


In many instances, a combination of single section electrolytic capacitors is recommended for replacement, wherever possible, instead of multiple section units of various capacities.

Stripped of all non-essentials, this manual will prove extremely valuable to the busy serviceman. By limiting the number of capacitor types required, he can thus carry a "fluid" stock that would move more rapidly and provide a more profitable turnover on his investment. Moreover, fewer capacitor types mean closer standardization, and faster deliveries to fill his stock needs.

The fact that the number of capacitor types has been "stripped for action" will in no way impair the serviceman's ability to handle any service job. Careful analysis by experts of all existing radio receiver circuits, physical structures of capacitors and set assemblies proves conclusively that service work can be handled with high efficiency by use of a reduced inventory of types as listed in this manual.

FOR quick and simplified reference to the listing of capacitor replacements in this manual each of the pages is headed as shown above.

COLUMN 1, Manufacturer and Model No. Manufacturers are listed alphabetically with models of each manufacturer listed directly under company name.

COLUMN 2, C-D Type—Part No. The recommended C-D replacement capacitors are listed under this column according to standard C-D types and part numbers. (Write for the latest C-D Catalog) Standard C-D units are also shown in schematic diagrams on pages 37 to 48. All part numbers followed by an asterisk (*) are standard C-D capacitor substitutes recommended for replacement of capacitors of unknown electrical characteristics such as those used in old models of receivers.

COLUMN 3, CAPACITY — MFD. (Divided into sections C1, C2, C3, C4, C5). The capacity of each capacitor section or unit is given for corresponding designations of filter circuits the numbers of which appear under Column 5. Working voltage rating of each capacitor or section is given under corresponding designations in Column 4. Where multiple section units are used in combination bypass and filter circuits circuit numbers of both are given in columns 5 and 6.

COLUMN 4, D.C. W. VOLTS (Divided into sections C1, C2, C3, C4, C5). D.C. Working Voltage rating of

each capacitor section or unit is given in this column corresponding capacity value designations under C1 to C5.

COLUMN 5, By-Pass Cir. No. Numbers under this column indicate the By-Pass Circuit which corresponds to that part of the circuit employed in the receiver. These circuits appear in the back section of this manual (pages 37 and 38), headed BY-PASS CIRCUITS.

COLUMN 6, Filter Cir. No. Numbers under this column indicate the number of the Filter Circuit which corresponds to that part of the circuit employed in the receiver. These circuits appear in the back section of Edition No. 1 (pages 39 to 48) headed FILTER CIRCUITS.

COLUMN 7, Rider's Man'l Vol.-P. Numbers under this column give the Volume and Page numbers of "Rider's Manuals" which give a complete schematic circuit diagram of the receiver or power supply for reference in checking the entire receiver circuit.


COLUMN 8, Mfgs. Orig. Part and Remarks. Under this column manufacturers' original part numbers of capacitors are given as well as any other special notes of information in abbreviated form concerning the capacitor or circuit in which it is used.

INDEX—Manufacturers are all listed in alphabetical order throughout the entire manual and indexed with company names at the upper right or left hand corner of each page.

Quick Reference

This handy manual has been carefully designed to help the serviceman find the correct replacement data quickly and easily. Column 1 lists the manufacturer alphabetically and the model numbers directly under the company name. Column 2 lists standard C-D types and part numbers. Column 3 shows capacity of each section or unit. Column 4 shows D.C. Working Voltage rating. Column 5 shows corresponding By-pass Circuit. Column 6 indicates the corresponding Filter Circuit. Column 7 indicates the volume and page numbers of "Rider's Manuals" for schematic diagram reference. Column 8 lists manufacturer's original part number plus special data notes. Bold face page headings facilitate index search for individual manufacturer.
