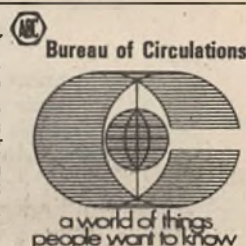

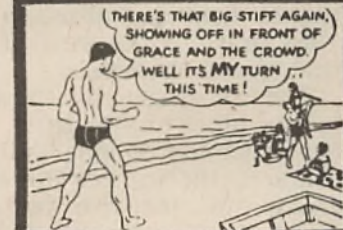

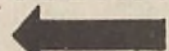

POP STAR OF THE MONTH

PAUL McCARTNEY

Tug Of War is Paul McCartney's latest lp, and if the initial signs prove true, should be the biggest album of his solo career. The recently released lp debuted at an unbelievable Number 5 on the Cash Box Top 100 Album chart! This makes *Tug Of War* the highest debuting album so far in 1982, and chances are it will hold that record for awhile.

The first single from the album is the blockbuster duet with Stevie Wonder, "Ebony And Ivory." The song hit Number One on the charts after just five weeks and paved the way for the release of the album.

Tug Of War is the McCartney album that his fans have been waiting for for a long time. One difference from past McCartney albums is that this time Paul teamed up with producer George

Martin instead of producing the album himself. The result is an lp that is along the lines of *Sgt. Pepper's Lonely Hearts Club Band* and *Abbey Road*.

Working together, McCartney and Martin have come up with a wide range of pop-styled tunes that will have the listener sitting up and taking notice. Undoubtedly, *Tug Of War* is centered around the two McCartney/Wonder duets. The seemingly simple black and white metaphor borders on genius, and the voices of McCartney and Wonder blend together nicely.

The other duet is titled "What's That You're Doing" and is just the opposite of "Ebony And Ivory." It's a super-hot pop-funk tune backed by Stevie's synthesizers. Other tunes that are definitely worth mentioning are "Here To-

with Carl Perkins, the man who wrote "Blue Suede Shoes." The rest of the tunes on the lp such as "Ballroom Dancing," "Dress Me Up As A Robber," "Wanderlust" and "Somebody Who Cares," makes up some of the best material that McCartney has come out with in a long time.

Paul McCartney's solo career began in 1970, while the Beatles were still considered a group. His first solo lp, *McCartney*, was released three weeks before the final Beatles album.

1971 found McCartney back in a group. The first lp released by Wings was *Wild Life*. McCartney's wife Linda, was part of the new group, and after some rough times, Wings was on its way.

Hit album followed hit album and Paul McCartney was soon established as the most successful pop musician in the world. Albums such as *Band On The Run*, *Venus And Mars*, *Wings At The Speed Of Sound* and *Wings Over America* stand as proof to that.

Although his talent and success were unquestioned, and the

day," which is the most powerful song on the album. Reminiscent of "Yesterday," this song is McCartney's personal tribute to John Lennon.

In a recent interview McCartney talked about "Here Today": "One of the feelings you always have when someone close to you dies like that is that you wish you could have seen him the day before to square everything up and make sure he knew how much you really cared."

"The song is about saying to John, 'Do we really have to keep this sort of thing (the feud) up?' But we never got around to doing it. I guess we never felt any urgency about it. We were behaving like we were going to live forever, which is what everyone thought in the Beatles days, right? I mean, who ever thought we were going to die?"

Aside from the two duets with Stevie, *Tug Of War* also has a duet

years had passed, McCartney was never quite able to break completely away from the tag "Ex-Beatle." Then again, neither had the remainder of the Fab Four.

As an example of McCartney's link with the past, is the place he chose to record *Tug Of War* — Abbey Road — the place in which the Beatles recorded almost all of their classic songs. Not only did he return there for his latest recording, but the man with him, George Martin, was the same man that had auditioned the fledgling Beatles in 1962.

McCartney even went so far as to have a perfect replica of Abbey Road built on his property. It is said that the original has hardly changed since his first visit 20 years ago. It remains as a testimony to a past that will never be again.

