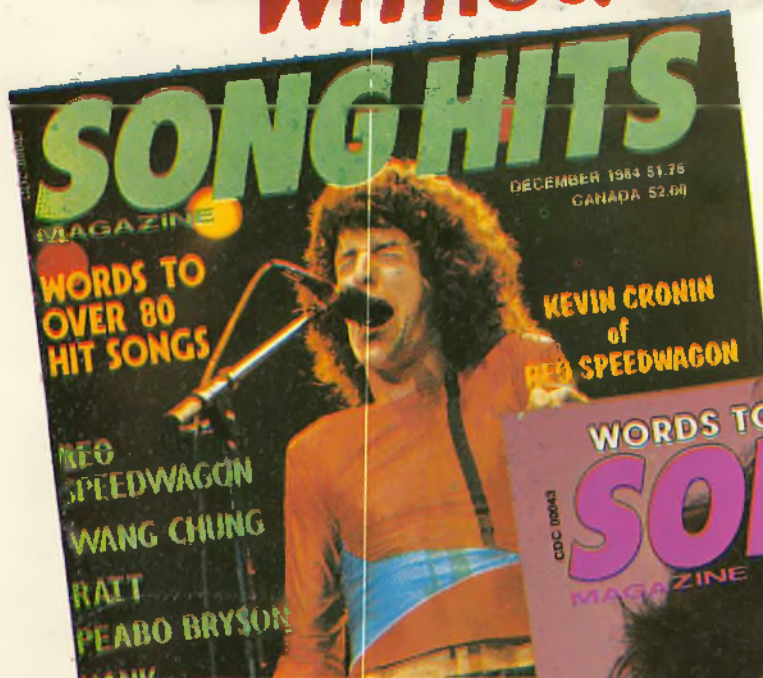

## \$\$\$ Under The Blade Twisted Sister Atlantic

While the band is scratching their collective heads trying to figure out how to top the success of the multi-platinum *Stay Hungry*, Atlantic Records has concocted an ingenious scheme: re-mix and re-release an album's worth of vintage Twisted material.

*Under The Blade* showcases original Twisted Sister material from the days when the band was covering Judas Priest and AC/DC songs in clubs up and down the Northeast. While paying their dues they were lucky to be able to sneak in a few of these originals (although the band was a big enough concert draw before their record contract to do a nearly all original

set). Included here is their first single, "I'll Never Grow Up" — from 1979.

Not as polished or as consciously commercial as *Stay Hungry*, *Under The Blade* displays the same tongue-in-cheek humor and mock rebellion that Dee Snider has purveyed into a career for the band. For the curious and the metal aficionado, *Under The Blade* is a must.

## \$\$ Shock The Motels Capitol

The Motels once promised to be "the next big thing." Martha Davis and her troupe of musicians played quirky West Coast new wave that was supposed to have an effect on the way we listened to

music. Another Chrissie Hynde of The Pretenders, or at least another Pat Benatar. And all we got was "Only The Lonely."

As far as pop ballads go, "Only The Lonely" is fine. But it isn't the statement The Motels had set themselves up for. That one big musical step to the right turned into a big ball of confusion. *Shock* does little to untangle the mess.

The dark and mysterious and sometimes avant-garde music from albums one and two is nowhere to be found on *Shock*. Wildly syn-copated rhythms have become slick horn charts and L.A. over-production. Over-produced and underwritten, *Shock* is anything but a surprise. Instead of the next big thing, we get a pop band with no apparent direction playing a jukebox full of non-hits. And it's one of those jukeboxes that often gets stuck on the same song.





## \$\$\$½ CRUSH

O.M.D.

Orchestral Manoeuvres In The Dark, who now call themselves O.M.D., have been around for a number of years crafting moody and romantic dance songs. *Crush* continues in that tradition.

From light, synthesized horn sounds and dirge-like drum machine effects, O.M.D. varies their arsenal of artificially produced sounds enough to keep the record from becoming monotonous. Martin Cooper's saxophone rounds out their sound with an optimistic accent.

