PROGRAM DIRECTOR
106.5 FM KXXR
KANSAS CITY

KXXR JUST EXPLODED IN THE FALL ARBITRON RATINGS BOOK. IT WENT 2.8 TO 6.0. THAT'S AN INCREDIBLE JUMP.

We are really pleased with what has transpired here. There has been a lot of hard work on all fronts, from promotion and programming to the sales department and the General Manager's chair, as well as a lot of corporate help from Olympia.

WHERE DO YOU HAVE THE STATION POSITIONED CURRENTLY?

It's a Rock Top 40 that leans very heavily on new music. There are two other Top 40s in town that had, up until recently, been very Urban oriented. There is an AOR, KYY, that is very gold based. We simply felt the niche was to play new Rock oriented Top 40 music.

SO YOU FEEL THE PENDULUM IS STARTING TO SWING THAT WAY?

Programmers around the country have allowed this position to exist by relying so heavily on Urban product and not being mass appeal or playing enough Rock product. They've essentially created a hole. PD's are now starting to re-evaluate what they've been doing and are beginning to see the value of incorporating more Rock oriented product into their mass appeal mix.

HAS THIS BEEN AN INTEGRAL PART OF YOUR BATTLE PLAN IN THE LAST SIX MONTHS?

Absolutely. On the one front, AOR's have been underserving their 18-24 year old demos and overserving their 25+. This has created a hole on the AOR side of the format. Therefore, there is a lot of interest with young adults who are AOR listeners, but who like new music.

WHAT ELSE MADE FOR THIS WONDERFUL SUCCESS IN KANSAS CITY?

We created a totally entertainment oriented product. I've gone on record as saying the 10 in-

a-row jukebox mentality is making radio very faceless. By making a radio station a totally entertaining medium through personalities, promotions, and music, you have a decisive advantage in this liner card industry.

I CERTAINLY SUPPORT YOUR PHILOSOPHY 100%. ALL ACROSS THE COUNTRY I SEE SO MUCH OF THIS ATTITUDE HEAVILY ENTRENCHED IN THE DEPTHS OF A PROGRAMMER'S SOUL.

A lot of the older programmers are very conditioned to what they believe works and doesn't work. I believe there are a lot of secondary market Program Directors who have some new and innovative ideas. Some of the older programmers should start trying to increase their awareness to what some other people are doing because these are the guys of the future. To the secondary guys out there, don't look to these major market Program Directors as total role models. Use your own ingenuity and try to improve upon the philosophies that they've used for so long.

TELL US ABOUT YOUR RELATIONSHIP WITH YOUR GENERAL MANAGER AND HOW IT WORKS?

Bill Hazen is our General Manager. He shows a lot of confidence in all his managers who work under him at the radio station. Consequently he gives us a lot of autonomy to make decisions. The decision making process internally is really a team effort among the managers of each department. There are no overwhelming egos creating any problems.

WHEN YOU GOT INVOLVED WITH BILL DID YOU HAVE A TALK WITH HIM AS TO WHAT THE BOUNDARIES OF THE RELATIONSHIP WERE?

I was hired before Bill. I had to do about 75 days of preliminary research before he came in. The segue was made very nicely. I am a team oriented player and so is Bill. After our first day together we knew that good things were going to happen.

DID YOU HAVE AN UNDERSTANDING THAT HELPED THE RELATIONSHIP TO WORK?

Naturally we discussed each other's philosophies and managerial styles. They seemed to be quite cohesive. Sometimes chemistry just happens. You know within a few hours of spending time with someone what their goals are and what their style is. It's one of those things that just happens.

WHO ARE THE KEY PLAYERS ON THE KXXR TEAM?

Bruce Demming was our Promotions Director, and now he has been elevated to the newly created position of Operations Manager. He oversees a lot of our promotions and marketing of the station and acts as a go-between on a lot of fronts in the coordinating of the sales department. It is a very valuable position and larger companies are just now beginning to justify the

position because of the value it has. We also have Gary Lekey who is a 20 year veteran sales manager in Kansas City. He knows Kansas City and he knows the people in it.

