THE POLICE

Six years into their career, the Police have left little to prove as a commercial entity. Hit singles, gold and platinum albums, soldout world tours, unanimous critical acclaim: Sting, Stewart Copeland and Andy Summers have had it all.

The Police have undoubtedly assumed an undisputed place among this planet's best and most popular bands. Yet, no amount of fanfare and success can alter the simple fact that they are working musicians — first, foremost and always — who are continually exploring and refining their craft.

The latest step is a record that has already been hailed as "a predictably unpredictable gem." The album is *Synchronicity*, and it is the Police's fifth album for A&M Records.

The group was formed by drummer Stewart Copeland in early 1977. Having tired of rock music's artistic and commercial excesses, Copeland decided on an alternative: a three-piece band whose music would be spare and reasonably simple, and whose approach to business would be equally streamlined.

Pop Star of the Month

Copeland was an American living in London when he first recruited Sting, a bass player, vocalist and sometime school teacher, whose name at birth was Gordon Mathew Sumner.

Towering skeletons of half-built ships rising above the tree-tops at the end of the street are among Sting's earliest memories. He was brought up by the docks in Wallsend, a suburb of Newcastle in the Northeast of England. The most significant event of his early life was when one of his uncles emigrated to Canada and left behind a guitar. Sting soon discovered an affinity for the instrument and music soon became a consuming passion.

He learned to play by strumming along to old Beatles and Stones records, but at 14 he discovered jazz. The unusual chords, intricate rhythms and improvisations opened up new musical horizons for him and it wasn't long before he became interested in jazz bass and bought himself a bass guitar.

Like many young players, he hung around the pubs and clubs occasionally getting to play on string bass when the regular stopped for a break. One night the regular failed to appear for the gig so Sting astonished the jazz fraternity of Newcastle by switching on his electric bass.

The jazz circle in Newcastle was limited so Sting took off to teacher training college for three years before becoming an art teacher at a village school in Cramlington. At that time he formed a band called Last Exit (referring to the motorway turn-off for Newcastle) which rapidly became the leading band in the Northeast of England. When the time came to uproot and head for London, the other members dropped out, leaving Sting to follow up a phone call he had had from Stewart Copeland. Sting, Stewart and Henri Padovani formed the first version of the Police.

It was Copeland, founder and driving force behind the Police, who thought up the band's name and recognized the charisma of guitarist/singer Sting. It was also Stewart who formed Illegal Records to release the first single from the Police called "Fall Out."

With his father's cosmopolitan background in the C.I.A. which

took him to several different countries, Stewart could have been anything from a businessman in the Middle East to a movie-maker in California. He decided at the age of 13 that he wanted to be a rock drummer. At first, his father wouldn't take his ambition seriously and told him that he couldn't be a musician unless he was prepared to practice for four hours a day.

Stewart's father knew what he was talking about because he himself had been a trumpeter in the Glenn Miller Band. Stewart showed his determination by finding some strong cardboard boxes and using them to practice his drum rolls on — for the required four hours a day, of course! Realizing he was serious about wanting to be a drummer, his father relented and soon Stewart had his first real drum kit.

By now, the Copelands were living in Beirut. Stewart was born in Virginia, but his father's job took the family to Lebanon where all the young Copelands were brought up speaking fluent Arabic as well as English, which they've never forgotten.

One thing Stewart is always being asked is the origin of the band's name. His answer is that the idea came from the family's police connection — and he realized, too, that as the boys in blue were constantly mentioned in the papers every day, each mention would serve as a reminder of the rock band the Police.

As for Andy Summers, it is his nimble fingers that produce those deceptively simple but effective guitar phrases which have done so much to put the Police's records on the charts all over the world. Playing the guitar has been his whole life and there was never any doubt in his mind about what he wanted to become — a better guitarist with a pile of gold discs and awards to prove it!

He was born Andrew James Somers but changed his name to Summers to save him from having to spell it all the time. This name is also very similar to Sting's surname, Sumner. A second coincidence is that each of them comes from a family of four children. Andy has two brothers and a sister. As if that weren't

enough, the way they all met was coincidence too — the Police (with their first guitarist Padovani) and Andy and his band were all booked as a package of rock bands touring France.

