# VINTAGE TELEVISION

## The Philco Predictas

By the late 50's, three major television manufacturers dominated the U.S. television market – RCA, Zenith and Philco, and each was looking for a way to increase its share of the consumer business. RCA was investing heavily in color technology which it had introduced a few years earlier. Zenith was offering a hand-wired chassis and enjoyed a favored position among independent dealers and service shops. Philco's strategy for the 60's was to revolutionize the black & white television industry, and that strategy resulted in some of the most unusually styled television receivers ever produced – the Philco Predictas.

Philco's engineers and designers produced a remarkable television receiver – "TV today from the world of tomorrow." Most Predictas featured radically different cabinet styles in which the picture tube was mounted on top of or separate from the cabinet rather than integral to the cabinet; see Figure 1.

Whether you are a casual collector, just want one for your collection or you are a "Predicta junkie" and have to have one of each model, you'll find that they are fun to collect and restore. This article will provide you with some information about the various models of Predictas and will give you some tips on restoration.

### THE HOLIDAY MODEL

In 1958, Philco introduced the Holiday (Model G4242) for the 1959 sales year; see Figure 2. The Holiday was a success as it was heavily promoted, and many of the sets were sold; thus, many of the Holiday models are around for collectors today. The set was available in a mahogany (M) finished cabinet priced at \$259.95 and in a blond oak (L) finished cabinet priced at \$269.95. A brass-plated stand and a UHF tuner were offered as options. Apparently, not too many of the UHF tuner options were sold because it is rare to find a set today with a UHF tuner.

The picture tube is mounted in a strap cradle

on top of the wooden cabinet which houses the 9L37 chassis. A plastic shroud covers the rear of the picture tube, and a plastic mask covers the front; the entire picture tube assembly can be swivelled to suit the position of the viewer. All of the metal trim pieces are brass-plated, and the result is an attractive television receiver which was initially successful for Philco.

### THE '59 FLOOR MODEL




Figure 3. A '59 Floor Model Predicta, Model G4654M.

One of the most unusual appearing Predictas is the '59 floor model (model G4654); see Figure 3. It was also introduced by Philco late in 1958 and features a 21" picture tube assembly mounted on top of a pedestal which is flat in the front and rounded in back, all supported by three stubby little legs.

Choice of finishes on the wooden pedestal included mahogany (M), walnut (W) and blond oak (L). A UHF tuner was available as an option. The 9L37 chassis is the same one used in the Holiday; and it is mounted vertically, wedged in

## THE TANDEM MODEL

Another radical design by Philco's engineers was evidenced in the Tandem (model G4710); see Figure 4. This set features a separate 21" picture tube and control unit connected by a cable. This allowed the viewer to set the picture tube anywhere he pleased within the limits of the cable. The particular Tandem pictured in Figure 4 was originally used in a tavern in Wisconsin. The bartender kept the control unit behind the bar so that he could select and adjust the picture, and the picture tube was set on a shelf on the wall where the patrons could enjoy "The Honeymooners" and Milton Berle.

The Tandem, introduced in 1958, was available in a mahogany (M) finish for \$329.95 and in a blond oak finish for \$339.95. The cable connecting the picture tube and control unit which houses the 9L38 chassis is 25-feet long, 1 3/4" wide and 5/16" thick. It consists of 17 wires which carry power, high voltage, vertical and horizontal signals, remote speaker wiring and video signals. To compensate for loss of video signal in the 25-foot cable, Philco's engineers

between the pedestal support posts.

It was an expensive television set – \$449.95 for the mahogany model and \$459.95 for the blond oak model. In 1988 dollars, you would have to spend \$1854.41 to purchase a G-series Predicta floor model with a blond oak cabinet!

## Philco Predictas - Restoraton Hints

In May 1958, Philco notified its dealers that the new "G" line of TV chassis was being released. By July 1959, the 9L35, 9L35U, 9L37, 9L38, and 9L38A chassis (the "9" signifies 1959 sets; a "U" suffix indicates UHF tuner) were announced. The 9L37 was used in a wooden tabletop Predicta, the 9L38 chassis in a two-piece Tandem Predicta, and the 9L38A in a Tandem Predicta which could connect to an auxiliary audio amplifier and stereo phonograph. The Predictas are easily identified by the swivel or remote 21-inch CRT's (a special short-length tube #SF21A/21EAP4). Another interesting console (which used the 9L60 chassis) was introduced at the same time – the Miss America with pop-up tuner.

Philco's 1960 "H" line of TV's included additional Predictas. The 10L43 chassis was featured in a new line of metal-bodied tabletops with 17" picture tubes. The earliest 17" sets used a 17DAP4; later sets used a 17DRP4. Some of the metal sets included an alarm clock which activated the TV for a preset period of time.