WHO ELSE IS ON YOUR STAFF?

Gary Franklin is our Assistant PD and Music Director. He is musically aggressive and has great ears. He also has good relationships with the record reps which is very valuable. I can get out of town for more than two days without worrying about the radio station. I know it's in good hands when I leave.

HOW WOULD YOU DESCRIBE YOURSELF AS A PROGRAM DIRECTOR? ARE YOU THE 24 HOUR TYPE WHOSE LIFE IS ALL RADIO, OR DO YOU SEE YOURSELF AS A MORE BALANCED PERSON?

Originally I was like that, but I think I've matured as a Program Director. I strive to listen like a listener and live my life like people who I'm programming to. I went to an Ozzy Osbourne concert last night. It's not that I'm an overwhelming fan of Ozzy Osbourne, but I went to get a feel for what the psychographic attending one of his concerts is like so I could keep that fresh in my mind. It's important to rub elbows with all different types of people. If you are truly programming mass-appeal radio you have to know what those people's lifestyles are like, whether you live it or not. It really is helpful on a day-to-day basis in making decisions.

IS THIS YOUR FIRST PROGRAMMING JOB?

No. I was with Drake-Chenault for a year as a consultant. Before that I was at KFMY in Salt Lake City and before that KSND in Eugene.

DID YOU WORK WITH BWANA JOHNNY?

I hired him for mornings. I was before Dave Shakes. Before that I was at KDU in Eugene which is an A/C-Top 40 hybrid. Dave was a PD for me when I was PD for a chain, and KWNZ in Reno was one of the stations in the chain. As a matter of fact, Todd Fisher did overnights for me in Reno and Jamie Hyatt, who is now at KDON in Salinas, was my old Music Director in Eugene.

WHAT DO YOU SEE DOWN THE ROAD FOR YOU? WHAT IS YOUR AMBITION IN RADIO?

To get rich. Seriously, I enjoy working with a lot of different people. I enjoy being opinionated and talking with guys younger than me who are facing the same problems I faced a few years ago. I want to teach them how to overcome them. I was brought up in a family of teachers and I guess there is some of that in my system. I want to have pride in our industry and I want it to get better. The only way for it to get better is for us to pass along our knowledge and to keep passing the torch to the next generation of radio programmers.



"CAN YOU BENEFIT FROM DOWN BOOKS AS WELL AS FROM THE UP BOOKS?"



CASEY KEATING PD, KPLZ - Seattle

You can always benefit from the up books. Down books are inevitable. They will always happen to a programmer at some time. There are very few stations that wouldn't expect that to happen at one time or another, so you take that and use it to your advantage. The first thing it should tell you is to keep your ego contained. Never believe your own press about ratings. It's a real ego container and it's also a chance to reveal what happened - what's going on in the marketplace, and if it's real or a fluke. It's a motivator. It gets you out there, out on the street to find out what's going on in people's minds. Sometimes the rebuilding process of fixing a bad book is as exciting as having a good book. Management realizes that Top 40 is a franchise, and they're going to protect it. It's not the end of the world when it goes down, and you have a real opportunity to make it better than ever. I just can't imagine any station saying we'll never have a down book. You will have them, so deal with it and use it to your advantage. It's only when something is broken that you can fix it. In our case right now it's the gnats, not the dragons, that are getting us. It's those real tiny things you have to do to win, and anytime I look at a ratings book, if we're down a little bit, I'll say, "Ok, let's find out what that gnat is! Where is the problem and how do we swat it, how do we fix it?" Generally we come up with something like "Oh wow, look at this, we can fix it," and we get a great sounding radio station because of the down book or a down trend. It does work.




ZAK SZABO PD, HOT95.9 - Baltimore

When you look at your down books you can take a look at your weaknesses and everyone else's weaknesses and you can react to that, but you can't react to just one book. The book goes up and down depending on the season and depending on the format.

