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

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

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# POP STAR OF THE MONTH

## Rick Springfield

**Success Hasn't Spoiled Me Yet** is Rick Springfield's latest album for RCA Records and despite the title of the lp, it is a statement that rings true. Even though Springfield has enjoyed a year of success that many people would envy, he remains the same quiet, down-to-earth person who's been working for this success for more than a decade.

1981 was the major turning point in Springfield's career. In that eventful year, he released his RCA debut album, *Working Class Dog*. This lp included a series of singles that catapulted him onto the national charts.

Take a look at a few of the stats — the album itself was RIAA certified platinum; the first single, "Jessie's Girl," held the #1 position on the charts for several weeks; "Jessie's Girl" also won Springfield a Grammy as the Best Rock Vocal Performance, Male, of 1981, in addition to an American Music Award for Top Song of the Year. The American Music Awards also selected Springfield as Favorite Male Vocalist and he also placed prominently in all of the music trade papers' year-end charts. This included awards from Cash Box as #1 male vocalist and #1 single. Two subsequent singles, "I've Done Everything For You" and "Love Is Alright Tonite," followed "Jessie's Girl" onto the airwaves and best-sellers charts.

As if all of that wasn't enough, Springfield's concept for the *Working Class Dog* lp sleeve, featuring his bull terrier, Ron, itself won a Grammy nomination for best package!

During all of that time, Rick had already become a household name as a regular performer in ABC television's daytime series, "General Hospital," which is one of the highest-rated shows in any time slot. In the soap, he plays Dr.

Noah Drake, a decidedly non-singing character.

The Rick Springfield story began on August 23, 1949, in Sydney, Australia. Rick was born the son of a career soldier — a Lieutenant Colonel with an M.B.E. Rick's childhood was spent on army bases in both Australia and England.

By the time he was a teenager, his family once again settled in Australia, and on his thirteenth birthday, Rick got his first guitar. He started to practice constantly, playing with friends and along with records. His favorites at that time were the Beatles and other bands of the early "British Invasion."

His first job as a musician was playing weekend dances. His first steady working band came about when he joined four friends to form a band called The Jordy Boys, which were named after Jordanville, a rough-life suburb of Melbourne. The group played American-derived blues in a style inspired by The Rolling Stones. "We were as hardcore as you could get," Rick smiles, "...at sixteen years old."

Rick soon found himself playing regularly and going to high school at the same time. His homework suffered because he was constantly practicing the guitar. Because of this a slight rift soon developed between parents and son. After an ongoing two and a half year battle, an opportunity presented itself that forced Rick to finally choose between continuing school or joining a full-time rock band. After an open discussion with his parents, he joined Rock House, a rock 'n' roll show band in the style of Sha Na Na.

"The band was asked to go to Vietnam to entertain and we jumped at the chance for adventure," Rick recalls. "We traveled all



over the war zones and saw a lot of action. We'd be playing for the troops and hear distant 'brummp, brummp' and someone would holler, 'That's incoming, gentlemen,' and we'd dive under tables and into trenches as the mortar rounds started exploding all around us."

Safely back in Australia, Rick joined another band, Zoot. It was with this group that Rick first started to record his own material. Zoot quickly became the top band in Australia. During the band's heyday, Rick was winning awards for being the top guitarist and songwriter in the country.

Springfield's first recognition in the United States came when a friend took his number one Australian hit recording, "Speak To The Sky" to Capitol Records in Hollywood. They were so impressed with Springfield that he signed a contract with them and recorded *Beginnings*, his first lp, which contained a remake of "Speak To The Sky," in London. The single was released in the States in 1972 and reached the top 15.

"At this point, I was not in control of my career," remembers Rick. Capitol Records mounted a publicity splurge that featured Rick in every teen magazine in the country alongside dozens of other teen idols who, although handsome, generally lacked Rick's credibility.

Older listeners who would have admired his abilities as a musician were put off by the kind of publicity generated by his well-meaning, but off-the-mark advisors. Rick might have found the right audience, and the right key to success then, if he had been allowed to tour, but problems in securing an Immigration Service Green Card made that impossible. So instead, he traveled in Canada, France, Germany and elsewhere just to get the temporary visas that would allow him to stay in the United States.