Abbey Road might remain the same, but McCartney, with the release of *Tug Of War*, has made a change, and it is definitely a change for the better.

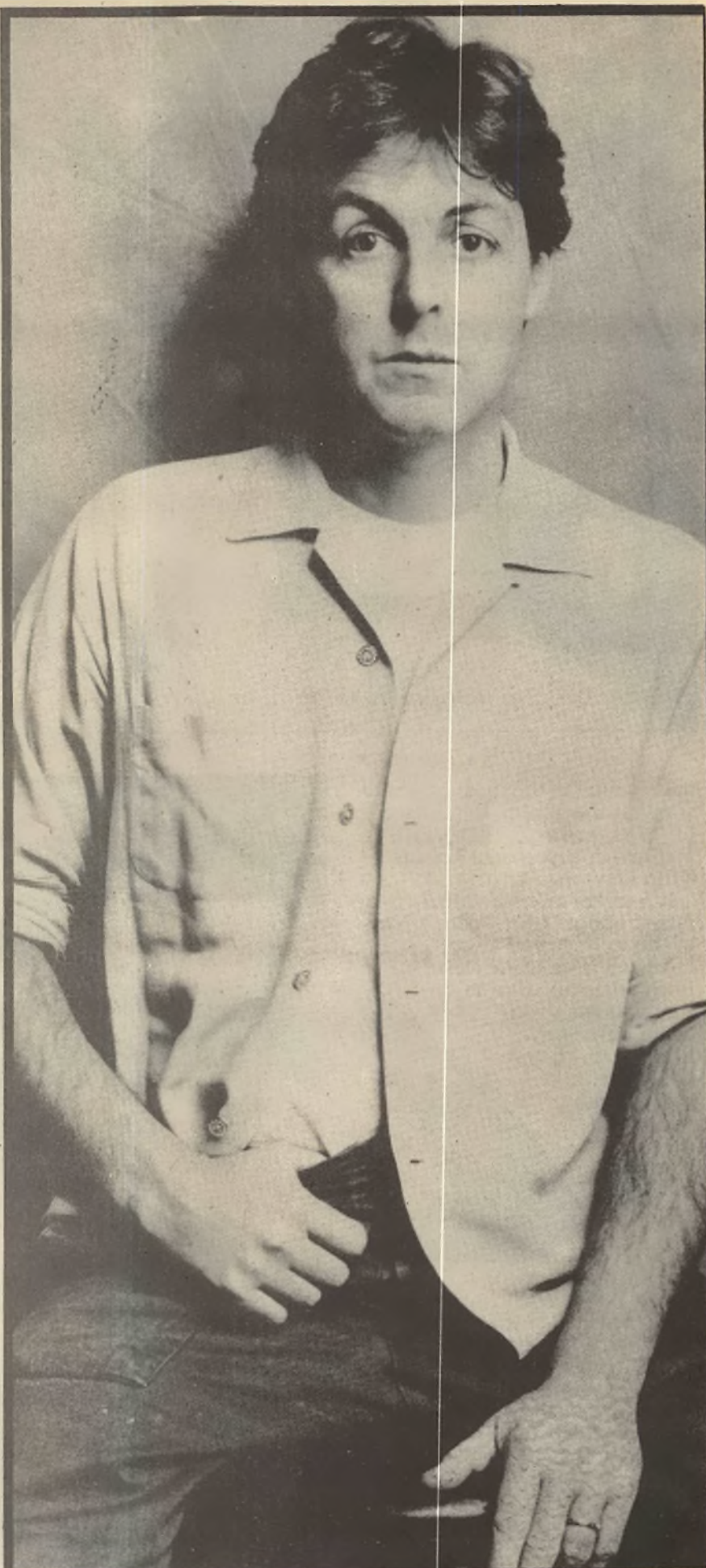

ELTON JOHN

POP STAR OF THE MONTH

Elton John's second Geffen Records offering, *Jump Up*, is named for a West Indian expression which exemplifies the essence of parties and good times. It is an appropriate title for the album that was inspired so much by the atmospheres of Antigua and Montserrat.

