## ICM Makes A Towering Move

ICM has made a bold move to strengthen its presence in the alternative music market by purchasing TwinTowers Touring. The deal was consummated April 29th and was announced by ICM's Bill Elson and TwinTowers' Bob Lawton and Steve Kaul on May 1st. Unlike other acquisition deals, ICM will not, for now at least, merge TwinTowers acts into its roster. The agency will continue to operate at its same funky Broadway location and will function as an "alternative office" for ICM in much the same way other agencies treat their Nashville operations. TwinTowers boasts a solid 40 act roster which includes Dinosaur Jr., Juliana Hatfield, The Lemonheads, Liz Phair, Mudhoney and Sonic Youth. Their phone numbers remain the same, but now they will be answering the phone ICM/TwinTowers. The two offices will be linked by computer and TwinTowers will now have the benefit of ICM's business and legal affairs departments. That should free Kaul and Lawton to spend more time as agents and less with the concerns of running a business. Elson said that many of TwinTowers acts signed with that agency because they wanted to be part of the independent environment Lawton and Kaul provided, and ICM would be foolish to jump in and immediately change that. And for their part, Lawton and Kaul said that if anyone ever thinks they have gotten too big for their britches, they should give them "a good swift kick in the pants."

## Why That's Libel

Wynonna and Naomi Judd's ex-manager, Ken Stilts, filed a \$20 million libel lawsuit against the *Globe* tabloid and one of its senior reporters, Bob Michals, last week. The suit was in response to an article that ran in the April 5th issue which said that The Judds claim Stilts stole \$20 million from them while he was their manager. "Wynonna and Naomi Judd have accused their former manager of bleeding them dry for 10 years — then dumping them," the tabloid reported. Stilts claims that the reporter was told the information was false prior to publishing the story and the tabloid has refused to publish a retraction. Meanwhile, Wynonna continues to build a whole new team for her solo career. She and Pro Tours, the company which booked and promoted most of her dates in-house, will sever their seven-year relationship at the end of the year. Pro Tours has quite a few dates already on the books but further booking inquires should go to her new agent, Rod Essig at CAA in Nashville. Pro

Tours prexy Steve Pritchard said his firm will now concentrate on its highly successful festival promotion business.

## Legal Eagles

The Eagles won a temporary restraining order May 3rd blocking its former label, Elektra Entertainment, from releasing another greatest hit package. The restraining order against the label's release is part of a breach of contract lawsuit the group filed May 3rd in Los Angeles Superior Court. The group claims its previous contract with Elektra has been fulfilled with the release of various compilation albums over the years. The complaint states the latest Elektra compilation would interfere with sales of a live album the Eagles plan to release at the end of their reunion tour which begins May 27th at Irvine Meadows Amphitheatre and runs through October. Late last month, Don Henley, Glenn Frey, Don Felder, Timothy B. Schmit and Joe Walsh actually came together on a sound stage at Warner Bros. Studios in Burbank for their first concert since the band broke up in 1980. They taped a concert that will be shown on MTV in late summer.

## The Music Police

Courtney Love was cleared of the drug charges that were filed against her the day before her husband, Kurt Cobain, was found dead at their Seattle home. Authorities now say the substance found in Love's hotel room was not heroin and the syringes found were meant to be used for injecting prescription painkillers. Love's attorney said she had been treated for an allergic reaction to prescription drugs April 7th, the day she was arrested after being taken to a hospital by paramedics. "I am delighted that this nightmare is over," Love said in a statement. "I can now concentrate on putting my life back together and mourning the loss of my husband." .... Tupac Shakur was arrested April 29th when a car he was riding in was pulled over on Hollywood Blvd. for going 45 mph in a 25 mph zone. After searching the car, Los Angeles police found a loaded .9mm automatic pistol and a half-

# TIM McGRAW

When Tim McGraw takes the stage these days, something very different happens in the audience — his fans sing along to his songs and they know all the words. "We've always had great reactions [and] audiences have always been good to us," McGraw told POLLSTAR. "But that's a lot different than [being] up there havin' a hit." McGraw said at two recent concerts — one in Louisville, the other in Houston — he was singing "Don't Take The Girl" off his current Curb release, and the crowd was singing along so he stopped and let the audience finish the rest of the song. "That was probably one of the coolest things that's happened. It was incredible. It was better than sex — almost."


