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ATTIC LP BROADENS AARON'S RANGE

Attic recording artist Lee Aaron is on release with *Call Of The Wild*, her 3rd LP. *Call Of The Wild* was produced by Paul Gross and Bob Ezrin, with contributions from Ezrin (keyboards), April Wine alumnus Jerry Mercer (drums), and journeyman bassist Spider Sinnavee. Aaron's current touring band consists of writing partner John Albani (guitar), Chris Brockway (bass), and Barry Connors (drums). Still in her early 20's, the Belleville, Ont.-born singer has appeared at England's Reading Festival and toured Europe extensively.

RPM recently spoke with Lee Aaron; via telephone, from Toronto's Phase One recording studio. How was the recent trip to Australia?

"Amazing," Aaron responds. "We were on a bill with 2 Australian bands - Opus and Wolfgang Ambrose - for a show to be broadcast on TV over there in the fall. It was sold-out, with the setting in the Alps near a resort called Kaprun. The audience had to take a cable-car up the mountain to see us!"

Here in Canada, Aaron recently did a show at Toronto's Diamond, a 70-min. set that she says generated "a positive feeling" for the band.

A professional musician since the age of 15, Aaron has since toured much of Canada, the U.K. and north-central Europe, where she is something of a phenomenon. Her debut LP, *The Lee Aaron Project*, was released in 1982.

Call Of The Wild, the new LP, is presently climbing the RPM 100 album



survey. It qualifies as 4 parts Cancon.

Does Aaron intend to alter her hard-rock style on the next LP to accommodate either North American radio formats or the presumed demands of an American label?

"I'm certainly not planning to change my style drastically" she asserts. "An artist, in trying to please those in the industry, or whoever, can go overboard; then it's not coming from the heart. I think that the so-called backlash against heavy metal will clean out a lot of dirt. It's like with any kind of music - there's good and there's bad. I like to call what I make good music!"

For better or for worse, Aaron has seem-



WEA releasing CDs in all-board package

The new compact disc release of Motley Crue's Theatre Of Pain will not be issued in the familiar jewel box packaging. This follows WEA's release of their first all-board package - Prince's Around The World In A Day. Although WEA's Gary Newman indicates the jewel box packaging won't be dropped completely, it's obvious the new all-board packaging is a priority. Newman does admit there have been some complaints over the new packaging but that orders for Prince and available new titles have been brisk, particularly for Motley Crue.

There have been some problems obtaining stock on some of WEA's CDs, but "Our fill isn't bad", says Newman. "We're running somewhere around 65 to 70 percent fill - but trying to get the last 25 to 30 percent is hell."

Newman also points up that "Right now business is really good - and if I listen to the major retailers - they're all gearing up for a nice Christmas on CDs." However, there is one problem as Newman explains: "Although my fill is fine now, I have a pre-determined quantity that is shipped in here

every single month. I can't get anymore than this quantity - and if CDs start to take off in September, October or November, I'm going to be in trouble - I won't have any stock." Consequently, dealers are beginning to order CD stock now - hoping they can guarantee the stock - or a good portion of it - for the fall shipping period.

CD releases available in the new packaging, besides Prince and Motley Crue are: The Firm (The Firm) and Led Zeppelin (Houses Of The Holy) on Atlantic; Talking Heads (Little Creatures) on Sire; and from Warner Bros, Joe Walsh (The Confessor).

Julie Ryan of A&B Sound in Vancouver reports that consumers aren't at all pleased with the new all-board packaging. "They throw away the cardboard, but they liked the jewel box, and most costumers kept the boxes." In spite of the dislike for the new packaging, there has been a heavy ordering of Motley Crue's new CD. The big CD sellers for the past week (July 29) were Tina Turner (Private Dancer), Cyndi Lauper (She's So Unusual) and Mick Jagger (She's The Boss). A&B is one of the heavy buyers of CD product, going through 1,000 pieces each week. "Just about everybody but Polygram are having problems supplying us with stock," says Ryan "and its been that way from the beginning." The stores overall top 3 CD sellers are Dire Straits (Love Over Gold) Pink Floyd (Dark Side Of The Moon) and Tears For Fears (Songs From The Big Chair).

