THE MOODY BLUES

POP STAR OF THE MONTH



The Moody Blues' long-awaited and hotly anticipated debut album for the '80s, *Long Distance Voyager*, shows this veteran band of innovators returning to the concept themes and metaphysical concerns which dominated their previous classics. This lp features the Moody Blues sounding better than ever, updating their music into a sound that's thoroughly modern and instantly accessible.

Long-standing Moodies followers will be happy to know that original members guitarist/vocalist Justin Hayward, bassist/vocalist John Lodge, flute-player Ray Thomas and drummer Graeme Edge are still together, with the addition of long-time collaborator, keyboardist Patrick Moraz.

Long Distance Voyager opens with a stirring Justin Hayward composition, "The Voice," that

plunges the listener right into the Moodies' famous sound, and track after track of superb material follows: John Lodge's mesmerizing "Talking Out Of Turn" leads into the driving "Gemini Dream," the album's first single, which is climbing the charts. This takes us into the heavenly strains of Hayward's "In My World." Side two shows the Moody Blues dealing with their refined place in the scheme of things, highlighted by Graeme Edge's poignant "22,000 Days," Lodge's "Nervous," and a trio of Ray Thomas' reflective rockers, capped by the emotionally moving autobiographical finale, "Veteran Cosmic Rocker."

The Moody Blues have always been innovators in the music world. In the mid-60s, with the assistance of producer Tony Clarke, the band evolved a revo-

lutionary musical direction after the success of "Go Now," their first hit single released during the "British Invasion". They worked with drawing together elements of both rock and classical music by using a newly designed keyboard instrument called the mellotron. The mellotron was able to reproduce pre-recorded sounds of classical string players.

Although many of those around them scoffed at the Moodies' experiments on the mellotron and with large orchestras like the London Symphony, it just happened to coincide with Decca Records' wish to release an album which would demonstrate the excellence of the stereophonic sound equipment the company was in the process of developing. With the label's go-ahead, the Moodies proceeded to create the album which proved to be a major

turning point in their career, *Days Of Future Passed*, and its masterpiece single, "Nights In White Satin."

Days Of Future Passed stood out among the rock albums of the time like a diamond in the rough. With the rise of the psychedelic age, the lp became synonymous with incense candles, black-light posters and acid trips, a haunting voyage that synthesized the dreaminess of classical music onto the urgency of rock 'n' roll. The Justin Hayward-penned "Nights In White Satin" became the anthem of a generation, and when re-released in America six years later, it promptly soared to the top of the charts.

The follow-up lp to *Days Of*



Future Passed, In Search Of The Lost Chord, firmly established the Moody Blues as a potent commercial force in their native United Kingdom. "Voices In The Sky" and "Ride My See-Saw", written respectively by Hayward and Lodge, each cracked the English singles charts, as the Moodies continued their innovative blend of orchestral rock. It wasn't until after the release of *On The Threshold Of A Dream* that the Moodies finally cracked the Top 20 album charts stateside in 1969. By this time, producer Tony Clarke had actually joined forces with the group as their sixth member.

As 1969 drew to a close, the band recorded and released *To Our Children's Children's Children*, an epic of time and space in which the Moody Blues explored the mysteries of evolution. They also solidified their American

standing as this lp hovered on the edge of the Top 20.

By the beginning of the '70s, the Moody Blues were recognized as not only one of the most innovative rock groups in the world, but also as one of the most popular. Album sales ran in the millions and standing-room-only crowds attended their concerts around the globe. Upon the release of *A Question Of Balance* in 1970, the Moodies climbed to #3 in the American album charts, with the Justin Hayward single, "Question," leading the way. This lp confirmed the group's standing as the cosmic philosophers of the rock 'n' roll world.

Their success continued with 1971's *Every Good Boy Deserves Favour*, which lodged in the Top Three slot on the charts on either side of the Atlantic. *Seventh Sojourn* became their first #1 album in the U.S., providing two more hit singles, both written by John Lodge—"Isn't Life Strange" and "I'm Just A Singer." In 1973, after five years of almost constant touring and recording, the Moodies felt they had earned a sabbatical from the grind. A measure of their success as a live act can be judged by the fact that, in 1972 alone, the band's American tours grossed nearly 2 million dollars!