McGraw's newest and second release on Curb, *Not a Moment Too Soon*, shot to the top of the country charts when it was released a little over a month ago. In honor of the feat, Curb Records and Image Management told McGraw they were going to present him with a plaque at a recent concert at Billy Bob's in Ft. Worth. The record company and McGraw's management flew his mother and girlfriend in for the special occasion. And when the time came for the presentation, McGraw got the surprise of his life — a brand new Harley Davidson. McGraw said he'd like to find a way to take the Harley on the road with him. "I don't know how I'm going to do it, but I'm trying to figure something out."

If McGraw doesn't find a way to take his motorcycle on the road with him, he will be away from it for 250 days this year. McGraw said he didn't tour a lot last year (only 150 days), but that will be different this year. "I think right now, at my stage in my career, [touring] is important. And plus, right now I enjoy it. I'm sure there's going to come a point where it's not as important and where I don't enjoy it as much. And when it comes to that point, I'm sure I'll cut down. But right now, I'm havin' a blast."

McGraw, who is booked by Rod Essig at CAA, is currently on tour with Sawyer Brown and Diamond Rio, and he plans to stay in that support role for a while. "We're not looking to jump out in the middle of anything right now. We just want to do our part and one of these days we'll get to headline [arenas]." Nevertheless, McGraw is headlining quite a few clubs in between support dates.

McGraw's recent success has not come without controversy. His hit single, "Indian Outlaw," has been attacked by some Native American organizations who have asked radio stations to ban the song because they feel the lyrics are offensive. But McGraw said he has also had an overwhelming amount of positive reaction from many Native Americans. "[The controversy] has really been overplayed. We've gotten probably two or three letters from Native American groups that are opposed to the song but we've gotten tons of letters [from Native Americans] in support of it. But anytime you have somebody that doesn't like what you're doing, it bothers you. And especially Native American issues, because I've been an advocate of Native American issues for a long time, [and] haven't been able to do anything about it."

McGraw has addressed the controversy surrounding the song with a few Native American groups and leaders, including Wilma Mankiller, principal chief of the Oklahoma Cherokee. "I don't know if they were able to see my point of view, because things get so mussed down it's hard to tell. But I think they realized that I



was not being malicious. I hoped they realized that — that was the main point of [the conversations]. When you have so many [Native Americans] who love the song and have adopted the song as their high school [theme song] and you have a few that don't like it, then that's when you don't know what to really think. Whose side are you supposed to take when you have a lot that like it and a few that don't? That's when you have to go with what you feel is right. And I've never thought the song was offensive, or I wouldn't have cut it to start with." So McGraw leaves the hit in his live repertoire and has no intention of pulling it from the album.

In fact, the controversy has done what public disputes often do — it has put McGraw and his hit song in the spotlight. And McGraw feels that the old adage — "any press is good press" — definitely applies to his situation. "In another situation, if I had not had anything to follow this song up with, then it would have been harmful. [But] I've always felt we were able to follow this up." And his instincts seem to be panning out — not only is the single on top of the country charts, his album has shot to the top end of the SoundScan charts. And his family couldn't be prouder.

