## Rock Hall Rolls

They said it would never happen, but the Rock and Roll Hall of Fame and Museum broke ground on its Cleveland site last Monday (7), with a who's-who of politicians and rock stars on hand, including Ohio Gov. **George V. Voinovich**, Cleveland Mayor **Michael R. White**, Hall of Fame founders **Ahmet Ertegun** and **Jann Wenner**, inductees **Chuck Berry**, **Ruth Brown** and **Pete Townshend** and recording artists **Billy Joel** and **Soul Asylum's Dave Pirner**.

The \$84 million, 150,000 square-foot project, designed by architect **I.M. Pei**, is scheduled for completion in mid-'95. The attraction is expected to pump \$75 million per year into the regional economy, attract as many as one million visitors a year and employ over 100 people. The exhibits are being designed by the internationally recognized **Burdick Group of S.F.**, which will include , bellybutton lint from **Madonna**, **Kurt Cobain's** toenail clippings and **Timothy White's** first "Music To My Ears."


John McL. "The Farmer In The" Doelp has been appointed Sr. Vice President of Marketing at Epic Records by Epic President Dave "Rubber" Glew.


## Shaq Raps



## Twitty Passes

Rockabilly songwriter turned teen idol turned country star **Conway Twitty** died last Saturday (5) at the age of 59 from complications after surgery for a blood vessel ruptured in his stomach. Twitty had collapsed on his tour bus on the way to his home in Hendersonville, TN, after a performance last Friday night in Branson, MO.

Twitty was born **Harold Jenkins** on Sept. 1, 1933 but changed his name in 1957 by combining the towns of Conway, Ark., and Twitty, Texas, and his performing career took off with more than 40 #1

hits, including "It's Only Make Believe," "Hello Darlin'," "Tight-Fittin' Jeans" and "Linda On My Mind." When he decided to switch to country, Twitty won the Country Music Association's vocal duo of the year award with **Loretta Lynn** from 1972-'75 and picked up a '71 Grammy for their duet, "After the Fire Is Gone."

Twitty is survived by his wife **Dee Henry**, four children and his mother, who all live at Twitty City, a nine-acre tourist complex in Hendersonville, a suburb of Nashville.




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# LIGHTNING

**R**od Stewart has been at the doctor's office all morning. Bad hay fever — probably not helped out much by a night on the town with his old Faces and Jeff Beck Group buddy Ron Wood. We should all look so good when we're under the weather. Rod is positively dapper in yellow slacks, a white T-shirt and a light vest with black pinstripes. In a few hours, he and his allergies will meander over to NBC studios to perform on "Late Night With David Letterman" — with Wood in tow and, presumably, leading our hero on another late-night Apple binge. You've got to admire the guy's stamina... besides doing Letterman, Stewart also spent a couple of days rehearsing and performing with Aretha Franklin for her "Duets" special.

But the real news on this trip is "Unplugged... And Seated," Rod Stewart's MTV concert special, album and home video. Sure, it's part of the "Unplugged" bandwagon but, yes, it's as good as the best performances that have been released under that moniker. Working with his regular touring band and Wood as a special guest, Stewart uses the "Unplugged" format to push back towards the music of his earliest albums, which were mostly acoustic and folk-oriented. He still raves it up a bit on numbers such as "Stay With Me" and "Hot Legs," but the show/album/video's best moments come on the slower songs — right down to Stewart wiping tears from his eyes after a tender rendering of Van Morrison's "Have I Told You Lately." But what made the Rodster really weep was the prospect of having to spend any time at all with HITS' Detroit "Pissed-On" Gary Graff "Gun Will Travel."

## ROD

with Rod Stewart **BY GARY GRAFF**

**During the taping of the Aretha Franklin "Duets" special, where were you when her strapless gown, unh, betrayed her?**

I was right behind her. I poked Gloria Estefan in the ribs and said, "She's having a bosom moment, dear. She's unwrapping her bosoms here, her ample cleavage." It was very nice singing with her, though [the taping] dragged on too long. We were there for almost four hours. But Elton was playing some tremendous piano.

**You really couldn't hear it very well, though.**

I told them to do that. [Laughs.] Elton and I are always playing games with each other.

