So help is on the way—but for the time being, we're all hanging on by the skin of our teeth.

A couple of records are selling—Bad Boy/Universal's soundtrack to the movie *Bad Boys II*, which remained at #1 for the third straight week, and UTV's *Now 13*, which stayed at #2, where it debuted last week. They were the only albums to break 100k on the week.

Now, this is where we generally drop in a quote from the retail sector—but if you think there's a retail dude willing to go on record with some inane comment about how terrific business has been, you're obviously on crack. We could make one up, of course: "It was another FANTASTIC week at our stores. We actually had one album go #1, and THERE WERE 10 RECORDS IN THE TOP 10 THIS WEEK!!!"

But we wouldn't stoop that low.

The only debut to show signs of life was Elektra/EEG R&B trio LSG (Gerald Levert, Keith Sweat and Johnny Gill), which came onto the chart at #6.

Wind-up coed rockers Evanescence, who climbed from #10-4 on a 13% increase, DTP/Capitol rapper Chingy (#9-5, off only slightly at -7%) and Blue Note's Norah Jones (#13-9, +7%) comprised the week's other feel-good stories.

Enjoying their summer lease on Top 10 real estate are Columbia/CRG's Beyoncé (#3), Shady/Aftermath/Interscope's 50 Cent (#7) and Murder Inc./IDJ's Ashanti (#8), while Interscope's Mya extended her stay to two weeks, as she nabbed the #10 spot.

Others showing sales stickiness included WB rap-rockers Linkin Park (#15-12, +3%), Maverick's maturing Michelle Branch (#18-13, -2%), WSM's ageless Cher (#20-14, +9%), classy Capitol band Coldplay (#22-17, +5%) and DreamWorks Nashville red-white-and-blue-neck Toby Keith (#21-19, flat).



The move significantly solidifies Virgin's Urban music profile, with Ridenour taking responsibility for all marketing and promotion functions associated with the label's Urban roster, which now includes Janet Jackson, D'Angelo, N.E.R.D., Dwele, Ruff Ryders artists Drag-On and Jin, Gang Starr, Beenie Man, J1 and Montebello Records artist Federation. He also plans to set up a model train set on the big table in the label conference room.

Ridenour will report to Lott, while working closely with L.A.-based Sr. VP A&R

"Big Jon" **Platt** "Inum Blonde" and VP A&R **Peter Farmer** "In the Dell."

"I'm looking forward to this great opportunity to broaden and strengthen Virgin's Urban music presence," said Ridenour. "I have great respect for all of the talented artists and executives at the label and am glad to have this chance to work with them all."

Now, if you'll please excuse me, I need to explain the meaning of 'in the heezy' to A Perfect Circle."

Commented Virgin Chairman/CEO **Matt Serletic**: "I'm very excited to welcome Lionel to Virgin. He brings an incredibly successful background in Urban music to the table and is one of the best executives and promotion men in the business. And the dude's bling-bling is utterly undeniable."

Added Lott: "Having worked with Lionel in the past, I know he's a man who's all about results. His talents and wide-ranging relationships will take our Urban music roster to new heights. Can I say he's the shiznit? I didn't think so."

Ridenour comes to Virgin from **Arista**, where he spent 10 years, rising to Executive Vice President. Prior to that, he held various management positions at **Capitol** and indie **Mainframe Records**.

BMG Rolls Out Q4 Lineup

BMG put on quite a show last week in NYC, but it was Arista boss Antonio "L.A." Reid who took center stage, introducing an impressive Q4 slate that includes releases by superstars OutKast, Sarah McLachlan, Pink and Usher.

With the potential WMG-BMG merger hanging over the festivities, 700 BMG managing directors from as far away as Tokyo—along with members of the retail, radio, promotion and creative communities—descended on the Millennium Hotel, where Arista, RLG Nashville, Jive/Zomba and the RCA Music Group touted their fourth-quarter releases.

In a well-prepared all-day presentation, patterned after *The Matrix*, Arista's Reid played the part of a fervent preacher. He introduced music and performers while singing along with every word, cajoling and rousing the troops, as BMG bosses Rolf Schmidt-Holtz and Michael Smellie beamed.

Jermaine Dupri's latest So So Def signing, old-skool soul singer Anthony Hamilton, earned the day's first standing ovation with a dynamic set combining the silky stylings of Marvin Gaye and the earthy sexual energy of Otis Redding.