"Women III" is the standout track. It's a song about a lady who succumbs to a humdrum suburban existence. The hopeless tone of the lyrics is overridden by the cheerful character of the instrumentation.

*Crush* follows in a long line of near-perfect O.M.D. records. It's likely that one day the band will break out of this mold of mere greatness.

## \$\$\$\$ Tina Turner Goes Country Playback Records

Since the release of the platinum-selling *Private Dancer* album, a whole new generation of music lovers discovered that Tina Turner can rock and roll with the best of them.

Now, thanks to Playback Records, a direct marketing label, fans of this sole survivor can enjoy *Tina Turner Goes Country*. This collection features 10 country gems performed in the inimitable Turner style.

Side one features the lady singing "Lay It Down," "Lovin' Him Was Easier," "Good Hearted Woman," "If This Is Our Last Time" and "Stand By Your Man." Considering what we know today about Tina Turner as an abused wife, listening to her sing these songs with true conviction tinges them with a sadness that suits the material perfectly.

Side two keeps up the pace set on the first side. "Freedom To Stay," "We Had It All," "Soul Deep," "If It's Alright With You" and a rousing version of Loretta Lynn's "You Ain't Woman Enough To Take My Man" round out this album.

No one will question the fact that the woman is a true survivor. Listening to *Tina Turner Goes*

*Country* this reviewer wondered who chose the songs on this lp. They are all heartbreak songs, telling stories of loves lost or love gone wrong. In short, it is the private dancer's private life in a nutshell. Make no mistake, it is not the Tina Turner of 1985, but the woman who several years ago was struggling to start all over again.

## \$ Fly On The Wall AC/DC Atlantic

Let's face it. AC/DC have shot their wad. From early metal anthems like "It's A Long Way To The Top" and "Big Balls" through the pop success of *Back In Black*, no one did it harder or better than AC/DC.

Brian Johnson may or may not possess the vocal talent of Bon Scott. Whichever side of the fence you sit on, there's little doubt that whatever voice he had is long gone. Angus still plays his ploddingly appealing leads, but there's little hope that he might come up with a refreshing lick or two.

Yet their lewdness has become more soporific than scintillating. What was once mischievous and fun has simply become routine and boring.

## \$\$\$\$ Greatest Hits Volumes I & II Billy Joel CBS

Although any collection of Billy Joel songs is a cause for celebration, I'd rather have a collection of Joel "B" sides than what's offered up here. An album with songs like "Miami 2017," "Stiletto" and "All For Leyna" would have made the perfect car-cruising cassette — which is what greatest hits' albums are all about.

*Greatest Hits Volumes I & II* boasts the same flaws as most collections. The major problem is a lack of cohesiveness. With Joel's penchant for borrowing from different influences for each of his albums, *Greatest Hits Volume I & II* suffers from the jukebox syndrome more acutely than other albums of the same ilk.

If you have most of his records there are two new recordings here. First is the close to perfect pop of "You're Only Human (Second Wind)" and one of Joel's best tunes ever, "The Night Is Still Young", which is a perfect piece of blue-eyed soul. If "The Night Is Still Young" is any indication of the direction Joel will take on his next record, then *Greatest Hits Volumes I & II* is the perfect stall.

## \$\$\$½ Back To The Future (Soundtrack) Various Artists MCA

The summer's most charmingly infectious movie boasts a soundtrack to match. With two songs by Huey Lewis and The News and one each by Eric Clapton and Lindsey Buckingham, it'd be tough to miss.

"The Power Of Love" is one of those pop tunes you start humming the moment you hear it. Even stronger is the play on words song "Back In Time." On this one, Huey sounds like he stopped in at the neighborhood bar to jam with some first rate musicians. Lewis is a tireless hit machine. Clapton's reggae injected "Heaven Is One Step Away" (produced by Phil Collins) shows us Slowhand in top form.

