RADIO STATS

OUR RELATIVE CHARTING, AS SEEN BELOW, RESEMBLES BASEBALL'S BATTING AVERAGES. IT ESTABLISHES A RATIO BETWEEN THE IDEAL, (HEAVY AIRPLAY AT EVERY STATION WHICH REPORTED), AND THE WEIGHTED COUNT THAT A RECORDING HAS ACTUALLY EARNED. THIS MATHEMATICAL FORMULA IS APPLIED TO EACH RECORD—FIRST REGIONALLY, THEN NATIONALLY. A DUAL WEIGHTING SYSTEM IS USED TO DERIVE THE COUNT. IT ADJUSTS FOR MARKET SIZE AND FOR HEAVY OR MODERATE AIRPLAY. THESE CHARTS SHOW THE RELATIVE INTENSITY OF RADIO AIRPLAY FOR BOTH NEW AND ESTABLISHED RECORDINGS.

Reviewer's Reaction: Bob Seger has been around. Although he is a relatively new figure to most of the country, he has been a rock 'n' roll hero in Michigan (especially downtown Ann Arbor) for a decade. Seger's fans here could never understand why his magnetic music was ignored elsewhere. Seger has finally achieved multiple platinum success and ironically the vehicle, on vinyl anyway, has been pop-rock ballads like "Night Moves" and "Still the Same" that have reached the millions that never picked up on his brand of primal rock and roll. The live "Silver Bullet" show since 1976 attempts to strike a balance between the "old time rock and roll" with its stirring synthesis of Chuck Berry style guitar and Motown soul with the more recent L.A. influenced pop-rock. Judging from the audience reaction to the show, Bob was able to please almost all of his fans, even the oldtimers. Because Seger writes expressive lyrics with catchy melodies, has a pleasant baritone vocal style, possesses a sincere good-vibes aura, and in the Silver Bullet Band has one of the great working rock and roll bands, the show was a smash. Among mainstream American rock & rollers, only Bruce Springsteen's E St. Band presently eclipses this wonderful appreciation.

THE NINTH ANNUAL EATING CROW FOR CHRISTMAS

Each year we go back to correct injustices done by our reviews in the 12 preceding months. Overrated Lp's are not now panned. We relisten to only those we feel we may have wronged. The criteria for choosing albums to re-review isn't well structured. Anything might lead to a re-review...hate mail, hate phone calls, a contributor's subtle remark indicating something obscene about our ears...things like that and our own reflection, adding the wonderful help of hindsight. This year's pile of ego deflators were all given a fair relisten. Of those chosen the following re-evaluations represent the Lp's which we feel were wrongly reviewed the first time through. The revisions range from minor to embarrassing. Finally, we apologize to those artists who we wronged by underrating their effort and we apologize to those radio stations who we may have misled. Naturally, we resolve to make no errors in judgment next year.

George Benson/WEEKEND IN L.A./Warner Bros. ZWB 3139
(We were very positive about this Lp but not forceful enough. Because of the combination of performance and material this Weekend In L.A. was better than average. It should have been elevated to Merit Plus status.)

Cheap Trick/HEAVEN TONIGHT/Epic JE 35312 (Our review noted the dynamic performance of Cheap Trick, but belittled the writing as average. That was plainly incorrect. Melodically, each song holds up to repeated listening, and lyrically they are one of the stronger rockers around. They have a sense of humor too. Merit Plus.)

Art Garfunkel/WATERMARK/Columbia JC 34975 (Being very sensitive to overly sweetened music lead us to place this album in the fringe category. Although its beauty was duly noted, placing it in the back of the Lp listings tends to undervalue the loveliness of Art's work. It is soft by rock standards, but in no way should Watermark be thought to be sweetened to reach a broader audience. The album is the natural reflection of the artist and as such should have been in the Merit Plus category. Sorry.)

Nicolette Larson/Warner Bros. BSK 3243 (Our original review recognizes the real qualities of Nicolette's album. But, the hesitation which interfered with rating the Lp higher than Merit was hidden. The thought of another Ronstadt clone, even a more than reasonable facsimile, was bothersome. Based on the album alone, Nicolette deserved better.)

Little River Band/SLEEPER CATCHER/Harvest SW-11783
(Though they tend to soften beyond what is necessary, The Little River Band offers high level writing uniformly through this album. The performance is crisp and clean and the Lp is a Merit Plus record not a Merit record.)

Bob Marley & The Wailers/KAYA/Island ILPS 9517 (Making the Kaya album a Merit Lp is a case of a critic getting influenced by circumstances beyond the music. Reggae's decline commercially probably affected our perception of this fine musical Lp. Any other artist who delivered an album as consistent in its song quality and performance quality would have been in the Merit Plus category. Whether or not radio or the marketplace would have supported it, we should have recognized it.)

