# BATTERY-OPERATED, DIRECT-READING AUDIO-FREQUENCY METER

A direct-reading, electronic audio frequency meter indicates unknown frequencies on a meter scale. Requiring no adjustments or manipulations, except the switching of ranges, it possesses all of the simplicity of a common voltmeter or ammeter. An instrument of this type will measure frequencies over a wide range and its frequency indications are unaffected by the voltage or waveform of the applied signal within wide limits.

In many practical applications, the frequency meter is superior to the use of Lissajou's patterns in that it requires no auxiliary instruments such as an oscilloscope or audio oscillator, demands no special operating skills, and can be used to observe a rapidly-fluctuating frequency which would be difficult if not impossible to follow with Lissajou's figures. Unlike simple, movable-coil frequency meters, the electronic frequency meter has high input impedance and accordingly imposes virtually no load upon the frequency source.

The electronic frequency meter described in this article covers 10 cycles to 100 kc in four ranges: 0-100 (measurements below 10 cycles not recommended in this range), 0-1000, 0-10,000, and 0-100,000 cycles at full-scale deflection of the meter. The readings are presented on the scale of a 0-1 d-c milliammeter, the response being entirely linear. Thus, a reading of 0.1 ma indicates a frequency of 10, 100, 1000, or 10,000 cycles, depending upon the range selected, but in any event always 1/10 of the full-scale frequency. The frequency indication does not change with signal voltage as long as the voltage is between 3 and 175 volts. Shifts occur only when the frequency changes. The input impedance corresponds to 0.1 microfarad in series with 0.27 megohm.

## Operating Principle

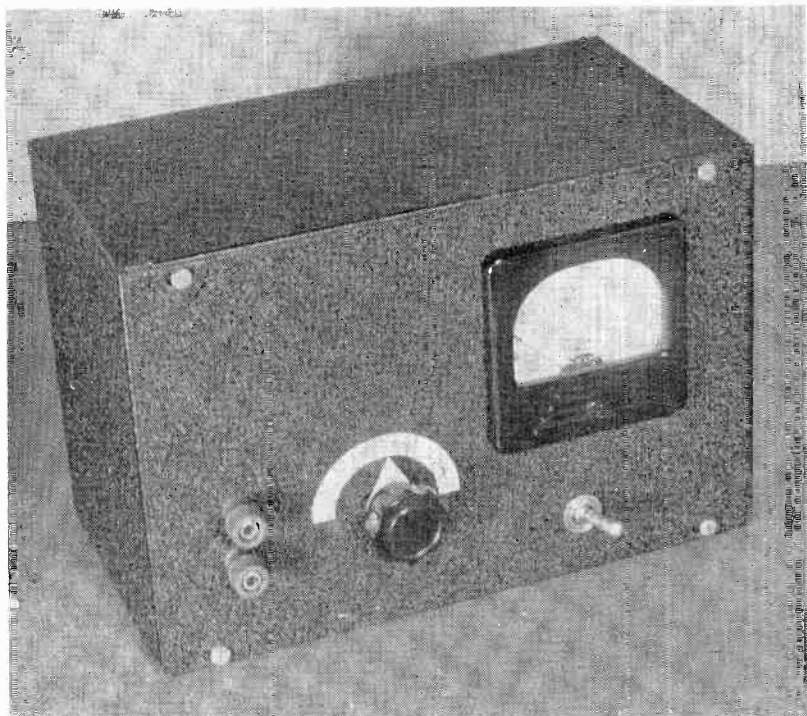
The electronic frequency meter operates on this simple principle: If a succession of pulses having the same polarity and constant amplitude are passed through a d-c milliammeter, the meter deflection is proportional principally to the pulse frequency. The meter response under these conditions is linear, and so only one point on the scale need be calibrated. The purpose of the electronic circuit ahead of the meter is to convert the signal of unknown frequency into pulses of that frequency suitable for presentation to the milliammeter. Changing the value of the coupling capacitor at the input of the meter circuit simultaneously with a meter shunt resistor changes the frequency range of the instrument.

The instrument circuit receives the unknown signal which may be sinusoidal or non-sinusoidal (e.g., square-wave, sawtooth, etc.) and first converts it into an essentially rectangular wave. This rectangular wave then is differentiated by C and R elements in the metering circuit into positive and negative pulses. Finally, a rectifier selects only the negative pulses which then are passed through the milliammeter.

## Instrument Circuit

The foregoing explanation now may be applied to the instrument circuit given in Figure 3. This circuit is seen to consist of a 2-stage RC-coupled amplifier capacitance-coupled to the meter circuit.

