





DreamWorks Nashville's Toby Keith is riding that patriotic sentiment all the way to the top of the charts with a #1 debut and 580k in first-week sales for his *Shock'N Y'All: Ain't America great?*

One of five other newcomers to the Top 10, Arista's Sarah McLachlan returned after a six-year absence to a hearty *Afterglow* and a #2 bow.

The rest of the debuts came from Columbia/CRG's *Now Vol. 1*, 1,987,765 (#3), A&M/Interscope's Sheryl Crow (#4), Murder Inc./IDJ's Ja Rule (#6) and Atlantic/Atl G's P.O.D.

Trans World's Jerry Kamiler, a closet Bill O'Reilly fan, enthused: "It was a great week of new releases. A very strong debut from Toby Keith. And I thought that was a spectacular number from Sarah McLachlan, who hadn't been around for a long time. Now 14 had a fabulous week, easily outselling the last one, which is a plus. Sheryl Crow did extremely well for a greatest hits package—and a left-winger to boot."

Arista's OutKast (#5), J Records' Rod Stewart (#7), RCA's Clay Aiken and Def Jam South/IDJ's Ludacris (#10) are the holdovers in the Top 10, where BMG and UMG had four apiece.

Other chart newcomers include Capitol's Coldplay CD/DVD hybrid (#11), Island/IDJ's Bon Jovi (#12), J Records' Wyclef Jean (#22), Desert Storm/Elektra/EEG's Fabolous (#23), Capitol's Bob Seger & the Silver Bullet Band greatest hits (#24), Lost Highway/IDJ's Ryan Adams (#25), RCA Nashville's Martina McBride (#33), Jive's Too Short (#38) and Walt Disney Records' Cheetah Girls soundtrack to the Disney Channel show (#48).

This Friday, 50 Cent's G-Unit/Shady/Aftermath/Interscope posse G-Unit goes head-to-head against Roc-A-Fella/IDJ's Jay-Z, with the two battling the Amaru/Interscope 2Pac soundtrack (which came out Tuesday) for next week's #1 record, while Arista's Pink, Reprise's Josh Groban and Atlantic/Atl G's Kid Rock will also be in the hunt.

Added Kamiler: "The macro decision to move a release date and get a record to the street ASAP because it's being pirated is the right thing to do. Hey, anyone know where I can download that Paris Hilton video?"

Specifically, the label has R&B sensation **Anthony Hamilton**, whose classic lived-in voice and Southern-fried grooves on his label debut, *Comin' From Where I'm From*, have found a warm reception. The album has sold more than 150k (up to 22-26k per week) since its release Sept. 23.

Arista Executive VP Promotion Steve Bartels points to the enthusiastic response from "key tastemakers, celebrities and industry critics" and the fact even he can dance to it as reasons for the album's success: "It's gritty, raw and powerful, yet enthusiastically passionate, and that's just my love life. It celebrates real and meaningful music. We are excited about the progress to date. Along with the impressive weekly and initial early sales, we are just starting the campaign and plan on a long focused launch to bring Anthony into the mainstream consciousness."

The Charlotte, NC native's momentum owes a great deal to grass-roots activity. The track's national video exposure has been strongly supplemented by love on 89 local and regional video shows, as well as endorsements from hip-hop artists like Murphy Lee, Ying Yang Twins and Bone Crusher.

"It's a rare occurrence in today's marketplace that artists show staying power without the obvious drivers being present," adds Arista Sr. VP of Marketing and Artist Relations **Mark Shimmel**. "Clearly there's a musical vocabulary at work here that listeners are sharing with each other. Perhaps the best artist development, overall, is good music. At least

that's what my crack team of psychics tells me."

Buddy Arnold, 1926-2003

Jazz saxophonist, recovered addict and revered Musicians' Assistance Program co-founder Buddy Arnold died Sunday (11/9) following complications from heart surgery. He was 77.

Arnold and wife, **Carole Fields**, beloved both in and out of recovery circles, started MAP in 1992 as a non-profit organization to help addicted musicians and industry people get treatment.

In lieu of flowers, a MAP spokesperson said donations to MAP would be welcomed in Arnold's name (see address below). Plans for a memorial are pending.

Bronx-born Arnold took up the saxophone at 9 and was gigging by 16. He served in the Army during WWII and after that toured with the likes of **Buddy DeFranco**, **Tommy Dorsey** and **Stan Kenton**.



Drugs increasingly interfered with Arnold's music, however, and he ultimately spent over 30 years as an addict—even landing in prison on occasion for junkie behavior such as writing false prescriptions.

During his last incarceration, he decided to get clean and did. Upon earning an early release, he took a job with a rehab program and began helping other addicts. After marrying in 1986, he and Fields began to work with musicians and eventually formed MAP.

Napster Nabs Three

Here Kitty, Kitty. Napster is downloading an upgrade to its programming staff.

The online music destination—once the scourge of the music biz, but now a law-abiding division of Roxio—has tapped industry vet **Darcy Fulmer** as a senior music consultant and promoted **Wendy Kayland** and **Michah McKinney** to Senior Director posts.

Fulmer, who previously served as Music Director at MTV, VH1, KROQ L.A. and KZZP Phoenix, among others, will oversee programming and liaise with the industry, while explaining to Executive VP Creative Affairs **Glenn Kaino** what "liaise" means.