In 1978, the Police, with their present line-up, signed a recording contract with A&M and initially released two well received singles, "Roxanne," and "Can't Stand Losing You." Both of these tunes were included on their debut album which was planned for an American release in March, 1979.

However, A&M previewed the Police for U.S. audiences on its *No Wave* compilation album in late fall of 1978 and by January, "Roxanne" began picking up major radio ads. In response, *Outlandos d'Amour* was rushed-released a month early and "Roxanne" went on to be a top twenty hit.

With this debut album, the Police established their ongoing tradition of creating high quality recordings with relatively small budgets. Recorded for \$6,000, *Outlandos* became a gold record worldwide.

Their subsequent albums are *Regatta de Blanc* (1979), *Zenyatta Mondatta* (1980), *Ghost In The Machine* (1981) and now *Synchronicity*. "Roxanne" and "Can't Stand Losing You" were the beginning of a string of worldwide chart-topping singles. Included in this group are "Message In A Bottle," "Don't Stand So Close To Me," "De Do Do Do, De Da Da Da" and the runaway hit "Every Little Thing She Does Is Magic."

The first single from *Synchronicity* is "Every Breath You Take," which has all the earmarks of becoming another Police classic.

This new album, like *Ghost In The Machine*, was recorded primarily at AIR Studios, Montserrat, and was produced by the Police and engineer Hugh Padgugam. Except for "Mother" (by Andy Summers) and "Miss Gradenko" (by Stewart Copeland) the album's songs were written by Sting. As usual, the Police played every instrument, including bass, drums and percussion, guitars, synthesizers and woodwinds.

As long as the Police continue to exhibit an astonishing range both musically and lyrically, their fans will keep coming back for more.

Joan Jett and The Blackhearts



Late in December of 1982, Joan Jett and the Blackhearts finally came off the road after a solid 2½ years of worldwide touring. Their plans consisted of taking a well-deserved rest and then begin recording their latest MCA lp, *Album*. Says Jett of the group's third lp, "You won't hear a lot of echoes and overdubs on the lp. I wanted the record to be very basic sounding. We're a rock and roll band and that's how I wanted it to sound."

To say the Blackhearts are just a rock and roll band is a bit of an understatement. Through talent, energy and sheer determination, Joan Jett and the Blackhearts have overcome every obstacle strewn in their path on the way to becoming a phenomenon.

When Jett's first album *Bad Reputation* was released in 1980, it became one of the top ten most-added albums in the trade magazine airplay charts and re-established the ex-Runaway as a cult figure. Rolling Stone called the lp "...a rock and roll autobiography that few ... performers had lived out so fully or told so convincingly."

1980's *I Love Rock 'N Roll* yielded two top ten singles: the title cut, which stayed at number one for eight straight weeks, and "Crimson & Clover," which went to number six. Once again, only praise was heard. Rolling Stone's Dave Marsh called the album "Irresistible ... Jett has lived up to the promise of her debut with this thunderously exciting set."

When the subsequent success of "Do You Wanna Touch Me," from the *Bad Reputation* album, gave Jett's first lp a belated new life on rock radio, she became the first in a line of artists to have their early works rediscovered with the explosion of new music on mainstream rock radio. In 1982, Joan Jett was voted one of the Top Female Vocalists in polls taken by Rolling Stone, Playboy, Billboard, and Cashbox.

Above all else, Joan Jett and the Blackhearts are a touring rock and roll band. They just love to work. An exciting part of the last tour was when they became the first American performing act to play in the German Democratic Republic (East Germany). The kids in that country had heard the Blackhearts music on the Forces Radio and on West German radio and were great fans. Despite the fact that the band could not take any money out of the country, it was a thrill to play their rock and roll in the GDR. The audience knew all the tunes and the shows were a huge success.

Album marks Joan Jett and the Blackhearts' first release on Blackheart/MCA. The lp features nine original Jett compositions and two Jett-style send-ups of old favorites.

Rock and roll influences began early in Joan's life. She had wanted to play guitar since elementary school. Her family moved fourteen times during her youth. Joan says "Maybe that's why I can't stay in one place for too long and love the road so much. I get restless."