Side Two is a disappointment. "Johnny B. Goode" is the only highmark and if you hadn't seen the movie it would have to lose some of its spark. The rest turns out to be rock and roll soundtrack filler.

## \$\$ RFTW Ready For The World MCA

Barely veiled Prince imitators, you have to believe that these guys made their first paychecks playing Prince covers in the club circuit. Melvin Riley fancies himself as his majesty's voice. He and Gordon

Strozier share the duties replicating the "Let's Go Crazy" guitar riffs.

These guys have the Revolution down all the way to the synthesizer sounds. Side one boasts their own versions of "Purple Rain" and "Let's Go Crazy." The point is this. RFTW is probably a talented band that needs their own set of licks. If they had really gone to school on their Princely mentor, then they would've tried to come up with a cornucopia of different songs. As it stands the group is ready for the world, but not as themselves.

## \$\$\$ Expose Taxxi MCA

Getting warmer. That summarizes the latest effort from Taxxi. Their last record showed promise for an inexperienced band still looking for their own sound. *Expose* finds Taxxi closer to the mark.

"Still In Love", the lead track, is the unquestionable standout. "Who Knows Me" runs a close second. Both showcase the production talents of Tom Dowd and the vocal strengths of David Cumming. Nicky Hopkins (the only guy to play with the Stones, The Beatles and the Who) helps out on piano as does Night Ranger guitar ace Brad Gillis. Taxxi also gets help on bass from Randy Jackson on the album that puts the band one step closer to the perfect groove.

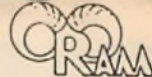

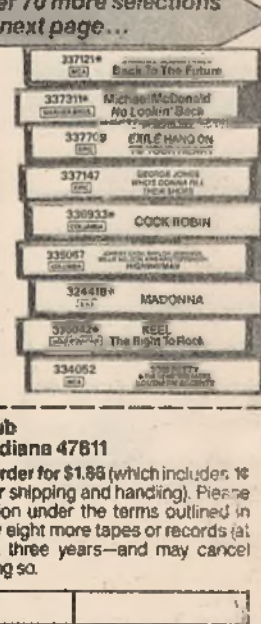

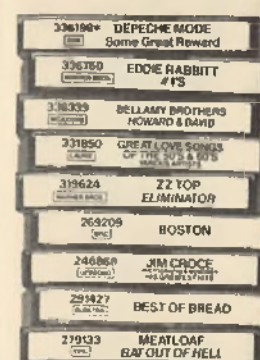

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# BRUCE SPRINGSTEEN

**H**e started the year off on a high note by winning his very first Grammy and as 1985 came to a close, Bruce Springsteen was still on an incredible high. It would come to be remembered as a year in which he enjoyed immense personal as well as professional success.

Add to his Grammy a number one album, a number one song, a brand new marriage and a sold-out "Born In The U.S.A. Tour" and Springsteen should be





quite satisfied with the past year.

In addition, Springsteen was featured singing a solo part for "We Are The World" as one of 46 entertainers calling themselves USA For Africa whose goal was to raise money for the famine-stricken people of Ethiopia.

He donated his time and talent willingly, later saying that "Any time somebody asks you to take one night of your time to help people who are starving to death, it's pretty

hard to say no.

"I think," he continued, "hunger in the world, in the United States as well, is such an abstraction to most people that trying to bring it closer, to make it more real, is something that has to happen. That's what this is all about."

Bruce was born on September 23, 1949, and was raised in Freehold, New Jersey. At the age of nine, he was saved, as were many members of his generation,

by music. He discovered Elvis, and his life was changed. He has been quoted as saying that "anybody who sees Elvis Presley and doesn't want to be like Elvis Presley has got to have something wrong with him." Springsteen tried to teach himself then and there, but was unable to handle the instrument, so he put it down. When he was 14, just as Beatlemania prepared to sweep America,

he picked it up again, this time forever.

