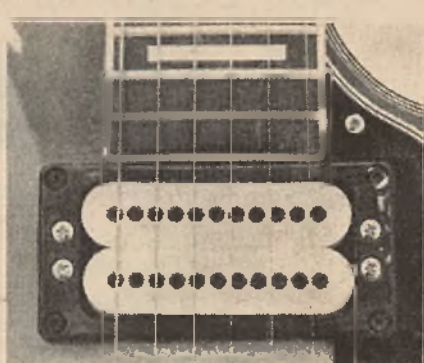

With the release of *One Step Closer*, the 10th album by the Grammy Award-winning Doobie Brothers, comes another milestone in the band's incredible career. The album marks the recording debut of the three newest recruits to the ten year old band - guitarist John McFee, drummer Chet McCracken and keyboard and sax player Cornelius Bumpus, all of whom joined The Doobie Brothers after the release of *Minute By Minute*, the group's biggest selling album to date with over four million copies sold in the United States alone.

The Doobie Brothers recently swept major honors at the Grammy

Awards, walking away with four Grammys, including Record of the Year for "What A Fool Believes," and Best Pop Vocal Performance by a Duo, Group or Chorus for "Minute By Minute." Michael McDonald won an additional two awards for Best Arrangement Accompanying Vocalists and co-writing "What A Fool Believes," the Song of the Year.

Each of the new members contributed songs on *One Step Closer*, making the album a total group effort. "The band is different and consequently this album will reflect that new energy," says Michael McDonald.

Keith Knudsen feels *One Step Closer* is "the best album we've done. This time we cut the basic tracks with everybody. We even did several solo's live, so we didn't have a lot of overdubbing to do."

There was increased pressure because of the success of *Minute By Minute*; but we worked hard and long and the material was well rehearsed. It was so much fun playing that we forgot about the pressure," says Knudsen.

The Doobie Brothers' success has been chronicled through the sales of more than 33 million records during

the past ten years, the group continues to set trends with its concert dates and television appearances. They recently filmed their own special for Home Box Office which aired in late 1979.

People Magazine recently called The Doobie Brothers the "elder-statesmen" of rock music and praised them for having "outlasted and outsold all their competition." As the title of their platinum album *Takin' It To The Streets* suggests, The Doobie Brothers communicate with their audience on a one-to-one level rather than as performer and plebian. It is by baring their musical souls that the public is able to watch the band perform live or on records and ingest a feeling of warmth, personalism and honesty. So after ten years and countless hit records, The Doobie Brothers remain on top with their original message still being heard: "Listen To The Music."

The group began in the highly street-oriented community of San Jose. It was in the winter of 1969 that singer/guitarist Tom Johnston was introduced to percussionist John Hartman by a mutual friend, Skip Spence (former member of Moby Grape and Jefferson Airplane). Johnston and Hartman decided to form a band and, with the addition of bassist Greg Murphy, Pud (a name they were going under then) was formed. The trio performed mostly around the Northern California area and tried branching out into different areas, which disillusioned Murphy. He was soon replaced by Dave Shogren. It was at this time that the trio found a need for additional instrumental and vocal support and secured these elements in the person of Patrick Simmons.

Simmons' musical interests were primarily bluegrass and folk and it was this different input that the Doobies were looking for. At that time, Simmons was working mostly as a solo artist while also running his own showcase emporium, Acoustical Musicians, Inc. Simmons decided to join the band, and soon afterwards the group changed their name to The Doobie Brothers.

The group prepared demo tapes of their material and soon secured a recording contract with Warner Bros. Records. The group's first album *The Doobie Brothers*, was released in the spring of 1971 and received positive critical response. The album also paved the way for a tour of many major rock centers during 1971 and 1972.

In October of 1971 the group returned to the studio to record its second album. The band had lost the services of Dave Shogren and

brought in Tiran Porter. Porter's command of bass and husky vocals proved more than ample replacement for Shogren and it was at this time that the band decided to expand its rhythmic potential by hiring Michael Hossack. The band was now ready for another plunge into the studio, this time with the assistance of producer Ted Templeman.