As a grade-schooler living in Rockville, Maryland, she got her first guitar. "My mother bought me a cheap Sears electric with a little Gibson amp which cost twenty dollars for the combination. I took lessons for about a month. The guy kept trying to teach me 'On Top Of Old Smokey' but I wanted to learn to play rock and roll.

"So I went home and played with my records up in my room. I really taught myself. I'd set up the stereo and amp and tuned my guitar to whatever song I wanted to play. I'd play things like T-Rex songs off the *Electric Wardrobe* album, or 'Honky-Tonk Woman' really loud. I was thirteen, fourteen years old."

In 1972, Joan's family moved to Los Angeles, where she started hanging out in a club called Rodney's English Disco, which played nothing but early 1970's glitter rock like David Bowie, T-Rex and Suzie Quatro. Joan started writing her first songs and met producer Kim Fowley. Together with Fowley and a drummer named Sandy West, she hatched the idea of forming an all-girl rock and roll band.

That band, the Runaways, toured for five years, cut three albums and played the kind of raw, overtly sexual music that was, to say the least, unheard-of from a group of teenage girls. Joan wrote most of the songs including "I Love Playing With Fire," "You're Too Possessive," "Wait For Me," "Don't Abuse Me," and the number one Japanese hit, "Cherry Bomb."

Joan says of her Runaway days, "It was my dream to play in a rock band and I was doing it. We didn't really pay attention to what was going on around us ... we were just normal teenage girls who swore a little bit and smoked and drank now and again, but we had a jailbait image and got put down for it.

"We were fighting uphill, it seemed, so we decided to wrap it up. I went back to L.A. to try to figure out what to do, but the only thing I know is music ... I had to get another band."

While living across the street from the Whisky A-Go-Go in 1979, Jett met Kenny Laguna and Ritchie Cordell. As a teenager, Laguna had been producer/songwriter and musician for the Ohio Express, Jay and the Americans, Tommy James and the Shondells, and the 1910 Fruitgum Company.

Cordell had been the composer of 18 worldwide hits, among them "Mony, Mony." Laguna says that on first meeting Joan, "I don't know what it was, but there was something really special in this girl." Kenny and Ritchie agreed to help Joan produce her first solo lp. Jett asked musician-friends like the Sex Pistols' Steve Jones and Paul Cook, and Blondie's Clem Burke and Frank Infante, to help record *Bad Reputation* for the Dutch label Ariola. Here in the U.S., this import album sold 22,000 copies within weeks of its release, heading to the top of the charts on stations like L.A.'s KNAC and Long Island's WLIR.

That album started a style on Joan's lps which has since become a tradition: the blending of original interpretations of classic songs like Sam the Sham's "Wooly Bully," the Isley Brothers' "Shout," and Lesley Gore's "You Don't Own Me," all rendered in Jett's inimitably hard, minimalist style.

Next, Joan formed the Blackhearts and began touring extensively, building a solid grass-roots support with a band that included Gary Ryan on bass, Ricky Byrd, on guitar, and Lee Crystal on

drums. Their reputation was built on the intensity and athleticism of their performances. Despite critical acclaim, they could not overcome industry cold feet and corporate tin ears.

When they couldn't get a U.S. record deal, Kenny and Joan decided to form their own label and used their personal savings to press records and set up their own system of independent distributors. No matter how they kept their expenses down, money was always a problem. One day, during the worst financial time, Meryl Laguna, Kenny's wife, and Joan's co-manager, walked into the kitchen and handed Kenny and Joan \$6,000. She had just cleaned out their child's entire college education fund. The tour could go on!

It was this tour, along with some adventurous radio program directors, that helped make *Bad Reputation* one of the ten-most-added discs of 1980. The demand for the lp quickly out-stripped the ability of Blackheart Records to produce copies, so Joan signed with the late Neil Bogart and Boardwalk Records.

Touring relentlessly, Joan and the Blackhearts recorded their next album, *I Love Rock 'N Roll*, between dates. Again, the collection offered original Jett tunes ("Victim Of Circumstance," "Love Is Pain," "You're Too Possessive") and a striking cover of Tommy James' "Crimson & Clover."