This Is The Moody Blues, a double album consisting of previously released material, came out in late 1974. During this time, various solo albums by members of the group, either alone or in collaboration, such as Hayward and Lodge's *Bluejays* lp, began to appear. This continued until mid-'77, when the band released *Caught Live + 5*. This lp was an intriguing collection of live recordings made at the Royal Albert Hall during 1969, with an additional side of five tracks cut in the studio in the late '60s, but never previously available.

Late in 1977, the Moodies met to discuss their future and decided to begin work on a brand new album, *Octave*, which was released during the summer of 1978. Shortly after the appearance of this lp, renowned keyboardist Patrick Moraz, who had previously played with Yes, joined the Moody Blues' line-up, replacing long-time member Mike Pinder.

Octave was the Moodies eighth

album and their first all-new release since 1972. Their unofficial disbanding in 1974 to pursue solo projects helped the group bring new ideas back to the band when they again joined forces for *Octave*. It took the group eight months to prepare *Octave*. The album consisted of ten new songs, all unique and all distinctly Moody Blues. Each member of the band contributed at least one composition to the album.

Octave producer Tony Clarke said, "Now that each of the Moody Blues has experimented with other musical styles and bands, they have returned to the group with fresh ideas and arrangements. This album will be an incorporation of those new ideas, and the traditional lush music that is the Moody Blues' trademark."

Following the successful release of *Octave*, the band embarked on their most extensive tour date. They played stadiums in 30 cities across the U.S. and Canada. Preceding their six weeks in America, the group also performed in Germany. This tour was the Moodies' first in five years and the crowds went wild.

To support the tour, London Records assembled the largest merchandising campaign in that company's history. Included in the campaign were pre-and post-concert radio spots in each city; 50,000 four-color posters which depicted the eight Moody Blues albums; 50,000 four-color *Octave* posters; 1000 4' x 4' blow-ups of the *Octave* cover; and 10,000 special distributor 'Moody Blues American Tour '78' kits, which included posters and easel-backed jackets. The tour was a huge success and the Moody Blues continued to assert their pre-eminence as the world's premier rock and roll band.

Now, after a wait of almost three years, the Moody Blues are back with *Long Distance Voyager*. On this lp they continue to fuse the lush atmospheres of classical music with the intensity of high energy rock 'n' roll.

Long Distance Voyager celebrates the Moody Blues' return to the recording scene by forming a tribute to their ever-formidable ability to break down rock's conventional barriers as major creative forces on the contemporary popular music scene.



POP STAR OF THE MONTH

FOREIGNER

In rock & roll, as in everything else, the only real constant is change — hit today, gone tomorrow. Having sold close to sixteen million records worldwide — and monopolized the Top Five for months at a time with the albums, *Foreigner*, *Double Vision* and *Head Games*, as well as singles like "Hot Blooded" and "Cold As Ice" — *Foreigner* is not about to go away tomorrow.

After a major personnel shift and almost ten months of intensive rehearsal and recording, *Foreigner* is now out to prove that, as a rock & roll band, they have only begun to grow. According to *Foreigner* guitarist, songwriter and founder Mick Jones, their long-awaited new Atlantic album, 4, marks the beginning of a new era for the band, now a quartet following the departures last fall of charter members Ian McDonald and Al Greenwood.

"Things became a little too comfortable, and people became a little bit jaded and blasé' about things," says Mick with pointed honesty. "I feel that what was coming off our records was becoming a bit predictable. This new album came out of a desire to get back the fire, the excitement that made the band in the first place. We are in a position where I feel that we have to move forward. If we came out with another "Double Vision" or "Feels Like The First Time," we'd just be repeating ourselves. The important thing for me is to keep going ahead, to get better, to do new things."

This new lp, co-produced by Robert John "Mutt" Lange (AC/DC, *Boomtown Rats*, *City Boy*) and Mick Jones, was recorded at New York's Electric Lady studios. *Foreigner*'s "heavy melody" sound, a combination of hard rock moxie and sharp commercial savvy, rings through loud

and clear on the rockers "Night Life" and "Juke Box Hero." Yet the band has also staked out new ground with songs like "Luanne," with its strains of vintage Buddy Holly, and "Urgent," a propulsive piece of heavy metal funk featuring a stunning solo by Motown sax great Junior Walker. (Other guest musicians include guitarist Hugh McCracken, English synthesizer whiz Tom Dolby, saxophonist Mark Rivera, synthesist Larry Fast, and keyboardists Michael Fonfara and Bob Mayo). As for the evocative ballad "Waiting For A Girl Like You," Mick admits, "It may be a little risky for us to do a ballad, but it is sincere. And the thing I want to get across with this album is the feeling and conviction behind it."