**Didn't you have to share a dressing room with him?**

That was a nightmare. You know what those old vaudeville theatres are like — there's just a sink and a couple of coat hangers in the dressing room. He got all his clothes in there, and that was it. He left no coat hangers for me! He's such a funny guy, though. I can't see enough of him... and on top of



that, I've had Ron Wood in town, so between the two of them...

**What kind of trouble did you get into with Woody?**

Woody and I went to the Rhythm Cafe and took our trousers down. Yes, we took our trousers down. We stood up and exposed ourselves. To who? I don't know.

**I'm surprised you didn't try to catch Van Morrison's show.**

I didn't know he was in town until I got here. Someone suggested that they wanted to produce a record of me and Van singing "Danny Boy," the old Irish ballad. I don't know if he knows anything about it yet; this came via Ron Wood, and anything Woody says is suspect.

**It's quite a nice moment on "Unplugged" when you shed a tear during Van's "Have I Told You Lately."**

And it won't happen again! I don't know what brought it on. I mean, I love my wife and my child, but God, I didn't expect that to happen. It was very un-me; it's usually football matches I get teary-eyed at — soccer matches to you. It did make for quite a magical moment, I suppose.

**Before there was any talk of "Unplugged," you were supposed to do an album of cover songs.**

What happened is they wanted it out really quickly. I didn't have time to finish it, so we decided to take some tracks from throughout my career — a Jeff Beck track, some Faces tracks — and just put a nice combination of them together with the new covers. It actually did very well; it goes from "Ain't Superstitious," the first track I ever recorded with Jeff Beck, right through to "Tom Traubert's Blues."

**It also includes an interesting version of Stevie Nicks' "Stand Back." Did you get much grief for that?**

I think I would have if it was released in this country. It's a fairly new song, but you've got to have a challenge now and then. Everybody told me not to do it — "How could you?" It was sort of like Otis Redding doing "Satisfaction" after the Stones, although I don't think "Stand Back" came off quite as well.

**So how did you get from covers to "Unplugged"?**

I was asked 18 months ago to do "Unplugged," but I didn't have the time then. I was in Australia when MTV asked me to do it, which was about the time Eric [Clapton] was recording his. I didn't want people to think I was jumping on the next bandwagon, either. But I said, "I'd love to do it." My first three albums are mostly acoustic anyway, mandolin and violin sounds. There was only one person I wanted to play on it, and that was Woody — or Jeff [Beck], but I really wanted Woody. He's an acoustic man, a wonderful acoustic guitar player.

**Did you get to pitch the idea to Jeff?**

Jeff has been suffering from his ear disease, tinitus. There is one thing I'd love to do before I go into my grave and that would be to record an album with Jeff,

especially in light of this Coverdale/Page extravaganza. I'd really like so much for the two of us to put out a record. He's so hard to get a hold of; I don't think he has a telephone or a fax machine or anything, but I'll get through to him somehow.

**Most singers are lucky enough to have tight relationships with one collaborator during their lifetimes, but you've done pretty well with both Ron and Jeff.**

Indeed, especially with Woody. As my wife said, "You two are like brothers." Woody's wife and my wife compare notes and apparently we have exactly the same sexual appetite, too. So it goes further than skin deep.

**Will Woody be able to play on your tour?**

Yeah. He said he would love to come out and do a few dates on the upcoming tour if he gets his Stones album out of the way. He said last night that if he knew he was up here doing "Late Night" with me, Keith would want him down there now. Keith gets very jealous when he does other projects.

**Was it a conscious decision to do mostly older material for "Unplugged"?**

Yeah, without a doubt. The most up-to-date song we tried was "Forever Young." We recorded it, but it didn't quite come off on that night. The ones we used are all folksy type songs. They have to be lyrically brilliant, which I think something like "Handbags and Gladrags" is; most of those slow ballads have got very strong lyrics. There's something very Gaelic and romantic about violins and mandolins, especially when they're adapted to rock & roll ballads. I think that's the best sound ever. That's all R.E.M.'ve done recently... violins and mandolins.

**How has doing an "Unplugged" affected**

**your view on future work?**

I could’ve quite honestly done an “Unplugged” with just one guitar — me and Woody alone. What I like is the idea of having those guys around me who are accomplished on acoustic instruments. It gives me a shot for the next album, on which I’m going to try to write acoustically, starting at Christmas, when this tour is over.

