TRANSISTORIZED INTERCOM

Pushpull class-B output-stage operation permits useful amounts of audio power to be obtained from conventional transistors. One loudspeaker-type application that comes quickly to mind is the small-sized intercommunicator unit.

A transistorized intercom has several advantages: Its small size, light weight, and operation from a small, self-contained battery suit it to field applications remote from power lines. It may be used as a "baby sitter" with complete confidence and safety, since there is no electric shock hazard should the instrument fall into the crib or in any other manner come into contact with the baby's body. Nor is there danger from burns, common to hot tubes and transformers.

The transistorized intercom described in this article is built around a 3-stage amplifier. While we have not worked for miniaturization in this model, it will be apparent to the reader that the intercom might be made much smaller, even to the extent of being housed in a small speaker box. Figures 1, 2, and 3 show various aspects of the instrument.

Intercom Circuit

Figure 4 shows the complete circuit of the intercom. Note that low-power transistors are used in each position.

Transformer coupling is employed throughout, to insure highest over-all power gain with a given number of transistors. NPN-type transistors (Sylvania 2N35) are used in each




Fig. 1. The Completed, Transistorized Intercom. Entirely self-contained, this unit is built into an 8" x 6" x 4 1/2" aluminum chassis box.




Fig. 2. Transistorized, High-Gain, High-Output Amplifier. This amplifier, built on a 6" x 3" bakelite subpanel, is the heart of the intercom. All components except coupling capacitors and switches are visible on the top of the subpanel.

stage. Two cascaded, high-gain "front-end" stages are employed. The second of these is the driver for the pushpull class-B output stage. Isolating capacitors, C_1 and C_2 , in the first two stages break the d-c path between the transistor bases and transformer secondaries to permit d-c biasing of the bases through resistors R_1 and R_3 . Bias for the output stage is obtained from the voltage divider, R_4R_5 . Emitter resistor R_2 provides negative feedback in the input stage. This lowers distortion and boosts the input impedance of this stage.

The transformers all are miniatures. Transformer connections must be made exactly as shown in Figure 4, according to the manufacturer's color coding. If the connections are swapped, audio oscillation will result in a sustained howl.




Fig. 3. Completely Assembled Intercom. The amplifier (Figure 2) is screw-mounted to the floor of the box. The ON-OFF switch and PUSH-TO-TALK switch are on the front panel (see here to the left above the amplifier subpanel). In this photo, the 3-wire cable has not yet been connected.

Figure 2 shows how the amplifier components are mounted on a 3/16"-thick bakelite panel 6 inches long and 3 inches wide. This panel later is mounted on the floor of the intercom box, as shown in Figure 3. Small holes

drilled in the mounting panel pass the pigtailed of resistors, transistors, and transformers through to the under side where they are connected to complete the circuit. Capacitors C_1 and C_2 are mounted under the panel and are not visible in Figure 2. The TALK-LISTEN switch (S_1) and ON-OFF switch (S_2) are mounted on the front panel (See Figures 1 and 3).

Operation of the circuit is simple. A 4-inch dynamic speaker serves as microphone when switch S_1 is in its lower (TALK) position or as a speaker when S_1 is in its normal upper (LISTEN) position. The TALK-LISTEN switch is of the spring-return type and is depressed to the TALK position. Each remote station consists simply of a similar speaker and switch (S_a). Thus, at "rest" each speaker (station) normally listens.

When S_1 is depressed, the master speaker is connected as a microphone to the input of the amplifier through transformer T_1 . The remote speaker, however, is connected to the amplifier output, through transformer T_a , by re-

remote switch S_2 in its normal (LISTEN) position. Talking into the master speaker thus gives communication with the remote station. The opposite action is obtained with remote switch S_2 depressed to its lower (TALK) position. The remote speaker then becomes the microphone, being connected to the amplifier input through transformer T_1 ; and the local (master) speaker becomes the reproducer, being connected to the amplifier output through S_1 in its LISTEN position. The remote station then talks to the master station.




Fig. 4. Complete Circuit of TransistORIZED Intercom.

The remote station is connected to the master station by means of a 3-conductor cable. Any number of similar remote stations, each consisting simply of a speaker (SPKR) and switch (S_2), may be operated. Each cable would be connected to output

terminals 1, 2, and 3, as shown in Figure 4 for the single remote station.

The amplifier gives an output of 125 milliwatts on normal-level speech delivered at a distance of approximately 1 foot from the speaker-microphone. This output may be boosted for noisy locations by raising the power supply to 12 volts. Cries and other sounds across a room are picked up and reproduced surprisingly well when the source is in front of the microphone.

In the original model, we felt no need for a gain control. One may be added very easily, however, simply by connecting a 15,000-ohm potentiometer across the secondary of transformer T_2 . The wiper of this gain control potentiometer must be connected to capacitor C_2 .

D-C power is supplied by the 6-volt battery, B, consisting of four 1½-volt Size-D flashlight cells connected in series. The class-B output stage and low-drain intermediate stages make the most economical use of the power supply and insure long battery life.

Mechanical and Electrical Construction

Figures 1, 2, and 3 show constructional details of the intercom

The instrument is built into an aluminum chassis box (LMB No. 146) 8" long, 6" high, and 4½" deep. The speaker, TALK-LISTEN switch S_1 , and ON-OFF switch S_2 are mounted on the front panel (See Figures 1 and 3). The amplifier subpanel (Figure 2), already described in the preceding section, is mounted on the floor of the case, as shown in Figure 2, by means of four 6-32 screws which support the panel high enough to clear the wiring and coupling capacitors.

The four battery cells are mounted on the inside of one of the side walls. See Figure 3. A strap made from antenna ribbon holds these cells in place.

The speaker is mounted behind a 4½-inch-square panel of perforated grille sheet. Mounted slightly off center on the front panel, the speaker offers no obstruction to the amplifier components.

The TALK-LISTEN switch, S_1 , is a Switchcraft No. 3033 component. The reader must bend the upper contact spring of this switch down slightly so as to make contact with the movable blade in the latter's spring-retained normal (LISTEN) position.

No special precautions are necessary in wiring the intercom. The connections themselves have been simplified by the subpanel-type construction of the amplifier which allows almost complete wiring of the instrument by interconnecting the pigtails of components.

Readers with the urge might make an etched circuit project of the amplifier.

Installation Notes

The intercom has been tested up to 600 feet and there is no reason why it should not operate reliably over much longer distances. In long wire installations, there will be some advantage to shielding the 3-conductor cable and grounding the cable to the chassis and earth at one end.

When the cable is run for a considerable distance out of doors (50 feet or more, in fact), a 2½-millihenry r-f choke should be connected in series with Lead 3 to suppress the effect of r-f pickup from local broadcast stations. It may be necessary also in stubborn cases to bypass output terminal 2 to chassis and ground through a 0.002-ufd mica capacitor.






