

## Houston Blasts Post

Whitney Houston's lawyer denied a *N.Y. Post* report that the singer checked into Miami Beach's Mount Sinai Hospital last week, where she was diagnosed with acute heart arrhythmia, allegedly brought on by an overdose of diet pills. The singer has sued the paper for libel, asking \$10 million in compensatory and \$50 million in punitive damages.

Attorney Sheldon Platt

"I THINK there is a lot involved that is taken for granted at the manufacturing level." The Serious Sincoff — page 40 said: "It's a total fabrication. She has never taken a diet pill in her life. She's outraged and hurt."

Houston has been in Miami rehearsing for her concert tour, which kicks off in that city this Monday (5). She performed for **President Clinton** in Washington, D.C. at a Democratic Committee fundraising dinner last Monday night (28).

The newspaper said Houston was frustrated by the weight she put on during her recent pregnancy and was even more upset after a chance encounter last month with a fit **Janet Jackson.** 

After the suit was announced, the *Post* retracted the story, claiming the patient in question was actually 87-yearold grandmother **Esther Houston**, who was rushed to the hospital suffering from diarrhea brought on by eating too many prunes.

#### **Stone Temple Pilots & More**

e've been yelling about Stone Temple Pilots and the "Plush" cut now for (it seems like) years, and now is not the time to pull back, for there is STILL work to be done. Yeah, Atlantic's promotion department has done a sensational job to date, taking a format-offensive cut and putting it on approximately 100 Top 40 radio stations, which has significantly helped to put the album at #2 nationally. But the question remains as to how big this project would be if the marketplace would bend the rules enough to let "Plush" continue to grow. Our advice to Andrea Ganis and her team is to just keep going and going. As it gets bigger, more walls will come down! And you never know. Our advice to Keith, Jeff and Dave: Keep an open mind. You never know.

And so, if Nirvana begat Pearl Jam, which begat Stone Temple Pilots, then who's next? Our attention is focusing on Porno For Pyros and their single, "Pets." Let's check the parts: solid MTV support in Buzz Bin and beyond, the beginnings of a Top 40 uprising masterminded by Stu Cohen, including a key add this week at Z100 New York and solid album sales now surpassing the 600,000 mark. Stay tuned, because the game is once again afoot!



#### Consultants Are Not Gods (But Then Neither Are You)

The use of consultants at Top 40 radio has gone through several different life-cycles, and appears to be on an uptrend again. Who are these guys? Do you need them? What can they do for you? How can you use them most effectively?

While it's true that many people hanging out their shingles as programming consultants are **out-of-work PDs** who've burned too many bridges to get another gig, there are thriving, successful consultants with track records of actually improving their clients' ratings and profitability! When looking for a consultant, look for one who has consistently been able to make his clients successful, not just his consultancy.

A consultant can be invaluable as an **outside**, **impartial observer** of your radio station and market. He's not emotionally tied to what's going on at your station — therefore he can see and hear things that you cannot.

Take care when you hire a consultant to choose someone with **proven results** in tackling your **specific concerns**. There is a consultant who specializes in virtually every niche known to man — so get a **specialist**. If you need to learn how to row a canoe, you don't hire a sailing instructor!

Be extremely aware of research companies that masquerade as consultants. Many of these firms charge exorbitant fees for their research products, and employ former programmers (now essentially salesmen) to help you implement their findings. You aren't getting the most bang for your buck in these situations. How about hiring a consultant to help you determine what you need to find out in your research, and then having him direct you to the best researcher for your specific needs? Most of the good consultants work with every major research firm out there and are eminently more qualified to address your needs.

If you have the luxury of a budget for a consultant, it's usually not a bad investment. One very important thing to remember — you are paying them. Management and ownership has the tendency to value the consultant's opinionheavily because they are paying the consultant for their "expert" opinion. Remember that you are the person who lives it and executes it 24 hours a day, and they are paying you to be held accountable for your station's ratings. Don't let yourself get pushed around. Be open and receptive to new ideas and perspectives, and you'll probably both learn a great deal from each other, and ultimately improve your ratings. Last time I checked, that was the whole idea.