McGraw's father, World Series pitching hero Tug McGraw, is thrilled with his son's success. And McGraw is proud of his dad's career and doesn't mind it when people look at him as a famous baseball player's son. "It doesn't bother me at all. That's part of my life and that's fine. I'm proud of him. He's done a great job. He's had a great career and I'm glad to talk about him anytime anybody wants to talk about him." McGraw and his father did not have a real relationship until the younger McGraw was 18 years old. But that hasn't negatively effected their current relationship. Tug McGraw reportedly gets very excited when he hears his son's songs on the radio. "He's having a great time with it, as is my mom and my grandparents and everybody. And I'm glad, because I want them to enjoy it."

McGraw has already begun the search for new songs for his next record. "We get demo tapes from publishing houses and I take them on the [road with us]." McGraw also writes songs, but won't record one of his until it is better than the ones he's getting from other songwriters. "These Nashville songwriters are great and nine times out of 10 they're going to beat me out." But McGraw doesn't plan on going back in the studio right away. "We'll probably record a new album toward the end of the year. I'm anxious to cut [a new record] but we're in no big hurry. We got a lot to take care of with this album first."

gram of marijuana. Shakur was kept in jail overnight and released on \$1,000 bail. Both the weapon and pot charges are misdemeanors. The driver of the car, Maurice Harding, was also arrested but was transferred to a medical facility first for an undisclosed problem. This was Shakur's fifth arrest in less than two years..... One of the two grand juries investigating child molestation allegations against Michael Jackson disbanded without bringing an indictment late last month. MJ remains under investigation by a Los Angeles County grand jury but the grand jury in Santa Barbara has apparently finished its work, although the D.A. there could call a new grand jury if he sees fit..... The Los Angeles D.A.'s probe into the possible mishandling of the Rick James assault case was turned over to state officials last week. The original investigation ensued when allegations surfaced that a D.A.'s investigator supplied heroin to a jailed witness who testified against James. The investigator resigned in February and no criminal charges have been brought thus far. After the allegations surfaced, James, who had been found guilty of assault last year, made a deal with prosecutors to stay his 5-year sentence and enter a drug rehab program instead.

Friend spent the last seven years as executive editor of *RIP* magazine and has also worked for *Album Network* and *HITS* magazines. He also was once the host of MTV's "Headbanger's Ball."..... Amy Brown has been named assistant GM at the Spokane Arena. She had been the marketing director at SRO Promotions and before that worked for Spectacor at the James L. Knight Center and The Centrum..... Keith Bailey has been named director of A&R for EastWest Records. He was previously an A&R director at Virgin Records.

## When I'm 64

A Beatles look-alike group has been charged for a third time with trademark infringement. Attorneys for Apple Corps Ltd., which owns publicity, trademark and tradename rights to The Beatles name, said the group, "1964 The Tribute," violated a court order forbidding the use of references to The Beatles. The group's agent, Mark Hellman of Group H Nashville, said they made an agreement with Apple to stop using a four-head logo that looks like the album cover of "Hard Days Night." But the promotion for a show at the Warner Theatre in Washington, D.C., apparently used the banned artwork as part of its advertising for an upcoming show and attorneys for Apple saw it. "As soon as we found out they were doing it, we called them and had them pull the ads," Hellman said. He said a ruling should be issued in a couple of weeks and he is confident the judge will understand that the group did not try to violate its agreement with Apple.

had an official name..... Jenny Berggren, singer for Ace of Base, was attacked at her home in Sweden April 27th. A woman allegedly camped outside Berggren's home for two days before breaking in, armed with a knife. Berggren was unharmed but her mother received stab wounds to the hand as the family overcame the attacker who was then turned over to police..... The three tenors, **Luciano Pavarotti, Placido Domingo and Jose Carreras**, will do a warmup concert in Monte Carlo June 9th in preparation of their concert at Dodger Stadium in Los Angeles July 16th — the night before this year's World Cup final. The proceeds from the Monte Carlo concert will go to an unnamed charity..... **MTV Networks** and Star-TV announced May 2nd that they have ended their affiliation agreement in Asia to pursue separate operations in the region. This comes amid reports of conflicts over money and programming. MTV Asia premiered on Star-TV's pan-Asian satellite television service more than two-and-a-half years ago. MTV Networks CEO Tom Freston said with the enormous potential of the Asian marketplace, the time is right for MTV to independently own and operate its business in Asia. MTV Networks is planning to launch two wholly-owned MTV channels in the Asian market later this year. Star-TV is owned by Rupert Murdoch's News Corp.

