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
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# POP STAR OF THE MONTH

# Simon and Garfunkel

The overwhelming reception that these two talented performers received in Central Park that night has carried over onto this nostalgic album. Further proof that old friends are not always forgotten lies in the fact that the duo debuted at #21 on the album charts!

Paul Simon and Art Garfunkel met each other for the first time when they attended grade school together. Their friendship survived childhood mainly because they had so many things in common, including a love of music. In 1957, while still in high school, they billed themselves as Tom and Jerry and cut their first top forty hit, "Hey! Schoolgirl."

Another thing they shared was their seriousness about the music they loved. They were in the habit of spending their time after school in long, serious rehearsals. For the past eleven years they have gone their separate ways and played their separate songs.

Everything has changed so much since they've been gone. Everything that is, except for the Simon and Garfunkel magic.

It was alive in 1970 and it all came back again on a cool fall night in September, 1981, when Paul Simon, Art Garfunkel and half a million friends gathered to hear their music again.

The results of this historical concert are twofold: Warner Bros. Records has released an album titled *Simon And Garfunkel — The Concert In Central Park*, and the duo are currently making plans to work on a brand new album together.

Listening to the Central Park album is like flipping through your Simon and Garfunkel collection. It is a 19-song, two-record set that re-captures all the magic of this mellow duo. It contains not only sterling renditions of the Simon and Garfunkel classics, but also several of Simon's solo efforts.

listening to each other's pronunciations and working at matching and balancing their voices.

But since this was only an after-school hobby, they both graduated from high school and went on to college. Simon went to Queens College in New York, where he majored in English literature, while Garfunkel attended Columbia University, where he majored in mathematics.

While at Queens College, Simon met a woman named Carole Klein (King) and the two recorded several demos together. He also spent some time in a number of semi-pro vocal groups including The Passions and The Mystics. By this time Simon had left law school and started to bum around Europe, playing in small clubs whenever he could.

After his return to the U.S., he teamed back up with Garfunkel and they recorded their debut album, *Wednesday Morning 3*.

A.M., with producer Tom Wilson. The year the album was released was 1964 and it didn't make that much of an impact on the American record-buying public.

Simon returned to Europe, taking Garfunkel with him and they played the coffee house circuit for awhile. The next step in their career that proved to be the big breakthrough was put into action by producer Wilson. He released the single "Sounds Of Silence," adding guitar, drums and other rock and roll paraphernalia. The song became an overnight hit and reached the number one spot on the charts.

The duo then returned to the U.S. as major stars and went on a string of concert appearances. 1966 was a banner year for Simon and Garfunkel hits. From their *Sounds Of Silence* lp came their second hit, "I Am A Rock." The lp was produced by Bob Johnston, as was the follow-up, *Parsley, Sage, Rosemary And Thyme*. This lp came through with the top five hit, "Homeward Bound," written while Paul was stranded in Widnes, Lancashire, plus "Dangling Conversation."

In 1967, singles from the *Parsley, Sage, Rosemary And Thyme*

album were still turning into hits. Included in this second wave was "A Hazy Shade Of Winter," "At The Zoo" and "Fakin' It." During this time Simon and Garfunkel were touring the United Kingdom, picking up more and more new fans.

The soundtrack of the smash film *The Graduate*, was released and the song "Mrs. Robinson," became Simon and Garfunkel's second number one single. The two were now a worldwide phenomenon. Shortly after this, they released their *Bookends* lp, and it was an immediate success. Singles on this lp included the above-mentioned "Mrs. Robinson," and "Scarborough Fair."

1970 became the turning point for Simon and Garfunkel. They released their sixth album, *Bridge Over Troubled Water* and the title track became their biggest worldwide hit to date. Other singles from the lp were "Cecilia" and "El Condor Pasa." After this, Simon and Garfunkel did what fans all around the world hope won't ever happen to their favorite group — they split up.