You suddenly realize what you do best, especially when you get to my age. Acoustic rock is probably the best vehicle for me. I’ve never really been at home with synthesizers. I’ve made some albums with synthesizers — wildly, desperately. But now I understand... I’m a guitar man.

But that doesn’t mean an acoustic album has to be all ballads. “Every Picture Tells A Story,” when it was recorded, used two acoustics with a little bit of electric guitar in it and a drummer who didn’t have a drum kit.

**Some famous rock & roll lore.**

[Mick Waller] was one of the laziest bastards that ever lived. Woody told me he

was it. They all gelled together nicely when you listened to the whole album. “Maggie May” almost didn’t make the record; no one thought it had any melody whatsoever to it. It was just a rambling song. If it hadn’t been for a d.j. in Cleveland who turned it over — “Reason To Believe” was the A-side — I’d still be digging graves in England.

**Between the “Storyteller” boxed set, the “Lead Vocalist” thing in England and now this, most of your work of late has been retrospective.**

It’s about time to start writing something. I usually wait until it’s time to do a record before I start — I’m not one of those natural songwriters that sits around every day writing songs. I need a bit of pressure. I need to be pushed into a corner and I’ll start writing. It used to be real hard work for me to write lyrics, a struggle. I actually miss it now. It’s been two-and-a-half years since I’ve written a song, so I feel I’ve got quite a bit to write about.

came to a couple of Stones sessions, drank all their beer and announced, “Sorry boys, I’ve drunk all your beers.” He came on a bicycle, wheeled himself home and ended up in a gutter. I would imagine he’s playing with some jazz guitarist or something now.

**Back to “Unplugged,” it seems like these shows prompt a kind of re-assessment for those who do them.**

That’s a good word to use. There are a lot of bands that shouldn’t do one. Like Arrested Development or Roxette — what the fuck they’re doing acoustic sets for, I don’t know. Someone like Eric has a large volume of work. You can change some of the songs. But that’s where the comparison with my album and Eric’s album stops. Eric’s album is more, I don’t want to sound insulting, but like something you put on when you’re having a sherry with dinner or having sex or something. It goes by and it’s almost a little muzaky. And that’s not putting it down. Whereas my album has some uptempo, really raunchy old stuff on it. I think I’ve got one hit single off this, the Van Morrison song. I wish everybody wouldn’t think it’s going to do seven million copies, but that’s the way record companies think. I’ll be pleased if it does a couple of million. But you must have a single on it to get it away. It didn’t used to be like that in the old days. You used to just make albums and not worry about singles.

**Can you get yourself back into that mindset?**

I intend to with my next album. I get a feeling it’s going to go back to that anyway. When I made “Every Picture Tells A Story,” we just put nine tracks down and that

**Like your very pleasant domestic situation?**

Maybe. But listen... I haven’t joined the pipe and slipper club just yet. I can still go quite mad; me and Woody went mad last night. But I don’t really know until I put pen to paper how it’s going to be. But I’m sure it will have an influence. I don’t think I’ll be writing songs like “Hot Legs” and “Infatuation” or things like that anymore. Then again, you never know.

**So, as a soccer maven, how do you think the World Cup will go over in America?**

I don’t know. I think it’ll be a big success. There were a lot of World Cup matches last night, and the British teams didn’t do well. I don’t think any of them will get through.

**They would if they formed a national team.**

There’s too much pride involved. Being a Scot, I’d hate to see the Scottish team dissolved into a British team. It would be one hell of a team, though.

**As you approach your 50th birthday, you’re still playing soccer — and rock & roll. Does it spook you at all?**

No, I must be totally honest with you — it didn’t on my 20th, my 30th, my 40th, and it won’t on my 50th. I’m not tremendously worried about growing old. I have no thoughts of retirement. I love it. Music makes, if I could just put it in a nutshell, it makes me so happy... doing it and everything to do with it. I love it, especially in the last five years, when there have been so many real highs. I haven’t won a Grammy yet, but I can live with that. ■







**X, "Hey Zeus!" (Big Life/Mercury/PLG):** Marked by decidedly more complex sounds, arrangements and subject matter, "Hey Zeus!" represents a definite, ambitious departure for these L.A. punk rock icons. X faithful will find the familiarity of "Clean Like Tomorrow" and "Big Blue House," reminiscent of "Wild Gift" and "Big Black Sun"-era X, a satisfying trip through the sound of their glory years, while "New Life" expresses their greater maturity. Exene and John Doe's trademark twangy two-part harmony is a joy.