ARE YOU SAYING THAT YOU CAN ALSO BENEFIT FROM A DOWN BOOK?

Yes you can. The up books only last as a natural high for about one hour, and then you're ready for your next book. When you have a good book it's easier to go upwards than to fall backwards. If you look at the trends, they don't reflect the outcome at the end anyway. If you panic every month it's just going to give you a heart attack. You can't do that. You've got to maintain a consistent sound. Sometimes you look at the numbers and you forget about the listeners. Keep servicing the listeners and the numbers will come.



KEITH ISLEY PD, HOT105 - Miami

There is no question about that. Any kind of a book, good or bad, is an opportunity to learn information about your station and the other stations. To have good books you have to understand why you have bad books. In some ways doing a thorough job of looking very carefully at the information in a bad book is even more important than when you're doing well. But of course by the same token you have to keep in mind ratings are not a precise science either, and that every once in a while a station is going to have a bad book for no reason other than some kind of sampling error. When looking at ARB's, either good or bad stations need to keep in mind that they really should look at them over a period of 2 or 3 books. If you are doing well and you have one bad book, then you have to resist being tempted into going into a panic mode and making changes just for the sake of making changes when the problem could be nothing more than an Arbitron sampling problem.

HOW DO YOU VIEW BOUNCING VERSUS DECLINING NUMBERS?

What you really have to understand is what other kind of activity is happening in your marketplace because every radio station has some kind of impact on every other station. Even stations not close to your format are going to have some kind of impact because there are only 100 shares and anytime any station goes up somebody else has to go down. What else is going on, such as a major advertising campaign or a major programming change at any station in the market, has the potential to influence your shares downward. The whole thing to keep in mind is to watch what causes those share changes. Is there something wrong with your station, or is it just due to the influence of activity elsewhere in the marketplace?



CHUCK BECK PD, WDFX - Detroit

I think you benefit by information and knowledge. I think it's very basic. You read the information and research and it's the way you interpret it to your gain or benefit. I mean the more information you have, whether it's from Birch, Arbitron, or your local research, the better off you are. So everyone should benefit and learn from it. That's the way I treat our research and books and numbers here.

HOW DO YOU VIEW BOUNCING VERSUS DECLINING NUMBERS?

I think you have to look at trends. I think if you take one book that's way down or one book that's way up, you have to weigh out your trends and watch for things happening instead of having a major reaction to one book. I think that is a major mistake if you have an ARB that drops way down and you start immediately making reactions. I think you should watch for trends and be aware of what's going on around you. I think programmers make a lot of mistakes when they see a down book and they immediately react and go insane and start changing the whole radio station. You have to watch the trends before doing that.



RIC LIPPINCOTT OM, Z95 - Chicago

Sure, a down book will tell you where you made mistakes and who in the market made the right decisions. A lot of times we tend to think of Z95 as being the sole controller of its destiny, but other radio stations in the marketplace will also control the destiny of your radio station or will have an effect on it. You can do a real good job, but if two other radio stations are doing a real good job also, you won't perform as well in the audience estimates. If you're doing a good job and one of the other two stations drops out, you might have an up book without actually changing anything. It's a tough question to answer other than to say that absolutely the down books are where the lessons are learned. I think that programmer depression was more prominent in the old days when they used to get four books a year and the sweeps were for four weeks each. They had to live with their mistakes for so long before the next sweep. Today a down quarterly report can be turned around within 30 days, and it almost seems like the Arbitrend and the monthly information has had a leveling effect on a programmer's emotions. I used to compare the emotion of a Program Director against the sales people at a radio station. The Program Director looks at a down book and it's devastating emotionally for him or her and they live with that for a period of time, though it's less time today than in yesteryear. A salesperson loses a buy and that afternoon they're in pitching someone else, and they might land a big account. Emotionally, they've got more opportunity to feel good about themselves or to stabilize their overall emotional makeup than a Program Director does. A Program Director has more opportunity, as I stated earlier, in that continuous ratings have had a more stabilizing effect emotionally than they used to have.



