



portfolio, selling a resounding 806k in the four days between its release last Thursday (2/6) and the closing of the chart.

Hastings' Mike Fuller took time out from dropping some science on his co-workers to enthuse: "After one of the most lackluster Januarys in memory, the heat surrounding the 50 Cent release is astounding. Interscope did a phenomenal job of setting this record up and reacting quickly to the piracy issues... Damn—I meant to freestyle that quote."

While the carryover effect wasn't as pronounced as on previous blockbuster weeks, 30 of the top 50 albums showed sales increases, including Open Wide/Columbia/CRG's Dixie Chicks, who gained 7% despite being unseated from the top spot by the unchivalrous 50 Cent, and Lava/Atlantic/Atl G's Kid Rock, who climbed on ex-girlfriend Sheryl Crow's Harley and zoomed to #3 on a whopping 40% increase.

Blue Note's Norah Jones (+2%) and Arista's Avril Lavigne (+3%) rounded out the Top Five. Behind them were Epic/SMS' Chicago soundtrack (which should pick up steam after scoring 13 Oscar noms) at #6, Epic's J.Lo at #7, WB cowpoke Blake Shelton bowing at #8, Goldmind/Elektra/EEG's Missy Elliott at #9 and Def Jam/IDJ's LL Cool J reentering in the 10th slot. Just missing the Top 10 was Wind-up's debuting Daredevil soundtrack at #11.

Fuller removed his street-style headphones just long enough to offer the following assessment: "Yo. Kid Rock had another huge gain behind his duet with Sheryl Crow, and the new cut that was stripped onto the LL Cool J record helped it take a big jump this week as well. Word."

The big story next week will be where 50 Cent winds up after his first full week in the stores.

# Old School/New School: Oscar Gets in Tune

The sound of music will resonate through the Kodak Theatre on March 23, when the 75<sup>th</sup> Academy Awards are handed out.

And that will include a list of potential winners in the musical categories ranging from 42-time nominee John Williams to first-time honoree Eminem.

With 13 nods, Chicago stands to become the first musical to be honored with the Best Picture Oscar since Oliver! back in 1968. In addition, hip-hop singer-turned-sitcom star Queen Latifah received a berth in the Best Supporting Actress category.

Oscar's music categories were dominated by a combination of old Hollywood standbys and rap and rock upstarts.

In the Original Song category, the big news is the presence of Eminem, snubbed in the acting categories for his critically acclaimed performance in 8 Mile, but getting a nod for "Lose Yourself," which he wrote with Jeff Bass and

Luis Resto. The Shady/Interscope/UMG Sdtrx album has sold close to 4 million.

Golden Globe winners U2's "The Hands That Built America," the song over the final credit sequence in *Gangs of New York*, gives Bono & Co. their first Oscar nomination ever.

Another Golden Globe winner, for Best Score, Frida composer Elliot Goldenthal, is up for that honor, as well as Original Song with "Burn It Blue," featuring lyrics by director Julie Taymor.


"I Move On," a song written especially for the end titles of *Chicago* by John Kander & John Ebb, who were previously nominated for '75's *Funny Lady*, is also contending in this category.

The final Original Song nominee is veteran Paul Simon, who burst to fame on the heels of his music in another movie, *The Graduate*, some 36 years ago. The veteran nabs his very first nomination for "Father and Daugh-

ter," from Nickelodeon's The Wild Thomberrys.

In addition to Goldenthal, longtime Spielberg collaborator Williams tops the list of nominees for Music Score, as he's acknowledged for his work on Catch Me If You Can. Also nominated in this category is another legendary film composer, Elmer Bernstein, for his '50s-evoking Far From Heaven score, along with Thomas Newman for Road to Perdition and Philip Glass for The Hours.





# 50 Cent Piece Count

You can stab him, you can shoot him nine times, you can try to keep him down, but no one can deny that Queens rapper 50 Cent's Shady/Aftermath/Interscope debut is a MONSTER.