The result was *Toulouse Street*, released in March 1972. This album attained instant recognition. It included their first hit single "Listen To The Music" which was written by Tom Johnston, followed by the smash "Jesus Is Just Alright."

During the spring of the following year the group released its third album, entitled *The Captain And Me*, which became a phenomenal success. The album contained the Johnston-penned hit singles "China Grove" and "Long Train Runnin'" which both entered the top ten on the national charts. Just prior to a tour promoting the *Captain* album, Michael Hossack was replaced by former Lee Michaels drummer Keith Knudsen. Keith learned the entire Doobie roadshow after a few short days of rehearsal. As a complement to John Hartman, Knudsen was perfect. Knudsen also has a very strong singing voice which is featured in the group's live show.

What Were Once Vices Are Now Habits was released in 1974 and achieved huge record sales like its two predecessors. The album included the group's first Number One single, "Black Water," which was written by Pat Simmons. The single sold well over two million copies.

Jeff Baxter was added to the ranks in December of 1974. His guitarmanship, on both the six-string and pedal steel, added another dimension to the band. He performed on the *Vices* album but did not record at length with the band until the following release, *Stampede*. *Stampede* was the beginning of a transition in the Doobies' career and started to feature more jazz and R&B influences. It contained the Doobies' smash single "Take Me In Your Arms (Rock Me)."

Takin' It To The Streets was released in March of 1976 and featured another new face in the form of pianist/vocalist/songwriter Michael McDonald. Sex symbol McDonald began performing with the group when he replaced an ill Tom Johnston during a summer tour in 1975. Like Baxter, he was a renegade from Steely Dan. McDonald, whose heavy rhythm and blues background surfaces on the *Takin' It To The Streets* LP, became a strong force in reshaping the new direction of the Doobies. Michael's piano phrases and

strong vocals stamp *Streets* with a unique sound and distinction. The album contained two smash hits, "Takin' It To The Streets" and "It Keeps You Runnin'," which were both written by McDonald.

Live! On The Fault Line bulleted to the top ten in July of 1977 and remained there for two months. The album also became a huge hit internationally with the single "Little Darlin'" garnering much attention in Holland and England. The album contained collaborations between Michael McDonald and Carly Simon on "You Belong To Me" (which became a top five single for Carly) and Patrick Simmons, Earl Randle and Willie Mitchell (writer and producer of many Al Green and Ann Peebles hits) on "Echoes Of Love."

Shortly after the release of *Minute By Minute* The Doobie Brothers announced the departure of drummer and founding member John Hartman as well as Jeff Baxter.

In May 1979 The Doobie Brothers added three new members to the group. Joining the band on tenor sax, keyboards, and flute is Cornelius Bumpus, who formerly backed Bobby Freeman ("The Swim") and was a member of Moby Grape from 1977-1979. Adding yet another dimension to the Doobies is percussionist Chet McCracken who brings his jazz background to the group. The Seattle-born McCracken was house drummer at the Baked Potato, performing with Don Randi's band from 1976-1979. John McFee was born in Santa Cruz, California. As a member of the critically acclaimed group Clover, John lived in England from 1976-1978. John is featured on violin, rhythm guitar, pedal steel and harmonica. He also plays dobro, mandolin, and "practically anything with strings."

The group has a unique style of writing songs. Although a song may be credited to a specific person (this is due largely to the fact that he has written the words and brought forth the musical idea), each song is a Brothers affair. "Usually what we start with is an instrumental track with no vocal, just the concept," offers McDonald. "The words will probably go along with what the music feels like. The band writes more from a musician's standpoint than say, someone like Kris Kristofferson, who writes a story idea and then writes the music around that. We usually write our lyrics around our music." In essence, The Doobie Brothers is a fraternal organization.

Despite the changes which have occurred throughout the years, The Doobie Brothers remain a cornerstone in the field of popular music, as evidenced on *One Step Closer*.

Carly Simon

POP STAR OF THE MONTH

Show business often has the unfortunate tendency to reduce stars to two dimensions — simplifying and idealizing until the figure on screen, record or stage bears little resemblance to the real person behind the facade. A beautiful face, distinctive voice or commanding presence becomes the sum total of the artist's public identity, leaving out the very real and human facets that are an equally important part of the total picture.