Of this last tune Jett noted that "That was the first single I remember buying as a kid." Propelled by the success of that tune and the phenomenal success of "I Love Rock 'N Roll," the lp skyrocketed up the charts and drew rave reviews everywhere.

For Joan Jett and the Blackhearts, the best part of releasing an album is always getting back out on the road and playing new songs for her fans.

"I don't really need that much in life," Joan notes. "Material things don't mean that much to me. As long as I can travel and play in front of people — whether it's a sweaty little club or a big place — to see those people smiling is what it's about. I live for that hour-and-a-half on stage. That's where my dreams all come true."

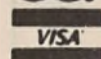

George Benson



There are few individuals in contemporary music who have been more honored or are more innovative than George Benson. Benson is a multi-million selling recording artist as well as a multiple Grammy Award winner whose hit records have consistently topped jazz, pop and soul charts. His distinctive combination of voice and guitar have created new standards of musical excellence.

In Your Eyes is Benson's seventh album for Warner Bros. Records, and his first album since 1980's *Give Me The Night* to feature all new material. The lp contains ten songs by some of today's top composers, with instrumental and vocal support by a host of special guest artists.

In Your Eyes was produced by the renowned Arif Mardin, and once again mixes the magic of Benson's vocals and guitar work in crisp and concise musical settings. It is the latest in a long

line of stylish, captivating Benson offerings.

George Benson began playing guitar at the age of eight. He later worked as a vocalist in a number of Pittsburgh r&b groups as well as performing as a vocalist on early recordings with Columbia and A&M.

During a long tenure with Creed Taylor and CTI, through the mid-sixties to early seventies, the vocal talents of Benson were almost completely overlooked. "While I was at CTI they didn't want me to sing, they just wanted me to play the guitar. A lot of people never knew I could sing, because I just wasn't given the opportunity to express myself vocally," he recalls.

As a CTI recording artist, it was Benson's fluid and distinct guitar style which brought him moderate success on a number of solo sets including his Grammy-nominated album *White Rabbit*. His reputation was also solidified by a succession of guest album

appearances with jazz luminaries such as Freddie Hubbard, Ron Carter, Hubert Laws, Herbie Hancock, Esther Phillips, Airto and Miles Davis.

In time, Benson formed his own group with Lonnie Smith on organ, Ronnie Cuber on baritone and drummer Phil Turner.

Undeniably, Benson first came to popular attention with the smash single "This Masquerade" in 1976. This tune was released from the platinum selling lp *Breezin'*. "This Masquerade" jetted to number one in the pop singles charts while the album went on to become the biggest-selling jazz album of all time. The single was also "Record of the Year" at the Grammy Awards. As of this writing, *Breezin'* has surpassed three million in sales and continues to be the greatest-selling album in the Benson catalogue.

Although this album opened the doors of pop music for

Benson, he had already established himself among jazz buffs as a guitarist of singular ability. His love for jazz came about after hearing a recording by the legendary jazz sax player Charlie Parker. He developed an abiding love for jazz and landed a gig in Brother Jack McDuff's organ trio in 1961.

Through his association with McDuff he met a number of jazz greats, including John Coltrane and Kenny Burrell. It was guitarist Wes Montgomery, however, who served as Benson's greatest musical inspiration. Montgomery was to become the young musician's close friend and mentor throughout the sixties.

While a majority of fans were still savoring *Breezin'*, Benson released his followup lp, *In Flight*. It proved without a doubt that George Benson was here to stay. *In Flight* went on to become his second platinum album and captured just about every award the *Breezin'* lp had notched the year before. At the same time, Benson's vocal talents and electric guitar licks yielded yet another hit, "The Greatest Love Of All" from the Muhammed Ali film *The Greatest*.

The enormous impact of Benson as a live entertainer created the avenue for his third Warner Bros. album, *Weekend In L.A.*, released in January 1978. This was his first live set for the label and its success was proved by its platinum status.