Recorded primarily at Air Studios on the island of Montserrat, *Jump Up* was produced by Chris Thomas, who worked with Elton last year on his Geffen debut, *The Fox*. The tracks on the lp were co-written with three different lyricists — Bernie

Taupin, Gary Osborne and a new name, Tim Rice, who wrote the poignant lyrics to "Legal Boys."

The album's mixture of moods varies dramatically, ranging from the chunky "Ball And Chain" to the despair of "Legal Boys." The mixture continues with the Motown shades of "Good Times" to the magnificence of the epic "All Quiet On The Western Front" (who says it's not possible to write an original protest song anymore?)

Then, just when one might think that sooner or later Elton must run out of new approaches, the late night mellowness of "Blue Eyes" assures us on the very first listening that here is another classic Elton John single.

Certainly not to be forgotten is the smash single "Empty Garden (Hey Hey Johnny)," written by Elton and Bernie Taupin. This tune is a tribute to John Lennon and the lyrics are undeniably brilliant. To top it off, Elton's voice has never sounded better than it does on this haunting melody.

Elton John was born Reginald Kenneth Dwight on March 25, 1947, in Pinner, Middlesex, the only child of Sheila and Stanley Dwight. At the age of four, Elton began taking piano lessons and by the time he was 12, he had played at the Ruislip-Norwood Music Festival in Middlesex.

1964 found Elton playing piano in the Northwood Hills Hotel bar for 1 pound a night plus as many tips as he could scrounge up. It was at this time he decided to leave school and take a job as a teaboy for Mills Music.

In 1965 Elton joined his first band, a local group called Bluesology. They made two records for Fontana called "Come Back Baby" and "Mr. Frantic." During an audition at the Kilburn State Cinema Bluesology were signed by the Roy Tempest Agency to back visiting American soul artists. Elton thought then he was on his way.

One year after this, Elton blew an audition for Liberty by playing five Jim Reeves songs one after another. Liberty, however, was impressed with his style and they put him in touch with aspiring lyricist Bernie Taupin. During the "Flower Power" explosion the duo started writing songs such as "Mirrors Of My Mind" and

"Lemonade Lake." DJM decided they were worth a gamble and signed them for publishing with Elton as a singer.

1968 was a year of changes for Elton. He permanently changed his name from Reg Dwight and he left Bluesology. Also, he began sharing an apartment with Taupin and they came up with a song — "I Can't Go On Living Without You" — which made it to the finals of the Eurovision Song Contest.

Elton's first album was *Empty Sky* and contained the single "It's Me That You Need." Released in 1969, the album was produced by Steve Brown. This lp was followed in 1970 by *Elton John* and *Tumbleweed Connection*. Also in 1970, Elton was reluctantly persuaded to come to the U.S. for a promotional visit. He played at the Troubadour in Los Angeles and reportedly turned the place upside down. By this time, Dee Murray and Nigel Olsson made up the Elton John Band, along with Elton and Taupin.

1971 saw the release of two more albums — a live lp, *11-17-70* and *Madman Across The Water*. The latter reached number eight on the American chart. The Elton John Band began touring regularly in America in 1972 and added Davey Johnstone to their line up. Elton scored his first Number One album, *Honky Chateau* that same year.

The follow-ups to *Honky Chateau* were two more Number One lps — *Don't Shoot Me I'm Only The Piano Player* and *Goodbye Yellow Brick Road*. During a tour in 1973, Elton broke all of his previous attendance records. The tour was climaxed by a Hollywood Bowl Concert. In the audience on that day were Barbra Streisand, Elizabeth Taylor, Steve McQueen and Ali McGraw.

Elton's next lp was *Caribou*, which was recorded at Caribou Ranch in Colorado. John Lennon guested on this lp and Elton returned the favor on Lennon's *Walls And Bridges*.