Marshall Tucker Band/TOGETHER FOREVER/Capricorn CPN-0205
(This album flows so effortlessly that it should have gotten more credit from us. The band has been at the top of the Southern genre for a long time and it shows it in this confident, consistent package. Merit Plus.)

Pat Metheny Group/ECM 1114 (We are all conditioned to ECM albums. The label is on the cutting edge with its advocates and its detractors. Everyone recognizes the label's unparalleled conceptual unity and everyone marvels at their consistent execution of the concept. The detractors note the coldness, the detached intellectualization of the music which ECM represents. That is our prejudice and it interfered with our judgement of this album. Metheny's music is as emotional and inspired as it is intellectually challenging and we should have recognized that immediately. Merit Plus at a minimum.)

CONCEPTS

EATING CROW FOR CHRISTMAS CONTINUED

Gerry Rafferty/CITY TO CITY/United Artist UA LA 840-G
Well, the sentiment was correct. We went on about the quality of the songs and harmonious performance. But, for reasons lost in time, we hedged in making Gerry's Lp one of a group of Merit Plus albums. It should have been placed in the Strongly Meritorious section without any hesitation.)

Rolling Stones/SOME GIRLS/Rolling Stones COC 39108
Obviously Some Girls was a Special Mention album. We had singled it out as a Strongly Meritorious Lp but that was not enough. Actually, we were, and remain, out of practice. By elevating the Stones Lp to the Special position now, we will be doing it for the first time and only time in 1978.)

Styx/PIECE OF EIGHT/RCA SP 4124 (Styx stands with Kansas at the top of the orchestral rock world, more highly evolved and evolved than Emerson, Lake & Palmer, Yes, Starcastle and Crack The Sky. We should have recognized that on first bounce. Fine songs and powerful presentation were mentioned, but not valued highly enough. It probably results from a prejudice against this style forged by the other bands, but which shouldn't have been applied here. Merit Plus.)

10cc/BLOODY TOURISTS/Polydor PD 1-6161 (The whole thrust of our original 10cc review was off. We claimed that it wasn't the same with the missing cc's. But, the fact is that it isn't much different. Certainly the presentation is still very strong and interesting. They take chances. What is much worse, however, is that our review omitted the mention of "Dreadlock Holiday" as a great song. We knew it immediately, honest. Merit Plus is a more correct rating for the Lp.)

Jeff Wayne's WAR OF THE WORLDS/Columbia PC 2 35290 (We rightly raved on about this album, but we did it in the Special Programming category. Jeff's album is too good to have let it get swept away. It should have borne the Strongly Meritorious banner.)

- John Coates, Jr./AFTER THE BEFORE/Omni-Sound N-1521
(His pleasing harmonic style makes a solo piano lp by John Coates, Jr. a treat. He is light on energy by comparison to a Jarrett or Corea, but he holds his own with appealing melodies. Write: Delaware Water Gap, Pa. 18327.)
- Dobie Gray/MIDNIGHT DIAMOND/Infinity INF-9001 (A collection of great songs makes this Dobie Gray lp the best he has ever made. Rick Hall's production sweetening moves this lp just outside our bounds, but has created a mighty pop album. Too good to completely ignore.)
- Richard Groove Holmes/DANCING IN THE SUN/Versatile M50 6604
(A weak mix on the drum kit gives the album an anemic feeling. The lounge jazz of Groove Holmes is more background than foreground in nature. The only track that has something of an edge to it is "Calypso Holiday.")
- Roland Hanna With George Mraz/SIR ELF PLUS 1/Choice CR1 1018
(Hanna is most comfortable in a slow, reflective tempo. His mellow music finds a place behind your life. Your choices tend to reach back in time.)
- Lee Konitz/TENORLEE/Choice CRS 1019 (Lee Konitz is capable of blowing the roof off. Here he retreats to a thoughtful, melancholy place probably due to the loss of a close friend as noted in the dedication. His soft-focus horn breathes pathos.)
- Lulu/DON'T TAKE LOVE FOR GRANTED/Rocket BML 1-3073 (Lulu returns to disc with a compact, classy pop music album. Good tunes and her lovely voice mix nicely.)

(Side one's title song is plainly disco. However, Moroder has established his rock influences before and he does so again on side two. "Evolution" has a big guitar and melody in addition to the big beat.)