Springsteen's parents went west soon after, but Bruce remained behind with his friends, living the standard '60s teenage life. He became a furious pinball fanatic, drooling over the Ronettes at the Brooklyn Paramount and spending hot summer nights experiencing the rits of sexual passage.

It was around this time that he also began playing music seriously, forming local bands like the Steel Mill (a loud, hard rock group), and Dr. Zoom and the Sonic Boom, in which friends would sit in, regardless of musical talent. Springsteen recalled that "someone would take a lead and we'd all fall down laughing." Another mixture of fledgling musicians was a 10 piece soul band that bore his name and included two members who would later be in Bruce's professional recording and performing band.

When he was 18, following a short stay at New Jersey Community College, Bruce played the Fillmore West in San Francisco, and auditioned for a local record company, which turned him down. He returned to New York and started doing the club circuit once more, both with his band and as a solo act. A friend introduced him to Mike Appel and Jim Cretecos, who became his managers and brought him to John Hammond at Columbia Records. After a brief presentation, which began with Bruce's rendition of his powerful "It's Hard To Be A Saint In The City," Bruce was put under contract to the company. The year was 1972.

One distinctive quality that Springsteen has is his ability to transform his experiences and environments, many of them seemingly unlikely musical material, into vivid compositions. Springsteen has come to be recognized as a street poet and he fashions art from what might be passed over as

hopelessly seedy.

His debut album on Columbia, *Greetings From Asbury Park, N.J.*, released in January 1973, was evidence of his talent. The lp contained a dazzling avalanche of rhymes and imagery that won Springsteen instant critical recognition as a singer/songwriter heir apparent.

But Springsteen's influences are less in the singer-composer mold than in the hot, blues and pop based records of the '50s and '60s, specifically Elvis; the large, percussion-crazy productions of Phil Spector; and urban rhythm and blues. Comparisons are generally misleading, but if Springsteen's music can be categorized after all these years, it can still be termed "Elvis meets Dylan under the boardwalk."

The combination of raw rock musicianship, narrative devices and unparalleled evocation of atmosphere came together again with tremendous force on the man's second album, *The Wild, The Innocent and The E Street Shuffle*. This lp was released in November, 1973. The songs contained on this effort revealed a cinematic sense of dramatic detail plus dynamic soul and Latin-tinged rock arrangements that showcased Springsteen's musical settings.

This lp received even more critical acclaim than *Greetings* and was, in fact, named one of the best albums of 1974 by Rolling Stone. It contained a series of vignettes — observations of characters and street life that added up to a strong, romantic yet unsentimental, personal vision.

The lp included "Rosalita," an inspired variation on a primal rock and roll theme; "Incident On 57th Street," on which Springsteen's dramatic sense is particularly evident; the moving "New York City Serenade" and the swirling "Kitty's Back." From this album, the Hollies,

who always had an ear for songwriting talent, recorded "4th Of July, Asbury Park (Sandy)," one of Bruce's most striking pieces of summer story-telling.

Next came *Born To Run*, the lp that established the man in the public eye as a major artist of our time. The title cut of this album quickly became the anthem for a generation, and today, 10 years later, it still holds up as an all-American classic. *Born To Run* fused the influences of such diverse artists as Phil Spector, Sam and Dave, Roy Orbison, Van Morrison and Bob Dylan into a form which even then could only be identified as pure Springsteen.

If Bruce's records have been raved about, live performances have sent normally cynical, somber critics to their thesauruses in search of new and appropriate superlatives. There truly is no more exciting live act in all of rock and roll than Bruce Springsteen and The E Street Band. In the past 10 years there has been only one change in personnel and that came when Steven Van Zandt left to go solo. Other than that, The E Street Band is: Clarence Clemons on saxophones, Max Weinberg on drums, Garry Tallent on bass, Roy Bittan on piano and Danny Federici on the organ. Nils Lofgren replaced Van Zandt.

No one will doubt that Bruce Springsteen can do it all. He can rip out a fiery guitar solo, sing with an urgency that seems to tear up his throat as it rips you to pieces, or get a crowd of people stomping and shouting. His single, "Born In The U.S.A." is yet another anthem that will be a classic for many years to come, as will the man himself.