Carly Simon is an artist who defies any attempt to reduce her to an entertainment formula. Her uncompromising artistry has been evident at every stage of her career, but there is another quality distinctly heard in her music: an honesty and sensitivity to express that experience in music both poignant and revealing. There is the unmistakable sense of a real person behind the songs of Carly Simon, someone we can touch beyond the public persona.

Come Upstairs is Carly's ninth album, her debut for Warner Bros. Records, and while the music is a distinct change of pace for her, that evocative personal sense continues to make itself felt. Of the LP's nine new tunes — penned by Carly and *Come Upstairs* producer Mike Mainieri — she remarks, "The material is less introspective, more directly emotional." A single listening to such tunes as the boldly aggressive title track, "Jesse," with its marvelous lyric twists, the propulsive, anthemic "Take Me

As I Am," or the album's centerpiece, a brooding tale of compromised love titled "In Pain," bears out her contention. "This is up, spirited music," she asserts and the crackling guitars and unembellished instrumental sound of *Come Upstairs* is indeed a stunning setting for the urgent, electric emotion brimming over in this new material. Even the haunting strains of "James" or the wry observation of "Them" are treated to a direct, no-nonsense delivery that makes the most of the message. On *Come Upstairs* Carly Simon has revealed parts of herself through her art that audiences are rarely privy to in a performer's work. It is an album of rare strength and insight.

Born and raised in New York City, Carly is the third of four children in the family of Richard and Andrea Simon (of the Simon and Schuster publishing house). Her early environment was a musical one; her father an accomplished pianist, her mother taking care to nourish her daughter's early interest in singing. Later, as a student at Sarah Lawrence College, she and her sister Lucy performed as a duo, cutting an LP for Kapp Records which yielded a hit single "Winkin', Blinkin' and Nod." In the late '60s, collaborating with Jacob Brackman, she wrote another hit, "That's The Way I've Always Heard It Should Be," which led to her debut album on Elektra Records, released in January of 1971. *Anticipation*, her second LP was

released later that year and in 1972 she was awarded a Grammy as Best New Artist. Since then nearly every one of her LP's has received a Grammy nomination.

No Secrets, her third Elektra offering, marked the beginning of her association with producer Richard Perry. It was an auspicious combination of talents as evidenced by the international success of "You're So Vain," the single from *No Secrets*. In November of '72, Carly wed James Taylor, one of the most famous and productive marriages in music, and the two set up housekeeping in Manhattan and Martha's Vineyard.

Hotcakes, her second Perry-produced LP, was released in the fall of 1973 and yielded yet another smash single "Mockingbird." 1973 also marked the gold certification of *No Secrets* (which has since gone platinum). *Anticipation* and *Hotcakes* as well as "You're So Vain" and "Mockingbird."

Sarah Maria Taylor was born to Carly and James in January of 1974 and subsequently brought a whole new dimension to the singer's life. "In terms of my priorities," she remarks, "my family is first." Nevertheless, she still found time to record her fifth LP, *Playing Possum* released in the spring of '74.

The Best Of Carly Simon came out in November of '75 and was certified gold in three weeks. *Another Passenger*, produced this time by Ted Templeman, followed in June of '76 and in



January of the following year, Benjamin Simon Taylor was born. It was in the summer of that year that "Nobody Does It Better," hit the charts. The tune — an Oscar nominated song that was the theme from the James Bond film *The Spy Who Loved Me* — garnered her a Grammy nomination and renewed her in-studio association with Richard Perry.

Also in 1977, Carly co-wrote "You Belong To Me" with Doobie Brother Mike McDonald, which appeared on the Doobies' *Lookin' On The Fault Line* LP. *Boys In The Tree*, her seventh long player was produced by Arif Mardin and featured her rendition of "You Belong To Me." The artwork for the album received a Grammy nomination. *Boys In The Trees* was followed, in June of 1979, by *Spy*, her last LP for Elektra before moving to Warner Bros. and cutting *Come Upstairs*.

