method of reproducing his favorite music wherever he goes. The small size of the cartridges simplifies storage and handling, thus enhancing the portability of these systems. A list of the most popular recordings available in all cartridge forms is featured in the index section of this guide.

Cartridges make ideal gifts for the owner of a cartridge player. Just be sure you know which of the three systems he owns. And for the on-the-go individual, a cartridge player—which ever of the above three systems you select—will be a gift he will enjoy for years to come.