Meanwhile, his management moved his recording contract to Columbia, who thought they were signing the teen idol portrayed in the media. Rick's album for Columbia was entitled *Comic Book Heroes* and was an expression of his growth as a musician, and was consequently more progressive than his first. Unfortunately, it was not the "bubblegum hit" Columbia was looking for, and once again the publicity machinery designed to promote and sell it was inappropriately geared.

Due to frustration and a desire to succeed, Springfield left Columbia and his management even though it was a wrenching experience that resulted in a legal tangle that left him without income and unable to record for anyone for three years.

"For the first time in my life I was out on my own," Rick said. "with no means of support. It was the lowest point in my life, and all the time I was receiving letters from kids saying they'd like to come to Hollywood and see my big house."

For the next three years, Springfield continued to write, arrange and record his music at home in total obscurity. At the same time, he pursued another love — acting. He studied with coaches Vincent Chase, Malcolm McDowell and Jack Garfein. When the period of imposed abstinence passed, Rick was quickly signed by Chelsea Records. "I made what I thought was a really

good album and it was getting a lot of airplay. Just as I started touring, the record company folded. I couldn't believe it."

So Rick decided to put on a play with a friend of his in order to maintain productivity. They rented a tiny theater on Fairfax Avenue in West Hollywood, created sets, and designed lighting and costumes. Friends, relatives and anyone else they could think of, were invited to the performances. "A man from Universal saw the play and signed me to a contract. I did guest appearances on 'The Six Million Dollar Man,' 'Wonder Woman,' 'California Fever,' 'Turnabout' and 'The Rockford Files.'" He also played a karate-trained policeman on "The Incredible Hulk," appeared in the TV pilot of "Battlestar Galactica" and wrote a song for an episode of "The Eddie Capra Mysteries" in which he also appeared as an actor.

As his career as an actor bloomed, Springfield insured his musical development by continuing to write and record in his four-track home studio. The tapes found their way to RCA and he signed with the label in early 1980.

Now Rick finds his work very much in demand. He maintains a rigorous schedule that includes taping segments of "General Hospital," rehearsing and touring with his band, and a demanding schedule of public appearances.

*Success Hasn't Spoiled Me Yet*, which reunites Rick with *Working Class Dog* producer Keith Olsen, was a hit upon release, with nearly half a million copies shipped. The first single, "Don't Talk To Strangers," is already a top ten hit and still climbing.

Springfield's plans for the future include a continuation of his work on "General Hospital," with a schedule that will allow him time to perform his brand of solid, timeless music to audiences across the country, and this spring, in Europe. In addition, he's scheduled to begin production in the starring role of a major motion picture, from Rastar/Columbia, for Christmas 1983 release.

From there, it will be anybody's guess as to what field of the entertainment business Rick will choose to tackle, and in all probability, conquer.

# CONCERT REVIEWS

## Rick Springfield

Hartford, Ct. — Rick Springfield came to Hartford recently and put on a fast-paced show that left the predominantly teen-age crowd screaming for more.

It was hard to tell if the fans were there to see Springfield the singer or Springfield the actor. While Rick wows them by night as a full-fledged singer/songwriter/musician, he also dazzles them by day as Dr. Noah Drake on the top-rated daytime soap "General Hospital."

Springfield opened his 90-minute set with "Kristina," a tune from his latest album, *Success Hasn't Spoiled Me Yet*, and he continued in rapid succession with half a dozen up-tempo songs including "Night Watch," "Black Is Black," "Everybody's Girl," "Hole In My Heart" and "Inside Silvia."



An amusing break from these little-girl love songs came when Springfield sang a song about an incident that is supposedly true in which he was confused with the rock star Bruce Springsteen. The audience went wild as Rick dejectedly repeated "she called me Bruce" over and over again.

The quietest moment of the entire concert came during a song titled "April 24, 1981," which Springfield wrote following the death of his father on that date. He sang this tune alone on stage without his band, and carried it off quite well, despite the fact that his audience became impatient with all the silence.

Springfield then called his band back on stage and launched into "Carry Me Away," "Don't Talk To Strangers," "Red Hot & Blue Love" and "Jessie's Girl." "Don't Talk To Strangers" is Springfield's first hit single from his *Success Hasn't Spoiled Me Yet* lp, and it received an enthusiastic applause along with a fair share of screaming.

During the course of the concert, Springfield repeatedly kicked or threw paper cups full of water into the crowd, much to the delight of the younger fans.