BILL RICHARDS PD, KKBQ - Houston

It's just like they always say, and I believe it to be true, you learn more by your mistakes than you do by your victories. That can be said of looking at your down books versus your up books. When you're down you've got to figure out how to get back up, so you really study what it is you're doing and what's wrong, and look at those stations that are having up books and try to figure out what they are doing right. It's a very simple question with what I think is a very simple answer. I think you can really look at trends and all sorts of things. A lot of people think Arbitron is inaccurate or a fluke. I think that Arbitron tells a lot of stories that are very seldom lies, if you really study it. I'm personally very good at breaking out the Arbitron. I was taught at a very young age by PD's I've worked with and other people along the way like George Burns. I do a lot of trending and tracking of rating information. You don't want to over react on a down book. You don't want to play it safe with an up book. A lot of stations have skyrocketed in a certain demo and think they're kicking ass only to see it go away the next book. In reality, if you would have done your homework, you would have known to keep working at it. If we did better this time I'd say, "Let's pay attention to this because I don't think it's going to be here next book." You really have to look at what the book is telling you.



"CAN YOU BENEFIT FROM DOWN BOOKS AS WELL AS FROM THE UP BOOKS?"

TOM CHASE PD, KROY - Sacramento

Definitely. It's almost more important to realize why you succeed than it is just to succeed. If you can't learn from your down books and learn from any mistakes you made, or at least analyze situations and changing trends, then you are not going to enjoy future success. An up book due to dumb luck might be less beneficial than a down book that points you in the direction of future success.

SO WHAT YOU'RE SAYING IS A SUCCESSFUL PROGRAMMER LEARNS FROM HIS DOWNS AS WELL AS HIS UPS IN THE ARB. WHAT WOULD YOU SAY IS THE APPROPRIATE WAY TO INTERPRET THE QUARTERLY ARBITRON BOOK? DO YOU HAVE A PARTICULAR PHILOSOPHY FOR VIEWING AND STUDYING THE RATINGS?

Prior to the availability of monthly trends, you had to look at the Quarterly Arbitron as the recent past, meaning you were trying to steer your radio station by looking in the rear view mirror. Now with the addition of monthly trends, I think that we're all able to keep our finger on the pulse of the direction of our stations. I don't think you can look at a Quarterly Arbitron as an absolute, telling you where your station is at this moment. I think you have to look at where your current trend is going and what's your view of the market.

HAS YOUR EXPERIENCE AS A PROGRAMMER INTERPRETING THE BOOK BEEN LOOKING AT WHAT WENT WRONG AS WELL AS WHAT WENT RIGHT?

Well, you'll never be satisfied with what you achieved. Successful people are always burning to get one step further, and therefore you have to analyze it as what could we have done better to achieve greater results.

BILL TANNER VP/Programming, POWER96 - Miami

Well, you can always learn from any situation and I think one of the best learning experiences is a down book where you have to get in and figure just what happened. We've had up books, we've had down books, we'll have many more of both I'm sure, and I think the down books probably cause a little bit more introspection. You look inward to try and find out what went on in your station as well as what forces took place in the marketplace. I think the basic process of analyzing any ratings that you get back is the same, you should look not only at what you are doing but what the rest of the market is doing, and the effect it's having on shares in the market as a whole and in your format specifically.

WHAT DO YOU FIGURE IS THE APPROPRIATE WAY TO INTERPRET THE QUARTERLY ARBITRON BOOK?