- Michael Gregory Jackson/CHARITY/Bija MJ-1000 (Clarity is at the intersection of clarity and avant obscurity. It flip-flops in and out of this plane and the never-never-land. There are lessons in ensemble harmonizing here. Other players include Oliver Lake, David Murray and Leo Smith.)
- Angel Romero/VIRTUOSO WORKS FOR GUITAR/Angel R-37112
(Classical guitar solos have marvelous production possibilities in album radio. As backgrounds and transitions they have been little explored. Angel is one of the emerging giants of the classical guitar. His precision play is remarkable.)

- Tom Lewis/ON THE OTHER HAND.../Sirey SRE 1-8 (His most significant contribution is style-injected arrangements. With Tom's good writing, they result in consistent enjoyment. A few tunes are terrific and a few get too tricky. Merit.)
- Phillip Innes Ltd./Virgin V 1114 (Stumpy Innes took a lesson from this post-punk group. Phillip Innes Ltd. The style remains, but it is packaged in a Beatles-more casual context. Delight power. Merit.)
- Blade/ALIVE FOR THE BORN/Star 2114 106 (The artist. Blade hasn't been around for a few years. The U.S. portion of this lp was recorded in 1976. Power-packed. Blade's skinhead rock was nothing next to the punk which was to come. Pretty good tunes. Merit.)

MERIT PLUS ALBUMS

(All Merit and Merit Plus Albums are recommended for serious progressive radio consideration, recognizing that not all of these recommendations are suitable for all stations. The Merit Plus Albums distinguish themselves with an extra vitality.)

Albert Collins/ICE PICKIN'/Alligator AL 4713 (A powerful, roadhouse blues guitarist Albert Collins stomps it. His kind of basic music is the basis for 90% of the rock guitar solos we hear. This is a top-notch recording of the man. Write: Box 60234, Chicago, Ill. 60660.)

Doobie Brothers/MINUTE BY MINUTE/Warner Bros. BSK 3193 (A typical Doobie Brothers album spins out of Minute By Minute. Super rhythm ties it together with a whiplash snap. A few fine songs highlight it. The rest of the songs benefit from the strong performances.)

Michael Mantler/MOVIES/Watt 7 (Movies is another strong Michael Mantler album. Though Mantler's repetition was made in new music circles, his current music is quite accessible. Here with Carla Bley, Larry Coryell, Steve Swallow and Tony Williams he shows us how-to again.)

Rod Stewart/BLONDES HAVE MORE FUN/Warner Bros. BSK 3261 (A mix which places Rod's voice deep inside becomes an annoyance. But, the songs are characteristically strong. The mix seems to be an effort to avoid repetition album-to-album. Like the Stone's, Rod shows a disco consciousness. The message is clear. Better than the average, but this is not a great Stewart. Side 2 tails off.)

MERIT ALBUMS

Marvin Gaye/HERE, MY DEAR/Tamla T 364 LP2 (Not particularly an R&B album, Here, My Dear seems to be truly reflective of the pain Marvin went through in an unsuccessful marriage. Much of the album, the whole of side 3, floats around looking for a place to be. Isn't that the feeling one has when in the after-limbo of an affair? Sides 2&4 emerge from the meloncholy, blue funk of the other two sides. This Lp is going to touch people.)

Chuck Kruger/WINDY & WARM/Sail 0103 (Jazzy. Chuck Kruger's music is windy and warm and it is also mellow. His style derives from the 40's and, with several of Chuck's well written songs, it finds its mark. There is a real talent inside this partially finished project.)

Lloyd McNeill/TORI/Baobab No. 2 (McNeill's flute rides a rhythm bed created by the likes of Buster Williams (bass), Howard Johnson (tuba), Dom Un Romao (percussion), and Nana (percussion). Still, it is Lloyd's melodic strength which unifies and resolves this album. Dist. by JCOA, 6 W. 95th Street, New York, N.Y. 10025.)

Various Artists/JAZZSTARS IN CONCERT/Milestone M-55006 (Truly a democratic affair, this album manages to feature each celebrity player individually and it still holds together. McCoy and Sonny and Ron and Al Foster are a formidable unit. Musical and lengthy.)

Andrew White/LIVE IN NEW YORK/Andrew's Music AM-31 (The legacy of Coltrane and Coleman is strongly felt in Andrew's music. Intensity is built-in until the second side when White changes up with the Stevie Wonder ballad "Easy Goin' Evening." His saxophone whines. Dist. by JCOA, 6 W. 95th Street, New York, N.Y. 10025.)

SATISFACTORY ALBUMS

(Albums of acceptable quality, which, of themselves, require only secondary progressive radio application.)

Pat Wells/HOMETOWN LADY/Sail 0102 (Pat Wells' Hometown Lady is a very pleasant local album. She is a decent writer and singer, but in this context she is limited. A lack of dynamic arranging and playing stifles her. A good demo. Dist. by Rounder.)
