NEW DEVELOPMENTS IN SEMICONDUCTOR DEVICES

With new circuits and devices appearing regularly in the semiconductor field, it is worthwhile occasionally to review certain of those developments which are of immediate practical interest. A great many of the advances described in purely scientific journals are chiefly of theoretical interest and often have only remote practical applications. The practical semiconductor technician finds most value in such information as can be applied immediately to the doing of new jobs or to the better accomplishment of old ones. This article describes a few such semiconductor developments.

Silicon Power Rectifiers

Advantages offered by new silicon power rectifiers are high operating current in small-sized units, higher peak inverse voltage ratings per cell than obtainable with selenium, low forward voltage drop, high temperature rating, and high maximum operating frequency.

A silicon rectifier cell $1\frac{1}{8}$ " in diameter and $1\frac{1}{8}$ " high, for example, has the following ratings: Maximum peak inverse voltage 300 v; average instantaneous forward voltage drop 1.3 v; maximum d-c output current in a 3-phase bridge circuit, with cells mounted on $5" \times 5" \times \frac{1}{8}"$ cooling plates, 160 amperes with convection cooling at 30°C (350 amperes with forced-air cooling at 30°C

and 30 amperes convection-cooled (75 amps forced-air-cooled) at 160°C ; maximum operating temp. 160°C ; maximum operating frequency 25 kc. Surge current rating is 1200 amperes (1 second) and 1,000 amperes (5 seconds) half-wave peak current. With other cells of different dimensions, maximum peak inverse voltage ratings up to 8,000 v are obtainable.

Lower-powered silicon rectifier cells, 0.38" in diameter and 0.32" high, require no heat sink and have the following ratings: Maximum peak inverse voltage up to 600 v, average rectified current (at 100°C) to 350 ma, maximum operating temperature 150°C , 1-second surge current 10 amperes, forward voltage drop 0.75 v at 350 ma, and reverse leakage current 200 microamperes at 600 p. i. v.

Silicon power rectifiers offer high operating power ratings in small physical sizes and light weight, together with high-temperature reliability. Rectification efficiencies up to 99% are obtainable. Their extremely low forward dynamic resistance (a few thousandths of an ohm) and low forward voltage drop promote good regulation in power supplies. Silicon rectifiers may be used in all standard power supply circuits. Series-connected cells have been employed in units where the peak inverse voltage is 100,000 v.

Aside from d-c power supply applications, silicon power rectifiers are employed in magnetic amplifiers, servomechanisms, motor control circuits, voltage regulators, high-current relay operation, frequency multipliers, autopilots, arc suppressors, magnetic clutches and brakes, and alternator field circuits.

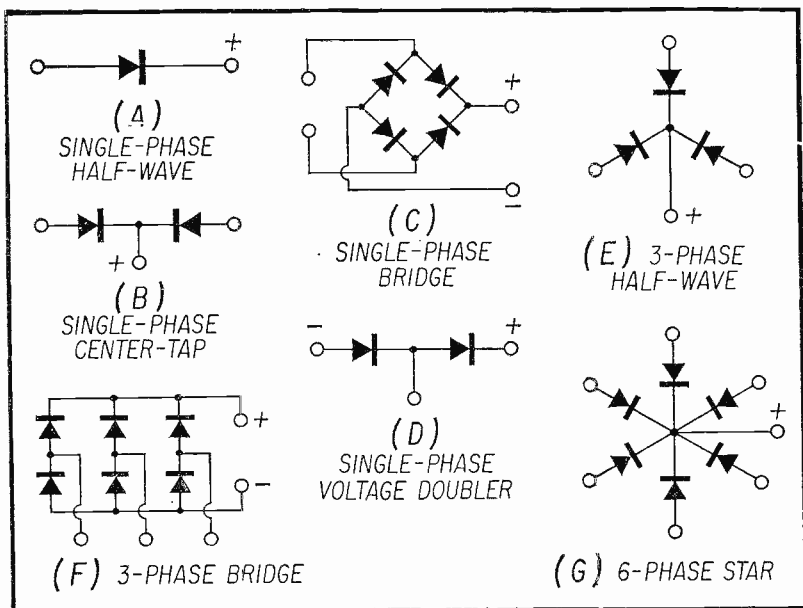


Fig. 1. Stack Configurations of Silicon Rectifiers.