To capture that feeling and conviction on vinyl, *Foreigner* invested a lot of time and energy, working in the studio a good sixteen hours a day, often six days a week, for almost eight months, according to Lou Gramm (lead vocals). "We paid a lot of attention to arrangements," notes drummer Dennis Elliott. "We'd often take a break from a session, settle down to a game of darts or football, and ask ourselves, 'Is this really necessary on this track? Does that really work?'"

"The premise for me," continues Mick, "has always been to make albums you can listen to from one end to the other, not just listen to the hit singles. When somebody pays what it costs for an album or a tape these days, I want to be convinced that we have done the absolute best we can."

As producer, Mutt Lange was content to demand nothing less than the best from the band. He took an active role in helping *Foreigner* shape their new material, creating an artistic tension

in the studio that has resulted in some of the band's hottest and most honest performances to date. "He took our songs and stripped them down," Mick confesses, "but I realized that he was really into the band, and he wanted to make a super record. He was very right at that stage to criticize us, to be straight with me about things, and how they could be better."

Bass Guitarist Rick Wills was also impressed by Lange's unique dedication to the project: "The album was a challenge for him. Here he had a band capable of selling millions of records, but he wanted to do more with it."

The band was also struck by the frankness of Tom Dolby, a new wave young buck who has played with Bruce Wooley & the Camera Club and recorded two experimental singles of his own. Says Lou, "Tom had no preconceived ideas of what *Foreigner* should be or sound like. He heard what he heard, played the way he wanted to, and it turned us on." Dolby went on to play on seven of the album's ten tracks.

"This is the kind of thing bands go through when they're slogging around in clubs before anyone's heard of them," says Mick of the changes in both personnel and musical direction reflected on 4. "Because of our success, we've had to do it in public." Which is not to say anyone in *Foreigner* has not done time on the rock & roll grind.

Born and raised in England, Mick Jones is a hardened veteran of rock wars in Britain, Europe and America. Only four months after he left school, where he was training for a career as a surveyor, he had already hit the road with his first pro combo, Nero and the Gladiators (by Mick's count, he was their 24th guitarist). In Europe, he wrote songs

and did sessions for French pop idol Johnny Halliday, a kind of Gallic Elvis Presley, before returning to London for brief studio sprints with Peter Frampton and George Harrison.

Next up for Mick was a short stint with Gary Wright, later of Spooky Tooth, in a band called Wonderwheel. The band moved to the U.S. and broke up for good after about a year. A short time later Island's Chris Blackwell contacted Mick and Gary to reform Spooky Tooth along with Mike Harrison — thus marking

Mick's "real first shot back on the English and American scene." The new group lasted for a couple of years, a time which Mick looks back on with largely good memories, although there were, as he puts it, "weird personality things" going on as well. The seeds for Foreigner were sown in early '76, when Mick finally decided to go his own way. Recording demos of his original songs, the project began taking shape as a permanent band with the early recruitment of Ian McDonald and Al Greenwood.

A native of Rochester, New York, Lou Gramm co-founded and sang with an Anglophilic hard rock band called Black Sheep, for which he originally doubled as singer and drummer. His rousing display of vocal bravado on the group's two mid-'70s albums convinced Mick that Lou had the pipes he wanted for his new band. Lou proved him right at the studio audition, where he got his first crack at songs like "Feels Like The First Time." The tape of Lou's audition eventually became the demo that helped Foreigner make their Atlantic connection.

Englishman Dennis Elliott, described by Mick as "the basic pulse of the band," played drums with a variety of name artists — including jazz-rock fusionists If, singer Linda Lewis and Roy Young, and Ian Hunter's Overnight Angels — before accepting Mick's offer to join Foreigner.