By 1974, Elton had attained superstar status. When his *Greatest Hits* album was released, the Number One song in the country was "Lucy In The Sky With Diamonds" and MCA reportedly paid eight million dollars in advance for Elton to renew his contract.

Following the release of *Captain Fantastic And The Brown Dirt Cowboy* in 1975, Elton announced a new line-up for his band. It now consisted of Johnstone, Ray Cooper, Roger Pope, Caleb Quaye, Kenny Passarelli, James Newton-Howard and, just for the Wembley Concert, Skunk Baxter. Along with the Beach Boys and the Eagles, Elton and his band played before 72,000 people at Wembley Stadium.

More albums were followed by more hits, including the 1976 tune "Don't Go Breaking My Heart" with Kiki Dee. *Greatest Hits Volume II* was released in

1977 and following this, Elton became the first rock singer to be inducted into the Madison Square Garden Hall of Fame.

In 1978, Elton established a new songwriting partnership with Gary Osborne and *A Single Man* was released. In November of that year, Elton decided to take a little rest after collapsing following a grueling tennis match with superstar Billie Jean King. Although he was rushed to the hospital after being suspected of having a heart attack, the diagnosis was severe exhaustion.

In 1981, Elton signed with Geffen Records and released his first lp for that label, *The Fox*.

Currently, Elton is riding high with the release of *Jump Up*. Planned for this year is a world tour which will see Elton returning to the stage for the first time in several years.

He has re-formed the best remembered Elton John Band for this tour — Dee Murray on bass, Davey Johnstone on guitar and Nigel Olsson on drums. The tour is scheduled to begin in New Zealand and Australia, and will include fourteen countries.

Jump Up is Elton John's twenty-third album in a recording career spanning 23 years, and undoubtedly, there will be much more to come.

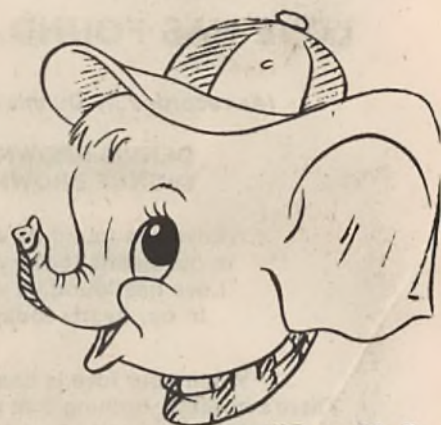

SOUL STAR OF THE MONTH

A TASTE OF HONEY



Hard work coupled with talent can succeed. Just ask Janice Marie Johnson or Hazel Payne, the talented duo known to music fans around the world as A Taste Of Honey. Since they have forged ahead so solidly in the competitive world of contemporary music, it is only fitting that the duo's fourth Capitol album be titled *Ladies Of The Eighties*.

On this lp, Johnson and Payne expand the formidable streak of success ignited with their splashy debut five years ago. By bassist Johnson's own standards, *Ladies Of The Eighties* stands as "our best album to date. The singles potential is stronger than it's been for any of our other projects. We feel it's got something for everyone."

In 1978 Johnson and guitarist partner Payne received a crash course on the potential of a single. That was the year their

very first recording, "Boogie Oogie Oogie," written by Johnson hit the top of the charts, becoming an international smash.

In the United States the single and its album, *A Taste Of Honey*, produced by Larry and Fonce Mizell and co-promoted by A Taste Of Honey, were both certified platinum by the RIAA. They ultimately went gold in both the United Kingdom and Japan. The record also nabbed the group a prestigious "Best New Artist Of The Year" Grammy Award.

"We hadn't really realized yet just what had happened until we came off the road," Johnson recalls of that hectic period. "The gold and platinum and the Grammy were all so overwhelming. A few months later we were sitting back, saying to ourselves, 'My God, we've got a hit record!'"

In July of 1979 the group released their second lp, *Another*

Taste. Once again produced by the Mizells and the group, with Johnson and Payne writing and arranging most of the material, the lp was a victim of disco's backlash in the U.S. Despite this, it climbed to the top of the charts in Japan, and both the lp and its single, "Do It Good," went gold.

