

WOULD YOU
BELIEVE....?
THE WORLD

It is now one hundred and twenty issues later and although it may sound somewhat ludicrous, we are still in business. Those who predicted our early demise have, themselves, disappeared or have joined the many who have come over to our side. One hundred and twenty issues of RPM Music Weekly have been published and sent throughout the world. In contrast from our beginning, we now have a great deal to say. Our industry has come of age and, as the advertising support within these sixty pages will prove, has graciously allowed RPM Music Weekly to be a voice for this multi-million dollar business.

Today the quality of the Canadian produced single has improved to such a degree that world sound men have given the Canadian sound an overwhelming vote of approval. The great ingenuity of Canada's producers has to be praised for bringing the sound up to a par with world productions. Essentially, these pioneers went into studios designed only for agency work and attempted to produce product for the world market against unsurmountable odds. Across Canada, sessions were being held in radio station, and makeshift studios, and surprisingly enough they were coming up with hits. Now, practically every province in the Dominion boasts an up to date recording studio. The attitude of most of the larger studios is still somewhat apathetic towards label work as opposed to the more lucrative commercial work, but this is changing. More of the last word in engineering sound equipment is being installed in the larger studios including the most necessary of all, the four track recording system.

We must now be very close to the same conditions that existed in England and caused such an upheaval in the world music industry, and from which the UK is benefiting to this very day. Through the press and general goading of the public by strong government forces, the public finally became aware that their homeside talent was being rather badly trodden by foreign product. A general hue and cry, by the populace, to keep Britain British resulted in legislation being passed restricting, somewhat, the use of foreign recordings. This gave the British recording industry a chance to have their product aired and a chance to compete. Although The Beatles were popular in the area around Liverpool and in some areas of the Continent, it wasn't until several very important and influential groups of stalwart Britshers began pushing for British recognition around the world, that The Beatles were skyrocketed to their pinnacle of fame. It was the old Colonial spirit that pushed and fought for British domination of the world music scene. The old saying of "The sun never sets on the British Empire", was once again revived. The Beatles contributed so greatly to the economy of Britain that The Queen bestowed the MBE on each member of the group. Could this same phenomenon ever happen in Canada, a country that knows no real feeling of patriotism? The answer, of course, is yes. It is happening.

WOULD YOU BELIEVE... ...THE WORLD?

Canadian broadcasters have contributed significantly to the cause of Canada for Canadians, and today more and more Canadians are hearing more "made in Canada" sounds than ever before. Radio stations, from coast to coast, have instigated shows of one, two and three hours to boosting the image of the country in which we live. The Moffat chain of stations announced in May of 1966 their plans to award the Lloyd E. Moffat Memorial Awards each year to those responsible for outstanding all-Canadian contributions to recorded music. The establishment of these awards was to honour Canada's Centennial year. There are some radio stations, however, that play ONLY ENOUGH Canadian and even those that play NONE AT ALL. This will change as the stations with the more progressive attitudes pass these rather poor unfortunates who prefer to capitalize on a borrowed format then create a market which would endow them to the country to whom they owe so much. The gentle push that was predicted in the year 1965 was to gentle. Reports have it that government circles are somewhat disturbed by the lack of out and out nationalism that was expected to be displayed by ALL radio stations in Canada. Talk of regulated radio is even stronger this year which may cause us to have this unwanted but necessary evil, a part of our life, before the Centennial year.

A major problem in developing the industry has been the categorizing of the industry. Radio stations who format as opposed to block programming have caused a war of music between broadcasters. Certain stations specialize in certain music and have great disregard for music other than what they play. The basic music of today has been, unfortunately, tagged "rock and roll" and any record that has a hit parade listing is regarded by many GMP stations as "rock and roll" and therefore not suited to their programming policy. The world music scene has changed drastically, and much of it is due to the influence The Beatles and the subsequent surge of British talent had on the world market. GMP stations found they were playing Beatle tunes, in the raw, and as performed by concert maestros. The need for entertainment has superceded the restricted tastes of the Program Director who programmed for his entertainment rather than the desires of his listening audience. Country music has shown up continually on the charts of those stations boasting a top forty format. Even the sleepy time ballads, reminiscent of the 40s have found their way to the listeners of "Hot Shot Harry" and his helpful bang bang forte. Top Forty, or better still The Top 100 has never been so confused. With so many great productions coming on the market it's getting more and more difficult to pick which record is great, greater or greatest. Many of the prophets have become exasperated and are now relying on the hit makers of the past. This routine won't last because it's these groups who are most fallible. These are the people who bomb very quickly. A look at the charts of a year or two ago will reveal groups who have come and gone never to be heard of again. To protect their interests and to maintain a consistency in their productions, many US producers have resorted to the use of highly talented sidemen for their sessions, with the picking of the group left to the time when the record is gaining significant action.