Throughout a career marked by commercial success and artistic integrity, Carly Simon has maintained an equilibrium between her public and private selves that is reflected admirably in her work. She is never out of touch with the very real things of life — family, marriage and children — and it is this sense of well-placed priorities that give her work its universal appeal. "I'm not just one person," she concludes, to which must be added that the many facets of Carly Simon make up one tremendously talented performer.

SOUL STAR OF THE MONTH

The Love, Togetherness and Devotion that LTD proclaimed as their central motivation when they formed and named themselves way back in 1968 have been more than fulfilled by their brilliant career. Years of struggle were followed by years of triumph and the group now stands enviously at the summit of the world they chose to conquer. Since "Love Ballad" from their third A&M lp broke them nationwide, they've endured and grown through a series of monster hit singles and ever more creative albums. Last year's *Devotion* lp completed a trilogy of albums of which *Something To Love* and *Togetherness* were the first installments. With that monumental achievement behind them, their new album, *Shine On*, combines the best of what has gone before with the new ideas that LTD's ever-expanding sophistication generates.

The history of LTD is by now a familiar one. The nucleus of the group formed in North Carolina and not long after, Jeffrey Osborne, then a drummer and now their lead singer, joined them after filling in one night in Providence, Rhode Island. They migrated to California and their first big break came backing Merry Clayton at the Monterey Folk Festival in 1971. Two years later, a recording contract with A&M set the stage for all the great music that was to come.

LTD's partnership with producer/arranger Bobby Martin was an important turning point in their career. His work at Philadelphia International had earned him a reputation as a man with one of the best "feels" in the business. The combination of LTD and Martin proved instantly potent: their first project was the group's *Something To Love* lp with its classic hit single, "Back

In Love Again." Martin has produced every succeeding LTD album and their latest endeavor surpasses all of their previous collaborations.

The new album is marked by a renewed vitality of the creative partnerships within the band. In fact, with the arduous trilogy now part of history, LTD's creative vigor is in fresh, new flower. From the rousing "Love Is What You Need" through to the shimmering poignancy of the lp's first single, "Where Did We Go Wrong," LTD demonstrates they are still in full command of all the powers that have made them such a durable success. Jeffrey Osborne's lead vocals are, as always, a highlight especially on

such ballads like "Shine On," co-written by Richard Kerr, the composer of such contemporary classics as "Mandy" and "I Know I'll Never Love This Way Again." The band's horn section is as sparkling and sassy as ever and its rhythm foundation, drummer Alvin Bennett and bassist Henry Davis, lay down a pulse that can't be denied. *Shine On* is LTD's finest accomplishment and if its power could be measured on the Richter Scale, it would be a ten all the way.

Little did Arthur Lorenzo Carnegie know that when he left his hometown of Haines, Florida, he would someday be a founding member of a multi-platinum musical extravaganza like LTD.



But with hard work and lots of dues that he paid while working in the Sam and Dave Band, that's just what he became. A multi-talented musician (alto and tenor saxes, flute and guitar), Lorenzo, as he's known in the group, has numerous outside interests including tennis and horseback riding. His skill as a visual artist gave LTD its first album cover. This Sagittarian has been married five years and is the father of a little girl.

Jack Riley, Jr.'s life as a professional musician began in his hometown of Miami. As one of LTD's earliest members, he too played with Sam and Dave. His trombone is an integral part of the band's unique sound and when he's not making music of his own he enjoys listening to Stevie Wonder and John Coltrane. Basketball and tennis fill this talented player's leisure time. He

particularly takes pleasure in LTD's live performances and although packing them into the nation's largest arenas is always a thrill, his best remembered moment of glory remains the band's electrifying appearance at the Monterey Festival in 1971. Of it he says, "We really had 'em standing on their heads."

While attending Howard University, Carle Vickers wanted to become a doctor but the dazzle and fulfillment of a musical career drew him instead into LTD. But in deference to his old dream and what Lorenzo describes as Carle's "mind and insight," the band has nicknamed him "Doctor." This Virgo plays trumpet, flugelhorn, saxes, and flute; furthermore, he pursues sports and collects state-of-the-art stereo equipment.