The record also won the Gold Prize in the 8th Annual Tokyo Music Festival. The group supported the honors with a tour of Japan and plenty of television promotion. They even did a Japanese commercial for Toshiba's Bom-Beat stereo cassette player.

If there seemed to be a marked absence of A Taste Of Honey on American charts in 1979-80, Johnson and Payne changed all that in 1981. The departure of A Taste Of Honey keyboardist Perry Kibble and drummer Donald Johnson left the responsibility for the band's musical direction solely on their shoulders. The duo then went into the studio with George Duke to work on their third lp. The result was *Twice As Sweet*, which was released in September of 1981.

The third single released from the lp was "Sukiyaki," a revitalized re-make of Kyu Sakamoto's 1963 international hit. The tune went to Number One on the national charts, and A Taste Of Honey had themselves another gold single. "We never doubted that song," says Johnson, who had the 1963 version translated and then re-wrote the lyrics. "It's a romantic song with a great arrangement; I knew all it needed was the chance to be a hit."

Not only did "Sukiyaki" put A Taste Of Honey back on the charts, but, as he has said in published interviews, the record also broke George Duke into the major leagues as a record producer.

The record also served to put A Taste Of Honey at the highest point of their careers. While looking at the background of A Taste Of Honey, it is obvious that music was going to be a big part of their lives.

The combination of Johnson and Payne is a unique, yet successful one. Tenacious and determined, Johnson describes herself as hard-working and "a perfectionist." "I'm a sensitive and good-hearted person," she says, "but I believe in doing things

right the first time."

Johnson's traits as a perfectionist show up clearly in the studio. Along with Perry Kibble, Johnson was a founding member of the group. Since that time she has developed as a principal songwriter, arranger and producer.

Janice Johnson was born in Los Angeles and raised in about 26 different area locations throughout her childhood. Her father was a printer/mechanic, but also played the piano and sang. Her mother, a nurse, was a member of a teenage all-girl band. Says Janice: "My mother played mandolin and I had two aunts who played piano and string bass. When I was young, my father used to play the piano and have us sing Billie Holiday and Dakota Staton songs for company when they came over to our house."

Janice devoted most of her early youth to studying ballet and modern dance. She began singing in groups at age 11 and studied music at the Grant Music Center and acting at Ebony Showcase Theatre and the Co-Real Artist Workshop. While in junior high school, she was a member of a four-girl singing group which included her sister Sharon.

While working in a group called Soundstage #1 Janice met Kibble and they began what would one day be A Taste Of Honey. Hazel Payne joined the group in 1976. Born in Los Angeles, Payne had interests similar to Johnson while growing up. She began studying tap dance and ballet at the age of four and wrote and performed her first musical composition at the age of nine.

Payne's childhood was devoted almost entirely to music. Her mother, an aspiring opera singer, received her Masters Degree and is a polylingual elementary school teacher, but is most responsible for inspiring her only daughter of six children to study music.

Payne studied music for a year at Fisk University in Tennessee, then returned to Los Angeles and began working in a series of local groups. "There must have been eight or nine groups," Payne recalls. "Most of them split up, and some reformed."

Hazel is a talented songwriter and arranger, and also plays the piano, flute, bass clarinet, B-flat clarinet, alto sax and bell lyre.

Janice Johnson and Hazel Payne seem to be the essence of the perfect musical combination. Now, with *Ladies Of The Eighties*, A Taste Of Honey is going for the platinum once again. Eight of the tracks on the lp were co-written and produced by rhythm guitar ace Al McKay (ex-Earth, Wind & Fire), with two

The Groove," the thunderous rock-flavored "Lies," the seductive mid-tempo of "Never Go Wrong" and the splendid reworking of "I'll Try Something New," the cover of the Smokey Robinson classic that became a smash single right out of the box.