True North's Cameron tours in support of LP

True North recording artist Doug Cameron has set out on a cross-Canada promo tour in support his first album, Mona With The Children.

The CBS-distributed label held back reporting the signing of Cameron, who is a former member of Cee Dee's a Toronto group, until the release of the title track as a single. This track has also been issued as a 12" single. The Toronto-based, Oakville-born singer/songwriter was signed to the label this spring.

Mona is backed by an equally-moving video directed by Rodney Charters. Pretty Pictures was also involved in the 5-min. video involving a cast of about 250.

The video, shot in early March, was made even before Cameron was signed to the label, and guests such names as Dan Seals, Buffy Ste. Marie, Seals & Crofts, and actor Alex Rocco who has appeared in such motion pictures as The Godfather, The Stuntman, and his latest, Gotcha.

Both the song and video are about the true story of a 16-yr. old girl named Mona Mahmudnizhad who was sentenced to death, along with 9 others, in Iran, for being of the Baha'i faith. Mona was the youngest to die in the incident. The executions took place in 1983.

True North's President Bernie Finkelstein took exception to criticisms made by Toronto Star's Greg Quill regarding the Mona video, recently aired on MuchMusic.

Said Finkelstein: "For the record, I am not anti-Muslim or Anti-Iranian. Am I against the actions of the regime of the Ayatollah Khomeini? Absolutely." Finkelstein went on to point out that "A sixteen year old girl was taken from her home in Iran, imprisoned, tortured, then hanged. Her crime: she would not recant her religion. Her story needed to be told. If the telling of this story is a 'one sided outburst', which it is not, then I wonder what Quill considers the sad circumstances of Mona's death; a collegiate debating class perhaps?"

Finkelstein continues with "As to the story taking advantage of the anti-Iranian sentiment in the West. Nonsense. The fact is the story took place in Iran. As to the consternation in Toronto's music community as Quill says, and I quote him 'no one doubts the story should be told'. As to whether Cockburn or Cameron should be compared to Costa-Gavras or Bunuel, time will tell, not Quill."

Continuing with "I fully stand behind the video and the song Mona With The Children." Finkelstein concludes with "If by consequence that action reaps the scorn of Greg Quill and others. so be it."

Cameron, who is himself Baha'i, explained that "the Baha'i faith is an independent world religion founded in 1844 of which the basic principle is a belief in the oneness of God." He continued with "The Islamics see the Baha'i religion as a threat because it is a new religion."

Three convicted in counterfeiting case

Three Montreal men were convicted in early July of offences under the Criminal Code, with respect to counterfeiting cassette product.

Jean-Pierre Lecours, Jean-Pierre Lesard, and Andre Lessard, all previously of Disques Imperial (Montreal), pleaded guilty to criminal counts of Fraud over \$200 (\$1,000 fine), Trademark Forgery (\$200 fine plus 2 years probation) and Conspiracy To Commit Fraud (\$1,000 fine plus 2 years probation) - all sentences consecutive.

The trio were accused of counterfeiting cassettes during the period of July 1981 to April 1982. The product concerned was that of A&M, Capitol, CBS, PolyGram, and WEA.

Between the U.S. (where a civil case was centered around this product) and Canada, as much as 100,000 pieces of product were seized and ordered destroyed by the courts.

Decline in Cancon is serious - CHUM's Jones

Brad Jones, Music Director of CHUM-AM in Toronto, says that although the quality of the Cancon releases has increased, the decreasing number of Cancon discs has become very serious. Meanwhile, the RPM 100 singles chart of July 20/85 listed 18 Cancon singles, a record breaking number in the 21-yr. history of the magazine.

"There's no doubt that the quality is up and the quantity is down," said Jones. "If you go back a couple of years you can see that it's been on the decline. Because the quality is better you can keep songs on the playlist longer."

Jones believes the quality of the recordings by Canadian artists this year, so far, can stand up to just about anything on the market. He noted however, that due to "the declining output of Cancon recordings, we sometimes have to add weak Cancon songs in order to meet the 30 percent quota." He continued with: "There's enough to get by week-to-week, but in some cases there are a lot of records that don't go on to become hits, that you have to keep on the playlist longer,

New CD player for Canadian market

A new Compact Disc (CD) player that the manufacturer claims has "3 real sonic differences" will be introduced in Canada next month by dbx of Newton, Mass.