I think what we really get these days for all practical purposes is a new Arbitron every 30 days. They just publish one every third month and call it an Arbitron as opposed to an Arbitrend. There are in fact some major differences that take place between the Arbitrend and the Arbitron, but to all intents and purposes they are a continuing story of the market. I think the important thing to remember with all Arbitrons is that they deal with history. They're always dealing with what is taking place at least 30 days ending and 30 days prior to when you get the report. The main thing to do is chart a reasonable, well thought-out market course specific for your radio station, and follow it with a good degree of singularity, but at the same time know what's going on with your competitors. You are always a product of what you do first and foremost, and that's what you control yourself. But you're also, to some degree, a product of the competitive forces that surround you, and you control those to some small extent also. Analyzing the Arbitrons that are coming out now and the Birch and all the other tons of ratings data that we get so much more of today seems like just part of what a modern Program Director does.

HOW SHOULD ONE VIEW DECLINING NUMBERS?

I think that numbers that are consistently declining over a long period of time have to be viewed as a sign that you need to examine the very roots of what you do, and the basic appeal of your radio station. Numbers that bounce around for a book or two are to be regarded as possibly that the market is in a state of flux. Things may calm down after all the changes have a chance to settle in with the public. I think one of the worst things that people do is that they get one bad Arbitron book and everyone panics and runs around and people start firing people. Program Directors get fired and Disc Jockeys get fired. It creates a state of near panic and perpetual instability in the market which is just not justified. Frequently the same Program Director that runs into numbers trouble at one station gets fired, goes to a station across the street and takes that

station to the top of the market. He didn't suddenly get smart when he went to station B from station A, he was pretty smart all along, just circumstances combined to make that particular situation look weird. The most important thing to keep in mind is this too shall pass. You're going to have good books and you are going to have bad books. Some of us always think that we are going to have nothing but up books. I got that reality check knocked into my head a long time ago, but it's important for the whole company to know it. A lot of people pay lip service to it, then they continue to freak out anytime they get a bad book. The reality is ARB's are going to go up and they're going to go down. I think people who live on the cutting edge of performance, as all of us in programming and other related fields do, are going to feel elation when we get an up book and feel disappointment when we get a down book. I think that's perfectly normal, but the major thing is don't throw out the baby with the bath water. Don't panic just because you get a down book. There are many factors that could have taken place, and there are many options you have to repair whatever mistakes you've made. Good managers and owners will realize when they have a good programming talent, and will hold on to them through thick and thin, until it becomes apparent that the Program Director is incorrect for that particular radio station. Great Program Directors have, at times, very bad rating books, and I don't think that for a long period of time very poor Program Directors have great rating books. That's the bottom line.

BILL DAWSON PD, Q124 - Roseburg, OR

I'd rather be very consistent. I don't get real excited when I have a real down book, and I don't get real excited when I have a real up book. The ARB can tell you, maybe, what you're doing right or wrong and what you can do better. Obviously if you have a really up book and then you have a really down book, either there was a real fluke that happened in the reporting, or you really are doing something wrong or made a drastic format change and it just went boom. It's like I said, I just don't get real excited either way. I'd rather see a consistent trend from book to book. I do know that when I have a down book I start re-evaluating. What are we doing? Where is it down? Is it down overall or is it down in certain dayparts? It tells me what I should be changing or whether I should make any changes at all. It doesn't really frighten me one way or another and it doesn't really bother me that much. If I had three or four down books, then I would start looking for a new gig.

CHRIS BAKER PD, KCPX - Salt Lake City

You also have to look at it as a trend. You can't just look at one down book and rely on that totally as being the answer because you always have to remember that all these surveys are estimates, which they state at the beginning of the report. If you are going to look at it, you need to look at a three book trend, and not just one book. But if you are going to look at it as a down book, you need to look and see where you lost shares. Try to pinpoint that and go back and look over what you've done. Try and figure out where you can recover. Find out if you are taking a beating somewhere. Find out why and what could be causing it in whatever daypart or demographic. Everybody has had those down books and sometimes you have to hold tight and believe you had a bad sample base or whatever and keep doing what you've done and you'll see that it comes back.