Amid screams of "Rick" and "We Want Rick," Springfield left the stage, and then returned for two encores. He started off in the middle of "Jessie's Girl" and followed this with another one of his hits, "I've Done Everything For You."

Springfield closed his show with "Love Is Alright Tonite," but he did not leave the audience in silence. They continued screaming until the lights were turned on and it was obvious that Springfield would not be coming out again.

Rick Springfield is a talented, versatile musician and entertainer who knows what his audience wants. He always seems to give them the best that he has, whether he's performing on the concert stage or the television screen.

One day, many years from now, music historians will note that in 1982 an adventurous band called Asia evolved from the point where the great bands of the 1970s left off. The four members of Asia were all key ingredients in the progressive rock movement that shaped the music of the previous twelve years.

Unlike many past attempts at the "supergroup" concept, Asia is working both conceptually and musically, with each group member having evolved from a major English "stadium-filler" band. The whole of this combination is clearly greater than the sum of its fabled parts.

Asia guitarist Steve Howe is no stranger to the world of rock. For eleven years Howe played lead guitar for Yes. During that period of time he won his share of

worked with Atomic Rooster, an obscure but historically and artistically important band in the late '60s.

Keyboardist Geoff Downes is a relative newcomer to the upper echelons of rock music. However, in a short period of time he has generated quite a bit of excitement in music circles. This is due mainly to the fact that he has mastered the Fairlight Synthesizer, advanced digital keyboard device capable of recreating virtually any conceivable sound.

In 1978, Downes became part of The Buggles, the duo whose hit

able to maintain the fragile balance between science and emotion. The science side is the high level of musical and technical sophistication with which they approach their art, while the emotional element of the Asia equation is the streetwise sensibility of the songs and, of course, the passion with which they are delivered.

Asia came together after Yes, Emerson, Lake and Palmer, and U.K. had reached the end of their ropes. Musical energy and inventiveness was not the problem for Howe, Downes, Wetton and Palmer — it was just a need for a new magic that the context of these previous groups was no longer able to deliver. Beginning in early 1981, these four talented musicians began months of rehearsal together.

During this time with Yes, Howe helped break Led Zeppelin's record of the most sell-out performances at New York's Madison Square Garden, as well as earning numerous gold and platinum records from around the world. Many of his performances with Yes on such songs as "Roundabout" and "I've Seen All Good People" are perennial favorites on American radio.

Drummer Carl Palmer was one of the founding members of Emerson, Lake and Palmer, where his high-powered, technically precise drumming created one of the most recognizable and influential drum sounds in the history of rock music. Prior to Emerson, Lake and Palmer, Carl

song, "Video Killed The Radio Star," sold more than six million copies worldwide. The Buggles' album caught the ears of the members of Yes, who recruited Downes to replace Rick Wakeman in the group's final year of existence.

Vocalist/bassist John Wetton is a longtime veteran of English rock and has recorded and performed live with King Crimson, Uriah Heep, Roxy Music and most recently, U.K. As a bass player and vocalist, Wetton was very much involved in the early stages of Asia's development. The current group is an outgrowth of a series of jam sessions John played with Steve Howe.

As a band, Asia is committed to taking the progressive rock movement a step further, firm in the belief that a progressive music renaissance is nearing. Because of the band members' vast collective experience, they are

Asia's first record went into production in late summer of 1981 in London at the Marcus Studios and at Virgin Townhouse studios. Asia spent five months working with producer Mike Stone. He is best known for his work with Queen, Journey and Foreigner. They completed nine tracks which constitute their debut on Geffen Records.

For their tour dates, Mike Tait, best known for designing the spectacular rotating, circular stage used by Yes, has developed a series of innovative lighting and staging effects. Thanks to the wealth of experience in terms of performing and recording abilities coupled with the truly mature attitude of each player in Asia, self-indulgences, such as unnecessary soloing, and petty differences are not to be found in this unit.

Wetton comments, "What used to take us eight minutes to put

across, we can now do in four without sacrificing any of the wide-screen drama." These guys definitely come across as artists who are still bursting with creative ideas and it comes through on their self-titled album.

The nine songs on *Asia* display a tremendous discipline, considering the virtuosity of Howe, Downes, Palmer and Wetton. There is a great deal of depth and variety in the repertoire, ranging from the distinct pop feel of "Heat Of The Moment," to the textured and haunting "Sole Survivor." Although the trademarks of each musician are evident, the overall effect is distinctly *Asia*.