The dbx DX3 - the firm's first CD player - will be showcased at the Canadian Hi Fi Show in Toronto Aug. 16-20.

The DX3 contains proprietary circuitry for compression, DAIR, and Ambience control, "benefits anyone can hear", according to dbx's Vice President of Sales and Marketing, Stan Peters.

The unit's suggested retail price in Canada is to be under \$1,000.

sometimes 16 to 17 weeks."

Ironically, CHUM-AM finds itself in the position of competing more heavily with sister station CHUM-FM, which recently adjusted its format towards a more pop-oriented audience from its previous album-rock only format.

"I think the record labels have made some pretty bold steps," said Jones, commenting on the recent Cancon signings. "I think they've been aggressive, but they are also being safe by cutting down on their Canadian rosters."

Truth - a "rock and roll band" - Lister

I.R.S. recording act the Truth are on release currently with Playground, an LP produced by Hein Hoven. RPM recently spoke, via telephone, with guitarist Mick Lister at the I.R.S. offices in Los Angeles.

"We're not an R&B band," he says emphatically, in response to the suggestion that some of the material is strongly reminiscent of later Jam or General Public, Truth labelmates. "I've never heard General Public. We're just a rock and roll band. The stuff about Mods following us was just a big press thing. We were referred to as 'the new Jam', that's all."

The evening of the interview, The Truth were slated to kick off their North American tour dates with a club gig in Los Angeles. A date in Toronto (22) at The Diamond has been firmed at this writing.

"The English press puts every new band in a box," Lister complains. "Europe and North America are certainly more open-minded about new bands."

The balance of the Truth lineup is Dennis Greaves (guitar, vocals); Chris Skornia (Hammond organ, piano); Richard Parfitt (bass); and Alan Fielder (drums). Greaves was a member of Nine Below Zero, a modestly successful R&B/Blues outfit that released 1 LP on A&M. Did Greaves bring much of the NBZ sound to the Truth? "Not really," Lister answers. Lister cites U2 and The Stranglers as personal favourites. "I like guitar bands," he agrees, "yeah... that's it! We're a guitar based rock 'n roll band!"

I.R.S. product is distributed in Canada by MCA Records.

Direct response works for Silver Eagle label

Rick Haines, General Manager of the Unionville, Ont.- based Silver Eagle label, reports that sales in Canada are "closer to 30 percent higher than last year at this time." Haines notes that with the exception of CBS, there are no other labels dealing in LPs and cassettes who rely on direct-response (TV advertising).

Recent successes for Silver Eagle have included a Don Williams compilation, a '50s/'60s set, Rockin' The House Down, and Country Fever.

The label is owned by Ed LaBuick of LaBuick & Associates, parent firm of Silver Eagle here, and in the U.S.

Luke Gibson firmed for Albert Hall

Legendary Canadian singer/songwriter Luke Gibson has been firmed for an Aug. 10 date at Toronto's Albert Hall. Gibson is renowned for his fronting of Luke & The Apostles in the '60s.

Murray McLauchlan recently produced 4 sides for Gibson at Toronto's Kensington Sound. A video of Graffiti Eyes, one of the tracks, has been released and is in light rotation on the MuchMusic video channel. The video was produced and directed by Marv Bernstein.

Gibson's current band includes Margo Davidson (sax/percussion); Mich Pouliot (drums); Jimmy Jones (former Apostle, on bass), and Ron Reed (keyboards).

Quality launch for Comsat Angels' LP

Jive Recording act The Comsat Angels have just released 7 Day Weekend, an LP recorded at London's Battery Studio. Three producers worked on the project - Mike Howlett (OMD, Flock), James Mtume, and Chris Tsangarides (Thin Lizzy, Mama's Boys). I'm Falling has been taken as the first single.

Based in Sheffield, Eng., the band began as Radio Earth, a trio. Following the addition of the 4th member, Radio Earth changed their name to The Comsat Angels, releasing 2 EPs on their own Junta label. Following a U.S. tour behind Fiction, an LP on Polydor, Comsat Angels signed with Jive. Their debut Jive LP, Land, featured the single Will You Stay Tonight and a remixed version of Independence Day from their first LP.