The double record was recorded live at the Roxy in Hollywood with a superb supportive cast including percussionist Ralph McDonald, drummer Harvey Mason, guitarist Phil Upchurch, pianist Jorge Dalto, keyboardist Ronnie Foster and bassist Stanley Banks.

The lp was produced by Tommy LiPuma, whose influences had contributed to the crossover acceptance of Benson on *Breezin'* and *In Flight*. The set highlighted tunes such as the Drifters classic, "On Broadway," "Weekend In L.A." and Leon Russell's "Lady Blue."

Weekend In L.A. became his third platinum album and Benson undertook a mammoth world tour of Japan, Europe and Australia as well as performing at Midem, The International Music Conference held in Cannes, France. The lp yielded his third

giant hit as well — a rendition of the classic "On Broadway" — used to great effect in the stunning opening sequence of the Oscar-winning film *All That Jazz*.

Following continued touring in 1978, Benson went back to the studio to record his fourth Warner Bros. lp. *Livin' Inside Your Love* was a further extension of the Benson persona. It was another two-record set interacting vintage Benson instrumentals with his equally scintillating vocals. The set contained the single "Love Ballad" and was quickly certified gold on its way to platinum.

Next came *Give Me The Night* in 1979. This spawned two more top ten hits, the title cut and "Love X Love." Benson's Grammy Awards in 1980 included Best Male r&b Instrumental Performance and Best Jazz Vocal Performance.

A compilation release, 1981's *The George Benson Collection*,

yielded the number one single "Turn Your Love Around." This brings us up to *In Your Eyes* and George Benson's astonishing career up to date.

In Your Eyes highlights material from accomplished songwriters including Michael Masser, who co-wrote the lp's title track and penned another of Benson's smash hits, "The Greatest Love Of All." Also, James Ingram, Mann & Weil, Arif Mardin and Toto's David Paich also contributed to tunes on the lp.

Among the galaxy of supporting musicians are included The Becker Brothers, bassist and labelmate Marcus Miller, the multi-talented Kashif — who along with Mardin, co-produced the lp's first single "Inside Love (So Personal)" — and many others.

In Your Eyes is a deeply felt, consummately executed album by an artist whose creativity knows no limits — quintessentially George Benson.

Country Star of the Month

Oak Ridge Boys

American Made, by the Oak Ridge Boys has shaped up to be the most successful release of their career. It earned itself a slot inside the top three on the lp charts, while the first single of the same name also equaled that feat. Currently, the second single from the lp is shooting up the charts. "Love Song" jumped an incredible 19 points on the singles chart in just one week!

The Oak Ridge Boys are: Duane Allen, Joe Bonsall, William Lee Golden and Richard Sterban. Only the Oak Ridge Boys, among all of today's successful acts, can trace their musical roots back nearly 40 years—to a then sleepy little region in East central Tennessee and a struggling band of gospel singers.

Until 1942, the place was a quiet rural community of marginal farmlands supporting three small villages, and certainly no national reputation. One year later that two-county tract was bursting with 75,000 busy people and Oak Ridge, Tennessee was forever marked in the annals of American history.

In 1942, the United States Army Manhattan Engineering District selected tiny Oak Ridge as the site to construct a top secret nuclear energy center. Now referred to as "The Manhattan Project," those four plants refined uranium for the bomb dropped on Hiroshima on August 6, 1945.

That former wide spot in the road became high priority, and one of the best kept secrets of World War II. As the powerful facility opened, security was so stringent that the entire city of Oak Ridge was surrounded by a well-guarded fence. The nuclear sites themselves were separately fenced inside that perimeter, and non-residents traveling to Oak Ridge were required to pass high level scrutiny before they could be cleared to enter or leave the city.

Times were hard and spirits low as the war years wore on. Production at the top secret plants was a steady effort around the clock, with shifts coming and going at all hours. To ease the burden of long hours and hard work, the Army had built several recreational facilities nearby where workers could see movies, play ball and enjoy some hand-clapping entertainment.