The band's third Briton, bass guitarist Rick Wills, joined the band in mid-1979, shortly before the *Head Games* sessions — and following stints with Peter Frampton, old mate David Gilmour of Pink Floyd, Roxy Music, and the reunited Small Faces. "The main thing with Foreigner has been its songs," says Wills. "We never do anything just for the sake of a riff or a special effect. I've seen stuff that took a week to get on keyboards that was thrown away in an hour."

That diligence has since paid off in spades. Released in March 1977, *Foreigner* set off a chain reaction in rock's global village, siring three hit singles and going on to sell five million copies. Their second album, *Double Vision*, shipped platinum in June of 1978 and has so far sold an astonishing seven million copies. The multi-platinum *Head Games* followed in September 1979.

"I don't think we're losing the basic core, the flavor that started the band off," Mick insists. "But I want the music to be exciting, interesting, stimulating. When it becomes boring, I'll do something else."



Upbeat pop/soul melodies and dazzling vocal arrangements are the highlights of the Pointer Sisters new lp, *Black And White*, on Planet Records.

Produced by Richard Perry (producer of three previous Pointer lps) at his Studio 55 in Los Angeles, Perry has managed to showcase the three voices in a sophisticated, yet honest and vibrant form.

The Pointer Sisters — Ruth, Anita and June feel that they've focused their style and vocal sound more sharply than on any previous album. *Black And White* features songwriting contributions from Anita and June — "What A Surprise" (written with Trevor Lawrence) and "We're Gonna Make It" (with David Foster and Mike Cotten). Throughout this album, the Sisters are backed up by top musicians including Planet labelmate Greg Phillinganes, John Robinson, Nate Watts, Tim May, Paul Jackson, John Barnes and Paulinho da Costa.

"To me," says Ruth, "Black And White means simplicity — the songs are as simple as black and white. But if you listen to the lyrics of each song, you'll hear a lot of needed messages, mostly about love. Black and white also means balance — there's a good balance musically as well as lyrically."

The new album was easier to record than past Pointer efforts — it took just five weeks' time in the studio. The sessions had to take place between dates on the group's hectic '80-'81 road schedule. "Black And White is one of the fastest albums we've ever recorded," June notes. "That's partly because we had a definite, positive direction we wanted to get across on this album — more consistency of sound, so when people hear us, they've got to know without question that it's us."

Adds Anita: "It's partly because we've all grown to the point that we feel much more comfortable in the studio. And our working relationship with Richard continues

to blossom. We know each other a lot better."

It wasn't always that easy for the talented trio. When they were children, their father, Reverend Elton Pointer didn't allow them to see movies or listen to music other than gospel and soundtracks to television shows, because as Ruth notes, "It was to protect us from the bad lives people in the blues and jazz worlds led." Singing was the one thing that came so naturally to the sisters that at first they didn't recognize it as a special talent. Along with their two older brothers, they'd grown up singing in the choir of the West Oakland (California) Church of God, where their mother, Sarah Elizabeth Pointer and father were both ministers.

"In the beginning," June remembers, "we had no one in particular to imitate. We'd never heard of the Andrews Sisters or 'nostalgia.' So we just started scatting stuff." The rhythm and blues they were later exposed to was only one of the musical styles they were influenced by: there was also country music ("We're a very country family," Ruth notes) and post-psychadelic Bay Area rock.

Despite their father's wariness, it was to San Francisco that Anita, June and Ruth first went to break into the music business back in 1969. That initial attempt, made without management, bookings or label backing, was unsuccessful, but not too much later, the Sisters were managed briefly by rock impresario Bill Graham.

During that period, they sang behind rock 'n' roll artists such as Elvin Bishop and Dave Mason at the Fillmore West. Performances like those led to a singles recording deal with Atlantic Records, which demanded the Sisters sing straight r&b. Two singles were released under the agreement, and both, as the Sisters quip, "were heard only in our living room."

Early in 1973, the Pointers

hooked up with San Francisco producer David Robinson, who helped arrange a new recording deal with ABC/Blue Thumb Records. When they played the Troubadour in Los Angeles that May (after raiding area thrift shops for performing clothes, the genesis of their "nostalgia" look), Jeff Wald caught their show and booked them on Helen Reddy's summer television show. "After that," says Anita, "everything happened so fast it was just a blur."

