(IX ers are still reporting this as KRN934). Also, 2 stations here used to be 10 watts, now one is only 2 3/4 watts and the other is virtually inaudible here (estimate 1/10 watt). Legal IDs approx. every 15 minutes, "This is Air Radio -- airport information radio for L.A.X. -- WNHB296, Los Angeles. (SMM-CA) 540 KSHO CA, Hesperia it is RS (not tests, as reported earlier) to stereo simulcast their FM jazz station, KKGO-105.1, nightly 2000-1200 (5pm-9am ELT) on *-second delay (using KKGO satellite feed). All IDs during simulcast are just "KKGO" except at 100 & 130, "America's jazz station--KKGO, Los Angeles and KSHO Hesperia." However, I have noted that sometimes the KSHO call is mistakenly NOT given across the top of the hour, so beware! (SMM-CA) (Other Exers have noted the IDs for KKGO only, hence the reports KSHO 540 KSHO CA, Hesperia 12/1 1949 have noted nightly, just before power cut that they give address & phone number, then sometimes add "From the Nevada border to the Pacific Ocean, this is KSHO-540. " Then 560 KLZ CO. Denver 11/27 0200 with KSFO nulled, "This is KLZ 56" into country music, coming in good. (CM-CA) 620 KCLQ CA, Hanford Tu 11/24 1245-1302, 1502 ex-KNGS. Simulcasts FM 107.5 KCLQ." Legal IDs as: "Classic Rock--107.5 FM and 620 AM, KCLQ Hanford-Fresno. " Pair here midday with KFI-640 slop somewhat 700 *KMJY* WA, Newport 12/5 0100 coming in good with country music. "This is KMJY, Newport, testing, "then sign off, (CM-CA) WA, Seattle 11/24 1900 heard nice "KRPM" ID coming in good, and 770 KRPM 990 CBW MB, Winnipeg 12/1 2200 "This is CBC Radio 990 in Winnipeg" into news. Coming in good. KKIS off air for ten minutes. (CM-CA) CA, Los Angeles 12/7 2100 now finally broadcasting true stereo 1070 KNX with Dolphins vs. Jets football game. Interestingly, left & right channels were opposite from that of KFMB-760 San Diego:

CA, Sacramento 12/13 1400 noted w/ "Sacramento"s only 24 hour classic station." Heard on car radio in Corte Madera, CA.

Sounds automated. Announcer sounds like he should be on AC or

CA, San Bernardino now simulcasts with its CHR FM, KGGI, during

morning drivetime. All IDs are "99.1." At 155 IDs as "K-Men 129

AM and 99-1 FM," followed at :00 with legal ID: "99-1 is KGGI Riverside-San Bernardino-Ontario, and KMEN San Bernardino-Riverside...with more continuous music." (Note that "gg-I" looks like "99-1."). This per FM reception, as KMEN is almost impossible

to hear at this location. (SMM-CA)

1290 KESP CA, Santa Barbara Tu 11/24 1850 ex-KXXN. Fair here midday with KFRN-1280 slop nulled, with Spanish programming and "Kah-Espanol" (K-Spanish) IDs. Legal ID in English: "This is KESP 1290 AM stereo in Santa Barbara. " (SMM-CA) 1320 KCPX

UT, Salt Lake City 12/1 0130 coming in good with "This is Power 99, " then DJ gave KCPX AM-PM ID, rock music. KGNR totally

1600 KMNY CA, Pomona now broadcasting in Kahn stereo. (SMM-CA) UNID:

820 12/9 0400 coming in poor under WBAP/KGNW. Had loop in NW direction. Possibly KCBF but not sure. Heard with AdCon music. (CM-CA)

Remember that Cuba tends to rearrange their frequency network every once in awhile; please report any such changes so we can maintain a complete listing. Also keep in mind that many outlets are allowed to drift off-frequency on occasion, very likely to QRM US stations.

Additionally, Radio Progreso programs can occasionally be heard on CMBM-860 (R. Metripolitana - La Habana) during the early morning hours. I assume this is for filler. Similarly, it has been noted in the past that virtually any Cuban net program can often be substituted on any Cuban frequency, so don't be suprised to find a different net program on unlisted frequencies on occasion. (Note that some frequencies already have more than one net outlet in operation, i.e. 590 now has Reloj & Rebelde transmitters, 640 with Progreso & Rebelde, 680 with Rebelde & Progreso, 910 with Reloj & Cadena Agramonte, 920 with Progreso &

\$ The 1180 Reloj outlet is most often found on 1179.5a with hetting on 1180 (R. Marti).

Anyone know of any Cubans from these nets still using 730, or other frequencies? A couple years ago I recall Gerry Thomas-FL reporting a Progreso Cuban on 890 - is this still on? Every outlet listed above has actually been heard here in Pittsburgh and by numerous other US/Canadian DXers --- so look for them TVocal