Figure 1 shows the stack configurations in which silicon power rectifiers are commercially available.

High-Power Transistor Switch

One commercial power transistor (Delco 2N174) now is capable of switching d-c power up to 1 kilowatt. This opens a new field of application hitherto unattainable in transistorized control circuits.

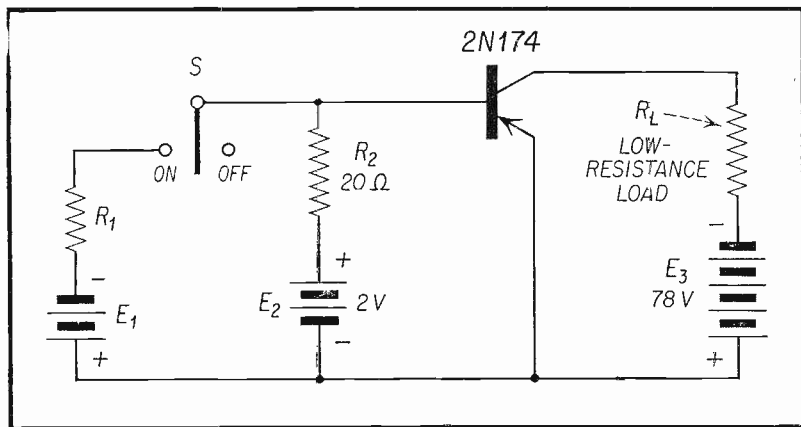


Fig. 2. One-Kilowatt Transistor Switch.

The common-emitter test circuit for the switching action is shown in Figure 2. Here, when switch S is thrown to its ON position, the collector current increases from a low value due to base bias E_2 , to 13 amperes. With the 78-volt d-c collector supply voltage (E_3), this corresponds to 1,014 watts. Due to the small voltage drop across the transistor, however, only 8 watts are dissipated by the transistor. The d-c base-input power for this operation is only 1 watt, which indicates that the base-to-collector power gain is approximately

1,000, or 30 db. Lower amounts of collector-circuit power may be switched at lower levels of collector supply voltage E_3 .

The switching time of this circuit is stated as 60 microseconds, roughly the period of 16.67 kc. The most significant limiting factor with regard to switching time is collector capacitance.

High-powered transistor switching will find applications where switch contacts in the power circuit must be eliminated, large control power amplifications are desired (thus, the switching circuit becomes a relay without moving parts), or when the power circuit is to be switched by means of suitable pulses.

Unijunction Transistor

A promising new semiconductor device is the unijunction transistor, formerly called the double-base diode. The commercially available unit is General Electric's 4JD5A1 shown in

Figure 3(C). In this unit, separate leads provide ohmic contact with each one of a silicon bar. This corresponds roughly to two base leads. A p-n junction is created at the center of the bar and a third lead is connected to this junction.

Figure 3(A) shows bias connections to this double-based junction diode. The junction is dc-biased in the forward direction by voltage E_1 . A potential gradient is established along the length of the bar by voltage E_2 . Because the junction is forward-biased, it emits holes into the n-type bar.