# THE SERIOUS Sincer

anufacturing, purchasing and production is a high-stakes game, and Arista Sr. Vice President Manufacturing & Purchasing Milton Sincoff is the music industry's high roller. We caught up with Sincoff at 6 West HQ where he orches-

trates the strategies that have established him as the industry's benchmark.

#### <u>A SERIOUS INTERVIEW WITH ARISTA'S MILTON SINCOFF</u> **BYDAVID ADELSON**

DAVE: Milton, how do you feel about our previous coverage of you?

MILTON: Obviously, egotistically, I loved it. But there were a few times I felt that you went a little too far — you know, with the pin-ups and people writing in, and all that love beast stuff. But, I appreciate everything you did and I know it's out of love and kindness. I know I'm a character, but underneath that character is a very sensitive, warm professional. Above all, I consider myself a business person and I take my work seriously. I'm not a stroker, I'm not a poser, I'm not a fraud and I'm not a politician. There's a serious side to me, which you're hearing. I can be very funny, but there's a seri-

ous side to it all.

DAVE: As long as you know it was done out of love. MILTON: I know that. DAVE: So is this interview. MILTON: I appreciate that. I appreciate that you've taken the time, in an industry loaded with a lot of good people, to single me out.

DAVE: Thank you, Milton. We appreciate you. Alot of people don't understand what the Senior Vice President of Manufacturing & Purchasing does.

MILTON: Manufacturing and purchasing.

DAVE: And production, of course?

MILTON: Yes, a lot of production.

DAVE: Tell us about it.

MILTON: I'm responsible for the overall implementation for all avenues of pre-production at Arista and its affiliations. That includes color separations, mastering, packaging, printing, marketing & merchandising materials and inventory management for all the various configurations and new technologies that go through a record company. That now includes DCC, laser disc, in addition to the conventional configurations, like singles, albums and CDs. I'm also responsible for interfacing with the various senior management of the company's Promotion, Sales, Artist Development and Finance departments. I'm the guy behind the scenes who's responsible for getting product on the street. I'm the guy behind the scenes for the posters, streamers, for all the marketing & merchandising materials that go up in the stores — whatever is needed to successfully market and merchandise product at all levels. Also promotion, as you know, plays a very vital part of the success of a record company. I'm the guy who's responsible for the various promotion departments of Arista's requirements at the radio level. You know, the special requests, the insane nightmares that we go through with all different configurations needed at radio. Then there's interfacing with Clive Davis, Roy Lott, Arista MILTON: I think the demands on the production department of a record company are far greater than they've ever been. I think there is a lot involved that is taken for granted at the manufacturing level. Once the music and the art work are turned in, there's a greater degree of pressure focused on getting the product to the marketplace. Also, the configurations now are more involved and there are more of them. It's more complex.

**DAVE: But Milt, what about commitment?** MILTON: Good question, Dave. I think some companies are tougher than others because of around the clock. The pressure was applied. We spilled blood. That's one of my expressions. We spilled blood — we made it happen. It was a great time.

DAVE: Milt, do you have any regrets? Anything you wanted to do in the industry that you haven't done? Did you ever want to be an A&R guy? Did you ever want be a promotion or sales guy?

MILTON: That's a tough one. I'm happy with what I do. I cover so much territory. I interface with such wonderful people that if I had to do it all over again, I think I'd do the same thing

Nashville, LaFace, Rowdy, and Rick Bisceglia, who has constant demands on me to get his product to the stations to help ensure his success at radio.

# DAVE: Whoa. What about all the cool graphics on the CDs, Milton?

MILTON: Once the art work is turned into me from Ken Levy's area — Ken runs Creative Services — I'm responsible for all the manufacturing that's required to take the art work and translate it into finished product necessary at the radio level. Commerical product too. Of course, Arista is a very heavily motivated A&R company. I keep going back to promotion only because it's a key ingredient.

# DAVE: Milt, how long have you been doing this?

MILTON: I've been doing this for Arista going on 15 years. I've been in the business over 30 years.