The next hits to come from *Born In The U.S.A.* were "I'm On Fire" and "Glory Days," two more tunes that have carried on the hit-making Springsteen tradition.

# Katrina and the Waves

## "Walking On Newfound Success"

Interview by Rich Sutton

*"The climax of our career as a country band was when we were playing in this officer's mess on one of the U.S. bases. In this room where we were playing, there were these double doors through to the bar. There were three people in the room when we started playing and then 'Dallas' came on the TV in the bar. They got up, walked through to the bar, closed the double doors on us and sat down to watch 'Dallas!'"*

*Although their inauspicious beginning as a Holiday Inn style lounge band covering country standards might not have heralded a bright future, Katrina Leskanich and her Waves had a rowdy hit single with their perfect pop song "Walking On Sunshine." In addition, their debut American record, Katrina and The Waves, bubbles over with an infectious spirit and spunk.*

*The band was born in 1981 on a military base in England. Drummer Alex Cooper, bassist Vince De La Cruz and Katrina all got together by way of their families' nomadic habits. Along the way, Alex, Katrina and Vince met up with Kimberley Rew — a Cambridge graduate with a degree in archaeology. Although not in the Air Force, his father worked in the oil business and he also moved around quite a bit. The four musicians managed to stay in the same place together long enough to put out a couple of records in Canada, and an EP in Britain. The critical success they garnered from those records is what landed them their first record in the U.S.*

**Rich:** Let's start at the beginning.

**Katrina:** I was born in Kansas and then I moved right away 'cause my dad's in the Air Force. I lived in Georgia, Florida, Nebraska, Massachusetts, California, just moving around all the time. Then my parents wanted to move to Europe and we ended up in England where I've been for the past 10 years. I still have the American accent because I lived on or close to American Air Force bases and there were Americans all around. When you're an American and you're stationed in Europe they like to make you feel like you're still an American. You still get good ol' Uncle Sam there with his arm around you. They give you your bowling alley and your pizza parlor. They even fly the hamburgers over!

**RS:** Do you think that's a pretty normal upbringing?

**Katrina:** No, I don't think that was pretty normal. You meet somebody and then they're gone in a couple of months and you never get a chance to really build relationships with anyone. They're always picking up and going. That's the Air Force way of life. That's why this line of work is easy for me. Always picking up and going, meeting people that I'm sure I'll never see again.

**RS:** It's interesting that you describe what you do as your line of work rather than your "art" or your "craft".

**The Waves:** Oh yea, this is work. It's work, but it's work that we've consciously chosen. Like this stuff here, you can't be artistic about this, "well, I'm not in the mood for interviews, so I'm not going to do it." You have to take a business approach to it. In the performance is where we get to be artistic. We can think of a lot worse things to do. We think we're really lucky to be doing this. We won't say that on interview number 15 of the day!

**RS:** I'm probably number 131.

**Waves:** Yea, it's getting close — I'm feeling rowdy!

**RS:** Was it a conscious choice to play rock and roll versus say, country music?

**K and the Waves:** When I was 16 and I got in a band, it was just a normal thing to start doing rock. Vince was into that so he got me into that, but we had a country band and we were a cover band for a long time. Before we got together with Kim, I (Alex) got together with Vince and Katrina. We were called the Double E Country band — yeeee haaaa! We used to do the worst gigs. It was hilarious. We just did it for the money. We thought we were making pretty good money being a rock and roll band. That mighty good money was \$125.00! But back then we just split it four ways and that was it. I wish it was that easy now. You start getting somewhere in this business and you never see any money out of the gigs. Since we started progressing, things are getting out of hand. That money just goes into some bottomless pit.