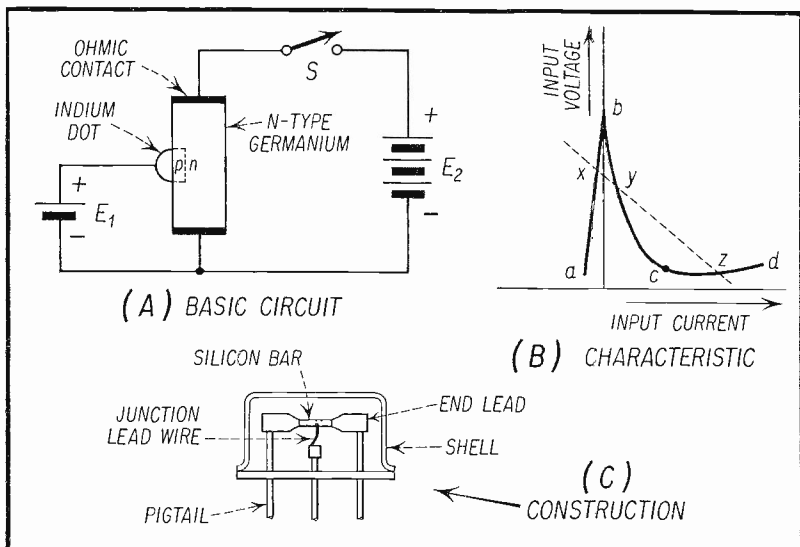


Fig. 3. Unijunction Transistor.

If E_1 and E_2 have the proper ratio, the potential distribution along the length of the bar and the polarity of its ends will be such that, when switch S is closed, the p-n junction acts as an emitter over its lower half and as a collector over its upper half.¹ This simultaneous injection and collection of carriers at the single p-n junction imparts a negative input resistance to the device. This is due to the shape of the voltage distribution along the length of the bar under these circumstances. Figure 3(B) illustrates the negative resistance characteristic. Note that as the input current is increased, the input voltage drop first rises from a to b. Then as the current is increased

further, the voltage falls to c. Beyond the latter point, further current increase causes the voltage again to rise, but more slowly, to d. The region between b and c, having a negative slope, represents a negative resistance, while slopes a-b and c-d correspond to positive resistances.

The b-c region is necessarily unstable and will provide monostable operation, if desired. However, if external circuit resistances are so chosen as to establish the load line shown by the dotted line, bi-stable operation may be obtained. The operating point thus can be flipped from x to z, or from z to x, being unable to remain at the unstable point, y.

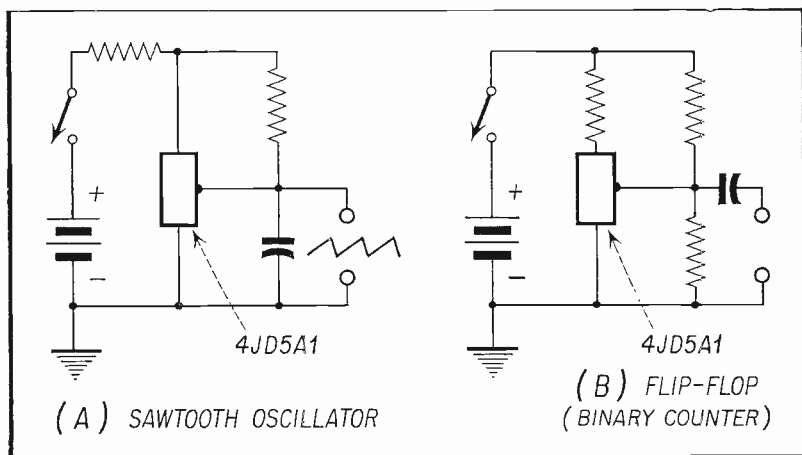


Fig. 4. Unijunction Transistor Circuits.

These monostable and bi-stable properties suit the unijunction transistor to oscillator, multivibrator, and switching circuits having considerable simplicity. Figure 4 shows circuits of a sawtooth oscillator and flip-flop employing the 4JD5A1 unijunction transistor. Note the economy of components. Similar applications have been described in the engineering literature.^{2,3}

By means of suitable manipulation of the d-c load line, the unijunction transistor may be made to operate as a monostable, bi-stable, or free-running device. This provides an intriguing active element for various cir-

cuits. This device is essentially a 3-terminal component with an N-type negative resistance characteristic between its junction (emitter) and base terminals.