The afternoon session started off with a three-song performance by Sarah McLachlan, whose long-awaited, still-untitled studio album, her first in six years, hits retail Nov. 4. Two new songs were previewed from Pink's new *Try This*

album (Nov. 11), and four from Usher's *Confessions*, (Nov. 18). Reid introduced the new double-disc OutKast album, *Speakerboxxx: The Love Below* (Sept. 23), actually two "solo" albums, one the work of Big Boi, the other by Andre 3000. Dido's *Life for Rent* (Sept. 30) climaxed the program, with the first single, "White Flag," leading Reid to call her "the best pop music lyricist in the business."

Other Arista acts with new albums include Aretha Franklin (whose *So Damn Happy* hits Sept. 16), Adema, the Neptunes, Trackmasters, Kelis, Da Brat, YoungBloodz and a comeback from '80s stalwarts Tears for Fears, now managed by The Firm's Simon Renshaw.

The following day, RLG Nashville presented its impressive Q4 release schedule, spotlighted here last week.

Jive/Zomba hosted a showcase (which inexplicably barred the media) to play tracks from Britney Spears' new album, and a live performance by NSYNC member JC Chasez, whose solo debut, *Schizophrenic*, drops Oct. 21. An R. Kelly greatest-hits collection is also on tap.

RCA/J touted a release slate including albums from *American Idol* alumni Ruben Studdard and Clay Aiken, Dave Matthews' solo debut and new CDs from Alicia Keys, Wyclef, Rod Stewart, Angie Stone, Eve 6, The Calling, Vertical Horizon and The Strokes.



WHO YOU CALLING INDIE?

In a novel scenario that promises new heights in obfuscation while likely giving rise to a cottage industry in promotion scorecards, certain former Tri-State promoters are going to work for certain record labels as **consultant/employees** in response to **Clear Channel's** ban on indies. Word has it **Lenny Lyons** is going to **Universal/Casablanca**, **Ross Grierson** will go to **one of two East Coast labels** and **Jason Prinzo** and **Denny Bleh** will go to **Capitol**, with Grierson, Prinzo and Bleh working out of the same Cincinnati office. While working directly for a label will allow the former Tri-Staters to talk to CC programmers (who may officially speak only to label personnel), the variety of deals being struck by each—indeed, some will continue their non-CC indie relationships—has many saying that keeping track of **who's doing what for whom** will be more difficult than ever... Whisperers whispering that **John Branca** is back in the **Michael Jackson** fold. Rumored to be high on the Jacko agenda is figuring out what it will take on

either side to resolve the superstar's **Sony** situation... Have **EMI** honchos **Eric Nicoli** and **Alain Levy** made **AOLTW** an offer of **\$750 million** for 75% of **Warner Music Group's** recorded-music business? If real, how much weight might be given to it in the **WMG/BMG** valuation proceedings? Some say a lot... Speaking of WMG/BMG, much tongue-wagging over reports that someone on the German side has been informally inquiring whether the **European Commission** is likely to green-light a merger. As sources close to the action say regulators may require **major asset disposals**, rememberers remembering it was **EMI's** unwillingness to part with **Virgin** that ultimately scuttled a planned **EMI/WMG** combo in 2000—much to the chagrin (and expense) of the latter... Meanwhile, assuming it isn't selling, wonderers wondering if EMI could become a buyer, should WMG/BMG be required to shed a label or two... And speaking of BMG, insiders indicating the strong likelihood of a **major wave of layoffs** whether or not the merger materializes. Is **one major BMG/WMG label exec** secretly hoping to get the axe, and its attached golden parachute, in order to seek greener pastures elsewhere?... Names in the Rumor Mill: **Tommy Mottola**, **Ken Berry**, **Ted Field**, **Larry Jenkins**, **Lyon Cohen** and **Fred DiSipio**.