Henry Davis' mother warned him that if he ever devoted himself to the musical career he dreamed of he would surely starve. But then almost every musician's mother must have said that at one time or another. Not every musician is as talented as Davis. His bass playing is a crucial ingredient in LTD's success and he is much in demand for other artists' sessions, having backed such greats as Herbie Hancock, The Sylvers and Smokey Robinson. Born on the Scorpio-Sagittarius cusp, he also plays piano, flute, and sax. Henry is married and has two children.

They say that Abraham Joseph Miller acquired his nickname "Onion" because he makes all the ladies cry. We're sure that's true but the name might also come from the fact that "Onion" is totally bald! Another Sam and Dave veteran, his saxophones are a spirited addition to LTD and he has been with the band since its beginnings in his home state of North Carolina. Onion, a Libra, also loves basketball and chess.

Johnny McGhee is a Chicago-born veteran of Motown whose dynamic rhythm guitar playing

and arranging spark a lot of LTD's fire. An extremely popular man on the Los Angeles session circuit, McGhee, a Capricorn, loves the music of Earl Klugh and relaxing with his family.

"I don't know why I took the gig. They didn't have any money," said Jeffrey Osborne about his becoming a member of LTD. All the gold and platinum records that line his walls must do something to refresh his memory. The son of a trumpet player, Osborne first joined the band as a drummer but that talent was soon dwarfed by his outstanding abilities as a vocalist. A Pisces who looks to Sarah Vaughan, Aretha Franklin, and Stevie Wonder for inspiration, Jeffrey has become one of the truly great soul singers of his time.

Billy Osborne was the musical director of the Friends of Distinction when he caught wind of what his brother Jeffrey was up to with LTD. Soon after, he was in a new band and LTD had a new member. As a vocalist, percussionist, and keyboard player, his maturity and leadership have been important to the group's ongoing progress.

At an early age, Jimmy "J.D." Davis began piano lessons and has never been far from a keyboard since. He was a founding member of LTD and now functions as its musical director. A Libra, J.D. is a strong advocate of free musical expression. His creativity also finds an outlet in photography. He is an avid reader and is married and lives with his family in Los Angeles.

Drummer Alvino Bennett is LTD's newest member having joined the band just after the release of *Togetherness* in 1978. A native of Chicago, Bennett worked with the cream of the Windy City's blues greats before moving to Los Angeles where he first backed Minnie Riperton. When not holding the pocket for LTD's blistering groove, this Gemini enjoys the company of his family.

MICKEY GILLEY

country star of the month

Long before Madison Avenue and Yves Saint Laurent discovered "Texas Chic," and long before the huge honky tonk club that bears his name was immortalized in the feature film, *Urban Cowboy*, Mickey Gilley was already a household name among those who take their music seriously.

Since Gilley first came into national recognition in 1974 with a song called "Room Full Of Roses," he has had eight number one records. In the summer of 1980, he broke chart records again when he had two songs — "Stand By Me" (from the *Urban Cowboy* soundtrack) and "True Love Ways" — simultaneously in the top five.

For years, Gilley has been delighting audiences around the country with his distinctive vocal talents — which enable him to work wonders with every kind of song from a honky tonk celebration like, "Don't The Women All Get Prettier At Closing Time," to a tender love ballad like "Stand By Me" — and his spine-tingling dexterity on the piano (which prompted one reviewer to write that it sounded like he had taken piano lessons in Harlem).

In the past few years, Gilley hits have included, among others, "I Overlooked An Orchid," "City Lights," "Window Up Above," "Bring It On Home To Me," "A Little Getting Used To," and "Songs We Made Love To."

Gilley's numerous appearances on national television have included, "The Midnight Special," "Sha Na Na," a profile on "20/20," "Dinah and Friends," and "The Mike Douglas Show." A network special done in Gilley's and a TV series based on the club are also presently under discussion.