In the fall of 1984 The Comsat Angels returned to the studio to cut 2 singles - You Move Me (One Good Reason) and Day One. A "Canada only" EP featuring both these and live versions of Land's 2 singles was subsequently released by Quality, Canadian distributors of Jive product.

The current lineup is Stephen Fellows (guitar, vocals); Andy Peake (keyboards); Mik Glaisher (drums); Kevin Bacon (bass).

Even at that hour there were eager fans filling up the room, taking their turns in saying goodbye. Three upper state New Yorkers drove in to say goodbye and then drove back home in time for work - now that's loyalty. Sandy isn't going too far - he will be doing specials and will be Director of Community Relations for CHFI. His predecessor, Jay Nelson was also on hand for the close-out. As you probably know, Jay is a veteran of jungle TV (remember Jungle Jay??), rock with CHUM, and "snooze moosic" at CKFM. Jay has mellowed considerably since his hey-day at CHUM. Of course, he's much older . . . somewhere around 39, he'll admit to. Anyway, Good Luck

Sandy - we'll miss "that nice man on the radio".

There's a change for the mornings over at CHUM-AM as well. Roger Ashby vacates this spot for John Majhor, who will co-host the morning drive with Mike Holland.

Toronto metal heads will also be getting a new guru with Jake Edwards taking over Scruff Connors morning show at Q-107. Actually, at that time of the morning, the music format is pretty tame - which is probably why Scruff was so popular. So . . . there's the update on the battle of Toronto radio . . . but remember those sage words of caution from Kim Zayac of CBS: "The battle isn't between AOR and CHR anymore . . . it's between stereo and mono. . . ."

Les enfants terrible are out . . . !!

In a very plush boardroom the conversation got around to the 2 "brats" and we are told that they are "not part of the deal".

Break it in Canada

More and more importance is being placed on Canada and a major company wants their records to "break in Canada" and be as big as Corey Hart and Bryan Adams. That's what they want and they're going to "spend money to make it possible".

Bryan Adams - No. 1 in the USA

A few weeks ago it looked as if Bryan Adams' Reckless LP had peaked in the U.S. - scoring a Top 10 on U.S. trades . . . and falling back to No. 12 the following week. But where there's life . . . there's more promotion . . . and "voila" says Gerry Lacoursiere - Bryan is moving back up the chart. A&M's Joe Summers has been keeping the hotline open to the U.S. and, just as we go to press, Joe got the big news: "Bryan is No. 1 in the U.S." says Joe. Yes, Bryan's Reckless LP finally tops the U.S. trades for the week of Aug. 10. . . . and that's with 3 million sales of the LP . . . a million in the last week or so. Canadian sales for Reckless have been certified this week as 6 times platinum (600,000 units sold). Anne Murray is the only other Canadian recording artist to have reached this magic figure . . . and "that's incredible".

Madonna takes them off . . . and!!!

All that fuss about Madonna in the raw . . . and a look at the photos . . . didn't do a thing for me. I'm glad I sneaked a look at the mags before shelling out all that money. (EC: I heard you were cheap . . . but this is ridiculous!!!). Anyway, Madonna's no slouch when it comes to capitalizing on a good thing. While her Like A Virgin LP quickly passes the half million units sold mark in Canada, WEA are preparing to release a 4th single from the LP . . . what else but Dress You Up. And, along with the release, Madonna, working closely with EMMC, a Los Angeles-based merchandizer, will be releasing a line of clothing to carry her own Boy Toy label. The single, in both 7" and 12" formats, will be released mid-August, and the clothes will debut sometime in September.

What's in an initial , , , ???

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



MUSICIANS AND THE LAW
IN CANADA

The legal profession has suffered a few bruises over the past few years insofar as the recording/entertainment industry is concerned. Like lawyers in any area of legal transactions - their benefits are up front and their losses minimal. The recording industry has provided some of these "professionals" with easy access to a "smash and grab" operation, described by one industry observer as "not unlike taking candy from a baby".