#### DAVE: Tell us about your roots, Milton.

MILTON: I've had very few jobs in this industry, unlike alot of people. I started at Kapp Records, with David Kapp. David Kapp was a pioneer in the business and I learned under his tuteloge. Then I went on to Neil Bogart at Buddah Records. I then went to work for Clive Davis, whom I've been with for the past 15 years. I've been fortunate to have learned from the sense of pride they take in their product. There is a degree of pride at Arista that perhaps some other companies lack. There's a sensitivity to the overall quality of manufacturing and packaging. There has to be, because of the quality of the music.

# DAVE: Milton, any classic stories from the trenches?

MILTON: I'm not a stroker, I'm not a poser, I'm not a fraud and I'm not a politician. I could write a couple of books, a couple of novels. I can tell a classic story, which ironically, is current on the

#### I'm doing now.

DAVE: Milton, do you think there's a tendency for the industry to take manufacturing, purchasing and production for granted? MILTON: Yes, very much so. We are in the background.

#### DAVE: What about the intense competition, Milton?

MILTON: Look, sometimes the going gets a little rough. I am competing against other production people who try to do the same things I do. I just know I do it better.







**B.B. King "Blues Summit" (MCA)** What more could Blues fans ask for? The immortal B.B. King appears here with a host of legends on an entirely new collection of 12 classic howlers guaranteed to make you feel a whole lot better. You get an authentic straightahead 12-bar swampy refrain with the



granddaddy John Lee Hooker on "You Shook Me," a roaring take of "I Pity The Fool" with Buddy Guy, sheer vocal power from Koko Taylor on "We're Gonna Make It" and even a specially-penned Robert Cray tune, "Playin' With My Friends," that captures the spirit of this momentous offering.



How many articles about you have man-

gled the definition of "auteur"? Quite a few. I've managed it myself several times because I get kind of fed up going on about it. The definition of the word wasn't quite so important. It was a good name for a pop group willful and provocative — which I like. Is the album title supposed to be a film reference, too?

You can take it that way. I just thought there should have been an album called "New Wave," and if no one else was going to do it, we'd have to. It has many connotations that may or may not be true.

### Are you as much of a film buff as it might seem?

Probably not as much as you might think. I sort of go through phases of it, where I really get into movies and am constantly reading movie star biographies. I haven't been into it for a while, but I feel a phase coming up. Also, the hotel we're in has a video hook-up and I've found they have "Harold And Maude." That made my day. I'm in an incredibly good mood because I know I'm going to get to watch "Harold And Maude" tonight when I get back from the show.

# How important was your opening slot for Suede?

It was important, but in retrospect, it

was good and harmful at the same time. In England, it certainly implied we had something to do with them, like we were some offshoot group. People expected us to be like Suede, and were disappointed, or didn't understand what we were doing. If you see us live or hear the record, it's a very long way from what Suede are doing. Finally, the British press see that now, and treat us as a force in our own right. **The British press has raved about "New Wave," but slagged your live shows.**

Since those first reviews, there've been positive things said about them. Most of the bad live reviews have been written by people who just didn't like us anyway. We're erratic live, which is a good thing. When we're really good, we're like 15 times better than we are on record

### How close do you feel to the characters in your songs?

It drifts in and out of being personal it's kind of mythologizing, fictional. I don't see any reason why you can't do that in a song — it's in the first person, but I'm doing it from a narrative point of view. There are bits that are very much about me, and there are bits that are very much disguised. A lot of it's just about the whole underdog thing.