### Bolton Be Molten Over Court Ruling

Michael Bolton will ask a judge to overturn a jury finding that he plagiarized the Isley Brothers' 1966 song "Love Is A Wonderful Thing" in his hit of the same name. The Los Angeles jury awarded the Isley Brothers 66 percent of all royalties from the single and credited the song with 28 percent of the sales of Bolton's album *Time, Love and Tenderness*. The 1991 album has sold more than 10 million copies. Bolton said he and co-writer Andrew Goldmark never heard — or heard of — the Isley's song. "They just didn't establish in any way that Andy and I could have heard their song. The jury's finding... is incomprehensible and is tragically wrong," Bolton said. It is estimated the decision will cost him millions. If the judge rejects the motion to overturn the jury's finding, Bolton plans to appeal.

### Academy of Country Music Awards

Moments after Garth Brooks welcomed his daughter August Anna into the world, he was named the country music entertainer of the year for the fourth consecutive year. The 29th Annual

Academy of Country Music Awards was broadcast from the Universal Amphitheatre May 3rd on NBC but Brooks was in Nashville with his wife, Sandy. One of the show's co-hosts, Alan Jackson, took home awards for best single and best album. Another multiple winner was John Michael Montgomery who was named best new male vocalist and his "I Love the Way You Love Me" was named song of the year. Vince Gill took home his second consecutive male vocalist award and Brooks & Dunn won their second consecutive duet award. Little Texas and the Gibson Miller Band were honored as best vocal group and best new vocal group respectively. Faith Hill, who is currently on tour with the show's other co-host, Reba McEntire, was named best new female vocalist of the year. And Wynonna won female vocalist of the year — her first award as a solo artist. The ACM broadcast was seen in about 13 million homes and received a highly respectable 13.4 rating and 21 share. In a separate ceremony last month, Toolie's Country in Phoenix was named the country night club of the year and Bill Bachand of Mr. Bill Presents was named talent buyer/promoter of the year.

### Change Of Venue

Viacom has confirmed it is exploring the sale of **Madison Square Garden** along with the N.Y. Knicks basketball team, the Rangers hockey club and the MSG cable sports network. The move is seen as a reaction to the dying merger between Viacom and Blockbuster Entertainment. Viacom had expected to benefit from Blockbuster's cash flow when it was fighting to acquire Paramount Communications, which owns the Garden operations, but after Viacom acquired Paramount the merger deal started to sour. Blockbuster stockholders are unhappy with the falling value of Viacom's stock and many security analysts don't expect the merger to be completed. Blockbuster is reportedly among the prospective buyers of the Garden's operations.... The multimillion dollar public purchase of the **Target Center** in Minneapolis was approved last week by the Minnesota House and Senate, and the bills now go to a conference committee. If the Legislature approves a state payment of \$750,000 per year, the Metropolitan Sports Facilities Commission, which also owns the HHH Metrodome, would become the operator of the Target