*Asia* is a song band, rather than a band of soloists. Within the confines of each song are the

nuances that will make this lp a joy both for the late night headphone listener and accessible to the car radio button-pusher on a Sunday afternoon.

Despite the many laurels Howe, Palmer, Downes and Wetton have to rest on, it's unlikely they'll opt for stagnation. Steve Howe is currently involved in working with new generation synthesizers and active electronic guitars. Geoff Downes is creating synthesizer sounds that were unimaginable as recently as three years ago, while balancing this new technology with more traditional keyboard approaches.

Carl Palmer has evolved his playing style into one of the most dramatic percussion approaches in years, ranging from the short

but explosively powerful drum solo on "Wildest Dreams" to the unusual rhythms he weaves into the most basic songs. John Wetton's bass playing is the perfect binder for the group, with his vocals soaring and blending perfectly with *Asia*'s instrumental prowess.

Also on tap from *Asia* is a video, produced by 10cc's Kevin Godley and Lol Creme, which represents yet another aspect of the tremendous creativity that characterizes *Asia* and its components.

Howe, Palmer, Downes and Wetton, who have contributed so much to '70s' music, have evolved on their own artistic terms to meet the challenges of the '80s as *Asia*, and make music once again that will be worth remembering.



# Third World

Third World has been an important part of reggae's long journey from Jamaica to the rest of the world. Their previous hits such as "96 Degrees In The Shade" and "Now That We've Found Love" introduced many music lovers to a form of music which was relatively unknown for a long time. Now, with their second Columbia release, *You've Got The Power*, Third World is once again bringing their universal sound to the forefront of popular music.

The first single released from the LP is titled "Try JAH Love," which was written and produced by Stevie Wonder for the group. It is currently a top 40 hit on the soul charts with the promise of rising even higher.

This album is so important to Third World because it finally marks the beginning of a much-anticipated collaboration with Wonder. Their paths first crossed in 1969 during a concert in Jamaica. They appeared with Stevie at many dates together during the next twelve years, including the Reggae Sunsplash in Kingston in July, 1981.

It was there that Third World joined Wonder on stage for his tribute to the late Bob Marley, "Master Blaster (Jammin')," and Marley's "Redemption Song." It was also there that talk of recording together began. But they did not meet again until the Black Music Association's Family Fair at the Rose Bowl in August, 1981.

The event began at noon and most of the audience remained through the other nine acts to see Third World bring the day to a rousing close around midnight. Wonder visited the band in their dressing room before their set, and the idea of a joint venture was explored once again.

Fortunately, it materialized.

Wonder wrote and produced two tracks on *You've Got The Power*, the one mentioned above and "They're Playing Us Too Close." Together, Wonder and Third World have created two memorable additions to the growing catalogue of musical standards.

Third World was founded in Kingston, Jamaica, in 1973 by keyboardist Michael "Ibo" Cooper and guitarist Stephen "Cat" Coore. Along with William "Rugs" Clarke (lead vocals), Irvin "Carrot" Jarrett (percussions), Richie Daley (bass), and Willie "Root" Stewart (drums), they combine traditional reggae with rock and R&B flavorings. The result is a distinct sound that assumes different forms with great ease, yet manages to never forget its origins.

In the same way that the group as a whole has not forgotten its origins, neither has the individuals in the group. "Rugs" Clarke is the dynamic and inspiring lead singer of Third World. When he replaced Milton Hamilton in 1976, his powerful, sweet voice helped provide the unmistakable Third World sound.

Although Third World is one of the best known and most accomplished reggae bands in the world, Clarke regards their music as experimental. "...in a sense we would like to project reggae music on a different level," he claims. "What we are doing is reconstructing it and moving ahead."

"Rugs" Clarke studied a full gamut of entertainment while living in New York City and was on the verge of a blossoming solo career when he joined Third World. His skills on electric, acoustic guitar and percussion make him one of the six ingredients that make up the tight, distinct rhythms in Third

World's music.

Michael Cooper, also known as "Ibo," is the acknowledged musical leader of Third World. Along with Stephen "Cat" Coore, he started the group in 1973. He was also the major force in establishing the group's basic musical direction and developing an imaginative and improvisational approach to the traditional stage presentation of Jamaican music. "Ibo" has led the production of three albums by Third World — *Story's Been Told*, *Arise In Harmony* and *Rock The World*.