Yes, indeed, at a time when #1 albums have been moving little more than 100k per week, 50 Cent's Get Rich or Die Tryin' stormed this week's chart with 806k. That's eight times the sales in roughly half the time, folks, as Interscope moved the release date forward five days from its original Feb. 11 release date to last Thursday (2/6). The enormous tally on just four days of sales brought 50 Cent's album the biggest debut since Shania Twain's Up! did 862k in November—a testament to Interscope's swift action in covering initial stock gaps.

Tower Records' Bob Feterl was blown away by the album's sales performance: "It's hard to remember a debut record that ever had this big a buzz in front of it. We all knew it was going to be a big record, but no one had any idea it would be this big. Credit UMVD with reacting to stock outages as quickly as they did. This is the first truly big record of the year."

The controversial rapper's major-label bow was pushed up due to rampant Internet piracy, according to Interscope Geffen A&M marketing guru and TV pitchman Steve Berman, who gushed, "50 Cent has exceeded our wildest expectations. It's a tribute to the vision of Eminem and Dr. Dre and the artistry of 50 Cent."

Trans World's Jerry Kamiler wasn't pleased with the label's decision to offer 99cent downloads of the track starting last Tuesday (2/4) on Pressplay and Liquid Audio, but he applauded the move to get the record in stores early: "We didn't have quite the amount of street-date violators that we did during Eminem's early release.

"We'll never be the first to break street date," Kamiler vowed. "But we'll never be the third, either,

It's rare that an album goes on sale on a day other than Tuesday, though it was done last Memorial Day weekend, when Eminem's The Eminem Show went on sale on Sunday instead of the following Tuesday. Then, last December, Columbia moved the release date of its Nas album up several days, as well.

Kamiler confirms that outages were a factor, but says that Trans World was hurt somewhat less than other retailers: "We were able to react quickly enough on Thursday to fix most, if not all, of the stock problems we had in our stores."


The Jamaica, Queens-born rapper, born Curtis Jackson, made his reputation by selling bootleg mix tapes on the street before inking a reported million-dollar deal with Eminem and Dr. Dre last spring. His feuds with, among others, Ja Rule, Murder Inc.'s Irv Gotti and Source magazine have served to heighten his appeal.



# **JOHNNY'S GOT A BRAND-NEW PARADIGM**

Double-Grammy Nominee John Mayer Has a Lot on His Mind, and He'll Tell You All About It

ohn Mayer is a talker, so much so that he managed to jam an hour-long interview into 15 minutes the other day. The 25-year-old double-Grammy nominee-for Best New Artist and Male Fop Vocal Performance—is also an immensely talented songwriter and an astounding guitarist, with one classic—the double-platinum-andstill-growing debut album Room For Squares—already under his belt. Artists like this don't grow on trees, which is why A&R reps are having such a hard time finding the next John Mayer. And for those who haven't seen this cat live, Aware/Columbia has just released Any Given Thursday, which documents, on double-CD and DVD, an entire, typically dynamic, live performance. Asking the questions and then getting out of the way during the course of the following near-monologue was the far-from-dynamic Bud "Hunt & Peck" Scoppa.

In terms of the Best New Artist Grammy, you obviously don't stand a chance. You're going up against four females-and one of them is Norah Jones. Yeah. Well, I understand Norah's thing completely-I know why.

# You do? Would you explain it?


Sure. Norah is the artist that people wish they were alive in the era of, and now have come to realize that they actually are. Because this generation will always wish that they had the same kind of reverence for music—that they had a reason to have reverence for music as their parents did. Norah Jones is the current real-time embodiment of all those classic remastered records that we have to listen to in order to hear these great artists. And I think people are jumping at the opportunity to now have an artist that they can see at a show tonight, that they can say 20 years from now that they saw. People are dying for that kind of history. That's the way I felt when I heard her, and I think there's a great effect in writing music that makes people feel smarter.