**RS:** How do they explain that to you, when you say, "okay, where is my check?"

**Waves:** They don't have to. We know because we have all these people turning up that are looking after you, driving the coach for you and the piles of equipment that gets bigger. I think you must have to be huge to make money out of gigs. Even the Rolling Stones don't make money out of gigs. They just make money out of T-shirts and stuff like that. Somebody told me the other day that Duran Duran, since they were costing 16 dollars a ticket, that they averaged another 16 dollars a head with the merchandising. That's absolutely mad! That's about 40 bucks for one kid to go to a concert. It's a lot of money.

**RS:** Let's get to talking about the album. Tell me about "Mexico."

**Waves:** That was Vince's idea. He





wrote the song and his father is Mexican so he listens to Mexican music all of the time. It's really quite clever.

**RS:** What about "Walking On Sunshine?"

**Waves:** The song, like the record, has a lot to do with the production. Without it, the song wouldn't pop out of the radio like this one does, which amazes me. If you're a musician and you sit down and listen to the soundtrack, it's

total mayhem. It's bloody chaos. Rhythmically it's all over the place. Snare drums stopping and starting up again. It's chaos, but it's fun when we try to mime to it on the... on the... lip synch, I'm sorry, lip synch is the phrase in this country. Lip synch on the TV, we haven't a clue to what we're playing or singing!

**RS:** The band sounds like it has a pretty big smile on its collective faces. When you're doing most of your

songs, there's a real happy feel to it.

**Waves:** Yea, I think we do. That is an advantage. I always insist on Katrina and I having our weekly tantrum. Apart from that, it's fun for us. You see, we can't stand on the stage and be serious and say, "look, this is significant, look at the way I play my guitar, listen to these five million notes." It's boring and we can't actually do that anyway. So it's just turn it up and go for it. That's the only way we can do it. That's the only way we know how!

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# KISS

**L**ongevity is the ultimate achievement for all bands, and while quality music might seem a "given" in reaching that goal, there's more involved than a string of hits. That decisive factor, the fans, will easily excuse almost anything their idols do, but the self-destruction of any group is attitude problems. Cut a weak track and the fans will call it "a different sound". Give a less-than-sparkling show and they'll call it "a bad night." But tell those same people who put you where you are that you don't sign autographs, ignore their handshakes, or surround yourself with bodyguards whose idea of security is to throw your admirers against the wall, and it's a safe bet your record sales are destined for a downhill slide, and rightfully so. When Kiss' Paul Stanley says "We're there for the people and they're there for us. We only get back what we give," truer words were never spoken. Their track record agrees.

After completing their immensely successful *Animalize* tour, Eric Carr, Bruce Kulick, Gene Simmons and Paul Stanley finished work on the 20th Kiss album, *Asylum*. During the early part of 1985, however, while still on the road, Paul Stanley took time to reflect on the Kiss legacy and predict a continuous healthy future for the group whose philosophy he defines as, "Be independent, follow your heart, and know that if you can dream it, you can do it!"

The inception of Kiss was the result of an uneventful meeting between Stanley and Gene Simmons via a mutual friend. Despite their basic disinterest in one another, a shot at participating on a third party's demo was the beginning of a partnership that became the short-lived Wicked Lester. After recording and shelving an album, Stanley and Simmons sought out new blood. An ad in *Rolling Stone* brought them to Peter Criss. As a trio they created classics like "Strutter" and "Black Diamond." Fifty auditions later, guitarist Ace Frehley rounded out the group.

"The music scene at the time," Stanley explains, "was a decadent cross between Berlin in the late 1930's and Liverpool in the late 1960's. New York was in the midst of the Dolls and that type of thing. We started promoting ourselves because no one else wanted us. I did newspaper ads and the four of us went around and posted up fliers at night so no one could see we were doing it ourselves. We would set up our equipment before we went on stage so no one could see us doing that ourselves. I remember when we had immense stacks of amps with no speakers because we wanted to look cool. We made our own clothes because we didn't have the money to buy any. We threw dances, built a following. We were the guys in the audience who never saw what we wanted on stage, so we did it ourselves. If there's ever been a magic about Kiss, it's that everything happened so naturally,

like the makeup. We sat in front of a mirror one night and said, 'Let's wear makeup.' Everything fell into place, without question. Kiss never used the word can't — we just went ahead."