As long as the input signal voltage is 3 v. or higher, the 1U4 tube is overdriven and saturates. The resulting hard clipping squares off the negative half-cycle of amplified signal voltage in the 1U4 plate circuit. The amplified positive half-cycle overdrives the 3S4 tube, squaring the opposite

half-cycle in its plate circuit. Thus, the 354 output signal has both positive and negative half-cycles clipped cleanly at an amplitude which is independent of the input-signal amplitude. This quasi-rectangular signal is differentiated by the output coupling capacitor ( $C_1$  to  $C_{10}$ ) and the meter shunt resistor ( $R_8$  to  $R_{11}$ ) and is rectified by the diodes  $D_1$  and  $D_2$ .

The frequency range covered by the meter scale is determined by the constants of the differentiating circuit. Thus, the range may be changed by switching simultaneously the coupling capacitor and meter shunt resistance. Capacitor  $C_1$  and shunt resistor  $R_8$  thus set up the 0-100-cycle range. The shunt resistors are rheostats which are pre-set during the initial calibration

for full-scale deflection of the meter in response to calibrating signals at various frequencies.

#### Battery Operation

The circuit shown in Figure 3 has been adapted for battery operation from an ac-operated frequency meter circuit which appeared earlier in the literature.<sup>1,2</sup> Battery power gives complete portability, hum-free operation, freedom from stray coupling via the power line, and allows both signal input terminals to be operated above ground.

Battery operation is economical in this instrument. The requirements are  $1\frac{1}{2}$  volt at 150 ma and 90 volts at 11 ma. For ordinary, intermittent use, small-sized self-contained batteries are entirely adequate.

### Construction

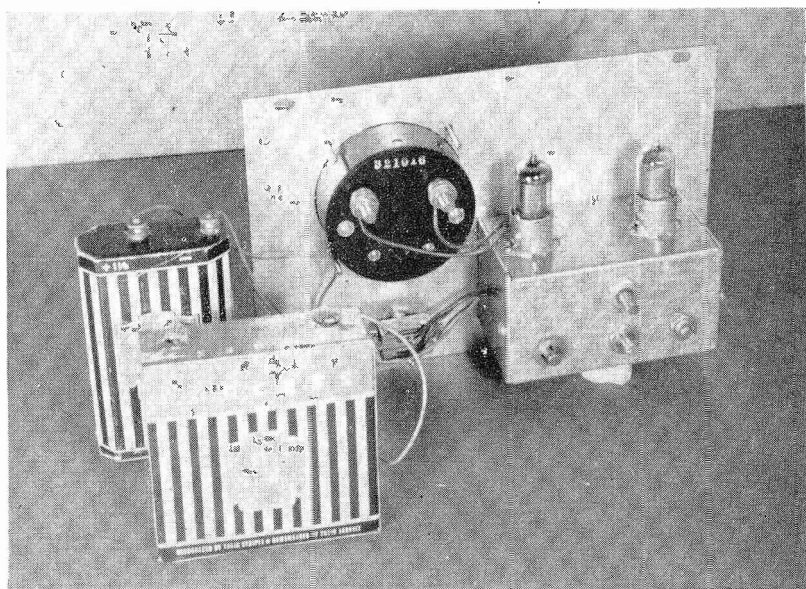
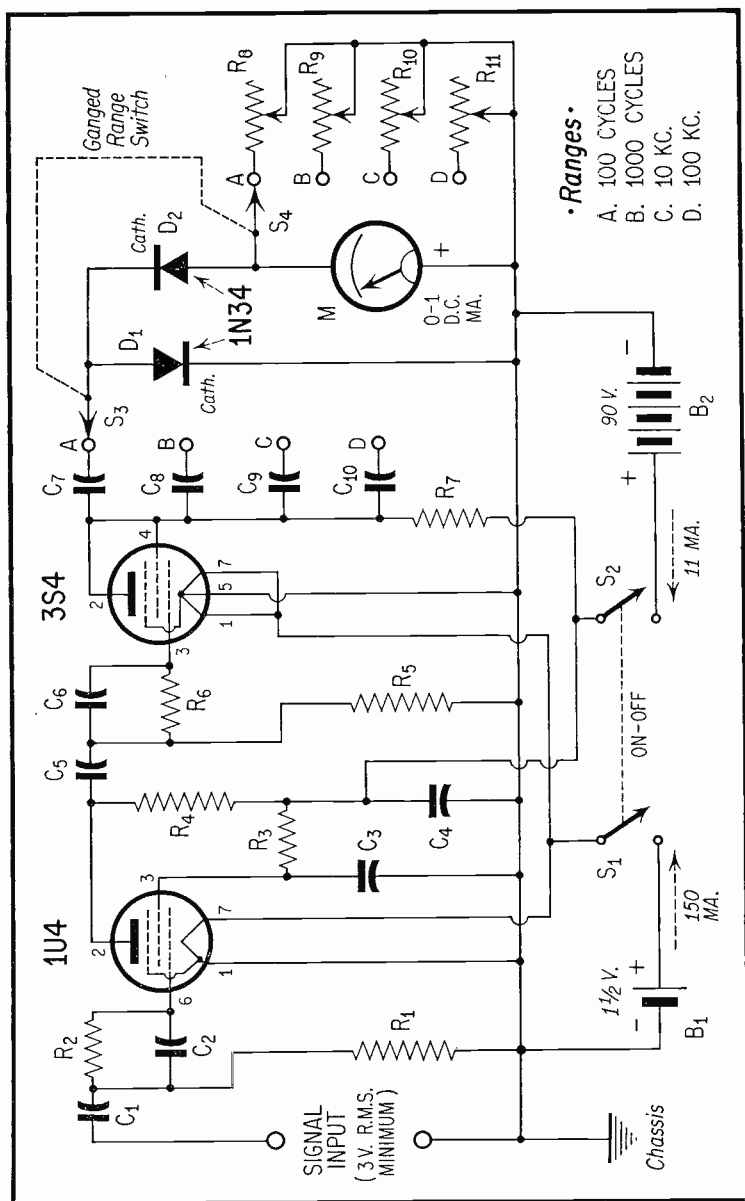