Lemme throw this out there, although it will sound like a bullshit question: Do the Grammys hold any significance for you?

Yes, they have a cultural significance for me, but they don't have an impact that would make me feel better about myself in and of the moment. But winning a Grammy would allow me to see all the other people who've gotten Grammys in that category and to see myself a little clearer in terms of how far I've come—because it's very difficult to see.

You're the son of a pair of academics. Although your stuff doesn't come as overly scholarly by any means, there's clearly a consciousness involved—an organization to everything you do. I grew up in a house where "fuck" wasn't particularly funny, but where you can really make somebody laugh if you choose the right word at the right time. I don't remember learning anything in school, but I remember learning everything at the dinner table-really going out for the long pass in terms of trying to impress my mom with word usage, usually having her correct whatever the wrong word was and send me on my way with the right one. I never forgot the words I learned. You couldn't get up from the dinner table except to consult a dictionary.

I find having a command of a range of tools is the same no matter what you do—the same musically, the same verbally. It's a matter of how your knowledge of something settles into your work so that it becomes intuitive. I just have a thing where I don't line two big words up to-

gether at the same time—that's like wearing all your best clothes on the same day. I mean, communication is a way of me getting you to understand what I'm thinking. If I can do that with the word "good," then perfect. So it's just a matter of using what you know at the right time.

# That results in accessibility.

Clever is an element, it's not an entire entity. I grew up starting to play open mics and coffee houses, and for a singer-songwriter of the truest caliber, clever is really what you go for all the time. But clever doesn't really hit people. Clever goes to your head, and feeling goes to your gut, you know? And I think there's a balance between being clever but also having something to put across. Looking back on it now, I think Room for Squares might be a little bit more cerebral than a gut punch. Right now in my life, I love the gut punch—and no one does that to me like Coldplay. Coldplay is all about the gut punch. It's an amazing album, and it's earnest. It's incredibly musical and incredibly important, a great male work of art, with real tenderness and introspection. It's a record of regret, remorse, apology, admission.

Do you consider Any Given Thursday your second official major-label album or a side thing?

I still call it a side thing. Room for Squares is my only record out, really. Everything that's not perfectly stated is not a statement to me.

And yet, if you consider Room for Squares to be too clever, you can correct that by presenting these songs in a sweatier way.

nology is an amazing thing, because technology has now equalized every single person in the sense of giving them an equal chance at making it. If you have \$2,000, you can make a record, too. And that's great, because it's gonna come down to talent.

Your new song, "Something's Missing," made a big impression on me when I first heard it during your Troubadour show in December. It struck me as a zeitgeist-referencing song, very much of the moment, and quite distinct from the introspective, personalized songs that dominate *Room for Squares*. Is that an important song for you?

"Something's Missing" was the first song of the new era for me. It actually serves as the archetype for the record that I'm making now. It'll sound more like "Something's Missing" than it'll sound like "No Such Thing." I've kind of embraced a more adult, more relaxed kind of sexiness rather than a frantic sexiness—a more relaxed musicality. It's not a chord a second; it's not these beats that are so poppy and swing so hard that they're like rays of sunlight. "Something's Missing" was the first song to come out of me that was really close to being exactly what I want in a song. I'm lucky to have that song because it showed me the way to my other songs.

I'm coming up with stuff that really excites me. My criterion for writing now is, "Do I want to play it live?" and will I want to play it live for two years? So I'm only finishing the ones that I'm gonna want to play for a long time...like this new song

"We will never get further along in this dialog as long as people keep condemning kids for stealing. They're not stealing. It's reprehensible to tell a kid that, by him double-clicking this thing, it's the same as stealing a pair of shoes from a store."



Absolutely. I mean, there are fucked-up notes all over this record. We didn't fix a lot of stuff at all—that's why it's called *Any Given Thursday*. I got a great representation of a really good night out of it. So it's the full set, in sequence, and some of the highs I think are brilliant, and some of the lows are laughable. But you know what? That's what happens in a live show.