Previous to his involvement with Third World, "Ibo" played in bands with "Cat" Coore (The Alley Cats) and with William Stewart (The Dramatic Visions). He completed studies in classical piano at the Royal School of Music in 1969 and today enjoys an outstanding reputation as one of the best keyboard players in Jamaica. When performing with Third World, "Ibo" plays organ, clarinet, synthesizer, piano, percussion, and with his timbre vocals, gives Third World's sound an added dimension.

Stephen "Cat" Coore plays lead guitar, cello, bass, mouth harp, drums, percussion and sings lead and backup vocals. He studied at the Foster Davis School of Music and was also trained by his mother, the late Rita Coore, who was one of the most respected music instructors in the West Indies.

Although trained in classical music, "Cat" switched to the hypnotic sound of the "Ska" beat in the early 1960s. Along with "Ibo," he laid the foundation for Third World. "Cat" has worked on several notable recording sessions, among them: Bob Marley & the Wailers, Delroy Wilson, Joe Higgs and Erice Donaldson.

Richie "Bassie" Daley is a self-

taught musician who plays bass guitar, guitar, percussion and contributes to the back up vocals of Third World. After seeing such acts as James Brown and the Impressions in the late '60s, "Bassie" got the incentive to perform on stage. Though some tried to discourage him, "Bassie" got his start with the Astronauts who, among other things, backed the Slickers on their reggae classic "Johnny Too Bad."

Irvin "Carrot" Jarrett was the drummer for the Jamaican National Dance Theatre and played with Inner Circle before joining Third World. He has also worked as a radio producer with

the University of West Indies, and in TV production with an adult literary program in Jamaica.

"Carrot" plays all percussion instruments to include the original sounds of the African Talk Drum, Repeaters, the Cethé, and the congas. To "Carrot", the drums are the heaviest and wildest instrument of man. "It is for each man to find his inner drum (to find his rhythm) and harmonize it with his natural existence," observes "Carrot."

William "Root" Stewart is Third World's principal drummer. He joined the band shortly after completion of their first album and makes a vital contribution to

the Third World sound. He also played with Inner Circle and then joined Byron Lee & The Dragonaires at the age of 18, touring the U.S., Mexico, England and Canada over a three year period.

As the heart and pulse of the Third World experience, Willy believes that the music is the international language of the world.

It is obvious that Third World is made up of a unique group of musicians seeking to spread ideas of peace and love. Their current project should help accomplish this. In *You've Got The Power*, they indeed have a very forceful messenger.

# COUNTRY STAR OF THE MONTH

After a string of successful records in a hard country mold, Joe Sun debuted on Elektra/Asylum in November 1981 with a thoroughly reverent reading of the traditional "Silent Night," both as a single and as a highlight of E/A's *Christmas Country* lp. His first E/A album, *I Ain't Honky-Tonkin' No More*, was released in February 1982.

Joe Sun was born and raised in Rochester, Minnesota. According to Sun, his childhood nights were

spent "wrapped up with a Montgomery Ward Airline radio that cost \$3 and pulled in the Opry from Nashville and an r&b station from Little Rock."

After leaving high school with no prospects for the future, Sun enlisted in the Air Force on the advice of parents and friends. While there he served in a Vietnam-based combat operations unit as a control duty clerk.

"I was captivated by the idea of Hollywood when I was growing

up," says Sun, "so when I got out of the service in late 1965, I made a point of getting there." He wound up working the late shift in a music store at Sunset and Vine, and walking the streets with a service buddy, both of them trying to find an interested record executive.

"All I ever found were some nickel-and-dime hustlers," recalls Sun. "I can still tell you just what they looked like: their pant legs were about six inches too short and pegged in a style that was 10 years out of date. They wore real skinny ties, also a long way from being fashionable. They had dandruff on their collars, you could see a little bit of white sock sticking out of their loafers, they had very little hair and smoked those big cigars."


Sun finally did cut some demonstration tapes in Hollywood and made his first public performance as half of a folk-singing duo at the Ice House in Pasadena. Then he headed back to Minnesota in mid-1966.

