

Heat Wave - Another major musical event at Mosport

Toronto: Members of First Festival Productions, along with various promoters, merchandisers, concessionaires, box offices, media and fans by the tens of thousands, are preparing for Heat Wave, a major musical event scheduled for Mosport Park on August 23. Heat Wave will be a 12-hour musical marathon, and the second such major event to take place at the racetrack 50 miles east of Toronto in just over two years. Following on the precedent of the highly successful Canada Jam in 1978, the promoters are expecting a gathering of over 100,000 people at Heat Wave. And from early indications, the estimate is a conservative one.

Unlike Canada Jam, which featured acts ranging from Kansas to the Doobie Brothers to Canada's own Prism and Triumph, Heat Wave is based on a new music/new wave theme. Acts already confirmed for the bill include Elvis Costello & The Attractions, Third World, Rockpile featuring Nick Lowe and Dave Edmunds, the Pretenders, the B-52's, Talking

Heads, and from Toronto, The Kings. The show starts officially at 9 am, but the promoters note that there will be music onstage as early as eight. There will be several more acts announced in the upcoming week.

Handling production on Heat Wave are First Festival representatives Larry Weinstein and Craig Nolan. Toronto's John Brower, involved on the outside of Canada Jam, is more directly involved in Heat Wave's production. Logistics master Lou Weinstein is production manager, handling sound, stage lighting and transportation.

The production of Heat Wave is a huge event in itself - - at a cost of two million dollars and with tickets at \$20, it will take 100,000 people to break even. Larry Weinstein notes, "If initial response is any indication, I think we'll do at least that. The park is suited to handle many more people than that, so we've put together a vehicle for a potential event that might be much larger than 100,000."

Tremendous energy has also been spent in planning Heat Wave. The producers have had to arrange the site and set up the stage, prepare for everything from concessions to sanitation and security, and arrange ticket sales. Heat Wave will also be taped, filmed and videoed for future uses as a feature film, a soundtrack album and a syndicated television special. By the time of the event, there will be roughly 1,700 people involved.

Sales are moving briskly over a 500 mile radius and as far away as Los Angeles, the event is receiving coverage and ticket requests. With highly experienced people like Weinstock putting the event together, the acts at Heat Wave will be presented in the most professional way possible.

And the staging will be highly professional. The same sound, lighting and stage facilities used at Canada Jam will be present at Heat Wave. They include a three stage movable system in which one group can be tearing down and another setting up while a third performs, enabling a very rapid changeover. The sound system has been added to and improved, and it will feature time-delayed sound towers - - additional speakers at roughly each 200-yard distance from the stage to ensure everyone a chance to hear the music loud and clear. In fact, it is now the largest outdoor sound system in the world.

With almost everything in motion, the only major new news should be the rest of the line-up. Expect a new British group, Dexy's Midnight Runners, to make their North American debut. Their album is near the top of British charts, and they are expected to be one of the major surprises of the show.

Heat Wave could break several acts. Canada Jam broke the Village People and the Commodores in Canada, boosted the Doobies' career and helped Canadian groups Triumph and Prism become established in the U.S.

It should therefore surprise no one if a young act like Dexy's or The Kings becomes very successful internationally within the few months after the event, or if an artist whose career has been lagging should find himself again at the top of the charts.

Mosport Park will not be open until 6 am Saturday morning. There will be on-site camping. There will be no parking on the site itself - - to avoid severe traffic problems - - and the nearest parking lots will be a long walk away. There will, however, be shuttle buses to and from the lots, and tour buses will be the recommended means of arriving at Mosport. In fact, tour buses will be the only vehicles outside of Heat Wave's own to be allowed on the site. Two-wheel vehicles will not be allowed within two miles. Security for Heat Wave will be intense - - the security budget is alone \$115,000.

Heat Wave marks the first major forum for new music anywhere in the world. The producers are convinced the world is ready for the event, and all signs indicate they are right.

New Gallup survey confirms home taping

Toronto: A Gallup Poll survey commissioned by the Canadian Recording Industry Association has further reinforced the industry's concern about the widespread incidence of home taping in Canada.

According to the survey, conducted by The Gallup Poll of Canada, over 54% of respondents who own a tape recorder had illegally taped music in the past 12 months. When the 16-29 age group is considered, the figure swells to over 66%. Over 55% admitted to taping music from borrowed records, with the figure rising to 64% in British Columbia and among those aged 16-29. In addition, 55% said they taped music off the radio, and in Ontario, over 20% admitted to recording music at live concerts.

