TELEVISION INTERFERENCE (TVI) FILTERS

Television interference (TVI) has been a greater problem to the radio amateur than broadcast interference ever was. This is due at least partly to the fact that television interference is somewhat more obnoxious to the eye than occasional radio interference is to the ear. Also, because of the higher frequencies at which they operate, TV receivers are more susceptible to interference from amateur transmitters than are the lower-frequency standard radios.

Most cases of TVI are rather stubborn; the amateur who must remove this interference or leave the air often finds his ingenuity taxed. During the past three years, considerable technical information regarding the TVI-proofing of transmitters has appeared. The recommended measures include the complete shielding of transmitters, and the filtering and/or bypassing of all power supply or control leads entering

or leaving the transmitter. When TVI persists even after these steps are taken, and it is determined that the offending signals are picked up by the receiving antenna or its lead-in, some form of interference filtering must be employed at the receiver.

High-Pass Filters for Receivers

The most satisfactory filter to install at the receiver is the high-pass type. This filter must be designed to suppress all frequencies lower than about 35 or 40 megacycles. The television frequencies will be passed with very little attenuation. While the cutoff ferquencies just mentioned will permit amateur operation up to and including the 10-meter band, the cutoff frequency would have to be raised to 54 or 55 Mc. if the 6-meter amateur band is to be used. It is probable, however, that a filter permitting 6-meter transmission




Fig. 1. High-Pass Filter for 300-ohm Antennas and Receivers.

would cause some impairment of reception in the nearby TV Channel 2.

We are devoting this issue of "The CAPACITOR" to a description of TVI filters largely as the result of the apparent wide interest of our "ham" readers in reducing or eliminating interference at television receivers. have selected for description filter designs which have given good service in the field. However, it must be recognized that each case of TVI is apt to be individual. There is no single cure for all cases. The reader must be prepared to perform necessary tests and to make such changes in any filter as may be required to correct a particular case of interference. We believe, however, that the filters shown in this article, will be found to be successful in a majority of cases.

Figures 1, 2, and 3 illustrate two types of high-pass TVI filters. The unit shown in Figures 1 and 2 is for use

with 300-ohm antennas; the one in Figure 3 for 72-ohm coaxial lead-ins.




Fig. 2. High-Pass Filter for 300-ohm Lead-in.

The 300-ohm unit (See Figure 1) is built in a 3½" x 3" x 2" metal radio utility box, although it undoubtedly can be made smaller in size. The two internal shield plates are cut from aluminum or steel sheet stock and folded for mounting as angle brackets. As may be seen in Figure 1, the ceramic capacitors (C₁, C₂, C₃, and C₄ in Figure 2) pass snugly through holes in the shield plates.

Each of the two end coils (L_1 and L_3 in Figure 2) is mounted by its leads to the lugs of a 2-lug terminal strip. The center coil, L_2 , is mounted by soldering its leads directly to the pigtails of the ceramic capacitors. Short lengths of 300-ohm ribbon, connected to the end terminal strips, provide input and output access.

The coils are wound with No. 26 enamelled wire on short lengths

of 3/16-inch-diameter insulating rod. Polystyrene or good-grade bakelite should be used. Required coil turns are given in Parts List at end of this article.




Fig. 3. High-Pass Filter for Coaxial Lead-in.

Construction of the filter for coaxial lead-ins (See Figure 3) is similar to that of the 300-ohm type. The three coils are wound with No. 26 enamelted wire on short lengths of 3/16-inch-diameter bakelite or polystyrene rod.

Required coil turns are given in Parts List at end of this article.

Note by reference to Figure 3 that capacitors C_3 and C_4 are returned respectively to coaxial connectors J_1 and J_2 . This procedure is necessary for proper high-frequency grounding in the input and output circuits. Coil L_2 is returned directly to the metal shield box, in which the filter is housed, as ground.




Fig. 4. Wavetrap Filters for TVI.

Wavetrap-Type Filters

The absorption wavetrap, long a standby in the elimination of radio broadcast interference, is also effective in some forms of TVI not requiring the complication of a high-pass filter.

Figure 4 shows the arrangement of wavetraps as filters for 300-ohm and coaxial lead-ins. An identical trap must be inserted into each lead of a 300-ohm line (See Figure 4A). Each trap is tuned to the frequency of the interfering signal. As shown in Figure 4A, the coils of the traps must be mounted at right angles to minimize mutual coupling. In order to prevent interference pickup by the wavetrap coil itself, both traps should be enclosed in shield boxes or cans.

Only one trap is needed, in the

"hot" lead, of a coaxial lead-in (See Figure 4B). For most effective operation, the entire trap should be shielded.

The tuning capacitors (C₁ and C₂ in Figure 4A, and C in Figure 4B) may be miniature air-tuned or ceramic units. For amateur bands, the maximum capacitance can be 50 or 100 uufd. Details regarding the number of turns for each coil, for a particular amateur band and tuning capacitor, may be found in the amateur handbooks.

Wavetraps are not as effective in interference elimination as are filters. However, in less obstinate cases of TVI they often suffice, and their greater simplicity recommends their use.

Construction and Installation Rules

- 1. Use adequate shielding in all filters and wavetraps. The entire unit must be housed in a metal box or can. A multisection filter must be further shielded internally by metal shield partitions erected between each filter section. This type of construction is seen in Figure 1.
- 2. Use fairly heavy sheet metal for the filter shield-box. Copper is the best material, but standard radio shield boxes more readily available in aluminum or steel are suitable. Employ solid construction, taking care that all holes are closed and shield partitions bonded tightly to the sides of the box.
- 3. Connect the filter output to the receiver antenna terminals by the shortest possible leads. If these leads are long, they may pick up interference after the filter.
- 4. Connect the filter box itself to the receiver chassis with a short length of heavy wire (not smaller than No. 14 in size) or bolt the box securely to the chassis. Ground the receiver chassis. By ground we mean an actual connection to earth. The ground connection must be a heavy wire (not smaller than No. 14 in size) run as directly as practicable to the nearest cold-water pipe or to a pipe driven at least four feet deep into moist soil.
- 5. If a wavetrap-type filter is used, set it to eliminate the actual interfering signal rather than using a signal generator for the adjustment. After this adjustment is made, remember that the trap is tuned only to eliminate signals on its resonant frequency. It must be retuned if the interference shifts to another frequency within its tuning range.
- 6. Before installing a filter of any kind in the antenna lead-in, determine by careful test that the interference actually is arriving via the lead-in. This may be done by removing the

- antenna from the receiver and observing whether the interference disappears. If it remains, it is probably entering through the power lines or by direct pickup due to inadequate shielding in the receiver.
- 7. Match impedances. Do not attempt to use with a 75-ohm receiver, a filter designed to operate in a 300-ohm line. Failure to observe correct impedance relationships will impair receiver operation as well as reduce filter effectiveness.
- 8. Always use a high-pass filter at the receiver. A low-pass filter may be used at the transmitter to suppress radiation of harmonics which might create TVI.
- 9. In all filters, use at least 3 sections for maximum rejection of unwanted frequencies. The greater the number of sections employed, the more effective filter operation will be.
- 10. A good filter is one using high-Q components. Always employ a top grade of mica or ceramic capacitors,