#### Did you ever really break into houses?

Um, I kind of dabbled in that a little

rits who sing about stardom, glamour and obsession are nothing new, but for Luke Haines, fame is a tragic flaw. On the Auteurs' debut album, "New Wave" (Carolina), Haines chronicles a world of showgirls and fanatics, petty criminals and stage children, faded stars and "American Guitars." Haines' characters are as scared, saddened and embittered by it all as they are fascinated, chasing the dream even though they know its realization could be the death of them, spiritually if not actually. His witty, savage and sometimes eerie stories are presented in classic British guitar-pop fashion (think Kinks, Only Ones, Go-Betweens), with ornamental grace notes of piano, cello and bells. Still recovering from shoegazing and grunge, England has welcomed the Auteurs with an enthusiasm second only to Suede in its abundance. HITS' own popophile Jason "And The Argonauts" Cohen spoke to Haines the night before the band finished up their American tour in L.A., where after checking out greed in Atlantic City (he lost) and remodeled junkie hotels in San Francisco, he would have the opportunity to view dolled-up embalmings of Hollywood iconography firsthand.

nothing too sinister, like kids kind of stuff, breaking into houses to see if we could do it, without actually stealing stuff. I find it quite unbelievable I actually did it.

#### The line everyone quotes in "Showgirl" is "Took her bowling/got her high." Do people bowl much in England?

Yeah, we do. I take it it's much more a thing you do here. That was like creating the atmosphere of the song, it was kind of messing things up a bit. The word "showgirl" has a different meaning in England — it's a post-World War II vaudeville type thing someone who does, like, a cockney sing-along. Here it's more to do with the kind of Las Vegas-type dancing girl. It was somewhere in between that; maybe I meant an Off Broadway, or an Off-Off Broadway actress.

#### How conscious was your repeated usage of the word "Star"?

It was kind of funny when some reviewer actually counted the number

of times it's on the album, but it wasn't something I was that conscious of. I was aware of stuff like "Starstruck" and "Don't Trust The Stars" in the titles, but even "Bailed Out" mentions it. I'm now aware that I'll never be able to use that word again.

GO BOWLING AND GET HIGH

**TH THE AUTEURS' LUKE HAINES** 

#### Who do you prefer being compared to, Ray Davies or Neil Tennant?

Um... goodness. I've never been compared to Neil Tennant... I don't think. He's growing on me, but I prefer Ray Davies, to be quite honest. What did you expect me to say?

# on the THOM YORKE AND COLIN GREENWOOD have just finished

their morning bowl of granola, and they have something on their minds. "D'you know where we can get some used Levi's 501's?" they inquire. "We can't go back to England without some." Given that the vocalist and bassist, respectively, for Oxford's curious new combo Radiohead are on their final promo junket stop in San Francisco and only have a couple of hours before the flight leaves, they probably won't be driving into any jean pools. "But these pants are impossible to get back home," they whine, as are the stylish Ray-Ban sunglasses they're proudly sporting.

Stateside status symbols are important to these Brits, eager to prove themselves against the U2s, Cures and Depeche Modes back home. But Radiohead is more than timely togs. They've just released an engaging Anglopop debut that contains one of the memorable numbers of '93, a self-deprecating little ditty dubbed "Creep." Yorke positively oozes uneasiness in the slithery chorus of "I wish I were special/But I'm a creep/I'm a wee-eer-do," and that feeling is magnified by the song's unassuming arrangement, which uh, sort of creeps along. And who hasn't felt like a creep at some point in any given relationship? Certainly not HITS' own lovable loser Tom Lanham "On Wry," who thought CREEP stood for Nixon's secret cash cow, the Committee to Re-Elect the President.

### I read where you failed at being an art student. Is such a thing possible?

THOM YORKE: The way I failed was, I went to college one morning, presented 'em with my paintings, and they told me I couldn't paint. That was about halfway through. I then disappeared for a month and came back with all these other works, so I didn't actually fail at all. I got a degree in Art and English. **Your sound's a very artistic one, not to mention American.** 

YORKE: Unh, without being too obvious, I hope. We have a great many favorite American bands, just like the Beatles did. Any British band that refuses to admit the fact they're influenced by American culture is lying through their teeth, because Britain doesn't have a culture. All Britain ever does is take American culture and sell it back to America again. "Prove Yourself" was kind of written about that. Oxford's a very intimidating place, but not in normal sorts of violent ways — it's like L.A. was for the brief time we were there. After the first few hours of novelty value, the California sunshine gets quite intimidating in the same kind of way