Is there a lot of that audience-participation stuff going on?

Absolutely. We have raffles and stuff.

The reason I ask is it would annoy me if the girls in the audience singing along drowned you out.

That's the issue with people at shows. I survive emotionally from playing shows, and I want those shows to be as important as they possibly can be. And at some point, I'm gonna figure out a way to accommodate each person at the show, not just physically but recreationally. There's two types of showgoers: There's the scream-along, "I love you" people, and there are the people who fold their arms and sway. And right now, those two types of people are standing next to one another.

# I'm a swayer.

Don't get me wrong—I'm a swayer, too. I represent swayers.

I think we've just stumbled upon the title of your next studio album—*Room for Swayers*. Speaking of that, how far along are you on that project?

I'm doing it all at my house right now; I'm just demoing. Y'know, tech-

"Fister." I'm kidding.

Hey, real quick, 'cause you're from HITS, and you're very ensconced in the argu-

ment of, "Why is the industry slumping? Is it because of file-sharing?" Print this if you can: We will never get further along in this dialog as long as people keep condemning kids for stealing. They're not stealing. What we're doing is, we're aggressively combating ignorance by saying, "Stop that!" Instead of trying to introduce kids to the love of a record. I just think it's reprehensible to tell a kid that, by him double-clicking this thing, it's the same as stealing a pair of shoes from a store. That will never, ever get a positive response from a kid, ever. Evereverever. But what it takes is, "Check this record out. There's a reason they print these things up and not put 'em over the Internet." There's a reason—and teach these kids the reason.

Your career is a testament to the effectiveness of that very taboo when it's employed in the service of building a buzz and, ultimately, a career. Absolutely. And it's difficult for me to have a true, unbiased vantage point because I've done well from it. But I also could've probably sold another half-million records if it wasn't for the burning. So it still affects me, but not in the way it affects someone with one diamond on their record and the rest rock candy. I just think it takes turning kids on to why they should own a CD. Turning kids on to the same thing that excited you when you got a Bob Dylan record; the same thing that excited me when I got a Stevie Ray Vaughan CD. There's a way to turn kids on to whole works of art—and it's not gonna get any better with labels putting their singles on Now compilations.

You turn people's ears off when you say downloading a song is the same thing as shoplifting. It's an imbecilic statement to make, and it blows the conversation out of proportion, so that you cannot have any rational dialog whatsoever... [takes a deep breath] Ahhhhh. Your counterclaim is dismissed. •

CAUGHT IN THE RAIN: I went to see Phantom Planet headline a sold-out show at the El Rey on Saturday night, after missing their also-sold-out show at the Roxy the night before. Now anybody who knows me at least peripherally knows I adore this band, and I have unyielding confidence that their talent will elevate them to worldwide prominence. Until the inevitable time when they sell millions and forget my name, I'm delighted the band includes me in its orbit. I'll admit to being slightly agitated when I realized the T-shirt I'd chosen to wear to the show (circa-Hermit of Mink Hollow Todd Rundgren) was older than any member of Phantom Planet. I'd better re-think what I'm going to wear to take Interpol to radio stations this week. I guess the **Television** T-shirt (circa-Marquee Moon) stays behind.... I suppose I'd better start making my mark, as it were, if I ever hope to transcend merely being old to LEG-

(despite Lenny Diana's reputation as a pushover), and even if these stations view the song as a "flavor" record, I believe they'll be surprised by their audience's passion for the Man in

END status. You can't think about Johnny Cash without the word "leqend" coming to mind. He has absolutely earned every bit of fame and respect he's acquired. "Hurt" was #2 Most Added this week at PoMo. Every time KROQ plays the song, the phones ring off the hook. This isn't because Johnny Cash is the star of a reality show on TV, or any other reason that would smack of "novelty." The song resonates with people who hear it, regardless of the demo. It's the "magic factor" in effect, which is