Out of neighboring Knoxville came the country/gospel quartet



known as the Country Cut-Ups consisting of four singers and a piano accompanist. The group traveled repeatedly to perform for the folks at Oak Ridge, and perhaps because of the times, they found that gospel numbers headed their audience request lists. They gradually built their entire repertoire around southern style gospel music and became one of the most sought-after acts in the area. Local fans took them to heart and began calling the performers the Oak Ridge Quartet.

As the war ended the foursome disbanded. Very soon after, four other singers took up the name and settled in Nashville as the Oak Ridge Quartet.

Singing spots changed periodically, but a group act held together and in May, 1959, they began billing themselves as the Oak Ridge Boys. Personnel continued to be replaced as one member after another dropped out to pursue other ventures. Despite this, gospel remained their musical direction for some time.

William Lee Golden joined the Oak Ridge Boys in 1964 and is the present day Oak with the longest tenure. Duane Allen was invited into the group in 1966; Richard Sterban in 1972; Joe Bonsall in 1973. These four talented individuals followed the gospel traditions of their predecessors until May of 1977 when the Oak Ridge Boys caught country music fever and launched their current country/pop style.

The very first album released featuring this new vein of music was titled *Y'all Come Back Saloon*. It was certified gold and spawned three singles for the group — the title cut, "You're The One" and "I'll Be True To You."

Their next three albums also achieved gold status. They were: *Room Service*, *Oak Ridge Boys Have Arrived* and *Together*.

Some of the hit singles from these lps were: "Cryin' Again," "Come On In," "Sail Away," "Dream On," "Trying To Love Two Women," "Heart Of Mine" and "Beautiful You."

A greatest hits album, released in October, 1980, became the Oak Ridge Boys' first platinum album. The major breakthrough for them came with the release of *Fancy Free* in May of 1981. This album went double platinum



(platinum signifies sales of 1,000,000 or more) and established a permanent place in country and pop music for the Oak Ridge Boys.

The first single released from that album was titled "Elvira" and it not only tore up the country charts, but also became a major crossover hit on the pop charts. It went on to become a platinum success, an achievement that doesn't happen very often. In 1982, "Elvira" also went on to win a Grammy for the Oak Ridge Boys as "Best Country Performance by a Duo or Group."

About their music, Sterban believes that, "I think the music itself is always the bottom line. I believe that if we follow the policy we've maintained to this point, and that is to always record the best music we can possibly record, the best lyrics available to us from the best writers, if we maintain that policy there will always be a place for us in the music business."

They continued with that policy and scored in 1982 with two more album successes. They were *Bobby Sue* and *Oak Ridge Boys — Christmas*.

The Oak Ridge Boys Band is also an important part of the group's talent and popularity. They are: Skip Mitchell, lead guitar; Don Breland, bass guitar; Ron Fairchild, keyboard/rhythm guitar; Steve Sanders, rhythm guitar; Fred Satterfield, drums; Dewey Dorough, sax.

Sterban also points out that, "One of the things that has taken the Oak Ridge Boys to the plateau where we are now is that everything we've done has always been first class, whether we could

afford it or not. People who spend their hard-earned money to see the Oak Ridge Boys deserve to see a first class show.

Therefore, the Oaks put big money into a top-notch sound crew, a dynamite light company, and the best production people. Our lights and sound are a show in themselves. And we've got the greatest band that could possibly be put together — guys who don't just play, but guys who care.

"Put that together with the people we hire for concessions, and then you've got to carry all of the equipment in trucks...we run three buses and two trucks on the road. We feel that all of it is very necessary and all of our crew is very gung-ho Oak Ridge Boys. That's like first and foremost, and it's really an exciting thing to have everybody working together as a big team with one thing in mind — and that's to give the folks a great show."

The Oak Ridge Boys have tried their hands at several different types of entertainment. They have appeared on such television shows as "Dukes Of Hazzard," "NBC Magazine," "Entertainment Tonight," "Kenny Rogers Special," "Tonight Show" and "Don Kirshner's Rock Concert," to name a few.

According to Allen, "The business certainly takes in a wide variety — movies, television, video projects — all of those things. We're entertainers; we leave everything open."

Finally, as far as Bonsall is concerned, the Oak Ridge Boys are "just an old gospel quartet with a rock 'n' roll band singing country music." That just about says it all.