It was an amicable parting of ways. Considering the fact that they were childhood friends who

had been singing together since around 1957, it was only natural that each would one day want to go solo.

Among Simon's solo hits were "Me And Julio Down By The Schoolyard," "Kodachrome," "Love Me Like A Rock," "Fifty Ways To Leave Your Lover," "Slip Slidin' Away" and "Late In The Evening."

Garfunkel's solo hits included "All I Know," "Second Avenue," "I Only Have Eyes For You," "My Little Town," "Wonderful World" and "A Heart In New York."

During the years following 1970, Simon and Garfunkel performed together occasionally in unscheduled appearances. In 1976, they held a reunion of sorts when they both appeared on the *Saturday Night Live* TV show, and sang "My Little Town."

Now, hopefully, they're back together — if not for good, then at least for several albums. *Simon And Garfunkel — The Concert In Central Park* is definitely a step in the right direction. The concert was also filmed by Home Box Office for cable television, and along with the album, should delight old fans and spawn many new ones for this talented duo.

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# THE GO-GO'S

## POP STAR OF THE MONTH



There is no question that The Go-Go's are the current musical success story. Aside from the fact that they are the first all-female rock band to achieve mass success, they also scored a number one smash album on their first time out. They are currently one of the hottest groups around because they are so talented and so unique.

The album that marked the turning point for The Go-Go's is titled *Beauty And The Beat*, and, according to Billboard magazine, it is only the 25th debut album in the post-Presley era to achieve the ultimate on the Billboard chart.

So, who are The Go-Go's? They are: Kathy Valentine, Belinda Carlisle, Gina Schock, Jane Wiedlin and Charlotte Caffey.

They are also five very gutsy, determined musicians who banded together in their search

for the elusive "Ultimate Good Time." They're so many different things all rolled up into one it's hard to describe. The group they put together is one of the bounciest, poppiest, most danceable outfits around. On top of all this, no one will argue that they are also five of the most energetic young women ever to lay down a melody.

The Go-Go's were formed in 1978 in the very heart of the Los Angeles music explosion. The original band members all lived in a rundown hotel in Hollywood. The fact that none of them knew the first thing about music didn't make a bit of difference. However, following a memorable debut performance at the renowned basement club, The Masque, they decided they'd have to learn or else.

"Our friends were the ones that


gave us our support at that time," admits lead singer Carlisle. "because I doubt that anyone who didn't know us would have liked us then. They kept us alive, kept us working, and got us to believe in ourselves."

The band really started to click with the addition of Caffey as guitarist/writer. She is responsible for penning the group's current smash, "We Got The Beat." Although she had formal classical piano training, she had never played guitar — which obviously made her a bona fide candidate for The Go-Go's lead guitarist. Her strengths as a musician and composer account for a great deal of the band's transformation into a smooth, tight, pop music unit.

In February 1979, drummer Schock arrived on the West Coast with Edie and the Eggs (Edie being the infamous "egg lady" from John Waters' underground cult classic, *Pink Flamingos*.) Evidently, Gina preferred being a Go-Go to being an Egg, because in May she joined as The Go-Go's permanent percussionist.

Throughout the remainder of that year, the band played on, molding their talents and developing a faithful following through a series of West Coast gigs. On more than one occasion they played with Madness. In doing so, they made such an impression that 1980 found the band bounding overseas to the United Kingdom where they toured extensively across England, Scotland, Wales and Ireland with Madness and The Specials.

While in London, The Go-Go's rushed into a single deal with Stiff U.K. which yielded "We Got The Beat." Buoyed by the new rock disco phenomenon, the song became that summer's dance club smash. It stayed in the Top 100 disco charts for nearly six months. This was definitely a sign of things to come for the talented ladies.



As a result, The Go-Go's returned to the U.S. on a new wave of excitement and anticipation which simply grew and grew until they began to make a habit of selling out every show they played. When they started breaking house records with their special style, people started to take notice and to take them seriously.