LEO DAVIS PD, Q104 - Gadsden, AL

ARB's are so hard to analyze. I think a down book is almost like new competition coming into the market, which is what happens a lot of times, so it can take a station that is set in their ways and make them think a little bit and be a little stronger and come up with new ideas. Whereas if you are always sitting on top, and you are always having an up book, you feel like "I'm doing great, I don't have to change anything," and you can get lazy that way. I think you can benefit in that respect, but I believe a smart programmer should always stay alert and always act like your last book was a down book. Keep trying to improve, and no matter what you can stay on top.

LYNDON ABELL PD, KBQ - St. Louis

There are a lot of things that can be considered benefits, one of them is the change in the competitive environment. Obviously if a down book keeps you from being attacked by somebody who may have considered changing format at that time, and didn't because there weren't enough shares to make it look attractive, it might buy you some time to implement everything that you want to implement, thereby allowing you success in the long haul. But that's really talking about a side benefit of the numbers going down, not the listeners going down. I'm not a real reactionary programmer. I think that one thing that people in radio need to keep in mind, myself included, is that these Arbitrons are estimates at the very best. Radio is a very mobile and difficult medium to measure. The average household has several radios. There are radios in the home, car, bathroom, office, your

friend's car, your friend's house, your friend's office, and the store that you shop in. They're everywhere. You hear radio in a lot of different places. Measuring all of that is really next to impossible, so what we are left with is measuring recall from those who are willing to put up with the Birch interviews or the Arbitron diaries. At best they are dealing with a small sample base, and they are certainly weeding out a certain type of individual who doesn't like to or care to respond to written or telephone inquiries. Anybody who is doing call-out research, which is similar to doing Birch, knows that lots of people hang up on you and you're not even going to sell them anything.

My point is that you should treat a down book not so severely. You should treat a down book with a question mark. In the same regard, you shouldn't go out and tell everybody you are the greatest thing in the world just because your station went up a point. You could very easily go back down a half point in the next book. Rather than just do that, examine what you did right to cause that. In the end it's going to be the long haul that determines how successful or unsuccessful you are, which is different for a radio station that's on the way up or a new station such as ourselves. It makes it very difficult if you're placed in the position of living or dying by one book, and there are a lot of people out there like that. We all take it very seriously. We have to since it's our livelihood, but in taking it seriously, understand the limitations of the ratings profits. It's fairly severe, but it gives you somewhat consistent results. I would question anybody who says they're supremely accurate. Going back to your original question, obviously there is the benefit of learning from mistakes. I would say that anyone as an individual can benefit by picking themselves up, dusting themselves off, figuring what they did wrong, and what they could have done to succeed. I don't think that can benefit the radio station too much. It may benefit the radio station down the line, because this person is a smarter person, but you would be better off winning as a radio station. There are always benefits to learning from your mistakes. If you can't learn from your mistakes you're going to find it hard to succeed in anything.

HANK NEVINS PD, MAJIC102 - Buffalo


We all have to take the good with the bad, and what you have to do is use those down books to analyze what the problem is and what you can do to improve it. By the same token, anybody who has been in the business for any length of time knows not to overreact to either a down book or a real up book because you're always going to get some fluctuation. If you see some downward trending, you can always benefit from that by analyzing what it is you're doing, and perhaps what it was you were doing when you were up.

JAY JARVIS PD, WGTZ - Dayton, OH

I think it's how you look at it and how you take it. You have to take Arbitron with a grain of salt because you're going to have some spiked books, and you're going to have books where the diaries might fall strangely. They might have diaries falling in an ethnic part of town where an Urban station might benefit. I've had down books since I've been here, but in the long run looking where we were when I arrived and where we are now, we're way up! So you can look at those down books to try and get a handle on the mistakes or the misdirection the station might be going in to make minor adjustments. Even to do that I would prefer to have at least two books to look at before I start making any serious changes. I had a night guy who had a pretty shaky book this past spring, and we were looking at that real hard. I called the jock and talked to him and let him know that I was concerned about it. We talked about what we were doing with the show and what we could do to change things around. We didn't make any major changes. We just tried to tighten it up and be sure we weren't getting off track and going in the wrong direction. We made sure we were going for the same goals. Sure enough the summer book came out and he had great numbers, and we just got the fall book today and he had great numbers. So definitely never make a major decision based on one down book.

