HOLLYWOOD — KRLA, the station that always scores first, has done it again! This time, KRLA becomes the first station in the world to have its own tv spectacular! Naturally, being KRLA, the spectacular will be about music . . . but not just about Beatle music. The name of the show is "KRLA PRESENTS . . . MILLION DOLLAR MUSIC." It will trace the beginning of rock and roll from the first days of Bill Haley back in 1955 right up to the present Beatle-mad days of today.

GIANT LINE UP

The show will feature live appearances and film clips of the greatest names in the record business, with a line up never before seen on one show. Among the stars appearing will be the Beatles, Elvis Presley, 4 Preps, Roger Miller, Dick Clark, Jack Good, The Vibrants, Bobby Rydell, The Coasters, Martha & Vandellas, Billy & Lilly, Chuck Berry, Sam & Johnny, Dee Clark, Sam Cooke, Duane Eddy, Danny & the Jrs., Connie Francis, Platters, Bobby Vee, Della Reese, Bobby Darin, Big Brother, Jan & Dean, Chubby Checker, Skip & Flip, Ray Peterson, Brook Benton, Paul Anka, Diamonds, Fleetwood, Bill Haley, Jim Reeves, Johnny Horton, and Little Anthony. Also scheduled for the show, but not yet confirmed, are the Rolling Stones, Dion, Shelley Fabares, Isley Brothers, and Jimmy Rogers.

D.J.'S WILL APPEAR

Every one of the KRLA d.j.s will appear for his own segment of the ninety minute show. Opening host will be Hank Mancini, who will introduce the d.j.s.