How refreshing to have available this type of information, described as "The first Canadian reference on legal matters in the music business". Paul Sanderson LL.B., a Toronto-based lawyer (performer and songwriter), who concentrates on entertainment and art law, puts into fairly understandable language some of the areas in which musicians should be wary of: copyright, assigning and licensing musical copyright, music publishing, copyright infringement, publishing agreements, recording contracts, live performance contracts and more.

Musicians And The Law In Canada should be regulation reading for the army of musicians/performers who want to survive in a profession that measures its success by its incredible mortality rate.

Sanderson doesn't provide all the answers - contracts aren't formatted - but he does suggest guidelines, without which the musicians/performer is just another "babe in the woods" waiting to be plucked.







Carroll's current single, *It Always Hurts Like The First Time*, is also included on the LP.

Slim Mason to Ebony PR

Slim Mason has been appointed Promotion Manager for the Kingston, Ont.-based Ebony label. One of his first chores will be the promotion of Kevin Simpson's new single, *Let's Not Be Strangers*. This single will be followed by Kevin's duet of *I Wish* with Vanessa Jean Moulton. Vanessa Jean is a new signing to Ebony.

New Haverland to Bookshop

New from Bookshop Records is Kelita Haverland's new single *I'm So In Love With You*, a strong follow-up to *Too Hot To Handle*. The new single is a Haverland original, produced by herself and Glenn Sutton.

Pawley shaping new single

B.W. Pawley's manager John Stewart, reports heavy exposure on Pawley's latest Globe single, *Long Distance Man*. Much of the immediate action was from radio stations in Ontario and the Western provinces, but Stewart is expecting good acceptance of the single from Eastern Canadian programmers who had given strong support to his last single. B.W. and his *Road Show* will be playing Labatt's Country Day at Toronto's CNE on Aug. 18.

Taylor & Perras to tour West

Tails핀 recording artists Tim Taylor and Anita Perras have just completed a busy July that saw them play Kelso Country Festival in Owen Sound with Ronnie Prophet and Glory-Anne Carrier; the first Sudbury Jamboree, with Mel Tillis, and John Conlee; and The Quinte Music Festival Opry North with Valdy, Marie Bottrell and Cliff Edwards. Coming up is a tour of the West which will be launched at the Downs in Winnipeg, followed by the Bar K in Saskatoon and the Rodeo (Kingsway Inn) in Edmonton. The tour will wind down in Edmonton for Country Music Week '85. Anita's new single, *Mutual Acquaintance*, a Tim Taylor original, produced by Mike Francis, will be released early in August. An album, the second from Tim and Anita, titled *This Is Our Night*, is also scheduled for August. The title track of the LP is currently looking good as a single and enters the RPM Country 60 this week.


Young goes country

The single will be released on the A.M.I. label in both Canada and the U.S. The band will be touring Ontario the first 3 weeks of August.

Murray to co-host CMA Awards

Anne Murray will co-host this year's Annual Country Music Awards with Kris Kristofferson. The show will take place in Nashville and will be televised by CBS on Oct. 14. Murray, who was last year's CMA double winner for Album and Single for a Little Good News, co-hosted the show with Willie Nelson 2 years ago. Her current Capitol single, I Don't Think I'm Ready For You, is heading for the top of the RPM Country 60 and is close to topping the A/C chart.

Joan Kennedy releases on MBS

Joan Kennedy, who recently made headline news with British royalty, surfaces with her new MBS single, If I'm Wrong. The single was produced by the Mercy Brothers and was co-written by Charles Browder and Keith Palmer, and qualifies as 2 parts Cancon (AP).

Ray Mercey beginning to roll

Ray Mercey's return to the business, It's All In The Touch, his single release on the MBS label, is beginning to form a pattern of acceptance across the country. Given an added boost to the single was co-writer Rick Giles, who took the time to come up to Canada from Nashville and do interviews with several major country stations.