COLIN GREENWOOD: Yeah, there's always a pressure on people to be known, to be doing something. Who is this "Creep" exactly? VONKT "Court" is reasonable to the source of

YORKE: "Creep" is more the way people look at you. The guy in the song doesn't necessarily believe that he's a creep, but he's being told he is. But these things change. "Creep" is the term for someone who follows people around and drinks on his own in bars and stuff, but the idea came from a rocky relationship I was having. I find it very disturb-

ing that there are thousands and thousands of these wonderful love songs which aren't really wonderful at all, and it's evident that the people who were writing them have never even been close to anything resembling the emotions they represent. Love songs have been killed by mainstream music, and to actually write a love song is kind of a peculiar thing to do these days. **Your album title, "Pablo Honey," is rather unique, too.** 

YORKE: That comes from the "Jerky Boys" crank-call tapes, the one where he rings up this guy and pretends to be the bloke's long-lost mother — he just chooses names at random from a phone book. We picked the tape up from Chapterhouse, who picked it up when they were on tour over here.

#### I read where there was a recent poll in England which asked kids to name their personal heroes, and they chose the video game character the Sonic Hedgehog.

Hedgehog. GREENWOOD: Yup. We played that in the studio while we were making the record. We love Sega.

YORKE: We figure that we shouldn't be doing music anymore, but music for video games. We ran into these 12year-olds one day, playing video games, and they asked us what we did. We said we were in a band, and they just weren't very impressed. They said, "Get out of it! Get into writing tunes for Sega!"

All the record companies in England are really paranoid about it, because the retail shops in Britain sell more games than they do records. But that's OK we're going into virtual reality rock anyway. We'll never leave our homes. We'll have rehearsals in cyberspace. GREENWOOD: You have these new pop stars like the Sonic Hedgehog that're creations of the company, not human beings, so they're controlled completely. But we're not Sonic — we can't be programmed to do things that the record companies want us to. Sonic's not gonna walk out on Sega and threaten to sign to Nintendo, now is he? "I want more money ... otherwise, it's Hedgehog wars.'

#### Which pops up in your song "Vegetable"... "I am not a vegetable/I will not control myself."

YORKE: A lot of things I write come from really simple ideas. That was a

funny song, because I had a lot of phrases floating around. But the principal image I had in my head was "One Flew Over The Cuckoo's Nest," and all the people that sit around the main area in the film that don't actually do anything except drool or go to the toilet without knowing it. But when you read the book, you find out that the Chief is the main character, and that's the brilliant thing about it — nobody speaks to him because he's the idiot.

The song "Anyone Can Play Guitar" is slagging off that whole "I wanna be Jim Morrison" thing. When they released Morrison's lyrics as poetry, I thought, "Oh God." It just showed what he was — a real piss-head. There were flashes, though, and he was very good-looking. And in that sense, I'd like to be Jim Morrison. **So instead of the "Lizard King," you'd**



Where does your reputation for being rude in interviews come from?

Don't believe everything you read! Obviously, you've been reading the English press. It's a very British thing... there's a really jealous attitude towards any success. It's very strange. If an English guy sees you in a Rolls-Royce, he'll smash it up. If an American saw it, he'd say, that's great, I want one.

#### A girlfriend of mine has this theory that the bass-player in the band is always the bad boy.

That's quite a cheeky theory. Actually, I appreciate the analogy. I've always found bass-players to be the hardest-working. I always used to drive the van for the group. You're the first one up in the morning; you have to load the gear. The band gets pissed because you wake them up. You can't get pissed because you have to drive. I went to a gig with Echo and the Bunnymen once. Guess who was driving their van? The bass-player. They end up being the most reliable and doing the most physical work. Now your friend's analogy as a woman might be valid. I'll go for the bad boy and charming, please.

#### Are you married?

No, never, but I do have two children. With my last girlfriend, we actually set a date. Then it went strictly downhill. We broke it off. You find people's true attitudes when you argue over little things. I still love her, though. I was actually looking forward to hanging up my boots and saying, "Yes, go for it."