Black.... Sometimes it takes more than a moment for radio programmers to accept that their audience's taste may differ from their own perception of their audience's taste. Most programmers didn't immediately "hear" the Evanescence song, "Bring Me To Life," which propelled the Daredevil soundtrack to a #5 debut on the HITS PoMo chart. PoMo radio hasn't exactly embraced the new Mudvayne song, "Not Falling," despite the CD selling over 10k/weekly. Whenever I hear the Atari's "In This Diary" on KROQ, I know this is a song destined to be one of the biggest hits of the year (I'm old, I know things). Jeff Sodikoff and Stephanie Harty had another massive week at PoMo, including WHFS, WBCN, WZNE, KFMA, KZON, WEDG, WGRD, WMRQ, KROX and more. Seriously, if you can't hear this record for your station, you should explore future opportunities in another format, preferably one I don't care about.... Congrats to Lynn McDonnell on landing her first Hot Hot Heat add, as the band moves from Sub Pop to Reprise. Yes indeed, KROQ added "Bandages," which is set for an add date of March 25. Lynn and Kurt are ruling the PoMo airwaves with The Used's "Buried Myself Alive," including KTBZ, WJRR, KKND, WEDG and WRZK.... Pete Rosenblum, Buddy Deal and Mike DiPippa had a spectacular week on two new Elektra bands: Socialburn's "Down" is performing like a HIT RECORD, prompting new love from Q101, KNDD, KTZO and WHTG. Blindside's "Sleepwalking" was added at WHFS, WBUZ, WDYL, KRZQ and KNXX, earning the Elektra gang a good night's sleep!.... Next week, it's ALL ABOUT THE WHITE STRIPES. Perry Ferrell's signature shit-eatin' grin was illuminating the room at Amoeba Records in L.A. when he, Dave and Stephen of Jane's Addiction announced the tour's comeback. WHJY's John Laurenti gets old school: "This is the first album in years that you can just needle-drop and anywhere it lands on the album you know it's gonna be a hit and magical on the air. That hasn't happened for me since Metallica's black album"... Epic labelmates Chevelle have another hit taking radio by storm with new "Send the Pain Below" adds, including WAAF, WIYY, KRXQ, WLZR, WRAT and WTFX. WTKX's Shark knows: "It's gonna be a monster. That melody just sticks in your head." WIYY's

Rob Heckman sums it up: "This track is a great follow-up to The Red'... because it's a HIT, too!" While Tommy's been knocking down walls on Outspoken (#28 and new at KOMP), he's getting Hot Action Cop rolling (on WMMS, WTFX, WTKX and WCPR)... 

Patty's campaign was bolstered by PoMo airplay at major market stations like WXRK New York, KROQ L.A., 99X Atlanta, KNRK Portland and WXTM Cleveland. Among the APM believers are most of the non-commercial stations, plus WXRT, WGVX, WRLT, KCTY, WOKI, KTHX, WRNX, KRSH, KBXR and others. Patty's also got a great buzz going on her new Jayhawks song, "Save It for a Rainy Day," which impacts next week (2/17), as well as on the magnificent new Lucinda Williams album... As A Rush of Blood to the Head approaches one million in sales, Coldplay's "Clocks" gets added at MTV (!!) and continues its ridiculously long run atop the APM charts. The band's Grammy performance at the end of the month kicks off a sold-out tour, which will include shows at the Hollywood Bowl and Madison Square Garden!! Props to Captiol's Steve Nice on his incredible job with a band that has clearly earned their world class rock status... With sales now at more than three million (!!), Norah Jones' Blue Note debut has outperformed the

expectations of even the most bullish pundits. The CD is now a permanent fixture in the national Top Five, in large part due to the saturation exposure Jones is receiving in the wake of all the Grammy nominations. The second single, "Come Away With Me," is now Top 20 Mediabase and picking up steam as WKOC and WMPS add the record this week... I was thrilled to see WYEP Pittsburgh

add indie artist Alexi Murdoch. WXPN PD Bruce Warren says that listener interest in Murdoch is "getting feverish with lots of great calls"... On the strength of multi-station airplay in Minneapolis