ROCKY MOUNTAIN HIGH: This week, the entire APM community will descend on Boulder, CO, for the annual **Triple-A Summit**. Perhaps the most genial of record industry gatherings, the Summit is not only an opportunity for major-league schmoozing, but also to hear some amazing music at, among other venues, the venerable Fox Theater. Among the acts performing throughout the weekend are **Dave Matthews**, **Blues Traveler**, **Nickel Creek**, **eastmountainsouth** (see big ems news below!), **Ziggy Marley**, **Guster**, **Bob Schneider**, **Los Lonely Boys** (see below as well), **Jonny Lang**, **the Mavericks** and more. The Summit is also a great opportunity to air out and discuss ideas that programmers and label folk have been dealing with lately, so naturally, there will be plenty of brain food. Among the highlights will no doubt be the Crystal Ball session led by **KINK** PD **Dennis Constantine**, on which will sit virtually every major market commercial APM programmer of note. The Rate-a-Record session moderated by **WXPN** PD **Bruce Warren** is always a hoot and promises to be one of the most well-attended of the weekend. But the sleeper highlight could easily come Friday afternoon during the screening of **Warren Zevon: Keep Me In Your Heart**. This VH1-produced feature documents Zevon's life since the discovery of his terminal cancer, as well as the making of what will likely be Zevon's

swan song album, *The Wind*. In addition to some amazing live clips from the prime of his career, there's some great footage taken on the day Zevon appeared on *Late Night* with David Letterman as the sole guest. There are also some priceless clips of album guest stars **Bruce Springsteen**, **Don Henley**, **Jackson Browne**, **Billy Bob Thornton** and others contributing their parts to the recording that give you the sense of what an event this record really is. Among the 30 or so stations treating it that way by spinning the Zevon-picked first single, "Knockin' on Heaven's Door," are **WXRT**, **KINK**, **KPRI**, **WXRV**, **WXPN**, **WFUV**, **WYEP**, **WDET**, **WTTS**, **WRLT**,


WFPK, **WRNX**, **KBAC**, **KRVB** and **KMTN**... It was a tense, three-way battle this week for Most Added honors between three very worthy records from **Neil Young**, **Dandy Warhols** and **Widespread Panic**. But, at the end of the day, it was the 'Spread who reigned supreme with "Fishing," which picked up 16 combined adds including **WKOC**, **WDST**, **WXPN**, **WZEW**, **KTHX**, **KTAO**, **WNCW** and **KBXR**. Neil and the Dandies split #2 Most Added with 13 apiece. Among those adding Young's "Bandit" were **KMTT**, **KGSR**, **WNCS**, **KOTR**, **KRSH** and **WFUV**. Included among the Dandy Warhols' adds for "We Used to Be Friends" were **WXRT**, **WXRV**, **WDET**, **WAPS**, **WVOD** and **WRNR**. Congrats to **Sanctuary**'s **Drew Murray**, **Reprise**'s **Alex Coronfly** (who also brought in **WZEW**, **KRVB** and **KTHX** on **Steely Dan**'s "Things I Miss the Most") and **Capitol**'s **Steve Nice**, respectively, on their solid impact weeks. Speaking of, the next couple are indeed packed solid with releases. Among the records "going for adds" over the next two weeks are **John Mayer**, **Sting**, **Radiohead**, **Seal**, **Lucinda Williams**, **North Mississippi All Stars**, **String Cheese Incident**, **HEM**, **Leona Naess**, **Robert Randolph & the Family Band**, **Ben Kweller**, **the Mavericks**, **Howie Day** and a host of others, including a wonderful **Gillian Welch**-penned song from **Joan Baez** called "Elvis Presley Blues" that we love and suggest you pay particular attention to... It was a breakthrough week for **Marc** and **Norma** at **DreamWorks** and their **eastmountainsouth** record "You Dance" as they bring three hee-yuge major market hold-outs—**KFOG**, **KINK** and **KPRI**! 'Twas also a big week for **Jason Fisher** at **O Music**, who landed **KMTT** and **KPRI** on **Los Lonely Boys**' "Heaven." Both of these projects are now clearly in high gear and, both being great live acts in their own way, their Boulder performances promise to be celebratory... Another title that is developing nicely is **Grandaddy**'s "Now It's On" on **V2**, with **KFOG**, **KBCO**, **WXRT**, **WXRV** and most of the non-comms among its early supporters and **KPRI**, **WTTS** and **WDST** adding the record this week... Props to **Virgin**'s **Ray Gmeiner** on the massive national "spin-crease" on **Ben Harper**'s "Diamonds on the Inside" as well as on bringing in straggler **WZEW**; to **Hollywood's Nick Bedding** for landing **KRVB** on **Pete Francis**' "One Train"; and to the newly hired **John Rosenfelder** at **KOCH** for bringing in **KGSR** on **Peter Malick/Norah Jones**' "New York City"... Finally, bigtime congrats to **KBXR** PD **Lana Trezise**, who took her station #1 25-54 in the current Spring Book... hitsmm@aol.com...