By 1962, the Predictas were a major flop; many of the remaining sets were sold at bargain prices to hotel chains. What turned the public and dealer off to this TV which Philco billed as "the repairman's loaf of bread"? Talk to most repairmen who still remember the Predictas, and you'll speak to people that hated the funny looking, cyclops-styled sets. There are a variety of internal and external flaws which contributed to their demise.

If you decide to restore a Predicta, note that most wooden Predictas have major vertical problems; the vertical integrator, all vertical capacitors, and usually the vertical tube should be replaced. The electrolytic capacitors in the low voltage supply are suspect, and check the coupling capacitors which lead to the picture tube. The diodes, thermistor, and fusible resistor are often burnt, plus many high voltage transformers (flybacks) are melted.

If you make it through all that, don't be surprised if the picture tube shows a metallic or silvery image – the first stages of tube

mounted a video amplifier stage in the picture tube housing. The base of the picture tube unit has a remote speaker connector for those people

who find it disconcerting to have the video and audio coming from different areas of the room.

Philco produced another version of the Tandem (model G4720) which, in addition to the television receiver, provides a four-watt high fidelity amplifier, a good quality six-inch woofer and an electrostatic tweeter. It was intended to be used with the matching G1606S high fidelity phonograph consolette for stereo reproduction.

#### INSIDE THE G-SERIES

The picture tube originally provided in all of the Philco G-series televisions was the 21EAP4 which was especially designed by Philco to be short from front-to-back (12 15/16 inches), and this was accomplished by designing a new electron gun and deflection yoke for a 110 degree deflection tube. The 21EAP4 was notoriously bad. The 2.36 volt filament was weak and tended to burn out easily, and the newly designed cathode lost emission and caused the picture to go dim after about six months of operation. It is estimated that the picture tubes had to be replaced in about 50% of the sets under warranty. Until this fiasco with the 21EAP4's, Philco enjoyed a good reputation for producing quality sets, but the problems with the picture tubes signalled the end of the Predicta line just as it was starting to be successful.

In 1960, RCA began manufacturing the 21FDP4 picture tube which was used as a replacement for the 21EAP4. The 21FDP4 fixed the problems caused by the Philco tube but came too late to help fix Philco's reputation. The 21EAP4 has a 2.36 volt, 600ma. filament, and the 21FDP4 has a 6.3 volt, 600 ma. filament; if you substitute, you have to add a jumper across one

burnout. Plus, the picture tubes have a 2.35 volt, 600ma filament, and the tube is very short, making substitution nearly impossible. Take heart, the metal-bodied line of Predictas generally are easier to repair. It seems the 17-inch sets were designed a little bit better.

Now that you have finally gotten it working, what else might these futuristic wonders have in store? Cosmetics can also be a headache. Knobs are often missing; the trim ring around the picture tube might have been removed by someone hoping to clean the tube, and never replaced; also, the front plastic might be cracked or chipped. Don't strip that pretty mahogany set; the finish was painted on. If you have a wooden Predicta with an area that needs restoration, you'll need to paint it. . . carefully. The metal sets often rust; again, touch-up paint is the best thing to try. The plastic front plate can be removed and then cleaned and buffed. Now's the time to clean the dirt from the picture tube face. With patience, the trim ring and spring go back onto the CRT shell.

Philco's advertising and publicity never really told the whole story. They showed the two-piece Tandem Model, but never mentioned the huge cord, over 20-feet long, which would lay exposed in your living room. They featured their new printed circuit boards, but didn't mention the metal shield just below the soldered side, making it nearly impossible to unsolder any component. They complimented themselves on the design of an ultra-short picture tube, but didn't acknowledge that the special purpose tube would be hard to replace.

Even with all these problems, the sets look great, a combination of the Space Age, the Fabulous Fifties and the Danish modern look of the sixties - all rolled into one! Poorly received in its time, the Predicta now turns heads faster than most designer chairs from the period. And, after some hard labor of restoration, you can sit back and watch TV on it. Re-runs of "Leave It To Beaver" and "The Moonwalkers" somehow look better on a Predicta. So, buy yourself three or four, and start fixing!

of the resistors in the filament string.

Sixteen tubes are used in the G-series chassis in a rather conventional design for 1958. No power transformer is used so the filaments are wired in a series string, and B+ is generated by a capacitor-input voltage doubler circuit. Printed circuit boards are used for the IF strip and the VOS (Video-Oscillator-Sound) section.

The G-series chassis was difficult to service and was generally despised by radio-TV repairmen. To replace a fuse, tube or pilot lamp, the back of the set had to be removed, all of the knobs had to be pulled, and the chassis had to be unbolted and slid out. In order to remove the VOS printed circuit board to repair it, 27 wire-wrap connections had to be disconnected and then soldered when the board was replaced.

