"Idaho was state #4 for me back in 1961, right after Wash./Calif./Oregon.  KGEM-1140 (Idaho is the GEM stateSMM) was the first logging, with KIDO- 630 also heard that first year. (KBOI-670 didn't exist until 1968, it was still on 950 kHz. back then.)				
"Today, if I need Idaho for a contest, I tune to the stations on 580 (KFXD)/ 630 (KIDO)/670 (KBOI), and whichever ID's first is the one I use; they're all nighttime regulars. Ditto KGEM-1140, which is loud along w/KRAK here.