The finishing touch to the group came when bassist Valentine joined the girls on stage. Formerly of The Textones, she added a compelling rhythm which melded beautifully with Gina's punchy backbeat.

Not only does this group perform their own tunes, (Casse and Wiedlin write most of it), they also

arrange most of their own stuff. They know what they're doing, and right now, they're doing it very well.

Despite all their current success, it took these talented ladies three years before they were able to latch onto a label deal, but it was worth the wait. Their breakthrough hit was "Our Lips Are Sealed." The record companies that turned them down are probably not too pleased with themselves at this point.

Immediately after signing with IRS Records in April 1981, The Go-Go's began recording *Beauty And The Beat* with producers Richard Gottehrer and Rob Freeman. The album showcases a band that has made extraordi-

nary musical progress since its formation in May of 1978. The lp's bright, clever and catchy songs — "Our Lips Are Sealed," "How Much More," "This Town," "Skidmarks On My Heart," "Can't Stop The World" and of course "We Got The Beat" — create a sound familiar yet original, classic yet modern, that is uniquely their own.

The Go-Go's have managed to master a fine blend of delightful exuberance and blistering rock. Their songs are ripe with real-life love and larger-than-life fantasy. Behind the delicate quintet's wall of sound dwells a heart of fire and gold. With their debut lp, *Beauty And The Beat*, they take it all the way to the top.

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

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# Diana Ross

## SOUL STAR OF THE MONTH



One of the most exciting headlines to emerge from the entertainment world in 1981 was this one: ROSS LEAVES MOTOWN! After 20 years with Motown Records, Diana Ross left for the greener pastures at RCA for a reported \$20 million plus contract! That's not too bad for a kid from Detroit who grew up in a housing project.

It is no secret that Diana Ross is considered by many to be the

quintessential performer and entertainer in the country today. It is also no secret that, unlike many of her contemporaries, the lady has no intention of letting any grass grow under her feet now that she is with a new record company.

Ross' first album for RCA, titled *Why Do Fools Fall In Love*, was released in November, and showed another side of the multi-faceted lady. Along with co-writ-

ing one of the tunes on the lp, Ross also produced the entire album. The first single released was the title cut, which was originally a Frankie Lymon tune.

Although Ross was criticized for releasing a remake as her first single, the tune was a showcase for her impressive vocalizations and quickly became a top 10 hit on the charts.

The second single released was the pounding "Mirror, Mirror," which also soared into the top 10. More hit singles are sure to follow from this excellent lp. Included on it are a fine mixture of uptempo material such as "Sweet Nothings," "It's Never Too Late" and the sensuous "Sweet Surrender."

Even before its release as the 2nd hit single, "Work That Body" had become the exercise song of the country. Also showing strong single potential is "Two Can Make It." Ross' solo treatment of the smash "Endless Love," is a haunting rendition that is marvelous. "Endless Love," which Ross sang with Commodore Lionel Richie spent nine weeks in the number one slot on the Billboard chart.

stranger on the Billboard charts. She holds the record for the most top-slated hits on the pop charts in Billboard's 41-year history. Needless to say, the competition has been tough. Tied for second in that category are Barbra Streisand and Olivia Newton-John.

Ross' six top-of-the-chart tunes were "Ain't No Mountain High Enough," "Touch Me In The Morning," "Theme From 'Mahogany,'" "Love Hangover," "Upside Down" and "Endless Love." These hits include only the ones Ross had after leaving the Supremes!

Without a doubt, Diana Ross is one of the most important all-around entertainers to ever appear on the scene. Her story is part of musical history and has already been written into all the books. She began her career in 1962 as the lead vocalist for a trio called The Primettes. They were

later re-named The Supremes.

Over a period of ten years, The Supremes, under the direction of Motown's Berry Gordy, had 15 records in the #1 spot and enjoyed the undisputed ranking as the leading female group in the world. Songs such as "Where Did Our Love Go," "Stop! In The Name Of Love," "Back In My Arms Again" and "I Hear A Symphony" helped to put them on top and keep them there.

