### MUSIC... home" music

"If you'll listen to the songs that were popular a year ago, you'll see that it hasn't been a sudden thing, but a gradual ac-ceptance, and then liking, of this type of music. I think there are several reasons for it. First of all. today's teenagers are a lor more hip than they were five years ago. They want more to their music than a simple tune and some meaningless words. I'm not saying there weren't good songs before, but quite a bit of them were just insipid recordings that you could forget the minute you heard it. Today's music lovers want depth to their songs. Most of them know enough about the music business to be able to tell when a record is really good or just slickly pro-fessional. When you reach 14 or 15 nowadays, you're a lot smarter than someone of the same age five or ten years ago ... you grow up faster. That's why the blues beat is taking over. The words to pop songs roday are intelligent . they mean something. "Time Is On My Side" for example . . . it's an old song, but no one was ready for it when it first came out. Now everyone is. It's not a "slick" song ... the words say something, and the Rolling Stones are saying something when they sing it. Actually, that's the whole thing . you can't get away with just singing a song anymore. You've got to know what you're singing, and it's got to mean something to you, the singer."