(resulting in over 70 weekly spins), Rhett Miller drew more than 300 fans to a Borders in-store the afternoon of his show with Neil Finn. When the Finn dates conclude, Rhett takes off for seven weeks with Tori Amos (commencing 3/3), which should propel the newly rejuvenated "Come Around" even further up the chart. And don't overthink Elektra's Jason Mraz record. Yes, "The Remedy (I Won't Worry)" is going faster than expected at Hot Adult, picking up more early adds this week in Minneapolis, Seattle, Cincinnati, Reno and several others. But this is no surprise. The track is a big fat smash. It's just shy of Top 15 at our format after only three weeks-practically unheard of for a new act. Do not relinquish your stake in this artist. Like his Internet word-of-mouth-nurtured brethren Train and Dave Matthews, we expect Mraz will be providing hits to our format for years to come... Wes Cunningham's been doing some out of town gigs. Full road report next week... Dar Williams, whose CDs routinely sell 100-150k, will set up the release of The Beauty of the Rain with a series of major-market in-store performances with Razor & Tie labelmate Marty Lloyd (of Freddy Jones Band fame). As expected, Dar's "I Saw a Bird Fly Away" is screaming at non-comm and garnering more commercial radio love every week, with WBOS being the latest to add the record... Ben Taylor's self-released CD is not his first foray into the biz. At 16, he contributed a cover of the Beatles' "I Will" to the Bye Bye Love soundtrack that, I've discovered, is fondly remembered by many in our world. "Island," the first track from Famous Among the Barns has attracted the interest of several major programmers and impacts next week (2/17)... A quick shout to ArtistDirect on their solid effort with Johnny Marr & the Healers. Virtually all the non-comms are on board, as are WXRT, WXRV and WKOC with WRLT and WGVX coming in this week... Finally, don't miss Kathleen Edwards on Leno this Monday (2/17). All the press and TV exposure have combined to make her Failer CD one of the briskest-selling debuts in our format, with over 10k sold in three weeks. There are currently 30 HITS APM reporters on "Six O'Clock News"... NP: a nifty threesong EP by southerners Adelayda on Superkala Records, recommended by KCTY PD Brian Burns... Kathleen Edwards, Failer (Zoe/Rounder): The taut reticence in the voice of this 24-year-old Canadian feels like the lid of a pressure cooker that could blow off at any moment. The force field Edwards erects between the acts of holding back and letting go is pure Lucinda Williams, but her bracing debut album also parallels the work of Kasey Chambers, her Aussie contemporary, in

its trad British underpinnings and hints of modern-day flirtatiousness. Failer has its share of stark, contemplative acoustic ballads, but Edwards seems just as comfortable in front of her rollicking band, sharing the foreground with shredding guitarist Dave Bryson. Together, they evoke the crackling intensity of Richard & Linda Thompson's Shoot Out the Lights on opener "Six O'Clock News," while "12 Bellevue" seethes like Neil Young & Crazy Horse. (BS)

The Datsuns, The Datsuns (V2): Being the latest rock-revival band saddled with next-big-thingness, as well as the latest thing out of New Sweden, er, New Zealand, The Datsuns already have a lot to live up to, but doubters facing this kind of cage-rattling fuzztone fury just don't last. More '70s metal than punk, but more punk than '70s metal, they kick out



the jams with everything on 11: "Sittin' Pretty" and "MF From Hell" get the riff-rock hog rolling like a latter-day Blackfoot on crack, while "At Your Touch," with its big rock organ sounds like Deep Purple fronted by Queens of the Stone Age's Nick Oliveri. "Freeze Sucker," meanwhile, provides the knockout punch. This ain't your daddy's import. (JO)