By 1969, Ross was ready to explore new horizons. She left the Supremes and released her first solo album, *Reach Out And Touch (Somebody's Hand)*, which rose instantly to the top of the chart. This was immediately followed by the #1 solo hit, "Ain't No Mountain High Enough." With these breakthroughs tucked under her belt, Diana Ross was assured of solo success.

Always prepared to take on new challenges, Ross set her sights on a brand new one — starring in the first of her own TV specials, "Diana." This special served to establish the lady as the total performer.

Hollywood began to take notice of this extraordinary one-woman talent as she continued with headline appearances in Europe, Las Vegas, New York, major concert arenas and in recording studios. In 1972, her film debut was launched.

The film was "Lady Sings The Blues" and earned Ross her first Academy Award nomination as Best Actress. Her strikingly real portrayal of blues singer Billie Holiday served to prove even more that the lady could do no wrong.

In 1976, the "Theme From Mahogany (Do You Know Where You're Going To)," rose to #1 on the charts and was nominated for an Oscar. Ross established a precedent at the Academy Awards that year when she appeared live on the Oscar telecast and sang the nominated song.

Later that year, Billboard, the top musical journal, named Diana Ross "Female Entertainer of the Century!"

As a solo artist with more than fifteen albums to her name, Ross' recording future has no limits. She has consistently proven her ability to convincingly handle every idiom from jazz to country, all the while maintaining a contemporary flavor and style. Most of her hits are crossovers. Their

appeal spans the pop, soul and adult contemporary charts like no other performer on the scene today.

As a performer, Diana Ross constantly strives to give her audience more than they expect — and she usually does just that. During a concert, she will stand in the midst of thousands of people, singing "Reach Out And Touch" while total strangers stand with hands clasped high over their heads. The warmth and chemistry that flows between her and her audience is indescribable.

Having just turned 38 (March 26), it would be logical to assume that Ross would begin slowing down a little and taking things easy. But that's just not the way she does things. She is at the

height of both her career and her physical beauty. The latter is evidenced by the glamorously sexy pose that she struck for the cover of her *Why Do Fools Fall In Love* lp.

For the past 20 years Diana Ross has done everything there is to do in the entertainment field. She has done it all with a style, class, grace and charm that probably won't be seen again for a long time to come.

She has garnered respect from her peers, love from her fans and personal satisfaction from her accomplishments. There shouldn't be anymore mountains left to climb. But then again, we're talking about Diana Ross, and that means that the next 20 years should be interesting, to say the least.

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# COUNTRY STAR OF THE MONTH

# T.G. Sheppard

There can be little question that T.G. Sheppard ranks high among the hottest talents in country music today. A consistent chart-topper, SRO concert attraction, highly visible television personality and consummate song stylist, T.G.'s formidable track record places him in a rarefied category all his own.

With *Finally!*, his sixth release for Warner Bros. Records, the singer has taken another giant leap forward toward country superstardom. *Finally!* was produced by Buddy Killen and highlights "Only One You," the latest in a burgeoning list of distinctive number one singles for the versatile entertainer.

*Finally!* is turning out to be the finest album of Sheppard's career to date. It has already notched itself a slot on the top ten country chart after only six weeks from its release date.

T.G. Sheppard has done just about everything on his way to becoming one of the best in country music — guitarist in a travelling band, promotion man, production company owner, recording artist and top drawing live attraction.

His musical roots lie in Jackson, Tennessee, where his mother, a piano teacher, reserved Sunday afternoons for musical get-togethers. By the time he was in his midteens, he had outgrown the local music scene and moved to Memphis, where he joined the Travis Wammack Band as a singer and guitarist.