A self-promoted 1973 concert at the Hotel Diplomat captured the attention of invited guest Bill Aucoin, who reportedly secured them a record deal within two weeks and assumed their management. Kiss was released in February, 1974, and although initial response to their intense theatrics and character makeup was, according to Stanley, "a hall full of snickers and chuckles," the group "always ended up getting two or three encores. There's no substitute for energy, sweat, and determination, and we had all three in abundance. We were like an unstoppable tank. Once everyone is giving their all, you just can't put a halt to it."

As the strength of their music and visuals increased, so did their audience. Kiss became the dominant music force of the 1970's, breaking ground in the area of live performance, and releasing a succession of million-selling albums. They were featured in every magazine and newspaper; made radio and television headlines. Their fans, organized officially as The Kiss Army, marched in record numbers around the world. The phenomenon reached unheard of levels, and inevitably, the group was subject to over-exposure. But their determination and perseverance enabled Kiss to beat the odds that critics had stacked against them, without ever compromising their values.

The departure of Peter Criss in 1979 was quickly followed by the introduction of Eric Carr. A few years later, a serious automobile accident forced Ace Frehley into temporary seclusion and Vinnie Vincent stepped in. Meanwhile, additional surprises were in the works. Following a quiet period in the U.S., Kiss landed a new record deal in 1983, exposed themselves for the first time without makeup, and unleashed *Lick It Up*. As their stronghold on rock and roll tightened again, Vincent parted ways. Mark St. John entered for *Animalize*, a blistering vinyl attack that again volleyed Kiss directly to the top of the rock hierarchy. However, as

they prepared for a European tour, St. John was incapacitated by a form of arthritis diagnosed as Reiter's Syndrome. Former Blackjack guitarist Bruce Kulick was called in. Stanley notes, "We had to go to Europe after *Animalize* came out and Mark couldn't even move his fingers. But we had to keep going. So I called Bruce — I had known him for years — to rehearse and tour. When we got to the States, we rehearsed with Mark. He was with us the first two weeks, then he had to go home, so we asked Bruce to stay. Kiss is too strong as a self-propelled entity to stop for any reason. It's an ideal, a philosophy, a way of looking at life and playing music. Everyone in this group is famous because of Kiss, not the other way around."

He continues, "The goal was never to have a six million-selling album, then everybody say 'Who?' We've been in it for the long run. If we were a museum piece touring on our past, I'd stay home. The only reason we continue is because what we do now is real good and what we will do in the future will be real good. We're a better band, better performers, and we get clearer and clearer as far as what we want to do and how to do it. We've always believed from the beginning in what we did, and we're proof that believing in yourself is the key." He observes, "There's more to living than television and a six-pack, and opportunities are limitless. People who say you can't are those who have failed. The important thing is to listen to your heart."

"What we initially brought, and still do," he reflects, "is devotion and a real commitment. When we first came out, audiences had been led to believe that bands, so-called 'artistes' were doing them a favor by bestowing their 'talents' on them and that was enough. Kiss cut through that. Now, bands are expected to give more because audiences have seen so much. For all that snickering at the start — Kiss is largely responsible for upgrading audiences' expectations and standards of what they deserve. We make sure every person is treated like this is our first show and they are the most important person — because they are."

"We're like McDonald's", Stanley observes. "'Over 50 billion served'. Only we can add, 'and everyone satisfied!'"

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# Book Review

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## **Chameleon: The Boy George Story** by Sally Brompton Hippocrene Books, Inc., 1985 Oversize paperback/\$9.95

This 155-page book is a must-read for any Boy George fan. From his birth on June 14, 1961 in southeast London, to the tremendous success he enjoys today, author Sally Brompton goes back into George's past and talks candidly with his mother, his father and a score of other people who were part of the same scene.