#### THE SEVENTEENERS




Figure 5. Two Predicta Seventeeners. A Model H3410V Princess with console stand on left and a Model UH3408C Debutante on right. Note the UHF tuner knob on the Debutante.

In 1959, Philco introduced the Seventeener decorator series for the 1960 sales year which included the Siesta, Princess and Debutante sets; see Figure 5. From a Philco ad: "It's a new era in Tele-fashion with decorator-inspired styling accented in dramatic colors." These sets feature a 17" picture tube on top of a painted metal cabinet which houses the 10L43 chassis. All models came with a console table and could be set on a table as well. A UHF tuner was an extra option on all Seventeener models and like the Holiday, it's unusual to find a Seventeener with a UHF tuner.

The Siesta (Model H3412) was provided with a

built-in clock mounted directly above the channel selector which can be programmed to turn the set on and off at designated times. Color choices for the Siesta were gold (GL) and beige (L). The Princess (model H3410) was identical to Siesta without the clock and was available in three colors - vermilion (V), beige (L) and mahogany (M).

Both the Siesta and Princess models have a perforated metal front grille and two brass-plated picture tube assembly support arms. Philco's low-end set was the Debutante (Model H3408) which came with a cloth front grille and without the picture tube support arms. The Debutante was only available in a charcoal brown (C) color and sold for \$199.95.

In 1961, Philco manufactured another cost-reduced Seventeener which was sold only to motels. It was an attempt to use up excess inventory, and the set is similar to the Debutante without the built-in antenna and some of the brass-plated trim pieces.

#### THE '60 FLOOR MODEL

Late in 1959, Philco introduced the '60 floor model (Model H4730); see Figure 6. It features a 21" picture tube mounted on top of a rectangular cabinet which houses a 10L43 chassis. The wooden cabinet is supported by a set of Danish modern legs, and the ensemble represents the most attractive of all the Predictas. Choice of finishes for this model were mahogany (M) and walnut (W). A UHF tuner was available as an option.

For collectors, this model is the rarest. It was manufactured at the end of the Predicta era, and few units were produced.

### INSIDE THE H-SERIES

Early versions of the Seventeen series used a 17DAP4 picture tube, and the later units used a 17DRP4 picture tube; both of these picture tubes proved to be more reliable than the 21EAP4. The two 17" tubes are not directly interchangeable since they require different centering magnet assemblies. If you swap picture tubes, make sure that you swap yoke assemblies also. The picture tube used in the floor model is a 21EVP4 with a 2.68 volt filament, and the 21FDP4 can be used as a replacement if a jumper is installed in the voltage dropping resistor circuit.

The H-series chassis uses 16 tubes and is essentially the same circuit as the G-series chassis except that it was physically laid out differently and included some improvements. It was a little easier to service than the G-series chassis. The addition of a power transformer provided high voltage directly and permitted parallel wiring of the tube filaments which greatly improved tube life.

### RESTORATION

If you acquire a Predicta in relatively good condition, it can be cleaned and polished to look good; also, it can be restored to provide a clear, bright and stable picture on all channels with a few evenings of work. The exterior work is relatively straightforward. The plastic parts can be polished; the cabinet can be cleaned and touched up where necessary, and the brass parts can be replated if badly corroded or pitted.

The picture tube mask can be a problem. It seems that the plastic used in the 21" masks was too soft, and they tended to scratch and gouge easily. The plastic used in the 17" masks was too brittle, and the masks tended to crack easily. If your set has a bad mask, you won't be able to repair it; your only recourse is to wait until a better one comes along. Incidentally, all of the masks were originally grey colored, and in time they turned to the shades of green you see today.

Restoration of the chassis includes checking all tubes and replacing the bad ones, replacing all capacitors except for the ceramic disks, and cleaning and lubricating the tuner and all controls. While you're working on the VOS board, it's a good idea to check the values of all of the resistors in the vertical and horizontal sync circuits as these resistors are critical; a few minutes spent here may save you hours later on.

Now you're almost ready to plug it in. If you are experienced with TV repair, proceed. If not, ask a friend to help you. Make sure you use an isolation transformer! The G-series chassis is transformerless, and one side of the power line is connected to the chassis. After taking these precautions and plugging it in, you should get a fairly good picture. If not, you'll have to do some troubleshooting.

There are a couple of areas which generally cause problems. One is the alternate action on-off switch. Over the years, the lubricant tends to harden in the switch and renders it permanently off. With a clear eye and a steady hand, the

switch can be disassembled, cleaned, repaired, lubricated and made to work again. Another problem area is the tube sockets on the VOS printed circuit board. The little connecting links in the socket tend to fail, especially after a lot of tube substituting. Replacement sockets are easy to find in those 1950's plastic clock radios you've been throwing away.