The Sisters subsequently made their first appearances on the Merv Griffin, Flip Wilson, Mike Douglas and Carol Burnett programs, and toured America, including dates at Caesar's Palace, the first appearance by black females on Nashville's Grand Ole Opry stage and the first gigs by a contemporary act at the prestigious San Francisco Opera House. They also went abroad to France, Holland, Germany and Japan. And in 1974, PBS produced a documentary devoted to the whole Pointer family.

In between all this, the Pointer Sisters' first two ABC/Blue Thumb albums, *The Pointer Sisters* and *That's A Plenty*, achieved gold status. They recorded four more albums for the label — *Live At The Opera House* (in San Francisco), *Steppin'*, *The Best Of The Pointer Sisters* and *Having A Party* — and made a strong impact on the charts with hit singles such as "Yes, We Can-Can," "Fairy Tale," written by Anita and sister Bonnie, earned the Sisters a Grammy award in '75 and '76's "Live Before You Die" was nominated for another. That same year, "How Long (Betcha Got A Chick On The Side)" from *Steppin'* was also a major hit.

But the Sisters began to feel confined by such nostalgic material as "Salt Peanuts" and "That's A Plenty." "We didn't feel we were growing as singers," June maintains. "We didn't really know what our voices could do."

So the Pointers left ABC/Blue

Thumb after '77's *Having A Party* and for a time went on to do their "own separate things." Ruth to have a baby, Anita and June to record solo demos. "But it wasn't as much fun being in the studio alone," Anita says, "because we all feed off of each other's energy so much."

With all of their talents once again combined, the Sisters released *Energy* in 1978. Produced by Richard Perry, the album was a stylistic departure from previous Pointer projects, and featured outstanding vocal readings of tunes by some of their favorite contemporary writers, including Becker & Fagen (aka Steely Dan), Bruce Springsteen, Stephen Stills, Loggins & Messina and Sly Stone.

The Pointers debuted their new live sound during January '79 in London with a one-hour show-

case performance at Ronnie Scott's Cafe that was so enthusiastically received the Sisters were immediately asked to sing on "Top Of The Pops" on the BBC. They followed that success with a triumphant performance at the MIDEM festival in Cannes, winning standing ovations from the primarily industry-oriented audience, and went on to make appearances on German, French and Dutch television programs that were equally well-received. The *Energy* lp and its first single, the Springsteen-penned "Fire," became huge international hits.

Energy and "Fire" also found favor among rock 'n' roll fans back home, so much that both won gold certification within weeks of each other. The Pointers further exposed their more contemporary direction with a series of dates all over America during

the spring and summer of '79, taking time out only to record their second Planet lp, *Priority*, on which the Sisters tackled songs by old and new wave writers such as Graham Parker, Bob Seger and Ian Hunter. After a tour in the spring of '80, they released *Special Things*. The album's first hit single, "He's So Shy," was released in August as the Pointers began a major hotel/supper club/concert tour that stretched into the first months of 1981.

By January, "He's So Shy" had been certified the Pointers' second gold single after achieving #3 pop/Top 10 r&b status and doing very well on the adult contemporary and soul charts as well. "Slow Hand," the first single released from *Black And White* is already climbing the charts and it looks as if the Pointer Sisters have come up with another winner.

The long and illustrious career of Conway Twitty has spanned more than two decades, and in that time he has won virtually every award country music has to offer, not to mention the numerous pop awards he has collected along the way.

But that doesn't mean he's ready to slow down with his hit-making songs. Twitty's latest album, *Mr. T.* on MCA Records debuted at #31 on Billboard's Hot 100 Country LPs and with such a strong first showing, should prove to break the top ten shortly. The first single released from this LP, "Tight Fittin' Jeans," is also doing very well on the singles charts.

Conway Twitty began his career in music as a million-selling pop artist during the late '50s and early '60s. He left the lucrative world of rock 'n' roll to pursue his real love — country music. The merging of Conway and country was an immense success. It's netted him more number one records than any other recording artist ever, over forty top national awards and sell-out crowds wherever he performs.

In his career, Twitty has managed to attain the best of all possible worlds: he's a recording artist par excellence, hit songwriter, award winner, SRO performer, and business entrepreneur. Besides all that he has still managed to keep a little time to himself for his favorite leisure activity, sports, and is a devoted husband and father.


