



# NEWS TO US

**ISSUE 897** Finally TV on the Internet. ManiaTV! (exclamation point theirs) is the first company to take full advantage of broadcasting live video and audio on the Net in real time, establishing a 24/7 Internet television network dedicated to the latest in sports, music and entertainment—think MTV when it was young, feisty and not obscenely rich. Though the resolution of the average webcast can't compare to the mother's-milk-like soothing effect of a cathode ray tube, the upstart company certainly can compete through cutting-edge content.

Mania's *The Daily Independent* is a one-hour show dedicated to featuring the music of independent artists, running every weekday at 1 p.m. EST. Already one step ahead of MTV2's major label-saturated *Subterranean* (*Chromeo?* They really should know better), *The Daily Independent* has plans to feature artists from the big indies like Sub Pop (Postal Service, the Shins), Epitaph (Atmosphere, Elliott Smith), Matador/Beggars Group (Interpol, Dizzee Rascal) and TVT (Lil Jon, Pitbull). Lil Jon and Elliott Smith together on one network, arm in arm, morosely sipping crunk juice from a basement on the hill? Sounds like heaven. Check it out at [www.maniatv.com](http://www.maniatv.com).

★ Bonnaroo, the jammy festival jam-packed with hot bands and hot bongs, is stepping away from its noodley heritage for its 2005 festival. Show organizers have gravitated towards more top-tier indie-rock acts, making the

2005 Bonnaroo an ersatz Lollapalooza for folks that have three days to kill in the hot Tennessee sun: CMJ faves like Modest Mouse, My Morning Jacket, the Mars Volta, Joss Stone, Iron And Wine, Rilo Kiley, Joanna Newsom, Brazilian Girls, Secret Machines, Ozomatli and M. Ward will all be making appearances at the fest, taking place from June 10 to June 12 in Manchester, Tennessee (60 miles south of Nashville).

Jam fans fret not. With Dave Matthews Band, the Allman Brothers Band, STS9, Umphrey's McGee, Particle and two sets from Widespread Panic, someone is bound to solo longer than your buzz lasts! Bonnaroo 2005 will also feature a 24-hour cinema (for watching movies... *on weed!*), a classic video game arcade (for gaming... *on weed!*), a brewer's festival (for drinking brew... *on weed!*) and even a Mardi Gras parade (to quietly and respectfully celebrate our rich New Orleans heritage). The site, a 700-acre farm, will also be equipped with wireless hot spots, a digital message board system and an Internet Café. Tickets go on sale Saturday, January 29th at 10 a.m. EST.

★ As far as we're concerned, this whole-garage-rawk revival can crawl back underneath whatever bongwater-soaked copies of *Nuggets* it lurched out of... except, of course, the mighty Turbonegro and the equally mighty Guitar Wolf, whose very existences may be hard scientific proof that there is a God. Luckily, fans of Guitar Wolf (the hottest thing to roar out of Japan

since Gamera) will have plenty of reasons to have a psychotic reaction in 2005. On April 19, New York noiserati label Narnack (the freaknicks responsible for the last smattering of Guitar Wolf albums in the U.S.) will provide domestic release for the exceptional Japanese Guitar Wolf tribute album *I Love Guitar Wolf Very Much*, where bands such as Blues Explosion, Lightning Bolt, Jim O'Rourke, the D4 and Puffy Amiyumi pay tribute to the influential scuzz rockers.

Since the 20th anniversary of the Guitar Wolf is right around the corner, Narnack is planning some super surprise show at New York's Beacon Theatre with, reportedly, "big, big, big guests" (which, actually describes the fat bass player in any number of famous garage-rock bands). Meanwhile, following the success of *Hi Hi Puffy Amiyumi*, Guitar Wolf is in talks with the Cartoon Network about developing a toon about the bombastic black-clad boys themselves—he, as long as it's better than *Hammerman...*

★ When you think Tommy Boy records, you think Irish bossa nova. Well, at least that's what you'll be thinking when you dive into the soundtrack to the film *Goldfish Memory*, with classic Antonio Carlos Jobim tracks performed by Damien Rice and Lisa Hannigan. The soundtrack also features songs by some notable Irish bands like the Frames and the Walls providing a backdrop for the dramedy, which looks at dating in contemporary Dublin. So it's like the Irish *Singles?* The album will be released February 22.