Kayland and McKinney both served at Roxio-owned Pressplay, where they spent most of their time explaining it wasn't a dry-cleaning company. Kayland previously worked at Elektra Records and House of Blues; McKinney was employed at Satellite Films.

The pair will jointly manage

programming and label relations, Napster's Sessions program and artist placement. They'll also work with the marketing department on artist campaigns while wondering where to forward **Shawn Fanning's** mail.

The moves follow the departure of **Alex Luke**, who'd been Napster VP of Programming since 2001.

In other Napster news, the company recently set up an unusual deal with Penn State University whereby the institution pays for legal student downloads (using a large-scale Premium subscription) as a positive anti-piracy measure. And starting next week, Napster will make prepaid cards available via 14,000+ retailers nationwide.

Since Napster 2.0 bowed, the company says it has sold more than 300k tracks, and Premium members have downloaded or streamed over 2 million. Napster believes Premium subscribers will pass the 800k mark by year's end.

WHO'S THE BOSS? Talkers talking overtime about what the power structure in the proposed **Sony/BMG** tie-up will really look like. How will BMG's **Rolf Schmidt-Holtz** and Sony's **Andrew Lack** share power? Is Schmidt-Holtz actually putting the finishing touches on a brief but impressive music career and planning a return to **Bertelsmann**'s TV division, as at least one report theorizes? As such questions swirl, insiders pointing out that structural issues are often where deals like this start to unravel... Other interesting factoids: the highest-ranking jazz album was Miles Davis' Kind of Blue at #12; highest female album was Joni Mitchell's Blue at #30, with Carole King's Tapestry (#36) and Patti Smith's Horses (#44) the only other distaff albums in the Top 50. First rap disc mentioned was Public Enemy's It Takes a Nation... at #48. The Ramones' first album finished #33, Television's Marquee Moon landed at #128, while Suicide's classic debut came in at #446. 



On the heels of last week's 100k+ sales debut, The Strokes' "12:51" found new love this week at KMYZ, KDGE and KBZT. It's time for the rest of you to give this record the benefit of the doubt, which you should also apply to the following SMASHES: OutKast's "Hey Ya" (sales are over 1.5 million!); Coldplay's "Moses" (75k+ bow for live DVD/CD; new adds at KPNT, KQXR, KFRR); Jet's "Are You Gonna Be My Girl" (enormous built-in familiarity from the iPod ads). I know it's hard to compete with new singles from Godsmack and Nickelback fighting for your attention.... Our beloved Ryan Adams' new CD, Rock N Roll, sold nearly 50k this week! WAVF had the presence of mind to add "So Alive" this week. This project is a labor of love for Howie and Christine at Island, as is the new Hoobastank single, "Out of Control," which scored HUGE this week with adds from both MTV and KROQ! Howie may now resume searching for the Paris Hilton tape on the Internet.... There was something very fitting about blaring The Darkness CD on my drive from NYC to Easton, PA. Why do I have the cell-phone numbers of at least 25% of the 50 hotties? It means your teenage daughter will love me... Audioslave's Chris Cornell has always been the standard by which I judge "Hot Guys in Rock." This had absolutely no bearing in WXTM, WPBZ and WPLY adding "I Am the Highway" this week. Well, maybe WXTM... Our friend Jeff Sodikoff has relocated to Chicago where, I'm pleased to announce, he's been named Sr. VP of Marketing for IEG, Inc. As Universal Music and Video Distribution continues to roll out its new JumpSTART pricing plan, Virgin Entertainment Group CEO Glen Ward seemingly stands alone in his refusal to give UMVD the terms they require to participate in the program. VEG has cut off all contact with the marketshare leader and continues to put the small quantities of UMVD product they do carry alphabetically in bins. No hit walls, no end caps, no windows feature any Universal acts. Although Ward will not comment, word has it that one-stops that have been supplying VEG with Universal titles are being pressured by UMVD to stop. How long can what Ward refers to as an "impasse" continue? One would have to surmise that it has to be hurting Virgin's bottom line by not featuring product that would otherwise be accounting for some 30% of their music revenues during the most important retail sales period of the year. But Ward downplays that notion: "Thank goodness everybody else is doing quite nicely at the mo-

ment," he says referring in part to BMG's current chart dominance. "Business has been pretty good." According to Ward, the current conflict hasn't changed any of VEG's expansion plans. Virgin currently operates 22 stores in the States and Ward says they are just about to announce two new locations to open in 2004. Also, VEG is in the process of refurbishing the eight-year-old 40,000 sq. ft. S.F. location with an eye to re-launch the store the first week of December. Ward indicates will represent the next generation of Virgin Mega-Stores and will feature an even broader mix of product lines than the current incarnations. Although he stresses that music will remain VEG's core business, the new store will shrink its music to non-music mix from 60/40 to 50/50. "That's just a reflection of what's going on in the marketplace anyway," says Ward. "It's not a case of substituting other products, but hopefully seeing incremental business" ... At presstime, Best Buy is putting the hugely controversial *Rolling Stones Four Flicks* live DVD set on their shelves, which has set off a bitter debate in the retail community over BB's exclusive rights throughout the holiday season. BB Entertainment honcho Gary Arnold defends his company's stance saying, "I started these discussions with Michael Cohl from TGA Entertainment at NARM. Every retailer in the nation was there. They were talking to any number of people, and we just happened to close the deal."