We have often been critical of Canadian programmers, the press and indeed the public for their apathy toward Canadian talent, but

somewhat we've overlooked the general attitude of those for whom we have been working so hard. The groups and artists themselves. The average Canadian group of musicians are making about \$150.00 for a three hour period. Some are making twice this amount. In short, they're doing very well. Audience adulation and the build-up of finances leads them into the recording studios where, in many cases, they've come up with a very commercial and competitive session. After a few short weeks of exposure in their own country, they're ready for the big time, and because we aren't fortunate in having a two thousand mile moat between Canada and The United States, some of the groups have begun to lock horns with US immigration in an attempt to break into the most nationalistic ridden market in the world, before even being recognized in their own country. Some have even gone to the extent of being produced in New York and Nashville. The results haven't been exactly overwhelming. A New York producer once remarked, "You can make a hit of a great record and you can make a hit of a bad record, if you pay off enough people, but you just can't make it with a mediocre record." Unfortunately, American produced Canadian sessions fall into that mediocre category. The only Canadian record to make an impression on the US market was "My Girl Sloopy" by Little Caesar and The Consuls. This record was produced wholly in Canada. The reason it made a noise on the American charts was because of its success in Canada where it was a giant. Some Canadian groups have used the American scene to their advantage. In the case of Wes Dakus and The Rebels, it was geographically sound for them to record at the Norman Petty Studios in New Mexico, where they were able to take advantage of the knowledge and equipment of one of the best sound studios on the North American continent. As soon as their session was completed they returned to Canada with their finished masters and made their pitch to the Canadian public. They have been intent on building their image as a Canadian group rather than join an already overrun and over-copied industry.

We can therefore ask the question, did The Beatles leave England? Did Mantovani decide he could do better in North America? The obvious success of these two is proof positive that proficient nationalism does pay off. We hope that Canada won't become the farm team of the foreign music industry. Programmers have often asked, "Are we going to create talent that will become an export? We feel strongly that it has already become obvious that Canada has far more to offer in fame and fortune than ever before. Canadians can live in Canada, tour from Canada, and record in Canada.

Canadian record companies are now beginning to follow the lead of the majors like Capitol and Columbia who are supporting the Canadian music industry to the fullest. One must not forget, however, the efforts of George Taylor, president of Rodeo Records, who has been producing at his own expense, recording sessions, for many years. Mr. Taylor advises that this year has been one of the best, financially, for his company. No doubt, due to the increased interest in Canadian talent by the buying public. Columbia and Capitol are now financing record sessions and scouting for more talent. Both have experienced sufficient returns on the single releases of their artists that they have either released or are about to release albums by these artists. Columbia, in conjunction with IBM, has arranged for a two record album set featuring the Toronto Symphony Orchestra conducted by Seiji Ozawa. One LP will be devoted to the works of Canadian composers and the other to the works of famous international composers. This very expensive session is to be released in celebration of Canada's Centennial year. Other record companies have also made plans to celebrate Canada's birthday, with suitable releases.

Canadian country has never looked so good. Arc's Phil Anderson and George Taylor of Rodeo have come up with many exciting releases that have been given approval by country stations across the nation. Acadia's Fred Roy and Scotty Gibbs of Frontier have laid plans for several smash releases. A newcomer to the field, Bruce Shaver of Bison Records, also looks good for making a lasting impression on the industry. An indication that the country field has great potential is the entry of the majors into this previously restricted area. Capitol with Gary Buck, Columbia with Johnny Burke and RCA Victor's Dick Damron.

All in all it's been a very good year. The future looks even better. Canadians are now ready to invade Canada.....WOULD YOU BELIEVE.....THE WORLD?