Johnny Cash, American IV: The Man Comes Around (American/Lost Highway/IDJ): It would have been easy for a legend like Cash to coast on his laurels. Yet on his latest collaboration with producer Rick Rubin, he assays a daring mix of material, uniting it all with his worn but compelling voice. Thus Nine Inch Nails' "Hurt," Cash's new, apocalyptic "The Man Comes Around," Depeche

Mode's "Personal Jesus," the Beatles' "In My Life," Paul Simon's "Bridge Over Troubled Water" (featuring Fiona Apple) and more form one spiritual fabric of anguish and redemption. Add dassically minimalist arrangements and stellar musicians, and you've got an instant classic. (SG)

Cat Power, You Are Free (Matador): I was first introduced to the cult of Cat at UCLA's "All Tomorrow's Parties" festival last spring, where the slight, 30-year-old Chan Marshall kept a Royce Hall full of Television fans enthralled with her quiet desperation. Her fourth album, and first of new material since 1998's Moon Pix, equal parts PJ Harvey, Nico,



Hope Sandoval and a distaff Leonard Cohen, features cameos by Eddie Vedder and Dave Grohl. Power evokes the tension between performer and fan in "I Don't Blame You," which could well be about Kurt Cobain, while linking the personal and the political on "Speak for Me." Sounding like an ancient blues man on the stark, proto-feminist "Good Woman," this slinky feline purrs regret with a chilling, pre-rapture whimper. Me...ow. (RT)

MUSICALLY SPEAKING: After the tales of fun and frivolity that filled this space a week ago, I currently find myself without anything even remotely close to as exciting to write about this week. I really had a pretty mellow last seven days or so. Granted, I did have date #2 with Jay (and it went very well, I must say, with #3 happening tomorrow and then we're gonna hang over the holiday weekend, too!). But, beyond that, my last few days have been spent sleeping, shopping for some new jeans, doing laundry and deaning my apartment. Not real exciting, huh? So, instead of my usual drivel about dubs, drinks, partying and boys, I figured I'd concentrate exclusively on music this time around—songs that are clearly hits and deserving of your undivided attention. And don't worry-with the long weekend coming, Field Mob and Ginuwine due to stop by the offices this week, several appointments slated with friends

for cocktails and a circuit party to attend at the Mayan on Sunday, the tales of debauchery will return in short order. You can count on that... Meanwhile, let's begin this musical journey with a shout out to 50 Cent and the entire Shady/Aftermath/ Interscope crew for the absolutely amazing sales figures his fulllength CD produced in its first week out. Despite early stocking problems at retail and a rushed, late-in-the-week release, Get Rich or Die Tryin' still managed to move over 800k units-wow! In fact, some retailers are even telling us that the rate it's selling is petter than that of the last Eminem project at the same time in its life cycle. That's high praise indeed... Another obvious cift to the Rhythm format is the second release from



NAS: "I Can" go past platinum.