Of essential importance to the industry are the poll results disclosed by Gallup that 38% of respondents are taping more often than they were a year ago, and that 32% have admitted to buying fewer albums since

they purchased a tape recorder.


Brian Robertson, President of the Canadian Recording Industry Association, noted that the survey results "add another layer of evidence that the illegal practice of home taping is eating away at the very heart of the

legitimate recording industry." Robertson further warned, "Record and tape sales in Canada this year are already down about 20% over last year, and if this rapping of the business continues, the public may not have any product left to tape in three or four years."

de Burgh Canadian tour to support new A&M LP

A&M recording artist Chris de Burgh is scheduled for a major concert tour of eastern and central Canada. The tour, comprising 13 concerts in three weeks, is in support of the Irish singer-songwriter's fifth A&M album, *Eastern Wind*. The tour begins with three dates in St. John's, Nfld. (Aug. 26-28), and includes concert stops in Halifax, Moncton, Quebec City, Ottawa, Toronto, London, Montreal, Hamilton and two dates in Winnipeg, Sept. 15-16. The tour follows de Burgh's current European tour.

Canada is one of de Burgh's most successful markets. His *Crusader* album is gold in this country, and *Spanish Train & Other Stories* is platinum. Now the artist is becoming more involved in Canada. The new LP, *Eastern Wind*, was recorded at Toronto's Manta Sound, using A&M U.S. staff producer David Anderle. That marks two firsts for de Burgh; the first time he has used an American producer, and the first album he has recorded outside of England. De Burgh is also using a group of Toronto-based musicians as his band. They consist of guitarist Tim Wynveen, Ian Kojima on sax, drummer Jeff Phillips, bass

player Al Marnie and Glen Morrow on keyboards. In addition to the band, the album features session appearances from the likes of Supertramp's John Anthony Helliwell on sax and singer Lisa Dal Bello.

Following the eastern and central Canadian tour dates, de Burgh and group are planning a further tour of western Canada in October.

Ontario Arts Council announces major grants

Arthur Gelber, Chairman of the Ontario Arts Council, has announced a total of almost four and a half million dollars in grants to a total of 604 recipient artists and organizations. The grants, which have been given to 175 artists and 429 arts organizations including 28 orchestras, were decided on at one of the Council's four major yearly meetings. They range from \$25 to L'Association Francaise in London and \$40 to the Pro Arte Singers of Kingston to \$400,000 for the Canadian Opera Company and \$312,500 to Toronto Arts Productions.

The awards were decided upon by three juries, one each for Choreography, Creative Artists In School and the Music Commissioning Program.

In making the announcements, Gelber commented, "Total orchestral funding by Council has increased substantially since 1963, when some 15 orchestras received \$108,850. During the last fiscal year, 32 such organizations were awarded close to \$1,500,000." Gelber noted the impact of these orchestras on their communities in terms of concerts, training and youth programs. He added, "Every grant dollar invested in these orchestras produces almost seven dollars in wages, fees and operating expenditures, with the original dollar returned in direct taxation."

Over the course of the 1980-81 fiscal year, an estimated \$12,500,000 in awards will be granted by the Council in a variety of art disciplines.

PolyGram cites support for Philips Compact Disc

Montreal: PolyGram Canada has issued a communique discussing the PolyGram Group's support of a new laser digital audio disc system currently being developed by Philips. The system features a very small disc capable of storing 60 minutes of music on a side, and offering highly enhanced sound quality. It is being developed under the name Compact Disc.

PolyGram has been involved on a worldwide basis in developing the system from the beginning, and has co-operated with Philips in establishing specifications for the system and in developing the disc itself. The company feels Compact Disc offers many advantages over the current analog audio system (standard records). Sound quality would be enhanced in terms of a wider frequency response and much greater dynamic range, better signal to noise ratio and very minimal noise and distortion.

In addition, since the disc is read by a beam of laser light, with no stylus to wear down the surface, it continues to reproduce the sound truly without damage from dust, scratches and stylus wear. Furthermore, the disc is smaller than the current seven-inch single, despite its capacity of 60 minutes per side, and therefore requires less storage space.

Representing the PolyGram Group, PolyGram spokespersons expressed their confidence that the advantages of the Compact Disc System will lead to world standardization of the system, enabling both the hardware (audio equipment) and software (music and records) industries to unite in promoting the Compact Disc. The communique states, "In this connection, PolyGram intends to be among the first in the record industry to join this system and to release its repertoire on Compact Disc."