Fig. 2. Inside Construction. Calibration rheostats are seen on the rear of the chassis box.

Figures 1 and 2 show constructional details of the frequency meter. Wide latitude is possible in the building, since the layout of the instrument is not at all critical and the reader can follow his own inclinations regarding mode of housing.

The instrument as shown in Figure 1 is housed in a metal box 9" long, 6" high, and 5" deep. Only the ON-OFF switch ( $S_1$  -  $S_2$ ), signal input terminals, range switch ( $S_3$  -  $S_4$ ), and indicating meter are mounted on the front panel.

Figure 2 shows internal construction of the instrument. The circuit proper is enclosed in a small chassis box 5" long, 3" wide and 3" deep held to the front panel by means of the range switch bushing and the insulated signal-input binding posts. The calibration rheostats ( $R_3$  to  $R_{11}$ ) are mounted on the rear wall of this box and their shafts are visible in Figure 2. The tube sockets are mounted on the top of the box.

There is ample room in the case

for the two batteries which are seen standing nearby in Figure 2. If the reader anticipates prolonged service periods, it will be advisable to employ a heavier-duty B-battery than the 90-volt Type N60 shown. Two slightly larger 45-volt, series-connected units can be fitted into the instrument case.

Because of the low current drain and the small battery tubes, the instrument runs cool and no need for louvers or air holes in the case has been evidenced.

In order to minimize battery drain, no pilot light has been included. The meter normally does not read in the absence of an input signal, so there is no clue that the instrument is running and the operator must assume responsibility for switching-off the batteries during idle intervals.

### Initial Calibration

After construction is completed and wiring is verified, the initial calibration may be made. Four accurately-known frequencies are required for

this purpose: 100 and 1000 cycles and 10 and 100 kc. The frequency source must supply at least 3 volts. A good audio oscillator will do for the first three frequencies. The fourth may be obtained from a 100-kc crystal oscillator.

Follow this procedure. (1) Remove the frequency meter temporarily from its case. (2) Connect the frequency source to the signal input terminals of the frequency meter. (3) Set the frequency source to 100 cycles and switch it on. (4) Set RANGE SWITCH  $S_3$ - $S_4$  to its position A, and switch-on the frequency meter. (5) Adjust rheostat  $R_9$  for exact full-scale deflection of the meter. Run the signal voltage up and down, noting that as long as it does not fall below 3 volts the meter reading does not change. (6) Set the frequency source to 1000 cycles. (7) Set RANGE SWITCH  $S_3$ - $S_4$  to position B. (8) Adjust rheostat  $R_9$  for full-scale deflection of the meter. (9) Set the frequency source to 10 kc. (10) Adjust rheostat  $R_{10}$  for full-scale deflection of the meter. (11) Set the frequency source to 100 kc. (12) Adjust rheostat  $R_{11}$  for full-scale deflection of the meter. (13) The calibration now is completed. Disconnect the signal source, switch-off the frequency meter, and re-install the latter in its case.

The intermediate points in any range may be checked by applying signals of various frequencies within the range and observing the meter deflection. For example, a signal frequency of 340 cycles should produce a meter deflection of 0.34 milliampere with switch  $S_3$ - $S_4$  set to its position B. This linearity of the meter scale makes possible the use of a single calibrating frequency in each range, as described in the foregoing explanation of calibration.

#### Use of Instrument

Use of the instrument to measure frequencies is as simple as using a non-tube voltmeter to check voltage: (1) Set the range switch to its 100-kc position (position D). (2) Connect the frequency source to the signal input terminals. (3) Switch-on both

the meter and the signal source. (4) Switch the meter successively to each lower range until deflection is obtained in the upper portion of the scale. (5) Read the unknown frequency from the meter deflection and range switch setting. Thus, a deflection of 0.93 ma with the range switch in position C indicates 9300 cycles.