Maximum ratings of the 4JD5A1 are: Interbase voltage (E_2 in Figure 3-A) 45 v, interbase power dissipation 250 mw, emitter current 50 ma, and forward emitter resistance (at interbase voltage of 10 v) 100 ohms.

Bi-Directional Transistor

Bi-directional gain is of interest in such circuitry as detectors, clamps,

and modulators. A small semiconductor device having this property is readily applicable to translator and computer circuits in which a large number of such components must be installed in a small space.

The GT-34S germanium pnp transistor (General Transistor Corp.) provides usable bi-directional gain. The tabulation below shows its characteristics.

produced by the meltback process provides amplification up to 120 Mc, and operating as a 110-Mc r-f oscillator delivers 10 milliwatts output. In pulse circuits, the output pulse from this tetrode has rise and fall times of 25 milli-microseconds and a width of 70 milli-microseconds. In a 30-Mc i-f amplifier, 3N30 tetrodes provide 70 db power gain at 3 megacycles bandwidth.

In a 6-stage 45-Mc television i-f amplifier, 3N30's have provided 57 db gain at 4 Mc bandwidth. And in a 2-stage video amplifier employing 3N30's, 33 db gain has been obtained between 30 cps and 10 Mc.

This transistor makes transistorized tv i-f, r-f, converter, and video amplifiers entirely feasible. It also opens new possibilities for the transistorization of radio frequency test instruments such as signal generators, heterodyne frequency meters, marker generators, grid dip oscillators, and miniature transmitters.

Additionally, this tetrode has been completely successful and equal to tubes in tuned-line oscillators, linear pulse amplifiers, driven blocking oscillators, regenerative pulse amplifiers, free-running multivibrators, r-f

amplifiers, high frequency converters, and electronic switches.

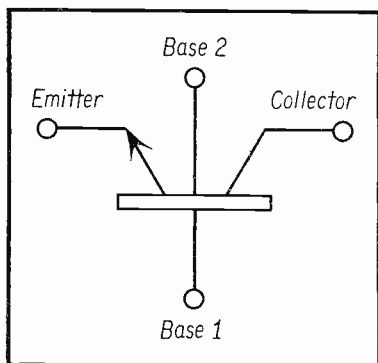


Fig. 5. Tetrode Transistor.

Figure 5 shows the symbol of the tetrode transistor. The following are the maximum ratings of the 3N30:

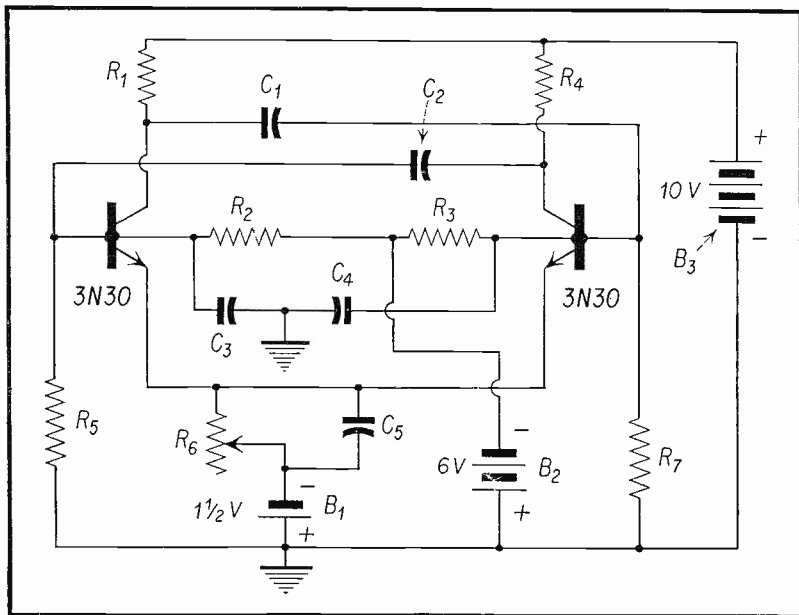


Fig. 6. Tetrode Multivibrator.