George's teen-age years were an incredible kaleidoscope of fashion trend-setting. If he hadn't become a pop singer, he probably would have become a fashion designer. This book reveals how, at a very young age, George had the ability to win over people of all ages. This is no doubt partly responsible for his tremendous success. He managed to break down all the barriers and the result was mass acceptance by a wide audience.

This book also pulls no punches about George's sexuality. With no pretensions, it discusses his early relationships and a confrontation with his parents concerning his preferences.

Another interesting aspect to this book is how closely George's life followed the London music scene through its different stages. The London fashion scene, and later the music scene, was practically formed around George and his friends. The more outrageous, the better, seemed to be their motto.

It becomes clear that music was never George's goal. However, he had his first stage experience with the band BowWowWow, and ended up staying with them for three months.

Halfway through the book, Culture Club takes shape: Mikey Craig, Jon Moss and Roy Hay join ranks with George. Their first record was "White Boy," released in May, 1982. Their second was "I'm Afraid Of Me," and was released in June, 1982.

By November of that year, "Do You Really Want To Hurt Me" was at the top of the British charts and ended up selling more than seven million copies worldwide. Culture Club was on its way, led by the very talented Boy George O'Dowd.

The book charts their course through their first album, *Kissing To Be Clever*, which sold nearly five million



copies, and established them as more than a one-hit band. It then follows them as they roared through North America, taking the country by storm and charting hit after hit along the way.

Toward the end, this book slows down a bit, but the excellent photos more than make up for this. *Chameleon: The Boy George Story* lets the reader take a peek at the man behind the myth, and the result is an interesting, well-written story of George's life up to this point.

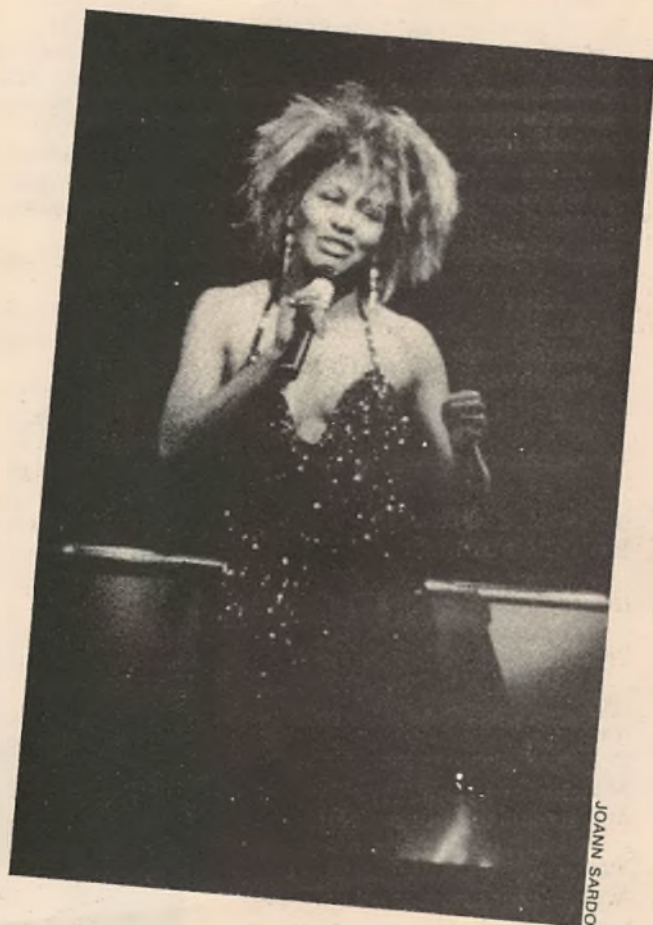

Following this, she broke into the autobiographical "I Might Have Been Queen," which is a song that no other entertainer can relate to as much as this woman. "River Deep, Mountain High" and "Nutbush City Limits" are standards that this woman has been singing for nearly 20 years.