JEFF CHRISTENSEN OM, KKQV - Wichita Falls, TX

I think without a doubt you can learn more from a down book because you sit up straight and take a look at where your weaknesses might be and where your strong points are. I think overall it matures the entire staff. It can pull an entire staff together or it can tear it apart depending on how you look at the book. I think even when you have an up book it's best to pretend like you have a down book, because as soon as you are no longer hungry, that's when they get you. I think our adrenalin comes from what we don't know. We're all enthused when going after the unknown...that success.

The shows, tentatively scheduled for July and next fall, will be part of a world tour that will see them playing their first concerts in Europe in 15 years and their first ever in France. Tickets have already gone on sale for shows in Germany. The tour will hit 10 more countries this year before going down under and to the Far East in early 1990. The BEE GEES will release their new album overseas in March, but will wait until July to issue it in America. Aside from appearances at special concerts last year, ATLANTIC Records' 40th Anniversary Party, The Nelson Mandela Tribute and a Prince's Trust Benefit, this is the trio's first major tour in more than a decade.


MR. MISTER RETURNS TO STUDIO WITH NEW GUITARIST... MR. MISTER is returning to the studio with a new guitarist, Buzz Felten, and a new approach to their music. Felten, who is officially replacing Steve Farris, is described by lead singer/songwriter Richard Page as a "more blues oriented guitarist. His technique is excellent, and he plays with conviction as well. The guy's got lots of soul. I think it will have a profound effect on MR. MISTER'S sound." Felten, who was a member of the Butterfield Blues Band at age 19, went on to become a member of Stevie Wonder's band before he formed the cult group Full Moon with Nell Larsen. Studio work on the yet untitled LP begins next week with producer Paul Devilliers, who produced the band's multi-platinum LP, *WELCOME TO THE REAL WORLD*.

KANSAS FANS TO TAKE THE STAGE ONCE AGAIN... KANSAS was so pleased with the results of inviting fans onstage to sit and sing back-up with them on their last tour, they're doing it again this time. In select cities, there will be three sets of bleachers on the stage, holding

45 fans, winners of radio station contests. KANSAS kicks off their tour for the album *IN THE SPIRIT OF THING* in Joplin, Missouri. Night Ranger will be their special guests. The tour will run through the spring.

ANNUAL MUSIC CONVENTION PERFORMANCES TO BE TELECAST IN EUROPE... The talent line-up has been set for the Annual MIDEM convention, the music convention meeting in Cannes January 22 through the 25th. To heighten consumer awareness, convention organizers have arranged for Rock and Jazz concerts to be broadcast throughout Europe. They are hoping the shows will also be shown in America. Breathe, The Gipsy Kings, Judson Spence, Milli Vanilli, Fairground Attraction, Tom Tom Club, Colin James and Prefab Sprout will be among the artists performing. Chuck Mangione, Billy Cobham and Ben Sidran will appear in the Jazz concert.

DEPECHE MODE FILM PREMIERES NEXT MONTH... D.A. Pennebaker's film of DEPECHE MODE'S last tour will be premiered at the Berlin Film Festival next month and have special screenings in New York, Los Angeles, Toronto and London. Plans are to follow the screenings by opening *Depeche Mode 101* in 50 more cities throughout April. The \$400,000 production follows a busload of fans who travel cross country to see the band's show at the Rose Bowl in Pasadena last June. Martin Gore says DEPECHE MODE is not worried about the poor showings of recent Rock films. He says, "Depeche Mode 101 will be handled more as an art film along the lines of the Talking Heads' successful *Stop Making Sense*." Gore adds that the band will support the film with a live album coming out in March, and a two week promotional visit during which they'll attend premieres in major cities. "But," says Gore, "we are going to underplay everything. There will be no massive advertising campaign. We are just going to let the film make it on its own merits."