Sun enrolled in Brown Institute in Minneapolis, where he studied radio broadcasting. His first job in the industry came in 1967 as an air personality for Key West, Florida rock station WKIZ. While there, Sun heard Mickey Newbury's distinctly non-rock record "Are My Thoughts With You," and "got totally turned on by what he was doing. I thought, 'That's the kind of music that I want to be around and to be associated with.'"

His next radio job was in Madison, Wisconsin, at country station WMAD. While there, Sun moonlighted as a singer and guitar player with a local country band called The Branded Men. "Although I was doing it for fun, I was the guy who kicked ass about getting serious. Some of the guys were married, and couldn't see throwing everything away for music. But I could. For me, that was the only way to go."

Fired from the radio station "because I sounded too much like a soul disc jockey," he moved to Chicago, working at a computer company and spending his weekends scouting the city's active folk-music circuit. He watched


performers such as John Prine and Steve Goodman and occasionally played in Sunday jams at the Earl of Old Town. In Chicago, he met Brien Fisher, who was then "running a little studio in Lombardi. It was a glued-together, fly-by-night, seat-of-your-pants country record operation. Some of the stuff he recorded there would be eligible for Ripley's *Believe It Or Not!*"

In the fall of 1975, Sun was still determined to make his living as a country music singer. He moved to Nashville, where he worked at a number of jobs leading to the country promotion desk for Memphis-based Hi Records. They were best-known as an r&b label with acts such as Al Green and Ann Peebles. While based in Nashville, his efforts helped catapult Bill Black Combo's "Bolin' Cabbage" single onto the charts, as well as saxophonist Ace Cannon's version of "Blue Eyes Cryin' In The Rain."

Fisher, in the meantime, had also moved to Nashville. Like Sun, he had also spent a considerable amount of time looking for a career hook and had finally made contact with a father-and-daughter recording team, Royce and Jeannie Kendall. He had arranged to produce them for the Chicago-based Ovation label. Fisher offered Sun a job promoting the record, compensating from the severe drop in salary from \$22,000 a year at Hi to \$50 a week by promising to produce Sun as an artist if he could promote the Kendalls onto the charts. When "Heaven's Just A Sin Away" hit the charts in '77 (it later won a Grammy and four other major awards), Fisher made good on his promise.

Sun's first single was a song he'd discovered at an Exit/In writers' showcase and taken to Royce who had turned it down. The first Sun single, which Joe promoted himself, made it to #4 — "Old Flames (Can't Hold A Candle To You)." Subsequent singles, "High & Dry," "Blue Ribbon Blues" and "On Business For The King," formed the nucleus of his first lp, *Old Flames*.

From the next album, *Out Of Your Mind*, "I'd Rather Go On Hurtin'" and the title track helped him win Billboard's "Best New Male Vocalist" award for 1978. "Shotgun Rider" from that same lp, made inroads into the pop charts as well.

*Livin' On Honky-Tonk Time*, Sun's third album, was released in October 1980. Sun saw this lp as a milestone in that it marked his first use of his road band, Shotgun, in the studio, and also included his first recorded efforts as a songwriter. He wrote "Bombed, Boozed & Busted (Livin' On Honky-Tonk Time)," which he composed with Dennis Knutson, and "Bottom Line," written with Jack Grayson.

The album also contained songs written by Hank Williams, Sr., Delbert McClinton, Bob Dylan and the trio of Billy Ray Reynolds, Dickey Betts and Gary Stewart.

*I Ain't Honky-Tonkin' No More* features more material in the same general direction as his previous efforts. Sun characterizes the new lp as "somewhat livelier" than its predecessor — "some ... fusion of rockabilly and country. It's certainly still country, but some cuts may raise a few eyebrows because they come dangerously close to rock 'n'

roll." Like the first three, this album was also produced by Brien Fisher, and like *Livin' On Honky-Tonk Time*, it features the members of Shotgun, this time augmented by guitarist Randy Soruggs, in whose Nashville studio the sessions took place.

Although Sun is seen by some as a member of country music's "outlaw" movement, and though he's certainly a colorful individual, Joe Sun says in truth he's "balancing commercial goals with artistic integrity. I've always known what I liked and what direction I wanted to go in when I heard it. The fact that I'm recording here in Nashville with my own band, not the usual 'A'-team session guys, is very rare in this town, and we're cuttin' the songs live in the studio with little or no overdubbing, like they used to make records. So what people hear on the record is what they'll hear onstage and vice versa. If I can believe it, they can believe it, and that's the bottom line."