## Between The Dates

The world's greatest rock n' roll band announced details of their world tour May 3rd in NYC, thereby virtually assuring that 1994 will be the biggest year in the history of the North American concert business. **THE ROLLING STONES** will begin their worldwide tour August 1st at RFK Stadium in D.C. and will be on the road in North America through November. Mick Jagger, Keith Richards, Charlie Watts and Ron Wood arrived at the tour press conference, which was staged at a seedy Manhattan pier, on board the *Honey Fitz*, a yacht once owned by John F. Kennedy. The Stones' new bass player, Darryl Jones, who sits in for the departed Bill Wyman, was not on the boat, but then neither was Chuck Leavell or any of the other longtime Stone's backup musicians. So far, the "Voodoo Lounge" tour consists of seventeen shows, all stadiums, in fourteen cities, with more cities to be added to the band's itinerary in the next few weeks. Virgin Records plans to release the new Stones album on July 12th. The tour will be sponsored by Budweiser (at one point the rumor was that it would be RC Cola) and produced by CPI. The initial itinerary also lists Oakland, Austin, Little Rock, Houston, Atlanta, Dallas, Tampa, Miami, New Orleans, and Gainesville, but no dates or venues were given. Eventually the tour will take the band to Japan, the Far East, and Europe. In 1995 The Stones plan on playing countries where they have never performed before, including Mexico, Brazil, Argentina, and Chile. For the North American part of the tour, three different acts will fill the support slot on a rotating basis, Lenny Kravitz, Stone Temple Pilots, and Counting Crows. Of the cities and venues that have been announced, it is interesting to note tour stops include several college stadiums in markets that traditionally have not been considered as "must play" cities. For example, instead of Milwaukee, the band is playing a college stadium in Madison. In Columbia, Missouri, the venue is the University Of Missouri's Faurot Field. In Columbia, South Carolina, it's Williams Brice Stadium at the University Of South Carolina. In fact six of the 14 venues announced so far are on college campuses. Gosh, wonder if the rent and merchandising deals at such venues was a major contributing factor in their selection? And what about the ticket prices? In a season that has already seen base ticket prices jump and golden circle prices above the \$100 mark for several acts, The Stones are keeping with their tradition of making the band accessible to the fans with prices set at \$25, \$39.50, and \$50. That's a real bargain in today's market. In fact that's cheaper than the base \$28.50 ticket the band used in 1989 for the "Steel Wheels" tour, although the mid-price and premium seats assure that the grosses will be much higher in '94. All in all, it looks like a brilliant plan put together by the Glimmer Twins and their cadre of advisors. Tickets for five cities were to go on sale May 7th with the rest to follow in the coming days. At the press conference, Jagger and the boys fielded questions from reporters, including a response to criticism that the band was "only in it for the money." "What about all the beer you can drink and all the girls down front?" answered Jagger. And they won't be playing Woodstock. "We weren't invited to the first, so we're not playing the second." Jagger also assured the crowd that this would not be the last Stones' tour. Jagger said, "I hate that sympathy thing that says, 'If you don't come, you're never going to see them again.'" Amid remarks by Jagger on how much prep he has to go through to do a two-hour show, and in response to questions about whether a band whose members are in their 40's and 50's can still rock like the old days, Keith Richards said, "Just look at us darling. You can tell.".... Suffering from a soar throat, **GEORGE STRAIT** told the 19,400 fans at his April 29th Anaheim Arena concert to hang on to their ticket stubs and to come back on May 15th. Strait had decided to "give it a shot anyway," but after a half hour on stage he was forced to call it a night..... Liberty Records artist **JOHN BERRY** was scheduled to begin a lengthy tour on May 14th but instead he will undergo surgery in Atlanta May 10th to remove a non-malignant brain cyst. Berry had been at an Athens, Georgia hospital visiting his wife, Robyn, who had just given birth to the couple's first child. While at the hospital, Berry, who had been suffering from severe headaches, asked for some medical advice leading to the discovery of the cyst. Berry is expected to recover fully and be back on stage in August..... If you think the price of Streisand tickets is too much, or that The Eagles are taking it to the limit, then Czech this out. Some tickets for a May 1st charity concert by **JOSE CARRERAS** and **MONTSERRAT CABALLE** in Prague, Czechoslovakia were priced at 80,000 crown, which equates to \$2,750. The 1,500 crown (\$50) and under tickets were virtually sold out, but according to a spokesman for the Czech Philharmonic, only one of the pricey tickets was actually sold.