Figure 6 shows the circuit arrangement of a tetrode-type free-running multivibrator due to Aldridge.⁴ This arrangement has been operated at a maximum frequency of $1\frac{1}{4}$ megacycle. The output voltage at 750 kc is reported as 10 v, and the rise and fall time of the output pulse as 0.3 microsecond. Such applications as this offer considerable promise for applications in frequency standards, square wave generators, counters, and similar devices.

Additional Devices

In addition to the devices described in the foregoing paragraphs, the reader will find that many standard components such as low-power silicon junction diodes, germanium power rectifiers, medium-frequency transistors, phototransistors, and ther-

mistors have undergone significant improvement during the past year. On many of these components, operating ranges have been extended and parameters made more stable. During the past year, several low-priced r-f—i-f transistors have been offered.

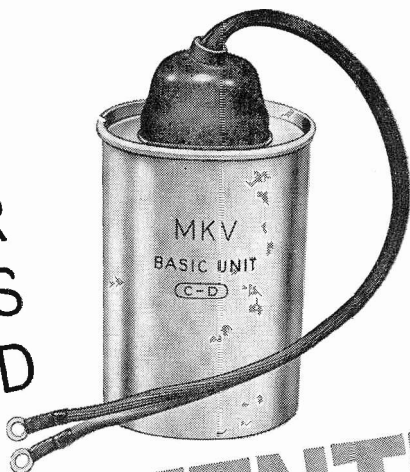

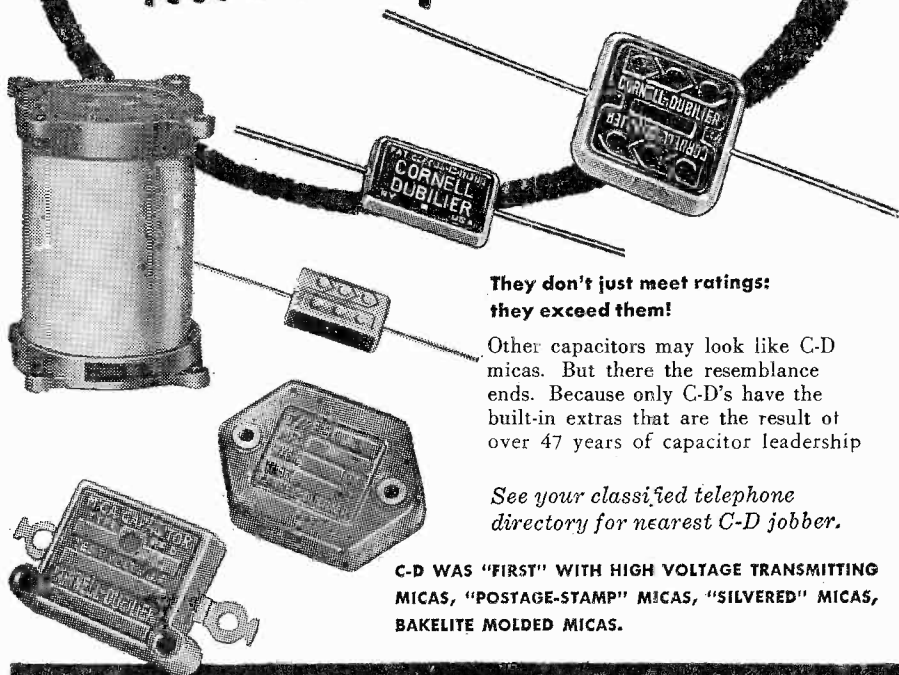