#### That doesn't sound too bad boy to me. Do you miss being a punk?

Attitudinally, I still am in some ways. It shows in my attitude toward promotion and music. We never used to do any interviews. We came from a punk background, so we felt the music should speak for itself, and not be surrounded by all that bullshit hype.

#### New Order's blend of dance and rock had many people calling you the spintual godfathers of Jesus Jones and EMF.

I like EMF's attitude. But as far as Jesus Jones, I think that's disgusting. If we were the spiritual godfathers of Jesus Jones, I'd be hanging up my guitar. I think they're rubbish.

The band is very involved in their ownership of the Hacienda in Manchester, a dance club with a rave atmosphere. How do you see the rave philosophy?

I've always found the rave philosophy in England to be, let's play some good music and forget our problems. But do you feel there's more to rave than just having a

almost 20 years after it started? We've got all that happening in Manchester in a place called Afflecks. It's like the punk-goth hangout. They're relating to the fashion. Punk isn't trying to change music anymore. The original punks bought the Sex Pistols record to shock their parents. Imagine if my daughter came home wearing a dog collar. I'd probably be laughing because that's what I did to shock my parents.

### I like punk music for more than just the clothes.

You listen to punk for enjoyment, just like I listen to the Velvet Undergound. I recently met [the Clash's] Mick Jones for the first time. I was a bit drunk and he came up and asked how I was. I'd never met him, but it was very nice. I was quite surprised he knew me. I'm a bit more shy and retiring. He's one of my heroes. I would never have gone up to him, like, "Hi, how are you?," like he did. Y'know, that fear of rejection.

#### Can New Order ever have the same degree of impact on people's lives that fans say Joy Division did?

I don't know, really. Maybe when New Order finishes, people will say that. Do you think people would be saying the same cerebral stuff about Joy Division if they were still going? You always want what you can't have. It's more mysterious that way. ■

ormer punk-rockin', ethnic food cravin', bass-playin' rock & roll bad boy Peter Hook most likely is the most colorful member of the U.K. dancerock band New Order. The three other current members of New Order singer/guitarist Bernard Albrecht, keyboardist Gillian Gilbert and drummer Steven Morris — all sound so low-key and agreeable compared to Hook, a clever, witty loudmouth with more opinions than Rush Limbaugh. New Order's refusal to compromise is leaendary — be it in their music or their firm decisions to do record covers and videos that are artistic and rarely show their faces. That stubborness is even more impressive in a year when there are so many cutie-pie boy videos on "120 Minutes" that lack any substance.

he group's roots are in the seminal Mancunian group Joy Division, a forerunner for everyone from the Smiths to My Bloody Valentine, which splin-tered apart on the eve of their maiden U.S. tour with the tragic 1980 suicide of lead singer Ian Curtis. The remaining members have carried on, though, and their current "Republic" album, their first since 1989's "Technique," is a major surprise. But make no mistake: Orzabal's brilliance and vireathtaking clarity reminiscent at times

Suddenly, Tammy!, "Suddenly, Tammy!" (spinArt): This sweet, steady and smooth-sounding trio from Lancaster, PA centers around Beth Sorrentino and her multi-timbral, multi-colored vocal style that resembles the qualities of Kate Bush and Harriet Wheeler. This heartwarming sound is nicely layered

over a bed of bass and drums and Beth exchanges piano for guitar with aplomb. "Stacey's Trip" and "Disease" are handled with the skill and subtlety that the band's namesake, Tammy Faye, never quite grasped. (Meredith Chinn)

**Over The Rhine, "Patience" (IRS):** Entirely original and completely involving, this Cincinnati band's delicate musical poetry provides a direct link to the work of the masters of deeply-affecting pop. Finding present day company alongside the likes of The Innocence Mission, this romantic quartet deals in shimmering



tragedy and an occasional bout with guarded optimism. The economical arrangements of acoustic guitar, bass and drums, with an occasional piano and electric guitar on this selfproduced album allow Karen Bergquist's expressive voice to steer the direction of their dreamy, elegant songs.