### Fishbone, "Give A Monkey A Brain..."

**(Columbia):** Upon the first listening of Fishbone's latest, you may be inclined to refer to MTV's "Young Ones" resident punk rocker's studded denim jacket and simply comment, "very metal." With the exceptions of the very Fishbone-friendly and skank-worthy "The Warmth Of Your Breath" and "Lemon Meringue," you'd be right. What's so impressive is how comfortably and convincingly this amazingly-talented band moves between sonic crunch and slippery ska. A sweaty, moshy good time.




**Sun 60, "Only" (Epic):** The dusky romantic lyrics, smooth, sensual vocals and the combination of folksy American and catchy English musical references conjure up memories of another fine duo with a gift for pop songs—Buckingham/Nicks. to take someone on as an intern and that person indicates he or she really wants to learn, that's an obligation. If you're a PD or an MD, take your intern with you to dine with that promotion person (who's gonna tell you you're wrong?). Invite him or her to observe a production session. Explain what's important about promos, liners, commercial copy, the format clock, etc. Make sure that they're present at that weekend remote and always explain the details—that's where the war is won or lost. For your effort, if the person in fact carries on, you'll get to feel good. Not a bad reward. Later.




# RERAP

What price knowledge? "We're learning," says Bruce Jesse of **Wherehouse**. On the heels of a successful Memorial Weekend promotion in which they were taking in used CDs for discounts on new product, we were bound to give Bruce a call and ask him how it went. "You're going to see us try a number of things. And the things that work we'll keep, and those that don't, we'll dump. But we're paying a heavy price for what we're learning [in operating costs as well as lost co-op ad revenue] and we want to keep the fruits of our hard-earned knowledge to ourselves." (In other words, a polite way of saying, "no comment.") And learning they are. What Jesse is too modest to talk about is the fact that **Wherehouse** has gone about the business of used product in the most scientific and pragmatic ways possible. According to our sources, the first step was to conduct a test at 24 **Wherehouse** locations split into four groups, using four different sets of criteria involving whether or not each store would give store credit or cash (or both) and whether or not they would accept "punched" product, although no stores are accepting anything actually marked "promotional" on the packaging or the CD itself. All stores have been and still are ac-

cepting "Record Club" CDs (the "eight for a penny" Record Club CDs have always been a sore subject with retailers, who bring it up everytime distribution has argued that used CDs brought down the "perceived value" of new CDs). A 23-page manual on the handling and processing of the used CD product was sent to all participating locations. You see, **Wherehouse**, in order to stay competitive in the used market, must be able to automate the value judgement on what a particular piece of used product is worth (if anything) the same way an indie store does. In most instances, the indie will have some savvy people behind the counter making those decisions. **Wherehouse** has to create that same savvy in their computer systems. "We had a promotion and we feel it was a success," says Jesse. "Now onto the next. We're still new at this and we still have a lot to learn..." Look for some heavy upper-demo sales on the upcoming soundtrack for "Sleepless In Seattle," starring **Meg Ryan** and **Tom Hanks**. The compilation has standard after standard by **Louis Armstrong**, **Nat King Cole**, **Jimmy Durante**, **Harry Connick Jr.** and more. This one should still be around for some of those "Unforgettable" Xmas dollars... Congrats are in order for **Radioactive's Lulabox** and **Russell Aiello** (as well as the entire **Uni** staff) on their recent retail promotion that benefited **Project Angel Food**, **Aid for AIDS** and the **Minority AIDS Project**. The promotion collected canned food for these worthy charities at Los Angeles record stores that included (please forgive me if I leave anyone out) **Tempo**, **Nickelodeon**, **Arons**, **Go Boy**, **Middle Earth**, **Rhino**, **Record Trader**, **Prime Cuts** and **Peer Records**. Thanks to you all.