No doubt, Mickey Gilley's music has been etched a little deeper in America's consciousness by way of his singing and speaking parts in *Urban Cowboy* where he, among other things,

emcees a Dolly Parton look-alike contest and sings two songs that are part of the film's soundtrack. But the fact is, years before *Esquire* Magazine, "The Today Show," and the *Urban Cowboy* crew (each of whom discovered the club in that respective order) ever set foot in Houston, Mickey Gilley and Gilley's Club, where he played regularly, were both thriving.

this capital of the urban cowboy culture has a population greater than most state capitals had during the heyday of the Old West.

But Mickey Gilley's Texas roots go back nearly a decade and a half before Gilley's club ever opened its doors. Prior to opening Gilley's with partner Sherwood Cryer, Mickey has spent ten years play-



ing. Gilley, along with his partner, Sherwood Cryer, founded Gilley's in 1970, and eventually expanded it into the 48,000 square foot mega-honky tonk that it is today. "It's just a honky tonk, but it looks as big as the MGM Grand Hotel or St. Patrick Cathedral," wrote Aaron Latham, whose *Esquire* article, "The Ballad Of The Urban Cowboy," was later adapted to the screen as *Urban Cowboy*. "It has about 40 pool tables under one roof. On a busy night,

ing at another Houston club called Nesadel, working the Texas honky tonk circuit, and hoping for bigger things. For a while, he had his own local TV show in Houston (which was shown twice weekly in different time slots) and later got more exposure by way of the television commercials he taped for Gilley's.

During these years, Gilley often spent his own money going into the recording studio, trying to convince someone that he had

potential as a recording artist. In 1959, he had a regional hit called, "Is It Wrong," and then in 1964, he had another called, "Lonely Wine." But neither record had led to anything more than a few more club bookings across the state. Then in 1974, he released a song on his own Asiro label called "Room Full Of Roses." Though it was released as a B-side, Houston DJ's began turning it over and playing it, and it soon sold tens of thousands of copies locally. "At that point the club was real successful and I didn't need a hit record," Gilley admits (*Country Music Magazine*, June, 1980.) "In fact, I didn't want to even record anymore!"

Nonetheless, with the help of a local producer named Eddie Kilroy, Gilley tried to interest a major label in picking up "Room Full Of Roses" for national distribution. But "Room Full Of Roses" and Mickey Gilley, were turned down by practically every Nashville company before Kilroy finally came back to Houston with a contract with the newly-formed country division of Playboy Records.

"Room Full Of Roses" went number one nationally on Playboy, as did more than a half a dozen subsequent Gilley singles.

With the success of "Room Full Of Roses," in 1974, Gilley had achieved what he'd been hoping to do ever since he first wandered into the music business during his teenage years. Gilley grew up in Ferriday, Louisiana with his piano-thumping cousins, Jerry Lee Lewis and the Reverend Jiminy Swaggart. At age 17, he headed for Houston where he landed a job as a "grease monkey." But soon after that, his cousin Jerry Lee Lewis had his first hit called "Crazy Arms." Mickey went to see him at a concert, and it altered his plans considerably.

"We'd played piano together a lot when we were kids growing up in Louisiana, so I was naturally anxious to see his show," Mickey recalls. "But when I took him to the airport afterwards, he pulled out such a big wad of hundred dollar bills that it made me decide right then I was in the wrong business!"

Gilley soon began singing and playing in Houston night clubs. Later, he journeyed to Memphis, Tennessee where he landed a



contract with Dot Records that resulted in a single, "Call Me Shorty." He once drove all the way to Philadelphia where he tried unsuccessfully to talk his way on to Dick Clark's "American Bandstand."

Later, he moved to New Orleans, then on to Biloxi, Mobile, or wherever else he could find work as a singer. Finally, he settled for two years in Lake Charles, Louisiana where he played a

lounge. "Right before I quit working in Lake Charles, I was at my lowest ebb," recalls Mickey. "I was beginning to see how hard it really is to become a star, and I honestly believed it would be best for me to get out of the entertainment industry."

Gilley returned to Houston where he stopped performing for six months and worked construction instead. But eventually, he began playing again. This time, he began to catch on locally. Instead of more disappointment, this time his music led him to his ten-year association with the Nesadel Club, the subsequent opening of Gilley's, and on to the national popularity he enjoys today.