B2K's nearly platinum pandemonium! "Girlfriend" is easily the buzz record of the week, picking up major adds like KMEL, WWKX, KUBE and WXYV a week prior to its official impact date, while generating immediate request action at both KBXX and WZMX. Can you say nobrainer? (And they're hot, too—a bonus!)... On to a slow jam that I simply cannot believe some people aren't playing yet, as all indications are it should also fall into the aforementioned "no-brainer" category at this point. I'm once again referencing Tyrese's "How You Gonna... of course. I mean, really, if you're not on this or got off it early, what the f\*%@ is your problem?? This record connects with your audience. And that fact is clearly visible in the continuing sales surge of the full-length CD—which is up 68% this week as it moves 32-18 on our national album chart. Can you believe that some people actually say that this jam "doesn't fit" their stations? What!!?? Urban ballads don't fit on Rhythm radio stations? Since when? Did I miss that memo? I must have, 'cause when I was still programming just a few short years ago, urban ballads were an essential ingredient in a winning musical recipe. There's just no way that could have changed at this point. But, whatever... Next up in the under-appreciated hit parade that makes up this week's column comes the Nas record. "I Can" is #3 Most Added this week, and is absolutely swimming in a sea of call letters, including B96, WPGC, KBXX, WCHH, WJMH, WMBX and on and on. As good as that is, in my opinion, the showing should be even stronger (and likely will be in the coming weeks). Why? First, there's a huge buzz on this jam. Second, the CD is already nearly platinum even before this cut kicks in. And third, this is melodic hip-hop with a positive message for a change. Its lyrics lift people up rather than tear them down, and I'm fairly certain playing this song early and often may very well do the same for your ratings... A hit that's perhaps crying for your attention a little more obviously (due to the enormity of his last project), is Joe Hecht and Cord Himmelstein's latest Fabolous record. "Can't Let You Go" was Most Added at the format last week and consolidates that heavy action this week by picking up new airplay at places like B96, WBTS, KOHT and KXMG. The chatter is forever increasing in volume and the phones are immediate at outlets such as KBOS, WZMX and KBOM. Time to get on board... And finally, from the this-could-probably-help-both-artists department comes the Busta Rhymes f/Mariah Carey effort, "I Know What You Want." Just now being officially worked by Michael Williams and the J Records team, this track has been buzzing at radio for weeks already, and this time around daims the #5 Most-Added slot. Majors coming in droves to the party include KBMB, KKFR, KQKS, KSFM and KYLD, with a bunch of terrific secondaries jumping on board, too, including KYLZ and KISV. Combine that with earpicks from great music people like Chris Tyler, Tap Money, Steve Kicklighter and Pattie Moreno and it starts to become pretty clear that this one's g-o-n-e... And that's also what I am, too-Gone! Until next week and the return of debauchery-C-ya!...

Wherehouse Music continues to quide itself through the Chapter 11 process. Insiders tell us they are very close to getting the much-needed DIP (debtor in possession) financing. Although the same sources also insist that WM's cash reserves are sufficient to see them through, whether or not DIP financing is acquired. In the meantime, WM is filing a 546G motion with the courts. which will accomplish a couple of important goals. It will allow WM to return product to their vendors, therefore decreasing the amount owed to each. It will also create the possibility (or probability, depending on whom you talk to) of being granted a postpetition line of credit from the majors that will give WM some much-needed breathing room in ordering product. The motion will come before the court on 2/21 and is expected to be granted. In any case, insiders tell us DIP financing should be in place anywhere from two to four weeks from now. For anyone that doubts they will suc-

cessfully come out the other side of this crisis. WM's Lew Garrett would like to point out they moved 34,000 50 Cent CDs in three days. There's a reason that the industry wants Wherehouse to stick around... Responding to demand from retailers for some entry-level pricing options for the consumer, Arista will roll out DVD singles from frontline artists Avril Lavigne, Pink, Usher and Clipse. This comes on the heels of Sony Music's rollout of its singles program this month. Arista sales honcho Jordan Katz tried the format back in 2000 with product priced at \$9.98 list (\$6.33 wholesale) and found a very cool reception at the time from consumers. He then tried a \$7.98 list (\$5.06 w'sale) and got a cool reception from retailers on the decreased margin. This current attempt is still a \$7.98 list, but gives the retailers an increased margin with the wholesale number lowered to \$4.81. Katz believes the timing is right, with the DVD format exploding and player penetration at an all-time high. Each will include two videos. Avril, for example, will include her current single, "I'm With You" and the last hit, "Sk8er Boi." They will also be marketed in the music, rather than the DVD, section, with a bright-red spine denoting the new format. Katz also insists that this latest initiative is not in lieu of a singles program and tells us that topper Antonio "L.A." Reid has "agreed conceptually to release singles again."