The Sleepy Jackson, Lovers (Astralwerks): Like Badly Drawn Boy and Damon Gough, this shifting Aussie outfit is the brainchild of a single individual. Perth singer/writer/guitarist Luke Steele channels the spirit of George Harrison, Lou Reed, Gram Parsons, Bob Dylan and The Band, but still manages to come across as a genuine original. The slide guitars in "Good Dancers" directly references the Quiet Beatle, and the fiddle in "Old Dirt Farmer" has the gentle earthiness of "Rag Mama Rag," while the bottleneck and banjo in "Come to This" is the Burritos doing Nashville Skyline. The ethereal female choir in the shimmering, soulful "Don't You Know" captures Steele's dreamy essence, but it's the grinding, "White Light White Heat" pulse of the sardonic first single, "Vampire Racecourse," that gives the music its paranoid urgency, as Steele demands rhetorically, "Is this what you want?" More than that, it's what we need. (RT)

Sense Field, Living Outside (Nettwerk): This SoCal crew has weathered several personnel changes during its 13-year existence, but the band's one constant throughout has been earnestness—heck, these guys were emo before they had a name for it. The group caught a wave with the hit single "Save Yourself," from 2002's *Tonight and Forever*, and the Brad Wood-produced follow-up contains the songcraft, dynamics and heart-on-sleeve sentiment to kick it up another notch for the onetime cult band. Stylistically, the LP draws heavily on the '80s, favoring the streamlined tempos and swirls, synth-based atmospherics that New Order once purveyed, and locating the hooks therein, with the unabashedly sincere, everyman's vocals of Jon Burch riding on top. The standout of this consistent collection is first single "I Refuse," in which syncopated verses resolve into high-rise choruses that reach for, and attain, a starry-eyed grandeur. Not for cynics. (BS)



The Libertines, Up the Bracket (Rough Trade): A punch up the bracket, in U.K. slang, is a blow to the face—and this hell-raising garage-rock debut certainly administers a few. With songs that crash along like a bar fight, the Tines live up to their name, and producer Mick Jones seems disinclined to clean up the proceedings. Frontmen Pete Doherty and Carl Barat pen rip-roaring, high-spirited salvos that pour out equal parts punk energy and retro-pop melody and then shake vigorously, as on "Vertigo," the toe-tapping "Death on the Stairs," the slammin' title track and the Buzzcocks-esque "I Get Along." But they're also fond of the occasional meandering digression, such as "Radio America"—which finds time, in its shuffling expanse, for an off-key salute to the Grateful Dead. It's loose, loud, feckless fun. (SG)

Blue October, History for Sale (Brando/Universal): Breaking out in a variety of directions on their second Universal release, the Texas fivesome conjures flavors of both Peter Gabriel and early R.E.M., while also exploring harder-edged material and taking enough musical chances to keep even the most dedicated pigeonholer from easily categorizing the whole. The unifying lyrical mission, however, seems to be to touch as many emotional raw nerves as possible, wrapping both the pleasure and pain of love and longing in impressionistic verse. Single "Calling You" (featured in *American Wedding*) is a transcendent love-from-the-road snapshot, while the crushing mistrust of "Sexual Powertrip" offsets the disarmingly melodic, yet unflinchingly introspective, "Chameleon Boy" and "Inner Glow," as well as the subtle, emotionally ambivalent closer, "Amazing." (JO)





And Liz, Lieberman and Cohen put Columbia's Bow Wow on the Rhythmic map as "Let's Get Down" is up almost 400 spins, while being another major phone bummer!! One more las chicas love is Frankie J. whom I witnessed Saturday at Hot 92 Jamz Funktastic Bombastic concert, making the ladies lascivious when he hit the mic! Michelle S.' show was a huge success with artists like Wayne Wonder and Da Brat opening up for all the old school favorites... 