Music was a natural career for Conway as he was growing up in Friars Point, Mississippi. He was the son of a Mississippi River boat captain and his real name was Harold Lloyd Jenkins. He learned to sing and play the guitar when he was five years old. And he's been singing ever since.

At age 10, Harold formed his own band, the Phillips County Ramblers. Extremely professional in their music, they had their own radio show on station KFFA in Helena, Arkansas. As he grew into his teens, Harold was undecided about what he wanted out of life. He considered becoming a minister, but decided against that. After graduating from high school, he was offered a baseball contract with the Philadelphia Phillies.

During a stint in the Army, he formed a band called the Cimarrons.

rons and played the club circuit throughout Japan. When he came home, a new kind of music had intrigued Harold — rock 'n' roll. He changed his name to Conway Twitty (taken from Conway, Arkansas, and Twitty, Texas) and set off on a rock career.

In 1958, Twitty wrote and recorded his first million-seller, "It's Only Make Believe." With a gold record to his credit, Twitty signed a recording contract with MGM Records and began his climb to the top of the pop music ladder.

During the next eight years, Twitty wrote and recorded several more hits, including three million sellers. But he became restless with the changing world of rock 'n' roll, and decided he wanted to go back to the music he really loved — country.

Conway later said, "I always wanted to do country music from the time I got out of the service, but I didn't for two reasons. First of all I didn't think I could compete with the Roy Acuffs, Red Foleys and all my country music heroes. Secondly, it was a matter

of age. I was only 23 then and in my opinion that wasn't old enough to sing country music. You have to experience all the many moods of life before you can sing those emotions from the heart."

The return to country music was inevitable for Twitty. Country music is the language of the heart and soul, and it is the music through which Conway portrays his innermost thoughts, dreams and aspirations. Friends introduced Twitty to Owen Bradley, who at the time was in charge of the Nashville operation for MCA Records, Inc., and Owen immediately agreed with Conway — country music was it.

Twitty's first country session was recorded in 1965. His success and fame as a country artist



high above the earth's atmosphere on a joint U.S./Russian mission.

It was during this time that Twitty teamed up with another MCA artist to do a recording session and more country history was made. Loretta Lynn and Conway Twitty have become one of the most successful recording duos of all time. Together this sensational duo has earned more than 35 country awards and has won the hearts of music lovers everywhere. Loretta has said of Twitty, "We work together good. To me, he's one of the greatest."

Unlike many country artists today who try to cross over into the pop music field, Twitty has remained loyal to country. One reason that Twitty doesn't need to cross over to the pop world is that he's already been there, back in 1958 with his first hit. "They tell me," said Twitty, "man, you've been on the other side of the fence. Why don't you jump in there? Why don't you go after some of those awards and things? Well, you know, I get an award every time I play a show... My main thing is good country music. There's been a consistency to my records, and the reason is that I pick the right songs. If I ever reach the point where I think it's the singer instead of the song, then I'll be in trouble."

The multi-talented Twitty has written more than 200 songs,

many of which he has recorded himself. He has one of the most distinctive voices in country music: a rich baritone and a total believability when it comes to letting the meaning of the lyrics come across.

Along with recording and writing, Twitty has other business interests. He owns several music publishing companies, including Neverbreak Music and Twitty Bird Music (co-owned by Tree International). He also jointly owns United Talent (with Loretta Lynn), the agency which is responsible for booking them and many others. Twitty is also the majority stockholder of the Nashville Sounds, a AA baseball team which plays in the Southern League.

Despite the seemingly endless touring, recording at Bradley's Barn in Mt. Juliet, Tennessee, and overseeing his other business interests, Conway is first and foremost a family man. "I don't have the same lifestyle that some recording artists have," he explains. "I enjoy the down home type of living — reading, fishing, doing things with my kids — not going to big parties." The father of four children, Twitty has been married to the same woman since before he entered the music business.

Conway Twitty has achieved everyone's dream of success, including his own. He has said, "I'm just a guy trying to make it in this



world and am very fortunate to be doing something I love to do and making a living at it. I have never lost sight of that." This is a simple philosophy, but one that has guided him to superstardom status and produced a legion of loyal fans not only in country music, but also in the music world in general.