Rio Records release new Marc Jordan album

Toronto: Rio Records has completed an agreement with the Toronto based management firm B.M.S. Investments and the Canadian Broadcasting Corporation under which Rio will release a new album by singer/songwriter Marc Jordan on the Rio Label.

The album was recorded live at Toronto's El Mocambo, April 11, by the CBC, with remixing at Sounds Interchange. Production was handled

by studio veteran Keith Whiting and Jordan himself. The set contains four songs previously released on Jordan's two Warner Bros. albums, including the singles Survival and I'm A Camera. There are also five new tracks. Among them is a debut Rio single, New York, New York, slated for release August 10. The album is set to be released the following week.

Shaded numbers indicate a strong upward trend and gains in airplay or sales. This chart is offered as a guide to new product and an indication of trends in Canadian markets.

His radio work has taken him to several countries, and when this is combined with his love for the sea and for travel, the result is Harbour Lights, the program that uses so many of his talents. And the success of Courtenay's program concept has prompted Celeste Records to release the first Harbour Lights album, while an illustrated book of stories and poetry is planned for the future.

Harbour Lights has travelled to different locations to bring authentic information to listeners. For example,

Courtenay visited Barbados in order to do first-hand research on the culture, the natural beauty and the music of the island.

Produced at CFQR-FM studios in Montreal, Harbour Lights has a two-hour format. And yet, each hour can stand on its own. Promos, intros and extros are available from the producer, along with the necessary cue sheets for each taped program. It is also important to note that many CRTC Canadian content categories are fulfilled in this pleasant, informative program.

Fall Line-up announced for Mariposa

Toronto: The Mariposa Folk Foundation has announced the line-up for its first Mariposa Fall Festival, to take place September 26-28 at the York Quay, Harbourfront in Toronto.

Mariposa, which had in years past been a large outdoor festival taking place on the Toronto Islands, will now be a smaller, more intimate event celebrating folk traditions in the urban environment - - in short, a 'city' folk festival. There will be music represented from the worlds of blues, reggae, traditional British, contemporary, storytelling and children's song and dance.

The Mariposa Fall Festival will begin with a Friday evening urban blues concert/dance. Performers will include the Downchild Blues Band with such guests as Morgan Davis, Michael Pickett and Rick (The Hock) Walsh, as well as blues master Robert

Junior Lockwood, whose band will include veteran Johnny Shines.

Day-long Saturday and Sunday events will include a wide variety of concerts and workshops in several locations, featuring such artists as Sandra Beech, Los Companeros, Mendelson Joe, Fred Penner, Truths & Rights and Sweet Honey In The Rock. On Saturday night, the festival will host a British style pub plus a concert, with performers to be announced shortly.

The Mariposa Fall Festival is a major part of the year-round program of the Mariposa Folk Foundation, an organization dedicated to the preservation and enhancement of folk idioms in and around Toronto. Tickets for the festival are available at Harbourfront, the Millwheel and the Mariposa office.

Perry & Leighton release on Burco



Stag Creek's Rostad keeps hectic schedule

Ottawa: Wayne Rostad, Stag Creek recording artist, has just completed one of the busiest seasons of his career. The sun months kicked off with his appearance at the July 1st (Canada Day) concert on Parliament Hill before an audience of more than 100,000. Governor General Ed Schreyer was so impressed with Rostad's performance that he visited him backstage where he picked up a copy of Rostad's album, *Writer Of Songs*. Concerts throughout eastern Ontario and Quebec kept Rostad busy well into August along with in-store

promotions for his album with several K-Mart stores. He also shared the bill with Roy Orbison at Ottawa's National Arts Centre.

Wakefield was the setting for Rostad's second annual Gatineau Clog (Aug 9-10), a country jamboree that has become a highlight for country artists during the month of August. Rostad then moves west to Winnipeg for a date at Ma Henning's Downs Motor Hotel and back to Ottawa for an engagement at the Ottawa Ex Bandshell.

Rostad, in spite of his busy schedule, still finds time to perform benefit

concerts which include fund raising for the Ottawa Civic Hospital as well as a benefit show for Muscular Dystrophy which will be held in Ottawa Aug 17. He will also be appearing at the Blues Festival (Aug 16) the only country act to be included on the show. Rostad is apparently well-respected in this field because of his very varied repertoire.

Stag Creek's George Voisine reports excellent sales for Rostad's album, particularly in the Ottawa Valley area. A new single, *Should Have Been Friends*, also culled from the album, is now being prepared for mailing.
