When I joined, I had a little over 100 stations. In the past two months, this has gone to 127...more than ever logged in a comparable period of time. This expansion made it necessary for me to rearrange my log by frequency, instead of just recording them in the order I received them. I hope to buy myself a small tape recorder soon so I won't have to use my sister's and so I can send taped reports to stations I really want veries from. After reading the sheet on how to report reception to a station, I decided to try KOMA again, having sent them, in the past 6 months, two very inadequate reports (before I new any better!!) 12/7 MM I logged them easily from 0005 to 0032 and mailed the report that afternoon. I hope they verify now. Question: is WTAR's OTH in Tidswater? (Norfolk, BN) There is no such city listed in my White's log. Is this another one of its frustrating errors? 12/11 Logged HCJB Quito, Ecuador from 2215-2330 with a fair signal at what looked like 1580 kc, with EE. However at 2329 they said were broadcasting on 21 and 35 meter bands; said nothing about 1580 kc. I looked in my not-so-trust White's Log and found them listed at 6050 kc.!! I guess I can't count them can I? My radio also receives Coast Guard at 1280 kc. so I wasn't surprised as I might have been. 12/12 received a weak tone at about 1580 kc. and as it came out of a deep fade, I heard the tail end of an ID: "...Y, Colombia, testing" I think twas HJAY but I'm not sure. Hrd also a weak unID tone from 0248 to 0330 but couldn't tell exactly what frequency it was...something around 540-580 kc. I can't tell the frequency by looking at the dial and there is no stations on the air close enough to me to make an intelligent guess. Listened to CFOR for over an hour that morning, too, trying to get some reportable material. Even though they are not 1000 miles away, they are my most northerly station, to date.