Sheppard spent considerable time on the road and in the studio before taking a job as a promotion man with Holline Distributors. Although he was singing and writing songs from the very beginning, he found the record promotion business provided a more stable livelihood. In this line of work he subsequently ended up as RCA Record's

Southern regional promotion rep. He was later to form his own independent production and promotion company, Umbrella Promotions, where he mastered the fine points of music marketing and merchandising.

It was around this time that T.G. came across the work of a young songwriter named Bobby David. David had written a tune called "Devil In A Bottle" that appealed to Sheppard's musical instincts.

Unfortunately, no one heard the hit potential he did, and after being turned down by eight record companies, T.G. decided to cut the tune himself. The result was a number one country song. This was to be just the first of many for the artist-turned-businessman-turned-artist.

While still holding down his promotion career, Sheppard began working dates on weekends. When he scored a second hit with "Tryin' To Beat The Morning



"Home" he began to think seriously of switching professions and returning permanently to his first love. His debut album yielded two more chart-toppers, "Another Woman," and "Motels And Memories." From that point on there was no question as to which direction T.G. Sheppard was heading.

By 1976 he was forced to give up Umbrella Promotions to concentrate on a thriving career that included numerous television appearances. Two albums, *Motels And Memories* and *Solitary Man* produced two more hits, including "Show Me A Man." Shortly after this, Sheppard signed a recording contract with Warner Bros. Records.

His debut release for the label was simply titled *T.G.* and contained the country charter "Mr. D.J." *T.G.*'s follow-up lp, *Daylight*, included "When Can We Do This Again." *Daylight* also happens to be the name of *T.G.*'s excellent road band. By 1979, with the release of his third Warner Bros. effort, *3/4 Lonely*, *T.G.*'s hit-making track record was one of the most impressive in country music.

The release of *Smooth Sailin'* in the fall of 1980 continued Sheppard's hit-making trend. This lp garnered no less than four hit singles — "I Feel Like Lovin' You Again," "Do You Want To Go To Heaven," "I'll Be Coming Back For More," and the classic "Last Cheater's Waltz."

*I Love 'Em All*, which hit the streets in the spring of 1981, repeated the trick with the smash "I Love 'Em Everyone." This single was not only a number one country hit, but a top 40 pop and Adult Contemporary contender as well. "Party Time," *T.G.*'s follow-up single, also found its place at the top of the country charts.


Additionally, his television appearances have made him something of a music and talk show staple. He made three appearances on the "John Davidson Show," in addition to a dozen or so other network and syndicated TV appearances that included both the Academy of Country Music and the Music City News award shows, "Mike Douglas," "Dinah Shore," "Nashville On The Road," "Pop Goes The Country," "Toni Tennille," "Solid Gold,"

"Midnight Special," "Merv Griffin" and "Country Countdown '81."

Beyond the statistics, however, is the real *T.G.* Sheppard story. He has worked a number of concert packages with Conway Twitty and has done equally well with his own headline dates, which have included some of America's top nightclubs. His show is meticulously planned and produced

toward arrogance as a defense mechanism. But not *T.G.* Sheppard, whose success has simply strengthened the basics of life he learned on the family farm in West Tennessee.

*T.G.* has currently been keeping himself busy. He recently co-hosted a two-hour syndicated special, "Country Jamboree," which will be aired sometime this year, and also guested on a recent



with plenty of room for spontaneity. Sheppard quickly establishes a rapport with the audience at hand. The tone of the show has as much to do with what he finds on their side of the footlights as with what they find on his side.

If one word best depicts what happens at the juncture point of these two sides, it's fun — a sheer celebration of being alive. Seeing that power work night after night could have a distressing effect upon less secure people prone

Bob Hope special. Add to this a nearly constant touring schedule including a number of recent opening spots for the Oak Ridge Boys and you have a man whose talent and popularity are together reaching new heights.

There is no question that *T.G.* Sheppard is among the most energetic, creative and likable entertainers in country music today. His flair for success has not only taken him to the top but should keep him there for a long time to come.