HEADQUARTERS... Unless you're livin' in LA-LA Land or Florida, ya got about a month or so left to summer. That's OK. LA's got the Kobe cloud hangin' over it & Florida's got hurricane season. But there are two DJz who've gotta lotta sun shinin' on 'em right about now. One iz a legendary DJ who's produced, performed &/or DJ'd on many, many records we've all played on tha radio, in clubs, etc., like Biggie, Jay-Z, Gang Starr, etc. The other iz legendary in hiz own right az one of tha top radio mix DJz ever. He waz mixin' @ Players in Frederick, MD, in '89, when one of his great mentors & mine, WPGC's "It's Me, It's Me, It's" Albie Dee, walked in, discovered him & had him start mixin' on-air on hiz show. He mixed prime-time for PGC for over 10 yrs., til 2000, & during hiz time, broke way too many records to mention in DC, doing hiz part to help alotta careers happen across tha map w/hiz airplay. Gang Starr's DJ Premier & Charles "The Mixologist" Rhone met in '97 after Premier caught Charles live in tha mix @ one of his DC clubz. They became good friends &, in 2000, when Charles moved to Jersey, tha two started spendin' time in tha studio, az well az tha gym, together. They are now the proud owners of the legendary D&D Studios, which

haz been renamed "Headqourterz (pronounced Headquarters) Studios," after a close friend of Premier's who unfortunately waz killed only two days after Jam Master Jay left us. Mixologist: "When I moved to NY, Premier waz one of thoe who showed me alotta love & really followed thru on things. Muzic aside, he's a great person & I admire & trust him that way. We complement each other well musically & now, we'll be able to work on a whole other level. I'm so honored to be w/him in this venture & can't wait to start puttin' out sum great muzic together in a studio from which so much legendary muzic haz already emerged." Headqourterz will feature four studios equipped, az you'd expect, from this duo, including Premier's famous & soon-to-be-upgraded Studio B, where Gang Starr's "Dwyck," Biggie's "Unbelievable," shitt by Limp Bizkit, Nas & alotta other big hits came from. They'll also provide video editing, protein bars & advice on how to be in hip-hop & eat right. Look for tha new studio to open sometime in the fourth quarter of this yr. & expect one helluva launch party to go with it! Tha address iz still 320 W. 37th St., NY, NY. It always makes this DJ's heart pump just that much better each time we get newz of DJz creating ownership opportunities for themselves in tha mix, so CONGRATZ TO PREMIER & THA MIXOLOGIST!!... R. The Sony-owned indie is said to be about to ramp up its Red Ink division with more bodies and an expanded mission statement that will include a larger radio promotion presence and even a newly created A&R department to obtain and create original content for the once runaway marketshare leader in indie distribution. Rumors have it that there is currently a short list of candidates to head the new unit and the hire should be announced within the next two weeks. The new head will report to RED Prexy Antonelli. There is talk of expanding the marketing as well as promotion departments. This takes RED back to a business model much more reminiscent of the days when Relativity, then Loud, served as wholly owned (by Sony) content providers for RED. And also when Michael Haentjes bought RED and ran edel america though it as proprietary product until fi-

nancial problems lead to his forfeiting RED back to Sony. Now, obviously, Sony is thinking RED should be back in the content game. Red Ink has been serving as a marketing arm for many RED-distributed labels that were too small to handle those duties on their own. Red Ink's Howard Gabriel is said to be staying on and will continue to work with those labels... Newbury Comics, the Coalition of Independent Music Stores, Music Monitor Network and the Alliance of Independent Media Stores are all converging on the Doubletree Inn in NYC's Times Square this Friday (8/8) for the first-ever confab of its kind. Some 140 employees representing 250 record stores nationwide are getting together for informal discussions and to be feted by hundreds of label geeks seeking to curry favor. Friday night, WEA has a presentation at the Knitting Factory. Saturday is BMG at the Bowery Ballroom. Sunday is a day of indie-label presentations featuring ADA, Koch, Caroline, Navarre and Welk. RED Distribution is included in the Sony presentation that night at the Mercury. Ryko is Monday afternoon, with EMM hosting an evening event at Tonic. UMVD closes the festivities on Tuesday at the Bottom Line. "It's a real experiment," says CIMS head Don Van Cleave. "We don't know if we'll ever do it again." All told, there will be 30 artists performing over a five-day period, with a ton of in-stores planned such as a Liz Phair appearance at Vintage Vinyl. More details next week.






about what is going on at **Geffen**. It seems that **Volcano's Warren Christianson** was offered the head-of-promo gig,