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WVON CHICAGO. #### Who was responsible for Bobby O'Jay getting into this thing called radio?

Before I got my first job in Montgomery, I was living in Milwaukee with my brother, going to broadcasting school in the day and working as a janitor at night. I was 17 or 18, sending out tapes everyday to radio stations. It took me about a year-and-a-half to get a response. Tracy Larkin at WRMA contacted me, we talked and I told him I was on-air one day a week at this radio station in Milwaukee, even though I'd never been on the radio in my life! Larkin said he had an evening drive shift for me, so here I was on my first shift without any experience. Little did I know Larkin knew I had never been on-air. He never said to me, "Bobby, I knew you had never been on the air, but I saw something in you and wanted to give you a break." So I really appreciate what he did for me.

The other influence which initially sparked me came from my cousin Melvin Jones, who now works for Capitol Records. Melvin came home one day back in 1967 while he was at WNOO Chattanooga, TN. I was about 12 years-old and he had this brandnew Mustang, a gorgeous girl on his arm, and I said to him, "Man, all you do is talk on the radio and you make this type of money." He said, "Yeah." I said, "Great!" So I started to prepare myself. I listened to WDIA and, from my hometown in Mississippi, I started emulating some of the great talent that was on-air at that time. Cecil Hale was a major influence as well as A. C. Williams.

#### Did programming come naturally to you or did trial-and error play a part in your career?

As time goes on, you learn from people who are winning. You try to get research in your hands, and I truly thank God for giving me the sense to know what kind of research I need and when I should implement it.

#### You've been a household name in Memphis for so long, do you feel that this will be your career home?

I'm comin' up on 40 in August. I got a feelin' that most people in the industry think I'm older; those who knew me know I was doing afternoon drive in Houston back in

1973 when I was like 20. Since I've been in the industry so long and at a major market so

early in my career, people probably think Bobby O'Jay is an old guy.

But I like programming and I love Memphis. I like working for [station owner] Regan Henry... he's very, very kind to me. Memphis has been very kind to me. You can live like a king here with a decent salary. I do think about going other places, but it would have to be a great situation. The money would have to be triple what I'm making now. It would have to be an unreal offer. Not to mention people that I trust. I'm at a point in my life where I don't want to work for people I don't trust. I want to work for and with people who appreciate my talent. The owner of the station knows me personally here. I get off on that.

#### What do you look for in new on-air talent?

I like to look for people who may be willing, but are unable. If a person is willing, but unable, I can help him. I have cultivated a great deal of talent. When I get young people from this market or smaller, I work with them so they can move on to bigger and better things. Because right now, we're not paying \$100,000 a year to jocks. [Laughs.] But I always encourage them to be the best they can be, and to move on to other markets.

#### What are some of the milestones you feel you've accomplished in this industry?

The things that really stick with me are the things that I did in Chicago. I did this promotion, "I Love My Job, And I'm Still Doing It." People from Chicago would come to Memphis. call me and ask. "Are you the same guy that used to do this in Chicago?" That was something I did back in '78 or '79 and people still remember! The other thing I remember is getting my first major award for air personality of the year back in '80 or '81. I still have it in my house right now. I had never thought of winning something like it. The one thing we've done here most recently was broadcasting for 31 days from a housing project. I consider doing things like that memorable.

WWBZ? ... Phoenix's KZRX raids KUPD again, taking Rob Trygg for mornings. Station is now on live 6am-midnight, with Z-Rock satellite overnights only ... New airplay adds come in from those Mexican (and we use the term loosely) banditos, Brujeria. Why do we feel that these guys are really the house band at Coyote? Accept comes in a close second with their first studio album in years; Engines of Aggression follow third, being a priority at Priority. Mercyful Fate close out mostly all stations add-wise and Blackie's back with a new one from W.A.S.P. "The Crimson Idol"'s a concept album and if you want to know more, call Capitol's Byron Hontas ... Airplay debuts start off with strong Suicidal and their rereleased, re-recorded, re-Schnapp-inated "Still Cyco."