New releases from 16th Avenue

16th Avenue Records is currently touting 2 new releases - one from Carol Johns, the other from Chris Whiteley & Caitlin Hanford. For Johns, (Walkin' A Fine Line) co-written by Dave Gibson and Larry Boone, is her follow-up to Moonlight Rider. There is no MAPL logo on the label copy. The Whiteley/Hanford single was produced by Bill Garrett and was co-written by the pair. This single, taken from their self-titled LP, does have a MAPL logo showing that the plug side and the flip (Bettin' On Love) qualifies as 4 parts Cancon.

King, Pride, Watson on TNN shows

Blues legend B.B. King appears Aug. 17 on The Nashville Network's Bobby Bare & Friends program, performing 3 songs - That's Why I Sing The Blues, Into The Night, and his 1970 hit The Thrill Is Gone. Prior to this, on Aug. 15, Charley Pride will guest on TNN's New Country, with Gene Watson set for an Aug. 13 appearance. Only 2 years old, TNN is seen in over 23 million cable TV households.

Cassette shipments up - Stats Can

Stats Canada figures for May, provided by CRIA, the Canadian Recording Industry Association, show that net shipments year-to-date were down for both 7" and 12" records, while the same figures for pre-recorded tapes (cassettes) showed a 22 percent increase. The 7" records shipped numbered 5,420,890; 12" records shipped topped 10 million, hitting 10,126,213. Net shipments of cassettes numbered 14,562,855.

Capitol releases new Bam Boo

Capitol Records has released the debut LP by Bam Boo, entitled Stop All Distractions. The LP was produced by Brian Ainsworth at Toronto's Wexford Studios. Come Day O'Night Eh, taken as the first single, is climbing the RPM 100 singles survey. The LP's other tracks are Remember Innocence, Miles On My Mind, Don't Give It A Name, Brand New Rage, The Best Thing, Coming Home Together, Put Me In Your Plans, Hey Hey, and For Real Or Nothing. All tracks were penned by guitarist Alex Stangl. Stop All Distractions qualifies as 4 parts Cancon.

Heavy guest list for Duran Duran

The forthcoming LP from Roger Taylor, Nick Rhodes and Simon LeBon (Duran Duran) will include contributions from ex-Pink Floyd guitarist David Gilmour, Grace Jones, and Sting. The LP is slated for a September release.

Nikki debuts on Spin label

Nikki (Nikki Loney) is on release with her debut single on the Spin label, Who's That Girl In The Picture. The song, penned by Richard Scherer, was produced at Kitchener's Cedartree Studio by J. Richard Hutt and Douglas Biggs. Who's That Girl In The Picture qualifies as 4 parts Cancon.

A native of Elora, Ont., Nikki sang at one time with the Toronto Children's Choir, and toured music festivals and colleges singing in a duo with her father George.

Musicians on the single include Pee Wee Charles (pedal, steel), Jamie Warren (background vocals), and Andrew Affleck (bass).

Nikki is slated to perform July 21 at CHAM's tornado relief benefit. The follow-up to Who's That Girl In The Picture will be Never Too Young, a song penned by Jamie Warren and J. Richard Hutt.

Bluenote presents Silver

Toronto's Club Bluenote is presenting singer Liberty Silver and her 6-pc. band Age Of Reason Aug. 5-10. Lalomie Washburn will sing background vocals with Silver expected to release an LP sometime this fall.

Everlys tour for '85 set

PolyGram has announced The Everly Brothers' 1985 World Tour, set to kick off July 19 in Dallas. The North American leg, to consist at this writing of 37 dates, will take the legendary duo from coast to coast. Canadian cities firmed were Toronto, Ottawa and Vancouver, the latter Aug. 31. The tour shifts to Australia in October and the U.K. in November. The Brothers' lineup will be Albert Lee (guitar), Pete Wingfield (keyboards), Phil Cranham (bass), Phil Donnelly (guitar), and Larrie Londin (drums). A new LP is set to be released midway through the North American dates.

Masterworks signs Marsalis

CBS Masterworks has signed Grammy-winning trumpeter Wynton Marsalis to a long-term multi-record contract. The label has already released 2 LPs by Marsalis - Haydn/Hummel/L. Mozart Trumpet and Baroque Solos And Duets. Marsalis has, for 2 consecutive years, won Grammys in both the Best Classical Performance by an Instrumental Soloist With Orchestra and Best Instrumental Performance by a Soloist categories.