### EPILOGUE

In 1962, Philco went bankrupt, and the remains were purchased by Ford. By 1965, Philco-Ford had abandoned the consumer television market. Did the early Predicta picture tube problems cause Philco's demise? Not entirely. Philco had a lot of other problems, but the damage to its reputation for quality must have financially crippled Philco's consumer products division. Philco's remarkable Predictas represent a significant aspect of vintage television history.

Whether you like their style or not, Predictas are fun to collect and restore. You're sure to draw comments of amazement from friends and relatives - especially if the sets work. Also, there is a certain unexplainable tingle of excitement you will feel while watching "I Love Lucy" reruns on your Predicta.

## MARTIAN & GEM CRYSTAL SETS The Tripods of New Jersey

Was it from outer space they came? And was it not Orson Welles who described those weird three-legged metal monsters descending upon Grovers Field in New Jersey?

Some fifteen years prior to that 1938 broadcast, New Jersey produced two tripod devices of their own. . . crystal sets. . . but weird they were. The most amazing point of interest was their similarity of design, even though manufactured by two totally different companies.

The set we see the most (but not too often) is the Martian manufactured in 1923 by Martian Laboratories of Newark, N.J. It was designed by Charles Marti and marketed as the Martian Big 4 (Figure 1).

The other crystal set is the less-known Little Gem, also produced in 1923 by Metro Electrical Co., Inc., also of Newark, N.J. (Figure 2).

Although their general appearance is similar,

the most obvious difference is the wire windings below the crystal units. The Martian has exposed copper-colored wire wound around six posts, while the Gem's red wire is wound around a 3" drum covered with a red-brown paper overwrap. Tuning on the Martian is done by sliding metal balls up and down one of two springs mounted vertically to the sides of the windings. The Gem has but one slider moving along two springs.




Figure 3. Catwhisker Arm on the Martian

The catwhisker arm on the Martian is a twistable L-shaped rod supported by a split post; see Figure 3. The Gem's detector probe is the familiar ball-between-two horizontal plates supported by a pivoting post; see Figure 4.

There are a total of ten rather unusual binding posts on the Martian set; four above (all marked "phone") and six below. Four match the head-phone posts above; the other two are "aerial" and "ground." The posts are unique in style and are

tightened by twisting the L-shaped wires. The Gem has but three standard-type binding posts; the one at the top marked "P" is for phones, and the two underneath are for antenna and common ground (for phones as well).

The upper finish on the Martian is an impressive heavy nickel plate, while that on the Gem is a rather thin nickel-over-brass, which wore through quite easily.

Now for the similarities. Both have identical

tripod legs. Under fire, both could receive Canada equally well (from Mass.), the Martian being slightly more sensitive. Both are 9" tall and have heads that are 3" tall. The Martian is 2 7/8" across the top, while the Gem is 2 1/4" across. In 1923, both crystal sets sold for \$6.50!

Take your pick . . . Either one will make a unique addition to your collection.









## Battery Set Power Supply An Adjustable, Regulated A, B & C Supply

Flexibility and precise voltage help eliminate the guess work when operating battery, farm and portable sets. Here is a regulated supply, with relatively few parts, thanks to the use of IC voltage regulators.

The B and C voltages are handled by Texas Instruments TL-783C regulators, designed to handle input voltages up to 135 VDC and putting out 125 volts regulated DC at up to 700 mA. This part can be found at most major electronic supply houses and distributors, from \$2.50 to \$4.00 each. With a bridge rectifier, potentiometer, electrolytic capacitor and a resistor, one can make a B and C power source with excellent regulation. Although one can literally operate directly from the AC outlet, use of an isolation transformer is strongly recommended.




Figure 1. A, B and C Regulated Power Supply

Shown in Figure 1 is my version. The B supplies 22 to 95 VDC, while the C supplies 22 to 50




Figure 2. Selecting resistors for desired output voltage range.

VDC. Selecting reference resistor will change the range, shown in Figure 2. The A supply is the typical LM317 regulator circuit. My circuit is set from 1.2 to 7.0 VDC. Again, one can change the range as indicated in Figure 2.

All the supplies are independent from each other. Any grounding or DC return is to be done externally for greater flexibility for various power supply hookups. The circuit shown has added features of a high voltage ON-OFF safety switch to warn the person of high voltage presence. A metering circuit is used with a power supply selector to allow reading of each supply through one meter. Use of an isolation transformer has two advantages. Not only will it handle the B and C supplies, but it will serve to isolate the person from a high voltage path to ground when using the B and C supplies. Also, the isolation transformer with the high voltage safety switch OFF

will allow the person to test AC/DC sets as shown in Figure 1.

With the exception of the isolation transformer, the power supply is not that expensive. The isolation transformer can be replaced with two fila-

ment transformers, with the filament secondaries hooked together. For collectors who like do-it-yourself construction, this is a fun circuit to build.