"The idea with this album is to stretch out, while at the same



tracks produced by Ronald LaPread (of the Commodores) and A Taste Of Honey. As on all their albums, Johnson and Payne contribute songs and collaborate on their arrangements.

Ladies Of The Eighties is full of contemporary music, such as the synthesizer-laden syncopation of "Sayonara," the festive "We've Got

time coming up with hit-oriented material," comments Johnson. "We decided long ago that we'd rather be leading the pack than following it. That's what *Ladies Of The Eighties* is all about."

With statements like those, and the music to back it up, it's very obvious where you can find A Taste Of Honey — at the top.

TERRY GREGORY

COUNTRY STAR OF THE MONTH

One of the most talented recording artists to enter the music scene in 1981 was an exciting and energetic young woman named Terry Gregory. Her first album, *Just Like Me*, was released on Handshake Records and has successfully established her as a force to be reckoned with in the music world.

The next Gregory album scheduled for release is called *From The Heart*, and should bring even more attention to this crystal-clear-voiced singer.

The first single from the album is "I Never Knew The Devil's Eyes Were Blue" which is an up-tempo tune that is reminiscent of Terri Gibbs' crossover hit "Somebody's Knockin'." But Gregory's smooth vocals and impressive delivery will immediately distinguish her from any singer around.

Several other excellent cuts on the album include "I Need Another Lover (Like A Hole In My Heart)," "I'm Still The Other Woman," and "The Last Goodbye." Although Gregory may be considered strictly country by many, several of her tunes have definite crossover potential.

Despite the fact that her first hit record came early in her career, Terry has been singing since she was five. Her first stage was the counter in her parent's grocery store in Takoma Park, Maryland. She was soon playing every retail shop on the block and, with supportive parents, she dreamed of larger stages to conquer.

Gifted with a remarkable voice and musical ear, Terry pursued music and drama fundamentals at Montgomery College in Rockville, Maryland. Soon after, a guest spot on local radio led to her first major competition, The National Country Music Championships. A second-place finish turned out to be a real winner for Terry — she was invited to share the stage for several shows with Dolly Parton and Billy "Crash" Craddock. Terry was originally asked to perform two songs, but





because the audience response was so overwhelming, her spot was increased to seven songs.

Gregory's taste for the stage and performing continued to grow after this experience, prompting her to enlist with Fire & Ice, a top 40 band that played clubs along the east coast, especially in the Washington, D.C. area.

Still not completely satisfied, Terry moved to Los Angeles to pursue a professional recording career. A friend, impressed with what he heard when Terry sang, introduced her to music publishing giant Al Gallico, who believed in her talents. Gallico introduced her to Ron Alexenburg, president of Handshake Records, and he signed her to his label.

Gregory's first hit single was the title cut from her first album, *Just Like Me*. This tune took the singer into the top 20 on the

country singles chart, which was good enough to earn her the Cash Box award as the #2 new female vocalist. The second single, "I Can't Say Goodbye To You" also made a good showing on the charts and brought even more attention to Gregory.

Her talents, however, are not limited to radio. Gregory has appeared on the "Merv Griffin Show" and several other productions, including the Dick Clark-produced "Legend Of Country Music," "The Bobby Wright Show" and "The Bobby Vinton Show."

Her love for live performances has found her opening shows for Mac Davis, Terri Gibbs, Doug Kershaw and Bill Cosby.

Although as a child she patterned herself after female singers such as Connie Francis and Janet Lennon, Terry Gregory has a voice and a style that sounds

like a young Olivia Newton-John in her early country days.

If her singing brings others pleasure, it's probably because it gives her so much pleasure to sing. "Emotion is the most important part, and if singing is feeling, then I'm always trying to reach out through the radio to touch the listener," says Terry.

Terry Gregory has so many things going for her — talent, good looks and personality — that her ultimate success is not a question of "if" but "when." Following the release of *From The Heart*, that question should be answered soon.

As for the future, Terry hopes to go on a concert tour as an opener for a major performer and get her old band back together. But it probably won't be too long before Terry herself is the major performer and someone else is opening for her.
