TESTING A. C. MOTOR STARTING CAPACITORS

Capacitor-type a. c. motors now are widely used in refrigerators and in many other household and commercial machines. High-capacitance a. c. capacitors start these motors as 2-phase units. After the motor reaches full running speed, or slightly before, an automatic switch cuts the capacitor and the starting winding out of the circuit, and the motor runs as a single-phase unit.

The capacitor thus is in the circuit only for a few seconds and usually is called upon to start the motor only occasionally. A motor starter capacitor accordingly need not be designed for continuous service. This is an advantage because small-sized electrolytic capacitors which furnish the high capacitance required for motor starting purposes can be used only for **intermittent** alternating current service.

Satisfactory operation of the motor depends a great deal upon the quality and condition of the capacitor. For example, it is imperative that the capacitor have the lowest practicable power factor. A high power factor is undesirable since it will reduce the motor starting torque. (A 2-to-1 increase in power factor can reduce the starting torque by as much as $2\frac{1}{2}$ to $9\frac{1}{2}$ per cent.) The best power factor would, of course, be zero, but such perfection is not obtainable in practice. The practical power factor range

in Cornell-Dubilier etched-foil dry electrolytic a. c. capacitors is $4\frac{1}{2}$ to 8%. However, technicians in the field accept as satisfactory any power factor not higher than 10 per cent. It is important also that the capacitance of a motor starting capacitor be as close as possible to the value specified by the motor manufacturer and indicated on the capacitor label. Moreover, this capacitance must remain reasonably constant in service. If the capacitance is too low, starting torque will be lost. But a capacitance increase, up to about 15% of the rated value, seldom affects starting of the motor.

A. C. Capacitor Ratings

Cornell-Dubilier electrolytic motor starting capacitors are supplied in the capacitance range 10 to 498 microfarads at 110 volts a. c. operating, 38 to 420 ufd. at 125 volts, and 10 to 157 ufd. at 220 volts. In addition to the electrolytic line; oil-impregnated, oil-filled Dykanol a. c. capacitors (especially suitable for continuous-duty services) are supplied in the capacitance range 1 to 50 ufd. at 165 volts a. c. operating, 1 to 50 ufd. at 220 volts, 1 to 60 ufd. at 330 volts, 1 to 20 ufd. at 375 volts, 1 to 35 ufd. at 440 volts, 1 to 25 ufd. at 550 volts, and 1 to 25 ufd. at 660 volts.

The operating frequency range of both electrolytic and Dykanol types is 50 to 60 cycles.

Testing A. C. Electrolytic Capacitors

The instruments ordinarily used by radio servicemen for checking capacitors cannot be employed for testing electrolytic motor starter capacitors. These instruments include bridges,

simple microfarad meters, capacitor analyzers, etc. The reason for this is that a. c. electrolytic capacitors must be checked at their rated a. c. operating voltage, and this voltage is not supplied





Fig. 1. Circuit for short-circuit test. •

by the instruments referred to. In some instances also, the microfarads scales of radio test instruments do not reach the high values common to motor starter capacitors.

The important quantities which must be measured are **capacitance** and **power**

cedure, taking the steps in the order listed:

(1) Make your test as rapidly as possible. If this rule is not followed, the capacitor will be forced to pass current longer than is safe and may become damaged.




Fig. 3. Curves for determining approximate capacitance from ammeter readings.

factor. Some other well-known tests, such as d. c. leakage and leakage to can are not as important in establishing the quality and condition of a. c. electrolytic capacitors. The three essential instruments required for checking a. c. electrolytic capacitors are (1) a. c. voltmeter, (2) a. c. ammeter, and (3) a. c. wattmeter. Each meter should be a multi-range instrument.

In order to prevent burning-out a meter in case the capacitor is shorted, a preliminary short-circuit test must be made before attempting to check capacitance and power factor.

When checking a. c. electrolytic capacitors, observe the following pro-

(2) Always test the capacitor first for short circuit. **Make the short-circuit test at the rated a. c. operating voltage of the capacitor.** Use the circuit given in Figure 1. For 110 or 125 volts, resistor R may be a 500-watt cone-type heater element. Or it may consist of one 500-watt (115-volt) lamp or five 100-watt (115-volt) lamps connected in parallel. For 220 volts, use four 500-watt cone heaters or ten 100-watt (115-volt) lamps in series-parallel. To make the short-circuit test: first measure the line voltage with the voltmeter, then measure the voltage drop across resistor R. If the two voltage readings are equal, the capaci-

tor is shorted and should be discarded. If the voltage across the resistor is lower than the line voltage, the capacitor has some capacitance and the other tests may be undertaken.

Where P is the wattmeter reading
 E , the voltmeter reading, and
 I , the ammeter reading

(5) To determine the capacitance accurately from the meter readings




Fig. 4. Complete circuit for checking capacitance and power factor. Read watt losses without capacitor and subtract from reading with capacitor in circuit.

(3) Check Capacitance. For a quick check of the approximate capacitance, use the circuit given in Figure 2 and refer to the graph, Figure 3, which gives the capacitance corresponding to the ammeter reading. The capacitance value obtained by this method will only be approximate. The capacitance can be determined more accurately by means of the setup shown in Figure 4. The method is explained in Section 5.

(4) Check Power Factor. Use the circuit shown in Figure 4. The power factor (in per cent) is found by dividing 100 times the reading of the wattmeter by the voltmeter reading times the ammeter reading. Expressed as a formula this is:

$$\text{p.f.}(\%) = \frac{100P}{E \times I}$$

obtained with the circuit given in Figure 4, use formula below. With the meter readings designated by the same letters given in the preceding paragraph, the capacitance formula is:

$$C(\text{ufds.}) = \frac{2650 \times I}{E} \text{ for 60 cycles}$$

Change the numerator to 3183 when the frequency is 50 cycles.

Testing Oil-Type A. C. Capacitors

Dykanol type a. c. capacitors may be checked in the same manner just explained for a. c. electrolytic capacitors. However, Dykanol capacitors are designed for continuous-duty applications. It therefore will not be necessary to rush the tests, since these capacitors will not be damaged by normal test currents.
